Stanstead Historical Society celebrates 70th b-day

Party to be held at Colby-Curtis Museum Aug. 21

The Stanstead Historical Society will celebrate its 70th anniversary Saturday Aug. 21st at the Colby-Curtis Museum at Carrollcroft, by throwing a party for the community complete with birthday cake, balloons, refreshments, croquet games, historical talks and a band concert.

From 2 p.m., croquet games which will be set up on the lawns.

"There will be people to encourage the players and provide a little bit of coaching," said Monique Nadeau-Saumier, curator of the museum.

Also at 2 p.m., bilingual historical talks will be presented at the Ursuline Convent across the street by Jean-Pierre Kesteman and Peter Southam, Professors at Universite de Sherbrooke who have just completed a comprehensive history of the Townships, 'Histoire des Cantons de l'Est.

"Kesterman will be speaking in French about the 19th-century and Southam will be speaking in English

about the 20th century," said Nadeau-Saumier.

Following the talks, an open-air concert will be presented in the new Victorian garden by the Newport Area Concert Band, a group of American and Canadian musicians directed by Jim Chapman. Saumier is also excited about the current photographic exhibit 'Window on the Past,' featuring photographs by J.J. Parker from 1899-1940 augmented by pieces from the museum collection and a presentation of drawings by the area's elementary school students. Admission to the museum will be free of charge.

"Seventy years is quite a feat for a museum," said Nadeau-Saumier. "The historical society comes from very humble beginnings. There's a little school house on the way to Stanstead East where we started in 1929."

The historical society and its collection had a number of homes, from the old post office, to Beebe, to the RCMP building in Stanstead.

"In 1992," Nadeau-Saumier said, "this house was given to the historical soci-

ety. It's a house that's not an empty shell. A lot of the houses in Quebec have been put together again. This is the original setting."

The house was built of granite in 1859.

"Granite was not usually used for houses. It was used for churches and official buildings like post offices," Nadeau-Saumier remarked. "There are a few other granite houses in Beebe. It was an ambitious project for Mr. Colby to build this."

Carrollcroft, with its library, a drawing room, dining room, solarium and kitchen largely unchanged and a grand upstairs full of original furnishings from the home including wonderful children's toys and clothing, original desks and writing materials, a four poster bed with antique lace cover was actually furnished quite simply compared with other homes of the period.

"The furniture is really very simple," said Nadeau-Saumier. "It's very pragmatic, reflecting the New England family roots."

Another aspect of the house which is

unusual is the sheer volume of archives left by a family which included the forefather, Charles Carroll Colby, a minister in the cabinet of John A. Macdonald, an architect, a doctor, lawyers and an

artist. The house was donated along with many medical and legal texts, libraries, artwork and photographs and correspondence.

Highlights include three-panelled portraiture from Italy - when glimpsed from the right and left sides and the front, a different portrait appears - the Limoges china purchased through a Boston company in the dining room, antique recipe books, the original ornate heating ducts in the library, a dollhouse inspired by the architecture on the Boston commons with neoclassical touches, a kaleidoscope and on the grounds, a stagecoach which Mrs. Colby had restored in the 1990s.

The Victorian garden is a recent development, created by Gina Fleet featuring lavender, daisies, lilies and other flowers and plants of the period. Plans are in progress for a rose garden, a peony garden and a pergola.

This "gem of a house", as Nadeau-Saumier calls Carrollcroft, is the perfect setting for the family archives and antiques and integration of the Colby Curtis collection of the historical society, named for the Colby family and Arthur E. Curtis Jr. who raised money for the purchase of this stately home.

The museum has benefitted from a number of sponsors, for the celebration and for work on the gardens such as: CRD-Estrie, Robert Benoit, Caisse Populaire de Stanstead, MRC, Ville de Stanstead and Syndicat de l'enseignement de l'Estrie.

Scottish songster captures country spotlight

*Johnny Reid
among country's
crème de la crème*

Johnny Reid, a former Bishop's University student, says he's honoured to be one of 20 musicians selected from a field 4,500 to play at the Showcase for the Country Music Association for Country Music Week '99 in Ottawa, the year's premiere country music event in Canada.

