

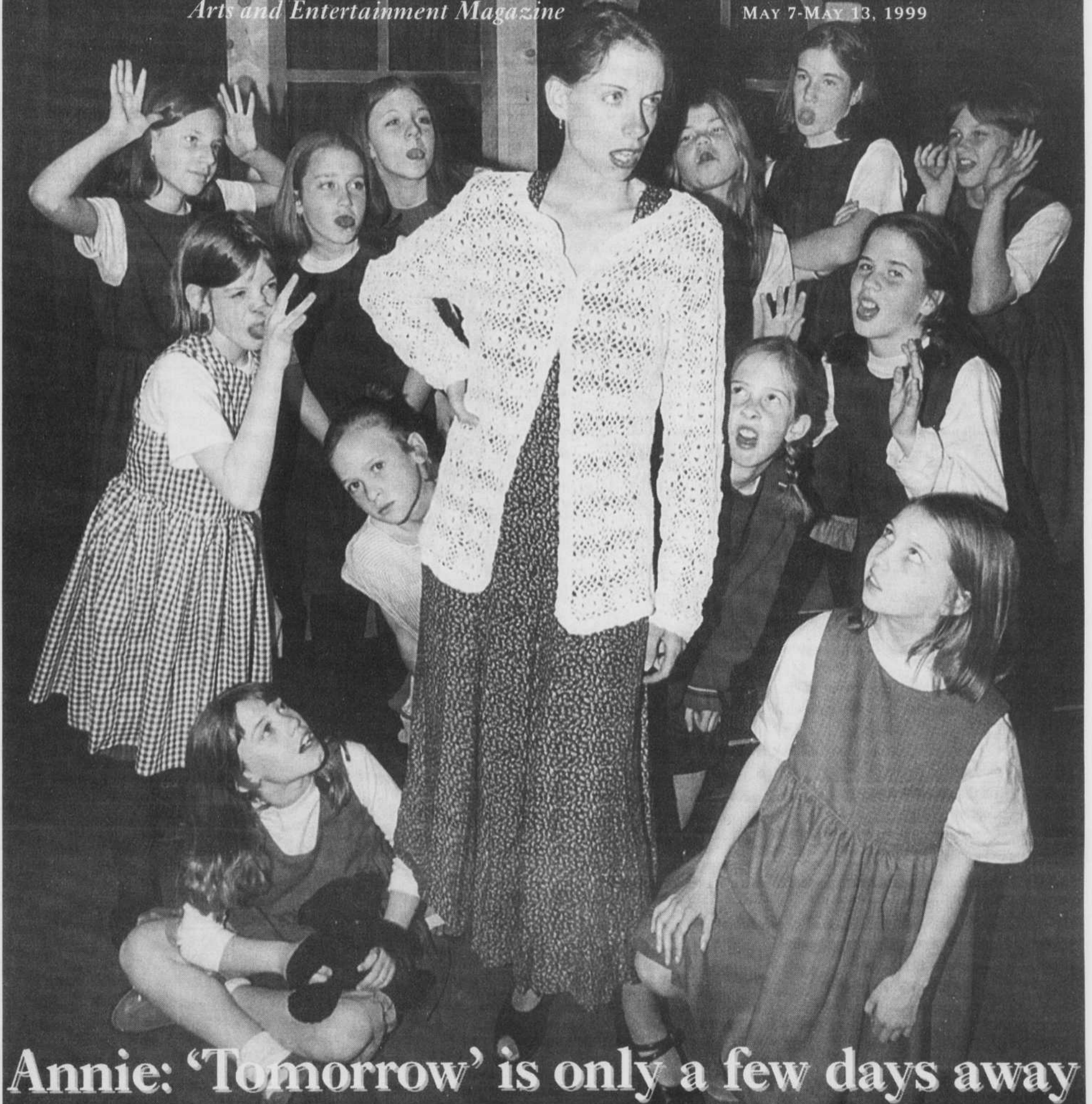

Shirley Haseltine Patton launched her first book, *The History of Moe's River*, to an enthusiastic crowd Saturday afternoon.

More than 100 people gathered at the Ive's Hill Community Centre to congratulate the new author and purchase their copies.

Business was brisk at the sales table, manned by Patton's husband, Bruce, while across the room, line-ups of people waiting to have their copies signed kept the writer busy.

