

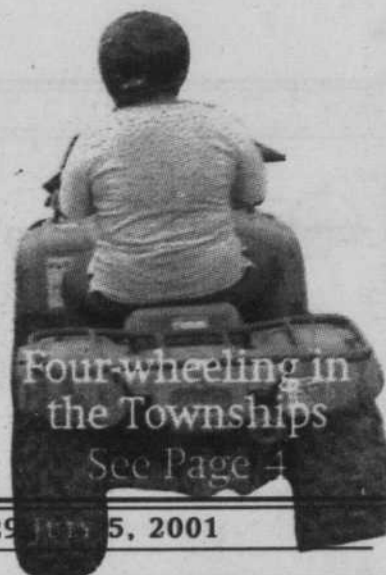

Paying tribute to Hank Williams

Ralph Steiner is having the time of his life. He is about to open in the Maynard Collins play 'Hank Williams, The Show He Never Gave' in the starring role. This will be his professional debut, but he's also performing in his hometown, and as if that isn't enough, he has also been rehired as the theatre's set carpenter.

Steiner is a busy, but very happy, man. "I would have to say this is one of the high points of my life," Steiner enthused about his role in Theatre Lac Brome's second production of the season.

"It is very much an honour to be included with this summer's brilliant actors and directors. I really appreci-

ate the opportunity Nicholas (Pynes, TLB's artistic director) gave me."

Playing the legendary Williams was not easy, however, as it pushed Steiner into unknown territory.

"Until I was asked to do this play, I knew very little about Hank Williams," Steiner admitted.

"I had heard the name of course, but I don't think I could have told you if he was dead or alive.

This has been a growing experience for me. I think Williams really knew how to capture the feeling of a song with his voice; sometimes he used a warble, or it might be a yodel, but he really got the song across that way. He was a remarkable man."

Williams was only 29-years-old when he died on New Year's Day, 1953 in the back of his Cadillac on way to a concert in Canton, Ohio.

"I think I am in better shape at 38-years-old than he was at 29," Steiner said.

"I've seen pictures of him during his last years, and he looked at least 10 years older. He looked really . . . ravaged."

By that time not only was Williams in bad shape physically from abuse of alcohol and painkillers, but his popularity had waned significantly as well.

"Towards the end, Hank had taken on this 'Lonesome Luke the Drifter' persona on stage," Steiner said.

"I think this added to his downfall. He was talking through a lot of the songs, not really singing them. He also had started preaching a lot — talking about the effects of divorce on kids and the effects of alcohol. I think the record buying public and the concert audience just deserted him over this preachiness."

Had he survived that night, would Williams have made it out alive? Could he have reactivated his career and made it to the Grand Ol' Opry?

"I personally don't think so," Steiner said sadly. "I think he was destined to die, one way or another. If he hadn't died that night he would have run his car into a tree or something not long after."

Steiner is enjoying himself so much with his role in 'Hank Williams' that he is seriously considering going into theatre as a professional.

"I would like to make a go of it," he said. "Enough people have told me to go for it, and now I think I'm beginning to believe it."

Going bananas for strawberries

It's time to go bananas about strawberries.

This craziness over our favourite berry breaks out every June. This year's bout, like the warm weather, has started early. Evidence: even dieters are eating strawberry shortcake, non-cooks are planning to make strawberry jam, and chefs are inserting strawberries into everything from appetizers to salads.

