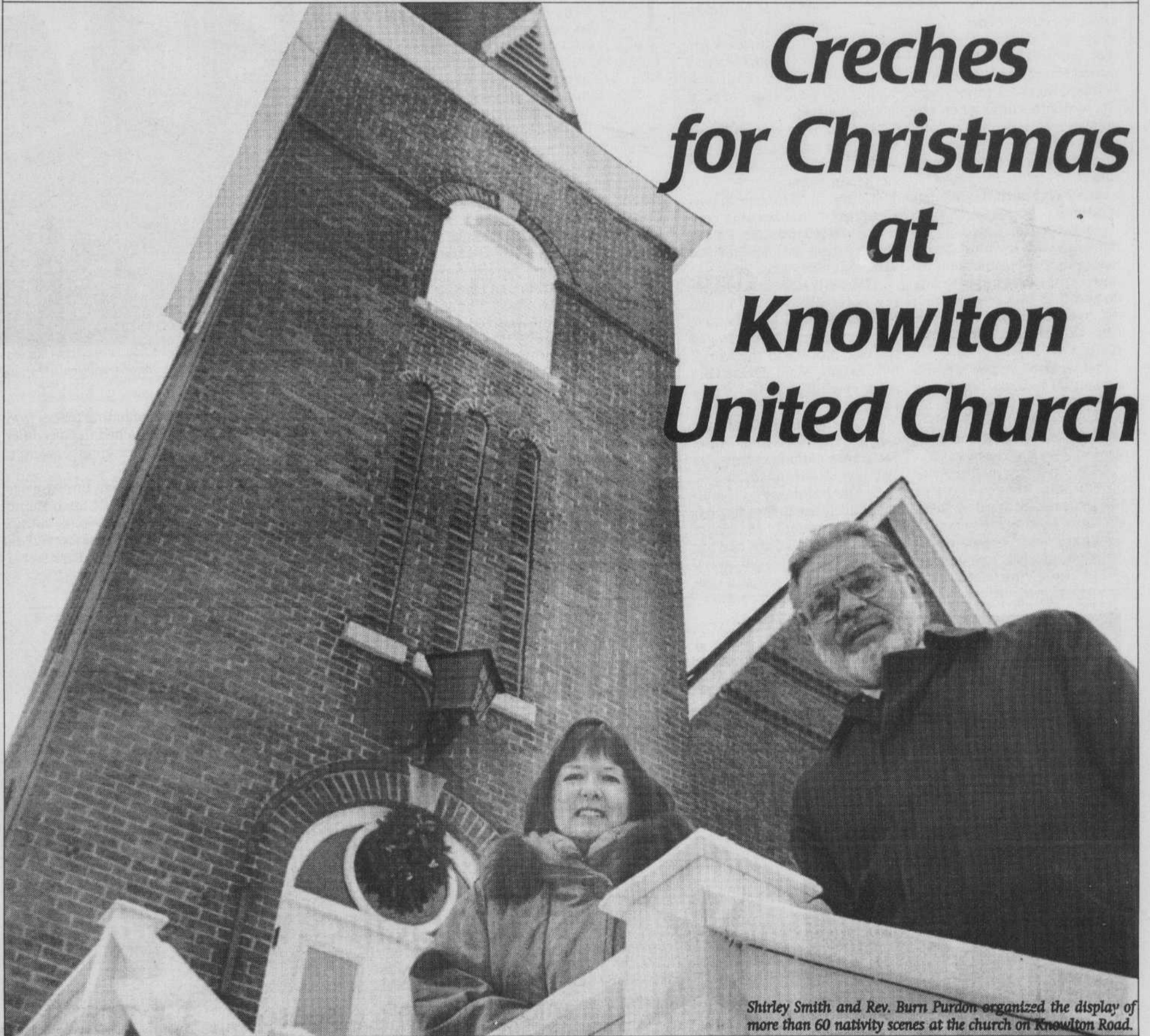

## Pianist André Gagnon to play in Coaticook Saturday

Internationally-acclaimed concert pianist, André Gagnon, will be performing in Coaticook this weekend even though he was too ill to give interviews. Organizer Robert Scalabrini said the recital will feature original compositions by Gagnon and a perhaps a few classics.