"This is what everybody is getting for Christmas" was an often overheard comment as people with five or six copies tucked under their arms paused to chat with friends and neighbours.

The Pattons both affirm that a last-minute decision to raise the number

of copies printed to 200 was a good idea.

"We only have 30 or 35 books left," said Bruce.

The history book was the brainchild of Shirley's mother, Rheta Haseltine, who spent several years gathering information. When she died before completing her dream, her daughter took on the task.

The resulting book covers the history of the tiny village between Compton and Martinville from the mid-1800s to the present day.

The work is brought to life by the inclusion of anecdotal material gleaned from various people and from old columns of *The Sherbrooke Daily Record* and other newspapers.

A display of old photographs of the area, organized by Bruce, was a major focus of interest at Saturday's launching.

Zeta-Jones: Former 'has-been' now a bombshell

Catherine Zeta-Jones insist she's just an old-fashioned kind of girl. An old-fashioned movie star kind of girl that is.

Think Ava Gardner, Lauren Bacall, Elizabeth Taylor, Lana Turner, Katharine Hepburn and Grace Kelly.

'What I love about the actresses of the 1940s and 50s is that they were allowed to be glamorous but could still be intelligent. They had style and wit, a combination that's not too common these days,' explains the voluptuous British star of *The Mask of Zorro* and this Friday's romantic heist movie *Entrapment*.

'Those old movie stars understood how wonderful glamour and glitz can be. I love going to movie premiers and waving at the crowd and having my picture taken.

'There was a time when I used to dress myself down and purposely try to look plain and frumpy,' recalls Zeta-Jones.

'I thought I was supposed to look as if I'd spent the night sleeping under a bridge in order that people would take me seriously as an actress.

'It wasn't until I started being me and walking into auditions looking like who I really am that I started getting roles.'

It was in her dressing-down days that she lost the roles in *Sabrina*, *Legends of the Fall* and *First Knight* to Julia Ormond.

Yes, Zeta-Jones could have been Sean Connery's Guinevere in *First Knight* instead of waiting to win his heart and spin his head as an international art thief in *Entrapment*. Connery never got to meet Zeta-Jones during the casting for *First Knight*. She was weeded out long before he got that all-important final look he always has before an actress is finally signed to one of his films.

Connery needed less than an hour with Zeta-Jones to know he'd found his leading lady for *Entrapment*. 'Catherine is not going to become a movie star. She is one already. You just have to look at her to know that,' says Connery.

She's a stunning, buxom beauty so unlike the all-too-typical Hollywood waif.

'It's very difficult to define beauty and attractiveness. You either have it or you don't and Catherine definitely has it,' explains Connery.

Jon Amiel who directed *Entrapment* says that Zeta-Jones is 'the most flamboyantly sexual woman on screen today.'

He adds that she is 'utterly confident in her sexuality. Though she is a sexual woman in full bloom there is none of

the sleazy sexuality of a Sharon Stone.

'Nor is there any of this boyish girl thing about her that we see in so many of these gamin little Hollywood actresses of the day.'

Amiel also points out that Zeta-Jones 'comes from a lower middle class background and she hasn't forgotten it. She's completely straight forward and honest which also helps make her so beguiling.'

Zeta-Jones, 29, was born in the Welsh fishing village of Swansea which is also the birthplace of her *Mask of Zorro* costar Anthony Hopkins.

Her father manages a candy factory and her mother is a seamstress. She has an older sister and a younger brother.

When she was 11, she had the title role in a community production of *Annie* and two years later was starring a London production of *Bugsy Malone*.

At 19, Zeta-Jones was cast as the racy daughter in a British TV series called

The Darling Buds of May.

'My whole life changed over night. Suddenly photographers were following me every where and journalists were going through my garbage to try to get some kind of story about me.'

She was linked romantically to such older men as British comedian John Leslie and American producer Jon Peters as well as singer Mick Hucknall and actor Angus MacFadyen a

Her fame on TV never really translated into a film career. She had roles in such films as *Splitting Heirs*, *The Phantom* and *Blue Juice*.

'I was 24. Helena Bonham Carter, Kate Winslet, Cate Blanchett and Emily Watson were getting the roles I really wanted and the British press was labelling me as a has-been.'

