remain attached to Canada."

When this was reported, the government was embarrassed and hustled to withdraw the documents. But, courting those votes during the referendum campaign, M. Parizeau insisted more than once that anglophones and allophones not only have a place in a sovereign Quebec, but, "You are us".

However, once it became clear that his referendum was lost, M. Parizeau told his followers their hopes and dreams had been defeated by money and the ethnic vote. He added, "Never forget that three-fifths of who we are voted Yes."

Let's try that again. "You are us." "Three-fifths of who we are voted Yes and were defeated by anglos and ethnics."

Next day, instead of apologizing for his gaffe and excusing it on the grounds of exhaustion and disappointment, he made

things worse by muttering darkly that it was not very healthy when a certain part of the population of a democracy voted 95 per cent one way. He may have been referring to the Montagnais (99 per cent against sovereignty) or the Inuit (95 per cent against) or the Cree (96.3 per cent opposed). The only thing for certain is that he did not mean any of the 52 Quebec ridings that have a population 95 per cent francophone.

I think broadcaster Jean

Lapierre, a founding member of the Bloc Québécois while MP for Shefford, summed it up best when he said Parizeau "lacked the class" to set things straight. And so he had to go.

I shall miss him. So will most cartoonists and columnists but all is not lost. Deputy Premier Bernard Landry stoutly declared that if Bouchard accepts the position of premier of Quebec, "I will be delightful at that acceptance!"

We may make something of Landry.

Musica Nova honors trio of 20th-century composers

SHERBROOKE — The music of three of the most original pioneers of 20th-century music will be celebrated in the second subscription concert of Sherbrooke's award-winning New Music ensemble Musica Nova.

Anton von Webern and Bela Bartok (both of whom died 50 years ago in 1945) and Paul Hindemith (born in 1895) each made groundbreaking contri-

butions to the development of the music of this century.

Musica Nova pays its tribute to all three in a concert on Friday, November 17, at 8 p.m. in Lennoxville's Bandeen Hall.

Hindemith and Webern will be represented in performances by Musica Nova's two sopranos, Eleanor Gang and Michèle Gagné.

Gang will perform excerpts from Hindemith's moving "Marienleben, Op. 27". Gagné will

offer an early song cycle by Webern in which the composer's rarified lyricism finds eloquent expression.

The astringent romanticism of Webern will also be heard in Brigitte Poulin's performance of that composer's miniaturized "Piano Variations, Op. 27".

The intimate works of Webern and Hindemith in the first half of the program will give way to the spectacular in a performance of Bartok's mesmerizing "Sonata for two Pianos and Percussion", with pianists Poulin and Michel Fournier, and percussionists Julie and René Bécharde.

All the performers on the November 17 concert have been heard frequently in the region with Musica Nova and other professional organizations.

Gang and Gagné have both

been soloists with the Orchestre de chambre de l'Estrie, as well as with the Ensemble vocal Amadeus and the Choeur symphonique de Sherbrooke. Both are professors of voice at Bishop's University.

In addition to active solo careers, Poulin and Fournier teach piano respectively at Bishop's and Sherbrooke Universities.

The father/daughter team of René and Julie Bécharde are well-known in the region as two-thirds of the all-Bécharde percussion section of the Sherbrooke Symphony Orchestra.

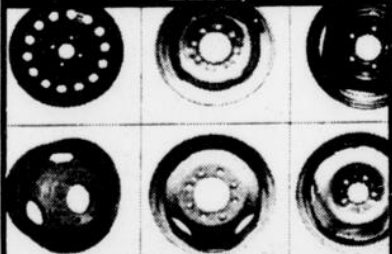

Gill to release hits album to cash in at X-mas

There's good news and bad news for Vince Gill fans.

The velvety-voiced singer has decided to delay the release of a new studio album until early next year in order to release a 12-track greatest hits package titled *Souvenirs In Time For Christmas*.

The album, which includes "I Will Always Love You" with Dolly Parton, "I Can't Tell You Why" from The Eagles tribute, and "The Heart Won't Lie" with Reba McEntire, is being released by MCA Records on November 21, just in time to be used as Christmas stocking stuffers.

