AT a General Monthly Session of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ely, held in the said Township on Monday, Fifth day of the month of March, in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty, according to the provisions of "Lower Canada Municipal and Road Act, 1855," and its Amendments—at which Meeting are present Flavien R. Blanchard, Esq., Mayor; Wilder Bartlett, Narcisse Bissonet, Augustin Dubreuil, and William Hackwell, all Members of said Council, and forming a quorum thereof—the said F. R. Blanchard presiding as Mayor,—the said Council doth hereby pass and ordain the following By-Laws, to wit:—

By-Law No. 13.

A By-Law to provide for the Assessment of a Sum of £630 12s. to help the Repairing and Opening of Roads, and also the Repairing of Bridges in the Municipality of Ely.

Whereas it is expedient and necessary to help the repairing and opening of Roads, and also the repairing of Bridges in the Municipality of the Township of Ely,

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Ely, and it is hereby enacted by said authority, in conformity with the provisions of "Lower Canada Municipal and Road Act, 1855," as is provided for by the Fiftieth paragraph of said Act, that a sum of Six Hundred and Thirty Pounds Twelve Shillings current money of this Province shall be and is by these presents assessed and shall be collected on all the Rateable Property in the Municipality of the Township of Ely, to be rated equally on all said Rateable Property in said Municipality, as set in the Valuation Roll now in force in this Township of Ely; and that the said sums so assessed (forming three pence per pound currency) shall be due and payable to the Secretary-Treasurer of this Municipality in money, currency of this Province, on or before the FIFTEENTH day of the month of MAY next, by the Proprietors or Occupiers of each respective Property.

By-Law No. 14.

That provides for the Assessment of a Sum of £105 2s., to defray the Expenses to be and those already incurred by the Council in the year 1860.

Whereas it is necessary to provide for the expenses to be and those already incurred by the Municipal Council of Ely during the year 1860,

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Ely, and it is hereby enacted by said authority, that, according to the Fifteenth paragraph, section Seventh, of "Lower Canada Municipal and Road Act, 1855," that a sum of One Hundred and Five Pounds Two Shillings currency of this Province is hereby assessed and shall be levied of all the Rateable Property in the Municipality of the Township of Ely, the said sum forming one halfpenny in the pound currency, to be rated equally on all the Rateable Property in the said Municipality, as set in the Valuation Roll now in force in the said Township; that the said sums so assessed and rated shall be due and payable to the Secretary-Treasurer of this Municipality in current money of this Province, on or before the FIFTEENTH day of MAY next, by the Owners or Occupiers of each respective Property.
