Bonheur d'hiver brings art to the people

This year's fifth annual Winter Art Invitational Bonheur d'hiver 2004 is an event which brings together a variety of works by 11 talented artists and artisans from the Townships.

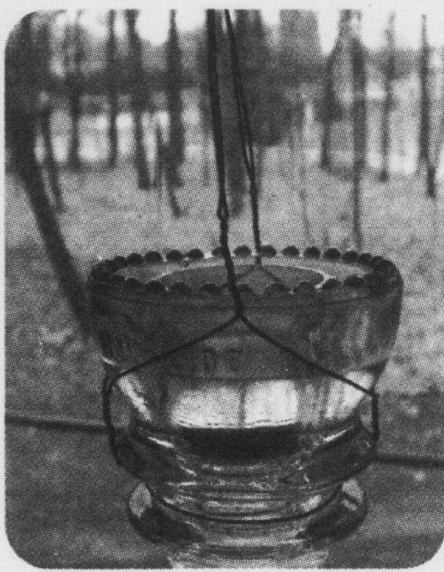
"We approached each of them to show as a group," said Annie Duriez, director of the Uplands Cultural and Heritage Centre in Lennoxville. "They don't necessarily know who each other are. They could be established artists, or they could just be starting out. I'm thrilled to be able to show them off."

Duriez pointed out there isn't a chosen theme for the show.

"The pieces we're showing reflect a diversity of talent through many different mediums. They don't have particular ties to winter or Christmas, however, everything is on sale which would surely make unique Christmas gifts," Duriez said.

Artists on exhibit include: Melanie Authier (St-Lambert), Tammy Bailey and Gilles Guimond (Cookshire), Suzanne Couture (Lennoxville), Noel Fontaine (Otterburn Park), George Foster (Ayer's Cliff), Margo Godin (North Hatley), Réjane McDonald (Sherbrooke), Jacques Maréchal (Sherbrooke), Maria Pop (Rock Forest), Jocelyne Poupart (Sherbrooke), et Heather Sampson (Bonsecour).

"I'm so excited, I've never participated in a show of this nature before," said Bai-

ley. "It's so local and close to home. Uplands has such a beautiful setting which fits right in with our furniture, as we are both working to preserve our history."

About a dozen of Bailey and husband Gilles' benches will be at the show.

"Some are Germanic style and some are traditional American style that are based on Upper Canadian style," Bailey said. "The early to mid-19th Century is where we get our inspiration."

Bailey adds they try to stay as close to the originals as possible by staying true to traditional colours, as pallets were limited back then.

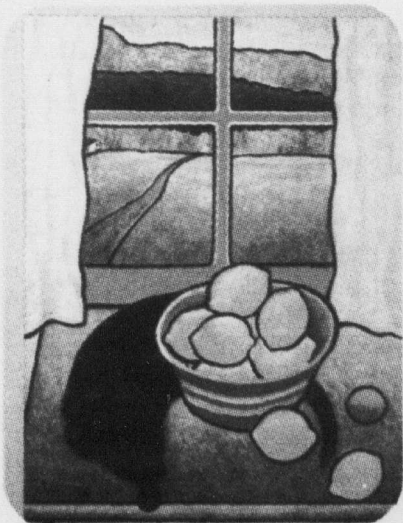
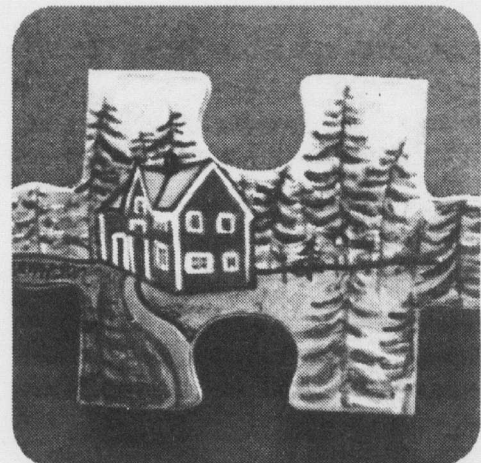
"Sometimes we work with milk paints, which is a mixture of limestone and dehydrated milk which comes in a powdered form," Bailey said. "They're very earthy tones."

