This Court and the Exchequer Court were organized under the provisions of 38 *V. L.* cap. 11.

The Supreme Court has both original and appellate jurisdiction—*Original*, as to (1) habeas corpus in criminal and extradition cases; (2) judicial opinions to the Crown; (3) private bills and petitions therefore referred by the Senate or House of Commons; and (4) civil suits in which the validity of a Dominion or Provincial Act is questioned. *Appellate*, in appeals (1) from the Exchequer Court; (2) from the Provincial Courts; (3) in habeas corpus cases; and (4) in election cases.

Exchequer Court

The Exchequer Court has original jurisdiction (1) in revenue cases; (2) in civil suits, when the Crown for the Dominion is plaintiff; (3) controversies between the Dominion and a Province, or between two Provinces.

The Judges and officers are the same as in the Supreme Court. They reside in Ottawa, where the Court sits 3rd monday in January and June.

Laval University

In 1663 was founded the Quebec Seminary
which afterwards became a regular College,
and it had, by successive additions, acquired
a high degree of importance, when it was
erected, by Her Majesty's Royal Charter, into
a University, under the style and name of *the
Laval University*. By this charter, which bears
date December 8th, 1852, no change was ef-
fected in the constitution of the Seminary it-
self, but a council composed of the directors
of the institution, and the three senior profes-
sors of the several faculties was empowered
to possess and enjoy all the privileges granted
to the Universities of the United Kingdom,
and especially that of conferring degrees in
the Faculties of Divinity, Law, Medicine and
Arts. On the 15th May, 1876, His Holiness
Pope Pius IX, gave to the Laval University,
the Canonical erection. His Grace the Roman
Catholic Archbishop of Quebec is, by virtue
of his office, Visitor and Apostolic Chancellor
of the University. The Superior of the Semi-
nary, for the time being, holds the office of
Rector.