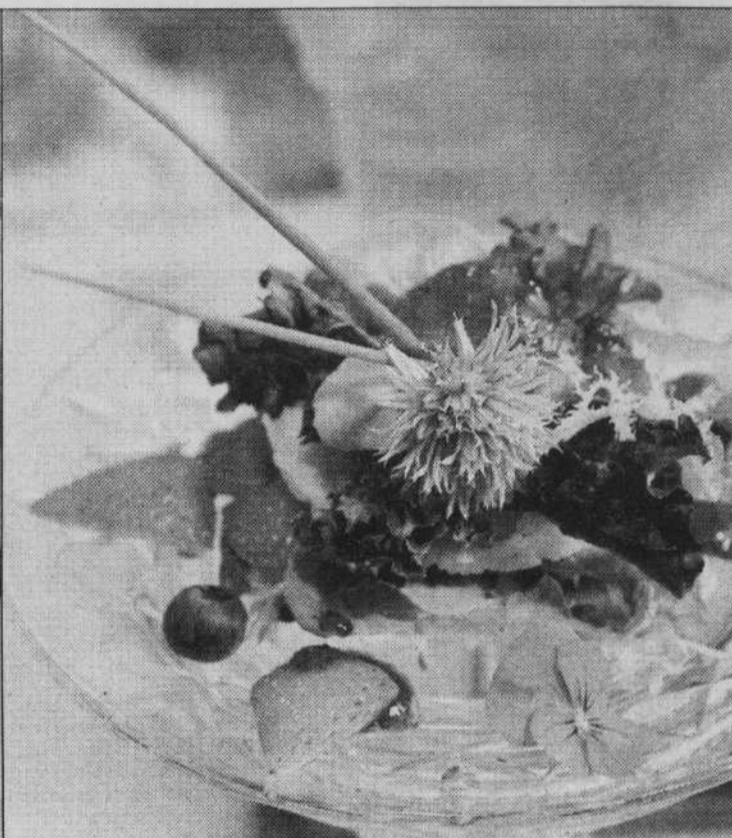
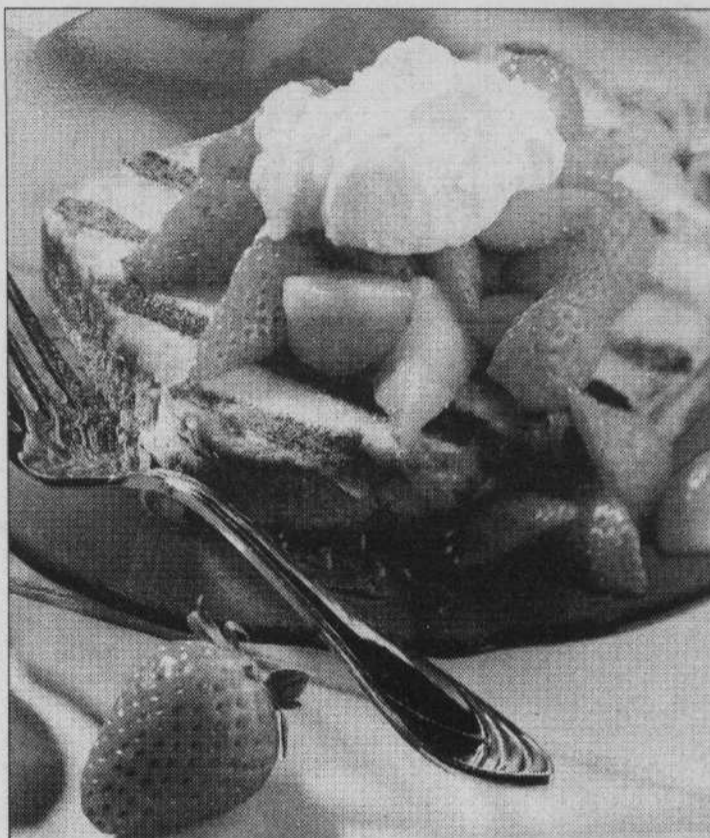
The new summer cookbooks are in accord with this year's strawberry party. A weekend-entertaining book combines these juicy, sweet morsels of pleasure with different cakes. A television cooking-show book tosses a salad of radicchio, endive and strawberries. A preserving book makes small batches of jam that even a beginner could handle. And a Montreal chef's grilling book suggests serving strawberries with fish.

That's right, fish.

Chef Thierry Daraize, the talented French-born author of *Sur Le Gril* (Trecarre, 128 pages, \$24.95), has published a tempting collection of grilled recipes, the one for dore (walleye) accented with strawberries, radishes and red peppers tucked among baby spinach leaves.

Daraize, a local television and radio chef who honed his craft with the likes of France's Michel Guerard and Daniel Boulud, also promotes other fruit-and-fish combos, one being salmon steaks with pink grapefruit and avocado slices, another, shrimps with apples, peaches and papayas.

Prize-winning Toronto cookbook author Jane Rodmell is part of the strawberry love-in, as today's mouthwatering photographs in her new *More Summer Weekends Cookbook* (Cottage Life Books/Firefly, 192 pages, \$27.95 paper-

back) prove. Better still, her desserts may be made in convenient stages.

Maritime innkeepers Ross and Willa Mavis also take the easy way to a fine strawberry dessert in their appealing little book *Outdoor Cooking from Tide's Table* (Goose Lane Editions, 256 pages, \$19.95 paperback). At their inn outside Saint John, N.B., they grill slices of pound cake, top with strawberry ice cream, then drizzle with jam, toasted almonds and fresh berries.

Salads need a dash of colour and

strawberries are a natural for the job. *Dish It Out*, by Christine Cushing, a cookbook based on the Life network cooking show of that name (Prentice Hall, 191 pages, \$26.95 paperback), zaps up the berries and greens with a balsamic vinegar-flavoured dressing.

Another strawberry salad idea is from *Picnic*, menus for 29 of these easygoing events, by DeeDee Stovel (Storey Books/Thomas Allen, 183 pages, \$15.95 paperback). The U.S. caterer and cooking teacher suggests tossing leaf lettuce with extra-virgin olive oil and then with a little balsamic vinegar and freshly ground pepper. Tote salad to the picnic, then toss with strawberries and a small red sliced onion, some toasted chopped pecans and crumbled blue cheese.

Proud of his four-ingredient strawberry surprise is Chris Knight, creator-writer of *The Great Canadian Food Show* TV series (his book of the same name is published by Macmillan, 150 pages, \$24.99 paperback). He boils a bottle of red wine, reducing it by half, adds 4 tablespoons (65 mL) freshly cracked black pepper, then dissolves a cup (250 mL) of sugar in this marinade for strawberries. Strain it through a coffee filter-lined sieve, add 3 pints (6 cups/1.5 L) berries and let soak for an hour. Serve fruit with whipped cream.