Peinture sur vaisselle is another art form to be appreciated at the show.

Artist Jocelyne Poupart said it's a ceramic workshop she stumbled across while visiting Australia in 1997 which inspired her work.

"I learned many techniques there, but I've developed my own style since. It's all about visual textures and bright

Treat your better half to breakfast in bed

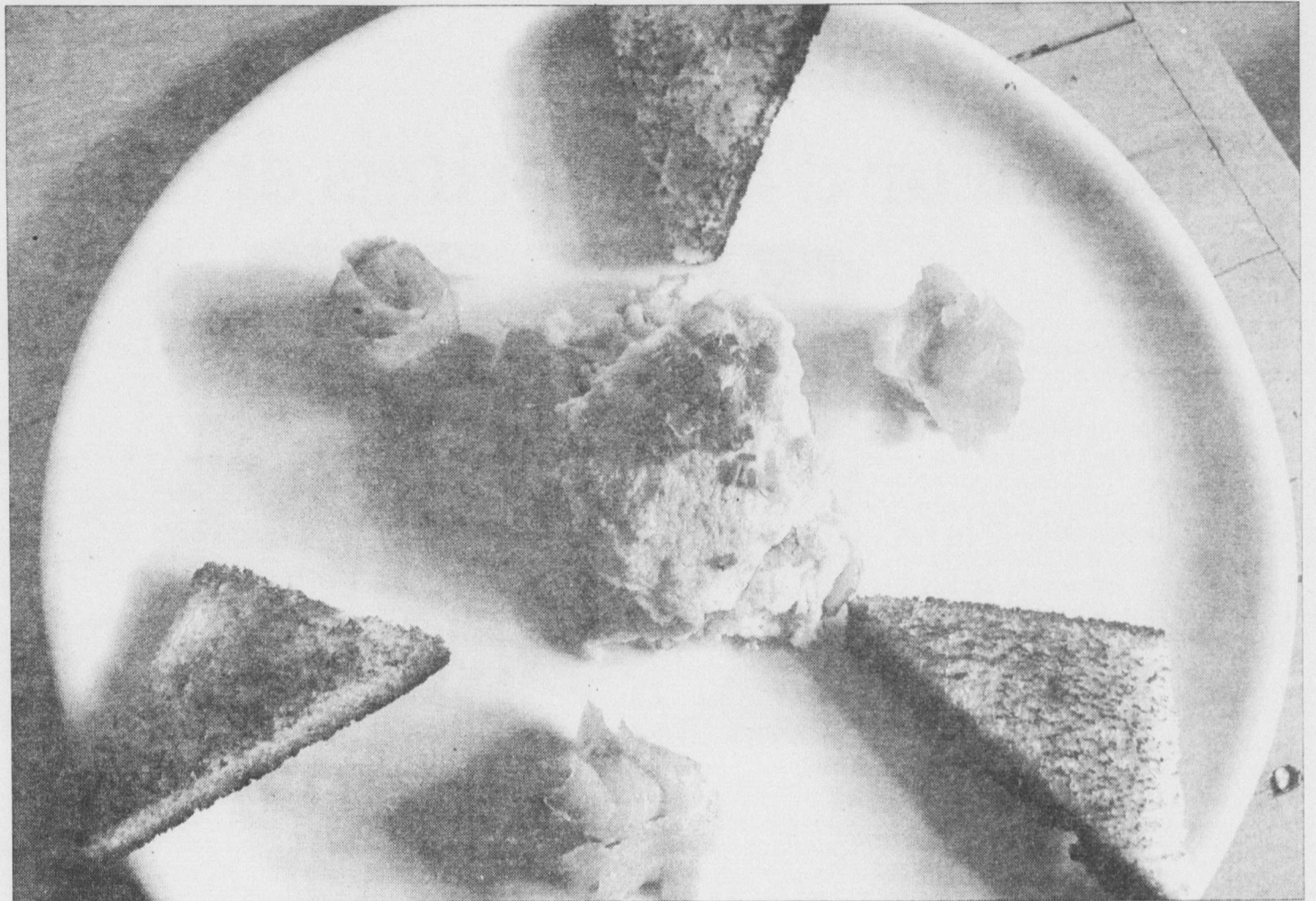
With days getting shorter and that November lethargy taking over, it is only too natural to spend more time under the comfort of our covers. That is what inspired me to tell you about an almost too simple breakfast recipe of mine: eggs soufflé.