Understandably dejected, Zeta-Jones left Britain for America where she starred in the TV series *Catherine the Great* and *Titanic*.

It was Steven Spielberg who spied her in *Titanic* and knew she had to be Antonio Banderas' fiery love interest in *The Mask of Zorro*.

Spielberg was right.

The *Mask of Zorro* made Zeta-Jones an instant sensation in America.

'Britain was the last market in which *Zorro* opened. I was already filming *Entrapment* and took a cab one day. The (British) cab driver looked at me and said: 'Have you given it all up then dear?' I smiled to myself and told him I had.

'It wasn't just cab drivers. That's how

the whole (film) industry in Britain thought of me.'

Not any more. Zeta-Jones has more offers on both sides of the Atlantic than she can handle.

She has already filmed the supernatural thriller *The Haunting of Hill House* and is due in Chicago later this month to film a cameo in the John Cusack film *High Fidelity*.

Zeta-Jones says she wasn't intimidated working with Connery in *Entrapment*.

'Sean comes from the same (working class) background that I do. For him, acting is a craft.

'The work is what is important to him. He's not interested in the gloss and glamor of celebrity.

'I know some people consider me a novice but that's simply not true. I've been in the business for 15 years.

'It's certainly nowhere near the scale of his career but neither am I a neophyte.'

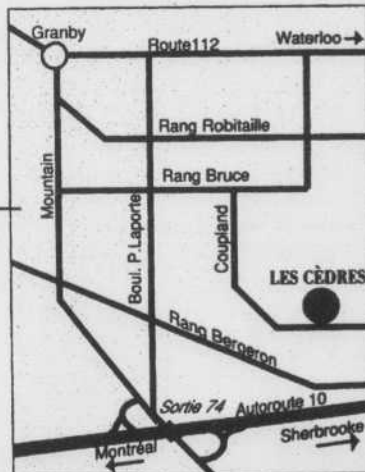

Some desperate orphans, a nasty matron, a charming millionaire, an American president and an adorable little girl are among the cast of thousands (40, actually) in *Annie*, a family musical presented by the Knowlton Players at the Pub Playhouse.

Yes, that means you will have to hear "Tomorrow" at least once again in your lifetime. The show hits the Knowlton stage next Thursday and runs for two weekends.

Director Lucy McAuley gives us the Knowlton Players's second musical production (after *Beauty and the Beast, Really!*) and she's doing it all seven months pregnant!

This is the troupe's first large-cast musical, however, and McAuley said they chose *Annie* precisely for that reason - it is a show that incorporates both children and adults.

"I felt Knowlton had missed out on a traditional upbeat musical," McAuley said, "and the kids worked so well in *Snow White* (her directorial debut). *Annie* also has a positive, upbeat message."

Most of the members of the cast are far too young to remember the comic strip *Annie* is based on. Many have no idea there even was a comic strip long, long before the movies or the musicals.

Harold Gray debuted his creation, "Little Orphan Annie," in August 1924 (before the Great Depression, the time the musical is set). The cartoon proved to be so popular that when *Annie* lost her dog Sandy in 1933, Henry Ford sent a telegram advising that Sandy be found right away. Also noteworthy is that *Annie* was a blonde in the strip, not a redhead as she has appeared in recent reincarnations.

The current production follows the story of a baby who is deposited at an orphanage in 1922. There is a note attached to her blanket saying her parents love her and will return for her. Eleven years later, *Annie* has not given up hope of a reunion with her long-lost family and stubbornly insists she is not an orphan.

Annie's orphanage is ruled by the sadistic and lazy Miss Hannigan, whose idea of taking care of kids is to make money off child labour. Into this dismal institutional life, Oliver Warbucks, a multi-millionaire, sends his personal assistant to choose a child for Christmas. For some unexplained reason, Warbucks needs a kid in his home for Christmas and where else to shop for a waif but an orphanage?

The assistant chooses *Annie*, who, determined to escape the orphanage, makes herself into everything the millionaire is looking for. What follows is a nefarious plot to swindle Warbucks and destroy *Annie*'s happiness but, as this is

an upbeat musical, the good guys win and everyone lives happily ever after.

McAuley said the play is compatible to the group of actors available to the Knowlton Players. Thirty-five girls tried out for the role of *Annie* and McAuley chose the utterly engaging Hallie Seline for the crucial role. Boys tried out as well and, since there were no parts for them, McAuley inserted a scene to incorporate them.