"He is one of the top 20 up-and-coming performers in Canadian country music as recognized by the Canadian Country Music Association," said his representative Chad Barter.

Reid's showcase is slated for Friday Sept. 10 at 6:30 p.m. when he will perform for a half an hour.

A thousand representatives from the Canadian Country Music community will be on hand to witness the new talent.

"I just want to prove to them you don't have to be a Texan to play country music," Reid said. "I was talking to a guy at a radio station in Alberta and he said, 'We can't believe there's a Scottish guy singing country music.' It all depends on what country music is to you."

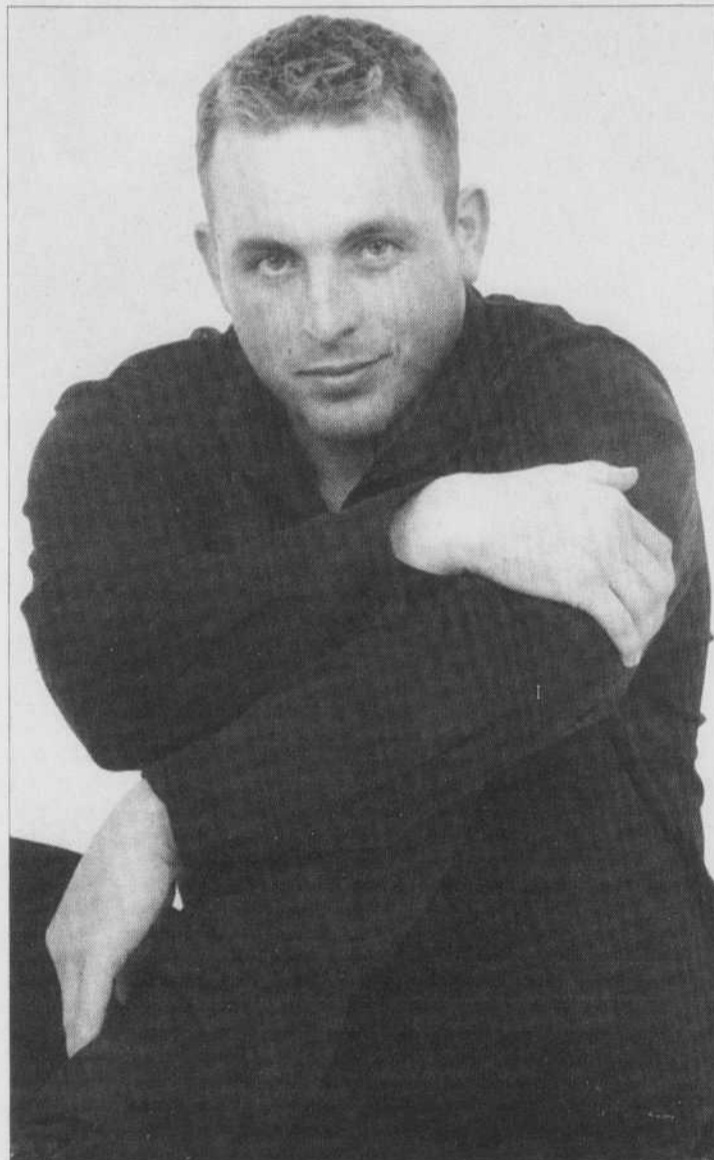
"Country music has always been sung from the heart. Because you sing about things that happen either bad or good, they're personal experiences. I don't sing country music because I'm a cowboy, but because I'm singing from the heart," he explained.

Reid is currently recording a new CD for nationwide release at the end of September.

"All the songs are by me or have been co-written with me," said Reid. "Because I have written the songs, they have much personal significance. The songs are all very different. Some are a little light but fun and some are pretty deep and mean quite a lot to me. One of the Toronto critics calls it 'rock, roll, country, soul.' The thread that ties all the songs together is me."

Unfortunately, there is no country music station in Quebec. Fans can tune in to CJMQ (Bishop's) and CFLX Sherbrooke to hear Reid's new single, "Given Up on Me."

