

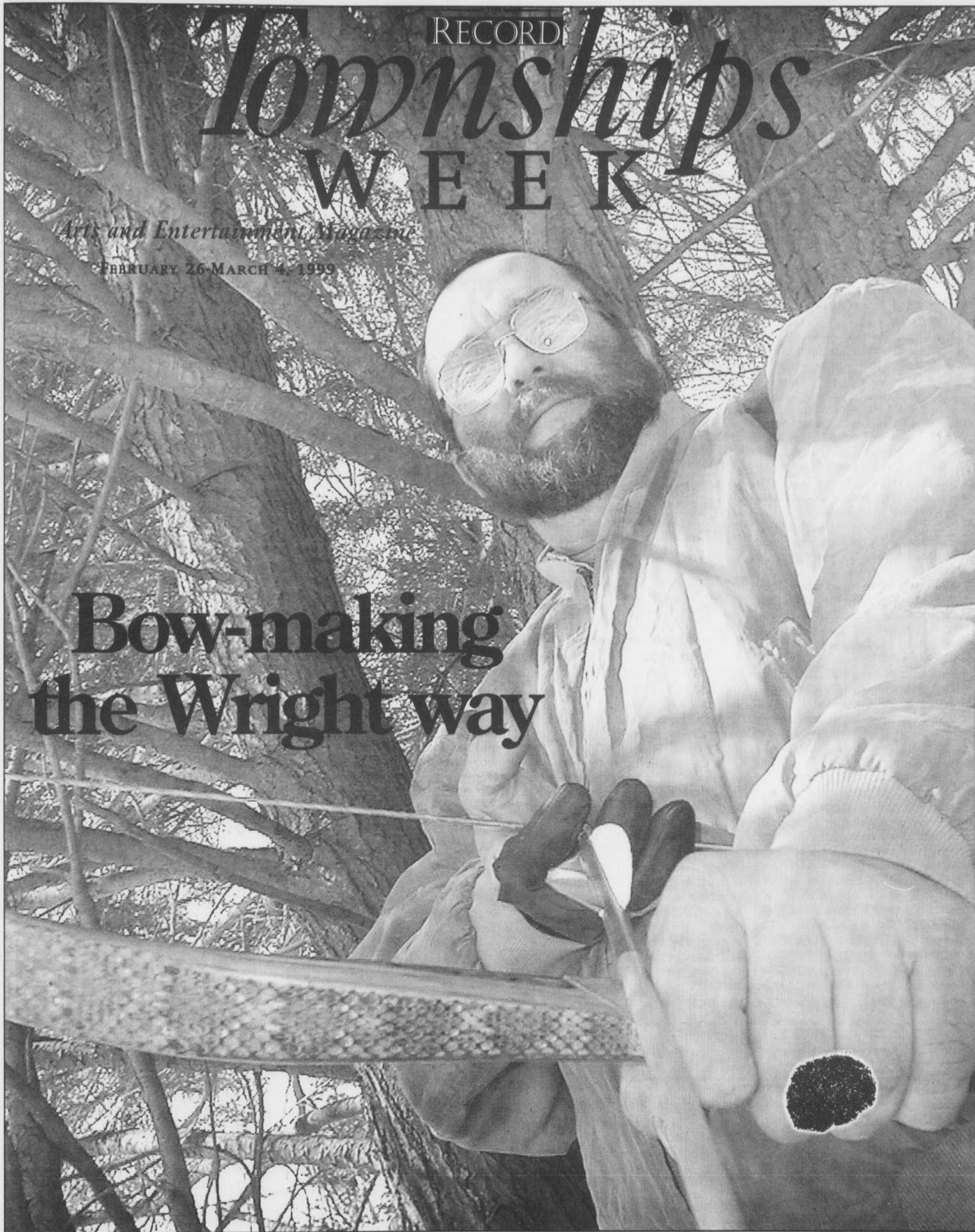

Get ready for Gilgamesh

Humanity's oldest story hits the Sherbrooke stage Saturday

Five thousand years, two translations and the Atlantic Ocean: that's the journey the Epic of Gilgamesh made to arrive here, in Sherbrooke, on Saturday, Feb. 27.

The Epic of Gilgamesh is a retelling of the 5,000-year-old Mesopotamian legend as interpreted by author/narrator Michel Garneau and performed by Le Petit Théâtre de Sherbrooke. It involves shadow puppets, live music, and narration. Le Petit Théâtre has brought the saga back after a second European tour, for their first performance in English.

Garneau is no stranger to the Epic, having worked with it extensively since he first encountered the story over 20 years ago.

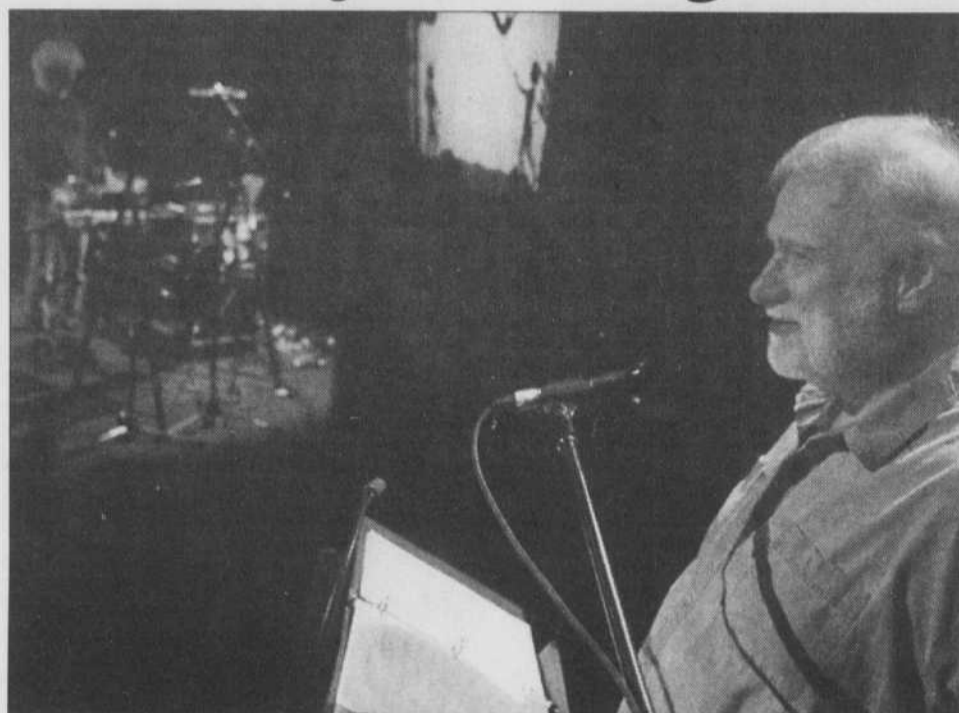
"I read a very personal version of it by an American poet called Irwin Mason. I found it very beautiful and it triggered a need," he said. "I began to read other translations to find out what the full story was."