If you read below, it will sound like plain ol' scrambled eggs — and it is. The only difference is in the silky puffiness of these eggs, beaten into a cloud before they hit the frying pan. Heavenly, I promise, and definitely worth the extra five minutes you'll have to spend whisking those whites. As for the smoked salmon, it is optional, of course. As are the toast points, which give this dish an elegant edge.

I remember those very rare occasions when my parents served caviar at home, always with crème fraîche, finely chopped hard-boiled eggs and toast points! We would mockingly eat them with our right pinky up in the air, imitating ladies who lunch. Serving the full combo — cloud of buttery eggs, toast points and salmon rosettes — to your better half in bed will somehow transport you two, even if for a moment, to a five-star hotel suite.

EGGS SOUFFLÉ WITH SMOKED SALMON AND TOAST POINTS

Ingredients (for two):
2 eggs
6 slices smoked salmon
2 tbsp. butter
3 slices white bread
Salt
White pepper
1 bunch ciboulette

Directions: Separate yolks and whites. Beat whites with a whisk until they triple in volume. Gently fold the yolks into the whites, mixing until fully incorporated. Add salt and pepper. Finely chop the ciboulette.

Roll up the salmon slices into a shape resembling a rose bud (rosette) and place them around the edges of two large plates (three on each). Toast the bread. With a serrated knife, cut off the crusts and discard. Cut slices in half, diagonally. Place three toast points on each plate, leaving the space in the centre for the eggs.

Melt the butter in a non-stick frying pan. Pour the eggs into the pan and cook them on low heat, until set — be very careful not to overcook them! Put half of the eggs soufflé in the center of each plate, sprinkle the chopped ciboulette on top, and serve at once, with a glass of OJ.

Chicken wings with twists

Every year I get a request for new chicken wings recipes. It's obvious this tasty little snack is a popular choice. Today, I present three flavourful wing recipes that quickly vanished from my serving tray when my dinner guests dug into them.

CURRY ALMOND WINGS

Curry paste and ground almonds give these wings an intriguing, South-east Asian-style taste.

Preparation time: 15 minutes

Cooking time: 25-35

Makes: 24 wings

24 chicken wingettes or drumettes
1/3 cup (75 mL) curry paste
1-1 1/2 (250 mL - 375 mL) cups ground almonds and lime wedges for garnish

Directions: Preheat the oven to 425 F (220 C). Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Place the wings in a bowl. Add the curry paste and toss to coat the wings. Place ground almonds in a shallow-sided dish.

Set a wing in the almonds, roll to

coat and then set on the baking sheet. Repeat with the remaining wings. Bake 25-35 minutes, turning once during cooking, or until cooked through. Arrange on a platter and garnish and squeeze with lime.

LEMON, CRACKED PEPPER AND SEA SALT WINGS

Three bold flavours give these wings a very pleasing, I can't stop at one, taste.

Preparation time: 10 minutes

Cooking time: 25-35 minutes

Makes: 24 wings

24 chicken wingettes or drumettes
3 tablespoons (50 mL) olive oil
1 tablespoon (15 mL) grated lemon zest
1 tbs (15 mL) cracked black pepper
1 tablespoon (15 mL) coarse sea salt

Directions: Preheat the oven to 425 F (220 C). Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Place the wings in a bowl and toss with the olive oil, lemon zest, pepper and sea salt. Arrange the wings on a baking sheet. Drizzle any oil and seasonings left in the bowl over top. Bake 25-35 minutes, or until cooked

through. Arrange on a platter and serve.

TEXAS-STYLE DRY BARBECUE WINGS

Make these tasty wings more or less spicy by increasing, or decreasing, the amount of cayenne pepper used.

