The Mails from Quebec to the several Post Offices in Upper-Canada, are forwarded every Tuesday and Saturday, at 4 P. M.

The Mails from Quebec to the several Post Offices in Nova-Scotia and New-Brunswick, are forwarded every second Wednesday, at 11 A. M.

During the Winter, Mails for the United States are forwarded from Quebec on Mondays and Thursdays, at 4 P. M. Postage to the Lines must be paid here, at the rate of 1s. per single Letter. Letters for Great Britain or Ireland, are forwarded via the States on the above days, and every second Wednesday via Halifax, the inland postage being paid here. In Summer the communication between Quebec and the United States, by Mail, is thrice a week.

The Mails from Quebec to the several Post Offices in the Eastern Townships, are forwarded every Wednesday, at 4 P. M.

The Mails from Quebec to the several Post Offices on the Ottawa River, are forwarded every Saturday, at 4 P. M.
