As I grew older, my interest in the game waned as the league expanded and I began to notice those things called 'girls,' but my dislike for the Habs remained at the central core of my being.

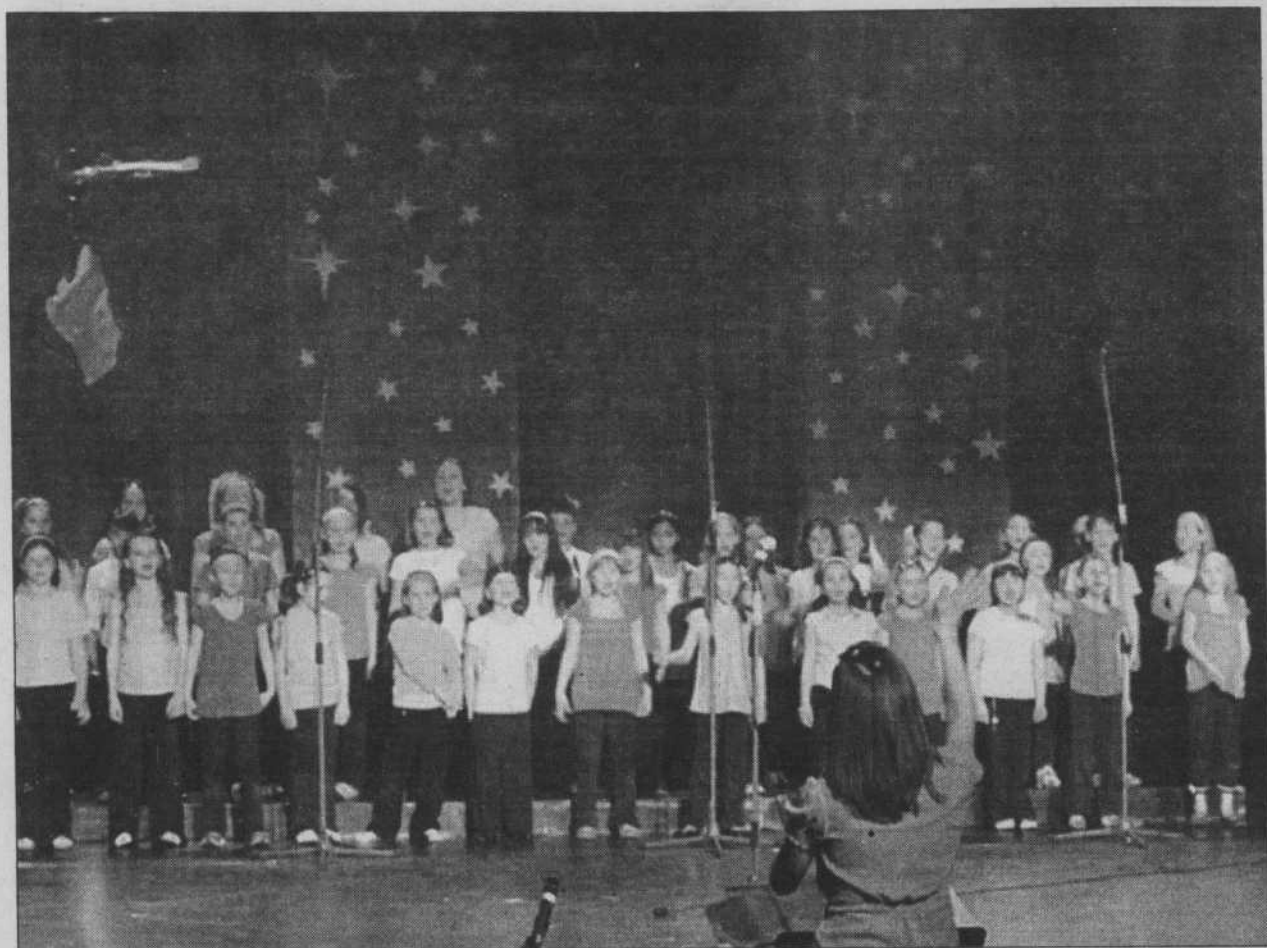

Kids changing the world

The kids are all right. Actually, they're more than all right. The students of Sherbrooke Elementary School will be singing, dancing and acting up a storm next week for a one-night-only show that music teacher Tracey Rivette guarantees will make a difference.

"We are giving something, we are doing something to touch the hearts of those we are singing to," says Rivette.

But she has a hard time explaining the impact. "It's not what the kids say, it's how they're looking when they're singing. It's how things feel in the room. They're singing a song and it just feels like a special moment."

That's the reward, Rivette says, that children discover after weeks and weeks of small sacrifices as everything finally comes together.

"Together We Can Change the World" is the story of young Peter Pessimism, who's feeling down because he has no purpose in life. He'll find one by the end of the evening.

Rivette enjoyed getting to know her students better - they usually see her only an hour a week - and teaching them about responsibility. "This is the one opportunity for the kids where they're not competing. It brings their voices and all their personalities together, like a team. They develop a sense of responsibility.

"A sport is instant fun. But when you pick up an instrument, a couple of weeks into it it's not fun anymore, it's work. You don't always want to practice... you might want to go outside and play, but you have to practice, because you don't want to let your team down."

Rivette began her teaching job devoting only 20 per cent of her time to music lessons, but time and lobbying eventually led to her full-time music-teaching status at Sherbrooke Elementary, a rarity at the Eastern Townships School Board.

As for the music show experiment, it's in its fifth year, and this year's event is at the Grenada Theatre. But why book an expensive, professional room for a bunch of, well, children? "Because the kids deserve it," Rivette says. "They work so hard. The quality is worth doing it in a big theatre."

There used to be auditions, but now all interested kids are accepted into the choir - 65 this year - though the six actors must still audition. The only other requirement is that they be in Grade 2 at least, for reasons of maturity. And of course, the kids must be able to read the words they're singing.

This musical also features dancers and a rock band. "It's pretty cool." There's pop and rock, but no heavy metal, Rivette sheepishly admits, though she tries to find value in every style of music (she's from Cornwall and grew up with country music, and was classically trained in voice at McGill University, but loves Celtic and folk, and also plays the guitar).