Two new albums are out this week and both of them are worth listening to, here's why:

Keith Whitley: *Wherever You Are Tonight* (BMG)

Keith Whitley died in 1989 but, like many other artists, he left unfinished material, and they found some interesting items going through his tapes.

This album was co-produced by Steve Lindsey and Lorrie Morgan, who was married to Whitley. Under their supervision, and along with chief engineer Benny Quinn, they isolated Whitley's vocal performances from the digital masters. Then arranger Ron Oates crafted entirely new music around each vocal track.

The result is an entirely new Keith Whitley album, to the pleasure of his fans and of lovers of traditional country music.

During his short career,

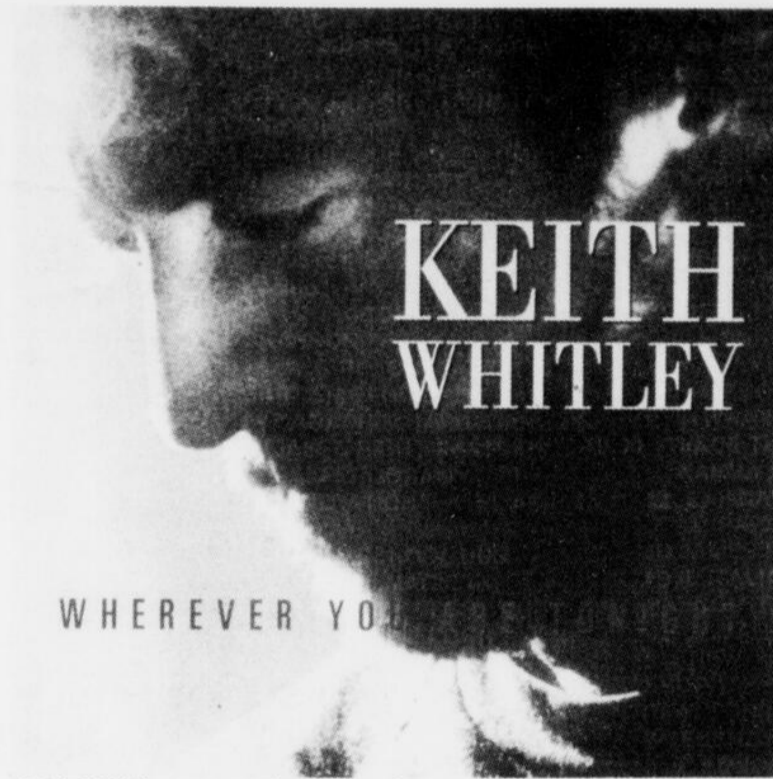
Whitley established that he wrote from his heart and mainly took his inspiration from his own life experiences.

He was also known for his outstanding vocals and the capacity to pass any given emotion in anything he would sing.

This album is a reflection of his life experiences and the fact that he's passed away gives it an added emotional dimension.

The title track is the heartwarming story of a late-night radio disc jockey and a regular caller to his request line: "She brought love to this lonely place, though I never even saw her face... this song goes out to you, wherever you are tonight."

There is also the sensitive ballad to love lost, "Losin' You All Over Again", the autobiographical "Light At The End Of The Tunnel", the lighthearted "Just How Bad Do You Wanna

Feel Good" and "Buck", a tribute to country legend Buck Owens.

It is an album that every country music lover should own since it is one that you can listen to over and over again and never get bored.

Aaron Tippin: *Tool Box* (RCA/BMG)

This one is Tippin's fifth album on RCA and most likely the big one, according to his own predictions. I think he's right. None of his albums ever displayed his incredible versatility and vocal power as much.

Bowles and Tom Shapiro's "Real Nice Problem To Have", in which one guy wishes he didn't have to call home to explain where he is, and the other wishes he had someone home waiting for him to call.

Tippin, who got married this summer, said the combination of a grueling tour schedule with building a new house and starting a new business got in the way of serious songwriting.

