A private telegram from Ottawa today says that Mr. Pelletier has been sworn in a member of the Privy Council and raised to the Senate. The dispatch does not say what portfolio Senator Pelletier will fill.

It is stated today that Mr. Justice Dorion leaves Quebec to replace the late Judge Mondelet, Mr. Justice Caron of Gaspe filling the vacancy in this district. The Honorable Mr. Laframboise, M.P.P., it is said will likely be named Judge of the Superior Court for the district of Gaspe.

The mode in which His Excellency the Governor General has referred to the success of British rule in promoting loyalty throughout the British colonial empire is well calculated to encourage the belief that still larger additions may be expected to the principle of confederation. During the last century an attempt was made called the Fox's India bill, to limit the Princes of India to the post of imperial legislators, and it would not be very surprising if something of the kind, in a form more acceptable to the people of England, were again attempted. The long-pondered change of the Queen's title, the visit of the Prince of Wales to India; the manifest expediency of cultivating the good will of the potentates and magnates of that sunny land which now acknowledges Victoria as its Empress, and the limitations placed on the use of the title of Excellency—all point to the probability of the approach of a day in which the policy of Fox will be revived in a form suitable to modern requirements, and in which the spirit of confederation will be extended to the Oriental regions over which British holds her envied Eastern rule.

AMERICAN NEWS.

Concord, N. H., Jan. 25. It is stated that several Savings Banks in the State have been doing general banking business without paying the Government tax. The estimated amount of taxes due is \$100,000. They have been notified to desist.

New York, Jan. 25. The House of Representatives on report of the Senate of Louisiana's investigating committee will present two reports. The majority will recommend sufficient to affect the general result, and approve of the action of the returning board in nominating as the electoral vote, but not its action illegal on the return of State officers and Legislators. The minority report will show that such intimidation as did exist was more than offset by the fair and irregularity of the returning board.

The same paper says Vice-President Ferry had an interview with the President yesterday on the subject of the Electoral Bill. Mr. Ferry gave the President a full interpretation of the measure, holding that the Senate could not act on the bill until the returning board was organized in the manner provided for in the bill. The President expressed confidence in the result. It was his intention to act promptly on the bill when it reached him. The Tribune's Washington special says the Democratic National Committee are making the necessary arrangements to secure a caucus to represent them before the Congress.

The Herald's special reports the pardon of General McDonald, the whiskeying conspirator, and anticipates the pardon of Joyce, also of whiskey ring notoriety.

The same paper reports that a stay of execution has been granted by the Governor of Utah for participation in the Mountain Meadow massacre. The case has been appealed to the Supreme Court.

A woman named Smith was thrown from a sleigh by a cow on the N. J. & Erie road, and had her neck broken. Gerritt C. Vankirk, of Monmouth county, N. J., died in this city, shot himself fatally yesterday. The cause was unrequited love.

Gold 4 1/2 cotton firm at 13 1/2-16. The Ottawa, from England, has arrived. Columbus, O., Jan. 25. In reference to the passage of the bill for counting the electoral vote, the President said to his friends: "I want it distinctly understood that I don't desire to influence the action of Congress one way or another in the matter of the Electoral Bill or any other matter relating to the presidential election. The whole thing is in the hands of Congress. I shall be content with its action."

Middletown, N. Y., Jan. 25. The liabilities of Jacob Hermance, of Ellenville, are reported \$300,000, assets, nothing. Hermance is accused of fraudulently obtaining endorsements to the amount of \$575,000. He has not been seen since his flight.

Watertown, N. Y., Jan. 25. Some weeks ago Mr. Couch, living near Sackett's Harbor, deserted his wife and child. Ten days ago Mrs. Couch gave birth to a child, which she brought to death in the stove yesterday. She is insane.

Washington, Jan. 25. The President has nominated Thomas Settle, of North Carolina, to be District Judge of Florida.
