#### REPORT OF THE GOVERNORS

The Governors have the honour to submit their S1st Annual Report of the Jeffery Hale's Hospital for the year ending 31st December 1946, and Reports of the following:—

The total number of patients for the year was 2,503 as against 2,338 in 1945, 2,377 in 1944, 2,446 in 1943, 2,033 in 1942, 2,098 in 1941.

The cost per day per patient was \$5.56 as against \$5.13 in 1945, \$4.86 in 1944, \$4.38 in 1943, \$4.59 in 1942, \$4.33 in 1941 and \$4.05 in 1940.

The Hospital Buildings and equipment have been kept in good repair.

The Pound Day held on May 12th amounted to \$973.30 in cash in addition to generous gifts of supplies.

Mr. F. D. Ross has been elected a Life Governor.

The Board wish to express their sincere appreciation to the Ladies of the Hospital's Auxiliary for the splendid work and assistance that they rendered the Hospital durind the past year.

#### REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT

To the President and Board of Governors, Jeffery Hale's Hospital, Quebec, P. Q.

Sir,

I have the honour to present this, the Annual Report of the Superintendent of Jeffery Hale's Hospital, for the year 1946, with attached detailed reports of hospital activities from those in charge of the various departments.

Annual reports are important milestones along the pathway of progress of any institution. When the institution deals with such important factors as the life, health and well being of the community, then such Annual Report becomes of more than local importance. The interest in this document must therefore be more intense among the cross section of the population that is specially concerned with this hospital's work and progress.

Such report is therefore an important milestone in the history of the hospital's work and endeavour, as it indicates how far the institution has proceeded along the pathway which leads to perfection, the goal of all hospital achievement. In arriving at perfection of service given to a Public that seeks our care, one cannot lose sight of the costs that such services entail, and the security of the institution giving such assistance. In the past costs and revenue had been fairly equalized but in the last two years things have been different and costs have over run receipts, consequently our efforts are now being directed towards striking a balance by endeavouring to augment revenues to meet increasing expenditures.

We are still struggling with problems due to the aftermath of war, and these deal with many phases of reconversion from war to peace. They are many, and include among others, shortages of man power, nursing, surgical instruments and equipment of all kinds, electrical and otherwise, drugs, provisions and finally construction materials.

The increasing high cost of all hospital necessities is a severe problem to those who are concerned with the finances of an institution such as ours. It is therefore noted with regret that this year's operations have produced a deficit larger than that noted in our Annual Report of 1945.

Examination of our figures shows that the increase of our deficit is explained by a gradual increased cost in most of our departments, but especially in two, namely, wages and provisions.

When there will be stability of costs in these two departments a great deal will have been accomplished to getting the hospital on a firmer base of security than any other effort achieved to date.

In the past wishful thinking motivated our hopes that this condition would soon improve but so far our hopes have not been realized. This is through no fault of the administration, as the cost of provisions and wages are out of our control.

Wages are still being increased and adjusted by a government instituted commission over which the administration has not any control. To date it may be stated without fear of contradiction that there has never been any downward trend in the adjustment of wages, at least as far as this hospital is concerned, and it is not probable that it will happen in the near future. The big question raised by this activity in the direction of higher wages and increasing costs is: Who is going to pay for them? Hospitals are already staggering under the burden of mounting costs.

Since 1939 the operating costs of hospitals in U.S. and Canada have gone up at least 40% and in some centres probably higher.

Most hospitals are not operated for profit. They are supported in part by philantropy and government payments for the care of the indigents. Patients fees are their major source of revenue, and at this moment the hospitals are meeting, as much as possible of the rise in their expenses, by charging patients more.

All agree however that the limit to what the public can pay has now nearly been reached, patients are now called on to disburse about as much as the traffic will bear, and some other way must be found to cover the cost rises.

The majority of hospital directors feel that in the long run, increased government support of one kind or another preferably more adequate reimbursement for the care of the indigent, is the solution. This Annual Report shows an outstanding milestone in the record of admission to our wards. In the report of 1945 it was shown that our total of admissions was 2,242 patients, that figure in addition to the number of inmates remaining in the hospital 31st December, 1944, some 96 in number, gave us a final total of 2,338, being our hospital population for 1945.

This year's report shows that our total admissions during the year 1946 were 2,393 accepted for treatment in our wards, being 151 patients more than in 1945. This figure should be augmented by 110 patients remaining in hospital on the 31st of December 1945, which brings up our total of hospital population to 2,503. This is a record figure. The highest number previously registered was in 1943 when our figures showed a total population of 2,426. This year's recorded figures are as previously stated 2,503, some 77 more than ever recorded in the history of this hospital. A record of service to community and government, of which all connected with the hospital should be justly proud.

