100 years of Missisquoi fashion

This Sunday, the Missisquoi Museum opens its first season in the new millennium with "Fashion Sense: 100 Years of 20th-Century Fashion in Missisquoi County."

"I wanted to look back at the old century as we stand at the cusp of a new one," said curator Heather Darch. "I started out taking a broad look and eventually focused it down to women's fashion."

The result is a collection of women's clothing and accessories that reflect the character of each decade of the 20th century. The changes in women's fashion mirror the dramatic social forces at work in a century that women entered as indentured servants and exited as a major economic force.

"Concealment" and "modesty" were the watchwords of the first decade of the 20th century: "Women were concealed under multiple layers of fabric," said Darch. "Many of the items in our collection from this decade were made at home, though machine-sewn." (She noted that sewing machines were a common appliance in Canadian homes by the beginning of the 20th century.)

"Women were still tightly laced into corsets designed to produce smooth, 's' curves to the bodice." This contortion of the rib cage contributed to Victorian and Edwardian women's propensity for fainting. The neck, leg and wrists remained concealed under high collars, long skirts and long sleeves.

The next decade's holocaust, the Great War, had an unforeseen consequence on women's lives as they were forced to fill roles previously reserved for men. Running farms and factories while husbands, fathers and brothers were away at war fuelled a growing women's rights movement. Corsets remained in place, but hemlines started to go up.

Pot-Pourri Choir sings Brahms

The Pot-Pourri Choir will perform "Brahms & Company," a program dedicated to the choral works of Johannes Brahms.

"This music has accompaniment: Sometimes two pianos, sometimes one piano and two French horns. The music is glorious and seldom heard. I think it is wonderful that an amateur choir in the Townships accepted the challenge of learning these pieces."

The amateur choir has been under the leadership of Reiningger since 1996. The 20-member a cappella group usually performs works of the Renaissance, although their repertoire also includes choral works from other periods up to the present.

"Singing without accompaniment is a challenge for any group," said Reiningger. "And there is the added difficulty of singing in different languages."

The choir also participated in a CD of Christmas music. Reiningger said that the CD will be made available this fall at Townshippers' Day.

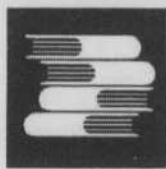

From novels and biographies to cookbooks and beyond, there's nothing like a good read

Brookner explores the human condition

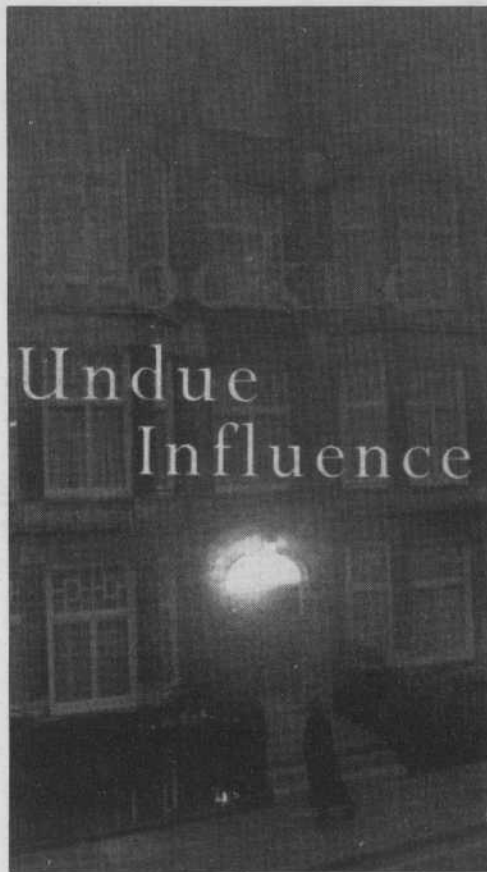

At one time or another, all readers must confess to having literary lacunae - those classic books that others simply assume we've read, or the numerous great books sitting atop or beneath the bedside pile.

Fortunately, I recently had a chance to chip away at that pile as I read Anita Brookner's 19th novel - *Undue Influence*. I have only increased the burden on myself, seeing that I'll now have to read the other 18.

