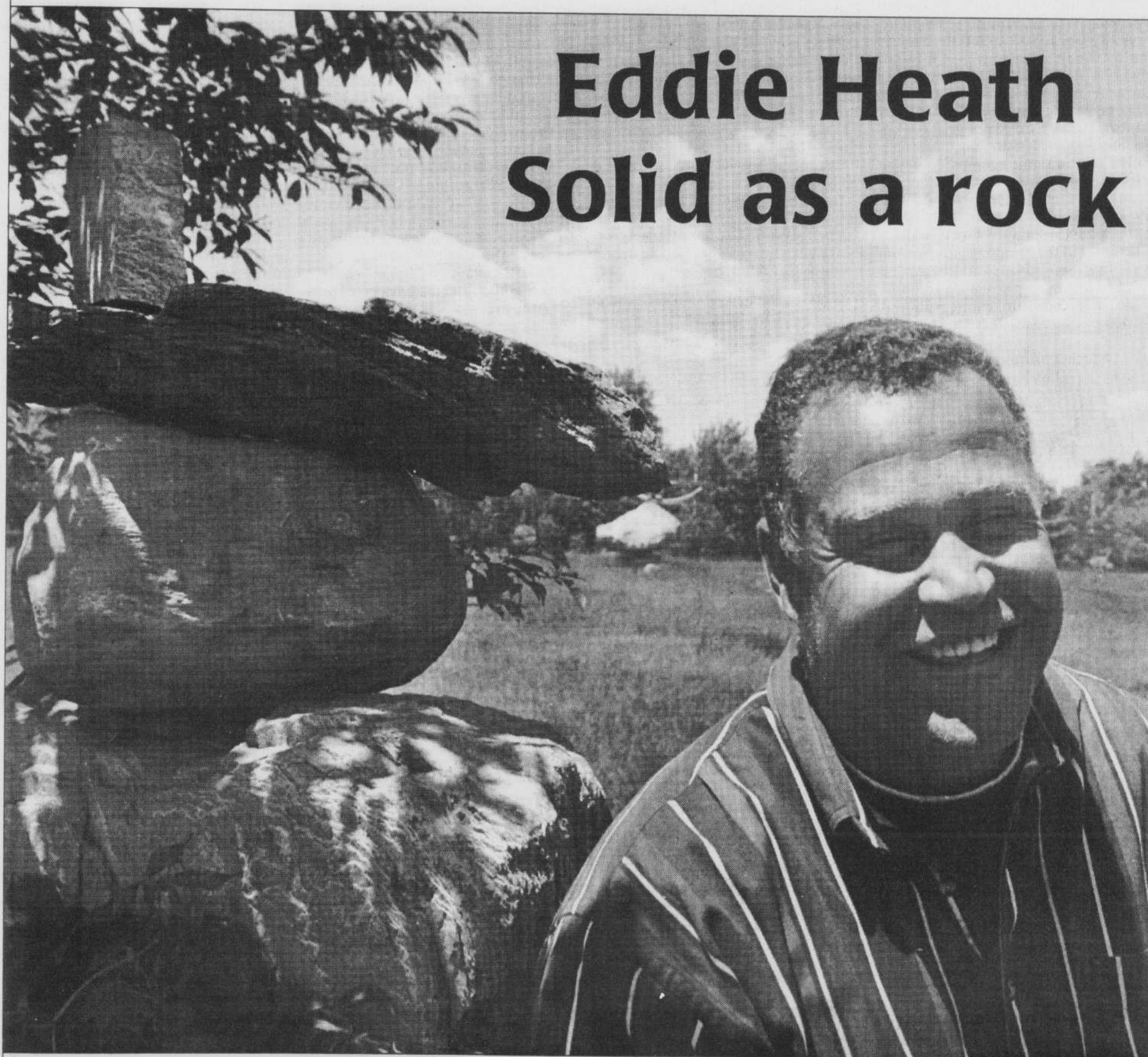

# Summer of music at Theatre Lac Brome

The seeds have been planted for Theatre Lac Brome's summer season of all-musical shows. It buds with New York-Paris, a revue penned by star Peter Pringle, unfolds with the return of The Megantic Outlaw, co-written by the theatre's artistic director Nicholas K. Pynes, and blossoms with Groucho: A Life in Review, co-authored by Groucho Marx's son Arthur and featuring tunes and skits from Marx Brothers comedies.