Again as was stated in last year's report the figures submitted by the different departments are most gratifying and resemble the record of increased admissions for this year in so far as showing substantial rises in the numbers submitted for 1946.

Our out-door service which gave treatment to some 5,108 patients in 1945, now presents for the past 12 months an increase of 1,880 over that figure, a total of 6,988 people treated in the different out-door departments, with a total number of out-door visits of 10,524, as compared with 8,505 noted in our last Annual Report.

It is desired to bring to your attention a hitherto unnoted out-door activity that is a "Well Baby Clinic", operated by the General Turner V. C. Chapter, Imperial Order of the Daughters of the Empire. This should not be neglected as it held 23 clinics attended by Dr. D. MacMillan assisted by 5 members of the order. In all there were 571 examinations carried out, immunization done and 30 patients requiring treatment or hospitalization were referred to us for admission or referred to the different departments of out-door dealing with specialists examinations.

We also note from their report that the order paid to the hospital \$337.40 for such items as serum, drugs, milk and an item labeled "Christmas Cheer", which is self explanatory.

The Cameron Maternity Ward statistics are most encouraging, the record figures of admissions noted up to the end of 1945 was 358. This year our figures are 419, a most successful years work.

Compared with last year's statistics, all other departments, Radiology and Physiotherapy, Anaesthetics and Laboratory show substantial increases.

This successful year's work was carried out in spite of overworked medical staff and depleted and overworked nursing service. To them and the loyal support given by those working in the various departments and in other hospital activities, is due the thanks of all interested in this hospital's welfare and it is but just that the fact be brought to the notice of all concerned.

There has not been any change in the medical personnel during the past 12 months.

In the course of our past year's administration we have had most sympathetic co-operation and wholehearted support from those who administer the Public Charities Act. Our thanks are due to Dr. Jean Gregoire, Director of Public Health of the Province, and to his Honour, Judge Morin, the Recorder of the City of Quebec, and their respective staffs.

Our relations with the various government departments have also been most pleasant and I wish to thankfully acknowledge the assistance and very cheerful co-operation of the staffs of the Department of Veterans Affairs and of the Department of National Defence.

As mentioned in last year's report such statement is necessarily incomplete if it deals only with the activities begun, and terminated within the period covered by this statement. This is true in all cases and is specially true of our hospital's position at the present time. The Governors are aware of the situation and are taking measures to meet the demands made by the changing world conditions.

A hospital architect has been consulted and a report has been obtained, which is receiving serious attention from those in authority and in due time their decision will be known.

There are many factors than can and will influence the Governors in their decision.

From coast to coast hospitals are over burdened with patients and to meet this excessive demand for hospitalization all parts of hospitals are crowded with extra beds, so much so that in an institution of medium size, admissions apart from emergencies, are on a strictly priority basis.

All this is not an indication that the health of Canada's population has hit an all time low mark, just the contrary.

For one thing the public has lost its fear of hospitals and has now discovered the importance of health.

Non emergency surgery has increased and is still increasing tremendously. Prepayment hospitalization and medical care plans are booming, especially in this district and their thousands of members are now seeking in hospitals, the care which they once had in their own homes. The birth rate has gone up and the death rate down, as a result the population includes a greater proportion of people in the older age groups among whom sickness is more prevalent.

Changed economic conditions have forced a greater number to live in flats where there is not any space for the care of the sick in such restricted areas.

Recent medical advances demand equipment and procedures that make hospitalization necessary now, where it was not considered necessary previously.

Busy doctors and the scarcity of private nurses are forcing patients into hospital thus relieving the doctor from the burden of making rounds of visits to private homes and permitting the patients to share in the skilled nursing available in institutions.

Most of these factors started before the war and grew with it, multiplying a hundred fold.

This situation is known to all and efforts are being made to relieve it, at least in some measure, by providing more hospital accomodation. To this end the four large hospitals in this city have all increased or are increasing their bed capacity in the past two years; one of them has more than doubled its bed capacity by erecting a large nine story annex to the original hospital.

The authorities of this hospital are not ignorant of these factors, but they also know that the rising cost of living and production of building materials have sent the cost of construction up to unprecedented heights, even if the building materials could be easily obtained, which is not certain, the cost of new construction might be considered almost prohibitive at the present time.

Uncertain world wide conditions, especially economic states may also be a factor in dealing with the decision as to making a change in our hospital buildings.

A sane and safe line of conduct under such uncertain conditions will require time and thought before arriving at a sound decision.