Claire Pitt, a 29-year-old woman has lived much of her adult life with her parents, and then her widowed mother. She works in a bookstore, happy with the routine of her life. Her mother dies shortly after the book begins and Claire evaluates her parents' marriage, wondering that they ever came together and if they really knew happiness.

Claire is a lonely character among lonely characters. She spends much of her days weaving stories about the intricacies of people's lives, based on a gesture or a facial expression. One day, Martin Gibson comes into the bookstore, a man she builds an entire story around. Claire discovers the discrepancies and similarities behind the story she creates around him. Claire and her best



friend Wiggy allow themselves to be talked into visiting the man's pitiable sick wife - a woman who turns out to be considerably tougher than she might seem at first glance. For Wiggy, this amounts to a couple of awkward visits and an interesting anecdote - for Claire it becomes something more.

Undue Influence explores the human condition in all its gracelessness, determination and sadness. It deftly explores the manipulations of love of all kinds. It is keenly

of an eye, is beautifully drawn. The 29-year-old Claire has allowed herself to be sheltered, though she travels, holds down a job and owns her own house. She is looking for something to expand her life.

Brookner avoids the cliché and manages to draw us into the small and ordinary world of Claire Pitt. She reminds us that nothing is ordinary in life and no one is normal. The search for love, so often fruitless, makes all of us worthy.

critical of English life and stoicism, but is never harsh. Claire, with her rich inner life and aimless reality is a metaphor for the writer - always observing, drawing life in, poking around yet absenting herself from life.

Though the novel often centres around Claire's thoughts, it is never boring. Although some of the characters flounder through life, they are never depressing. This character who works in a bookstore but doesn't read much, who uses words like "adman-tine", "minatory" and "pre-lapsarian" regularly, who veers from self-loving to self-loathing in the blink

Early Canada captured in biography

For most of the thousands of people who left the British Isles during the 19th century, emigration meant the chance of a new and better life. They were escaping grinding hardship in their native land; they were fleeing the disease, starvation and hopelessness that engulfed Britain's labouring classes at the end of the Napoleonic wars. Anything was better than what they were leaving behind."

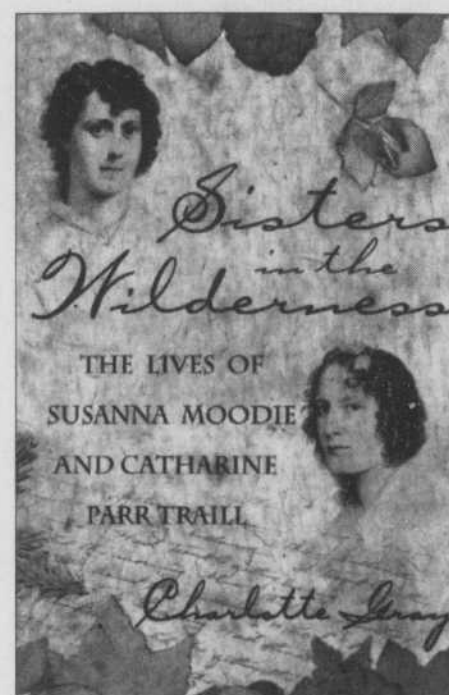
This mindset of early Canadian settlers is described in Charlotte Gray's well-researched biography, *Sisters in the Wilderness: The Lives of Susanna Moodie and Catharine Parr Traill*.

Authors like Margaret Atwood, Timothy Findley and Carol Shields have written prose and poetry about Susanna Moodie, one of Canada's first writers, and Charlotte Gray shares in the fascination with this often sharp-tongued, disillusioned writer.

In early 19th-century Eng-

land, Susanna and her six sisters struggle to keep up with fashionable society after their aristocratic father dies, and their mother is left with a small income. In England, Susanna, Agnes and Catharine Strickland are celebrated authors of stories and poetry. Agnes was to become famous for her royal biographies, whereas Susanna and Catharine would face much hardship as they go off to Upper Canada with their Scottish husbands.

'Grandma Moses' with humour

Without ever taking an art class, Ayer's Cliff folk artist Janna Kendall has captured reality, humor, harmony and iconography, making her paintings worth more than 1,000 words.