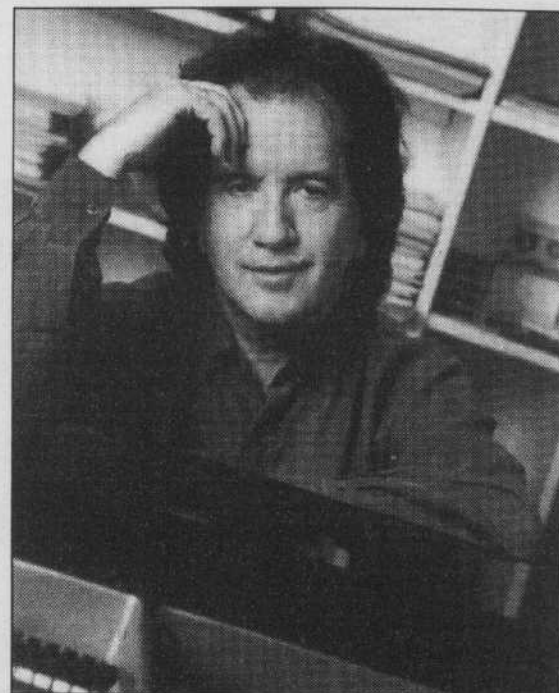
"The concert's music will not be traditional Christmas music but will consist primarily of music pulled from Gagnon's repertoire and compositions," he said.

The 55-year-old pianist started his career as an accompanist for many well-known French singers, including Pierre Letourneau, Renée Claude and Claude Gauthier. He decided to follow a solo career and performed piano pieces by Mozart at Place des Arts in Montreal in 1967. His first album, "Notre Amour Pour les Amants," was recorded in London, Eng. and was an instant success. Many albums followed, but none were as well-received as "Neiges." That album, released in 1975, won two Juno awards for Best Album of the Year and Best Canadian Instrumental Artist and helped launch Gagnon's first cross-Canada tour.

Gagnon has performed in countries all over the world, including Romania, Greece, Venezuela and Mexico. He has written many musical scores for movies and plays. In 1988, Gagnon collaborated with Québec author Michel Tremblay to write the music for an opera called Nelligan.

Nelligan won a Felix in 1990 for Best Show of the Year.

Scalabrini said Saturday's concert will also include a few surprises.

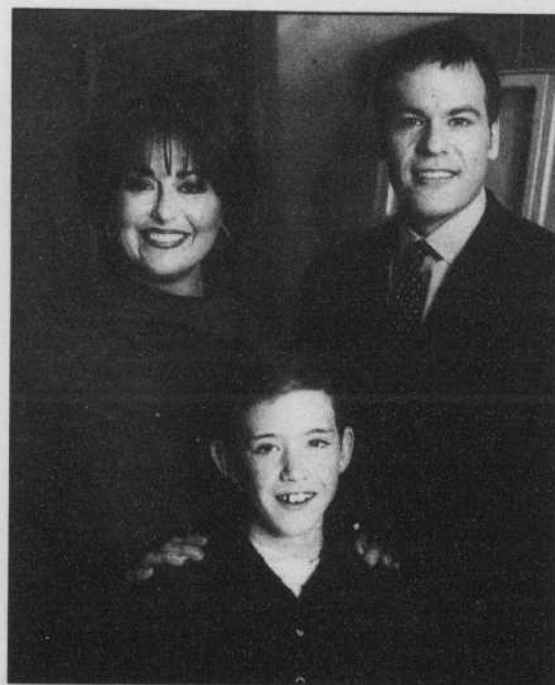

# Alien sequel not worthy of resurrection

**A** sequel can sometimes seem extremely appealing to hardcore fans, especially when it involves a very popular series, featuring non-stop action and plenty of visual candy.

Unfortunately, this is not the case for Alien Resurrection, the fourth installment in the albeit diehard saga of one Ellen Ripley (Sigourney Weaver), a hardened woman who has had to face some nasty xenomorphs in the past. Now, 200 years after the conclusion of Alien 3, when Ripley died in order to destroy the Alien Queen foetus which had opted to incubate itself into her abdomen (are you confused yet?), scientists have successfully cloned Lt. Ripley (that is, after seven atrocious attempts), in order to get

a viable specimen of the creature. The experiment leaves the new Ripley with interesting attributes (acidic blood, lightning-fast reflexes, a feral attitude - just your basic human/alien hybrid), and leaves the Queen Alien to reproduce on her own.