The season matures into September with pianist John Arpin and actors Rob Burns and Glen Roy performing a tribute to Eddie Cantor, and the musical comedy duo Bowser and Blue.

Pynes said the season wasn't planned with music in mind.

"We wanted to bring back The Megantic Outlaw, because it ran at the end of the season and it was very popular, but not enough people had a chance to see it," said Pynes, who wrote the script based on the life of well-known Townships bandit Donald Morrison with Montrealer Edward S. Herkes.

Pynes said last year's production was a tentative tryout, with the barest of sets and minimal expenses. This year, he said it has been "significantly changed" and much of the music is new. Pynes himself will be playing the accordion during the play.

The other plays were chosen, he said, "to balance the season."

In Pynes's vocabulary, 'balance' is an important word. So is 'Quebec content'.

The Megantic Outlaw resulted from Pynes's wish that Theatre Lac Brome produce plays that "reflect our society,

that reflect the inherent nature of Quebec."

Pynes is an American from New York who thinks regional theatre owes it to its audience to give them something that has meaning for them, that relates to their lives in their community. Broadway shows may be bigger-sellers, but Pynes said they don't really have much to do with life in the Eastern Townships.

Although New York-Paris does not exactly sound like a little bit of Knowlton, Pynes said the revue is bilingual as one of the two characters is French (albeit from France), married to an American.

Star Peter Pringle wrote the play with co-star Kathlyn McAuliffe in mind. McAuliffe was the delightfully doomed diva in The Pinchpenny Phantom of the Opera and starred in last year's Megantic Outlaw production.

Pynes said he and Pringle wanted to work together, and they discussed possible productions together, eventually coming up with the idea of a bilingual cabaret couple crossing the ocean, bickering and performing.

With the bilingualism, Pynes said he felt there was some content for Quebec

audiences to relate to.

Groucho, A Life in Review departs from the regional approach, however. It offers Marx brothers fans a chance to relive some of the greatest moments from their movies and vaudeville acts. A combination of music and comedy, Pynes said the play seemed like a good ending to the major productions of the summer.

He said Marx Brothers fans will love it. "It uses the best bits from their work, and those who aren't big fans don't have to sit through the whole movie."

The other advantage is that the same actors who appear in The Megantic Outlaw are working in Groucho, giving the audience a chance to see them in some very different roles.

Theatre Lac Brome's summer season opens on Wednesday, June 25, with New York-Paris, and the opening gala takes place Saturday, June 28. Other events on the agenda include the House and Garden Tour on July 9 and the Midsummer Night Gala on July 27th. 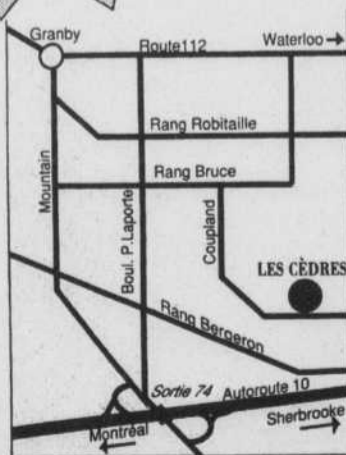

## It's wet out there in the trenches

When the weather became unbearably hot and humid last week, I did something I swore I would never, ever do. I bought both of my kids their very own water pistols.

My reasoning went something like this: it's warm out. They can chase each other around the park, squirt each other with water, cool off, have some fun and I won't have to push them on the tire swing for hours on end because they'll both be otherwise occupied.

Little did I know that most other parents on my block had the same idea. Our friendly neighborhood park has turned into a war zone, with a dozen or so pint-sized soldiers running around with loaded pistols, Super Soakers and water balloons, all of them taking or-

ders from a bossy 12 year-old water war veteran who barks out orders on how to "take down" civilians.