Using iconography, derived from ancient folkloric symbols (to add hidden meanings), Kendall's style has been compared to Grandma Moses, with humour not unlike Norman Rockwell.

She adds personal touches, such as images of local buildings or portrayals of people in her life. Her favourite piece, *Harmony*, which she started in 1995 and finished in 1997, is a painting to which she added Stanley Holmes' round, burgundy barn in Stanstead.

"If you spot a rooster, I'm demonstrating the reality of one's dream or fertility. A string of fish means a humble person whereas only one fish is the ancient symbol for Christ. A butterfly symbolizes freedom and a deer means prosperity. Round barns are good luck omens since there are no corners for the devil to hide," said the artist.

"I started making money in 1993 when I put an ad in *The Record* that said 'Artist for Hire.' CBC radio asked me to do an on-air interview. Mr. Jack Quart heard and inquired whether I could do folk art or not. I wasn't sure so he gave me a folk painting to imitate. After that, my work was starting to be seen and I had an interest from someone who asked me to do a sign. I then did my first two paintings for a playing card company. The company bought the rights and I got to keep the originals. I then did a series of 13 for a Montreal greeting card company, sight unseen. It was really nice to walk into a Jean Coutu and see my cards but they were making more off my cards so I began on my own. My dad went out to the garage, pulled out his saw and taught me how to make frames and cut glass.

"In 1997 the Atlanta and New York Trade shows began selling my paint-

ings as well as the Gift Trade show in Montreal. At the moment I am working on a Canada Day series," said Kendall, referring to the recently painted works in her studio.

From her finished works she produces greeting cards, playing cards and lithographs (high quality copies) to sell, but will always keep the originals in hopes that "some day they might be worth something."

Kendall has lived in Switzerland, traveled across Canada, the U.S., Mexico, Dominican Republic and Barbados, getting her art out there and hoping to experience life to its fullest. "Of all the places I have lived and traveled, the Eastern Townships is where I've found the best of everything," she said.

Kendall's artistry goes further than her '000 paintbrush' and acrylic paints, she has produced an herbal lotion line.

"I manufactured my own line of three hand creams and bath salts. The one I named 'pain eraser' is for persons suffering from arthritis, 'moaning muscles' is pretty self-explanatory

but 'winter hands' has been a big seller in hospitals and with construction nart.qc.ca.

workers."

One can take in a lot by visiting her studio. The wall with more than 100 framed autographed pictures of celebrities from the Smothers Brothers to Clint Eastwood demonstrates her belief in being able to accomplish whatever you put your mind to. The opposite wall gives you something to look at for hours - her already finished works. One of the 100 carefully hung projects was a clock with simply a gold heart in the center.

"I did this piece after an Easter egg hunt I organized. I couldn't have done it without the help of local volunteers; people helped without thinking twice, and to me they have hearts of gold.

"I published nine joke books in the memory of Myrtle Bowen who died of cancer. As ill as she was, she still laughed and I am a firm believer that laughter is the best medicine."

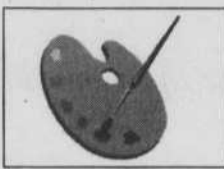

Liberalization continued into the "Roaring Twenties" and, in 1929, Canadian women were legally declared persons, able to claim property, retain custody of children, hold political office, sign contracts and enter universities.

The Art Deco movement, Craftman style and interest in all things oriental softened the lines in women's clothing. "In the '30s, as the Depression deepened, colours became darker. Clothes from the 1920s were re sewn, but the loose-fitting styles remained. Turbans and short hair styles were popular," said Darch. Women in the workforce also became more daring, sporting men's fedoras, trench coats and pants.

She notes that the technology of fashion also changed with the introduction of nylon in the 1930s. With the beginning of the Second World War, zippers, material and nylon were rationed, forcing home-makers to recycle and redesign their clothing. However, women were once again forced into the workplace, this time with lasting consequences. "The 40s saw the return of restrictive clothing (the girdle), and a broadening in the shoulders as shape returns," notes Darch.

