Budget 2009: A realistic and responsible budget

Budget 2009 was prepared with an eye to our residents' main concerns. Gatineau opted for prudence in its projections in order to avoid as much as possible any nasty surprises. Managing a city in full bloom is no easy thing. The demands are substantial and resources are limited. While higher levels of government may have increased their financial support to municipalities over the last few years, what they provide is far from sufficient, hence the need to provide cities with new sources of revenue.

For 2009, the municipal budget adjusts taxes by 2.2%, which is less than Canada's Consumer Price Index. This will enable us to maintain and enhance services to residents. The property tax is also adjusted by 0.7% to pursue implementation of the fire safety cover plan imposed by Quebec's Ministère de la Sécurité publique. Because of the measures taken by Gatineau to manage residual materials efficiently and responsibly, it has been able to freeze this year's rate at \$159.77

Partnership between Gatineau and Tricentris

Gatineau has signed an agreement with Tricentris to build and operate a recyclables sorting centre that will be up and running by 2011 in the environmental zone.

It should be noted that Tricentris is a not for profit organization, and one of the main players in Quebec when it comes to the volume of municipal waste processed.

The agreement with Tricentris specifies that it will:

- cover 100% of the investment in the infrastructures;
- start operations by 2011;
- construct a LEED building with a capacity of 70,000 tons;
- provide sufficient capacity for the next 20 years; and
- offer Gatineau membership status.

By the same token, Gatineau commits to:

- sell Tricentris a lot measuring approximately 25,000 m² in the environmental zone;
- maintain and promote recycling; and
- entrust all of its recyclables to Tricentris until April 13, 2017.

Gatineau's membership status will carry several benefits, including a seat on the board of directors, and dividends for awareness programs. The agreement also provides for an annual fixed cost of \$6.83 per ton in 2011, calculated as a proportion of Gatineau's population.

This agreement represents a partnership approach with an association of municipalities (more than 70) whose mission is to develop and increase awareness about recycling.
