In all, 48 giant billboards were installed, in the form of cylinders, emblematic of the factory chimney of the industrial time of the region, emphasizing images of women who marked the history of Quebec and in particular the geographical sector of the channel of Lachine. Names go from Marguerite Bourgeoys, Gabrielle Roy, Lise Payette, Phyllis Lambert, Dominique Michel, Diane Dufresne and others.