No man, woman or infant is safe once the cover of darkness begins to fall.

Once the pistols are loaded and ready to go, you can hear the screams of adults taking cover behind park benches, under picnic tables - some even scampering into the tube slide for safety. Forget it. You can run but you can't hide from these little warriors. After all, they average three to four feet tall and can scurry like rats over, under and into the tightest squeezes you can imagine.

I myself am not safe once I drag my children back home after 90 minutes of water combat in the park. They know

Do I regret having bought them water pistols? Well, I'll admit it makes me uneasy to hear my daughter shouting, "Shoot me! Shoot me!" in an excited squeal and I cringe when I see my son

putting the pistol in his mouth, "shooting" water down his throat. Yet in all honesty, I think the neighborhood kids understand the difference between actual violence and the harmless fun they're having with water guns. And the moment I see even one child cross the line into disrespect and truly aggressive behavior, I will pull my kids out of there and the war will be over permanently, with all sides losing.

But for now, the sun is out and my kids are in the bathroom filling up their pistols, getting ready for another scorching day in the trenches. I'm warning everyone right now: My children are armed and dangerous, so public, beware. Take no prisoners. And if you see them, remember: They are to be bathed on sight.

# Summer schedule has plenty to offer public

It's 2 a.m. and the halls are empty. Doors are locked. Classes are finished and Bishop's campus is ready to go to sleep. But, deep in the basement of the student union building, the sound of music and the smell of coffee keep a few people wide awake.

They're on the late night shift at CJMQ, 88.9 FM, Bishop's University's radio station. CJMQ is technically a student club funded by Bishop's students but its signal and fan-base go beyond the campus' borders.

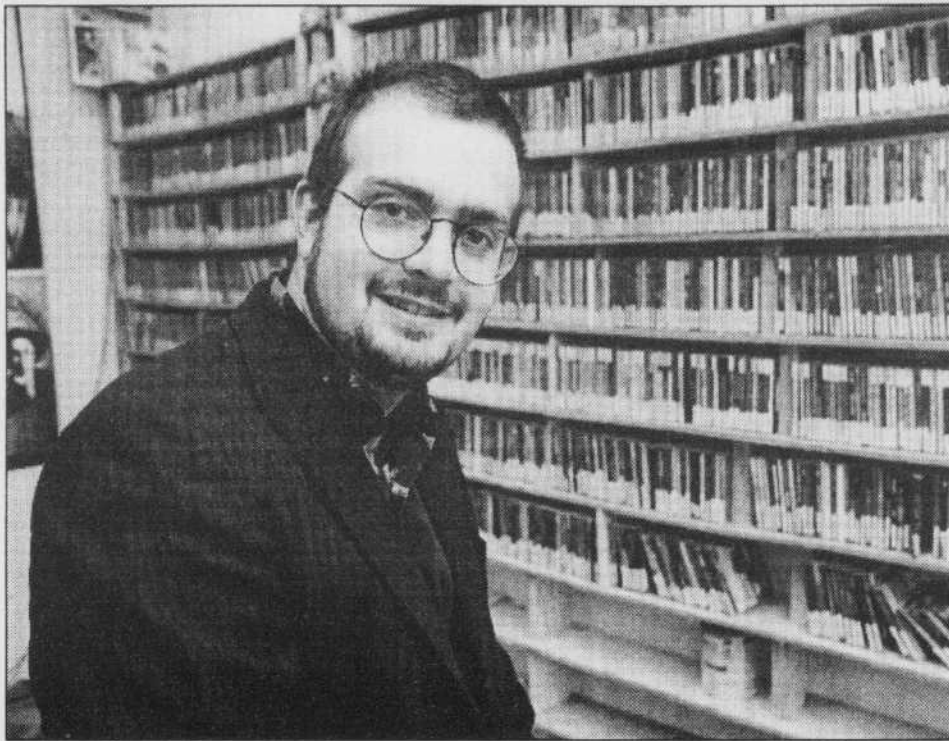
"This our first summer (operating) on the air," said station manager Matthew Shepherd, a graduate of Toronto's Ryerson Polytechnic University.