In conclusion this report shows that the hospital has had a most successful year, the high standard of medical service is maintained, and all connected with the hospital look forward with hope to a continuation of such good work during the coming year.

#### REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF NURSES

Quebec, February 11th, 1947.

To the President and Board of Governors, Jeffery Hale's Hospital, Quebec, P. Q.

#### Gentlemen:

I have the honour to present the forty-fifth Annual Report of the Jeffery Hale's Hospital, School of Nursing, for the year ended the thirty-first of December 1946.

In the past year many problems and difficulties have arisen, the most important being the acute shortage of nurses. We had hoped once the war was over that this condition would be relieved, but with the war a year and more in the past, we have come to realize that this shortage of nurses is not a war-time but a peacetime problem and that we must find the underlying causes if our hospitals and schools are to continue to exist. A trend for increased demand for hospital care has been progressive over a number of years and a trend toward decreasing the hours of duty per nurse. With practically every family in the community taking Blue Cross insurance and agitation for shorter hours and increase in salary, these trends will continue to be progressive, and the acute shortage of graduate nurses will not be relieved until the Schools of Nursing enrol and graduate sufficient number to meet the modern demands on nursing service. The shortage of graduate nurses is undoubtedly partly due to the overcrowding of our hospitals with the aged and chronically ill. We have an increase in number of this type of patient because homes are not accepting this responsibility due to lack of help and necessary facilities. A second factor is the practice of admitting patients over and above the bed capacity without regard for the maintenance of a proper nurse-patient ratio. overcrowding and understaffing bring about undesirable working conditions, discourage the nurse and make it impossible for her to find satisfaction in her work of caring for patients. As a result the hospital loses her service to some other field of nursing.

In our School of Nursing we have not had a decreased number of applicants but we have had fewer applications with the necessary qualifications. Due to the fact that the same entrance requirements are demanded in the seven English schools of the Province, more students are applying to the larger schools in Montreal, as the young people of to-day do prefer the larger centres. All the small schools of nursing are experiencing this same difficulty and even the two small schools in the city of Montreal report this same problem. Before an application can be considered in a school of nursing, the candidate's academic standing must be accepted by a University in the Province. At the present time a plan is under discussion to train a group of workers to assist the nurses in hospitals, and a definite pattern for the training of the nursing assistant is beginning to take shape. While the need for such workers has been becoming more and more evident, the necessity of protecting the patients, the workers themselves and the nursing profession as a whole, has been prominent in the thinking of the Nursing Associations.

Our Graduation Exercises took place on Thursday evening, June the Sixth with Mr. J. T. Ross presiding. The invocation and benediction were given by the Rev. Donald MacKay, B.A. Th. B. and the address to the graduating class by Rev. John MacKay, B.A. B.D. Mr. James Boswell moved a vote of thanks to the speaker and the prizes awarded by the Board of Governors were presented by Mr. R. C. Webster to Mrs. Jean Nott and Miss Catherine Flett. The hospital diploma was presented to each member of the class bringing the total number of graduates to three hundred and thirty seven. Twelve preliminary students entered the school during the year and ten were accepted.

Fewer changes have occured in the permanent nursing staff but the general duty group continue to move to the larger centres usually because the salaries are more attractive. It is with regret that we report the resignation of Miss Annette Marsh, Supervisor of the Private Patients and Women's Surgical wards, for a period of three years. Our best wishes go with her as she commences her married life in England. We were fortunate in securing Mrs. C. Davidson to fill this vacancy. Miss Edith Coull resigned as ward supervisor of ward "O" and has been replaced by Miss Kathleen Forbes. Miss Elizabeth Frazer was appointed to our Military Ward

and Miss Marjorie Jones to the general duty staff. Miss Irene Matthew and Miss Dorothy Costello have been acting as assistant night supervisor and Miss Edith Taylor has joined the staff of the Douglas Wing. As our out-door department has been steadily increasing, we have realized for some time that a nurse in charge of out-door patients was an absolute necessity. During the summer we were fortunate in securing the services of Miss Louise Eager to fill this position. Miss Eager is one of our returned nurses from South Africa and with her breadth of experience is a most valuable addition to the staff. Miss Molly Taylor one of our nurses who served with the Navy during the war years, has been appointed to the X-Ray department. As a great many nurses returning from Over-seas have joined the nursing staffs of D.V.A. hospitals very few are available for civilian nursing service.

On the first Sunday in May, the Annual National Memorial Service for nurses was held in the Baptist Church, the Rev. C. W. Cook conducting the service.