However, the modest, deferential woman of the century's first decade was being replaced by a go-getter image epitomized by actresses such as Katherine Hepburn: aggressive, capable and taking charge. It was during this decade that Quebec women finally received the right to vote and were allowed to run for office, rights conferred on western Canadian women decades earlier.

In contrast to the new-found freedom of the 40s, social forces in the 50s pushed women back into a restrictive, socially confining environment of the home to vacate jobs for returning veterans. Darch said that fashion reflects this neo-femininity, characterized by "the big bra, full skirts and high heels."

This emphasis on elegance and modesty continues into the early 60s, but the conservative swing was to be short lived as the first post-war generation (the baby boomers) came of age. This indulged generation revelled in the avant-garde, welcoming the beat generation, the British invasion and fostering unrest over Cold War politics and the war in Vietnam. Hemlines skyrocketed and bell-bottomed jeans and bomber jackets replaced A-line skirts.

"The 1970s were the 'anything' goes' decade," said Darch. "Jeans remained universally popular and hemlines went up and down with minis, midis and

maxis. By the end of the decade, disco brought in halter dresses for women, afros and leisure suits for men." Polyester and rayon were 'in', as were platform shoes, earth shoes and unisex clothing.

Darch describes the 1980s as a decade of excess, the rise of everything "power": the power suit, power reading and power lunches. A growing middle class spent proportionately more disposable income on clothing.

The decade saw the rise of athletic footwear and pull-on clothing. Hollywood's influence can be seen in the "Flash Dance" craze with oversized sweaters, stirrup pants and sweatshirts.

Fashion also came from the street rather than the Paris runways with the advent of punk: spiky hair, safety pins, torn clothing and leather. "The 90s were an interesting way for the century to end," she concludes. "They were an amalgamation of all things: the return of the drop waist of the '20s, the tapered suits of the 40s, the retro fashions of the 60s and 70s and the street and athletic fashion of the 80s."

Darch is understandably reluctant to venture a guess at what the shape of fashion in the 21st century will be. "In the 1960s, we were told that we would all be wearing spacesuits by the turn of the century. Yet in the last decade, we had recycled fashion: everything old is new again."

Newly colonized Canada attracted many down-on-their-luck English settlers who jumped at the chance to start over. But as Susanna and Catharine discover, life in Canada is not all it's cracked up to be. The inexperienced Moodies and Trails have to clear their own land and grow crops, and each year they struggle to pay increasing debts. Canada is a place where class divisions are nonexistent, and Susanna finds little sympathy with the rough-mannered, working-class Canadians.

Susanna and Catharine become well-known for their books *Roughing It in the Bush* and *The Backwoods of Canada*, but publishers take advantage of them and they receive little profit from their success.

Gray creates a biography of the Stricklands that is also chock full of

historical information about Canada's beginnings as a country. We learn about Canada's expansion from a variety of shanty towns with unpaved roads and uncleared bush to industrial towns with schools, libraries and railways. The sisters watch as Sir John A. Macdonald becomes first Prime Minister of the Dominion of Canada and Ottawa becomes its prosperous capital.

Through anecdotes from journal entries, letters and poetry, the personality of each sister comes through. We meet the brilliant, moody Susanna Moodie, who would become a critical, cranky old woman, and the calm, optimistic Catharine, who raises her sister's spirits in hard times.

Both sisters' works remain today fascinating accounts of pioneer life in Canada. Susanna Moodie's *Roughing It in the Bush* is still one of the best-known books about the hardships encountered by idealistic early settlers.

This is an excellent biography of the famous Strickland sisters which truly captures the atmosphere of early Canada.

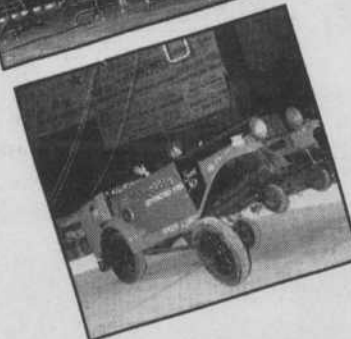

A world of adventure, comedy and drama awaits

Is Star Wars: Episode 2 already in trouble?

