## Nanette Workman returning to her roots

She is known throughout Quebec for a string of rock and disco hits in the early 1970s and her work with the Quebec rock opera *Starmania*.

But Nanette Workman, now 58, said she is not ready to retire after having recorded some recent albums that use American blues themes.

"I have not stopped in the 37 years I have been in this business," she said in a brief interview before performing a two-hour concert at the Gourmands Festival in Asbestos last Saturday evening.

"If I stop, I will drop. I do a lot of festivals in Quebec each year for my fans."

According to her manager Roch Saumure, Workman is considering a return to tours outside of Québec, especially in the United States, which she left in 1966 to come here.

"She will be doing concerts and appearances in France, Belgium and Switzerland later this year," he said.

"She is also going to return to her native Mississippi to see how the American market reacts to her blues work."

Saumure said a key appearance will be at a nightclub in Clarksdale, Miss., owned by American actor Morgan Freeman.

"Freeman saw her last year at a Blues festival and liked her enough to have her come back to his nightclub this fall," said Saumure.

"We think this could create interest in her recent work in other parts of the States."

Saumure, who has known Workman for 20 years, and has been her manager for the past five, said other attempts at tapping the lucrative American market failed partly because promotion is costly in the U.S. and partly because Workman did not feel she was ready.

"She had a good album in the 70s called *Lady Marmalade* which sold well in Quebec, and she ended up

opening for Paul McCartney's Wings band.

"But promotion was costly and she and her band did not feel they were ready to tour extensively, so the American record company that was involved lost interest and dropped her."

A native of Jackson, Mississippi, Workman was signing in musical stage shows when she met Québec signer Tony Roman, fell in love with him, and came to Montreal.

She had to learn to sing in French and by the early 1970s, had a string of rock and disco hits, mostly in Quebec, with titles such as "Lady Marmalade," "Danser, Danser" and "Ce soir, on danse."

This led to studio work in England and France with such bands as the Rolling Stones, and later, a role in *Starmania*, which did well in France.

By the mid-80s, Workman had settled down in Ormstown, Quebec where she gave birth to a son and concentrated on studio work, small tours and work as a radio DJ and television appearances in Montreal.

Saumure said raising her son, now 16, was difficult for her when she wanted to perform or record.

"She would bring her son on the road or into the studio, because she felt guilty about leaving him at home with other people," he said.

"The members of her bands and the people at the studios had to accept this if they wanted her to perform and record."

Saumure said now that Workman's son is in his teens, she feels she can spend more time away from him. He believes she is now more interested in touring despite approaching the age of 60.

"Singing and performing is her passion, her life," he said.

"But she is not looking for a big success. We've said the door is still open for her if she wants to go through it."

Saumure said her recent emphasis on American Blues music was sparked by the death of her father three years ago.

# A summer dessert easy as one, two three

**H**ard to believe, but true: this dessert, which always earns the highest praise from my friends, is actually the easiest one I have ever thought up.

Who could ever guess that golden sautéed slices of pineapple could taste so juicy inside, and pack in just the right degree of sweetness?

Well, they do - thanks to the lime zest, which balances out the sugars and provides the needed punch.

The only inconvenience is having to prepare this dessert at the last minute.

It just doesn't taste the same when reheated. Serve with a scoop of vanilla ice cream or, for a more striking presentation, with lightly sweetened blueberries (while they're still in season).

If you are inviting friends for a barbecue, go ahead and throw the pineapple slices on it too.

Just make sure that the pineapple slices are grilled on a clean, perforated tray of their own, after the meats have been removed from the heat (wouldn't want those flavours to mingle!).

