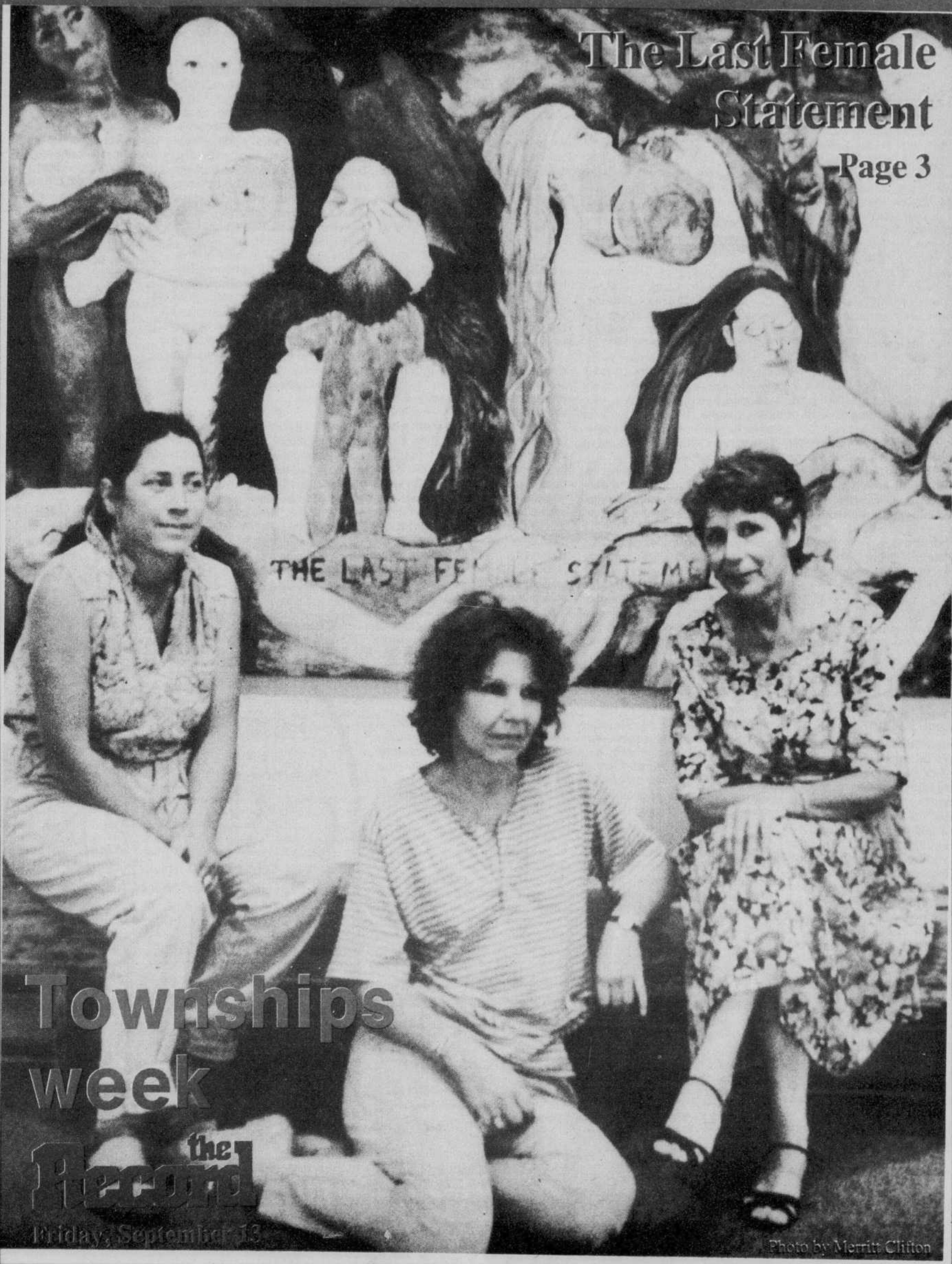

philatelic business. Britstamps specializes in stamps of Great Britain and Channel Islands. Dave puts out a price list which costs a dollar. This is refundable with your first order.

Canada's first ever Wildlife Habitat Conservation stamp was launched recently by environment minister Suzanne Blais-Grenier.

The four dollar stamp which features a "Mallard Pair Early Winter", is taken from a painting by Canadian Artist Robert Bateman. One point two million copies of the stamp were printed and, are on sale at all philatelic counters of Canada Post Corporation. You may also purchase copies through the mail by writing to the National Philatelic Centre, Antigonish, N.S., B2G 2R8.

Migratory game bird hunters will be required to have the stamp affixed to their hunting permits. These permits, along

with the stamp, are available as a package at any post office for the price of, I believe, \$7.00.

The stamp is being sold to raise funds which will be turned over to Wildlife Habitat Canada, whose objective is to preserve and protect wildlife habitat, in particular, the wetlands. The environment minister will be turning over 1.3 million dollars as an advance payment on revenues from stamp sales.

Keep in mind that there is absolutely no philatelic content in this stamp. It is being written up in this column because it is a good cause. The United States has been issuing this type of stamp for quite some time. There are people who include these stamps in their collections. They are colorful and make for nice topic subjects.

If you are going to be in Toronto the weekend of September 13, 14 and 15, don't miss Stamp-Ex Canada, being held at the Sheraton Centre. This is a very worthwhile show. Much has been done for young people this year. So, if you have nothing better to do, why not

zip up to T.O. and enjoy.

Canada Post Corporation recently released two stamps. The first to commemorate Louis Herbert, the first apothecary in Canada. The second is to commemorate the 1985 Inter-parliamentary Union. The conference took place September 2nd, 3rd and 4th. Both are available at your local post office or through the philatelic services of Canada Post.