Lurking in the pages of *The Vegetarian 5-Ingredient Gourmet*, a new book by

U.S. writer Nava Atlas (*Broadway/Random House*, 262 pages, \$23.95 paperback), I found my corner-cutting method of serving strawberries: combine a pint (2 cups/500 mL) sliced berries with sugar (from 2 teaspoons/10 mL up) and let stand 30 minutes till their juice makes a syrup. Serve over cake, ice cream, etc.

Brunch is a natural for strawberry creations, says Florida cookbook author Laura York in her book *Simple Strawberry Sensations!* (self-published by Simple Sensations Marketing, LLC, 533 S. Howard Ave., Suite 855, Tampa, Fla. 33606, phone: 813-832-4482, \$16.90 U.S. money order, postage included).

French-toast slices of bread spread with a mixture of cream cheese, powdered sugar, vanilla extract and cinnamon and dipped in eggs and milk, she suggests, then serve with her maple strawberry syrup. Pancakes, waffles, scones or muffins take equally well to this syrup.

Following, you will find some of these recipes and others to enjoy for the next few months as growers supply us with good berries through September.

Grilled Walleye with vegetable and red fruit salad

The salad must be cold, and the fish should be hot, says chef Thierry Daraize in his new book *Sur Le Gril*. Strawberries, carrots, radishes and red peppers are the red foods.

(Serves 4)

1/2 cup (125 mL) carrots
1 stalk celery
4 large radishes
3 large handfuls of tender young spinach
1 medium cucumber
1 red pepper
1 green onion
1/2 pint (1 cup/250 mL) strawberries
1/4 cup (50 mL) cherries, stoned (opt.)
1/4 cup (50 mL) grapeseed or olive oil
1 tablespoon (15 mL) raspberry vinegar

Juice of 1 lemon
Salt and freshly ground pepper
4 fillets of dore

- Cut all the vegetables in fine julienne strips or slices. Leave fruit whole or cut in half. Toss together gently and keep cool. Make the salad dressing with the oil, vinegar, lemon juice, salt and pepper. Chill for one hour. Grill the fish over medium heat, one minute a side. Toss salad with dressing and serve aside fish.

Talking all that jazz

Bassist Charlie Biddle brings his magic back to Townships

The love affair between Charlie Biddle and the Eastern Townships will once again be cherished when the jazz great celebrates his 75th birthday with a performance at the Haskell Opera House on July 29, 7:30 p.m.

Born and raised in Philadelphia, Biddle soon realized that total musical freedom for black performers could only be found north of the border.

After serving in the U.S. army, Biddle took advantage of the G.I. bill to study music at Temple University in his hometown. In 1948, at the age of 22, and looking for somewhere that accepted him and his music, Biddle moved to Quebec.

With his own band, he traveled across the province, introducing jazz to many small communities that had never heard it before. Biddle and a variety of other jazz artists brought music confined until then to the black clubs of the southern U.S. to towns like Sherbrooke, Magog, Knowlton and Asbestos.

In fact, it was while staying in a hotel in Asbestos that Biddle met his wife Constance.

"Back in the 1940s and '50s, Quebec was the Mecca for black entertainers," Biddle told the Record, citing at least five jazz clubs in the Sherbrooke area alone.

Biddle, who now lives in Montreal, added that the Eastern Townships and its people will always hold a special place in his heart.

"It was my main hangout," said the bassist noting that small town audiences in the Eastern Townships never saw him as a black man but as an entertainer.

"Jazz was always bigger in Montreal, but it was more accepted in the small towns because people weren't into that bullshit," said Biddle. "They didn't see color, they thought jazz musicians were joyous and entertaining."

When Expo '67 came to Montreal, the Biddles immediately saw a chance to put local jazz talent on the world stage.

Constance convinced organizers to give Biddle the use of the Youth Pavilion to produce jazz concerts. It was there that artists such as John Coltrane and Thad Jones were introduced to a worldwide audience for the very first time. Biddle knew then he was setting a new path for jazz outside his home country.

"I think I was one of the first guys to bring jazz from the States and really put it on the map," said the man who finally received his Canadian citizenship last fall.

"It was put on a level for everybody to see."

In 1979, sensing that jazz music in Quebec had been ignored by radio stations long enough, Biddle organized the Jazz de Chez Nous festival to showcase local talent.

"I saw the decline in the music I lived for," he said.

"In Montreal, nobody was playing it anymore."