"There are a lot more community members in the summer schedule which is necessitated by the number of students that leave. The second big difference (from fall programming) is that the schedule is now being structured for listenability instead of for convenience."

Instead of last term's string of mismatched programming, the summer offers a timetable of shows organized according to genre.

"Our first priority is to be a good campus radio station for Bishop's University," declared Shepherd who has been station manager since last August.

"At the same time we're defined as a campus-community station. (Being) the only local English broadcaster in the region, (because) the CBC is mostly from Montreal and Quebec, brings along the

responsibility to be a community radio station as well. There is a very definite obligation to try to meet the needs of the English-speaking community outside of Bishop's."

One person trying to bridge that gap is Tanya Bolduc a native of Sherbrooke and Bishop's graduate. She's at the station since last fall with her morning folk-celtic show, and recently began hosting CJMQ's new "Blue Monday" time slot, part of the station's enormous 12

hour jazz music line-up from 10

a.m. - 10 p.m. Her show, "Curiosity and Jazz", started as a jazz and interview show at 4 p.m.

"I had seen a special years ago about Oscar Peterson and that's what tweaked me into jazz, said Bolduc. "I play half traditional jazz, vocal and some instrumental. The other half is Canadian jazz. I love the 4-6 p.m. spot because people are driving in their cars, to and from work. Last week, I got a call from a Wisconsin penitentiary!"

Jan Carlos Byl, a fifth-year Bishop's student, along with friend Barry Cal-

houn, co-owner of the Lennoxville Georgian Pub, follow Bolduc's show with their own "Barry and the Big Dumb Guy." Both claim to be great jazz fans, but they will admit their music genre branches out past the traditional into acid jazz and funk.

"We play a lot of Bullfrog, People Playing Music, Skyjuice: bands that have actually been to Barry's bar before," said Byl, originally from Washington.

"I grew up with a heavy rap back-

ground, very R & B, which has sort of transformed into a new-age hip-hop feel. Whenever I come across anything new, I like to bring it in. I think that a lot of the music that we play, especially the Canadian content, which is stuff that people wouldn't hear otherwise," added Calhoun, "To use Bullfrog as an example: I never would've known who they were if they hadn't come to town but what an incredible band."

Another disc jockey duo is Jessie Aulis and Annie Plante. This mother and daughter pair, host a country music show from 4-8 p.m. every Tuesday.

"I've been very hard to destroy the (image): if you listen to country music you have a pair of boots and you're supposed to stay in the barn," asserted Aulis, "It's so stupid because country music is so much more polished than it was thirty years ago."

At the opposite end of CJMQ's musical spectrum, Champlain student Nick Syrianis's "Transient Circus," heard Fridays from midnight - 2 a.m. features the best in electronic music: trans-ambient techno, minimalist classical, trip-hop and rave.

"Minimalist classical is contemporary composition, taking a certain piece and repeating it," Syrianis said, "That's why people say 'my god it's repetitive! . . . But with slight changes every time it's repeated. Anything that's made using a sampler, a synthesizer, a drum machine, a mixer, a keyboard, a computer, a sound modulator, a sound effects processor: anything that has electronic circuits and produces sound - I will play that sort of music."

CJMQ's tamer side includes William Davis's two shows. The first on Wednesday from noon - 2 p.m. which is a french spoken-word show called "Englishman in Sherbrooke" about various community social groups, and the second show, "the Café du Palais Drive to the Weekend," helps promote musical acts coming to Sherbrooke.

"We've had (on the show) the federally funded Project Access which tries to create projects to eliminate drug abuse," told Davis, who works at a Sherbrooke youth centre.

"We're going to have the Lennoxville Youth Centre and the Association of community organizations of the Eastern Townships."

Almost anyone can apply to become a DJ through the internship training program and, since an increased number of people will be able to hear the radio station after the proposed signal boost, Shepherd expects more community members will want to become involved in the station.