The Company, as many futuristic super-corporations could call themselves, had planned to purposefully grow these Alien creatures in order to train them, perhaps for military purposes. Of course, this is an Alien franchise movie we're talking about, and obviously something goes wrong. Dead wrong.

As with the previous three movies, there is an interesting cast of lesser ac-

tors in this newest attempt, which makes any choice to kill them off more easy, should the script ask for it. Among them are sci-fi veterans Ron Perlman (who is most remembered as Vincent, the feline looking

beast from TV's Beauty and the Beast), Michael Wincott, who can be seen in the last Brandon Lee film The Crow (and also The Three Musketeers (1993)), not to mention Brad Dourif, who has appeared in over a dozen sci-fi/horror oriented films (Dune, Child's Play, also seen in TV's X-Files and Millennium).

The least impressive performance in this film has to be the one inflicted by the always vacuous Winona Ryder, who portrays the latest model in android

technology (big acting stretch, folks!), whose sole purpose is to eliminate Ripley, should the clone prove more alien than human.

The tall and slender Sigourney Weaver gets a rather hefty \$12 million salary with an even bigger paycheck should she be willing to take on Alien 5.

Any positive things said about this unfortunate sequel must be taken very lightly. Although the special effects will dazzle the visually hungry, its lack of potential as far as gorefests go leaves fans of precedent treatments much disappointed. For maximum viewing pleasure, may I humbly suggest the best of all four Alien films, James Cameron's excellent Aliens (1986), which starred a slew of future Hollywood stars.

## Blues singer Jonny Owen sings from the heart

**J**onny Owen is one of those rare musicians that can't read a note of music.

"I don't know where it comes from, I just sing what I feel," he said.

When he was just 16 years old, the Montreal native recalls hearing tapes of Elvis Presley's earlier songs with the Sun Session Recording studio. He also listened to music by Carl Perkins, Buddy Holly and Gene Vincent. These were the singers that Owen said he copied during his early years as a performer.

"Elvis was my first musical influence and it was his brand of rockabilly that led me to the blues," he said.

Owen is extremely thankful to a friend's stepfather, a jazz musician, who introduced him to the blues. It was the music that changed his life.

"He was the one who introduced me to the music of Big Bill Broonzy and Muddy Waters," he said. "And I don't know how I can ever repay him."

Then he heard the music of Lighnin' Hopkins, Robert Johnson and Mississippi John Hurt, all of which have become his heroes.

Owen was given his first guitar when he was 18 years old and since that time, he's never looked back.

"I couldn't read music so Steve Tadros a good musical friend of mine introduced me to some chords E, D, E and E, A, B, 7 for two keys," he said.

"That gave us some shades. It was crazy, but somehow it went over."

Owen said he dreams of making his living as a full-time musician, but for

now he has to work part time.

However, no matter what he does, his music is always with him.

"Even if I'm digging ditches or pumping gas, the music is always within me 24 hours a day," he said.

His friend and manager, AJ from Delta North Music Inc., believes that

Jonny has a great future.

"I have great expectations for him, it's only a matter of time before Jonny becomes big," said AJ, who has been Owen's manager for almost five years.

He said Owen has opened for many bands appearing in Montreal such as Offenbach on Canada Day and every time Owen plays, he is invited to return.

"To me, he's one of the troubadours, the guy who writes his own songs and music," he said.

"He's a strong song writer with intelligent lyrics. He's just a very creative guy."

Until January, Owen had been playing his own material as well as person renditions of songs by Bob Dylan and Elvis Presley.

He has since formed his own band, Jonny Owen and the Redeemers, which features guitarist Normeo Zabala, bass player Dave Lavoie and drummer Marc Lajoie.

Owen has also recorded a CD, called "No Turnin' Back," which will be released in February.

Jonny Owen will perform at the Knowlton Pub on Friday Dec. 19 at 7:30 p.m.

Check out his blues song, "Miles Away from Forgiveness". It promises to be an unforgettable musical evening of blues and rockabilly!

## Knowlton church displays creches for Christmas

**W**hen Rev. Burn Purdon was looking for a way to attract tourists to his church during Christmas, he decided to create a display of nativity scenes.