McAuley stressed this is "the Knowlton Players's version of *Annie*, not Broadway, not Montreal, not the movie. Our biggest problem was authenticity; just how authentic to make the show."

One of these problems concerned Sandy, *Annie*'s dog.

"We thought about a real dog, but we didn't have a trained stage dog available to us, and dogs can react very unpredictably in a situation like that. So we settled on having Robby Putnam play

Sandy (another role for a boy)."

The only hesitation the board of directors of the Knowlton Players had concerning such a large and ambitious production was the cost of the rights. Yet they also wanted a play that would attract a large audience of all ages. McAuley presented them with an acceptable budget and rehearsals began in January.

McAuley said she is impressed with the youngest members of the cast.

"They are like sponges, they absorb everything. Like the choreography (by Darleen Bell) - they knew the steps of their number after a couple of hours and they never got it wrong after that. Another surprise is Michaela (Barnes - Miss Hannigan)! We knew she could act, but when she opened her mouth to sing, out came this incredible voice. It was amazing. Add that to her ability to get into the character - well, she's just

incredible."

Barnes, a regular in community theatre, is rather terrified at the prospect of singing.

"I am nervous about the singing. I'm not having as much fun as I usually do. I have to sing a solo! But (co-musical director) Sarah Hoblyn has worked wonders - I'm very grateful to her."

Miss Hannigan is not an unfamiliar sort of character to Barnes, who played the evil queen in *Snow White*.

"She is wicked, but she is a different character from the Wicked Queen, although she does have the same evil motives. Aggie Hannigan is a lush who thinks she got a raw deal in life. She also thinks she's attractive, but she's not - she's slimy! It's just the singing that really throws me off." Barnes said her character, the matron of the orphanage, is the comic relief in the play - even though her effect on her charges is anything but funny.

Seline is pretty down-to-earth for a would-be child star. There is nothing of the stage brat in this 11-year-old. A fan of the movie for the last few years, Hallie always thought playing *Annie* would be wonderful. When she heard of the auditions she set her cap on the juiciest part.

"There were a lot of people at the auditions, but I did think I had a good shot," she said, grinning. "I'm nervous about the singing, but I'm getting better. I think I have improved a lot since January."

Hallie's last notable role was Grumpy in the Knowlton Players production of *Snow White*. She has acted in four plays so far, starting quite young as a 'Jumbly' in *The Owl* and the *Pussycat*.

She is not notably stressed about her role.

"I'm nervous about forgetting lines; I have trouble remembering my two big speeches. But memorizing isn't that hard - reading and memorizing are really the same thing. I'm also a little afraid of singing in front of everyone, but I do feel okay about 'Tomorrow' (her biggest and most recognized number)."

Asked if being *Annie* has changed her life, Hallie shakes her head.

"No, all that's changed is just the feeling that there's so much stuff to do. But it has not affected my homework. There are so many rehearsals, it's true, but, such is life."

Hallie hasn't figured out her future yet - acting beckons, but so does teaching and art. As she herself notes:

"I'm just your typical little girl!"

Favourite picks for moms who love country

Tim McGraw and Lorrie Morgan strike the right chord

Everything blooms in May: tulips, lilacs and country music releases. It's a month for celebration and this coming Sunday we'll pay tribute to mothers.

Here's my pick of some albums for moms who are country fans:

TIM MCGRAW, A PLACE IN THE SUN, (CURB)

The only surprise in this new release is the renewed pleasure of hearing Tim McGraw sing his heart out on this first-rate collection. Those who have loved earlier classics such as Not a Moment Too Soon and Everywhere will have plenty to cheer about on A Place in The Sun.

The new album offers 14 songs from Nashville's best songwriters, ranging from recent Oscar winner Will Jennings and his pal Rodney Crowell, Aimee Mayo, Rory Michael Bourke, Bob

DiPiero to performers Kim Carnes, Mark Collie and Deryl Dodd.

USUAL FLAIR

He has selected every song with his usual flair and one more time McGraw is right on. He is a magical interpreter making every song come to life instantly. Whether he sings about good love or love gone wrong, he is always honest and convincing.

The first single released "Please Remember Me," is an excellent ballad that rocketed to the top of the country music charts as soon as radio dj's started to play it. This is exactly what happens when McGraw has a new song.

