The Toronto Telegram has been interviewing the Inspector of Steamboats with reference to the seaworthiness of the lake steamers generally and the "Armenia" in particular. If the Inspector is correct, it is as dangerous to attempt to cross one of the lakes as it is to attempt to cross the Grand Trunk or Canadian Pacific railways in the streets of Montreal. Here is his statement: "The 'Armenia' is just as safe as the 'Rupert' or any other of the larger boats which ply on the lakes. It is not a matter of degree that she was never built for passenger traffic, and should not be used for such a purpose. It is not the same kind of boats on the lake which are somewhat top heavy, and when caught in a storm leak over, yet have sufficient breadth of beam to right again when skillfully handled. The captain of the 'Armenia' is a Frenchman, then you find them useless. I speak from experience and do not exaggerate when I say there is not one steamer on the lake which has the proper kind of crew.

People who travel by lake steamers will not derive much comfort from the assurance that the "Armenia" is as safe as the other large boats, seeing that she has such tremendous drawbacks. There is not much satisfaction in having a choice of top-heavy boats, manned by landmen, to travel by. According to the Inspector these boats, safe enough in their direction, are only safe through a storm by a chapter of accidents. There is a fearful responsibility on somebody's shoulders for permitting such boats to carry passengers.

A MYSTERIOUS DISAPPEARANCE.

Last, stolen or strayed—a meteor. It was last seen about 8:35 o'clock last evening. Where it fell is a question still disputed. A gentleman residing in the southwestern suburbs of St. Lambert saw it "burst" over the river above the Victoria Bridge. Other people saw it fall in a garden on St. Antoine street, in the Shamrock Lacrosse Ground, at Cote St. Antoine and elsewhere. But all that we have heard from at present saw it in the same direction, and they hear from some one who saw the beautiful phenomenon while looking eastward we will not attempt to locate it very nearly. The apparent position of a meteor like its apparent size, its apparent speed and the apparent distance it travels in a luminous way, must be the particular elements of the meteor seen last night seemed to be travelling at a pace which could be beaten by a City Passenger Railway car, but its actual speed was probably nearer thirty miles a second. It may have travelled many miles in the few seconds during which it commanded the attention of the good people of Montreal. Whence it came, we are certain as when it went. Whether a fragment of a flighty comet or of a sober, well behaved planet like Mother Earth we cannot tell, for even the doctors of astronomy differ, but we believe Sir John Herschel's theory is generally accepted with regard to the origin of meteors, and the appearance and disappearance of meteors. Intense heat is supposed to be generated by the friction of the meteor with the earth's atmosphere, through which it travels at from eighteen to thirty miles a second; incandescence follows and the meteor becomes a particularly brilliant fireball striking the earth, passes beyond the limits of the earth's atmosphere, or until Kilkenny Cat fashion, there is nothing left of it but its tail, which falls invisible to the ground in the form of dust. The following telegram probably refers to the same meteor that was seen here for a time at Montreal, and at Casnovia, and considerable allowance must be made for over-estimation as to the duration of the phenomenon:—

CAZNOVIA, N.Y., July 3.—A magnificent meteor passed from almost directly overhead, in a horizontal at 8:25, leaving a trail visible for 10 minutes. Before disappearing, the trail became sinuous. The light was much greater than the meteor.

The question seems to be, not so much, how near did it come to Lambert or Cote St. Antoine, but, how near did it come to the earth.

NEW LOANS.

The caulkings of the Government organs over Sir Leonard Tilley's new loan is unduly and unwisely prolonged. They seem to regard a new Canadian loan with the same proud satisfaction that Mr. Milowber regarded a new U. S. loan with the same pride in his signature. We can fancy myself reader of the Mail waking up long enough to exclaim to himself, "Well, but after all floating a loan is very much like getting into debt." Canadians should not allow themselves to be deluded by the catching, into the idea that they are getting rich by the accumulation of the debts. Few Canadians realize the full import of the extravagance of their masters because the burden of taxation is disguised. It is not the less heavy, but it looks less like taxation than does direct taxation. To give a man a lively interest in the economical administration of the country's finances there is nothing like the periodical visit of the tax-gatherer demanding one's contribution to the national treasury, towards the cost of railway subsidies, etc. in dollars and cents. When a man is buying sugar he does not stop to consider what proportion of the purchase he is making for the Canadian Pacific Railway and what proportion to the interest on the public debt. But the worst form of indirect taxation in Canada is the present taxation of the future. Not only the natural resources of the country, a magnificent property, but the fruits of the future labor of the people are heavily mortgaged to the present generation, and the Province of Quebec, where among the principal sources of "revenue" are loans, Crown lands and the Dominion subsidy. Revenue is derived from other sources but unfortunately in nearly all