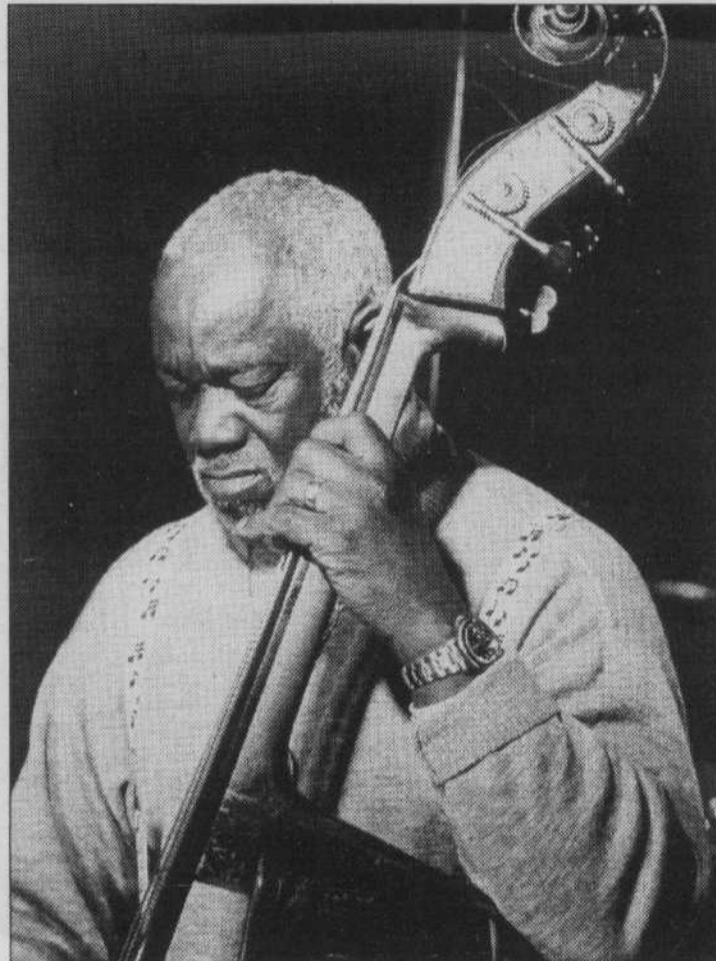
Many criticized Biddle's project because they believed jazz was foreign to Quebec's culture.

However, with CBC radio broadcasting the three-day event, jazz came to the forefront of the music scene in Montreal with great results. Yet, due to financial problems, Jazz de Chez Nous was a one-time event.

The following year, many of the individuals who worked with Biddle on Jazz de Chez Nous helped organize the first Montreal International Jazz festival.

Despite the progress it has made in Quebec, especially in small towns such as Asbestos and Shawinigan. Biddle believes radio stations can do more to promote jazz and its artists.

"It's time for people to start controlling what they listen to and who they want to hear," Biddle said, who is very passionate about the lack of airplay jazz gets on al-

most all major radio stations in Quebec.

People should demand the music they love, or risk being subjected to the same songs over and over again on every station, he added.

By the end of the 1970s, Biddle and some friends had opened Biddle's Jazz and Ribs in downtown Montreal as a place to showcase international jazz talent. Biddle played weekly, and is credited with reviving the careers of such greats as Oliver

Jones, Oscar Peterson and Raneé Lee.

Although he has been an innovator in getting people to appreciate jazz, his love for the music goes well beyond attendance figures or television ratings.

"I'd go to work even if there was only one person there," said Biddle. "That's how much respect I have for the music I play. One in the audience is just as important as 100 to me."

While he also admits he played an important role in getting jazz the exposure that has helped it become very popular with people of all ages in Quebec, Biddle acknowledged that it has been a team effort from the very beginning.

"I played a major role by playing all these years and by not letting anything stop me," Biddle said.

"It also helped that I was married to the right person and had a family who was willing to put up with me."

When asked why jazz has come such a long way in a little over a half-century, Biddle reveals something that hundreds of thousands of visitors to Montreal's festival have discovered over the years.

"Jazz reaches more people today because it swings. It's like Duke Ellington said, 'it don't mean a thing if it ain't got that swing'."





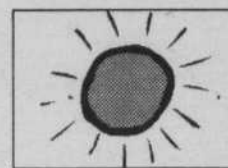

Four wheelin' fun at Quebec-USA quad weekend

*Mud, sweat, beers
and thank God for
mashed potatoes*

Rolling Thunder! That's what it sounded like when hundreds of four wheelers tore through the countryside on a 160-km trip from Coaticook to Beecher Falls, Vermont during the Quebec-USA quad trip this past weekend.

Buried in the mud, ATVs seem relatively friendly, but when a line of about 50 of them roar wide open down a dirt road with a plume of dust behind them 20 feet high, it looks and sounds like something out of the apocalypse.

The scene around the Candlelight restaurant in Beecher Falls, where almost 900 quad enthusiasts stopped for lunch on Saturday was equally bizarre. Mud-spattered quads were parked on every inch of public lawn and sidewalk, and lined up six deep at the town's two gas pumps. Quadsters strutted around the one-horse town like an invasion force.

But war hadn't brought these battle-weary dust-covered soldiers out of the woods and into the light of day. Fun had. And fun was certainly in abundance during the fifth edition of one of the biggest annual quad events in the province.

Ask yourself, what could be more fun than tearing a noisy, muddy swath through the forest with 900 other crazy machine heads on St-Jean Baptiste weekend.

My guides for the day were the Eastern Townships regional director for the Federation of Quebec Quad Clubs, Yvan Perron, and his wife Suzie. They lent me a Suzuki Quad Runner 500, and we hit the trails around 9:30 a.m. Saturday.

Once I got the hang of the clutchless shifting I could concentrate on keeping up with Suzie, who was just ahead of me and flying along on her Kawasaki 650.