We now know that Canadian actor Hayden Christensen has won the coveted role of Anakin Sky-

walker in the next Star Wars movie. That resolves at least one burning question concerning the filming of Star Wars: Episode Two.

But there's an even more pressing ques-

tion that needs to be answered: Has George Lucas finished his script?

The recurring buzz out of Hollywood is that Lucas is still frantically working on a screenplay for a movie that is due to start

shooting next month in Australia. The gossip mills also say that Lucas's problems in making up his mind over the casting of Anakin were symptomatic of a larger difficulty - the fact that he has been dragging his feet over a script which was supposed to have been completed long ago.

Part of Lucas's

problem is that he's a proud and stubborn man whose ego was wounded by press reaction to *The Phantom Menace* - particularly the recurring criticism that he was a bad director and an even worse screenwriter. Despite the fact that the best of the Star Wars movies - *The Empire Strikes Back* - was written and directed by other people, Lucas is determined to prove that he's equally competent in these areas. And since the Star Wars movies are his baby, he can do what he wants.

The other big question has to do with technology.

Samuel L. Jackson, who has joined the Star Wars stable, has come close to saying that Lucas is more interested in technology than people. And years ago Mark Hamill - who starred in the original trio of Star Wars movies - scoffed that if Lucas had his way he would dispense with actors completely and create all his characters in the computer.

It's not easy playing a peevish teenage murderer

Joaquin Phoenix just wants a little respect for his *Gladiator* role

Joaquin Phoenix has a problem. He doesn't like the way audiences are responding to his performance as the warped young villain in *Gladiator*.

It's not good enough for him that filmgoers love his scenery-chewing portrayal of the evil scheming Commodus - that they boo his nefarious schemings and cheer his demise. Phoenix wants something more from audiences and critics. He wants respect.

"What's it like playing a 19-year-old tyrant?" you ask him and the 25-year-old actor visibly cringes.

"Well, there you go!" he explains sounding peevish about the whole tone of the question. "I hope that's not all you see. I've certainly tried to give him a lot more!" Phoenix has trouble with the fact that essentially he's called upon to play a spoiled young Roman delinquent whose ambition to be emperor leads him to commit murder and lock up his adversaries. To add further spice to the proceedings, he lusts after his sister. Instead, Phoenix seems to think playing Commodus is the equivalent to playing Hamlet. The situation is a perfect example of an all too frequent phenomenon - the actor who falls so in love with his character that his perception of the role is out of whack with the opinion of everyone else.

"I certainly tried to fill him with a number of shades and emotions," Phoenix says earnestly. "It was a great experience because it was so rare to have that opportunity, to have a character who is multi-layered and where you're able to express so much."

The earnestness mounts: "Often-

times in films you get these one-note characters and they can be so dull for an actor and audience, and I just thought this was a unique opportunity." In the tone of an actor who thinks there's something unique in wanting to find depth in a performance, Phoenix invokes the name of *Gladiator* director Ridley Scott for support. "I've looked into a lot of his films like *Blade Runner* and *Alien*. The characters seem so rich, and I think he values the nuances and intricacies of a character as much as the vastness of his visuals and the large canvas on which he works."

But perhaps you can forgive Phoenix for attempting to give a character like Commodus a weight and substance he doesn't really deserve. After all this is a young actor who has lately yearned to be something more than just a teeny bopper's delight. After substance abuse drove his older brother, River, to an early grave several years ago, Joaquin

moved to the forefront of the Phoenix family of performers, and started sending out signals of a new seriousness.

For example, his name. He was born Joaquin Raphael but at the age of four decided he wanted to invoke nature with his name: while out raking leaves with his father, he selected Leaf. So, in his

earlier film roles, he was billed as Leaf Phoenix, and it wasn't until the early '90s that he reverted to his birth name.

He also started taking bigger risks. There was nothing conventional about the black comedy, *To Die For*, and his performance as a naive, sexually obsessed teenager who falls into the clutches of Nicole Kidman who not only seduces him but goads him into committing murder on her behalf. In *Return To Paradise*, he played a student whose drug usage during a trip to the Far East brings him to the gallows. And in *8MM*, he earned accolades for a darkly witty performance as a young man with inroads into the murkier levels of the porn industry.