The Irish Post Office announces the release of two series of stamps as follows, Industrial innovation, 22p featuring a visual display unit and a 26p stamp depicting a pictorial contrast between the modern turf cutting machinery and the traditional hand tool, the Slean.

The second series comprises of one stamp only, a 44p stamp commemorating the 150th Anniversary of the founding of The Institution Of Engineers of Ireland.

Both series will be issued on October 3rd and are available by writing to; The Controller, Philatelic Bureau, G.P.O., Dublin 1, Ireland.

Granby plans 10-day food festival

GRANBY — Restaurant owners in the Granby area and lovers of fine food from as far away as Quebec City are looking forward to an annual gastronomical festival that promises to be bigger and better than ever.

The Granby Gastronomical Festival has become the Granby and Region Gastronomical Festival for this, its ninth year, including restaurants from Waterloo and Bromont in addition to those in Granby.

"Passports" to the festival are available in Caisse Populaires all over the Townships and in Montreal, with the menus of all 30 of the participating restaurants printed in detail, as well as notices of the special events going on from October 3 to 13.

During these ten days the restaurants are going all out to show people, especially from outside the region, why Granby was named Gastronomical Capital of the Townships by the Regional Tourism Association, said Jacques Charbonneau, president of the Association des Restaurateurs-Hôteliers de Granby et Région.

NOT JUST TITLE

"It gives us the chance to prove to tourists from outside the region that it's not just a title," he said.

In the past the festival has proven beneficial to restaurant owners in the area, he said. At his

pub, the Brasserie des Galeries de Granby, he has had clients say they came because friends had attended and enjoyed the festival in previous years. For the coming festival, two groups of about 30 from Quebec city have already made reservations at the Brasserie.

"This shows a certain interest from outside the region which would be impossible without the festival," said Charbonneau.

Unlike the Eastman festival, on now, the Granby festival does not involve each restaurant representing a different country. The menus are simply more elaborate and tempting than usual.

But there are a couple of special evenings planned, including a Bavarian Night at the Brasserie des Galeries de Granby starting at 6:00 October 9, and a Lancia Spaghetti Night starting at 5:00 October 13 at the Polyvalente J.H. Leclerc.

Also, on October 7, waiters and waitresses will have a chance at a \$500 scholarship and various other prizes by exhibiting their skill in a kilometre long obstacle course through the middle of town carrying a tray of liquid-filled glasses. The route hasn't been set yet, but it will end in the parking lot of the Galeries de Granby sometime after 6:00.

Last Female Statement features divergent styles

SUTTON — Colors running riot, un-self-conscious nudes, inspired semi-abstract composition, and exquisite drawing fill Arts Sutton through September 22.

It's all part of 'The Last Female Statement', a provocative exhibition advertised as 'Works In Progress.' The former title appears as banner on one of the focal pieces, a wall-sized oil painting by Bernice Sorge Geoffroy. The latter describes the experimental intent of both the show itself and many of the individual works in it.

"We want to create a studio atmosphere," explains Geoffroy. Thus many works are unframed. A few are unfinished. Others are not actually hung on the walls. Some are on easels. Many originated as classroom exercises, completed without looking at the paper, and/or within strictly limited time periods. The artists all work in various mediums, not always those of their preference. Since Geoffroy, Migneault, and Plomteux all share exceptional drawing ability, an experimental outlook, and great love of bright color, their works could be mistaken for those of a single creator - of an outlook and consciousness transcending any one of them as an individual artist.

UNIQUE INDIVIDUALS

Which is where 'The Last Female Statement' comes in. All four participants are unique individuals, who do have particular personal styles and sometimes diverging opinions. Yet they are working together in a mutually complimentary way within a gallery that has often proved too small for even two artists or one schizophrenic. If 'The Last Female Statement' could be put into words, it's probably something to the effect of 'welcome everyone.'

While Geoffroy, Migneault, and Plomteux clearly supply the creative energy here, Annett's presence is a puzzle until one weighs the message. Annett, both in person and in her pain-

ting, is as reticent as the others are dynamic and outgoing. Her portraits are all very neatly and carefully framed. Her style favors hard edges, clear definitions: regardless of her politics, she's an artistic arch-conservative, where the others are raving radicals. But she is here for a good reason after all. There is room among 'Works In Progress' for her work, too, helping to supply context and contrast for the others. Without conservatives, without living traditions, there could be no radicals either.

DESERVES HIGH PRAISE

Each of the 'radicals' deserves high praise for versatility, skill, and imagination. Geoffroy, of Dunham, has always been an experimental, often conceptual artist, to the extent that many local art viewers don't really appreciate her drawing skill. It appears here. She draws live human subjects as well as anyone living or dead, often in attitudes that only cameras usually capture - and then only on repeated tries. There's also a book's worth of philosophical thought behind each and every one of Geoffroy's works, no matter how quickly it may have been executed.

Plomteux, of Cowansville, has traditionally been much less inclined to experiment - at least in public. Her chief success has been at the highly disciplined medium of lost-wax batik. While colorful, flowing, filled with love of life and light, her batik works have also tended toward conservatism, with hard edges in the foreground and traditional, apolitical subject matter. As a painter, Plomteux has labored in the shadow of her much better known sister-in-law, Tabbia Tiziana Plomteux. Most of her paintings previous to those displayed here have suggested emulation of Tabbia - and like most imitative works, have been second-rate.

BREAKS LOOSE

This time around, Plomteux breaks loose. She still uses some of Tabbia's techniques, but her

painting style is now convincingly her own, as is her subject matter. Her political concerns surface, along with new confidence. In short, an all-new Myriam Plomteux exhibits here, more exciting than ever.