Before we left Coaticook, Suzie assured me she doesn't usually drive her own machine, but this time the grandmother of eight was intent on doing some serious trail shredding. She tore out of Coaticook in the direction of the trails, and I tried to keep her in sight through the clouds of dust. Once we hit the rougher terrain, Suzie bounced fearlessly over rocks and stumps, through mud and creeks as I fought to keep up.

Some grandmother...

At one point, we hit a quad-jam (sort of like a log jam except with quads) and

had to wait almost an hour before we could continue.

Suzie said Yvan would tackle the hill which was causing people so much trouble first. If he thought it was too dangerous for the two of us, he would ride our machines up afterwards.

Suzie tore up the rock-strewn mud slide like a grandmother possessed, so I wasn't about to hang back. I stuck my machine in four wheel drive and skipped up the steep slope with white knuckles. Out of the corner of my eye, I watched one poor fellow dragging his machine to the side of the hill to make way for the traffic.

"It's because the smaller machines, don't have as much power," Suzie explained later. "All four wheels aren't working to get you over the rough bits."

Once we got over the hill, we still had a long way to go. We blasted through some more muddy trails in the direction of the border, and after what seemed like an eternity of bone-jarring ridiculousness, and full-throttle insanity, we arrived at the border.

The border guard asked for our 'permees de condjoor silboulait,' and then waved us through. It was 3:30 p.m. be-

fore we sat down for lunch at the Candlelight. I told Suzie I had never been more dirty or hungry in my whole life. She smiled, and told me today's ride was the longest they had ever had as part of the annual event.

We sat down to help ourselves to some of the mashed potatoes, ham and roast beef from the buffet. Later, over the biggest slice of chocolate cake ever seen south of the border, Suzie flashed a big grin and said, "Now, for the first time all day, we are well." I couldn't have agreed more.

But we still had to get home.

After lunch, it rained hard. Dustwise, this was good news.

After gassing up, we tore home at full speed. Yvan and Suzie were now together on a Bombardier Quest, and Yvan wasn't wasting any time waiting for novice stragglers such as myself.

As we tore along through the rolling countryside around St-Venant-de-Hereford and St-Herménégilde, I couldn't help thinking it might have been nice if I could have heard something - perhaps the chirping of little birds? - over the psychotic roar of the beast beneath me, or have seen something of the cowering

wildlife. But quadding is not about bird watching. Quadding is not about smelling the flowers, or communing with nature. Quadding is about roaring engines, mud-spitting tires and nature reduced to a blurry peripheral vision, or a quivering piece of shrubbery torn off and hanging from your back rack.

I had had my fill by Saturday evening. So I thanked the Perrons for their hospitality and headed home to wash the dirt out of my ears.

About 450 people had registered for the encore performance, Sunday's ride to Sawyerville. Suzie later informed me that Sunday's ride was "excellent."

"It rained in the morning, so there wasn't as much dust," she said. "Everyone loved it."

Without a doubt, the fifth edition of the Quebec-USA quad weekend was a success. If a sixth edition is looking like less like a reality (see today's sports section), it's not because of a decline in four wheeling's popularity. This crazy pastime has a lot of fans. The residents of those small, quiet towns between Coaticook and Beecher Falls are likely already having nightmares about next year's "invasion of the four wheelers."

More than 60 Township artists, from sculptors to painters and photographers to craftsmen, will fill the Frederick Amsden House art gallery as it hosts the 3rd Annual Eastern Townships Art Competition.

Among the many artisans featured at the exhibition, which runs from June 29-Sept. 2, many recognizable artists like Gordon Ladd, Virginia Cope and George Foster will have works on hand for judging.

"I challenge anyone to find a better show in the area", said Matthew Farfan, co-owner of the Frederick Amsden Art Gallery.

"We are proud to be able to say that we were the first to display the works of Debbie Everett, Liliane Mertens, Estelle Sabourin, Gustov Verderber and Kara Springer, just to mention a few."

Due to that Stanstead is located on the Canada-U.S. border, organizers feel comfortable that the gallery will be able to reach a larger audience on both sides of the border.

"I feel this is the best exhibit that we have done," said Josiane Caillet, co-owner of the gallery.

"The exhibits range from folk art to photography. I wish we could have a prize for each category. It is very difficult to narrow down the applications."

Applications for the competition are submitted and selected according to originality, quality and variety. Prizes are awarded by a panel of judges, who include Sylvia Bertolini, Richard Dubé, Normand Gladu, Matthew Farfan and Josiane Caillet.

The exhibition will also conduct a popular vote of the exhibits, selected by everyone who attends. The winner of the vote

will be honoured at an awards ceremony at the gallery, scheduled for Aug. 10, 7 p.m.

Yet, organizers above all emphasize the priceless originality and personal touch of the exhibits on hand, whatever the medium it is presented in.

"I decided to do something to honour John Steinbeck," said Raymonde Vanasse-Martin, one of the show's featured artists.

"He has always been a favourite of mine. He loved the land and saw the beauty of even its smallest detail.

I chose to use a variety of techniques to express these feelings. I feel it appeals to the intellectual as well as the innovative minds.

"I take it as a compliment when someone expresses their views about my creations even though it was not necessarily what I had in mind when I did it."