None of these movies suggest an actor willing to go the easy route and Phoenix is continuing this pattern with an upcoming acting assignment, *Quills*, a historical piece about the Marquis de Sade.

"A lot of scripts come my way and most films that are made don't interest me," he confesses. "So that means that maybe I don't work as much, and that a lot of films I've chosen haven't been particularly successful - for which I blame myself completely. But I have gone out of my way to find projects that were unique and different and offer an interesting perspective."

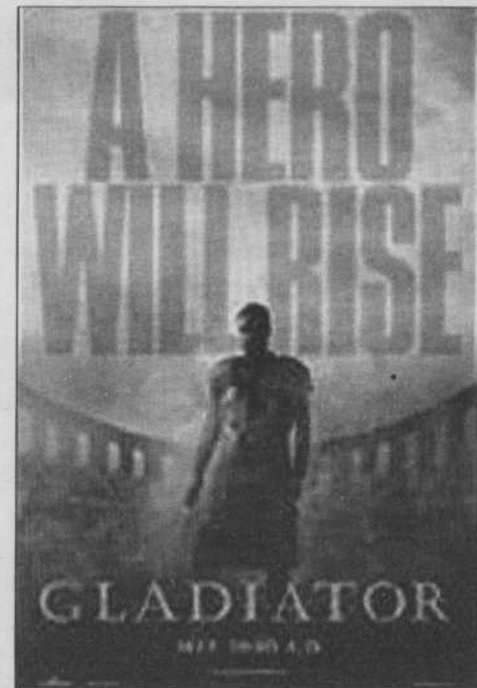
In the case of *Gladiator*, it would be a bum rap to suggest that the casting of Phoenix as Commodus was the equivalent of asking a boy to play a man's role. Although the movie wreaks havoc with history, it's accurate on one point - Commodus was still in his teens when he became emperor.

There's a rueful tone in Phoenix's voice as he talks about communicating the mental turbulence of someone who has been "cheated out of his childhood." But instead of filmgoers showing sympathy and compassion for such a character, they insist on perceiving him as someone they love to hate... someone they can wholeheartedly hiss, particularly during the climactic battle with hero Russell Crowe.

Even so, for all his wistfulness over having his performance misunderstood, Phoenix does admit he loved bashing swords in the final moments of the movie.

"I'd never really had this kind of opportunity before. It combined everything an actor could want in a film - physical scenes, sword-fighting, the sheer epic dimensions of it all."

Now the serious young actor has given way to the enthusiastic kid with a new toy.