The project's not really about her musical interests, though, but about those of her young charges. It's important to connect the show with what's playing on the children's iPods, Rivette says, yet to pass on a useful message. The musical was a joint work, written by Rivette and a student teacher and others who helped out at different times. It's directed by Rivette and Jeanne-Mance Fortin.

The SES spring concert is at 7pm on Wednesday, May 19 at the Granada Theatre on Wellington Street in downtown Sherbrooke. Piano accompaniment by Champlain College's Fanny Gaudette. Tickets are \$7 for children and \$10 for adults; call 819-562-3515.

Music at the end of the Rainbow

Philippe Custeau spends a lot of time on a song, knowing that if it becomes a hit, he may be forced to perform it every couple of weeks for the rest of his life.

"We want to make sure we're always putting out something good," says Custeau, the lyrics writer, dobro and piano player for local fan favorites Jake and the Leprechauns. "If I can't see myself playing that song two years down the road," Custeau confesses, "if it doesn't grow on me..." his voice fades out. If he doesn't truly love the song, it gets junked. Think of it as quality control. A lot of that likely went into Custeau's last year of work, as his band Jake and the Leprechauns will launch its third album next month. At Midnight, The Birdsong was produced by Mark Lawson of Arcade Fire, mixed by Michael Neron, and features appearances by Patrick Watson drummer Robbie Kuster and Blue Rodeo's Bob Egan.

This album comes with big names and big expectations for a band that has been pumped up by local music journalists as one of the best the region has to offer, not to mention one of the best morose alt country bands ever.

The new album, Custeau notes, will offer a slightly different sound, a bit more upbeat and a bit less country. Finishing touches and a final launch date are being finagled as you read this. In the meantime, there are also upcoming Townships gigs to prepare for. On Friday, May 21, Jake and the Leprechauns perform two sets at a special dinner event at Wellington Street's hip Antiquarius café (Custeau's brother is a co-owner). It's a much more intimate show than they're used to, Custeau says. For a more raucous evening, check out the July 18 show at the Vieux Clocher de Magog, and on Aug. 26 they're in Lac Megantic at the Parc des veterans, for their first performance at the annual Lac on Fête, where bands from around the province pop by to play on the lakeshore for small but enthusiastic nature-loving crowds.

Custeau owns a chiropractic business with other family members, but he's focussing right now on artistic projects. He's writing a second novel and has a Toronto literary agent, but won't give anything away about the plot. He's "one of their young proteges," he says, and hopes to have the first and second novels published simultaneously.

There's also a planned collaboration with Joseph Boyden, the winner of the 2008 Giller book prize. Boyden is working on a third book of fiction, and he's told Custeau he'll get a chance to see the manuscript. Custeau hopes to release an album based on the book's themes (Boyden's publisher did not return a request for details before deadline). "When a book comes out for [Boyden]," says

Custeau, "he basically tours the world. It's big enough for me that he allowed me to read the manuscript!" Custeau hopes to pull in other top names: "It's a more costly project than we're used to," he says.

Jake's second album has sold perhaps 2,000 copies, and Custeau still personally delivers them weekly to Archambault in Sherbrooke (the band's biggest sales outlet), and snail-mails CDs to small shops located in the farther regions of the Eastern Townships. The band has just signed its first distribution deal, and has a promoter to push the new album nationally. "Distribution is good," Custeau says, "but people have to order the record."

But for Custeau, the new album is already so last year. "This album is going to come out in a month, but those songs are already old for me! I'm working on new songs."

The lyricist is sometimes teased about his cryptic songs. He says words need to be fuzzy: "It needs to be suggestive to the listener, that it bring an image to mind. But there needs to be enough room to create on their own. That balance is a delicate one. Like good poetry, it brings something to me."

Custeau's other Leprechaun half is lead vocalist C-Antoine Gosselin, who receives lyrics via email and creates music for them. "The music always gives more meaning for me. The song takes on a life of its own," says Custeau.

There are up to six people in the band, but these two are its nucleus. They even record rough takes before they rent expensive sound studios, allowing other musicians to hear what's desired. "We do everything differently than most

people do," says Custeau. "We'll book a studio for a couple of weeks, we know what we want. Our bass player and drummer are really good friends, and they know exactly what we do. It's basically perfect on the first try."

The band doesn't tour so much — it's oldest member is 40, some have children, and Custeau himself is 33. "We're past the age when six guys in a van want

to travel around the country sleeping on floors." Having said that, the band is "very active" — being ignored in the press means a fickle audience may forget them.

Three upcoming gigs and a new album should fix that. Find Jake and the Leprechauns at jakeandthelprechauens.com.

Remembering the King of Pop



Remember the King of Pop grabbing his crotch and balancing on his tiptoes? You can relive that moment – and you should. Because for all that we laughed about Michael Jackson – and sometimes were upset by him – his music defined a generation.

Thriller was Jackson's sixth studio effort, released in 1982, and some 100 million copies have been sold. Jackson went on to use his stardom to break down racial barriers (one video showed black, white and Asian faces morphing from one to the other), and made eccentricity into big news for the supermarket tabs.

Centennial is bringing in Classic Albums Live: Thriller, in October. Musicians will recreate every note from that album on stage.

The show is part of the High Five! Series, which includes:

- *Haligonian Joel Plaskett, winner of the 2010 Indie Award for Solo Artist of the Year who also picked up a Juno in April in the Adult Alternative category.

- *Vancouver's Delhi 2 Dublin, a band that mashes up bhangra, Celtic and Dub

- *The "back-porch rusticism" of Toronto folk-rocker Basia Bulat

- *And Lily Frost, whose latest, *Viridian Torch*, is a departure, according to her website: "We were used to thinking of Lily as a creature of the urban landscape, of the night, a torch singer and chanteuse in the Julie London tradition, whose sultry singing is best imagined soaring above the smoke of some dimly lit nightclub or speakeasy. But for inspiration, this time, Lily has tapped into the wilderness of Canada, of ancient trees, terrifying electric storms, irritating insects, and romance with the land, as expressed in French poetry—specifically, a corner of Lake Huron her family has called its own for three generations."

