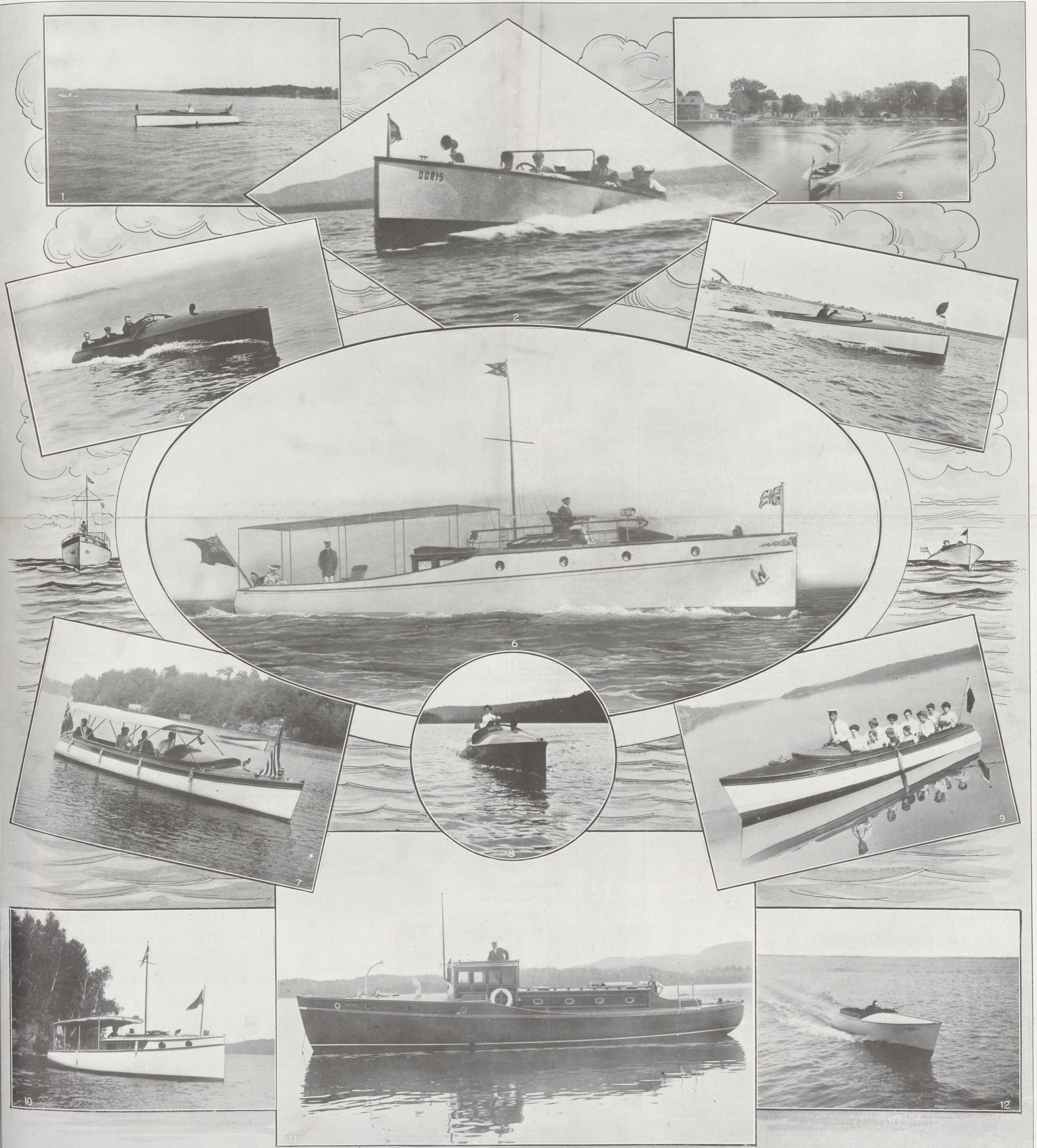


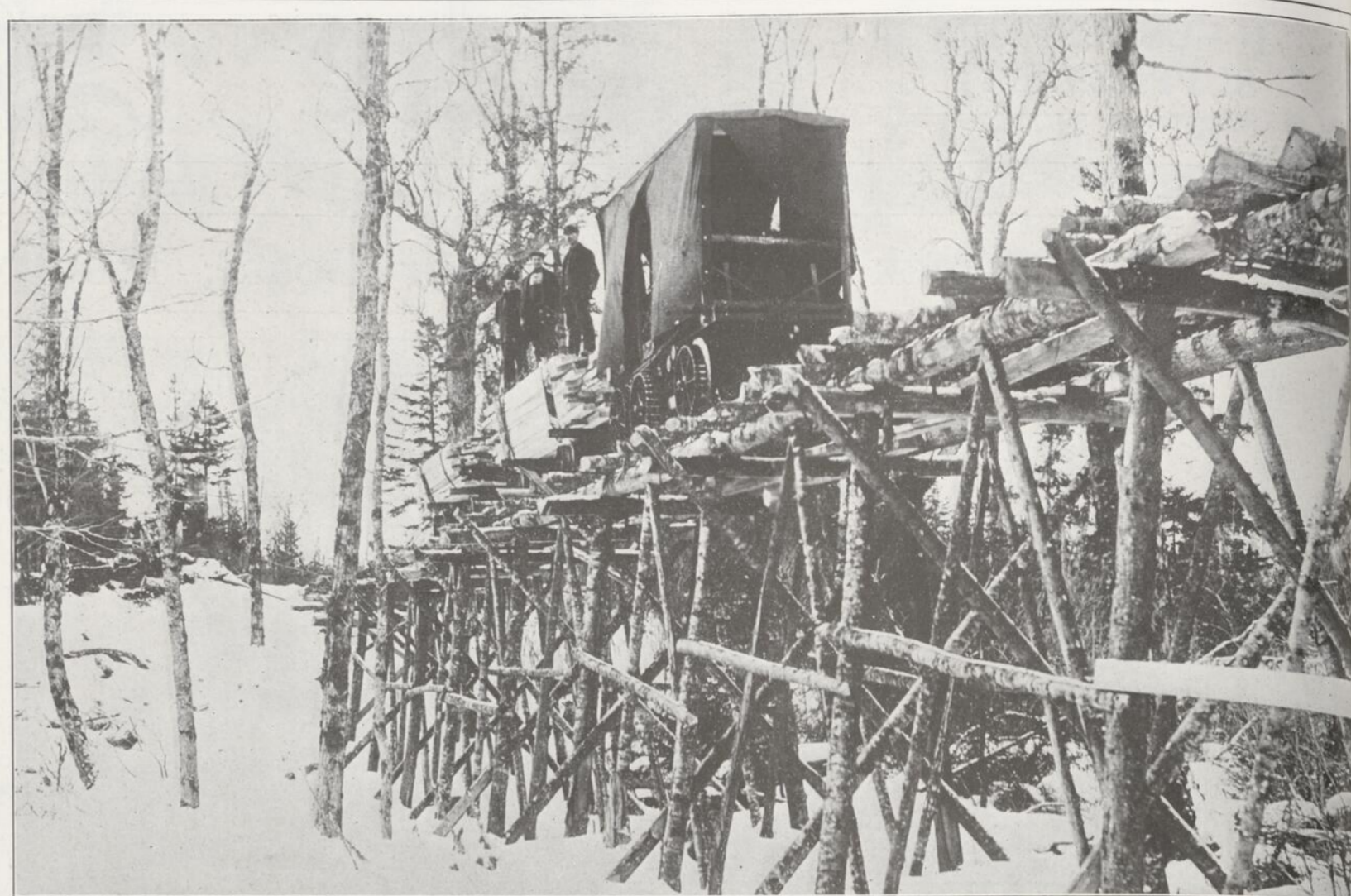

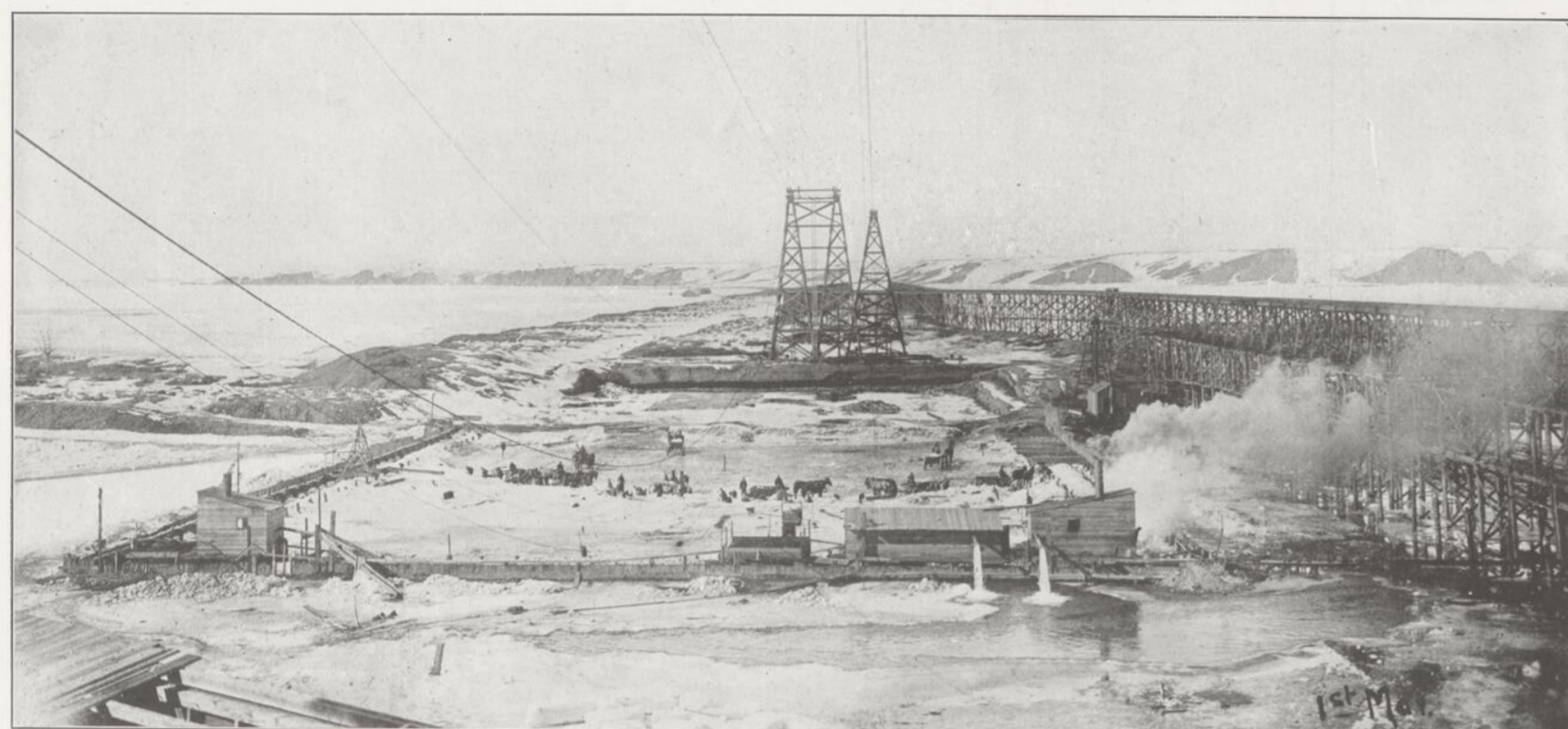

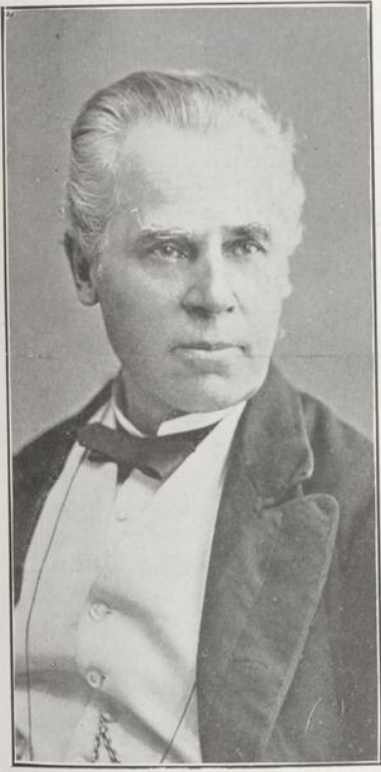
**YOU KNOW IT BY THIS**



PERPETUATING THE MEMORY OF A GREAT CANADIAN—In the course of a few years the commercial metropolis of Canada will possess a truly magnificent memorial of the late Sir George Etienne Cartier, Bart., who did so much to bring about Confederation. It has been decided that a monument, costing approximately \$100,000, shall be erected at the foot of Mount Royal. Subscriptions are now being solicited to defray the cost of the Memorial and an