Noella Migneault, of Montreal,

isn't quite a stranger to Arts Sutton, but she isn't well-known here either. She may be much better known here after 'The Last Female Statement' or 'Works In Progress' closes. Her presence is ubiquitous, her contributions significant, in a variety of me-

diams. One suspects she might be the immediate catalyst to this whole exhibit, the first of these young feminist painters to truly choose her own direction, the one who inspired organizer Geoffroy to secure gallery space for them all together.

Mailer adds some wrinkles to murder mystery genre

Tough Guys Don't Dance by Norman Mailer (BALLANTINE-RANDOM HOUSE): \$4.95, 370 pp.

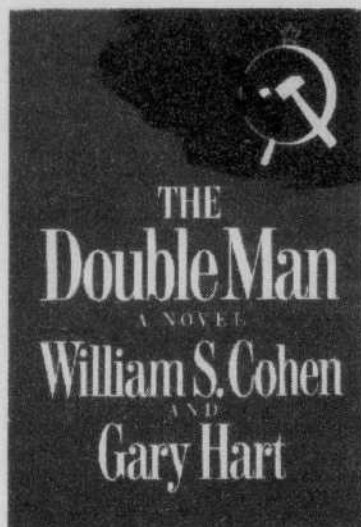
It has long been the expectation of the American critical community that Norman Mailer would one day write the classic novel that has been awaited since his literary debut with *The Naked and The Dead* in 1948. The Egyptian epic, *Ancient Evenings* was not it either, but it is surely one of the most perplexing, outrageous and remarkable murder mysteries written by anyone.

Mailer's hero is an ex-con, sometime writer living in the artists' colony of Provincetown, Massachusetts at the hook end of the Cape Cod sand spit. Recently separated from his wife, Tim Madden sits drowning his sorrows in a P-Town bar as the book opens.

As a narrator, Madden is mad-deningly discursive, indulging in long meandering philosophical musings on American life and morals, as he attempts to reconstruct a chance meeting with a couple from California for us. Infatuated with the blonde beauty, Jessica Pond, who reminds Madden of his exwife, he awakens the next morning with a gigantic han-

gover and a complete blank about the events of the previous night.

When he finds the front seat of his car smeared with blood, he is racked with an ominous dread that he may have killed the couple from the bar. The Provincetown Acting Police Chief gets into the act, and from then on *Tough Guys Don't Dance* becomes a puzzle mystery with serious literary pretensions.

Leave it to Mailer to seize upon a genre like the mystery novel, add a few wrinkles to it, and in a sense make it his own through the complexities of characterization that go into his portrait of Tim Madden.

Ex-con, writer, philosopher, pessimist, Madden is one of Mailer's most intriguing characters, and his attempt to nail down the culprit guilty of committing a number of gruesome killings makes him one of the detective genre's most unlikely, memorable members. *Tough Guys Don't Dance* may be a literary disappointment in the purest sense, but still, one of Norman Mailer's failures remains head and shoulders above much of the output of many American writers.

The Double Man by William S. Cohen and Gary Hart (MORROW-MACMILLAN): \$24.95, 348 pp.

If it appears strange that an unsuccessful candidate for the Democratic Party's leadership would be writing a best-selling spy novel, it is perhaps even more remarkable that Colorado Senator Gary Hart chose a Republican as his co-author. Hart and the Senator for Maine, William S. Cohen, call upon their considerable experience with such important portfolios as the Select Committee on Intelligence, in fashioning *The Double Man*, which has enough of the Washington routine of daily politics mixed in with treacherous terrorism strikes to catch the interest of readers of Ludlum or LeCarre.

The Double Man concerns an

investigation into the increasingly bold terrorism plaguing the West undertaken by Thomas Chandler, a Connecticut senator, and the startling disclosures that he is preparing to make. Chandler's probe discovers some complex links between increasing amounts of cocaine and heroin entering the United States, with links to the Soviet Union; the Mafia and anti-Castro forces who were embroiled in the Bay of Pigs operation; and the supposed retaliatory nature of John F. Kennedy's assassination by either Castro, KGB or even Mafia agents.

Such a plot, intertwining the current fixation on drugs and crime with America's obsession with the Kennedy mystery, means that Cohen & Hart strike some resonant chords for spychasers. *The Double Man* is an ambiguous title, in that several of the key players are engaged in activities as very deeply imbedded moles — one of these is E.W. Trevor, the head of the CIA, who is secretly undermining Chandler's investigation into terrorism by having managed to "turn" the senator's very own lady, Eileen Dunham.

The Double Man has a verisimilitude in its depiction of the daily life in Washington's senatorial chambers, and the committee skulduggery that usually doesn't make for compulsive reading of the Ludlum kind. Cohen & Hart don't get bogged down in the political tedium, and make Senator Chandler interesting enough that the reader sympathizes with his plight as the complex plot winds. As a committee of two, Cohen & Hart succeed in making *The Double Man* clearly one of the more interesting bits of writing to emerge from usually prosaic Washington.

RECORD REVIEWS

John Waite MASK OF SMILES (EMI-AMERICA)

Former lead singer and bassist for English band The Babys, John Waite scored a big hit in the summer of '84 with "Missing You", but failed to repeat a year later, as his second EMI-AMERICA album arrives at the close of 85's summer. Successor to NO BRAKES, which also spawned "Saturday Night" and "Restless Heart", is MASK OF SMILES, Waite's attempt to keep it rolling.

First single from the album is "Every Step Of The Way", which like the rest of the record has as a notable feature the fact that the singer's voice has really been highlighted on the mixes. Not that the No Brakes Band could be said to have toned down behind Waite's vocals; on the contrary, they are beginning to blend into a solid unit.