#### INGREDIENTS (FOR FOUR)

4 fat slices of ripe pineapple (not cored)  
2 large limes  
1 tbsp. sugar (or 2 if pineapple is not very ripe)  
2 tbsp. unsalted butter  
1 cup blueberries  
1 tbsp. confectioners' sugar

#### DIRECTIONS

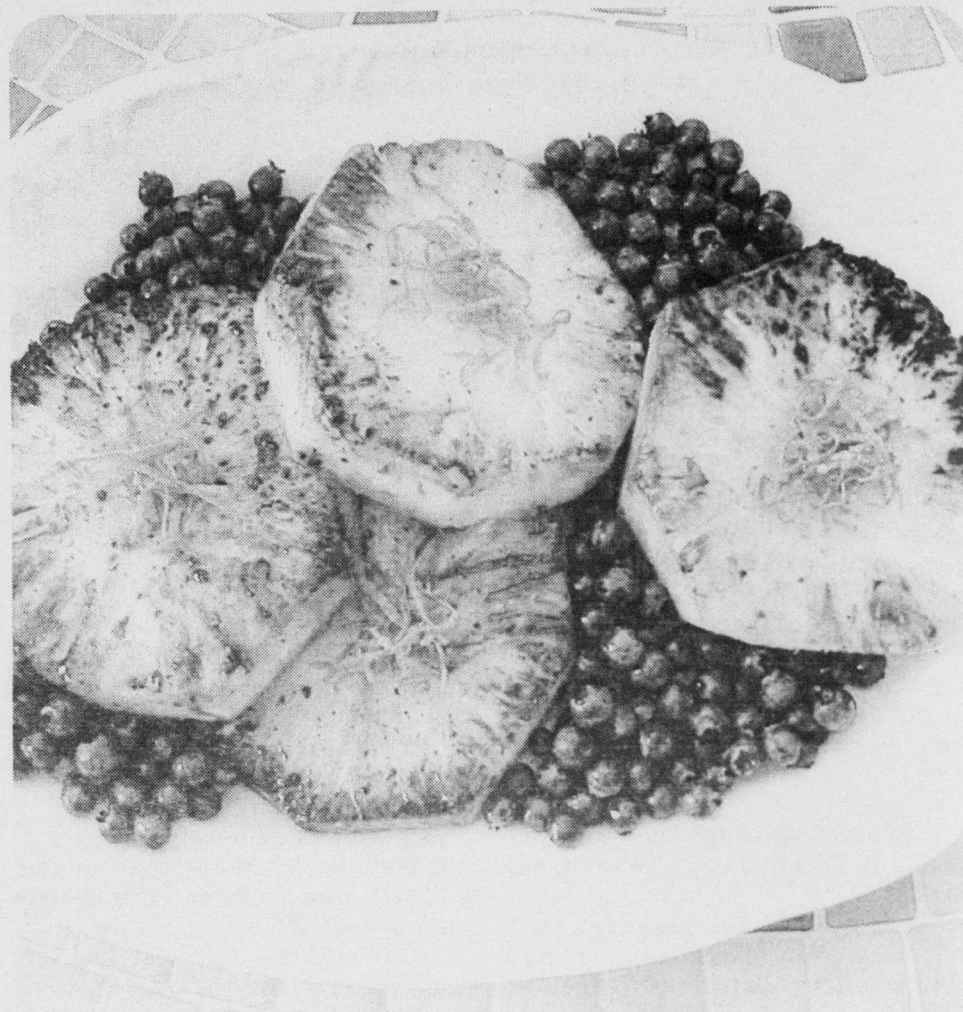
1. Wash the limes and grate the peel to obtain the zest. Wash the blueberries and drain, leaving them out on the counter to dry.

Toss them in a bowl with the confectioners' sugar, shaking the berries to and fro until the sugar has thinly coated them and has fully dissolved (it will turn from white to transparent).

2. Try a bite of your pineapple to determine how much sugar to use. If very ripe, you will hardly need to sweeten it. In your largest non-stick frying pan, melt the butter.

Turn the heat to high and fry the slices for about 2 minutes on each side, or until they develop a light brown crust, turning only once (you may want to fry an extra one as a tester). Top the center of each slice with some lime zest and set them on a platter.

Sprinkle the blueberries around the edges and serve at once.

With just a light drizzle of olive oil and vinegar, dinner can be served. For dessert, top premium vanilla ice cream with sliced fresh strawberries.