"It's been played on a pretty good rotation from Newfoundland to B.C.," said Reid. "We are really excited, really happy. The last five weeks have been really busy. I've had next to no sleep. As my grandpa used to say, 'good luck is when preparation meets with opportunity.' We are hoping to release another two singles and two videos by Christ-

mas."

Reid's new video for "Given Up on Me" airs Aug. 23 on Country Music Television (CMT).

Reid's band draws on Canadian talent.

"The band is a hodgepodge of some of Canada's best musicians," he said. "The majority of them live in the Ottawa valley or Toronto. They are great musicians as anyone coming down to the Showcase will see. Some people may have seen Steve Piticco who performed with me at the benefit for the Lennoxville Youth Centre. He is said to be the best Canadian country

guitar player. He has been chosen by the Canadian Country Association as instrumentalist of the year a number of times.

Another musician is Al Bragg, also producer of the album who's been in the Canadian Country Hall of Fame. Since leaving Bishop's, I've been able to network, so I am working with the best Canada has to offer," he said.

Although no longer here, Reid remembers Lennoxville fondly.

"I sure do miss that little town. I keep telling people down here, it's the best hidden secret."

And Reid said Townshippers continue to support him.

"I have had literally hundreds of e-mails letting me know everyone's behind me and supporting me. I read all of those

and a large part of my days are spent reading those e-mails."

Reid's Web site at Johnny Reid.com gives updates on his career, music videos and concert dates. Fans can in-

sert their e-mail addresses to receive information and will be able to download "Given Up on Me."

Reid's schedule continues to be fast-paced. "I'm leaving Oct. 6 on a radio tour. We're going to go from Newfoundland to B.C. and everywhere in between. It will probably take a month."

For fans interested in seeing Reid perform, Barter is organizing a bus trip to Ottawa for the Showcase. The bus will leave the Lennoxville McDonald's between noon and 1 p.m. to return that evening. Sponsorship from local businesses - tax refundable donations in amounts such as \$50, \$100 and \$200 to help cover the cost of the bus would be greatly appreciated.

Reid and Barter are hoping to be able to charge \$5 or \$10 for the bus ride. Cost of the Showcase is \$5.

Musical tour around the world closes 48th season at Festival Orford

The Orford festival will close its 48th season with a musical tour around the world and a tribute to Samuel Barber.

On Friday, Aug. 13, at 8:15 p.m., the Orford Masters will entertain the audience with a musical odyssey entitled "World Music" carrying the audience through Italy, Czechoslovakia, Brazil, Japan and the United States. The program of this journey will include a Fantasy on William Tell for flute, oboe and piano by Gioachino Rossini, Three Madrigals for violin and viola by Bohuslav Martinu, the Ketiak for percus-

sion by Akita Nishimura, the Bachianas Brasileiras not for flute and bassoon by Heitor Villa-Lobos and the Grand Concerto on themes from Verdi's I Vespri Siciliani for oboe and strings by Pasculli.

Interpreters include Orford students: Lorraine Prieur, piano; Lorand Fenyves, violin; Robert Verebes, viola; Kathleen Rudolph, flute; Philippe Magnan, oboe; Scott Hartman, trombone; James McKay, bassoon; Peter Kurau, french horn; Paul Merkelo, trumpet; Alain Cazes, tuba; Paul Fortin, percussions.

This 48th season of the Orford Festival will close with a tribute to Samuel Barber, Saturday, Aug. 14th, under the direction of Yuli Turovsky. The Orford Festival Orchestra will interpret concerti for violin, piano and cello from the famous American composer. It will also be a unique opportunity to discover the tal-

ent of three young soloists, winners of the fourth Orford Arts Centre International Music Competition.

Samuel Barber is one of the foremost representatives of 20th century American music. Born in West Chester (PA) in 1910, he died in New York in 1981. He wrote in a romantic vein that contradicted the aesthetic revolutions of his contemporaries, responding to critics with fierce independence: "I have always composed what pleased me, without that feverish desire to find at all cost the last possible novelty; this has, I believe, required considerable courage."

The public auditions for the Fourth International Music Competition will be held at the Gilles Lefebvre Hall of the Orford Arts Centre, on Wednesday Aug 11th. The names of the winners will be announced during the evening.