# Sutton sculptor Heath enjoys challenging art

When self-taught Sutton sculptor Eddie Heath won the Grollo d'Oro International Artistic Competition in Italy two years consecutively, he caused organizers to change the regulations for this world-wide event.

"(First) it was the first time that a North American sculptor had won it, and then it was the first time in its history that a sculptor had won twice," said Heath, who won the contest in 1983 and '84.

"It bent a lot of people out of shape because sculpture is second-class to painting (there)," Heath said. "I was fortunate, they just didn't see anything better within the 45 categories."

Quite an accomplishment for a physical education teacher turned stone sculptor.

"It was both an honor and a humbling experience," he said. "There were about 250 pieces submitted from 45 countries from around the world and holy smokes, here I was."

After his second win, the governing committee of the competition changed the rules so no sculptor can win and no artist can win two years in a row.

Heath said he just fell into Grollo.

"A friend of mine who was collecting my pieces told me to send some photographs to New York for this competition, so I did. Next thing I knew, they wanted my artwork. So they sent down their packaging people and boom, it was off to Italy. Just like that."

"I was now in the big leagues," he added.

Heath's life changed with the win. He started receiving invitations from art connoisseurs worldwide and decided to accept one from a Dominican priest in Malta. Father Mario Zerafa, a museum director, was a leading Renaissance expert who authenticated renaissance paintings.

Father Zerafa helped give Heath the confidence he needed.

"He was not a fan of abstract work," Heath said. "He didn't like my form but he liked how I used the stone. I was pushing the stone to a limit where I was comfortable. But other sculptors weren't at ease with my work."

Heath learned his art while working with the Artigianos, a group of skilled native Italian craftsmen - who work only in stone - in Pietra Santa, an artistic community not far from Carrara in Italy where numerous marble quarries are situated.

"I went there to buy some tools and ended up staying there on and off for about three-and-a-half years," he said. "I found two of the best Artigianos while I was looking for a studio."

They liked his work, but not his technique.

"They turned me around," he said. "They showed me how to find the grain, what was up and down in a stone. They also taught me how to choose the right stone for the right form."

While in Malta, Heath was commissioned by Father Zerafa to create a stone sculpture from limestone for the museum. And it was there, while visiting the ancient temples that he made a discovery which brought him closer to his artistic vision. It happened while visiting some of the oldest temples in the world - some 1500 years older than Stonehenge.

"I spent two weeks crawling around seven or eight temples absolutely fascinated," he said. "One particular morning at four a.m., I was sitting at the edge of this temple watching the sunrise over this huge stone - I had goose pimples."

He said the stones were arranged in a primitive manner.

"But you could see that these people took great care in what they were doing. They had to use their ingenuity to move those stones. They used their hands in a way that I hadn't looked at before. See-

ing their work humbled me. Those were detailed but very simple forms made by hand."

Seeing those magnificent stones and ancient handicraft kept Heath's vision in the abstract.

"I found my calling in the weirdest place. This helped me with keeping my lines simple but direct," he said. "When I have an idea, I go right into the stone and get it. That's where the skill is needed."

Heath said one needs more than physical strength to work with stone. "You need the determination to get what you want."

His career in the arts began in 1974 when, sensing the need for a change, he took a teaching position in Montreal.

"I was just starting to draw, so I would draw early on in the morning, teach in the afternoon and then attend drawing and painting classes as a guest in the evening," he said. "They were long days, but I enjoyed it."

In order to concentrate more on his art, Heath worked on oil rigs in the Arctic to raise the necessary funds. While in the Arctic, he met Inuit artist Jimmy Jacobs.

"Just seeing the simplicity of these people working with what they had, the simplicity of their stone sculptures, was inspiring," he said. "To me it brought the carving and the stone

arrangements together, and I needed to make that direct connection between the two."

In 1979, he moved to Sutton and mounted his first exhibition of carved driftwood pieces of birds and swans at Arts Sutton.

The exhibit was emotionally, spiritually and financially rewarding for Heath, who said he was drawn to the peace and quiet of the forests surrounding Sutton.