New season at Centennial

Centennial Theatre is not a place to see the latest pop sensation. Director Luce Couture and her staff book shows at least a year in advance – which means May's Top 10 hit-maker might get to Lennoxville in 2012.

"The pop artists are even more difficult," says Couture. The newest flash in the pan always performs in downtown Sherbrooke: "We don't do that. We receive subsidies from Canada and Quebec, and we have a public mandate for a variety of shows in a variety of disciplines."

That means modern dance, it means world music, it means string quartets. But don't think that makes Centennial boring. The just-announced 2010-11 season features a mix of the fun and the truly famous that's actually quite impressive.

Couture is most proud of snagging the Trio Tanya Tagaq. The Nunavut throat singer has worked with modern classical greats the Kronos Quartet and pop oddity Bjork. "(Tagaq) is a major artist in the world," brags Couture. "It's not often you get that. She's so intense, you cannot stay insensible to her presence on stage."

In fact, Couture says, she checks out most acts before she books them.

Tagaq is in Lennoxville in February, and is part of the Vivat Series, one of the seven series of the next performance season, billed as "Sheer Brilliance" by the Centennial team. Buying season tickets to one of the series before June 30 is a \$90 to \$115 outlay for four or five shows, depending on the series. (And the JET 7 card, Couture offers, gives you any three shows and four movies).

Vivat is the most mixed series, and launches in November with Norman, a tribute to National Film Board pioneer Norman McLaren. He created animation effects that had never been seen, and helped turn film-making into a true art form. "I'm most proud of (booking) Tanya Tagaq as an artist," says Couture, "but I'm most proud of bringing in Norman as a show. I've been three years working on this."

"It's one of the best shows I've seen in years, and I see a lot of shows."

Norman appeared to rave reviews at Montreal's Place des Arts, and it's a multimedia homage with holograms and live action. It's this reviewer's must-see recommendation of the season.

Also in the Vivat Series is Circa, the Australian circus arts group, and *Dulcinea's Lament*.

Remember Don Quixote, who builds himself a suit of armour and assaults the arrogant and the simply confused as he travels the world? Quixote's priest believes firmly that his era's pulp fiction – romantic tales of knights-errant battling for justice – have driven the good parishioner mad, and so burns the books in a giant bonfire. But in fact Quixote has taken not books, but the (ahem) noble and (ahem) fair maiden (and barmaid) *Dulcinea* as his

muse, and loves her chastely. *Dulcinea Langfelder & Co.* mix text, song and dance to explore the life of the absent heroine.

For all these big name acts, Couture can get frustrated. Centennial doesn't have high audience numbers. For some reason, Sherbrooke residents won't make the trip down to Lennoxville. There might be some sort of odd worry about coming into the strange world of anglophones?

"I can't explain it," Couture says. "We've increased the number of people coming this year. It's word of mouth, more and more people know it's okay to come here! If you're in downtown Sherbrooke, it's the same distance, 7km, to come here as to go to the Centre Culturel (located at the Université de Sherbrooke). The same distance!"

Couture admits that Centennial, located on the joint Bishop's University and Champlain College campus, suffers from certain problems. The signage (good luck trying to find Centennial in the dark if you're a newbie), the lighting problem, finding a convenient parking spot on a night when classes have pulled in dozens of students who also need parking.

As for the theatre itself, the number of tickets sold must be restricted to even fewer than the usual 550 or so when an Italian style staging is required – that's normal for dance, where artists must be at the front of the stage or the sightlines for those seated at the far sides of the room are impossible. Seating is limited to 400 for dance.

But Centennial Theatre also has some great pluses, she adds. "I love the fact you feel this intimacy in the hall. Wherever you are, there's a warmth. You're so much closer."

WHAT ELSE?

There are seven series in total for the Centennial 2010-11 season.

- * Music, C'est Chic! features Wop Wow Wow (six Italian musicians from Montreal do jazz, pop, rock); Jill Barber and Michael Kaeshammer (chanteuse and boogie-woogie pianist); Emilie-Claire Barlow (jazz); Chic Gamine (percussion, harmonies, world music); Meaghan Smith (swing).

- * The World at Your Feet Series features Deolinda (Portuguese influenced); Jayme Stone (award-winning world music); Monica Freire (Brazilian roots); Bambara Trans (mixing the African with the North American); and the George Gao Ensemble (erhu and pipa players).

- * Undeniable Jazz features Andre Leroux, Robin McKelle, Yves Leveille Quartet, Yannick Rieu and the Spectrum, and Brandi Disterhoff. "There's no pop in here," confirms Couture. "These are artists dedicated to jazz."

- * Tutto Danza, in collaboration with the Université de Sherbrooke's Centre Culturel, presents *Le Carre des Lombes*; Fortier Danse-Creation; Trial and Eros; Compagnie Mayday; The 605 Collective.

- * The Gems! Series includes stunning classical musician Lara St-John; Marie-Josée Lord; Bataclan; Ensemble Made in Canada; plus a "to be announced" show in collaboration with the nearby Bandeen Hall.

The Wright Stuff

Country singer Chely Wright, 39, came out publicly last week and announced that she is a lesbian. She confirmed the news in an interview with People magazine and said that she had been holding back in order to protect her career.

Chely Wright is also currently on her media tour for her new album, the first in over 5 years, titled *Lifted Off the Ground* and for her memoir, 'Like Me'. But sadly, since her coming out, the topic of her being gay is front and center and gets more attention than her new work.

Her book follows the singer's story from her Kansas childhood through her rise as a country music singer. She chronicles her dreams and aspirations of a career in music, and the harsh realities of recording contracts and concert tours.

The artist shares stories from her seven trips overseas to perform for U.S. troops, as well as her friendships with stars like Vince Gill and Brad Paisley, whom she dated for a while.

Her accomplishments came at a very high price, forcing her to lie and pretend that this part of her life didn't exist along with the shame, and her struggles with integrity. It was the price she chose to pay in order to live her dream and become a country music star.