Electric light switch orchestra

Slate sculptor takes inspiration from historical figures

If you're looking for something unique and artistic to cover your light switch, grace your coffee table or function as a door, then visit the slate sculpture display of artist Robert Philippe Babin.

In his current show at restaurant Monsieur Paul on College Street in Richmond, Babin is exhibiting a series of 45 light switch plates, one for every year of his life, as well as two stunning table top sculptures and a full size door.

A combination of red slate from Bedford, green slate from Vermont and local grey slate, Babin's sculptures resemble the residual fragments of a forgotten civilization, evoking sensations of antiquity, mystery and poetry.

The Montreal native settled in Melbourne two years ago, after a life of traveling around Canada, working in the performing arts. A former set designer, choreographer, actor and dancer, Babin has now channeled his sense of rhythm and movement into the enduring permanence of stone.

No stranger to sculpture, Babin first began modeling wood surfaces as a teenager.

"I enjoyed that quite a bit" he said, "I liked the results but I injured myself with the sharp cutting tools too frequently."

He abandoned the wood carving craft, with his fingers intact, and pursued a career in theatre. Fifteen years later he began working with stone.

"It was a hobby, really, I would find pieces of soft stone in the river bed and carve runic symbols into them for my friends. The work seemed more suited to me, the tools were friendlier. I had no idea at the time I was working with slate."

His move to Melbourne, to a house a few hundred feet from the slate museum Musee d'Ardoise, steered him back to exploring self expression through working with stone.

Babin's original inspirations came from the wood sculptures of traders, *coureurs de bois*, of the early 17th-century.

"These were men who traveled about, coming into contact with native people, Chinese people. What I

saw of their work inspired me to carve something that would blend the ancient with a sense of the future," he said.

"I look at what kids are doing today with graffiti, the sophisticated three dimensional designs some of them are making. I wanted to avoid the figurative, folklorist work that has been done to perfection already. Some of my designs are inspired by computer generated images, some from old oriental games, ... some I don't know where it comes from."

Many of Babin's designs, which he grinds into the slate using chisels and a rotary grinder, remind the viewer of the invisible energy fields which surround us all. Magnetic fields, gravitational fields, twisted and shaped by the boundaries of the slate fragments producing visible rays, points and textures in the stone surface. After working the stone to his satisfaction, he coats it with two layers of varnish.

"Slate is very porous," he said. "It has to be sealed or the humidity gets in, the stone begins to work and deteriorate."

Babin's sculpture Spirit Friend, standing 18 inches high, is a good example of his many sources of inspiration.

"It began with a dream. When I woke, I knew I had to create a stairway. When the stairs were made I mounted them on a vertical slab of slate, then, after some reflection and discussion, I cut the hole with the stairway penetrating, continuing around the other side, and then returning again at a higher level. The idea is that you are facing reality, but you have to go behind to get more knowledge and then return somewhat wiser."

"When I completed this piece, it was not properly vertical. I thought of O. Sullivan, an author on Celtic wisdom. I just finished reading a book which speaks about Celtic knowledge and approach. I realized we come from clay, we rise from it, so I used pieces of red slate as a base to represent the clay that this piece rises from. By adjusting the thickness of the pieces I effectively leveled the sculpture."

The surface of the piece is covered with hieroglyph-like representations of dance choreography. Etched cubes of pyrite frame the portal of the upper balcony. The effect is at once ancient, futuristic and other worldly.

Babin has exhibitions planned in Frelighsburg, Vermont and France.

Country is cool and so is David Ball

Watch for new release from Bishop's crooner John Reid

It's Friday the 13th, and the day to avoid black cats and ladders if you're a bit superstitious.

On the other hand if you're the skeptical type these stories won't bother you at all and this will be another normal day. A good day to start your weekend listening with new country albums.

Here's my pick of new albums for this week:

DAVID BALL: Play (Warner Bros.)

David Ball is an artist steeped in the great country two-steppin' good time western dance-hall tradition and his biggest hit "Thinkin' Problem," is a testament to that spirit.

It's been five years since this catchy ballad took him to No. 2 on the country singles chart but subsequent efforts ever since have failed to bring the same success. This new album titled *Play* just might do it for him.