#### Fresh Salad Pizza

#### INGREDIENTS (MAKES 4 TO 6 SERVINGS)

2 (12-inch/30 cm) purchased, pre-baked thin pizza crusts  
1 (125 g) tub light boursin cheese (seasoned with garlic and fine herbs)  
1 small red bell pepper, chopped  
1 small yellow bell pepper, chopped

1/2 small English cucumber, quartered lengthwise, then cut crosswise into thin slices (about 1 1/2 cups/375 mL)

1 cup (250 mL) grape tomatoes, halved  
1/2 cup (125 mL) pitted kalamata olives, halved

1 cup (250 mL) crumbled feta cheese  
2 tablespoons (25 mL) finely chopped green onions or fresh chives

2 tablespoons (25 mL) extra-virgin olive oil

2 tablespoons (25 mL) balsamic vinegar

Salt and pepper

#### DIRECTIONS

Bake pizza crusts directly on oven rack at 375 F (190 C) for 10 minutes or until heated through.

For each pizza, spread half the boursin cheese evenly over pizza crust.

Top with half of each of the red and yellow bell peppers, cucumber, tomatoes, olives and feta cheese. Sprinkle with half the green onions. Drizzle with half the oil and vinegar. Sprinkle

with salt and pepper to taste.

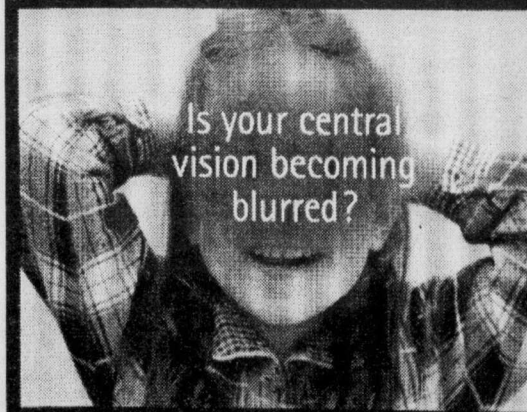

# Father and son strike musical chord

Does that face and that laugh seem familiar? To some, Brian Curtis' picture will conjure up memories of the good old days when 'The Silver Eagles' was the top band on the local scene.

These days, fans may see Brian back on the stage as part of the popular 'Mountain Dew' band, with his son Christopher joining him on drums.

"I don't think of myself as anything special. I love to play music and entertain folks. I consider it a hobby more than a job. When I started playing with the 'Whiteliners' back in 1981, I was the youngest one in the band, now I feel like the old man - especially now that my son Christopher is with us in 'Mountain Dew'. I am really very proud of him. He has a lot of talent. When he was just a little guy, he used to go to our performances.

"He grew to know a lot of the music and was usually found at the drums during break time when he thought no one was looking. I joke with him now that when he becomes a star, I will be driving his tour bus and going to his performances," joked Brian proudly.

"I count myself lucky. Through my music, I have met many really nice people that I would never have met otherwise - making some really good friends. The nice thing about playing in a band is that there isn't just one person who does the singing.

"We all get into the act. I am really more comfortable this way as the focus is not always on me. It's a team effort." added Brian in his usual modest way.

It seemed only natural that Christopher would take an interest in music. Music was a big part of his childhood. He is currently working at Everest in Ayer's Cliff but will be returning to Champlain College this fall to study music.