These readings led to a fuller understanding of the world's first recorded story and in 1975, Garneau was called upon to expand his Gilgamesh experience even more.

"In 1975 I did my first theatre adaptation for the National Theatre School," he said. The production, which involved the entire French department and ran over four and a half hours, met with great acclaim. "It was an enormous thing, quite extraordinary," Garneau said.

Needless to say, Gilgamesh stayed with Garneau and when his colleagues Isabelle Cauchy and Michel G. Côté began to talk about doing a children's shadow-theatre production, "I suggested the Epic of Gilgamesh," he said. The nature of the tale made it a natural choice for shadow theatre.

"It is an ancient and basic text," Garneau explained, "and shadow theater is also something that is very ancient and

basic. It is a very simple thing and is quite magical. Kids should be kind of blasé because they deal with images in a very fast fashion, but still when they are confronted by a simple screen and shadows they are fascinated."

But can a story more than 5,000 years old really be relevant to people - children - today? Absolutely.

"It's a profoundly moving story; a rite of passage thing, a very basic archetypal thing," said Garneau. "It's the story of life and death. The story of being young and wild and arrogant and violent and feeling invincible and discovering that you are not. And that death is there, that you are going to die and there is nothing you can do about it."

To ensure the

story would entertain children, Garneau, Cauchy (the puppeteer) and Côté (the composer and musician) asked the experts.

"We recruited a group of children from Stanstead to take part in a workshop where I told them the story - I had done the first draft of a shorter text - and we worked with them to find out what things and moments and characters they liked," Garneau said.

"You can work with the texts and have

the children draw silhouettes and make puppets," he added. "It's a very simple thing: all you need are sheets and light."

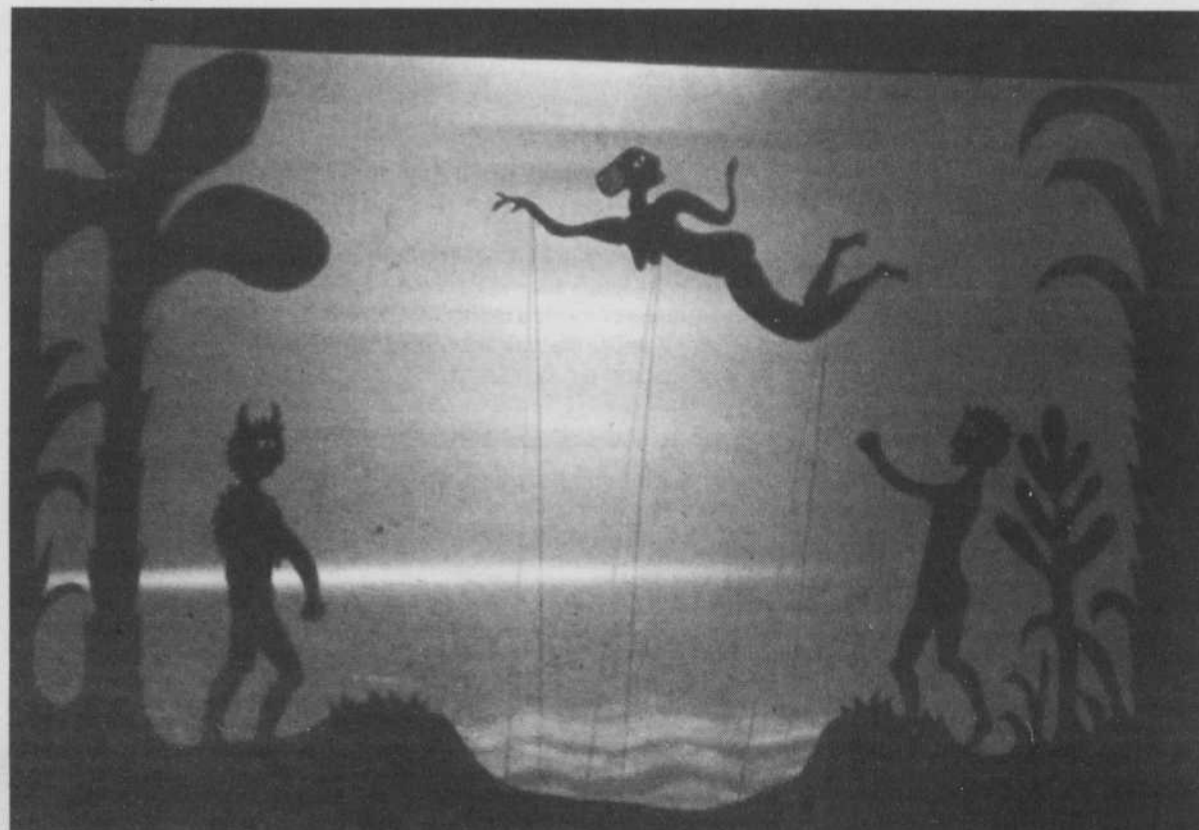
After reducing the Epic to a more workable hour, all other aspects of the play were whipped into shape. Cauchy worked with Sherbrooke graphic designer France Leduc to create an overall look and design for the piece, and Côté began to create a very intricate score based on Garneau himself. "I taped the text for him and he put it on his computer and built the music around my voice using my rhythms," Garneau said.