encouraging response is being made to the appeal of the Monument Committee for funds. The above picture is a reproduction of a photograph taken in front of the Church of Notre Dame, Montreal, on the occasion of the funeral of Sir George on June 13, 1873. The funeral was of a most imposing character; troops lined the streets, a special car drawn by eight horses caparisoned in black conveyed the body of the deceased statesman to the place of interment, and enormous crowds paid reverent homage to the illustrious dead.

A NATIONAL movement is now under way in Canada to erect a monument to the late Sir George Etienne Cartier, Bart., who was one of the Fathers of Confederation and an able lieutenant of the late Sir John A. Mac-

donald, G.C.B., first Prime Minister of the Dominion of Canada. The memorial, it is expected, will cost in the neighborhood of \$100,000, and will be erected at the base of Mount Royal, so named by Jacques Cartier, the intrepid French explorer who discovered Stadacona (Quebec) and Hochelaga (Montreal), and to whose family Sir George is said to have belonged. Subscriptions will be taken up all over Canada to defray the cost of the monument, which promises to be one of the largest and best in Canada.

Sir George passed away in London, on May 20, 1873, two days before the date set for his return to Canada. He had been ill for some time and had gone to London to seek expert medical assistance. The following is a translation of Sir George's last letter, written on the first day of the month in which he died:

London, May 1st, 1873. My dear Pomville, I have the pleasure to tell you that I keep on progressing. The month of April, however, has not been favorable to my health. The cold was too severe. I hope that the warmer temperature shall come to us now. I have taken passage for the 15th instant, but I am obliged to delay my departure until the 22nd on account of the cold