"It's an insular community where they have very quiet times between the ski and summer periods. Their forests have grown back to their natural state and being in them is a true experience - you don't hear the jets and helicopters flying over your head."

After that year, Heath returned to Montreal to work as a coach at Selwyn House boys' school. During this time period, he switched mediums and started working in marble and alabaster.

"In stone, you can shape a form whereas in wood, the grain and the color of the wood takes over the form," he said. "Stone takes a longer time, but you can arrive at different endings - it's more challenging. It's my medium."

When Heath returned to Sutton eight years ago, he made a decision to experiment and be free.

"I didn't have a telephone and I didn't want to be disturbed. I just wanted to absorb everything around me and let everything come out as a natural flow," he said.

Heath, who was commissioned to recreate Britain's Stonehenge on a private Iron Hill property, said stone has its own language.

"It stays consistent. I receive a comfort from the staying power of stone."

He also takes pieces of stone and arranges them in a form that has spiritual and emotional meaning.

"There's a definite artistic thought process that one goes through in balancing forms and it keeps me in the abstract expressionistic lines," he said.

Nowadays, Heath works in the forest.

"I respect it. I know when to go in and when not to and when I can take a stone out of the earth," he said. "I give reverence to every stone because they have energy."

Heath's work is a reflection of what he sees every day. It can be with a painting or a marble or wood carving.

"If you're true to yourself, your artistic expression will be an honest statement that will be accepted by all levels of society," he said.

"I love what I'm doing. There's no question about it."

# Canada's Duane Steele loves life on the road

**D**uane Steele didn't have the easiest task at the Ottawa Civic Center opening a show for David Lee Murphy and Canadian songbird Terri Clark.

Warming up a crowd can sometimes be very hard but Steele handled it like the pro he is. In no time country music fans were singing along and enjoying his excellent performance.

Steele is a talented singer-songwriter but also a warm, easy-going person as I discovered in his dressing room a few hours before the show.

Born on October 5, 1962, Steele started singing, playing and writing early and didn't give up.

He formed the group Northern Sunrise with friends and cousins at 14. "We played every wedding dance in the Northeast for four years straight. I think growing up that way sparked me and the bug bit me big time" recalled the artist.

"We almost made a record, we cut five or six things I'd co-written at the time. To listen to them now, it's hilarious, I sounded like a little kid" said Steele. "Music was pretty much always my focus, though I'd always threaten to go off and do other things."

After getting fired from a bar band, this native of Hines Creek, Alberta, spent time as a forestry surveyor in Northern Alberta: but music was still on his mind. In December 1982, Steele lost everything when his house burned to the ground.

"All that I salvaged was a guitar and a violin of my Dad's. I'll take that for what it was - a good omen," the singer said of the disaster that made him realize that music was indeed in the cards for him. After that things slowly started rolling with his career.

A recording deal with Mercury/Polydor brought a good debut album titled P.O. Box 423 which is also one of the songs on the recording.

"P.O.Box 423 is a unique title for an album but we liked it and we also made it the fan mailing address in Nashville" said Steele.

Although the album is not distributed in the U. S., there's hope for the next one.

"I moved to Nashville almost four years ago where I write songs for a major publisher and it brings me support in that it gives me a chance to develop my career on the other side of the border" said Steele.

"We're cutting a new album in June and we'll approach the label once more down there. It should be ready by fall and we hope that it will work out," said the "Stuck On Your Love" singer.

Should fans expect the same type of work from this sophomore effort?

"The new album will stylistically be pretty much the same, but with more of

Duane Steele's songs, He says.

"Everything and anything can inspire a song, they come from all sort of places, and life in general provides topics for songs. I often co-wrote so all it takes is that one of us comes out with a catchy line and a song is on the way" he continued.

Although the artist is excited about going 'in studio' to record the new

album, he said he will miss life on the road and is planning to return as soon as the work is over.

"I really enjoy being on the road. I've been playing my music live all my life and I've spent a lot of time travelling. I'm not married right now so it gives me the freedom to do it. I also get to go in Northern Alberta two or three times a year to visit with my family" said Steele.