Joining in with the No Brakes



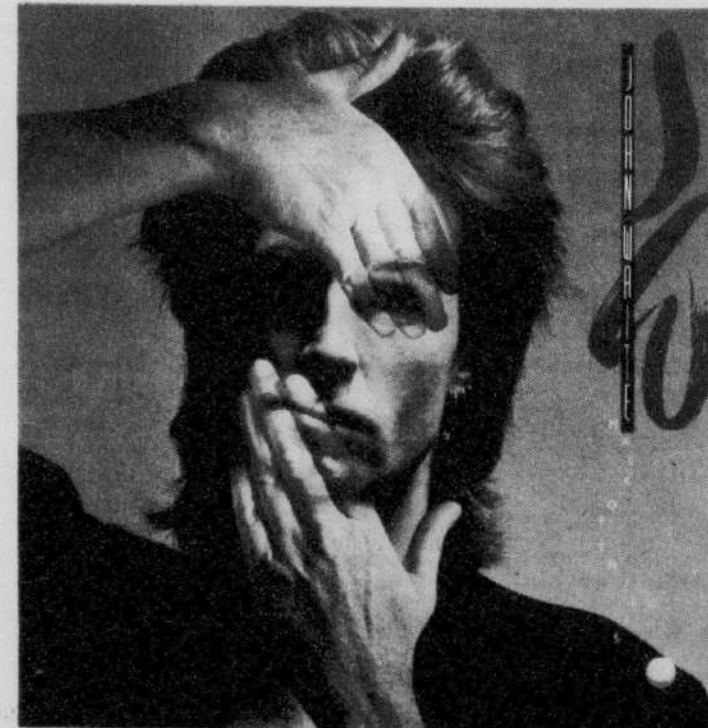
roster of John McCurry (lead guitars), Tommy Mandle (keyboards, synths), Frank Larocka (drums), and Joey Vasta (bass) are the Borneo Horns who backed David Bowie and his Serious Moonlight World Tour in 1983. The sound on MASK OF SMILES is not unlike that of a Bryan Adams, with Waite's quality of possessing a clearer, truer voice not hurting him in the comparison. The songs here do not, however, appear to be as powerful as the collection that gave rise to the emotionally poignant "Missing You".

The Statlers PARDNERS IN RHYME (MERCURY-POLYGRAM)

The pride of Staunton, Virginia, the Statlers have adjusted to a personnel change when tenor Lew DeWitt retired to be replaced by Jimmy Fortune in 1982, and on PARDNERS IN RHYME they seem to be aging like fine wine. Fortune's smooth tenor is almost feminine in its prettiness as the Statlers work through the Rick Nelson hit "Hello Mary

Lou", against the select pickers that are generally available to producer Jerry Kennedy. Trivia buffs can score a few sure points on Mary Lou when they ask who was the co-author of the song with Gene Pitney? The unforgettable Cayet Mangiaracina, of course!

Harold Reid, the resident clown with the Statlers, with a voice like a Frisco Bay foghorn, gets all of his bootheels into the lead on "Her Heart Or Mine", a song that's worth it just to hear Chip Young's picking on the bridge and fade-out. The revival standby "Amazing Grace" lets the Statlers show why their harmonies have clung together over the years — with a bottom end in their barbershop chording as solid as the Statlers have, anybody could mail in the lead and tenor parts, which just happen to also be held down by two of the sweetest voices in country music. Even more mellifluous than before, the Statlers have carved a niche of their own after working backup to John R. Cash for so many of their early years.

Van Ginhoven paper art is innovative, but confusing

SHERBROOKE — Anke Van Ginhoven's exhibition entitled *Fragments de Terre* (Earth Fragments) in the University of Sherbrooke art gallery begins with a very poetic message from the artist explaining her work.

And that's probably a good thing.

Otherwise, it would be difficult to get much out of what you are seeing.

Van Ginhoven's medium is paper. She doesn't draw on it, or paint on it, or even turn it into paper-maché and make figures with it. She manufactures it, completely from plants and weeds found on and around her farm outside of Sutton.

Van Ginhoven spent some time in Japan in 1981, learning the ancient Japanese art of paper-making, and since then has adapted the methods she learned, experimenting with every imaginable plant substance to see what textures and colors each will produce in a paper.

Although she produces some hasty-notes and writing paper to sell, the main purpose of her work is to produce works of art. **VARIOUS FORMS**

These works take the form of

wall-hangings and three dimensional displays with various paper objects arranged on the floor or hanging from the ceiling. One in the University of Sherbrooke show is in the form of a primitive sort of book lying on a table.

There are different hues and textures, although mainly variations of brown and off-white; there are geographical designs achieved with different textures of paper; there are leaves and seeds sandwiched between layers of paper to form silhouettes when the light shines through; there are sticks and bundles of straw attached to and combined with different kinds of paper.

"Paper was chosen for *Fragments de terre* because of its ephemeral nature and the fact that you can dispose of it after use; a sign of our times," explains Van Ginhoven in her introduction to the exhibition. "The fragility of the material becomes a metaphor for that of the environment."

She goes on to explain that implied in the vulnerability that is so evident in the environment is the need to protect that environment.

A KIND OF FOCUS

With this explanation, it is pos-

sible to observe the works with some kind of focus, and indeed, they seem to convey a sense of the transience of life and the delicate balance of nature. I don't know if they would have done so if there had been no verbal footnote to the display. I suspect not.