Now with her admitting her sexual orientation, the publication of her memoir and the release of a new album Chely Wright is finally living free.

Sadly enough, people have been very unkind to her since the news came out. She has been accused of using her coming out as a big marketing plan for her new album. The comments everywhere are mean and disrespectful. What the future has in store for her is hard to predict.

She has always been a great singer/songwriter and that hasn't changed at all. Chely Wright released her debut album, *Woman in the Moon*, back in 1994 and won the Academy of Country Music Award for Best New Female Vocalist in 1995.

Since her debut she has released seven studio albums with more than fifteen singles hitting the Country charts. In 1997, she released 'Shut Up and Drive' her first Top 40 single on the Country charts. In 1999, she scored her first #1

song with 'Single White Female'. Over the years, Wright got numerous awards and nominations from both the Academy of Country Music and the Country Music Association.

Chely Wright is also the founder of the Reading, Writing and Rhythm Foundation, a non-profit charity dedicated to improving education in America's public schools. The Foundation has donated musical instruments and funds to schools nationwide. She has moved from Nashville and now lives in New York City.

Her brand new album, on Vanguard Records was produced by Rodney Crowell. It includes eleven songs all written by Wright except for the song 'Heavenly Days' which she co-wrote with Crowell.

Overall, the collection is very smooth. There's nothing really country on this album but it is still a gem. Those who like Wright's work will find her better than ever, just a lot less commercial sounding.

'Broken' is about lovers and you can hear the pain when she sings 'So here we are, just you and me/The sum of all our injuries' while 'Wish Me Away' is one of several very vulnerable moments for the artist. Wright delivers every number using very smooth and intimate tones.

There's real humour in 'Notes to the Coroner', a playful take on heartbreak; and Wright is really upset on 'Damn Liar', a kiss-off that more than a few people will relate when you hear her sing 'You're scared to death that I'll run into/The one before me you put through hell'.

There are moments of breathtaking truth, from the swaying waltz of 'Like Me' ('Who's gonna end up holding your hand?/A beautiful woman or a tall handsome man?') to the raw honesty of the closer 'Shadows Of Doubt' ('And right now you don't call me friend/But I'm still here where I've always been'). She's a poignant accomplished songwriter. Every moment rings with absolute honesty.

The entire collection showcases an artist who has undergone a dramatic artistic transformation, emerging as a singer/songwriter of the first order. But the new album would never have come to be what it is if not for an equally dramatic personal transformation, which she has candidly and painstakingly documented in her memoir.

Who cares if she is gay or straight? It doesn't really matter. Wright's *Lifted Off the Ground* speaks highly for itself and should resonate as great work. Her fans will recognize her wit and talent.

This album may be described as haunting and the music is beautiful and addictive. It's definitely not as commercial or upbeat as some of her prior work. Still this is the Chely Wright that we love, whose life has taken her on a different journey.

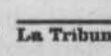

Defining the undefinable



STYLE FILES WITH TUESDAY'S CHILD

Imagination is more important than knowledge. - Albert Einstein

Epiphanies - few and far between, sparkly little things, silvering grey matter, snap crackle popping their way through your cerebral hemispheres. Somewhere lightbulbs light up, burn out, maybe even burst. During an interview this week for DH Radio on CJMQ (inspired by the Dishpan Hands that runs Wednesdays in this very publication), I had one of those moments.

The interviewee was Ryan Kamstra, of Toronto band Tomboyfriend - an encyclopedia eclectica of a group of musicians, taking the stage with props and costumes galore, each song a feisty bonanza of goodness.

So what kind of band is Tomboyfriend? We've entered a musical

phase that defies all order....never mind category. This may frustrate the music biz, and perhaps the music stores the most. When an artist's influences are as vast as the pool available to Gen. X performers is, methinks we need a new system.

Case in point: a child of the 1980's, I remember the earlier days of music that was dubbed "alternative" - it wasn't particularly radio friendly as a rule, tended to include relatively dark and mature subject matter, was poetic and a little harsher. It was the time when I distinctly felt my parents not understanding what I was listening to, let alone why

I was listening to it. At some point in the mid-1990's, the "alternative" category seemed to become a plunking ground for anything that the music industry didn't know what to do with. The more unusual or new-sounding the music got, the less of a fit there was for a whole plethora of new musical groups gaining a following.

With bands like Tomboyfriend, a gang commonly found to be approaching the range of a dozen artists on stage rocking out in sweet mad harmony, including a bio-chemist and a poet among other nifty, bright band members, perhaps the record companies and track

slingers like HMV are going to have to take a new approach. I'm warning you though, it's going to take some schooling on the clerks' parts. Maybe everything will have to go alphabetical, and then a touch screen with the following exercise could be found:

- 1) Enter your three favourite colours.
- 2) Do you prefer: a) checkerboard b) plaid or c) polka dots.
- 3) Name six musicians you would love to have supper with.
- 4) What books have you read more than twice?

There could be a myriad of questions. You could fill it out any number of times, in any type of mood. Once your questionnaire has been completed, based on you that day, suggestions of bands would come up. If you're like me, seeing a familiar face on the bill for a new TV show can determine whether or not you watch it. Certain actors tend to stick to certain styles or genres; for example, knowing in advance that a movie stars Jim Carrey or a show stars Kevin Sorbo provides insight into the quality and type of entertainment you can expect and help you

decide whether or not to watch it.

As a film and TV fanatic, I tend to keep track of what kinds of projects my favorite actors are working on, or what kind of actors my favorite projects are casting, on sites like "http://www.imdb.com" (the god of my idolatry) and "www.cinematical.com." While Web Therapy is produced independently (sorta, it's sponsored by Lexus) similar star-studded shows are popping up on network sites. The WB ran a web series called Childrens' Hospital in 2008 created by Rob Corddry (The Daily Show) and starring Michael Cera (Juno, Arrested Development), Megan Mullally

(Will & Grace). Unfortunately, since the WB is an American network I've yet to find Childrens' Hospital streaming on a Canada-friendly site but it has great reviews. Woke Up Dead, a self-explanatory zombie series starring Jon Heder (Napoleon Dynamite) was recently picked up by Showcase to stream on their website after airing on www.crackle.com. It also stars Wayne Knight (Newman from Seinfeld), Krysten Ritter (Gilmore Girls, Veronica Mars) and Daniel Roebuck (Matlock, Dr. Arzt on Lost).