"Once the bug is in you, it's there all the time" said the tall Canadian singer explaining the way he feels about life on the road. His love for meeting new people and new fans is obvious.

As a Canadian writer in Music City, Steele's songwriting has been cross-pollinated. "Songwriters come from different places, were brought up with different beliefs, in some cases, a whole different life in general... I say, throw it all in a big bowl and mix it up!"

After all, he reasons, love is the same anywhere and if you talk about feelings, they're similar wherever you are and whether you are Canadian or American.

Steele is a dynamic bandleader who lives for his music, he's seen his share of buses, motels and honky-tonks. He's a multi-talented performer who does his own thing without trying to be someone else and no easy comparisons can be made.

Shaw's colleagues steal the show

## Annual festival offers perfect variety of plays

The Shaw Festival specializes exclusively in the plays of George Bernard Shaw and his contemporaries (1856-1950) - plays about the beginning of the modern world. Ian Gaskell, a drama professor at Bishop's University, recently returned from the festival. This is part one of a two-part series on this year's festival.

The subject of Mrs. Warren's Profession, written by Shaw in 1894, so shocked late Victorian sensibilities that the play was not licensed for public presentation until 30 years later. Mrs. Warren's profession is prostitution.

We are all prostitutes - that's what capitalism means. And as Shaw would have it, there is no moral difference between a high-society marriage based on money and the commercial transaction between a streetwalker and her client. The fact that one is seen as a good match and the latter vilified as shameful is hypocrisy.

### FALLEN WOMAN

The hypocrisy manifested itself in the theatrical convention that the "fallen woman" could only be portrayed as a remorseful, guilty creature fated to commit suicide in the last act. Shaw's resolution, however, has Mrs. Warren, the proprietor of a string of successful brothels, marching bravely out to live comfortably on the avails of prostitution.

The Festival Theatre production, directed by Tadeusz Bradecki and designed by Leslie Frankish, foregoes the

solid late Victorian world and replaces it with a patently artificial stage reality. Done with music hall drops and a

bridging quartet of singers exhibiting the work ironically as a censored piece of scurrilous theatre, this interpretation has more of Bertold Brecht than Shaw.

Shaw is to Brecht as socialism is to Marxism - it is mostly a matter of degree. Like Brecht, Shaw in his own way "alienates" - takes the familiar and makes us see it in a different way. Both believe in the didactic power of theatre, but Brecht's techniques are not easily adaptable to what is in essence a drawing room drama. The effect of this staging is to replace the essential sub-

versiveness of Shaw's piece with overt propaganda.

Does it work? Well, yes, it's something like the curate's egg "good in parts." In the rather underlit second act interior, and in the music hall quartet's straining after significance, the concept becomes irritating and seems at odds with the play. But in the final scene, the stage image conforms wonderfully to the message - the grey impenetrable surround of capitalism imposing itself on the small fragile world of human relationships.

Strong performances propel the action. Nora McLellan's somewhat histrionic Mrs. Warren is nicely balanced by Jan Alexandra Smith's incisive interpretation of her respectable and accomplished daughter, Vivie. If their final confrontation didn't quite reach the expected climax, we can blame Shaw's rather wordy conclusion.

The rest of the cast, especially Norman Browning as the vile Sir George Crofts, performed with the precision expected of this fine company.

### THE TWO MRS. CARROLLS

At the Festival's Royal George Theatre, a delightful proscenium style auditorium, Martin Vale's *The Two Mrs. Carrolls* receives a tight, visually pleasing production at the hands of director Joseph Ziegler and his designers. As light summer entertainment, this play is an excellent choice, showcasing the company's acknowledged brilliance in tight ensemble performance.

A model of subtle acting and careful pacing, the production achieves what it sets out to do. This is a thriller which enforces a real suspension of disbelief. Put simply, the production engages its audience. And in spite of the playwright's suspect plot manipulations, the action becomes entirely convincing and gripping.

David Schurman as the self-absorbed artist and Laurie Paton as his increasingly paranoid wife are particularly strong in a flawless cast.