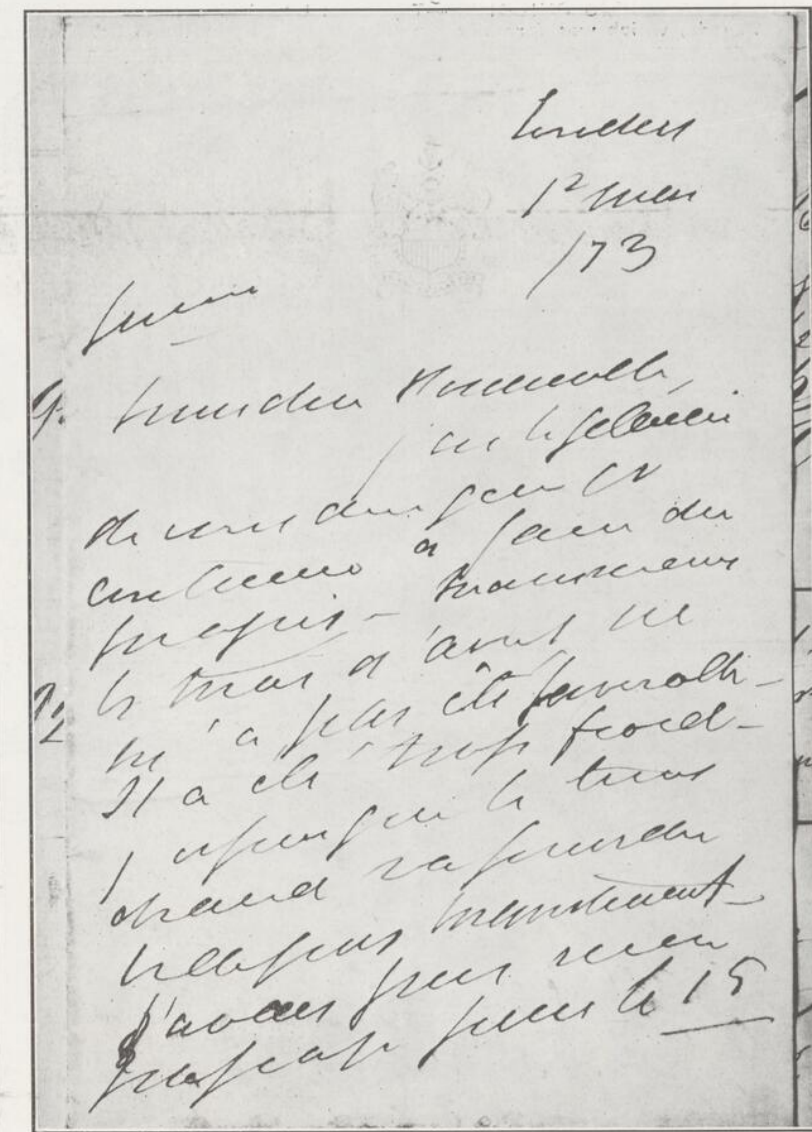

THE FATHER OF SIR GEORGE ETIENNE CARTIER.



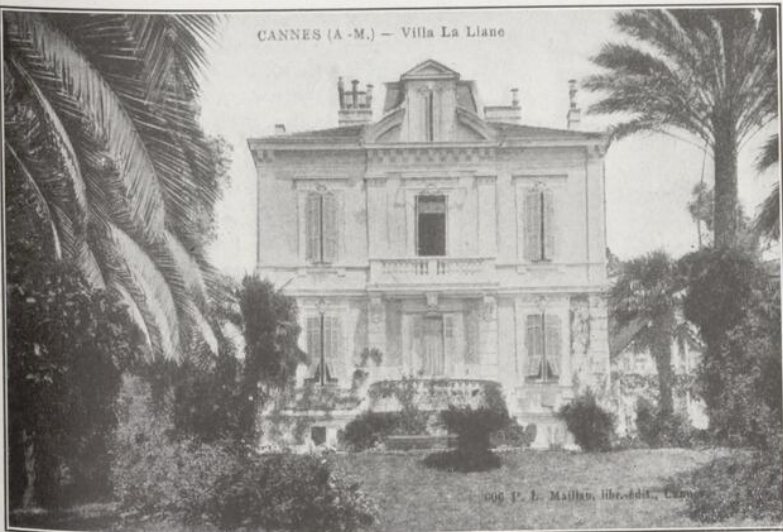

PERPETUATING THE MEMORY OF A GREAT CANADIAN—Facsimile of one of the pages of the last letter written by Sir George Cartier. It was addressed to his friend and partner, Mr. T. P. Pomville, K.C., and was written on May 1st, 1873. Sir George had gone to England to consult eminent physicians. He had resolved to pass his last days and die in the country which he loved so much and whose future he had done so much to assure. On finding that his recovery was impossible he announced his departure for Canada on May 22nd. He died, however, on the 20th, two days before the date fixed for the commencement of his ocean voyage. His public funeral took place in Montreal on June 13.