Preparation time: 10 minutes

Cooking time: 25-35 minutes

Makes: 24 wings

1 tablespoon (15 mL) chili powder
2 tsp (10 mL) ground cumin
1/2 tsp (2 mL) paprika
1/2 tsp (2 mL) oregano
1/2 tsp (2 mL) salt
1/2 tsp (2 mL) ground black pepper
1/4 teaspoon (1 mL) cayenne pepper
1 teaspoon (5 mL) sugar
24 chicken wingettes or drumettes

Directions: Preheat the oven to 425 F (220 C). Line baking sheet with parchment paper. Combine all ingredients, except the wings, in a bowl. Add wings and toss to coat.

Arrange the wings on a baking sheet. Bake 25-35 minutes, or until cooked through. Arrange on a platter, serve.

Dance company Running Wild in Lenn

Dana Gingras believes that the things you experience in life are tattoos that mark you.

"There are stories our body has to tell," says the choreographer and founder of the critically acclaimed Holy Body Tattoo dance company. "There are memories trapped in the body and your unique experiences are sacred."

Gingras and her partner Noam Gagnon are bringing Holy Body Tattoo's latest production, *Running Wild*, to Centennial Theatre at Bishop's University on Nov. 30.

For those who are familiar with Holy Body Tattoo's works, *Running Wild* is a departure from the big lights, big sound, big multi-media performances that audiences have come to know.

"It's totally stripped down," Gingras says. "It's a collection of short works with solos and duets. We wanted to be able to take the show anywhere so that we could add or take things out. It's different for us."

What remains, however, are the emotions that come out through Gingras'

and Gagnon's performance.

"All our shows in a sense deal with love, loss, longing, desire, becoming consumed," Gingras says. "There's a sense of passion and the push and pull of the negotiation that comes through that passion. But the new territory for *Running Wild* is the moments of lyricism."

Gingras says instead of the driving edge of multimedia onstage, *Running Wild* focuses on the body and how movement coming from every day gestures break down into performance language.

Holy Body Tattoo was founded in 1993 after Gingras and Gagnon met each other at a dancing competition in Vancouver. Gingras says they got along right away.

"We felt like outsiders, that we didn't quite fit in, so there was this complicity with each other," she says.

She adds that they have a good dancing relationship where they are able to challenge each other.

"It's a shifting, back and forth between each other creatively."

Gingras says she and Gagnon don't see themselves as purely a dance company.

"We're inspired by film, music, text, projection," she says. "There's lots of layers of choreography. We aren't a traditional company."

This is the third visit Holy Body Tattoo has made to Lennoxville, performing *Circa* and *Our Brief Eternity* previously.

"We're lucky because we get to travel," says Gingras, who's been touring for eight years. "But more than a vacation, we are doing what we love. It's very stimulating."

Gingras and Gagnon will have two guest dancers, Day Elesic and Blair Neufeld.

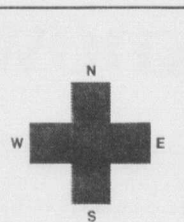

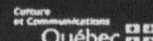
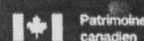

Hynes going back to the basics

If it's true that jazz is the purest form music can take, pianist Michael Hynes' take on it is both essential and elementary. If nothing else, the eclectic Hynes likes to stay close to sound, especially when he's the one making it.

"We have already divorced ourselves from music by using those machines," he says referring to his instruments, which he perceives more as impediments than tools.

Music, the very nature of sound, courses through Hynes' bones as he speaks, as he rattles off interspersed concepts as faits accomplis. He is a generous blend of technical musician and musical talent, as unlikely an amalgam as one could find in this Townships village, struggling to become even quainter than it ever could be.

Listening to the two recordings Hynes produced, Chamber music chansons sans voix (1996) and Four (1997) is like listening to the sound of a primal cry being fired across stellar dimensions that most of us are unable to grasp.

Perhaps the problem is just that, Hynes' music need not be listened to but simply enjoyed in its complexity.