With all his talent along with his ability at picking the songs he wanted to put on this new album, he shouldn't have to worry. The first single, "That's As Close As I'll Get To Loving You", is already a favorite on country music radio.

Amadeus Ensemble evokes legend of Saint Cecilia

Singers pay homage to patron of song

SHERBROOKE — Poets have sung her praises in literature, painters have captured her spirit in colorful art, sculptors have honored her with impressive statues and musicians have celebrated her in moving scores.

Now an Eastern Townships choir pay their respects to Saint Cecilia, the patroness of music and musicians.

On Saturday, November 18, the Ensemble Vocal Amadeus de l'Estrie plays a concert composed entirely of words and music written for Cecilia, a Roman Christian martyr who died in 233 AD. Appropriately, the show, titled "Laetare Caecilia" (Latin for "Rejoice Cecilia") takes place at Saint-Jean-de-Baptiste Church in Sherbrooke.

There is a rich tradition that exists of music written by European and British composers in honor of Saint Cecilia, and the pieces selected by choirmaster André Martel span the currents of time but do feature one thing in common — a reverence for the woman martyred for refusing to honor Roman gods.

Two odes to Saint Cecilia will be performed by the 30 chorists and four-member band at their first concert of the season. The first was written by British composer Henry Purcell (1659-95), who wrote many works for the perennial celebrations on Saint Cecilia's feast day, November 22. The piece to be performed by Amadeus was composed for a text Nicholas Brady wrote in 1692.

HANDEL, TOO

The second ode, by George Frideric Handel (1685-1759), was composed to a text by English poet John Dryden (1631-1700). Handel's "Alexander Feast" (1736) is also on the program.

Proving that reverence for Saint Cecilia cuts across national boundaries, the Mass of St. Cecilia by French composer Charles François Gounod (1818-93), an excerpt from the Mass of St. Cecilia by Italian composer Alessandro Scarlatti (1659-1725) and Awake My Lyre (1624) by Englishman John Blow will also be featured.

Rounding out the program are a motet by Italian composer Luca Marenzo, and a traditional Gregorian chant to Saint Cecilia.

Chorist Dominique Daigneault said the music is wonderful, but the texts can be a bit thin.

"The main theme is harmony," said Daigneault. "Cecilia was putting everything in harmony. She was with an angel and she was praying and the angel came down from the sky

and Cecilia started to sing and make some music for harmony."

"Harmony is always coming back," added Daigneault with a laugh.

Although this music praising universal harmony written for Saint Cecilia is less-known to francophones in Quebec, Daigneault said not to worry.

"It's very easy to listen to. It's nice. People will enjoy the music," said the St-Elie-de-Brompton piano teacher.

As a performer, Daigneault said she loved singing these spiritual oeuvres.

"The main thing that is fun is that many pieces are split for two groups, so all the phrases are going over each other. It's really something to sing this. It's kind of a big instrument with many voices."

POPULAR ABROAD

German-born chorist Jutta Riegel is quite familiar with these works.

"It's very popular in all German-speaking countries. In Europe, everybody would know about Saint Cecilia. Here, it's not as well-known. We're introducing it."

Though the choir is committed to introducing its patrons to an eclectic lineup of works, Riegel said mounting these shows is not easy.

"The government has cut all our subsidies. We used to get three to five thousand dollars from the provincial government. Now, we receive zero from," she said, shaking her head.

"Most of the classical groups were left out and particularly choral groups, and it's a shame. Culture is important to keep," she said. "Right now, it's very difficult for us to exist."

FUNDRAISER

The choir's major fundraiser for the year takes place on Friday, November 10, at the Estrie-mont hotel in Magog.

Riegel said next Saturday's concert will cost about \$6,000 to put on.

The choir will be joined by five soloists on November 18 who will be familiar to regular patrons of the group.

Soprano Dominique Cimon of Ottawa, tenor Hugues St-Gélais and bass Mario Tremblay of Quebec City, alto Noella Huet of Montreal, and Christine Bernard will add their res-

pective voices to the evening, along with a quartet of musicians from Montreal, Quebec City and Sherbrooke.