During November and December Miss Nan Humphries gave a series of lectures on home nursing to a group of St. John Ambulance students. Even though this additional work was a sacrifice we were very happy that a member of the staff was willing to assume this additional responsibility as Mrs. Jamieson has never at any time ignored an appeal for help. I gratefully acknowledge the assistance given by both the St. John Ambulance and Red Cross helpers.

In the spring of 1946 the Women's Auxiliary of the hospital was started and I feel that a well merited tribute should be paid to Mrs. Lennox Teakle for organizing and acting as President during the first and most difficult year. Had it not been for her interest and enthusiasm I feel that this very important and necessary work of the hospital might never have been started. To the Executive, Convenors of all committees, and to every member of the auxiliary I gratefully acknowledge the contribution that each one has given and hope that this excellent work will be continued through the years. Their most outstanding accomplishment has been the equiping of a special room in the Obstetrical department where the babies food is precared. This money was obtained by holding a hospital tag day.

The responsibilities of the medical staff are numerous, nevertheless they have given generously of their time to the

School for teaching and medical care. We gratefully acknowledge this help without which our school curriculum could not be carried.

Representatives from the Red Cross visit the Veterans every Saturday afternoon and distribute cigarettes and candy. The patients were generously remembered at Christmas and during the holiday season a group of carol singers came to the wards and brought happiness and enjoyment they would otherwise have missed. We very much appreciate this visit from the Red Cross at this season of the year and we are particularly grateful to Mr. C. Dunn for planning this form of Christmas cheer. Miss Maud Thomson continues her faithful visits to the seamen, taking care of all requests.

Christmas in the hospital would not be Christmas without Dr. Carter very generously giving his time to act Santa Claus and it was evident that the most depressed patients in the wards forgot their aches and pains for at least the time being, and responded to his happy personality.

Miss Frances Rhodes assisted by Mrs. William Soles, representing the General Turner Chapter of the I.O.D.E. have faithfully distributed books and magazines to the patients from their library. This opportunity of getting reading material is much appreciated.

Many times during the year there were numerous problems and difficulties that seemed unsurmountable and if the Board of Governors had not always given a sympathetic hearing and offered assistance toward a solution, a Supt. of Nurses could easily have been caught in a whirlpool of discouragement. It is important that we, whose mission it is to help others, have courage to go forward unafraid into an unknown future, with faith in ourselves, faith in our profession and the ultimate solution of our problems.

#### TREASURER'S REPORT

Our Operating Income for the year 1946 amounted to \$179,839.95 as compared with \$168,661.71 in 1945, and our Operating Expenses were \$245,708.24 as against \$200,984.08 the previous year, resulting in an Operating Loss of \$65,868.29, to which amount is added \$2,842.10 for Depreciation on Furniture and Equipment, making a total Debit of \$68,710.39.

Partially offsetting this loss our Endowment Revenue provided \$37,756.23, Interest and Discount \$330.75 and our Annual Public Appeal realized \$11,678.95 making a total of \$49,765.93 from these various sources, and thereby reducing the loss for the year to \$18,944.46. This latter amount increases our accumulated Deficit from former years to \$36,481.14.

During the past year Jeffery Hale's Hospital, together with other similarly administered Hospitals, has had to cope with the continued problem of steadily rising costs and particularly from the excessive demands of Wages — now controlled by Government Legislation — and to the increased cost of Provisions and Supplies, the present situation being the most difficult ever experienced and the only apparent solution is an increase in our Hospital Rates, or a Government Grant — possibly both.

A Legacy of \$24,918.90 was gratefully received from the Estate of the late Geo. B. Bacon, of Boston, and an amount of \$951.76 realized from the Redemption of Securities over Book Value, which items as in the past, have been credited to Capital Account.

The Books of the Hospital have been duly audited and the Securities verified by Messrs. McDonald, Currie & Co., Chartered Accountants.

Mrs. Patterson entertainment Convenor report Carol singing on Dec. 23rd which was greatly appreciated by the patients. Plans are being made to show movies from the Board of Education once or twice a month.

Mrs. Jennings, Sewing Convenor, gave a detailed report of various garments made, namely, X-Ray gowns, binders, Scultetis binders, masks etc.

Mrs. Fackney reported briefly on the dressing situation, that literally millions had been made during the year. She requested that more members form groups for this work.

Mrs. R. Studor, House Convenor reported that the equipment for the Infant Formula Room had been installed in Ward G. This consisted of a Frigidaire, a three burner Electric Stove, a Table, and a sink. The ceiling light has been ordered. It was decided to purchase a suitably inscribed plaque for the door. Two adjustable wheel chairs have also been ordered.

The President then addressed the meeting saying that the first year of our Auxiliary had been rather difficult but most successful and thanked the Executive, the Convenors and the members for their loyal support.