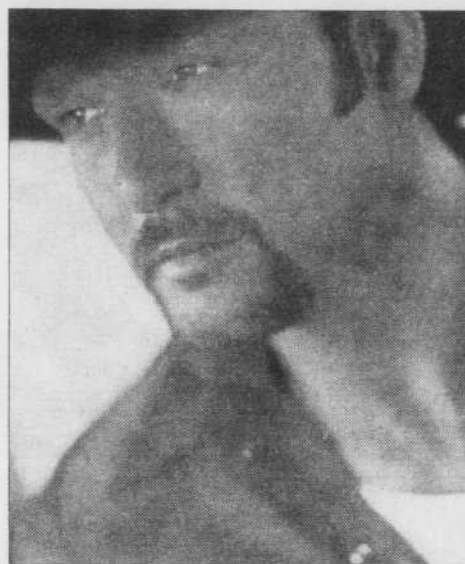
The man has a lot of charisma and he makes everything sound full of warmth, love and hope with vocal qualities listeners never tire of.

Take the first cut on the album, "The Trouble with Never." If he were a lesser singer, he would never have pulled it off, but Tim McGraw makes it work. Anybody with less honesty would have sounded silly singing a line such as "The trouble with never is never never works."

"Somebody Must Be Prayin for Me" is a positive ballad celebrating luck, love and family.

There's also the good ol' boy number titled "She'll Have You Back," a hilarious play on words that is a silent salute to country legend George Jones.

"My Next Thirty Years," is an upbeat reflection of years past and a positive view of years to come. "Sev-

enteen" is filled with nostalgic wisdom and affection for the teenage years.

On "My Best Friend" McGraw offers a heartfelt and subtle delivery as he shows appreciation for the friendship that makes the best relationships. Another highlight is the beautiful "Eyes of a Woman," which will appeal to women of all age.

There's also the feel-good sound of "Something Like That," and the Spanish-flavored "Senorita Margarita." With this new album more than ever Tim McGraw proves his talent and good taste in picking perfect songs and A Place In The Sun is really where he belongs.

This is the best money can buy of everything he has done so far.

LORRIE MORGAN, MY HEART, (BNA)

It has been a long time since country music fans have heard about Lorrie Morgan. Her last release, Secret Love, was more of a pop experiment than a country testimony.

My Heart, her new album sounds more country but still explores the pop ground. But we're still far from the type of songs that made people love her, such as "What Part of No," "Five Minutes" and "Except For Monday."

As always Morgan is poised, adven-

turous and strong and it seems like she's kept her child's sense of wonder. That, along with her heartfelt renditions, will be the key elements to the album's success.

TOUCHING DUET

The first single released is her touching duet with Sammy Kershaw "Maybe Not Tonight," on which they wrestle with how to relight the flame: "We fell out of love/ we can fall back in." The collaboration of the two is quite effective. Another strong and beautiful ballad is "Strong Enough To Cry," a reflection on what a man should be.

There's "Between Midnight and Tomorrow," about the struggle over leaving a drunken, abusive husband. On the title cut Morgan goes down a list of things that would make her life better

but finally admits, "My heart don't need a thing but you."

Morgan sounds sensual enough on the sexy remake of Bryan Adams' "The Only Thing That Looks Good On Me Is You." Listen carefully as toward the end of the song she casts a wink at her bad-girl turn by adlibbing, "Welcome to the Grand Ole Opry, folks."

Her husband John Randall collaborates on one song "On This Bed" truly a beautiful song which Morgan renders very well. Overall this is an excellent album even though Morgan's vocals can't compare to others such as Faith Hill, Martina McBride, Trisha Yearwood, Reba McEntire. Although she's got a smoky, gravelly voice that can do wonders with sad and sexy songs, she's a singer with an attitude and sometimes this is what makes the difference.

9: Years since Michelle Pfeiffer was the cover girl of the first of People magazine's 'The 50 Most Beautiful People In The World.' lists. "I look like a duck," she said then. Now 41, Pfeiffer is back on this year's list. Again, she's a quacker-jack cover girl.

0: 100% real Canadians on People's 1999 Beautiful People list. The closest The Great White North gets is Friends co-star Matthew Perry, American-born but the son of Canadian Suzanne Perry, Pierre Trudeau's former press secretary and also a former model who gave her son good cheek bones.