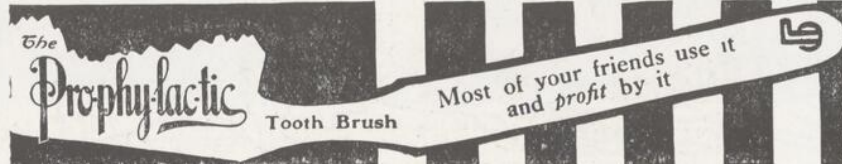

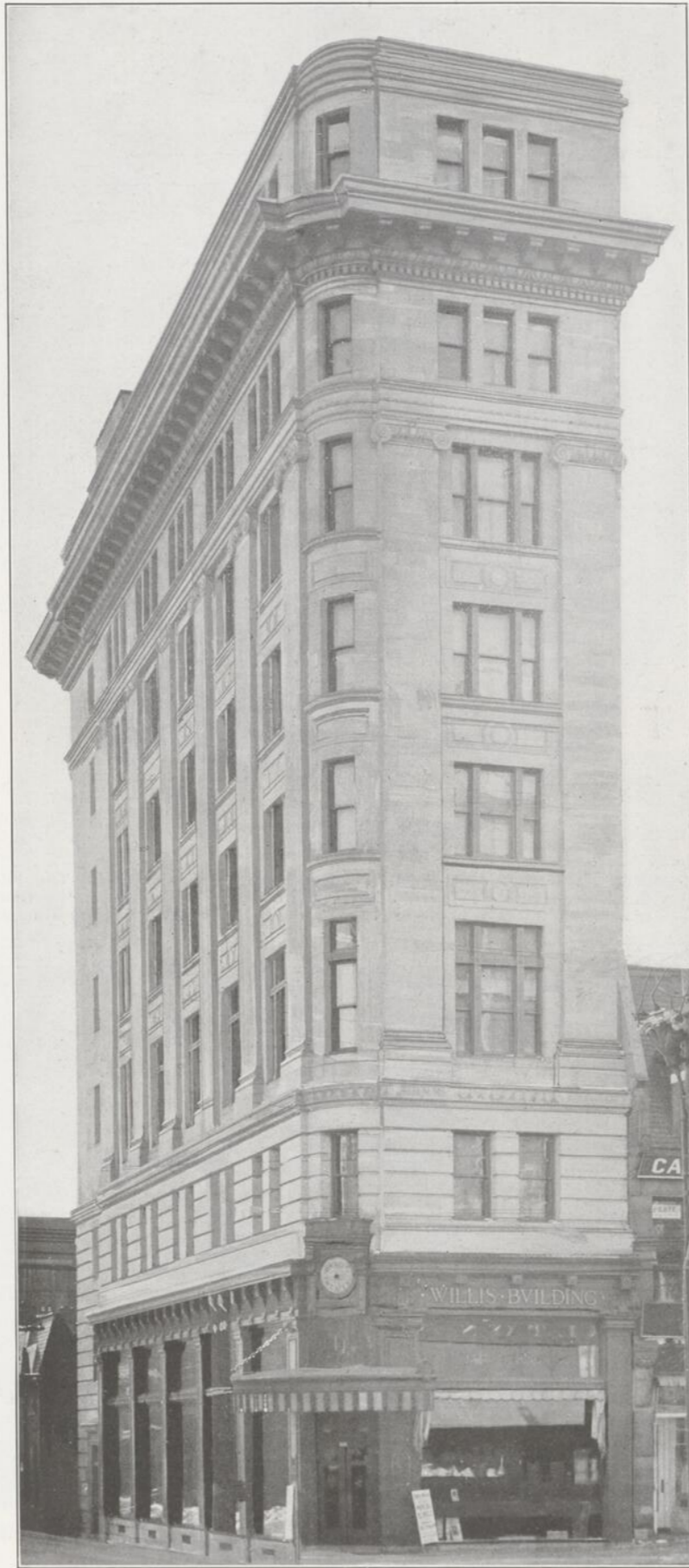

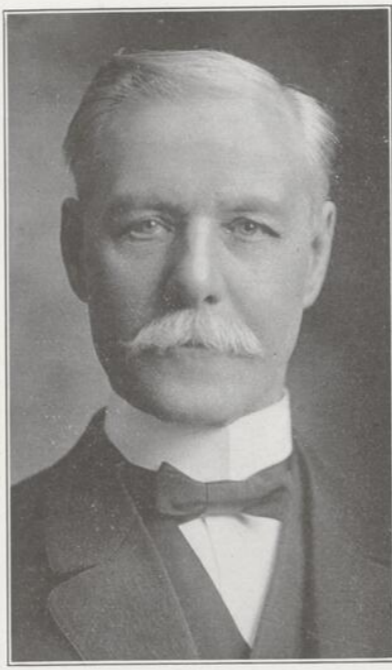