Apart from the words and music written for Saint Cecilia, there have been many other artists who have created paintings and sculptures in her name. These include Florentine painter Bernado Daddi (1290-1348), Italian baroque painter Domenichino (1581-1641), who created the frescoes of Cecilia's life for a church in Italy, and Italian sculptor Stefano Maderno (1576-1636).

But although there are innumerable works in the art world dedicated to Saint Cecilia, there are only skeleton reports about her life — and even those are contradictory.

Cecilia was martyred for refusing to honor Roman gods, that is agreed upon. But one story states she was beheaded after attempts to suffocate her failed while another says she escaped unharmed after being thrown into a boiling bath, survived an executioner's attempt to behead her, and died three days later.

Virtually nothing else is

known of her life. Legend has it she spoke to God in her heart, and artists represent her playing the organ, but whether she had any musical talent whatsoever is unknown.

But that didn't stop the founding of the National Academy of Saint Cecilia in Rome in 1566, the oldest music academy in the world.

Cecilia went to her final resting place in 821 AD, when her remains were interred in a crypt in the church that bears her name in Trastevere, Rome.

After its ode to Cecilia, the Amadeus choir will once again present a sing-a-long Christmas concert on December 17 at Plymouth-Trinity Church in Sherbrooke with proceeds going to the Moisson food bank.

The Ensemble Vocal Amadeus de l'Estrie performs its concert to Saint Cecilia on Saturday, November 18, at 8 p.m. at Saint-Jean-de-Baptiste Church in Sherbrooke. three to eight musicians.