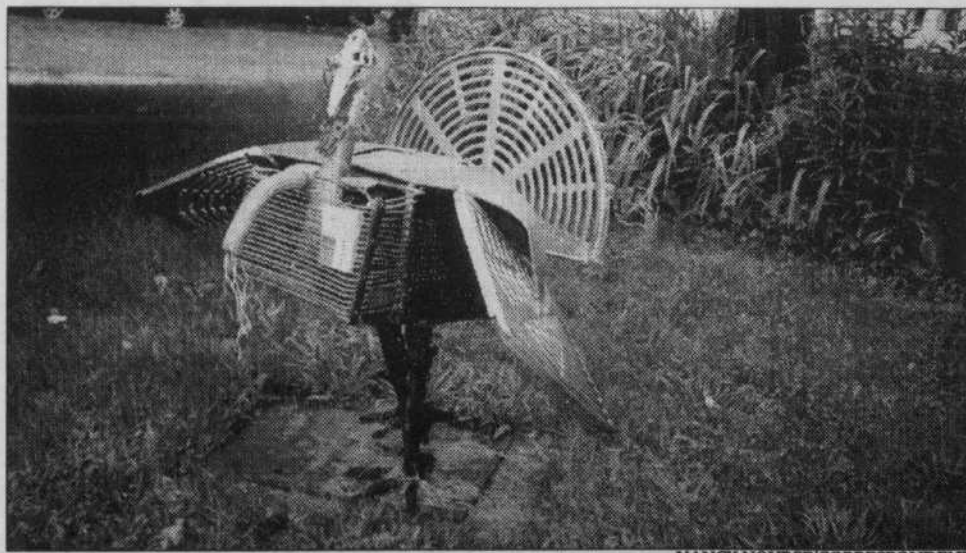
Fellow artist Denis Palmer of Sawyerville takes a different approach to his work, opting to attend auctions and sketch the activities around him. Much of his work develops out of memories, experiences and his relationships with people he has met throughout his life.

"I like to talk about my work because it is based on people and places that have a very special meaning to me," he said.

"In my painting entitled 'Myrtle's Kitchen', I tried to recreate the warm, cozy feeling one has when they sit in my friend's kitchen. It is a place where you can chat with friends and forget about your worries."

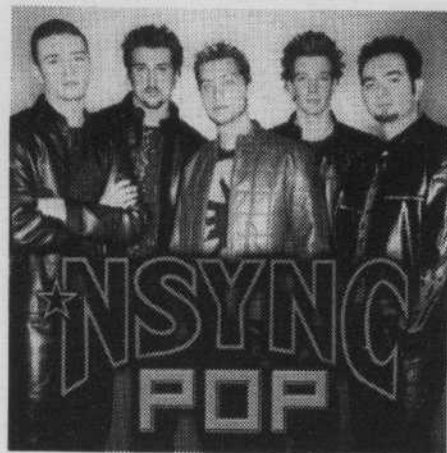

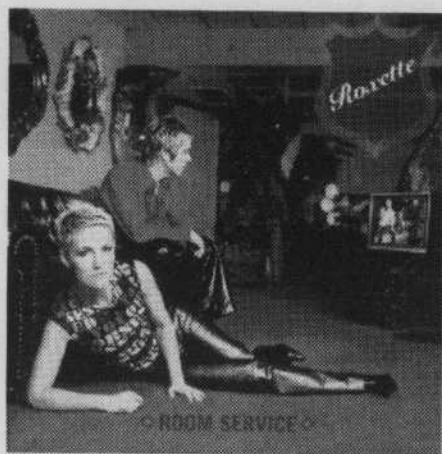

This, their 10th album, will surely please fans of the group that became popular in the late '80s early '90s, with such mega-hits as 'The Look', 'Dangerous' and 'Dressed for Success'. The '80s influence is still present in the band's latest album, but the tracks remain a modern and solid assortment of pure Roxette hits, making *Room Service* an enjoyable outdoor summer album. 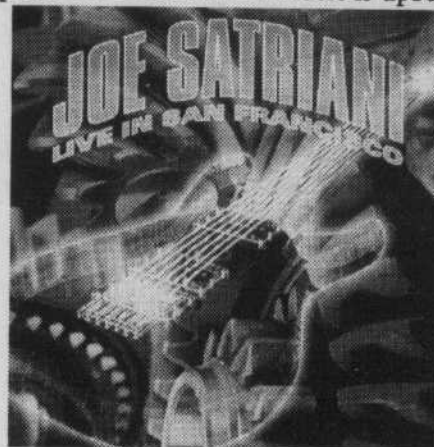

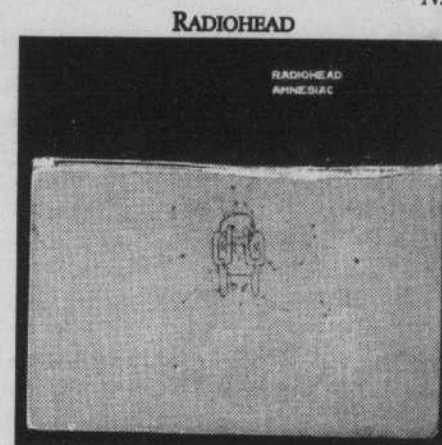

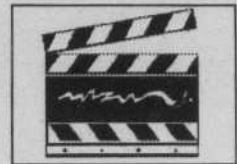

Rumours of Brando's bad behaviour untrue

Jamie Lee Curtis raves about husband's 'mockumentary' movies'

So what about those stories that Marlon Brando was cavorting about in the nude during the shooting of *The Score* in Montreal?