"In speaking with my brother, who is also a reverend, I invited him down from Ontario to share his collection of creches as a base for us," he said, adding these manger scenes have a special significance for him since he made them as a teenager for his family and friends.

There are currently more than 60 nativity scenes on display at Knowlton United Church on Knowlton Road that have been lent to the church from Rev. Ken Purdon, Rev. Burn's brother, and members of the community.

Shirley Smith, a member of the church's congregation, volunteered to help organize the display.

"We wanted to augment Rev. Ken Purdon's collection. The idea was to have creches from the community, so I put an ad in the Brome County News asking people to loan their creches for the display," said Smith.

The display has also motivated children from the community to make their own.

"One of the teenagers from the pastoral church has made a creche from origami and that inspired one of the younger kids, who is presently creating one now," said Rev. Burn.

Since Rev. Burn also administers to The Creek United Church on Brill Road, a few creches were loaned from members of that congregation.

The history of the nativity scene, also

known as the manger, can be traced back many centuries to Italy, Germany and Britain. Legend has it that St. Francis of Assisi asked the Pope if he could portray the birth of Jesus with cattle, sheep and people in the town square.

"It's a wonderful educational tool, it shows us the whole idea of God coming into our midst which is a universal theme," said Rev. Ken.

In Italy, families create their nativity scene by adding a new piece to it each year. In some American cities, the mangers are composed of hundreds of figures, including the butcher, the baker and townspeople. Some even have scenes of mountains and waterfalls.

Rev. Ken said a collector in Germany had accumulated 3,000 figurines for his creches, now on display in a Munich mu-

seum.

"It has to do with history and traditions and the way different cultures celebrate Christmas," said Rev. Ken who, with his wife Joyce, brought a variety of 38 creches and banners from Toronto made from clay, ceramic, different types of wood, stained glass, cloth and decoupage.

"We have many fond memories of the creches that were given to us from people from my congregations," he said.

"Christmas is deeply endowed with sentiment and memories of our childhood and friendships."

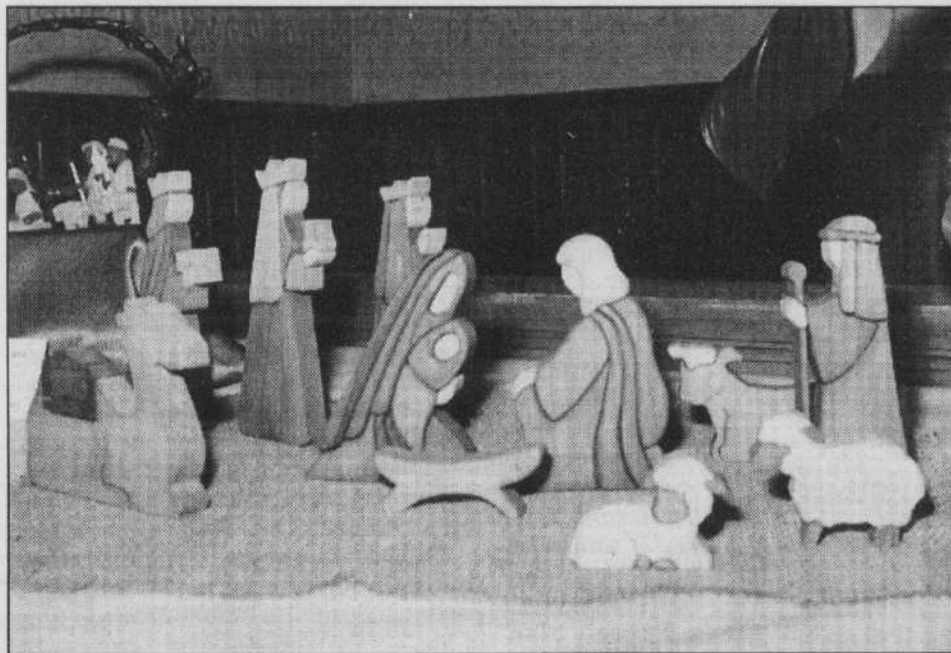
Rev. Ken said there are famous wood carvers in Oberammergau, Germany, who create nativity scenes in all shapes and sizes.

"They're very expensive," he said. "Today you can buy creches all over the place, but no doubt they're made in China, Hong Kong or Japan."