The result is a blend of live percussion and pre-recorded music, modern but with allusions to ancient music and Eastern rhythms; so well fused with Garneau's narration that the group uses technology to meld the two. "It's like another speech alongside mine," Garneau says. "It's a very precise score. I have a device that shows me where I am, otherwise it would be very difficult to do all the subtle things that Michel has prepared for me."

The final result is a magical retelling of the oldest work of literature known to humanity, something Garneau feels has a message for people of every age.

"It's a very noble text because it doesn't try to come up with phony answers. It states very clearly that on the big questions, there is no answer," he said. "You're sent back directly to yourself and your own life and the fact that you were given this gift and it's going to be taken away but while you have it, it's beautiful."

The Epic of Gilgamesh will be presented at 2 p.m. on Feb. 27 at 174 du Palais Street in Sherbrooke.

Modern musings on an ancient art

Anna Grant adds her own touch to the Mandala

It's an art form as old as humanity itself and it's finding an outlet through Lennoxville artist Anna Grant.

It's called 'Mandala' and, as Grant says, it's an artistic expression with something for everybody.

"Mandala art is described by many people different ways," she said. "But it's Carl Jung that mentioned first that it's connected with the archetypes of the unconscious. I haven't read a lot of Jung, but that's what people who do Mandalas mention foremost."

Mandala, a Sanskrit word for 'circle enclosing a square,' consists of geometric outpourings, meticulously detailed by the artist. It is found in art and architecture around the world.

"It starts in the centre and grows out. What I like to think of it as is an attempt to find order in chaos," said Grant, who works in the archives department at Bishop's University. "For a lot of people, drawing Mandalas is a calming process."

Grant said her first steps towards drawing Mandalas were unconscious.

"I've been doing it for years, and they've grown from a crude little doodle on a school notebook to something more and more sophisticated," she said. "Years later, somebody told me that I was drawing Mandalas. I looked it up and said, 'Oh my goodness! I had no idea I was doing art that is known all over the world!'"

Grant said drawing a Mandala takes 10 to 12 hours, but it's rare for her to complete it in one or even two sessions.

"It's not something that I can just sit down and draw from beginning to end in one afternoon," she said. "Sometimes

one Mandala can take from a week to a month to complete; there are times when I get to a stage and I sit and stare and... nothing. Nothing comes. Other times I can draw for an afternoon and get a lot done."

One of the things that draws Grant to the Mandala form is its openness, both to artistic and viewer interpretation.

"Different people see different things in Mandalas," she said. "Sometimes when I draw a Mandala, there are times when there are special and powerful things in my life. Later I'll look back and say, 'Oh, there's something coming out pertaining to that.'"

Both good and bad experiences may work themselves into Grant's work.

"There's one I drew while I had some tooth trouble, years ago, and a friend looked at it and said, 'I hate looking at that, it looks like the roots.'"

The very popularity of the Mandala as an art form has been both a blessing and a curse, said Grant.

"I was at first discouraged to see how many Mandala Web sites and home pages there were (on the Internet). In a sense it was good, because I could see that there are lots of people doing it and think it's great, but after a while I got depressed and started to think, 'Well, I'm just one of a bunch of people doing these things, so who cares.'"

But the more Grant researched the Mandala, the more she found she was indeed creating something distinct.

"I realized that a lot of the people who draw these Mandalas draw them very similar to the traditional Eastern Mandalas, or more typically a lot like the Jungian Mandalas," she said. "The same colours, the same structures. Mine, I think, are more intricate and more varied, whereas the ones that I've seen on the Internet do look alike. In that sense, I feel good that I do have a bit of originality."

Grant's originality stems from the fact that she never set out to create Man-

dalas per se, just do draw.

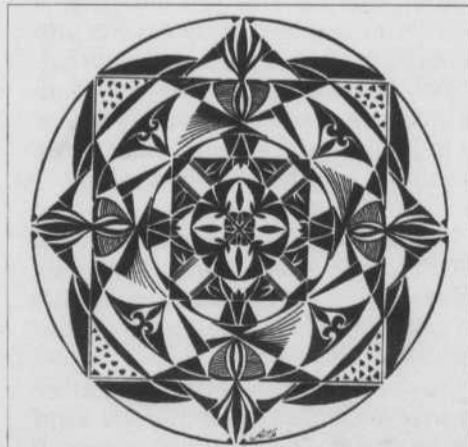
"Some of these people went to Mandala workshops and learned how to draw Mandalas, how to meditate before drawing one, whereas with me, my earliest drawings aren't even symmetrical, they're very crude."

Now Grant has decided to 'go public' after years of drawing Mandalas for herself and friends.

"This year, I took the leap of making a black-and-white calendar. My main objective was just to have some nice gifts to give to friends and family, and the response was great, so I'm thinking about a larger run for next year and have them out there in the shops," she said.

"It would be nice to have an exhibition. More and more people are seeing my brochure and I have a modest Web site. It's a start, and it's certainly progress from just having these drawings in a case in my living room."

"Now I'm doing something and people are responding."

Striking a new chord

Michael Goodsell and the art of steel guitar

Michael Goodsell is about to make Quebec musical history. The Ayer's Cliff artist's debut CD, *Steelin Some Jazz*, the result of years of hard work and perseverance, is set to be released. Thought to be the first of its kind in Quebec, the veteran musician has added steel guitar to some jazz classics.

As he sits down for an interview over breakfast at Cafe Java in Lennoxville, Goodsell is quick to smile and offer a friendly joke.

"I see this as an accomplishment, I did it for the love of music" said Goodsell about his independently produced recording.

