## **INITIAL CONTACT**

Complementary to the information provided in the classes for patients at the Centre intégré de cancérologie de Laval (CICL), the interdisciplinary team at the Centre has produced some informative videos for its clientele.

Produced in French and English, these videos respond to the patients' needs for information when they are required to consult with a specialist at the CICL following a cancer diagnosis. The videos strive to increase client awareness of the care and services offered. Three videos are available: one that introduces the CICL to the patient,

another describing the chemotherapy treatments that are offered, and a third explaining the radiotherapy treatments.