The nativity scene was originally a method of showing the coming of Christ to an illiterate population. It was usually displayed in the town square or the church. Today, the creche is often placed at the foot of the Christmas tree in many homes or on the fireplace mantle.

In the Knowlton United Church entrance, there are five banners made from cloth of the prophet Isaiah, an angel, shepherds, the wisemen and Mary, Joseph and the baby Jesus. The banners were made 15 years ago by Marie Fenwick, a member of Rev. Ken's congregation at the Hillcrest United Church in Toronto.

The banners and nativity scenes are on display at Knowlton United Church at 234 Knowlton Rd. to Dec. 21 from 12:30 p.m. to 4 p.m.

New album reveals passion and faith

# Wynonna opens the door to her life

The variety of country music on the market is getting broader all the time. Here are a few of this week's samples.

**WYNONNA: The Other Side** (Curb/Universal)

Wynonna's music has always had more of a blues twist than the average country music singer. It seems that since she's started her solo career her voice is becoming richer.

Even the daring "Why Not Me," which she recorded with her mother Naomi as The Judds sounds very timid compared with her new album.

Wynonna opens the door in the biographical "The Wyld Unknown," in which she throws off the tabloid stories and asserts who she is.

The song says "I'm a woman of passion, a woman of faith," and this is indeed what the new album is made of - passion and faith delivered by a convincing artist.

Wynonna shares writing credits on

the fun-filled, "Troubled Heart and a Troubled Mind," while Naomi makes an appearance on the hot "Don't You Throw That Mojo On Me." Songwriter Kenny Wayne Shepherd also contributes great guitar work.

This album offers one of the best duets I have ever heard as John Berry joins Wynonna in "We Can't Unmake Love," a song that explores the commitment of love to one's children.

It's amazing to see the faith in love that comes out of Wynonna's ballads, even when they're songs about heartache. "Always Will," is a fabulous philosophical song that has a few lessons to teach us.

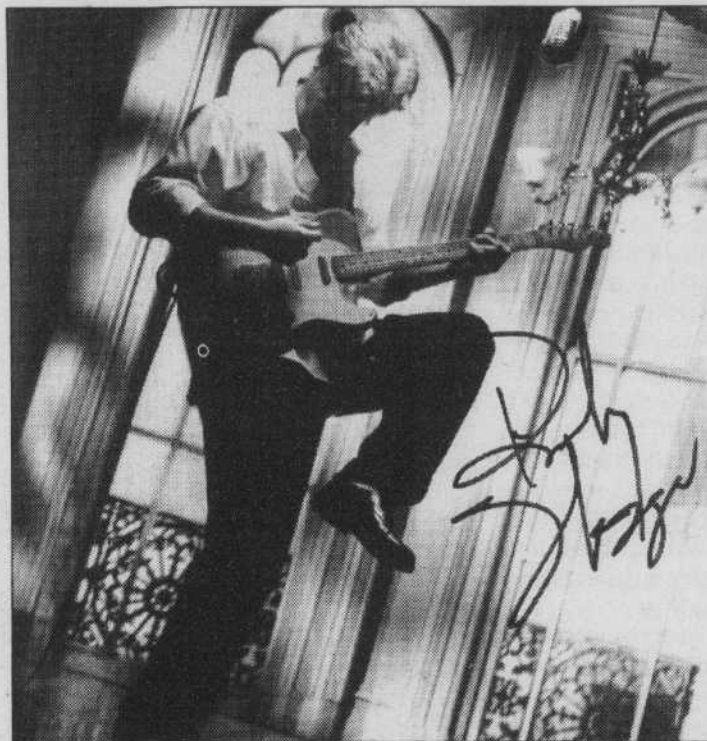
Wynonna takes turns being sassy, sad or funny, but she shines on everything included on this new collection.

Wynonna has evolved from a shy, young country singer to a star who is definitely in control of her career.

**RICKY SKAGGS AND KENTUCKY THUNDER: Bluegrass Rules!** (Rounder-Skaggs Family)

Ricky Skaggs has been promising to release a bluegrass album for a long time and here it is. It's his first bluegrass record in 15 years.

Most country fans know how much Skaggs loves bluegrass music. When he

homecoming in "Rank Stranger." Skaggs and his musicians close with a faster than fast version of Monroe's wordless classic, "Rawhide."