Ball's self-penned songs often have a sad side but "I Want to With You" it takes another direction: "Put a little ring, third finger left hand/ Stay with somebody who will love and understand/ Girl, I want to with you," all sound positive enough.

The man who's been called the human jukebox so many times appears to be

more concerned with his music making, co-producing for the first time and demonstrating his songwriting skills more than ever.

Ball is one of the foremost singers to keep the traditional flame burning, proving it in the beautiful "Hasta Luego, My Love." The Texas dance hall tradition is alive and well with "Lonely Town," a swinging number in which Ball excels.

"I'm Just a Country Boy," is a bouncy upbeat ballad Ball co-wrote with Dennis Morgan, writer of the Barbara Mandrell 80s hit "I Was Country When Country Wasn't Cool." Well, now country is more than cool and David Ball contributes to

its popularity with his strong and warm country vocals as well as his talent to write a good song. He is no disappointment as a live entertainer either as he displays a whole lot of energy.

One highlight of the album is the emotional "Going Someplace To Forget," on which Ball displays his total understanding of country music.

This is a finely tuned album which should bring Ball a lot more recognition than he's received so far.

MERLE HAGGARD: Live at Billy Bob's Texas (Smith Music Group)

This album is part of a collection featuring some of the most prominent country singers recorded live at the famed Fort Worth honky-tonk. This album features the Hag at the top of his game and the reaction of the raucous crowd at Billy Bob's helps fuel his performance.

Merle Haggard's phrasing has never been better than on "I Think I'll Just Stay Here and Drink." "Workin' Man Blues" kicks up the tempo and energy level and then he belts out the classic bar room ballad "Tonight The Bottle Let Me Down."

This is a huge 18-song treat as the Hag pours out his soul backed by his longtime band, The Strangers, and guest Johnny Gimble adding his skillful fiddle and mandolin licks.

Included are "Mama Tried," "That's The Way Love Goes," and his No. 1 smash hit from 1969, "Okie From Muskogee." Every numbers still stirs the audience into a frenzy.

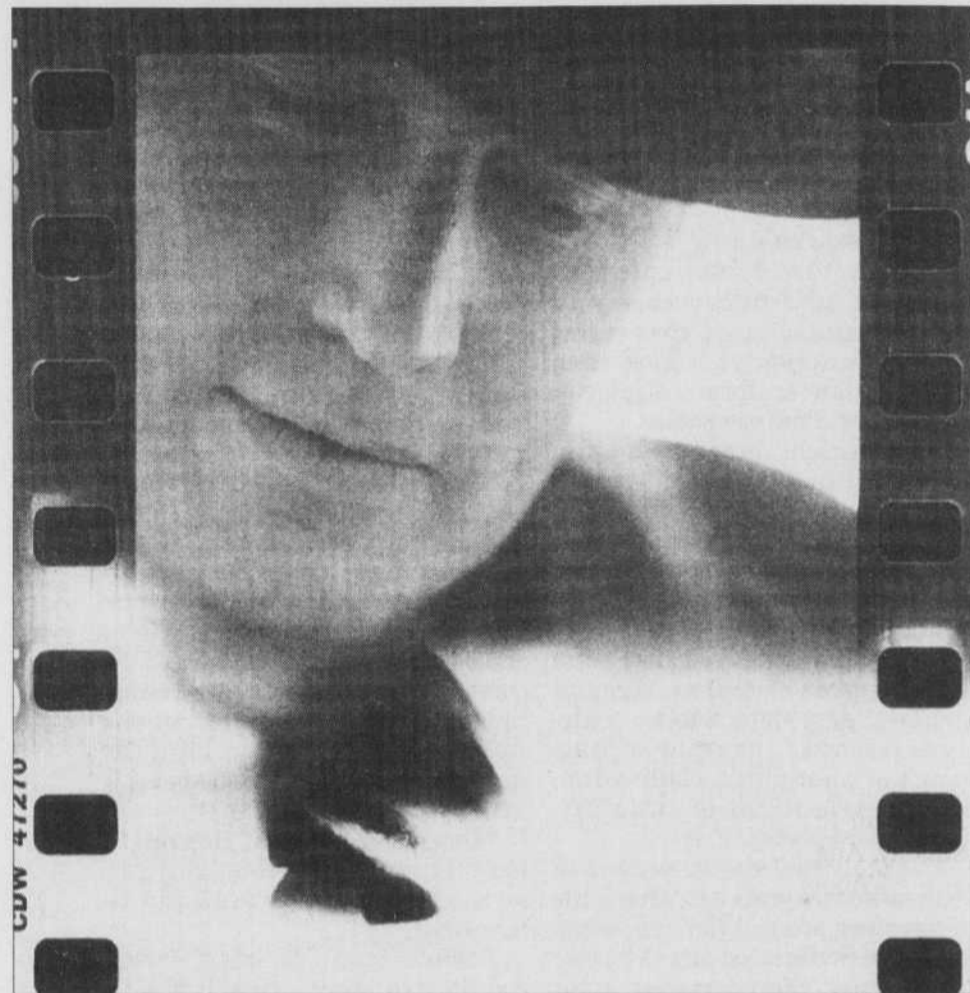
Haggard gives a soulful treatment to the bittersweet ballad "If We Make It Through December." His voice reflects both desperation and hope as only he can do so magically.