If you can believe director Frank Oz, the rumours are totally untrue.

"No wonder Marlon won't talk to the press," Oz told Southam News on the weekend.

Last summer, a Montreal newspaper reported that the 76-year-old Oscar winner was carrying his penchant for eccentric behaviour to extremes during the shooting of the heist thriller. Sources from the set told the local newspaper that Brando and costar Robert De Niro had clashed over Brando's demand that he have his lines fed to him by hearing aid and that he was demanding that De Niro direct his scenes instead of Oz. Even more fascinating was the allegation that Brando showed up one day naked from the waist down, the idea being that Oz would be forced to concentrate on his head and shoulders and conceal his massive girth.

The reports sparked a denial from unit publicist Peter Silberman that Brando was nude or that De Niro had directed his scenes.

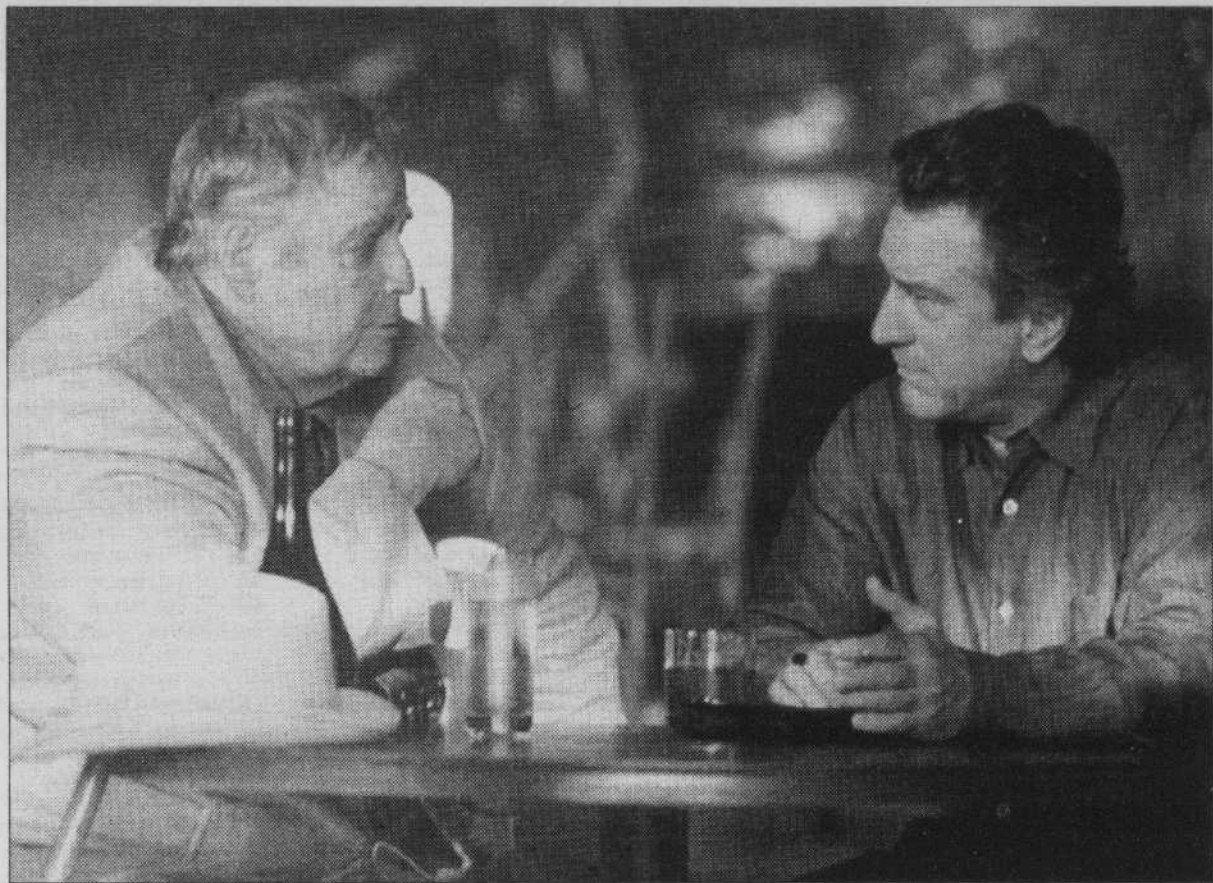
Unfortunately for Brando, the story wouldn't go away. Two weeks later Liz Smith, one of the most widely read gossip columnists in North America, was repeating it for millions of readers around the world. Then the popular entertainment Web site, Mr. Showbiz, did its spin on the story — "Nude Brando Terrorizes Set" was the headline — and its version continues to be available to anyone on the Internet.