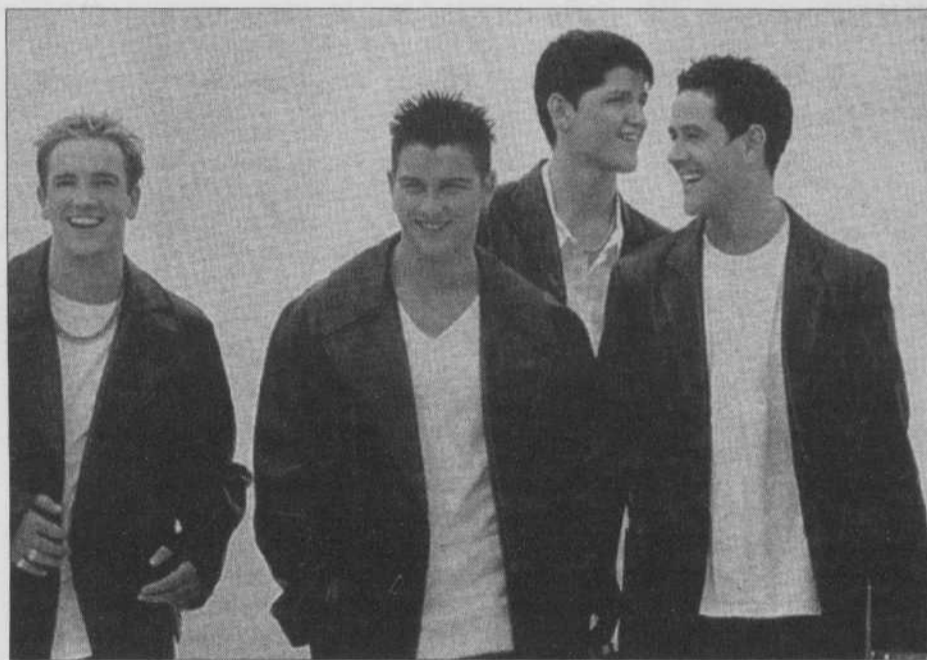

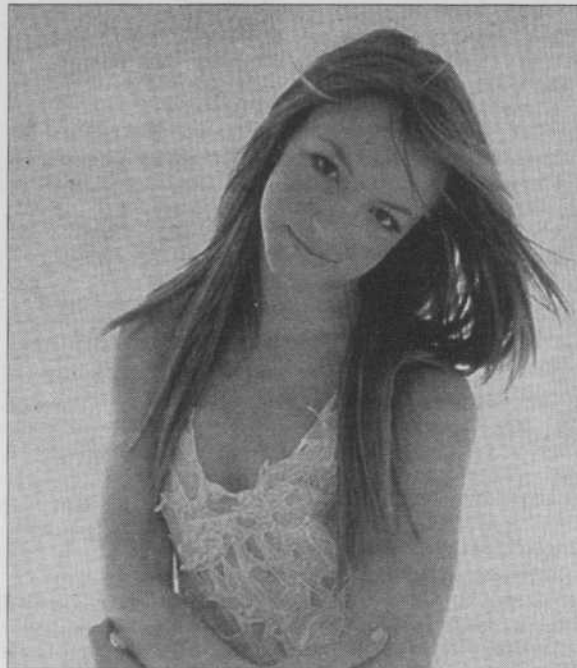

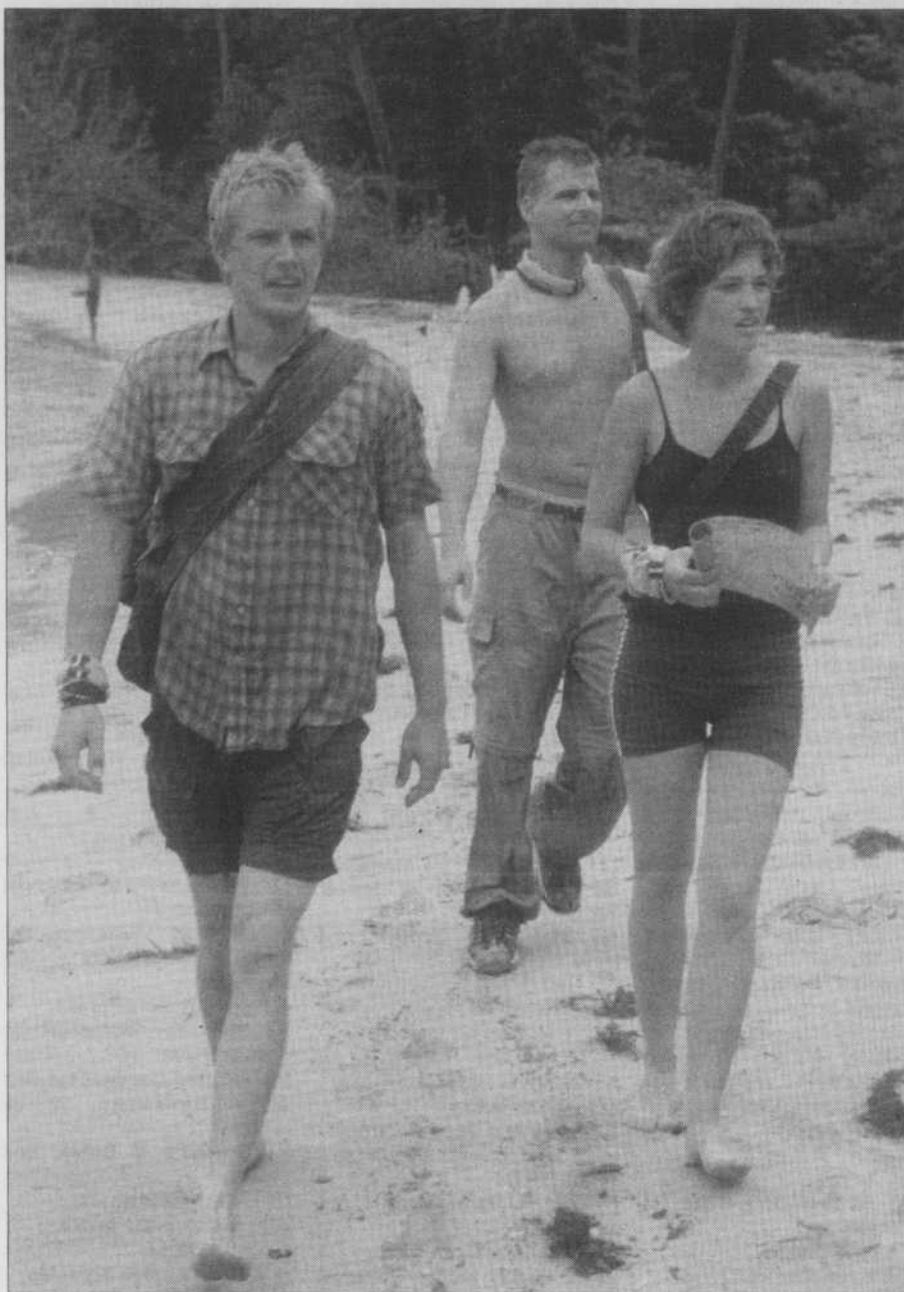

It sounds like *Lord of the Flies* for adults. Only in the case of the ballyhooed CBS show *Survivor*, the folks marooned on a South Pacific island chose to be there. 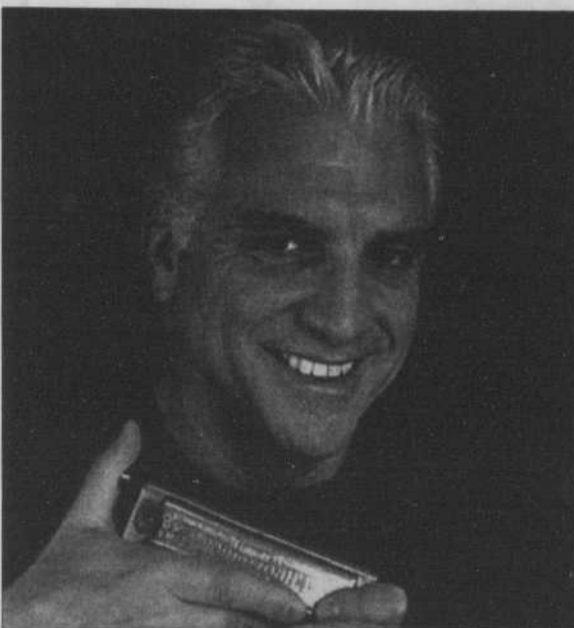

Sicilians in Hamilton



TV DATA

The city of Hamilton is known for three things: steel, comics (Martin Short, Dave Thomas and Steve Smith, among others) and Sicilians.

It is incredible to think that 10,000 people hailing from the same Sicilian town settled in one Hamilton neighborhood during the 1950s. That was 2,000 more than remained in Recalmuto. Charly Chiarelli (pictured) was among those immigrants. Born in Recalmuto in the Sicilian province of Agrigento in 1948, he came with his family to Hamilton when he was 8 months old. Ask him how it came to be that 10,000 people from one small town on the other side of the world came to be living in an even smaller corner of Hamilton, and he has a ready answer. "Really, the question is: 'How does one person from Recalmuto make it to Hamilton?' Once you've answered that, you know how the 10,000 did it," Chiarelli says. "They did it through the one. Once somebody meandered there and gave word abroad that there's work and the streets are paved with stainless steel, they all trickled over." It is precisely the same means, he says, by which his one-man show *Cu'Fu?* went from being a series of anecdotes about his colorful Sicilian family to an acclaimed theatrical production and then a national TV special. The hourlong TV adaptation of *Cu'Fu?* airs Wednesday, May 31, on Bravo! Canada.