52: Age next week of the Cannes Film Festival, touted as the most prestigious, important cinema extravaganza in the world.

2: World ranking of the Toronto

International Film Festival now. American filmmaker John Sayles, a regular at Cannes and Toronto, says Toronto emerged from the pack because, like Cannes, "It's a true international film festival," and not just an extension "of America's cultural imperialism."

2: Miserly number of 'totally' American movies picked for competition at Cannes this year: Sayles' Limbo and Tim Robbins' Cradle Will Rock. Two other Franco-American co-productions are in too: David

Lynch's The Straight Story and Jim Jarmusch's Ghost Dog: The Way Of The Samurai.

3: Films of Atom Egoyan in official Cannes competition: Exotica (in 1994), The Sweet Hereafter (in 1997) and now Felicia's Journey. That's three straight for Egoyan, a Cannes record for a Canadian.

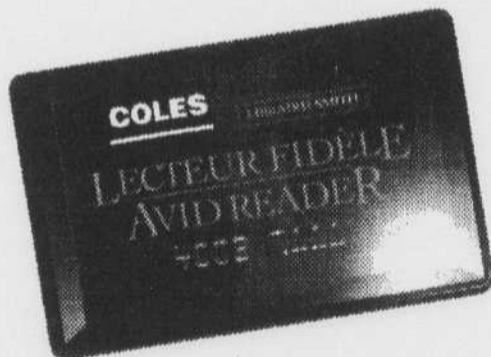

Soap fans mourn the end of Another World

So that's it! After 35 years, it is over. In an effort to streamline its daytime schedule, NBC has canceled its longest-running daytime serial, Another World. The last episode of the drama airs Friday, June 25.

"I thank all the people working on Another World for an incredible job at giving their audience an amazing 35-year run," NBC Entertainment President Scott Sassa says.

"It was a very tough decision. However, these changes allow us to take a major step toward putting our shows in pattern, which is critical to our success in this daypart."

In other words, AW drew the short straw and will be replaced by James

Reilly's new soap, Passions.

AW, which premiered May 4, 1964, was the first to go to the hourlong format. The show went through several writer and executive producer changes over the last 10 years. During that time AW lost focus and had a difficult time keeping its audience. It has been at the bottom of the ratings pile for years.

Earlier this year Christopher Goutman joined the show as executive producer. He tried to bring the focus back to the core families and fan favorites. Goutman was making inroads, and fans were delighted. But it was too little too late.

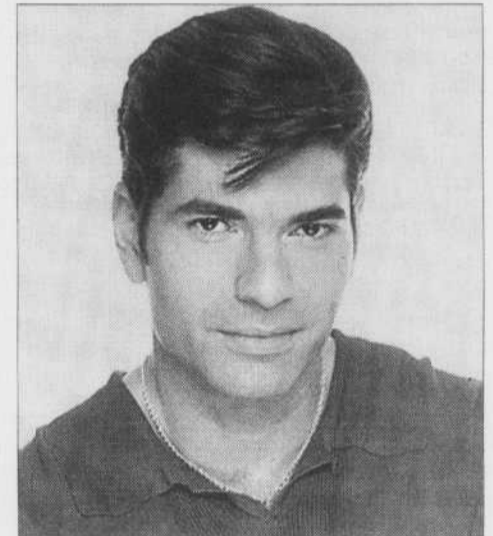
"We've known for quite some time that NBC's decision could go either way," says Mary Alice Dwyer-Dobbin, executive in charge of production for

Procter & Gamble. "Although we certainly wish the outcome were different, it's a sad comment on the television industry as a whole that a soap, especially one with so much history, has to be canceled to make room for a new one."

The producers promised they would give viewers the best possible show until the final episode.

"The threat that we might be canceled has been out there for years," Joseph Barbara (Joe, AW) says. "We just come in and do our jobs. We try not to think about it."

After lengthy negotiations last year, Days of Our Lives was extended through 2004. In April, Aaron Spelling's Sunset Beach was given another six-month extension.