His compositions hold nothing of Dizzy Gillespie's arrhythmia. In them you'll find none of those comforting albeit fundamentally pelvic rhythms woven into Ella Fitzgerald's archetypal vocalizing. Nor is his music expected.

He remains aloof, impossible to anticipate either in mood or musical gender which leaves the listener with little else than an inane ability to interpret the sounds Hynes forces out of string instruments as mercilessly as he decants the essence of surprise from percussion.

Hynes is to the ears what stars are to the eyes. Problem is, is that the star to which he points may very well be the sun and thus not for the enfranchised music consumer.

His style is for those aloof nonchalants who disdain, at least superficially, the effervescent and all too predictable sludge.com that we have forced upon us daily.

If you enjoy Camille Sansom's classical strafing of jazz, if you can stand the interminable silencios fol-

lowed by rapid-fire staccatos he thrusts at you as components of a complex musical scheme, you'll love Hynes.

As difficult as his two CDs may be, they are more

akin to belligerent girls than intransigent mistresses. Yet just as we are warming to the idea that we should rent them some shelf space between Mike Olfield's tubulars and Buddy Guy's rhapsodies, Hynes is about to take us on a slow career curve.

He's about to play live in Sutton.

Au coeur du village will welcome Hynes and world renowned Hungarian flautist Ittzés Gergely on Nov. 28 at 2 and 8 p.m. and again on Nov. 30 and Dec. 1 at 8 p.m. in the salle Alec et Gérard Pelletier on Maple Street. These sessions are expected to be music from the inside out, as music was intended to be.

The combination of a strut pianist and multi-dexterous piper is as promising as any purist could ever hope for in these parts. What has been passing as live jazz recently is in for a well-merited headlong shove into the orchestra pit when Hynes breaks loose in a live improvisation recording on Wednesday evening.

But Hynes would be well advised should he envisage this venue as a giveaway. He may be well acquainted with recognition in other parts, as far as the local crowd is concerned he's "from away" and will have to earn it the hard way. Hynes will have to rebuild from the ground up.

He not only stacks an axe, he can grind it to perfection, something anyone who claims to appreciate music will be on hand to enjoy.

Also part of the flowing struggle will be recognised local names such as accordionist Agathe Genois, saxophonist Gilles Manville and percussionist Darcy Philip Gray, ensuring that the \$10 admission fee to this venture will be the week's best investment.

As far as the visuals that adorn his CDs go, Hynes has again managed well above average. The near visionary photographic talent of Julia Harris brings out more than the best Hynes has to offer. Harris' lens poetry is only surpassed by the firm grasp she has on graphics which, just as the recording studios that have captured Hynes' talent worldwide, isn't an advocate he could do without.

All in all, enjoying Hynes' jazz is not unlike eating sushi in a Studebaker; not for the unsettled. His notes can leave you as breathless as the angel's portion that blows wind right through a gaping hole in your chest.

Yes, they do know it is still Christmas

What happened to the money? Bob Geldof was a washed-up punk singer in late October, 1984. The Boomtown Rats, the band he fronted, had been without a hit for four years. But his life — and the lives of thousands of others in Africa — were about to change.

The catalyst was a BBC news show reporting from the scene of what was being called "a biblical famine" in Ethiopia. Geldof was intensely moved

by what he saw. What he did about it was brilliant.

First, Geldof wrote a charity tune, 'Do They Know It's Christmas?' with Midge Ure, the singer of Ultravox. Then, using his famous "abrasive persuasion," he got the top stars of the day — Paul McCartney, Sting, Bono, George Michael, Duran Duran, Boy George, Alison Moyet, Phil Collins, Paul Weller and Spandau Ballet among others — to record it. The supergroup was called Band Aid and the song was No. 1 in 13 countries by Christ-

mas 1984, raising more than \$18 million US.

Six months later, Geldof is on TV, pounding on a glass table: "Don't go to the pub tonight," he urges. "There are people dying now. So please, stay in and give me the f— money."

His pitch was for Live Aid, a 16-hour transatlantic show from London and Philadelphia that ultimately raised about \$80 million for famine relief. Geldof had brought together the power of rock, the immediacy of live TV, and the extremes

of human misery — a combination that caught the world's imagination.