Movies under the sun

Oh, but the movies are glorious. But a proper night out at a movie house gazing up at the silver screen is ever more rare — even as movies themselves, like the 3D blockbuster *Avatar*, are becoming more expensive to make for the producers and need ever more viewers to make them financially worthwhile.

In fact, some Townships venues that regularly show English-language flicks com-

pletely shut down during the summer. The Town of Brome Lake offers a movie a month — but not, for example, over the summer. And this month, Centennial Theatre in Lennoxville announced that it's finally giving up completely on its money-losing film series.

"Movies are facing some very significant challenges in terms of their financing," says Steven Woodward, a film professor at Bishop's University. He says few of his students bother going out to the theatre anymore. What few movies they watch are downloaded from the Internet or seen on DVD.

"Only by making very expensive, visual-effects-driven films like *Avatar* can the studios get an audience to actually go to the cinema," says Woodward.

"Three-D, which has been tried many times in the past, is the latest gimmick designed to get people back to the cinema.

Other technologies that were used in the past to pull audiences into the cinema were colour and widescreen, both in the 1950s when TV was becoming the predominant form of entertainment."

But Townships entrepreneurs aren't giving up on the big screen this summer quite yet. It's just that the focus is different, the audience more targeted. Sutton's Salle Alec Gerard Pelletier schedules the occasional English-language (or subtitled) movie. On Sunday, May 23 (at 1:30pm), there's *H2Oil*, a Canadian documentary about Alberta's oil sands. (You can pick up a Salle program in municipalities around Sutton, or check

them out online.)

Centennial Theatre, which has been showing movies since the late 1980s, has tossed in the towel. But movies still matter, says Centennial director Luce Couture.

A special deal worked out with Sherbrooke's downtown Maison du Cinema offers four movies and three live Centennial shows (plus various other discounts) with the JET card. "We're still building cinema [audiences]," says Couture, "but we believe in collaboration. And there's no limit date for the card."

In fact both Maison du Cinema and Galaxy Sherbrooke have made solid commitments to English-language film, often showing multiple Hollywood flicks in their original versions in any one week. Cowansville's Princess Theater has in the past regularly included English in its weekly lineup.

Perhaps most impressively, the Orford Arts Centre has such faith in the importance of the silver screen that it is launching an entirely new summer film festival — showing real classics. The Orford Film Club premieres June 14th at 8pm with Charlie Chaplin's *City Lights*, a stunning 1931 film (in English with French subtitles). Entry is free, and the series continues Mondays through to Aug. 9. More than half are either in English or feature English subtitles, and each film is introduced by Orford Artistic Director Jean-Francois Rivest. There's *Citizen Kane*, *The Last Temptation of Christ*, and *Amadeus*. (Check out the Arts Centre's website or pick up a program for the complete lineup.) Subtitles aren't for everyone, but film professor Steven Woodward has no problems with them. In fact, they can be a plus.

"The movies have always been a commercially driven enterprise, so their makers nearly always want them to be distributed to the broadest-possible audience and are willing to do what is necessary to allow this. In the era of the silent cinema (pre-1929), films could be shown anywhere in the world just by changing the intertitles. Now, we need subtitles or dubbing in order to let that happen.

"My knowledge of French (and other languages) is not sophisticated enough for me to understand francophone Quebec movies without subtitles, so I'm happy that they're there. They don't interfere very much with me watching the film since I can read them very quickly.

"However, I believe that subtitles do make audiences respond to films in a more rational and literal way since they switch on that part of our brains associated with reading. Perhaps that's why we tend to see foreign films with subtitles as more sophisticated and intellectual."