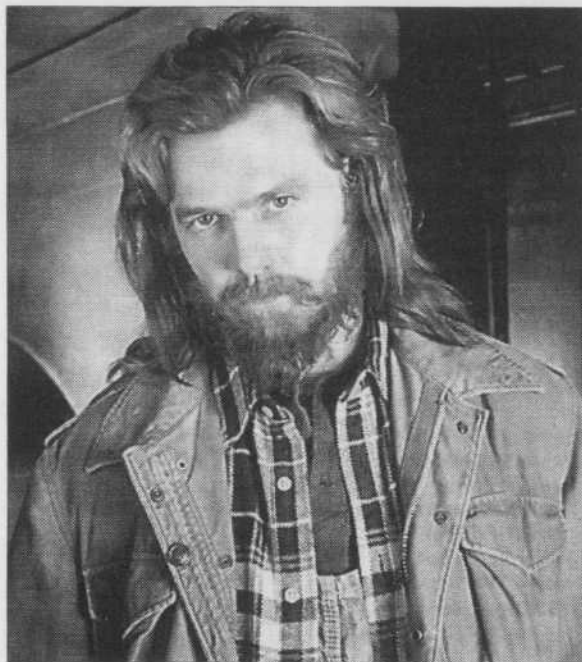

Swingin' With Ellington

It's OK if you aren't familiar with Duke Ellington's great jazz music before seeing the latest *Great Performances* episode, *Swingin' With Duke: Lincoln Center Jazz Orchestra With Wynton Marsalis*. Even famed trumpeter Marsalis, the program's host, admits he wasn't "turned on to Duke" until he'd reached the advanced age of 20 or 21. "The first thing that struck me about Duke Ellington's music was the sophistication of it," Marsalis says. "It was something that I didn't really know existed in American music (outside of) classical music." Commemorating the centennial of Ellington's birth, the 90-minute program, produced in the new HDTV format, airs Wednesday, May 12, on PBS. Fortunately for viewers, Marsalis is as lively a personality and as good a musician as his subject. Marsalis and the Lincoln Center Jazz Orchestra, which specializes in Ellington's music, are joined by Dianne Reeves, a blues singer following in the footsteps of the great Ella Fitzgerald. Fitzgerald is heard as well, in vintage recordings of Ellington compositions. Ellington, who died at age 75 in 1974, is seen and heard in footage from 1929 through the 1960s. And throughout is the best of his music: "Don't Get Around Much Anymore," "New Orleans Suite," "Take the A Train," "Mood Indigo" and more.

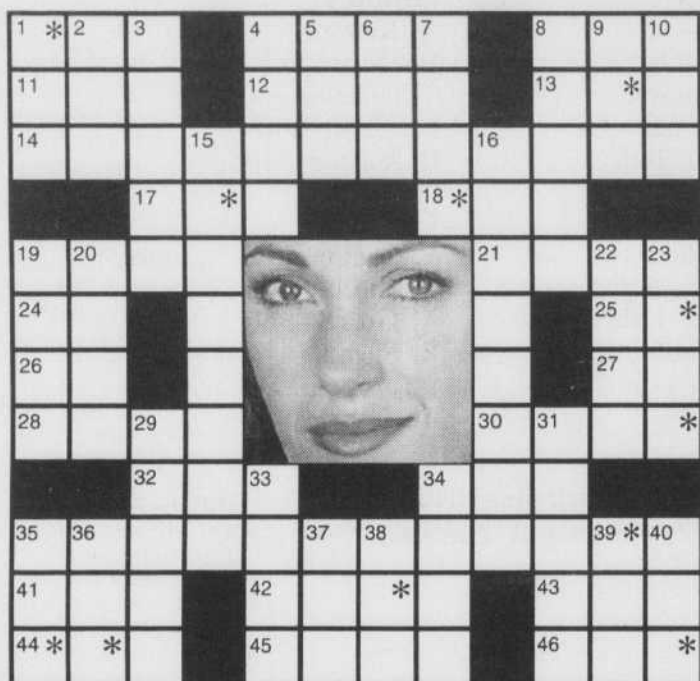

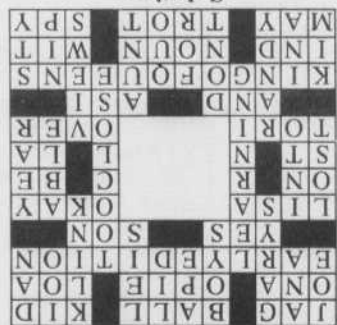