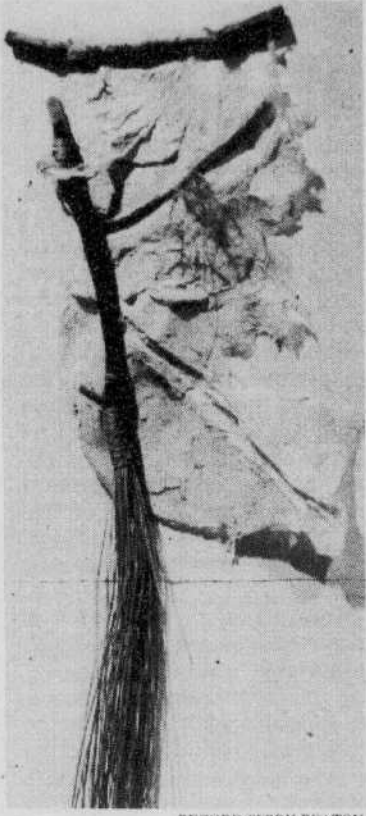
Perhaps Van Ginhoven should give the public a chance to grapple with the work itself. As it is, she sums up its "message" for us before we ask her to, which inevitably shapes our perception of that work.

Though we're all inclined to ask ourselves, or the artist if available, "What does it mean?" for the artist to feel the need to en-

hance her work with words somehow puts the work into question.

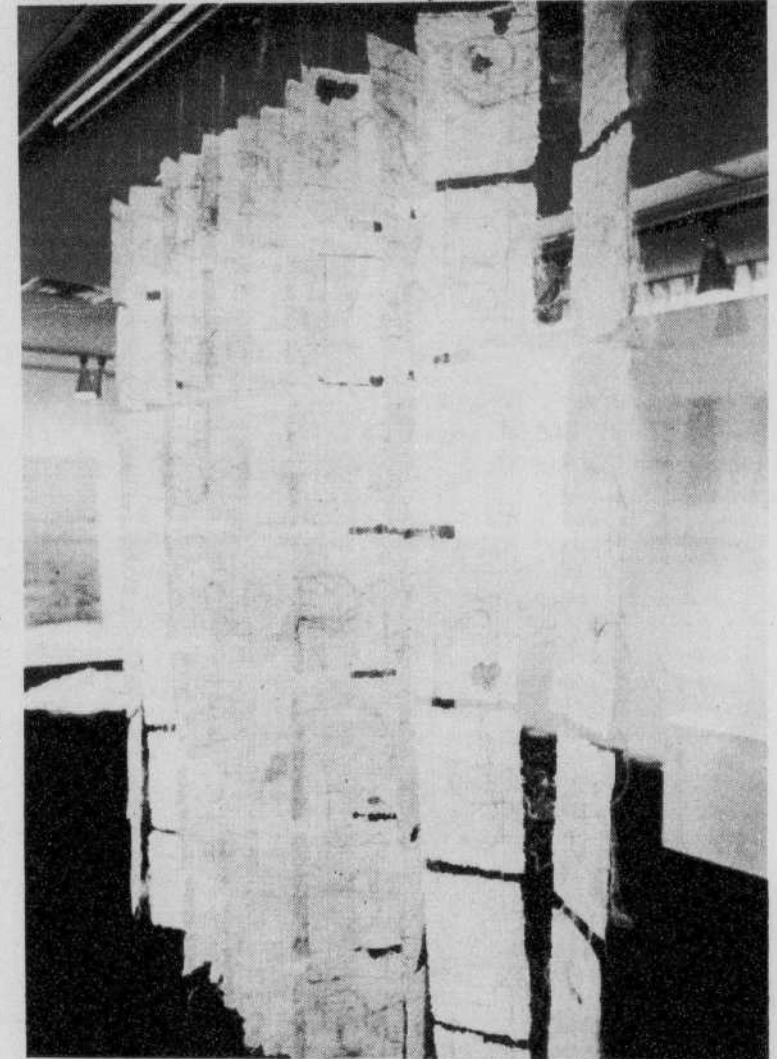
However, Van Ginhoven must be given credit for an innovative approach to art, for being a pioneer and an individualist. It takes such people to break down traditional paradigms regarding art, and open up possibilities for future artists.

The exhibition is in the art gallery of the cultural centre at the University of Sherbrooke until October 3. Hours of the gallery are 12:30 to 5 Monday to Friday, 8 to 10 p.m. Tuesday, Wednesday and Saturday, and 1 to 4 p.m. Sundays.

Historical society aims for \$150,000

LENNOXVILLE (LS) — The Lennoxville-Ascot Historical and Museum Society launches a campaign to raise \$150,000 this Sunday with a garden party on the lawn of Speid property in Lennoxville.

The society hopes to buy the property, with its 14-room Georgian-style house, to serve as a museum and cultural centre. The house dates back to 1862 and its history forms an important chapter in the history of the town and region.

John Paddon, of Compton, bought the land in 1861 and built the house a year later. The pro-

perty was passed on to his daughter Agnes and her son-in-law Reverend Archibald Campbell Scarth.

Dr. Scarth was an influential member of the community, as assistant minister and then rector of the St. George's parish, for a total of 45 years, and a professor at Bishop's College school. Scarth's two sons were important figures in the region's banking business.

A friend of the family, Henry Speid, acquired the property in 1918, and made some changes to the house, then passed it on to his son Arthur. Arthur Speid was

well-known as a town councillor, a mayor at one time and a great theatre enthusiast who contributed much to the Bishop's University Drama Society.

The Historical Society wants to preserve the property because of its historical value, as well as to realize several cultural projects, such as children's theatre workshops and an art gallery.

The garden party runs from 2 to 4 p.m. Sunday, rain or shine at 50 Park Avenue in Lennoxville. The Gay Nineties will provide the music, and apple pies, coffee and ice-cream will be sold for the profit of the historical society.