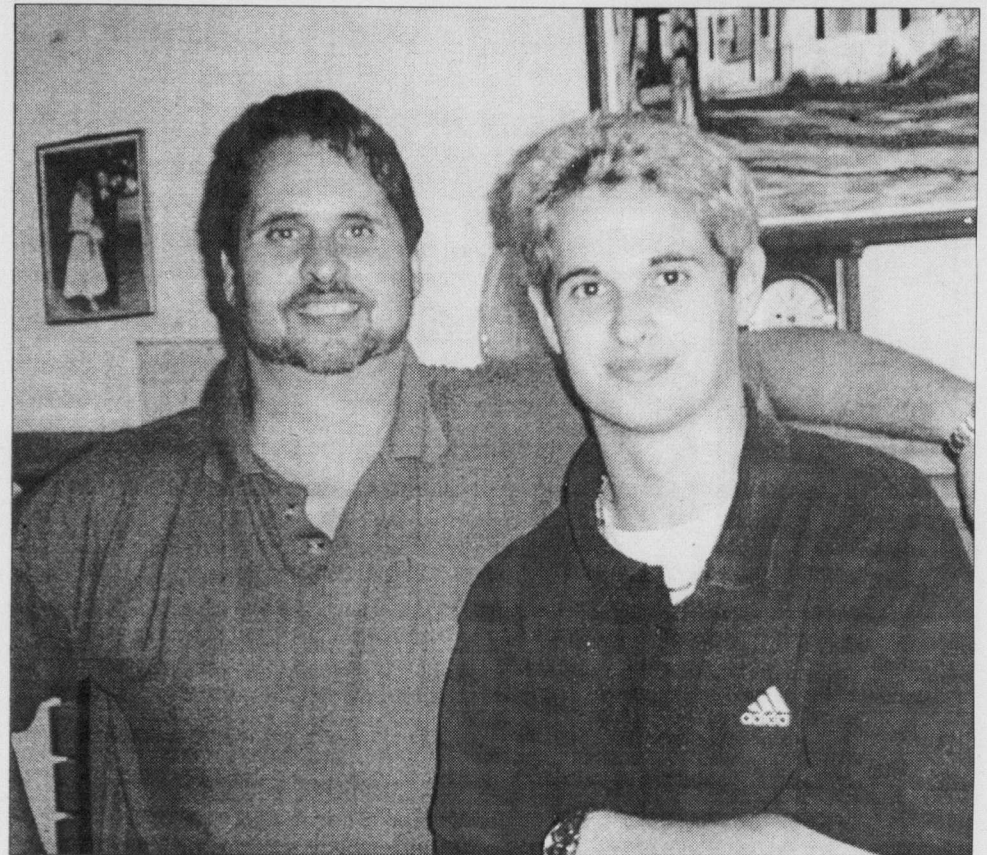
He is working towards a degree in studio engineering. He says it would be great to make a profession out of playing music, but if that doesn't work out, being a studio engineer will keep him in the midst of what is happening.

Christopher occupies his 'spare time' by not only playing drums with 'Mountain Dew' but also as member of two different rock bands, 'Fluke' and 'Student Crossing'. 'Student Crossing' performs the top 40s, never pop rock, while 'Fluke' focuses more on old rock and blues. It makes for a very busy schedule, but sharing the same passion as his Dad, he wouldn't have it any other way.

"Some guys enjoy father-son time with their Dads going fishing or hunting, Dad and I play music together. I have learned a lot from him and think he is a great role model. We may work crazy hours but hockey players do too, don't they?" Added Christopher.

"I have been a part of 'Student Crossing' since I first went to Alexander Galt. I still stayed with them even after I graduated from Galt. We play at festivals, parties and dances at Galt, of course. The members of 'Fluke' all go to Champlain College which allows them the option of playing in the bar scene around Lennoxville," explained Christopher.

"I am the youngest member of 'Mountain Dew' which plays mostly for benefits and festivals. The only time

that I can remember that I felt torn between the groups was when I played in both the 'Fluke' and the 'Student Crossing' bands at the Battle of the Bands on Townshippers' Day. 'Fluke' won.

It was an odd feeling - I didn't know whether I was supposed to be feeling sad or happy!" added Christopher.



# Q&A

## Arnowitt at the Haskell

Do you like to spend a relaxing evening with good friends and good music? If so, the Haskell Opera House is the place to be this Saturday evening, Aug. 23. Michael Arnowitt, renowned pianist, will be performing an all-Gershwin program, featuring piano renditions of two of Gershwin's greatest compositions, 'Rhapsody in Blue' and 'An American in Paris'. Vocalist Susan Reid will join Arnowitt to perform some of Gershwin's arrangements on the program.

Arnowitt has performed in piano concerts throughout the U.S., Canada and Europe.

Recently, *The Record* spoke to Arnowitt about his music career.

**THE RECORD:** "How long have you been playing the piano? This Saturday's concert is to be entirely on the works of Gershwin. What do you find special about him?"

**ARNOWITT:** "I have been playing the piano since I was four-years-old. I never seem to get tired of it. You can always improve on your interpretation of particular pieces and how you perform them. It may be the same piece, but it seems to change with you as your life changes. I like to perform Gershwin. He was so talented at both piano and composing tunes such as 'Summertime' and 'I Got Rhythm'. There is a lot we can all learn from his work."

**THE RECORD:** "There is a part of the performance at the Haskell Opera House that is near and dear to your heart. Would you tell us about that?"