So what does Oz say? "I'm so glad you asked me because I want to clarify," says the director who started his show biz career doing the voice of Miss Piggy on *The Muppets*. He does admit that all was not sweetness and light during the shooting of the movie which casts Brando as an aging crook who enlists ace jewel thief Robert De Niro to break into the Montreal Customs House and make off with a priceless artifact. Oz seems to suggest that in Brando he was dealing with a Jekyll-Hyde personality. "This was a sweet, gracious, complex man — and we had our difficulties and it did-

n't go easy." But Oz also says the nudity bit is a bum rap and that although Brando did strip down, it was only to his underpants.

The alleged nudity happened the day they were shooting a scene in a nightclub. "It was Montreal. It was very hot. It was very humid. We were in the jazz club. There was no air conditioning, and Marlon was about to do a scene, and we were setting up the lighting. Anyone who knows theatre or movies knows that showgirls dress and undress in front of men and men dress and undress in front of women. It's movies. It's the theatre. It's just a matter of getting the job done."

All Brando was trying to do was cool off a bit while waiting to shoot his take. He was amusing himself by playing the piano, but he had taken off his trousers. Oz suggests this would be normal behaviour for a man used to living in torrid climates and keeping as cool as possible. "He's lived in Tahiti for God's sake! Marlon was just playing the piano. He had his underpants on. He had his shirt on. The costume lady was with him, waiting for the take to start. He was playing the piano, and when we said, 'We're ready to shoot the take, Marlon,' he put his pants on, and we shot the scene. That's all there was to it."

When *The Score* opens on July 13, moviegoers will see several distance shots of a full-length Brando in all his massive splendor. And yes, he's definitely wearing clothing.

Jamie Lee Curtis is a great fan of husband Christopher Guest's "mockumentary" movies. She laughed herself silly watching last year's *Best In Show*, which deals with dog owners and their behaviour at dog competitions, and Guest's 1997 amateur theatre spoof, *Waiting For Guffman*. But there's no way that she'll ever act in one of them, and the reason is that Guest needs actors like Eugene Levy and Fred Willard who can improvise, a skill at which Curtis is absolutely hopeless.

"I don't improvise," she says. "I wouldn't be able to improvise one word. It looks so easy, but it is really hard to do, and the people who do it are absolutely at the top of the field." She regards those people with total awe.

The role was originally written for Dustin Hoffman, but he dropped out. Then it was reworked for John Malkovich who initially accepted it and then decided to pass after there were delays in completing another movie. So now Jeremy Irons is taking on the part of a gentleman thief in French director Claude Lelouch's new thriller, *And Now Ladies And Gentlemen*. Filming began last month in Paris.

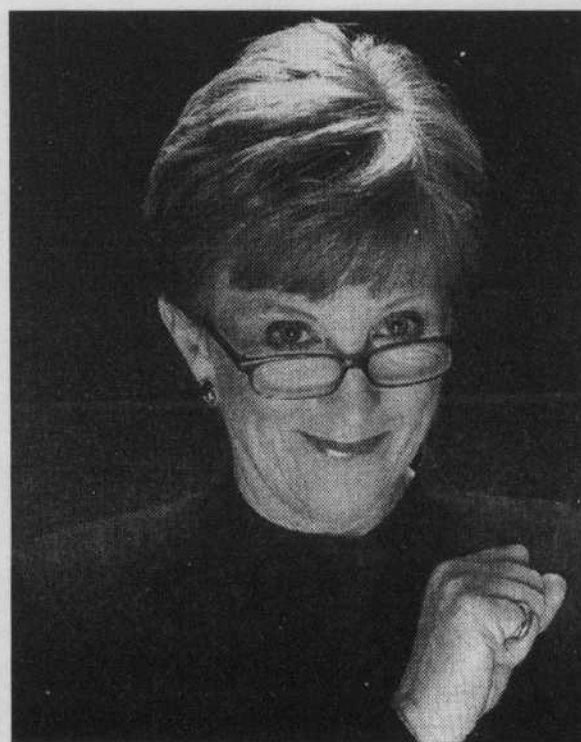

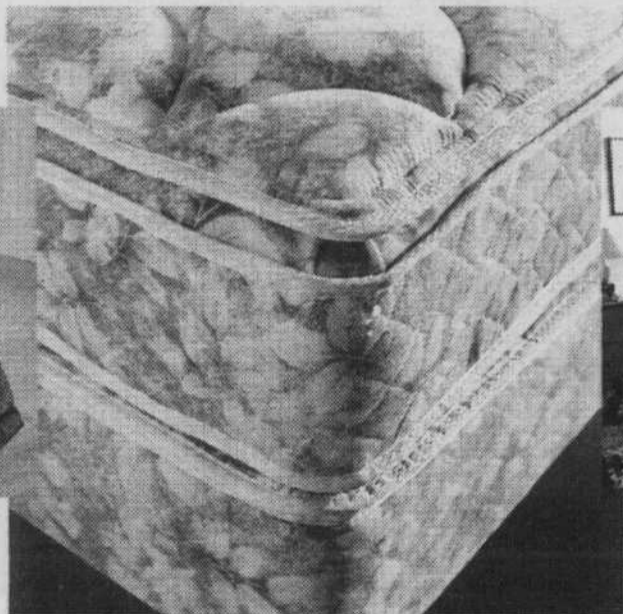