His love of music was born early. Goodsell spent many nights at his father's hotel, The Rock Cliff, watching the night's entertainment arrive and then perform their sound checks. Later, other musicians, like Alan Bailey, would

influence Goodsell.

"But I think that my main influence was the late Jerry Robitaille from Jerry & Jo'An."

Impressed by Robitaille's wailing steel guitar, Goodsell decided he too would one day play that instrument.

"I used to hear Jerry play and think this is what I want to do."

Goodsell chose 10 songs including "Canadian Sunset," "Girl From Ipanema," "Night Life," "And I Love Her," and "The Shadow of Your Smile" to perform as instrumentals.

Listeners won't find any experimental or progressive jazz on Goodsell's CD, just soft easy listening numbers.

For this album Goodsell used the late Alan Bailey's steel guitar - a double neck, Sho-Bud.

"With a double neck steel guitar the front neck is used for country picking while the back neck permits you to play jazz" he explained. "The neck is completely different which requires another approach."

"It was quite a challenge since playing country mostly requires three to five chords while playing jazz involves

12 to 15 chords all the time and is a lot more technical."

Some of the Townships' best musicians - drummers Bruno Hamel and Richard Bergeron, bass player Guy Breton, keyboardist Vincent Beaudoin, guitarist Mike Goudreau and saxophonist David Elias lent their talent to Goodsell's recording.

"I actually played steel guitar on two cuts on Mike Goudreau's release set for an April release and I was delighted to have him perform on my album," said the musician.

A journeyman performer, Goodsell has paid his dues playing with a about a half-dozen bands over the years. He got his start playing steel guitar and guitar in the early 70s with the original Big Foot. Then he moved on to bass guitar and joined Bob Boisclair, Louis Levesque and Rick Benney to form Royal Male. By 1979, Goodsell knew the steel guitar was his passion so the part-time musician went to Nashville to learn from one of the very best. A six-day intensive session with renowned teacher Jeff Newman laid the foundation for what was to come 20 years later.

In 1987, he and Mike Goudreau formed Chapter Two and finally played alone for about five years in restaurants and lounges.

"I found it hard to play alone and it is a lot of work. You also miss the comfort of having people on stage with you and the interaction," said Goodsell, who would like to form a new band in time for the summer concert circuit.

His current life-long project is doting on his two preschool-age children. As he mentions his son and daughter a smile forms and he quickly reaches into his wallet to display the latest snapshot.

"I've always been labelled as a country musician and I love country music but there is so much more I want to do. The label is not always a good thing."

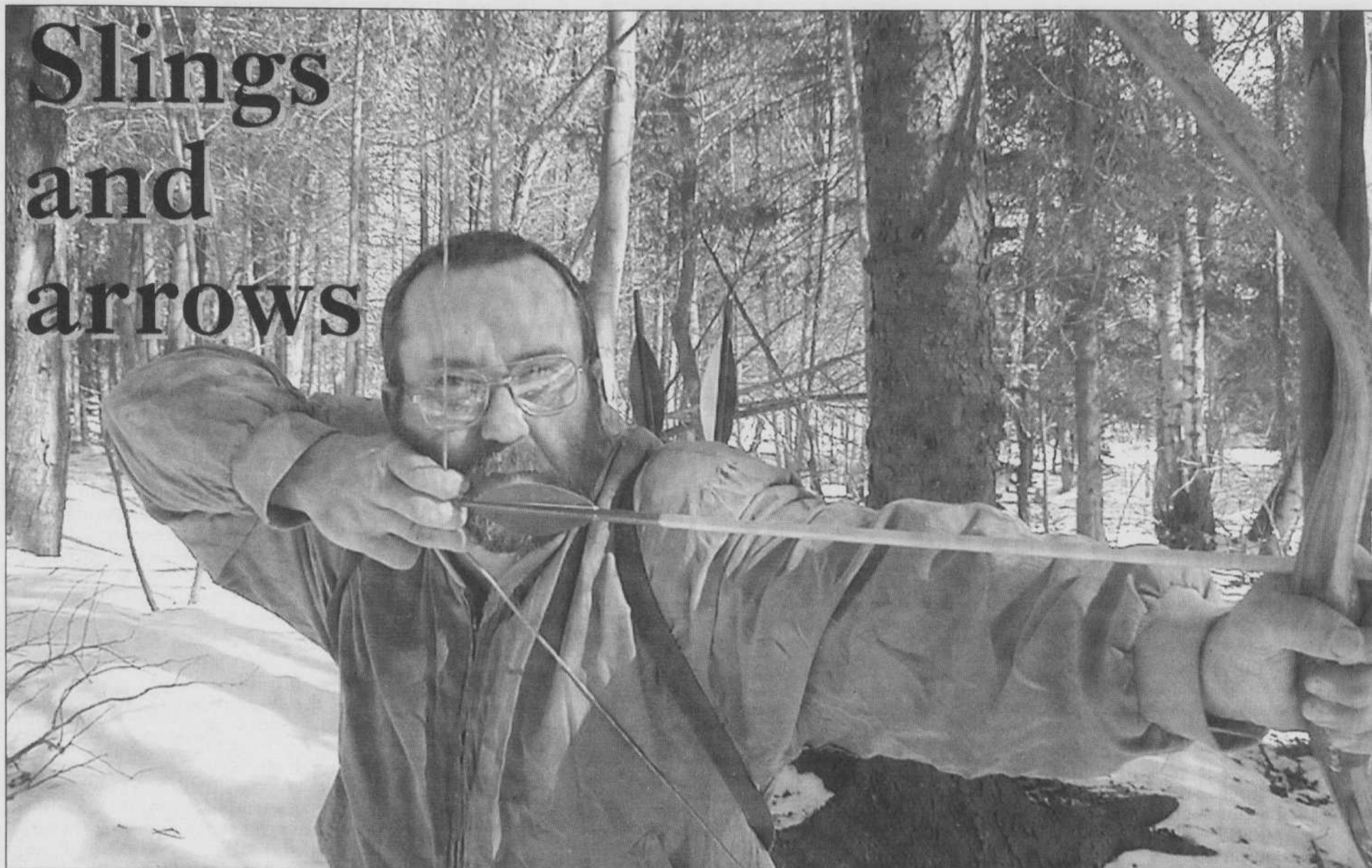

Rodney Wright hopes handcrafted bows will bring a little outrageous fortune his way

Rodney Wright lives just off the Fulford Road in a comfortable cabin surrounded by woods and wildlife - a fitting place for a man who wants to make his living making bows, quivers and arrows. Wright, who makes 14 different models of bows, grew up with archery.