**ARNOWITT:** "Unfortunately, a lot of really good original pieces, both classical and pop, fall through the cracks. The way that the composers really wanted them done was never actually put into print. In the 1980s, I began a project to transcribe Gershwin's own improvisations which I had to take from piano rolls done in the 1920s. This was when Gershwin was at his most spontaneous. The versions that are done today are more of how the artist interprets

Gershwin and less the way that Gershwin actually performed his compositions."

**THE RECORD:** "We heard that you were involved in a recent 'Ella Fitzgerald Nite'. Would you tell us about it?"

**ARNOWITT:** "I helped organize a tribute to this talented lady. We picked out about 20 of her tunes that were most popular in the early 40s through to the 60s. The ensemble for the evening consisted of over 20 Vermont musicians who played to a standing-room only audience. It was a huge success as well as a

lot of fun for the musicians".

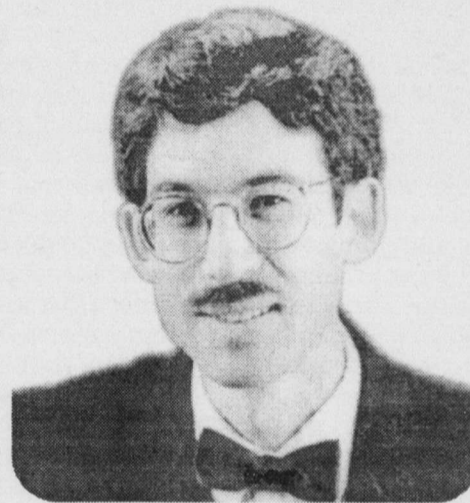
**THE RECORD:** "You are also well-known for your involvement with 'good will' projects. Could you elaborate on this?"

**ARNOWITT:** "I get great satisfaction out of helping people. My talent lies in music and I like to organize events, so putting on concerts for what I feel are worthwhile causes

seems like a logical thing to do. One such concert raised funds for humanitarian aid for Balkan war refugees, in 1999, which raised \$10,000. We were informed that what was most needed were medical supplies (first aid type kits) and clothing. There were people who attended who gave cash donations but the audience was also asked to bring something that could be used to make up the kits that were requested. We managed to have enough supplies to make up 300 kits."

**THE RECORD:** "Are you currently working on any projects?"

**ARNOWITT:** "I co-founded the Green Mountain Jazz series which is in its third year. I am currently working on transcribing the 24 preludes by Frederick Chopin to enable me to put together a concert dedicated to his work. During concerts, I like to give a short narration of the composer and the life he led at the time he wrote the composition in hopes that the audience will leave the concert hall not only satisfied at the evening they have just spent listening to good music but also a little more educated on those who put so much work into giving the world these well-loved tunes".

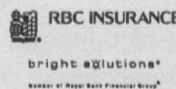

# Disraeli native begins her rise

She has taken part in singing competitions in Canada and France and was invited on stage last Saturday evening to sing one song with Quebec star Nanette Workman before some 9,000 people at the Asbestos Gourmands festival.

But Gladys Beaudoin is hoping the opportunities will not stop there. The 16-year-old resident of Disraeli, near Thetford Mines, has bigger dreams and hopes her clean, firm, high voice will bring some form of stardom.

"Working with Nanette Workman was special," she said. "She is a strong singer and I had no problems working with her. It proved to me that I have potential and that some major members

of the music industry accept me."

Beaudoin (she goes by the stage name "Gladys") hopes that acceptance can translate into a singing career in the years to come, with an eventual recording contract.

But she realizes many decisions have to be made about how she will create that career. What singing style to adopt? How much exposure will she need? What audience should she appeal to? What language should she sing in?

"I know I want to have a solo career," she said. "I don't want to be part of a larger group or band. And I still need to decide which type of music I want to sing."

Beaudoin discovered she had a singing voice when she was six. She was asked to sing in her local church and was hesitant because she had never sang a tune before.

"I thought I had not understanding of music, no passion for it. Then when I started singing, it felt easy and I had no troubling handling the tune."

After winning local contests, her parents hired Thetford Mines manager Yvon Mathieu and sent her on to other competitions in Quebec and other parts of Canada, including an annual singing festival in Winnipeg, Man.