La La La Human Steps redefines concept of dance

son with a troupe of dancers that are guaranteed to shake any preconceived notions you may have taken on a primary level."

La La La Human Steps has been described as "a frenzied Montreal dance troupe", (the San Francisco Chronicle), and the dancing as "aggressive and competitive and full of danger and risk-taking" (New Dance magazine). The troupe is characterized by its avant-garde use of high-energy movement, daring acrobatic movements and bold theatrical images.

The Troupe's past productions have included *Businessman in the Process of Becoming an Angel*, *Lily Marlene in the Jungle*, and *Oranges*, which won choreographer Edouard Lock the Chalmers award in 1982.

The troupe presents its latest work, *Human Sex*, at the Centennial 8:30 Saturday September 14.

Human Sex conveys a message that has something to do with hope, passion, the risk of human relationships and the breakdown of perceived sex roles. But choreographer Lock, the mastermind behind this production, warns that the audience should not look for a narrative line in the piece.

NOT A LESSON

"There is not so much a lesson or a statement, although those things can be read into it," he said in a phone interview from Montreal, "but rather something to be

taken on a primary level."

Most art, aside from film, doesn't have a specific statement or narrative line, he explained — it's just that people have been taught to look for one.

"If I wanted to say something specific I wouldn't choose dance," he said. "It's not a specific art form. It doesn't convey a very clear idea; it conveys a more instinctive type of communication."

"People generally won't know how to react (to my piece)," he said. "They won't let their instincts come out."

But in past performances he says he has noticed an evolution in the reaction of the audience as the show progresses. "As they get used to this play of off-balance and quick reflexes they start having a lot of fun with it," he said.

Even the dance company's name reflects Lock's vision of what dance should be. Originally it was called simply La La La, commonly the first words a baby speaks. "It expresses my sentiments of not wanting art to be overly intellectual," said Lock. *Human Steps* was added later, he said, to reflect the company's fundamental interest in human movement.

Despite the acrobatics, the crashing and catapulting that characterizes the troupe's work,

Lock says there is gracefulness as well.

COMPLEX INSTRUMENT

"There is a lot of hand-dancing in our works," he said. "While classical ballet will treat the body as a linear thing with almost geometrical definition, I like to think of it as a very complex instrument, and some of the most complex features are the hands, the head, the extremities."

Although there is a musical score written especially for the piece by two young Canadian composers, Randall Kay and Louis Seize, the dancers contribute to the musical content through a series of laser beams projected across the stage which, when interrupted by the dancers trigger percussive sounds.

"The movement translates to music without having a third party involved," said Lock.

In choreographing the dance, he worked separately from the musicians, without hearing the musical score until a few weeks before the first performance, in April. This way, there are two strong art forms both vying for the audience's attention, he said, neither overpowering the other.

Splash star Tom Hanks can't pass up an opportunity

NEW YORK (AP)—As a child, Tom Hanks spent most of his spare time sitting in front of a TV set. Today, the zany actor and comedian has little time for the tube: He's too busy pumping out a string of movies.

"It came to a point where I could tell what time of day it was from what was on television," he said. "I am almost totally a product of that medium."

For Hanks, who is now 30, there wasn't much for him to do as a child growing up in Oakland with his restaurateur father except watching television.

It was a passtime that's paid off for the hot, Hollywood actor who starred in the hit movie *Splash* and who's now appearing in *Volunteers* with John Candy and *The Man With One Red Shoe*, a Victor Drai remake of the classic French farce *The Tall Blonde Man With One Black Shoe*.

Though *Splash* grossed \$80 million, *The Man With One Red Shoe* has been a summer flop. *Volunteers* is doing better, though.

"I like the movies because it's the big time," Hanks said in an interview at his art deco Eastside Manhattan apartment. "The only reason I do movies now is because I can."

"I did *Splash* which made me a star, and now I can make other movies. After all, how many people are asked to make movies?"

WORKS HARD

Since *Splash*, Hanks has been churning out films.

"Though it is emotionally draining and physically exhausting, I couldn't afford to pass up the opportunities that have come my way in the past year," he said.

He's in New York completing Steven Spielberg's *The Money Pit* in which he and Alexander Gudonov vie for the affections of Shelley Long. When he's finished, he'll begin his sixth movie, *Nothing in Common*, with Jackie Gleason. The comedy-drama will be a departure for Hanks from his usual boy-meets-girl movie.

It is that basic formula on

which producers have relied for every movie Hanks has done. Ever since his first movie, Hanks has been cast as "an everyman" who somehow winds up in an unusual situation involving a beautiful woman.

"Taking an average person and placing him in a non-average situation has been the basis for good drama dating back to Euripides," Hanks said. "My device as an actor is to display a wide range of emotion in a short period of time. I lose Tom Hanks and disappear into my characters."

Hanks spent the early years of his acting career doing repertory theatre in Oakland.

He landed his first role while still in high school in a production of Tennessee Williams' *Night of the Iguana*. While a student at California State University in Sacramento, Hanks was invited to intern with the Great Lakes Shakespeare Festival in Cleveland.

As a member of the classical company he made his professional stage debut as Grumio in *The Taming of the Shrew*.

WINS AWARD

Remaining with the company for three seasons, Hanks widened his classical repertoire by performing in such works as *The Two Gentlemen of Verona*, for which

he won the Cleveland Critics Award for best actor.

Hanks then moved to New York where he appeared in a number of low-budget films including *He Knows You're Alone* and *Mazes and Monsters*.

ABC recognized his talent and sent him to Hollywood to test for

Bosom Buddies.