A DVD of the Live Aid concert comes out this month, and TV shows marking the 20th anniversary of Band Aid will go on about how the rockers "fed the world" and "saved" Ethiopia.

But rock is simple, and international politics is complicated. Geldof deserves credit, but some critics are saying the mythology of Band Aid/Live Aid is not supported by the facts.

Five questions with Yvan Dagenais

Q & A

Yvan Dagenais' life as an artist has taken him down many different paths in his desire to share his passion for art. Using oils and pastels, he has created landscapes, portraits and nature scenes in a realistic format.

When he is not overseeing the gallery that he opened in North Hatley, he is busy teaching visual arts to his students at the University of Sherbrooke. His artwork has been exhibited throughout Canada and the United States in venues such as the Musée Beaulne, Festival International des Arts in Montreal, Salon International de la Peinture, and la Biennale de Paris au Grand Palais in France.

Yvan Dagenais sat down for an interview with *The Record* at his gallery in North Hatley.

THE RECORD: Would you tell us a little about your background as an artist?

DAGENAIS: "I received my degree in arts plastiques from the Cégep in Old Montreal. I studied for my bachelor of education at the University of Sherbrooke and my masters degree in arts plastiques at UQAM. I decided to open my own gallery about 10 years ago as a means of providing exposure to other artists who could use a helping hand."

THE RECORD: What helps you when you're doing portraits?

DAGENAIS: "It is through a form of non-verbal language that I first get a sense of the inner character of a subject. Even before I have actually spoken to a person, there are ways to get to know someone."

"Haven't you ever seen someone at a distance and instinctively created a mental image? It could be the trace of a smile, or lack of one at all that gives a clue into a person's true characteristics."

"I am happy with a portrait if it brings out a person's inner character as opposed to something that is merely a compilation of lines, regardless of how well they may be laid out."

THE RECORD: How would you explain the expression 'looking at something with an artist's eye'?

DAGENAIS: "To me, it refers to the ability to understand the depths or intricacies of what you are seeing, not just the main outline or top layer. While many artists have to go to school to learn how to be able to do this, many others are born with an instinct to know what will work and what will not, knowing how much or how little to add. I think it is the same with other artists as well - each in their own domain."

THE RECORD: Why do you believe the life of an artist is an endless frustration?

DAGENAIS: "You could work for years

at perfecting your craft but never reach a level of total recognition. Those that do reach the higher echelon of the world of art are as limited in some ways as those who are much more low key and sell only a few of their works."

"Artists with a high visibility usually find their works restricted to top grade galleries but their work is now less accessible to the ordinary person."

"If you think about it, many artists, who were considered great in their time, are rarely heard of now and many of those who received negative comments from the critics are now highly acclaimed worldwide, like Monet."

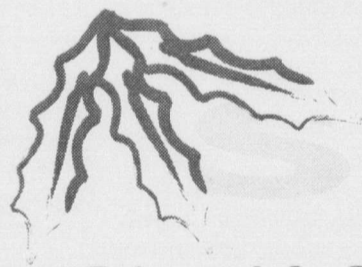
THE RECORD: If you were to put aspects of your life in order of importance, what would you say?

DAGENAIS: "I would say that it is an impossible thing to ask me to do. I approach my life as I do when I look at a work of art. A painting is made up of a series of lines and movements but each has its own importance in time - a never ending circle. For me, a person's life is exactly the same - constantly juggling all aspects whether it be my family life, my work as a teacher, a gallery owner or an artist. Each has its own place in the scheme of things."

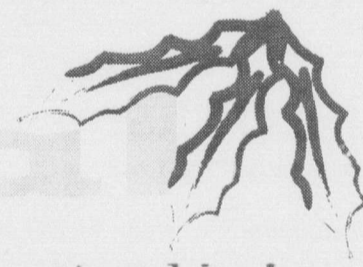

The Hip to join Canadian Music HOF *Music*

The Tragically Hip will be inducted into the Canadian Music Hall of Fame in the same city that saw them fired from a gig during their first tour outside their native Ontario.