When she was fourteen, she was singing at competitions in France. Mathieu then started sending out her resume, photos and test recordings to agents in Quebec, hoping that someone would appreciate her talent.

"When the people for Workman said they wanted a local talent to sing with Nanette when she came to the festival, they saw where Gladys came from and contacted me," he said.

"They felt she had a voice that could work with Nanette's style and would

add a bonus to the concert."

Beaudoin realizes that any singing career will have to include songs in English, given that many Quebecers are still hooked on top-ten American tunes and that her duet with Workman was all in English. But she admits she still has trouble speaking the language, given that Disraeli, and her birth town in

nearby Lambton, have no English speakers.

"I can do many styles of music with English words," she said.

"I can hear and understand the words. But when I get the music sheets, I have to rewrite the words in a phonetic form so I can pronounce them correctly."

# The Royal Family is better than ever

Let's be frank at the outset about *The Royal Family*. Despite its gilt-edged dual authorship — the legendary George S. Kaufman and the formidable Edna Ferber — it isn't that memorable a play. The fact that the original production lasted 340 performances on Broadway is less a testament to its quality than to the fact that the whole world knew it was based on two illustrious American acting dynasties — the Barrymores and the Drews — who back in those days made headlines the way J Lo and Ben Affleck do now.

Despite its tantalizing theatrical background, its situations and characters seem surprisingly conventional. There's the heroic matriarch who heads the family, a daughter who keeps threatening to give up acting so she can marry her millionaire admirer and go and live in Brazil, a granddaughter who's rebelling against family tradition but comes around in the nick of time, a flamboyant son who's a superb actor and a notorious womanizer — and, of course, that staple of all such plays, the sympathetic but harassed producer.

They can all become rather tiresome — especially when they shout a lot. They were especially tiresome two years ago in London when that doyen of London directors, Sir Peter Hall, mounted a star-studded production featuring the likes of Judi Dench, Harriet Walter and Julia McKenzie, none of whom were used to good advantage.

Under Hall's direction, *The Royal Family* seemed curiously sluggish, and a play already vulnerable to charges of being trivial was trivialized even further. But it would be unfair to impose a similar verdict on the Shaw Festival's revival which made a secure landing Saturday.

Director Martha Henry, doing a bit of moonlighting away from her normal Stratford venue, has mounted a brisk, funny, observant production which is infinitely preferable to the 2001 London revival.

To begin with, there is a show-stopper of a performance from Goldie Semple as Julie Cavendish, the actress who represents the second generation of this great dynasty and is constantly threatening to give up her career. As written, Julie is essentially out of the stockpot, but Semple goes the extra mile in giving her character shading, humour and an unexpected degree of emotional warmth. This Julie can be as exasperating as anyone else in the family. She can be shallow, self-absorbed, fickle, extravagant and given to wild indulgences — witness her obsession with hats.

She has a short fuse, especially when dealing with

the outrageous antics of her actor brother (Peter Hutt) and her troublesome daughter (Caroline Cave).

She has her own eccentricities — when we first meet her, she has taken up boxing — and she's capable of making excessive demands on the tolerance of her millionaire boyfriend (Ric Reid). Out of this a credible human being assumes shape. Furthermore, few actresses are as good at orchestrating a big scene as Semple. She did it a couple of seasons back in *Easy Virtue*. She does it again in *The Royal Family* when she lets loose with a hilarious rant about the monstrousness of the actor's life and the intolerable burden of a family like hers: as she works herself up into a crescendo, you almost hear the roar of the cannons, the blast of the trumpets and the clanging of the cymbals in the background.

Peter Hutt, dashing and demonic as the impossible brother, is hilarious in a role clearly modelled on John Barrymore. Norman Browning serves up a memorably succulent slice of ham as the aging uncle who continues to pursue acting roles which are no longer suitable for him, and Nora McLellan is both funny and truthful as the dumpy wife who still thinks she's capable of playing sylph-like characters on stage.

Caroline Cave's granddaughter is the obligatory ingenue role, but she brings it off delightfully. And as Fanny Cavendish, the aging but indomitable family matriarch, Patricia Hamilton has some of the wittiest speeches in the play — example: "Marriage isn't a career, it's an incident!" — and makes the best of them.