"I've been shooting a bow since I was a kid," said Wright, who lives with wife Sue, son Jason and three large dogs, Crusher, Daisy and Cashmere. "Bow making started as a hobby 10 years ago. It took some time to get the problems worked out and I registered my business in 1995."

Wright gave a casual tour of his basement workshop where he manufactures and displays an assortment of his archery products.

"The modern bow has an average 55-pound draw," he explained, pointing out the estimated 160-pound draw of bows found in the excavated wreckage of Henry VIII's warship, the Mary Rose.

"The English long bow is 60 or 62 inches long and the design allows for the storage of maximum energy for shooting heavy arrows. The longer the bow, the less chance there was of it breaking in battle. The recurve bow is named for a small, secondary curve at the ends. The Hunter Takedown bow is lightweight and rugged, designed to be taken apart into 2 or 3 pieces for traveling. Compact bows such as the Buffalo Hunter are only 48 inches, ideal for shooting buffalo off horseback."

Each bow is slightly different, so Wright had to master the manufacturing process for each. His English longbows, for instance, are made from a single piece of wood. Because a single layer lacks the flexibility of a laminate

bow, the longbow must be handled with finesse. It's the only model that he will not guarantee against breakage. Other models, such as the Hunter Recurve are laminated to add strength and flexibility. Wright's clients can select from local woods such as ash, black cherry and yew. More exotic woods such as bamboo, Osage orange and bocote (a wood imported from Mexico) are also used, with the finest woods reserved for handles.

Once the woods have been selected, the bows must be shaped. For laminates, the bowyer places strips of wood in a custom jig for lamination. His laminated bows taper at the rate of one thousandth of an inch for every inch of length. The jig then goes into an oven for curing for six hours and out comes a laminated bow, ready for finishing. Leather grips are added, as well as deer or cow horn nocks at the ends to lessen chaffing by the string. In addition to bows, Wright also makes styles of arrows and leather quivers.

Wright has shown his archery products to shows in Montreal, Ottawa and Chicoutimi, but says the best advertis-

ing is word of mouth.

"People in France are my biggest customers...they buy more than Québécois," he said. "I went to France on a vacation and sold one bow. It was word-of-mouth from there."

Although his biggest market is Europe, his bows, priced between \$400 and \$570, have a big price advantage over U.S. bow makers because of the exchange rate. He enjoys another advantage in that Canadian bowyers are few and far between. So, he and wife Sue are putting the final touches on a website that will display his works to archers worldwide in the hope that the added sales will enable him to become a full-time professional bowyer.

An avid archer himself, Wright enjoys competing as much as building his bows. "Archery is a quiet sport: You have to concentrate on what you're doing, eliminate all other distractions," he explains.

A member of the Archers Brome-Bolton, he will be taking part in the Tournoi d'arc to be held on March 6 in Knowlton and will be giving away a bow at their June 5 and 6 tournament.

No gamble for Kenny Rogers fans

Newly released
boxed set
includes 80 songs

Around the world, I am The Gambler. When I go to Korea or Japan, for example, people see me and go 'Ah, the Gambler.' Thank God for that song, because it gave me an identification—especially, perhaps, because we've done five movies as well. The song really is a wonderful piece of philosophy, not just about playing cards or gambling, but about life in general. I'm a writer, a decent writer, so I know that there are a lot of times when you use certain words for the purpose of rhyming. But there is not a wasted lyric in The Gambler. Every lyric is germane to the concept of that song. It's a wonderfully constructed piece of material" said Kenny Rogers about recording "The Gambler," his signature song.

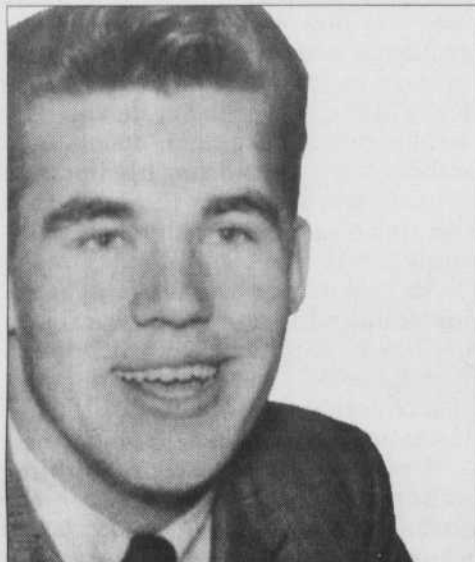
This is one of the many quotes included in the liner notes for the country star's latest release, a boxed set. The words offer a glimpse into this star of music and movies' world.

Here are my reviews:

KENNY ROGERS, Through the Years; A Retrospective. (Capitol)

If you consider the list of hits Rogers has charted over the years it makes you wonder why a boxed set was not released earlier. With the co-operation of a half-dozen labels, all of Rogers hits are here along with a good share of his early work and duets with Dottie West, Dolly Parton and Sheena Easton.