The album closes with a song he co-wrote with his ex-wife Bonnie Owen, "Today I Started Loving You Again." This is the album that every Hag fan should add to their collection.

JOHN REID ON CMT

Talent and hard work are finally paying off for country singer John Reid who managed to build quite a fan club in the Townships while studying at Bishop's University. Reid's last performance in the Townships was at the fund-raiser for the Lennoxville Youth Center last spring. Since then many things have happened to the young singer who takes his music and songwriting very seriously. There's a new album slated to be released in late September and Reid is currently in studio recording the last four songs for this collection.

The first single titled "Given Up On Me," has been released and has been doing especially well for an independent release.

In order to support the new song Reid just finished recording a video under the direction of Joel Stewart from Calgary, who has worked with Jann Arden and the popular group Moist.

This video will be sent to CMT around Aug. 23 and it should go on rotation shortly after that.

The Canadian Country Music Association Showcase is where new artists get a shot at showing their talent in front of the country music industry talent scouts and record company executives. This year the Canadian Country Music Association of Canada has chosen 20 applicants out of 4,500 to be part of the 1999 Canadian Country Music Week Showcase.

John Reid has been chosen one of five male vocalists at this event; the CCMA also picked five female vocalists, five duos and five bands.

Reid is slated to perform Sept. 10 at 6:30 p.m. in a 30-minute showcase. Johnny Mac Entertainment, Reid's company with partner and manager Craig MacAdam are setting to rent buses to bring fans from the Lennoxville area to the Ottawa Congress Centre for this event. Photographer enjoys sculpting light

Photographer Diana Harding-Tucker, shared her passion with viewers at the Brome County Historical Society in Knowlton last week where she was showcasing her photo images, inspired by Picasso.

"For me the fascination is light and what it does to film, you can sculpt light in the darkroom," said Harding-Tucker who also shoots scenes of her travels across Canada.

Harding-Tucker likes to use a special kind of film. Her prints are selenium-toned using a fibre base paper which enhances her black and white tones.

"When I look at that one, (Wine and Roses) I always hear music.

Sometimes I can shoot a scene in 20 minutes and other times it could take eight hours," she said.

When it comes to technique,

the Queen's University grad says she is self-taught, modeling her style after Ansel Adams, 'my god in photography'.

"He prescribes pre-visualizing the image before you take it," she said.

Her latest exhibit in Toronto, 'Contact 99' was a city-wide show promoting photographers.

"Two photographic galleries started this exhibit in '97 to increase the awareness and appreciation of photography," said Harding-Tucker who is also involved with digital imaging.

When she returns to the Townships, she plans to have more local scenes.

"I had many interesting visitors who really liked my work."

Her next exhibit will be at Arts Sutton in 2000.