The smaller roles also shine — Robert Ben-

"When she returned to Mississippi to see her family, she realized her roots were there and that music from that area was blues and jazz music," he said. "She said she wanted to return to her musical roots, and that meant blues."

Her last two CD albums, "Roots and Blues," and "Vanilla Blues Café" are given over to the classic rock style of the American South. At the concert in Asbestos, 14 of her 17 songs were blues songs, which were sung in English before a francophone audience.

Saumure said her choice of blues style has been well received by local audiences, despite the fact the words are in English.

"Her fans here are loyal, no matter what language she sings in," he said. "But she argued that blues songs can't be properly sung in French. It is a style that is American whereas French has a more poetic base which can't accommodate blues works."

Saumure laughs at the irony of her boss' present career situation, given that she sings in English, but has mostly French fans in Quebec.

"The country she is from does not know her at all, but she is loved here in Quebec," he said. "She still has a bit of an American accent, but the fans don't care."

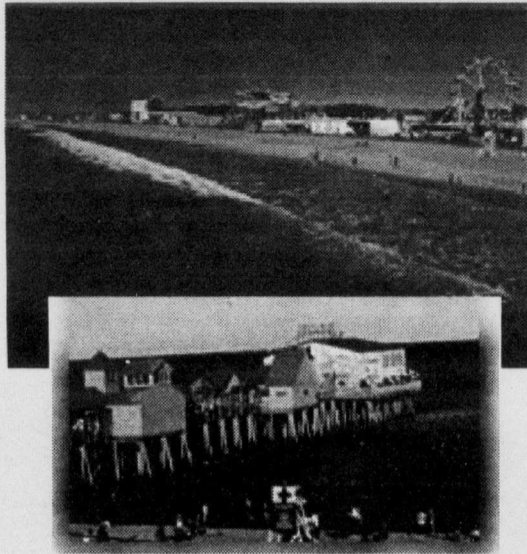

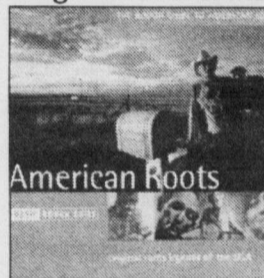

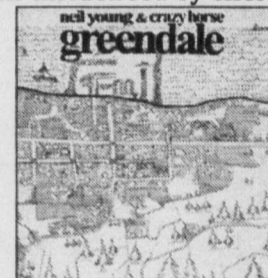

# Orford music school is paradise

The Orford Arts Centre's music school goes by the name Studea Musica, a title appropriate for describing its vocation: the study of music.

For six days in the summer, young music students and their parents come from all over North America (this year, the student body is half American, half Canadian) to learn not only instrumental technique, but how to incorporate music into voice, body and soul.

Studea Musica has been in operation for eight years now, and the instruments taught are piano, violin, cello, and as a new addition this year, the flute.

Gilles Comeau, director of the school, emphasizes that although the students are young (four to 17 years of age) this is not a music camp.

"Students come with their parents. All are under their parents' supervision. We offer musical activities all day long including private lessons every day, movement in music, choir, chamber music, improvisation, group theory and afternoon and evening concerts. But parents

are responsible for any other activities."

The cost for the six-day event is approximately \$250, but families are responsible for food and accommodations. This year, says Comeau, there are over 300 students, parents and teachers-in-training.

"All of our residences are full. Some participants have had to book accommodations off-site."

The rapid expansion and popularity of the Orford school is most likely due to word-of-mouth advertising, as well as the music teacher training program that includes the possibility of obtaining university-level credits and even completing a microprogram through Laval University.

As well, Studea Musica offers its students the opportunity to meet and collaborate with a contemporary composer. This year, it is Ontario resident Nancy Telfer.

"It's like paradise here," says Telfer of the Orford Centre. "The geographical surroundings, everything is so well-organized, and the parents, teachers and students enjoy the way music happens all the time in many different ways."

"People understand English, French or sometimes both. It's my first experience at Orford, although I had been hearing about the institute for a number of years."

Telfer believes that students benefit from the experience of meeting and per-

forming with a music composer.

"Many of the students who are here for the first time have never met a living composer, to talk about performance, to help them polish a piece. This gives me a wonderful opportunity to talk with performers."

