Notes

The widths of the streets as
measured & stated in this
Plan are upon the authority
of the Road Surveyor &
the Dimensions of the Ground
agreed with those stated on a
Plan on record in the Road
Surveyor's Office, except the
line on W. Gill Street, which
I found to be $\frac{1}{2}$ foot longer
and the line of division from
the College property which I
found to be $257\frac{1}{2}$ feet instead
of 260 leaving a deficiency
of $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet. the width of Foundling
Street however I found to
have an excess of $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet
and it is therefore probable
that the true line of division
from Foundling St. should ter-
minate at a point $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet from
the corner of the College Wall
as indicated by the line dotted
thus
