STEAM ENGINES.

For stationary high pressure Engines, working not over twelve hours per day:—For each horse power 7 00
 Or for every hundred gallons of water (the supply to be determined by meter) \$0 05
 For stationary low-pressure Engines: for every 100 gallons of water the supply to be determined as above by meter) 0 05
 All rates herein imposed for Steam Engines shall be separate and in over and above any other rate for water imposed on the premises.

DISTILLERIES, BREWERIES, &c.

Distilleries, Breweries, Dye Houses, Railway, Printing and Photographic establishments and all manufacturing establishments, Colleges, Seminaries, Nunneries, Hospitals, Asylums, Academies, Houses of Industry and Reformatories, may be supplied by meter, and charged as follows:
 When the quantity used averages 1,000 gallons per day or less, at the rate of 30 cents per 1,000 gallons; when the quantity used averages from 1,000 to 2,000 gallons per day at the rate of 20 cents per 1,000 gallons.
 From 2,000 to 3,000 \$0 28 | From 6,000 to 7,000 \$0 21
 From 3,000 to 4,000 0 27 | From 7,000 to 8,000 0 19
 From 4,000 to 5,000 0 25 | From 8,000 to 9,000 0 17

 When the quantity averages over 10,000 gallons per day, 15 cents per 1,000 gallons.

An annual rent shall be paid by the consumers for the cost and care of meters, as follows:
 For a 1/2 inch meter \$3 00 | For a 2 inch meter \$14 00
 For a 3/4 " " 3 75 | For a 3 " " 25 00
 For a 1 " " 4 50 | For a 4 " " 45 00
 For a 1 1/2 " " 8 00 | For a 5 " " 100 00

The above rent to be paid semi-annually, that is to say, one-half on the first day of May and the other half on the first day of November in each year.

Persons desirous of supplying their own meter may do so with the written permit of the Superintendent of Water Works. When water is required for purposes not specified in the foregoing Tariff, the rate shall be fixed by the Water Committee. They shall have power to ascertain, by meter, the quantity of water used in any of the above cases, and charge accordingly. \$4 00
