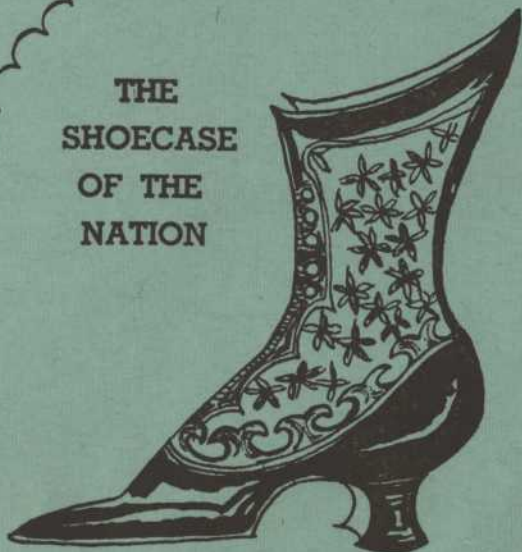

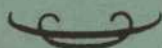

The Mountain Playhouse is this season celebrating its tenth anniversary, which makes it Canada's oldest operating Summer Theatre.

Founded in 1950 by Joy Thomson, it has been under the management of Norma Springford since 1952. Mrs. Springford, a former resident of New Brunswick, has been living in Montreal for the past seventeen years and it is under her inspired direction that the Playhouse has become Canada's leading Summer Theatre.

Mrs. Springford is a governor of the Dominion Drama Festival, chairman of the Western Quebec Regional Drama Festival, a member of the Sir George Williams College faculty as drama director, a member of the Canadian Guild of Drama Adjudicators and director of the McGill Players Club.

The Mountain Playhouse is the only English speaking Summer Theatre in the Province of Quebec and, located as it is atop Mount Royal in the heart of Montreal, has always been popular with tourists as well as with lovers of theatre in the City who find it an oasis on a hot Summer night.