Louise Abbott presents Eeyou Istchee: The Land of the Cree

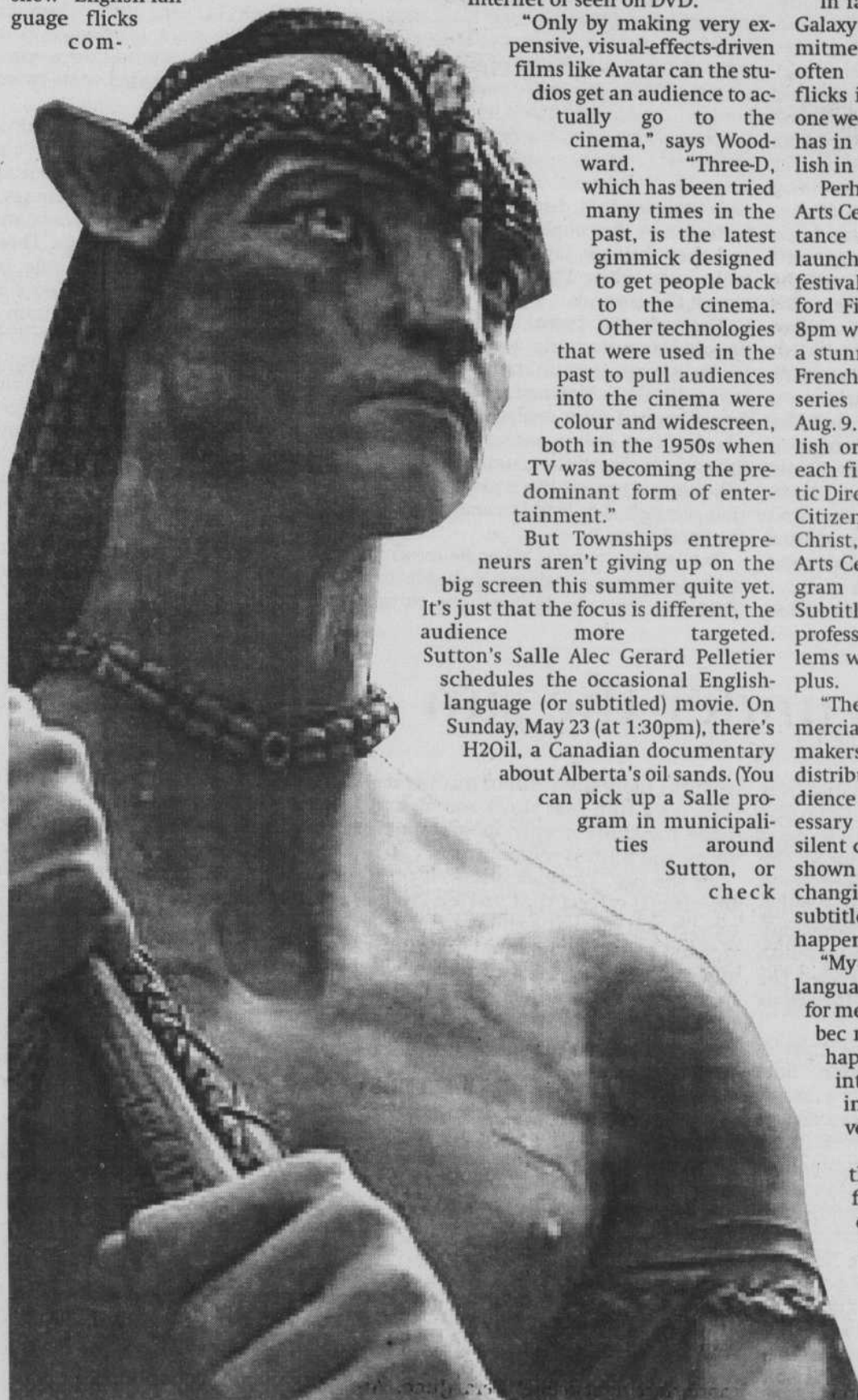

On Monday evening, May 17, writer, photographer, and filmmaker Louise Abbott will make a presentation about traditional and present-day Cree life in northern Quebec to the Eastern Townships Canadian Club at Hôtel Le Président, 3535 King W., Sherbrooke.

In collaboration with COTA (the Cree Outfitting and Tourism Association), Abbott and her husband, photographer Niels Jensen, are producing a photo book titled *Eeyou Istchee: The Land of the Cree*, scheduled for publication this fall. They have also produced several video documentaries for different Cree groups in the past two years. They have made nine trips to northern Quebec, traveling by land, sea, and air to document a wide variety of traditional Cree activities and events. They have visited remote fishing and hunting camps, and summer gatherings in historical encampment sites. They have witnessed the annual caribou and goose hunts; the trapping of marten, beaver, and rabbit; the scraping and stretching of pelts of different kinds; the setting of a gill net under the ice; and other traditions associated with catching, preparing, and preserving fish.

"Through our work up north," Abbott says, "Niels and I hope to introduce the Cree to people outside of northern Quebec. The mainstream media tend to focus on the problems of aboriginal communities. We're trying to show how the Cree are drawing inspiration from the land and from their traditions to confront problems head-on and move forward in the modern world. As Bradley Georgekish told us in Wemindji, "The old ways keep us balanced. They show us where we've been, and we need to know where we've been to know who we are and where we're going."

In her presentation to the Canadian Club on May 17, Abbott will share some of her video footage of the north, giving viewers insight into the lives and values of the Cree of yesterday and of today. The public is invited for 6:30 p.m. Canadian Club members are invited for 5:30 p.m. to attend the club's annual general meeting. Reservations are required. To reserve, please call 819-832-3308.



Taking things at face value

Sometimes appearances deceive

Everyone functions in life based on recognizing what is familiar, slotting new experiences into categories based on what's happened in the past. When we sit down we assume the chair will support us; when we eat a meal, we assume it won't poison us, and hopefully will taste good; out for a drive, we routinely step on the brake pedal, confident that our car will stop. Such actions are only reasonable and, indeed, necessary. We can't question everything around us or we would never get through the day. Nor should we; the vast majority of the time our assumption that something familiar will behave in a predictable way is borne out by experience.

But what if someone you knew — someone in fact very close to you — wasn't who or what you thought they were? What if your most important expectations were turned upside down, and

your comfortable, predictable world came crashing down around you?

It's a chilling thought, and one that makes for a riveting new thriller in the hands of Canadian crime writer Linwood Barclay.

Linwood Barclay

It's no secret that Canada has more than its share of world-class crime writers, not that this is a new phenomenon: Torontonians Peter Robinson and Maureen Jennings have been on the scene for more than twenty years, entertaining readers around the world. And more recently Louise Penny and Giles Blunt have earned global followings with their original, award-winning crime fiction. Now former journalist Linwood Barclay has clearly joined their ranks: his debut thriller *No Time for Goodbye* became 2008's bestselling crime novel in the UK on sales of over 600,000 copies, and has been translated into nearly three dozen languages; its sequel, *Too Close to Home* garnered the Crime Writers of Canada's Arthur Ellis Award for Best Novel of 2009. Nor is Barclay merely a one-trick pony: with his quirky sense of humour (he has published several darkly funny crime novels and was shortlisted for the Stephen Leacock Medal for Humour) Barclay is much in demand as an after-dinner speaker, and later this month will be the Master of Ceremonies at Toronto's Bloody Words, Canada's largest annual crime writing festival for authors and fans.

But this time the redoubtable author

has outdone himself, with a compelling, original standalone tale that will grip you from the opening pages and hold you in its grasp until the very end.

Never Look Away
(Doubleday, 2010)

Family time. Journalist David Harwood has planned an outing at a major amusement park with his troubled wife Jan and their four-year-old son Ethan. It is a day that will change their lives, utterly and forever.

By the time they arrive at the sprawling complex Ethan is nearly asleep. They load their son into a stroller and enter the park, and David goes ahead in search of some ice cream cones for the family. On his way back he spots his panic-stricken wife, bordering on the hysterical. She says she only turned away for a moment and the stroller, with their son in it, disappeared. A frantic search by the couple proves fruitless, and they split up, Jan heading for the main gate while David continues to search the grounds.