The Kingston, Ont., rock band will receive the nation's top musical honour as part of the 2005 Juno Awards ceremonies in Winnipeg this April, the Canadian Academy of Recording Arts & Sciences announced Tuesday.

"Do we get a watch or something?" joked guitarist Rob Baker as cameras flashed at the MTS Centre, Winnipeg's new downtown arena, where the Hip were slated to perform Tuesday night. "I just want people to know our new album is important and we're looking forward to the future. We're not retiring!"

In 1988, before the Tragically Hip became a household Canadian name, a now-defunct Winnipeg bar called the Diamond Club fired the straight-ahead rock band for not playing cover tunes by American hit-makers.

Of course, the Hip went on to sell more than six million albums, win 11 Juno Awards and gross millions in concert-ticket revenues — all the while dis-

playing a distinctive Canadian cultural identity.

On Tuesday, CARAS president Melanie Berry lauded the quintet composed of singer Gord Downie, guitarists Baker and Paul Langlois, drummer Johnny Fay and bassist Gord Sinclair for creating its own sound and transcending musical stereotypes.

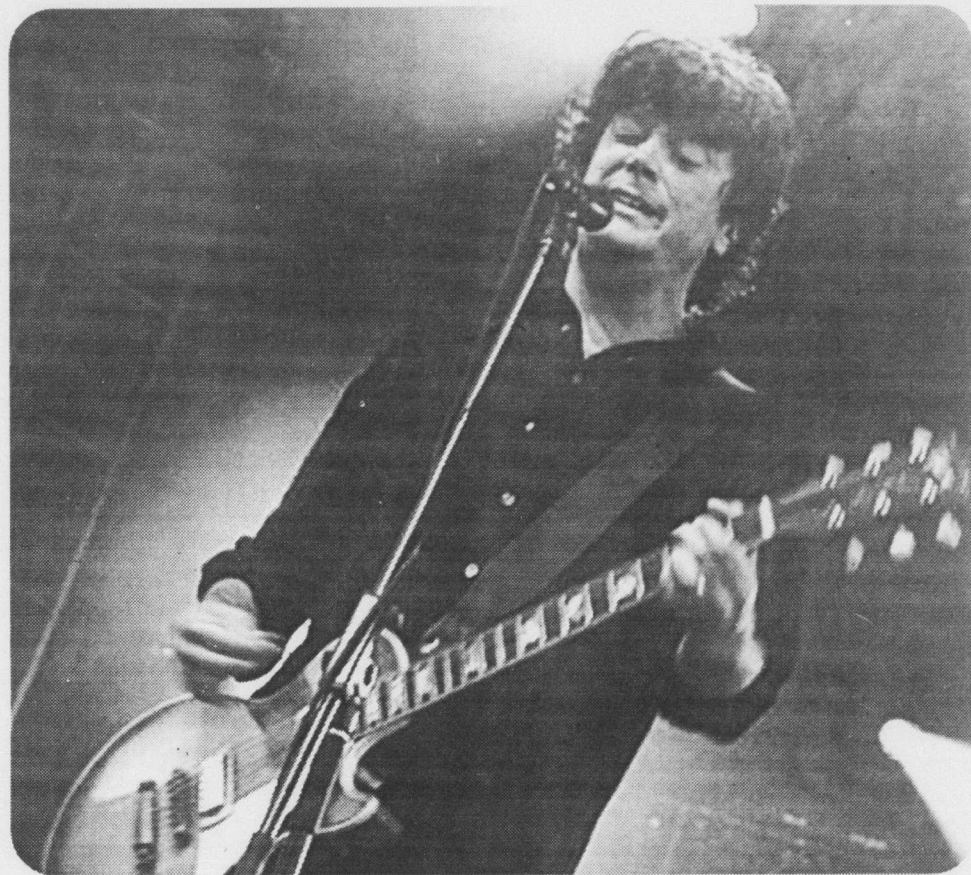
"It's a funny thing for a group like us," said Sinclair. "We've always had a narrow focus on a specific project, whether it's a recording or a tour.