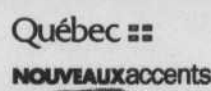

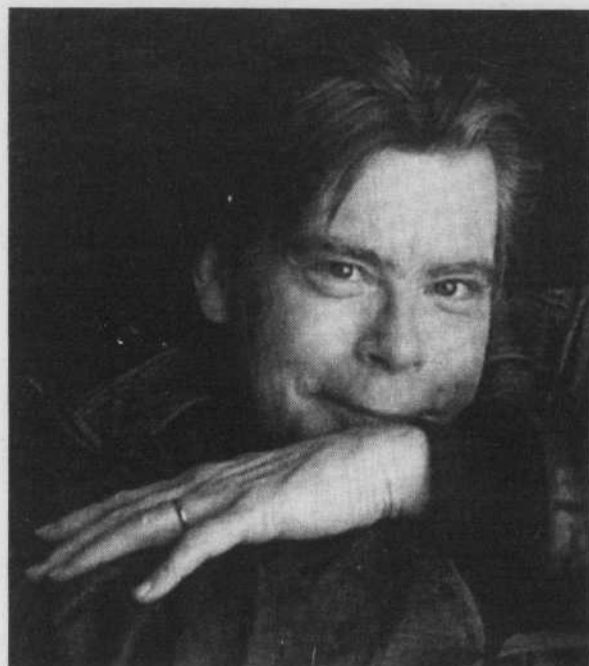

Singer-songwriter Roy Orbison, best known for his plaintive chart toppers "Cryin'" and "Only the Lonely," is the subject of filmmaker Greg Hall's new biography *In Dreams: The Roy Orbison Story*, airing Tuesday on Bravo! Canada. Orbison began his career when he was a West Texas teen-ager in the 1940s and scored hits in each of the next four decades. Bernie Taupin, Elton John's songwriting collaborator, pays tribute to Orbison's songwriting abilities in the documentary. Canada's k.d. lang, who sang a duet with Orbison on a rerelease of "Cryin'," suggests that his ethereal voice came from another spiritual plane. Also interviewed are Bruce Springsteen, who presented Orbison at the Hall of Fame induction, and a number of rockers who were heavily influenced by the singer, including Bono, late of U2, and Led Zeppelin's Robert Plant.

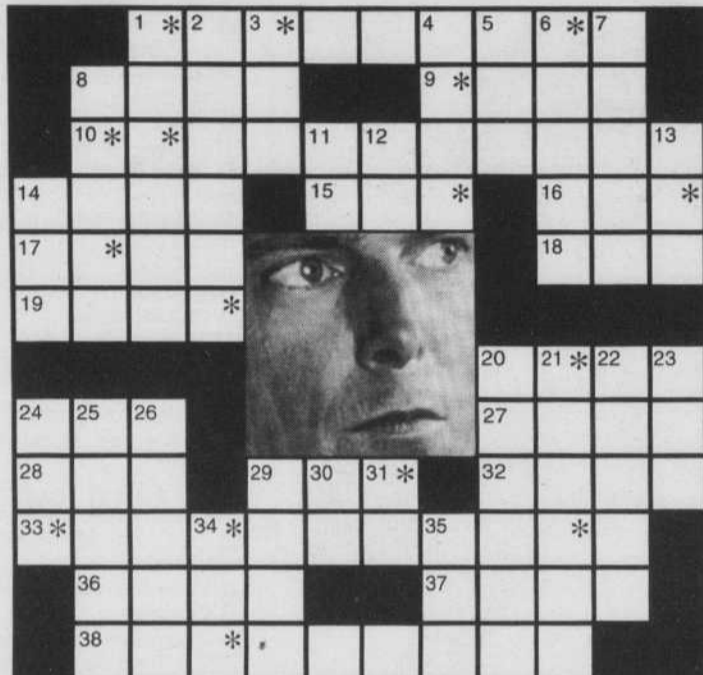

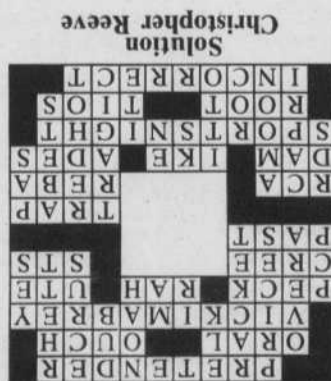