The boxed set includes 80 songs on four discs and a 32-page liner notes

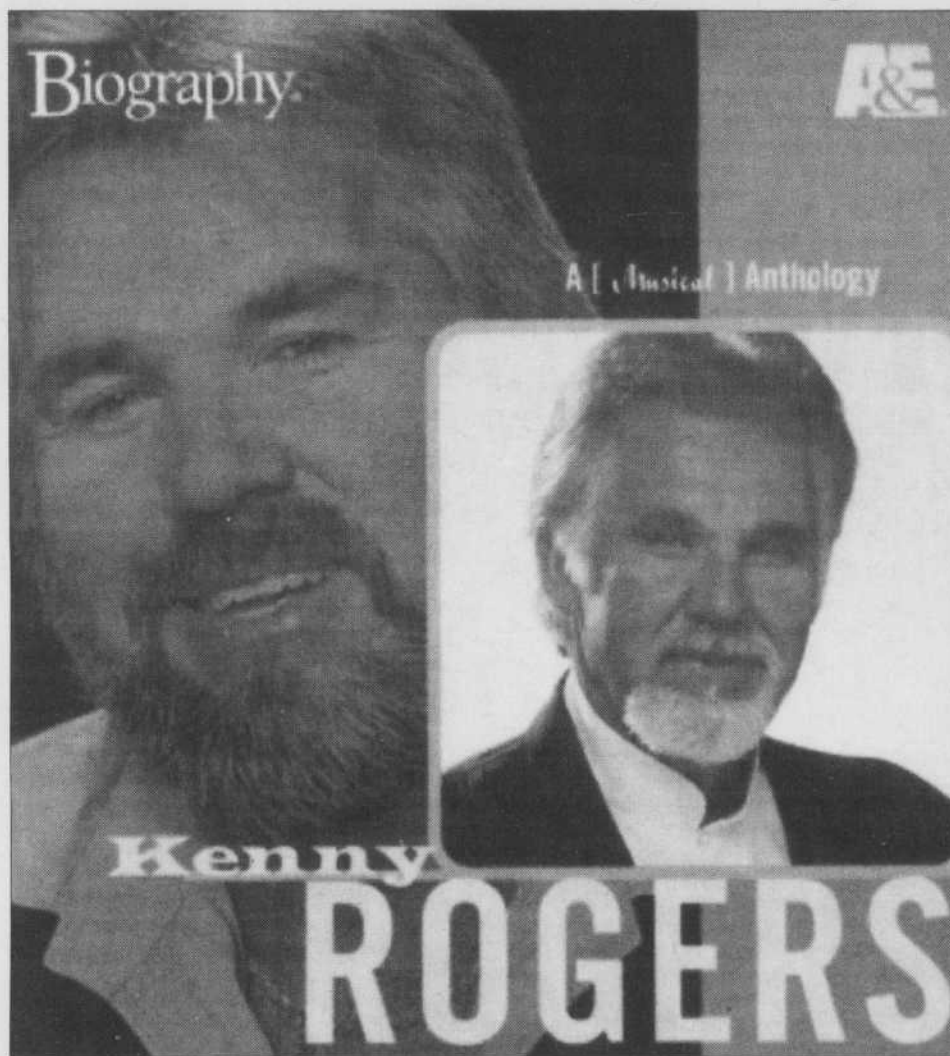


Rogers in the early days.

which include comments from other artists.

HOUSTON PALS

The set includes early work from the 50s when Rogers and three of his Houston pals harmonized their way to local acclaim with the sappy "The Poor Little Doggie."

He also cut some rock 'n' roll as Kenneth Rogers and sang jazz with The Bobby Doyle Three. The First Edition's first hit was the pop and rowdy "Just Dropped in (To See What Condition My Condition Was In)."

The strong country flavour in much of The First Edition's work proves Rogers roots were country.

SOLO HITS

He scored success with solo hits on both the country and pop charts in 1976 and 1977. During the late 70s and 80s Rogers racked up 20 No.1 country singles including the philosophical "The Gambler" and "Coward of the County," to strong ballads such as "You Decorated My Life," "She Believes in Me" and "Morning Desire."

KNIGHT IN SHINY ARMOUR

No one is as convincing as Rogers when he sings "I'm your knight in shiny armour and I love you." No doubt many women are ready to believe him.

This career compilation of the "Sweet Music Man" is very complete and was well worth the wait. It's a must to have in your collection if you're a Kenny Rogers fan.

KENNY ROGERS, A (Musical) Anthology. (A&E/Capitol)

This is the second CD on the market that features the best of Kenny Rogers. This package does not live up to the quality or breadth of material found on the boxed set.

This compilation includes 14 songs including some of his biggest hits such as "The Gambler," "Lady," "Lucille," and "Sweet Music Man."

Also included are four of his duet with Dottie West such as "What Are We Doin' In Love," "Every Time Two Fools Collide," "Anyone Who Isn't Me Tonight" and the popular "All I Ever Need Is You."

This is a nice compilation for Kenny Rogers' fans as every number is a hit. The album offers 45 minutes of pleasurable listening. Also included is a mini booklet with a short biography of the man who has great accomplishments both in the pop and country world.

NEAL MCCOY, The Life of the Party. (Atlantic)

Neal McCoy is always referred to as Mr. Entertainment because of his electrifying, energetic, live performances. The life of the Party is McCoy's eighth album and his best work so far.

This album is certainly aptly titled to describe what McCoy has been to country music and all his fans during his career but on this album you'll find that it's not all party music.

The native of Jacksonville, Tx., has done some very serious work here and you can hear the difference.

This doesn't mean that party music has been left out. There's "The Girls of Summer," a hell-raising anthem with fancy fiddle work, hollers and whistles. It seems very easy for McCoy to sing about sandy beaches, string bikinis and beautiful women, enough as he says, "to make my eyes bug out."

ROMANCE

He also offers some pretty good takes on romance. They can be uplifting and heartwarming or deal with heartache such as the title song "Life of the Party," which is an achingly sad mid-tempo number about someone trying to be the life of the party just to hide his heartbreak.

"Only You," a declaration of devotion will surely become a favoured wedding song. This number casts McCoy in a whole new light and is one of the singer's best performances.