Though he lacks the range and maturity of more seasoned film actors such as Dustin Hoffman, Sidney Poitier and William Hurt, his natural flair for situational lunacy clearly distinguishes him from other young Hollywood stars.

He is married to actress Samantha Lewes, who lives with their two children in the San Fernando Valley.

"Family stability is even more important to me," Hanks says. "I had three sets of stepmothers by the time I was in junior high school."

Apparently they put on an overwhelming and spellbinding performance full of leaps, tumbles and gravity-defying feats as well as using contemporary music that is partly produced by the dancers themselves as they move. Their latest production, *Human Sex*, is described as an expressionistic series of images portrayed through dance to suggest the risk, hope and passion of human relationships. This is at 8:30, and seats are reserved, so don't think you can get the best seat in the house by coming late and barging though the line-up. Call 563-4966 to reserve instead.

Last Wednesday the horror-comedy *Jeudi le 12* started at the *Petite Salle* in the cultural centre at the University of Sherbrooke, after a successful summer at the *Théâtre Thé des Bois* in Deauville. The play will be presented at 8:30 Wednesdays through Saturdays until

September 28.

Coming up at the *Pigeonnier* September 19 though October 5 is *La Petite Bougraisse*, a one-woman show about life as an obese person in a world that says "thin is in". Written by *Christian Bédard*, the play will be presented only Thursdays through Saturday nights.

Exhibitions/Events

It seems every second time the phone rang last week someone was inviting me to a *vernissage*, so if visual art is your thing, there's plenty for you to see this weekend and in the coming weeks. I'm only sorry I couldn't answer all the invitations.

Merritt went to see an exhibition at *Arts Sutton* which you can read all about on page three of Townships Week, so I won't be repetitious, even though paraphrasing some of what he said would help me fill this space — which is rapidly becoming a major priority at this point.

I went to see Sutton artist *Anke Van Ginhoven's* work at the *University of Sherbrooke gallery*, and was a little hard on her, I suppose. (See page 5). I confess I have a bias toward representational art and generally lean toward the conservative, despite my efforts to keep an open mind and expand my horizons. So keep this in mind as I babble on learnedly on whatever topic it may be. And by all means go see for yourself. Van Ginhoven's exhibition continues until October 3.

At the same time you can take a look at an exhibit of work by *Wayne Boucher*. The exhibition is called *Wayne Boucher: A Survey*, which seems to suggest a variety or pot-pourri. However, I found the exhibition rather monotonous. Large, and mostly in black and white, Boucher's paintings are mainly what I would call the ink-blot variety: the kind that everyone will see something different in.

Much more interesting to me, in the lobby to the *Salle Maurice O'Bready* at the U de S is a collection of photographs by *Jack Turner* and *Neil Livingston* entitled *Painting with Light*. Turner uses oil paint to add colour to finished prints, mostly of land and seascapes, to capture different moods. Livingston does somewhat the same thing, but with color xeroxing: the electrostatic layering of a pigment on a piece of paper by machine. The exhibition is small, but worth taking a look at.

The *Horace Gallery*, on King Street in Sherbrooke has an exhibition of paintings by local artist *Françoise Hamel*. I haven't managed to see this yet, but it continues until September 22, so there's still plenty of time for both you and I to see it. The *Horace Gallery* is open only Wednesday to Friday noon to 5:00, weekends 1 to 5.

Painter *Fernand Labelle* continues at the *Laurier Museum* in Arthabaska until September 27. Labelle is originally from Cornwall and his first interest was political science, but while studying in Paris developed a passion for art. Since then his work has been exhibited all over the United States and Canada and in several European countries.

On CBC television from 9 to 11 p.m. Saturday the opening of the **Calgary Centre for the Performing Arts**

is telecast live, corresponding with the **CBC Radio** broadcast.

At 11:30 p.m. Saturday CBC television features the **Genie-award winning movie The Changeling**. Starring **George C. Terrorists and traders keep travellers on their toes

This article is the fifth part of a series on Israel by Stanstead resident Chick Schwartz.

From the kibbutz, we headed south but made a side trip to the Golan Heights. Our entire trip was made by public bus except for this day. We rented a car and drove to Nimrod's Castle (very reminiscent of ruins on Wales or Scotland but older), the Sea Of Galilee, and Tiberias. For lunch, we drove up this winding road in the mountains and stopped in Maj Dal Shams, a small village occupied mostly by Druze.

There, we bought our usual fruits and pita, etc., and had a picnic back down at the Sea Of Galilee (the entire shores of which, by the way, was filthy beyond belief). Then we drove on into Sfad where the famous artist's colony is located, turned in our car and checked into a hotel high up on the outskirts of town.

The next day, while reading the Jerusalem Poste (English language daily), I came upon this intriguing article. It seems that for the first time in twenty years, the Druze were practising terrorism. Yesterday — the day we were there — they had mined the road around this little village in the Golan Heights...Maj Dal Shams. The Israeli army was there now with mine detecting equipment clearing the roads.

The old tummy did backflips for hours.

TOOK IN A MOVIE

We saw some really good art, and lots of the other kind too in Sfad. We also met some extremely pleasant artists there. That evening, we thought we'd take in the local flick. "Osterman Weekend" was playing in English. It was really good but somewhat convoluted for youngsters to figure out. After it was over, we sat in the theatre explaining the complications to Hardy and Zack.

This guy up at the front of the theatre was babbling something in Hebrew with much jesticulation, but we really didn't pay much attention to him and went on with our elucidation. Five or ten minutes went by, it was about 9:45 p.m. and this guy comes jumping down toward us yelling and shaking his arms like crazy. We couldn't understand a word he was saying, but it couldn't have been more evident, he thought we were nuts and wanted us out - NOW!