Through the crowd David spies a bearded man running away. Shifting his view he spots an unattended stroller in the distance. Making his way to it his fear is washed away, replaced by a sense of relief that only a parent can know: Ethan is in the stroller, unharmed and still asleep. It seems the crisis is over: all that remains is to find Jan and give her the good news.

But David is wrong. When he returns to the gate Jan is not there. He heads for their car, but she is nowhere to be

found. He tries her cell phone, but that too is fruitless. David notifies Security, and the police quickly respond, throwing up a perimeter around the park and searching all vehicles as well as the grounds. But David's problems are only beginning: a search of the amusement complex fails to turn up his wife, and most baffling of all, a check of surveillance tapes shows no record that she entered the park at all. The police begin to focus their attention on David, certain that he is keeping something from them (which he is). Just when he thought things were impossibly bad, they're about to get a whole lot worse.

A shocking plot, loaded with twists and turns

In April of 2009 I said that *Too Close to Home* was Barclay's best work to date. This book easily surpasses it; going from strength to strength Barclay combines a shocking plot, loaded with twists and turns, sub-plots and red herrings. There is a layer of authenticity to his tale, informed by Barclay's own experience as a journalist. Managing to maintain a high level of suspense while avoiding gratuitous violence, *Never Look Away* is a strongly written, fast-paced thriller that will appeal to readers looking for a cracking plot but without needless gore. A fine addition to the genre, it must already be considered as a serious contender for next year's Best Novel awards.

Barclay's next novel, *Only Death is Real*, is slated to come out in 2011, and I'm already looking forward to reading it.

Woodward is himself not so sure about starting up something new. He's considering offering a new series of films that have first been shown at the Toronto International Film Festival (TIFF). "I'm wary of making the arrangements for this because, like the Centennial film series, there's a good chance that not enough people will attend to make it worthwhile."

While Woodward saw *Avatar*, he

seems to prefer the older classics over the new (of *Avatar*, he wrote: "[N]o one cheered as the humans were shipped off or breathed deeply in awe as the credits rolled. They simply wandered out, dropping their 3-D glasses obligingly into little slots in big boxes outside the theater, perhaps content with knowing that they, too, attended the first run of the biggest box-office draw of all time").

The last movie he saw was Andrzej Zulawski's 1981 film *Possession*. "Sam Neill and Isabelle Adjani play a couple going through an extraordinary painful breakup. It's a horror-drama using expressionistic imagery, much in the vein of [Roman] Polanski's *Rosemary's Baby*, so the wife's infidelity is pictured in terms of her making love with an octopus-like creature. She murders all those men who find out about it, in quite gruesome ways. Zulawski is not interested in normal ways of representing the world in film and his extreme vision is, he feels, a much more

truthful representation of human nature. It's a film that shook me up and made me think deeply about human desire and human relationships."

In the end, Woodward says, it's not the special effects that matter: "If, by movies, you mean the ability to tell stories and represent the world in pictures and sounds, then movies have never been more important."

Whether on YouTube or in a cinema itself, they can help make sense of our world.

Movie nights have often been used as fundraisers by local groups, from students at Alexander Galt Regional High

School to the Bishop's University Pre-Med group. They can still book Centennial Theatre, but Development Officer Sonia Patenaude warns that a successful evening requires work and a solid amount of luck.

Centennial can only show second-run movies, not first-run Hollywood blockbusters.

Success "always depends on how well the fundraising team promotes and advertises, and also which movie is showing. Of course," adds Patenaude, "if only 40 people show up everybody loses."

"Movies are readily available on the Internet so unless the movie is shown opening weekend as they would at [a commercial movie house like] Maison du Cinema, people will not venture out of their home comfort zone.

"Kids' movies do much better, but again many factors contribute to success or failure — movie selection, timing, weather, other activities."

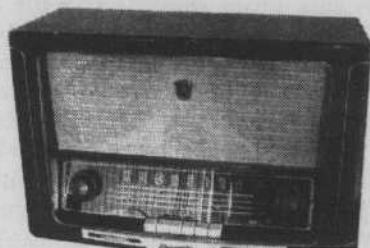

You may know David Anderson as a local photographer who has worked for The Record and other Townships papers over the years, but probably not as Radio Communautaire Missisquoi's (RCM's) new sales manager.

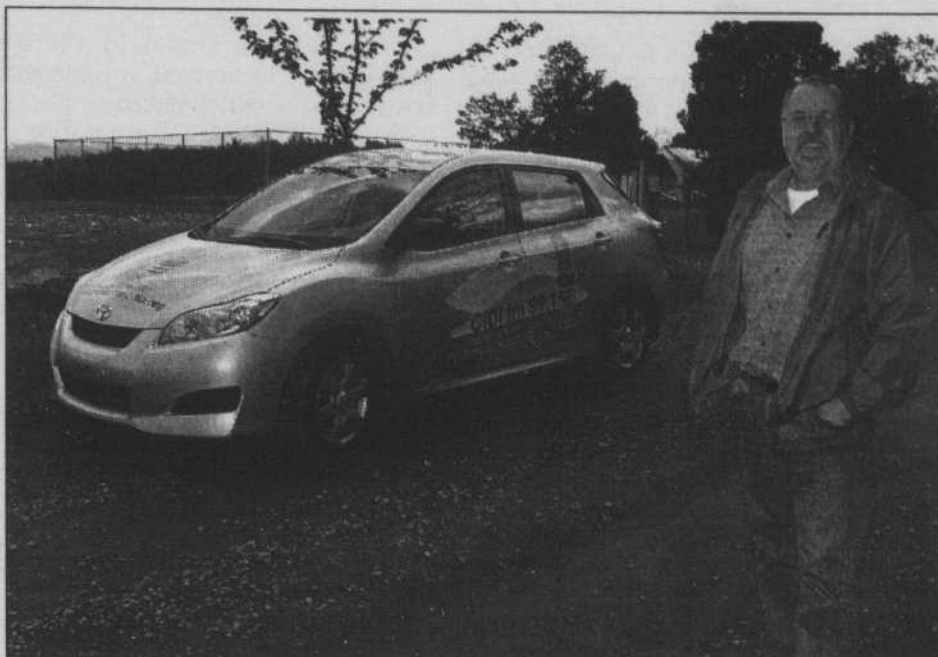
He's one of many RCM volunteers, and for the past four years, a member of its board of directors. Anderson represents a fresh new dynamic in the Brome Missisquoi and Shefford regions (a non-profit company ready to reach out to a new market) and fully intends on satisfying the needs of local businesses and their communities.