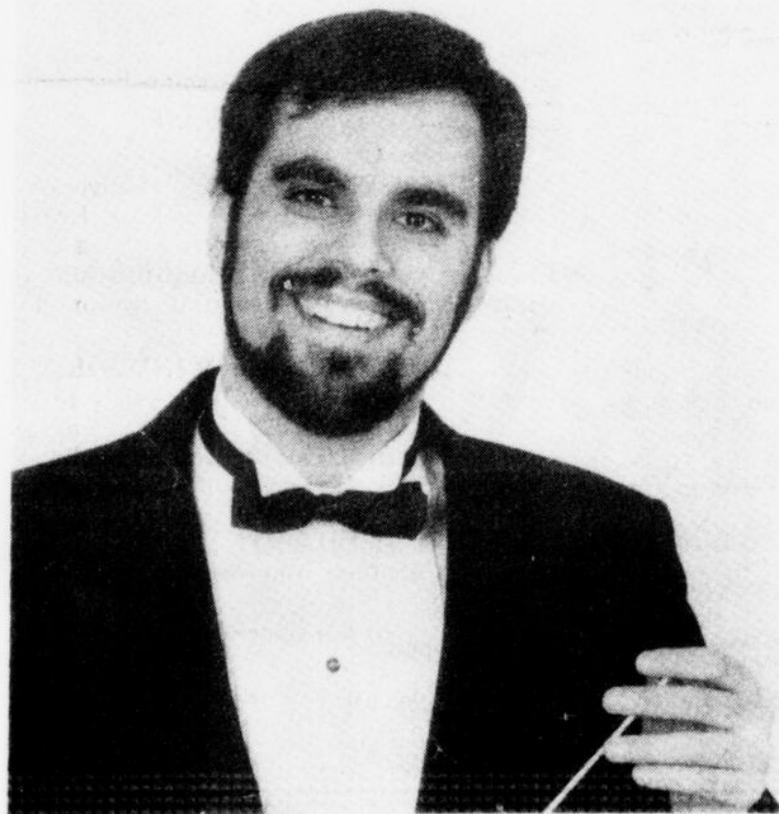

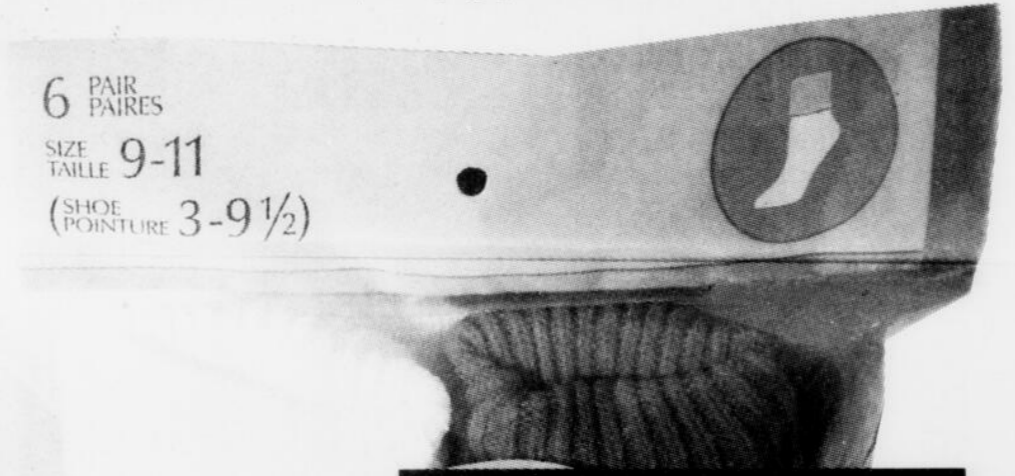

Estas, president of the Plattsburg club. Everyone present is looking forward to next year's get-together and maybe it will expand because of the friendly laid-back atmosphere.

The Christmas Island known to most people is located in the Indian Ocean some 230 miles south of Java. It is governed by Australia, has a population of about 3000 people and an area of 135 square miles. Christmas Island issues far more stamps than the population can possibly use.

There's another Christmas Island that is far less known with fewer people within a smaller area. This particular Christmas Island is located on Little Bras d'Or Lake on Cape Breton Island in Nova Scotia. It does not issue its own stamps. So what is this remote place noted for?

Each year around this time the postmaster begins receiving large amounts of mail to be sent from this point in order that letters will be cancelled using the Christmas Island cancellation.

Last January, I said I would remind you of this unique service. You can give your philatelic friend a unique present by sending cards to this post office to be cancelled and forwarded

from there. Address your cards as you normally would and affix the appropriate postage. Bundle them up and address the bundle to the Postmaster, Christmas Island Post Office, Cape Breton Island, Nova Scotia. I don't have the postal code but you can get that through your local post office.

Last year's cancellation was a beautiful wreath incorporated with a klussendorf machine cancellation if I'm not mistaken. If you are a collector and like nice cancellations, send one to yourself. Say what you like but the majority of postal employees are extremely accommodating.

The Christmas stamps are out and while I haven't gotten

around to buying any as yet, comments will be saved for a later date. Have you managed to buy the United Nations commemorative issue yet? Well, it is a nice issue. In fact, I would suggest you buy a souvenir sheet of 10. The heading makes the stamps appear that much more attractive.

Speaking of Christmas stamps, San Marino issued a lovely set-tenant set of three depicting from left to right, Santa Clause coming down a hill towards a brightly lit Christmas tree with children around it and a nativity scene close by. Over the manger is a star that radiates over the other two stamps with two

angels holding a banner that reads, 'Gloria in Excelsis'.

In upcoming articles, a few facets of philately such as tagging and papers will be either reviewed or updated. I think you will find the history of the tagging of stamps particularly interesting.

Remember the CSDA show taking place in Montreal the weekend of November 24-26. It's the opportunity to find the elusive material missing in your albums and to see what's new in albums and supplies.

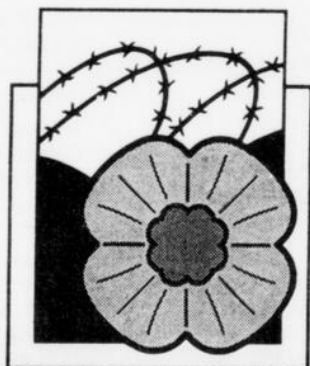