She has composed a special piece for this year's final concert on Friday evening, called "The Orford Round", to be performed by the choir.

Studea Musica's various concerts, including orchestra, choir, solo and chamber music are free and open to the public. Final concerts will be held tonight at 7:30 p.m. at the Orford Arts Centre.

# Adkins' booming voice back in the spotlight

Two major qualities have made Trace Adkins an artist regularly saluted by the music industry. His rich and distinctive baritone, so powerful that it can rattle any window, and his showmanship have established Adkins as a favourite both as a recording artist and a performer on the road.

Despite his success, Adkins has had some rough time in his personal life. He recently got out of rehab where he went to solve his problem with alcohol. This was the wise decision of an artist who knows how much he has to give to a legion of fans. They have loved and followed him since the release of his debut in the mid-90's.

His natural charisma, his commanding stage presence and his good looks are other qualities that appeal to fans. His first two albums went gold and platinum, while the Academy of Country Music voted him 1997's Top New Male Vocalist. It was a very good start for a new comer.

Now his first Greatest Hits Collection is available and it's just when you see all the hits assembled on the same album that you come to realize that Adkins' accomplishments are impressive.

The new album offers two new numbers. There's the tender ballad "Then They Do," a wonderful song about fa-

therhood. It is actually so popular that his management reports that it has already inspired a book of stories collected from parents all across America.

The second new song is titled "Welcome To Hell" in which Adkins sings his anger for what terrorists stand for. This song could be about anyone from the Hells Angels to rapists, and it is just at the end of the song that you find out that it is about terrorism.

The other songs are all familiar because they've sort of become calling cards for Adkins. There's the hillbilly honky tonker "I Left Something Turned on at Home" and Adkins is not referring to the stove.

There's a few good-time rockers such as "Big Time" and "(This Ain't) No Thinking Thing" which features Adkins' extraordinary range, the power and depth of his voice. His voice really sets him apart from other country singers.

The album also offers some fine country ballads about heartaches where you can feel the pain in Adkins' voice, such as "Don't Lie" and "Every Light In The House is On". The lanky singer is really in control of his voice, and is always convincing as on the up-

tempo "More" and the downbeat "Help Me Understand".

"The Rest of Mine" has become one of the finest wedding songs and offers some fine work on the fiddle and the bass guitar. There's also his career launching "There's A Girl In Texas," while "Lonely Won't Leave Me Alone" comes in as one of the finest moments on the album.

More recent is the beautiful "I'm Trying" about making all the efforts possible without always succeeding.

"Chrome" is most likely the less country number that Adkins has ever recorded, but it is still a fun song about a girl who's crazy for everything that shines, mainly chrome found on nice, expensive cars.

Adkins was raised in the little town of Sarepta, LA, the son of a factory worker and a schoolteacher. He learned to play guitar before he was even a teenager. The six-foot-six Adkins was bound to be successful. At 17, he became the bass singer in a regional but very popular gospel quartet called The New Commitment.

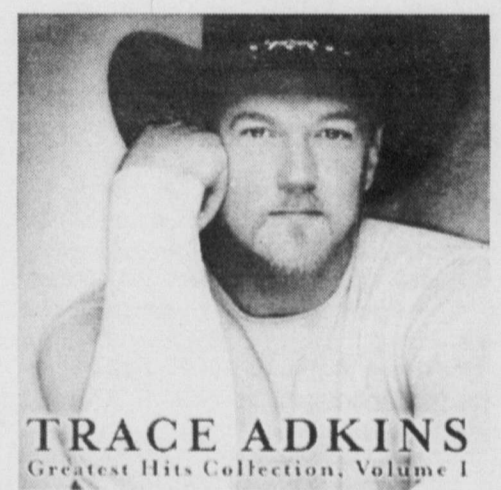
The group recorded two local albums when the singer was only 18. He also played tackle and linebacker in college.

friend, he packed his bags and moved to Nashville in order to pursue a career as a singer. There he met producer Scott Hendricks.

Hendricks signed him to Capitol Records right-off and his first hit was in 1996. This new Greatest Hits is a wonderful compilation to own for the die-hard fan, as well as for the fan who wants to discover Adkins.