"Completely," is a ballad with a killer chorus which benefits from McCoy's agreeable tenor but the highlight on this new release is "The Strongest Man In The World." The song with its surprising ending will strike a common emotion with mothers everywhere.

This album could very well be Neal McCoy's most acclaimed work as he seemed to have reached a new level, bound to take him much further as a performer.

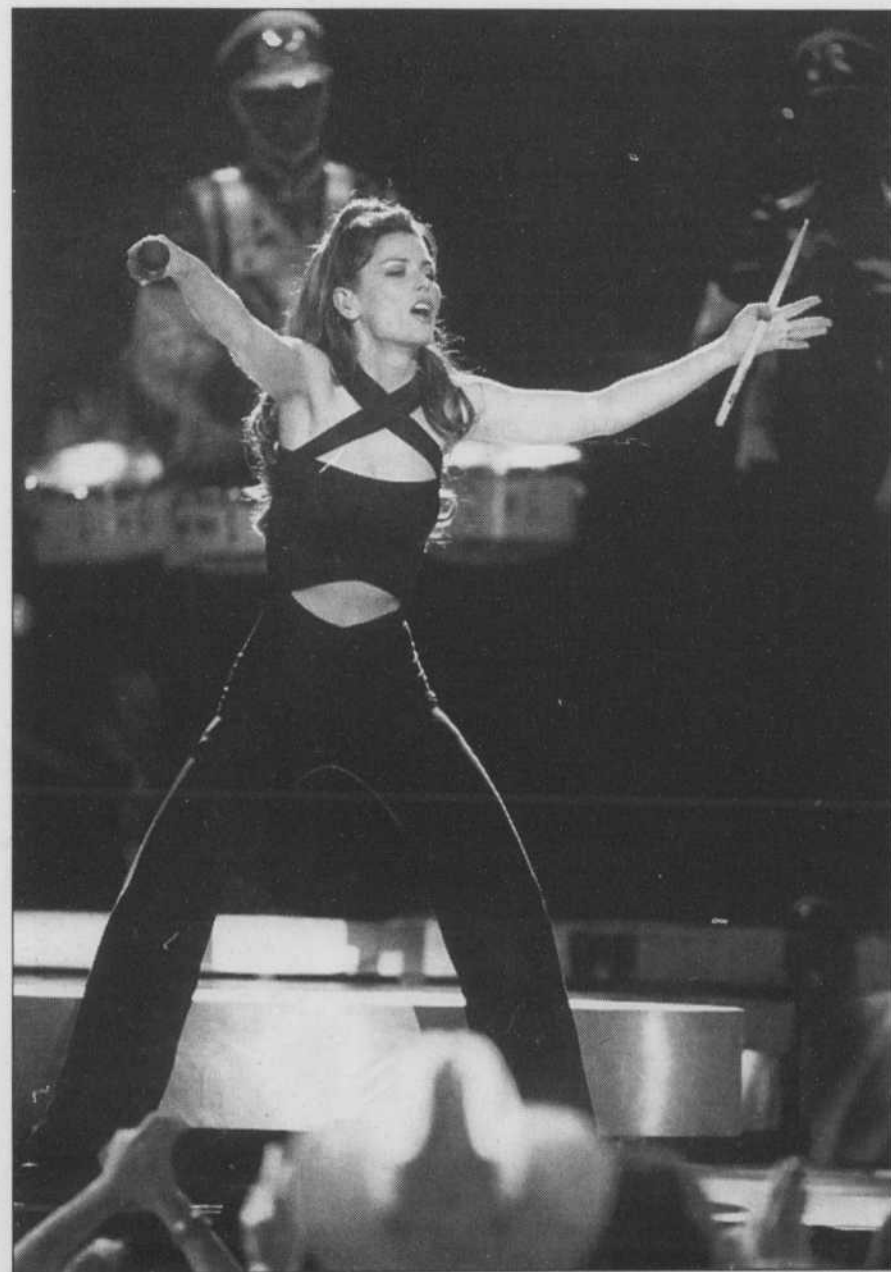

Pop royalty join queen Shania in TV special

There's quite a difference between the snow-covered bush of northern Ontario and the sandy beaches of Miami. It's almost as great as the one between Shania Twain's impoverished childhood in Timmins, Ontario, and her current status as an international superstar and six-time Grammy nominee.

These contrasts are reflected in Shania Twain's *Winter Break*, airing on CBS Wednesday, March 3.

The special, featuring guest stars Elton John and the Backstreet Boys, was taped at two special outdoor Miami concerts.

The program also includes footage of Twain taped in her Ontario hometown in January. Twain uses these chilly Canadian segments to reflect on her roots and to introduce her guests.

The Timmins tapings gave Twain a chance to look up old friends and visit with her younger sister and two brothers. Twain cared for her siblings for three years after their parents died in a 1987 car accident.

"Going back was great," says the 33-year-old singer, who now shares a Florida home with her husband, music producer Jeff Lange.

In addition to her visit home, what sets the show apart is Twain's choice of guest stars. John has been one of her idols since she was a child, she explains.

"I've just wanted to sing with him and meet him and just be with him for a long, long time," she says. "So much of my listening time has been to his records."

John and Twain swap hit singles in a duet performance of his "The Way You Look Tonight" and her "You're Still the One."

Twain's other guests, the Backstreet Boys, are always, in a way, part of her tour. Twain should get pumped just keeping

track of her phenomenal record sales. Her 1995 album *The Woman in Me* and her 1997 release *Come On Over* have both gone multiplatinum.

At last count, *The Woman in Me* had topped 11 million in sales, a figure only three other women have achieved with a single album: Whitney Houston and two of Twain's Canadian compatriots, Celine Dion and Alanis Morissette.

Twain says she loves the fact that Canadian female singers have been so successful internationally, and it doesn't surprise her.

"I never thought that being Canadian was ever going to stop me. Sure, when you come from another country ... there's always a period of breaking through," she says. "Canadian artists should have no anxiety about that. You have just as good a chance as anybody else to make it in another country if you want to become an international artist."