Well, we figured it must be customary for movie goers in Israel to leave immediately after the screening. Wierd, but no big deal. Live and learn.

We sauntered out, (this guy from the theater went running past us like a house on fire), and walked leisurely the several blocks to the bus stop. Our hotel was about five miles away, perched on the top of this hill (not a real handy location, but cheaper

because of its distance from town).

BUS STOPS AT 10

After waiting fifteen or twenty minutes, we realized that no buses were coming. That's what all the commotion at the theatre was about. He was trying to tell us that the buses stopped running at 10 and we were going to miss ours, or at least make him miss his.

No problem. We'd take a taxi - they're relatively cheap in Israel. We walked back to the centre of town to find a cab. None there. Went to a hotel and found that the taxis also stopped running at ten o'clock. The clerk called several cab companies as well as five of his friends with cabs explaining the predicament these dumb yankee tourists got themselves into. No dice.

You ever walk five miles uphill the entire way at 11 at night taking turns carrying a sleeping six year old?

From Sfad, we went to Be'er Sheva to visit the Bedouin market. Located right on the edge of the desert, every Thursday morning, the Bedouin come from all over loaded down with their fantastic embroidery, old clothes, daggers, copper and brassware, tabacco and other smokeable products, ancient coins, pottery shards, extra goats and sheep, etc. About 6 a.m. they spread their wares out on the ground and are ready to trade. They start early in deference to the light-skinned yankees since by 10 or 11, the sun is so intense, most of us can't stand the heat.

LAYERS OF CLOTHING

By some magic totally in opposition to what we learned in high school science back in ought and eight, the Bedouin women wear several layers of clothing - all black. The outermost layer is wool, and they appear relatively comfortable in temperatures far in excess of 100°F.

No matter where we went in Egypt and Israel, (the Bedouin respect no boundaries), we'd see them tending their flocks of camels, goats, and sheep in the most desolate and un hospitable surroundings conceivable. Often, the only semblance of shelter would be a low woven twig lean-to affair which offered only modest protection at best. As often as not, no shelter was available. There they'd be...hunckering in their black clothing, staring off into the desert.

These ladies were of course covered from head to foot. Many wore gold rings through their noses with flat gold pieces dangling off. Since their husbands could send them off at any time, this gold gave them at least a bit of security should they find themselves without property or support at the whim of their husband.

FIERCE BARGAINING

Anyway, back at the market, the bargaining was fierce. Andy, our eldest son, found a Bedouin

gentleman with a plate covered with ancient coins he had unearthed while tending his flocks. "How much for this one?", Andy asked.

"Twenty dollars," Farouk answered.

"Two dollars," Andy countered.

"I'll let it go for ten dollars," Farouk responded. (How do you lose money on something you've found?)

"Sorry, but that's more money than I want to spend," the boy said as he started walking away.

Farouk jumped up and followed Andy shouting, "since I love you like a brother, I'll let you have two of the coins for ten dollars."

"How about three for six dollars," Andy asked.

"But these are old coins," the Bedouin responded, "genuine museum pieces."

"Sorry," Andy said as he again started walking away.

Sensing a sure sale, Farouk pursued. "How much money do you have?" he asked.

"Eight dollars," Andy replied as he had already given the rest of his money to one of his brothers for exactly this reason.

"Let's see, my brother," the Bedouin said. Andy then flipped his pockets inside out thus proving his total wealth to be eight dollars. "O.K.," Farouk said. "Two ancient, museum quality artifacts for eight dollars. You'd better get them before the Cairo Museum buys my entire stock."

"You've got a deal if you'll sell me three for eight dollars," the boy countered.

"Do you realize my losses if I let you have three for nine dollars," whined Farouk.

"But you know I only have eight bucks," Andy answered, again starting to leave.

"Give me the money Yankee,"

was heard ringing throughout the market. The deal was consummated with each negotiator barely repressing a grin of total triumph. Three ancient coins for eight dollars.

Andy could hardly wait to show his latest treasures to his brothers. "Look what I just

bought," he said handing the coins to Paul.

"Ya, I know," Paul responded. "I just bought some too. In fact, two of mine are just like a couple of yours. Got em from that guy right over there. He's got a whole pot full of them - your choice - two bucks apiece!"

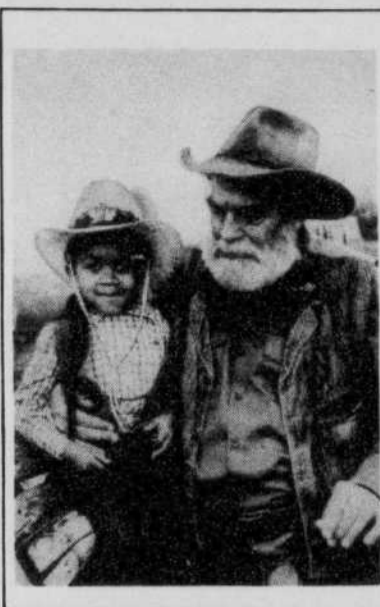

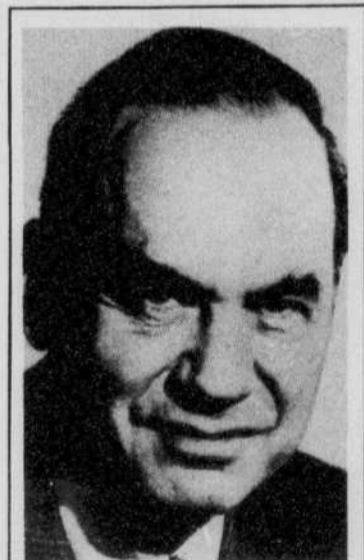