Skaggs current country project called, "Life is a Journey," is recorded on Atlantic Records. It's very good, but this bluegrass project is done with Rounder, the recording label also used by Alison Krauss.

This is one of the best bluegrass albums I've heard so far and it will be hard to top.

**DELBERT MCCLINTON: One of the Fortunate Few** (Rising Tide)

This is McClinton's first album in four years. It features a terrific collection of songs and guest musicians such as B.B. King, Mavis Staples and several country artists.

Vince Gill and Lee Roy Parnell contribute to the up-lifting song, "Sending Me Angels." A trio of distinctive voices - McClinton, Lyle Lovett and John Prine - join forces on the rockabilly "Too Much Stuff," a complaint set to some breathtaking boogie-woogie piano.

Parnell, Pam Tillis and Patty Loveless also help out on the fun-loving tune "Monkey Around," in which McClinton has the most amazing line of the album: "Once you had me dancing at the end of your chain/ begging for your small-change love."

The highlight track of the album is a heart-breaking Otis Redding song "You Were Never Mine," which could stand up against the soul classics of the 60's. McClinton is so convincing on this number you can almost hear him crying.

This Texas-born, award-winning singer/songwriter is one of the fortunate few who has been admired for four decades. Skaggs has done everything from teaching John Lennon how to play harmonica to performing at Bill Clinton's 1993 Inaugural Ball.

On this album, his harmonica work shines throughout the entire collection particularly in "Lie No Better" and "Best of Me."

This is a rockin' type of album, one you'll want to buy.



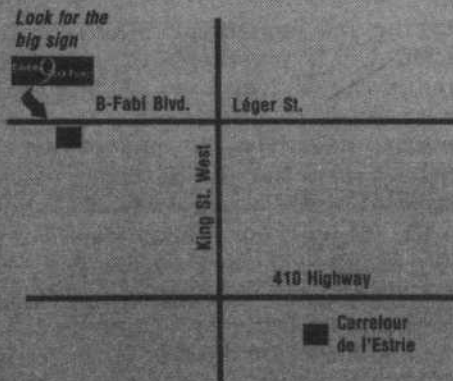

Life and Times profiles

## Our favorite TV daughters Jennifer and Cynthia

It's a little hard to imagine what Canadian television would be like without the Dale sisters, Jennifer and Cynthia.

When it comes to recalling Canadian drama series, the most common phrases of description are "the one with Cynthia," "the one with Jennifer" and least commonly, "the one that never had either of them in it."

CBC-TV profiles the two actresses in "The Dale Sisters," an episode of Life and Times airing Sunday, Dec. 7.

Cynthia probably is the better-known of the two because of her work on the CBC series Street Legal.

She also was the subject of gossip following her romantic involvement with CBC anchor Peter Mansbridge, who was married to fellow CBC anchor Wendy Mesley

at the time. All three have maintained a stony silence and there are no revelations in the Life and Times episode.

But, the Dale sisters are best known for their acting.

Street Legal's Olivia Novak was the first "bad girl" in a Canadian series. The character stood out in contrast to the overly moral Leon and Carrie (Eric Peterson, Sonja Smits). Jennifer's Betsy Bigley in 1984's Love and Larceny and its 1991 sequel, Grand Larceny, was an authentic and charming con woman who swindled New York bankers.

Both sisters have experienced their share of failure. Cynthia's attempt at playing a private detective in CTV's Taking the Falls met with the same fate as most attempts at going over Niagara Falls in a barrel. Jennifer was added to the cast of CBC's ailing Side Effects in the hope she would accomplish what Cynthia

did for Street Legal. It didn't work and Side Effects expired. And Jennifer's most recent series, Once a Thief, premiered to strong ratings on CTV, but quickly slipped and was pulled from the schedule in favor of Nikita.

In addition to interviews with the Dale sisters, the Life and Times profile features observations from Eric Peterson and Brenda Greenberg, executive producer of Street Legal and Side Effects. There are also comments from Alliance Communications head Robert Lantos (Jennifer's ex-husband) and Richard Monette, who directed Cynthia in Camelot at Stratford.

There are plenty of clips the sisters from their TV appearances as children in the early '70s to behind-the-scenes looks at Camelot and Once a Thief. The highlight is watching the two sisters interact in joint interview segments.