In fact, Twain's down-home Canadian roots have proven something of an asset in the United States. The media seem enchanted by the notion of a sexy chanteuse who knows how to plant trees, handle a chain saw and jump-start a car.

Twain says she's used to bucking stereotypes, including those that assume because she presents a sexy, navel-baring image onstage and in videos, she is more sizzle than steak.

"You don't have to mask your femininity just because you're capable of doing a lot of other things," she says.

Shania Twain's *Winter Break*, airing Wednesday on CBS, features Twain in concert from Miami and in private moments with friends and family in her Ontario hometown of Timmins. Onstage, the Canadian chart-topper is joined by superstar Elton John and the pop sensation Backstreet Boys.

Do Canadians love comedy? You Bette!

If you think Bette and Ed Macdonald are funny, you should see the rest of the family.

Bette is an acclaimed Nova Scotia sketch comic with a facility for creating broad characters, and brother Ed has two Gemini Awards for his writing on the popular CBC-TV satire series *This Hour Has 22 Minutes*. For years, the Macdonalds have collaborated on popular stage and television projects in Atlantic Canada.

But at family reunions, they play second bananas to their two sisters and brother.

"We're actually the least funny in the family," Bette Macdonald confides.

The key to Ed and Bette's comedy success, she says, is selfishness. While their siblings all went into "meaningful"

work - counseling, legal aid and teaching - "Ed and I do this totally self-indulgent stuff. We help no one," she quips.

Unless, that is, you consider laughter therapeutic.

The Macdonalds provide a fair amount of that kind of medicine in their new six-part series *The Bette Show*, beginning Monday, March 1, on CBC.

The show, a mix of field segments and sketches taped before a studio audience, aims at a niche somewhere between *The Carol Burnett Show* and *CODCO*.

Each episode begins with Bette's brief comic monologue, which gives way to a series of sketches, many of which take their cue from television.

In one segment, two outdoor TV show red-necks give tips on how to hunt, shoot and mount street mimes. Another

sketch parodies the ecological sermonizing of a low-budget nature show. Recurring characters include a semi-coherent VJ from "MT TV" and Bette's favourite, Pepper, the breathy-voiced star of *Girl Cop*.

Ed is the show's chief writer but often finds inspiration in the characters his sister invents.

"We have an advantage," Bette says. "Being brother and sister, we understand each other. There's not a whole lot of work in (maintaining the partnership), and we can get right to it because we don't have to be polite."

Bette Macdonald brings humour from writer brother Ed (This Hour Has 22 Minutes) and the rest of the Nova Scotia Macdonalds to The Bette Show, her new comedy venture premiering Monday on CBC.

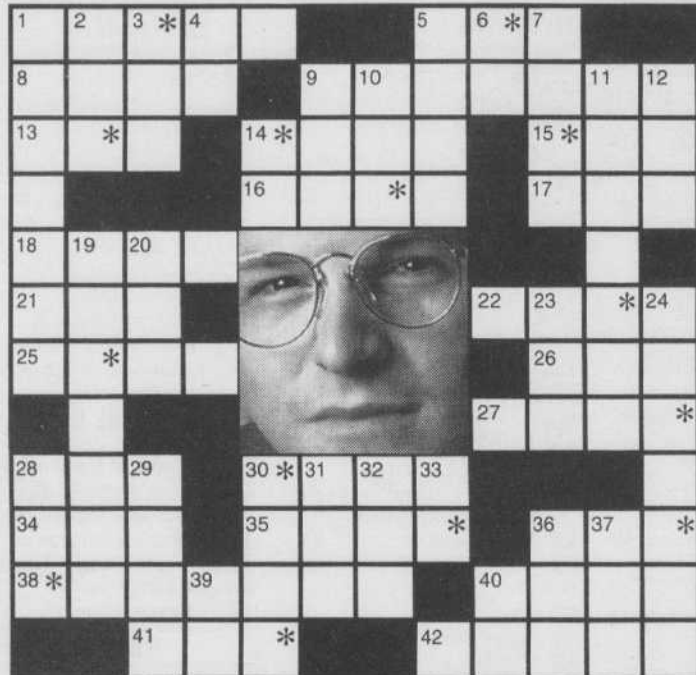

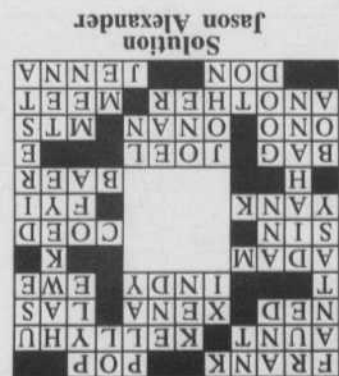

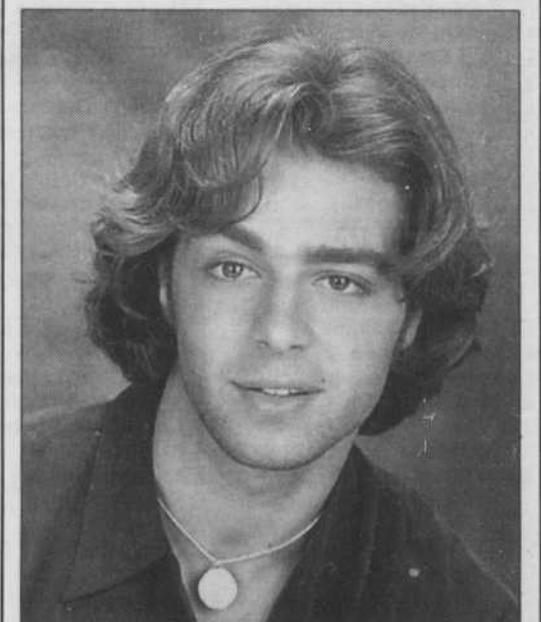