It's not hard to understand how local economies have suffered the effects of globalization. When big-box franchise stores take over our home turf and leave the mom-and-pop businesses we grew up with folding under pressure, believing that bigger is better, then we as a community become submissive and no longer know who we are.

Herein lies the opportunity for RCM. Anderson understands that he offers a unique product, namely confidence. Yes, he understands that confidence is what RCM sells, and that he represents a nonprofit company selling a service disguised as advertising. He is by no means being deceptive. He's being honest.

"CIDI ads that run 20 times per month are six to eight times lower in price than other commercial radio stations in the area," explains Anderson, "it's a very good bargain for advertisers, and many businesses in the area like the idea and will try it even if they have never advertised on radio before.

Another great selling point is that the ads are prepared in both English and French since we are a bilingual station.

The only one in southern Quebec, I might add. It was Maurice Singfield who pushed the idea to have bilingual ads. It's who we are. The majority is francophone. For example in my home we speak *franglais*, my wife is French and I'm English. It's who we are."

Thanks to RCM, radio advertising has become affordable to small businesses, giving many the opportunity to be on the radio for the first time. Exposure is what advertising is all about and makes businesses, organizations, communities and individuals feel like they can make a difference. Without it we lack confidence as a community. We don't know who we are.

"My time is spent with the radio station developing this ad strategy," says Anderson, "and getting the work out. It's exciting. It's wonderful. I was uncomfortable with doing sales in the beginning, but now I look forward to sitting down and talking to people."

Before Anderson joined RCM he had been a member of the board of directors for the nonprofit Sunnymead Organization for approximately 5 to 6 years and worked for Singfield Piano as a partner for 30 years, first as an apprentice, then as piano technician.

In the past, as a photographer Anderson was focused on capturing images, but now it's different. "Since the tower

is almost in place," he explains (it should be up and running by the end of May), "I am committed to selling a lot of ads in the area of Brome Missisquoi and parts of Shefford."

Working in sales has opened Anderson's mind to a lot of different things: "Doing this work is a tremendous confidence builder. I never thought I would be able to go out and do what I'm doing, but I took it on."

He is quick to add that, "I am not alone, and have had some great ideas and help from volunteers like Warren Woodworth, a member of RCM's advisory committee and co-host of CIDI's Let's Talk Jazz (along with Keith Mizener), whom I consider to be my mentor."

Anderson is thankful that Woodworth's door is always open for needed direction and adds, "He has a tremendous sales background and even though he's retired now, his wisdom is incredible."

Woodworth is not the only mentor Anderson has. David Grenville with his corporate background, another member of the advisory committee, also helps Anderson develop ideas. "He works on the communication end of things for RCM," points out Anderson, "and is very good at getting our message out to the public as clearly as possible."

Last but not least is Donald Grey Donald, the third advisory committee member. "Donald has been a great addition to the sales team with his marketing and sales background," claims Anderson, "When it came to the idea of having our sales vehicle, he was another one who felt our presence had to be visible throughout the area. So we leased a vehicle. It's basically a sales and promotional vehicle which has a logo for the radio station on both sides. It's an eye-catcher," says Anderson. "And, it's only the first of what we hope to be many to come."

This summer Anderson will be very busy traveling throughout the station's listening area and beyond. He wants to attract advertisers from outside the area such as Montreal and the greater Eastern Townships area.


"The production team is also exciting," says Anderson, "Maurice is at the helm, with Scott Edmonston and Holly Bailey, our two full time employees at the station. I gather the basic information for the business and they make the ad into an emotional story. Together, we build something to fit the client."

CIDI's tower, at this very moment, is standing on Patch Hill waiting to be connected to the Knowlton studio and will be operating at an effective radiating power of 1450 watts by the end of the month. Anderson says: "I'll be happy to come and see you, talk to you personally about your ad, find out what drives clients to you and together with the production team we will build something that will work for you. Also, if you spot me with my car in your area I'll buy you a coffee at the nearest coffee shop."

At around nine we drove down to the pub to see how close people were to finishing. We went into the kitchen to ask how long they would be and got told by the Mike, the chef, to leave and to stop distracting people. We went back to the house, weak with hunger, wasted a little more time with games and then put the chicken in.

Our oven is old and the numbers on the dials are all worn off so we didn't know what temperature we'd set it on. About an hour later Jess was convinced that it wasn't even cooking. I said I thought it was, and to stop opening the oven already. She wasn't happy that there didn't seem to be any juices coming out of it to make gravy. A little later when the door opened and the chef and three kitchen staff walked in, we all breathed a sigh of relief and relaxed. Simon (a Canadian from Tofino) went straight into the kitchen and took charge. First he told us condescendingly that the place was a mess and started cleaning up. Then he drained the potatoes, mashed them, took the chicken out, (it was cooked) took the stuffing out of the chicken, made gravy and carved the chicken.

We were quite impressed with all this because he was sick and we didn't even think he would come. But then Simon has a different way of getting over being sick than most people. Last time he was sick we'd stopped by his house on the way to a party and found him three quarters of the way through a bottle of Jameson's. He'd even wanted to come to the party with us but couldn't because he hadn't gone to work that day and his boss would have been there.

The food was good. Mike started us on a round of giving thanks ("That's what this is about, I gather?") He's a Kiwi. We went around the table and it was things like; 'Good food, good company, friends, our health, my son at home, the surf...' For dessert we had rice pudding and a pumpkin pie made by Mike, who's actually a pastry chef. People don't eat that here so he'd googled how to do it; it was delicious.

I love food. I think eating with people and sharing is such an important thing and I think there's a reason why so many traditions revolve around eating. By the time I got to bed that night it was four AM, but it was a great evening and well worth staying up for.