"We've never given much thought to our career as a whole. Clearly, we're at a juncture in our career where people want to look back. But we're looking forward. We're already planning to go back into the studio next year."

The Hip will be inducted into the Canadian Music Hall of Fame on Saturday, April 2, at the Winnipeg Convention Centre as part of the non-televized 2005 Juno Awards gala. The band will also be honoured at the CTV-televized Juno Awards show at the MTS Centre on Sunday, April 3.

Previous Hall of Fame inductees include Neil Young, the Guess Who, Joni Mitchell, Glenn Gould and Anne Murray.

colours," Poupart said. "I don't actually make the pottery itself. I do the painting, engraving, and decorating on cups, teapots, plates, bowls — you name it."

This is also the first time her work has been displayed at Uplands.

"It's an honour to have my work showed here," said Poupart.

Duriez hopes everyone will take the opportunity to visit Bonheur d'Hiver 2004 to not only support the artists, but the Centre itself.

"It's always free to visit," said Duriez. "We encourage people to take ownership of that. Revisit this wonderful home, which was preserved for the community, or discover it for the first time."

Uplands will be closed from Dec. 20 to Feb. 6, 2005.

Daniel Wolf, writing in *The Spectator*, points out that although there was a severe drought in the area, the "biblical famine" was a military tactic carried out by the Dergue government of Col. Haile Mariam Mengistu.

Mengistu was fighting three wars (in Tigray and Eritrea in the north, and in the Oromo lands in the south). The dictator used food as a weapon of war — bombing crops and markets, and setting up roadblocks to block the movement of food. Mengistu's methods were bound to create famine, and they did.

While Live Aid and Band Aid grabbed the media attention, they funded only a small proportion of the aid effort: 90 per cent or more came from Western donor governments.

In a terrible irony, roughly 90 per cent of the aid would pass through Mengistu's hands because Western governments would only deal with a recipient government — not with rebel movements.

As Wolf says, people who gave Geldof "the f— money" found themselves supporting "the very government that was causing the famine we were supposed to be alleviating."

Mengistu largely determined where the aid was distributed, and much of the food aid in Tigray — the epicentre of the famine — went to his armies.

In 1984-85, up to a \$1 billion in aid flowed to Ethiopia. Mengistu made sure the thousands of

aid workers and reporters who flew in converted their Western dollars to the local currency at a rate favourable to the government.

In 1985, Mengistu tripled the country's foreign currency reserves, using the cash to build up his war machine. Meanwhile, the army routinely commandeered aid vehicles for its own purposes, taking whatever aid supplies it wanted.

Nobody knows for sure how many lives were saved, says Wolf, or what happened to people after they left the aid camps.

This much is certain: The war went on for six more years, claiming many thousands more lives.

Band Aid/Live Aid was rock's most glorious moment — but it was also, in Wolf's words, "a badly flawed exercise."

A new version of the Band Aid record is being recorded this month, 20 years after the original topped the charts. This time Ure and Geldof have signed up Coldplay, the Darkness and Robbie Williams, ignoring the likes of McCartney and Bowie. The single will be released in time for Christmas with the original version as the B side. Once again, the money goes to famine relief in Ethiopia and Sudan.

"Musicians tend to be idealists," Sting says in the current *Vanity Fair*. "A song can plant the seed of an idea in the minds of the people who hear it."

True enough. But maybe this Christmas, rock's idealists will think harder about how to help the starving.

Charlie Haden's Land of the Sun promises more of a good thing. A few years back, the bassist released Nocturne, a standout CD of Cuban ballads that mixed tenderness, sophistication and jazz soloing. You won't likely know Marroquin's compositions before hearing them, but they are affecting in Haden's caring hands. Arranged by pianist Gonzalo Rubalcaba, who has a gossamer touch at the keyboard, the disc's 10 tracks are classy, moonlit affairs, coloured by flute, trumpet and saxophones. On Land of the Sun, saxophonist Joe Lovano and Rubalcaba return to add depth to the dreaminess, but other players make less of an impression.

MICHAEL BRECKER, DAVE LIEBMAN, JOE LOVANO Saxophone Summit: Gathering of Spirits (Telarc)

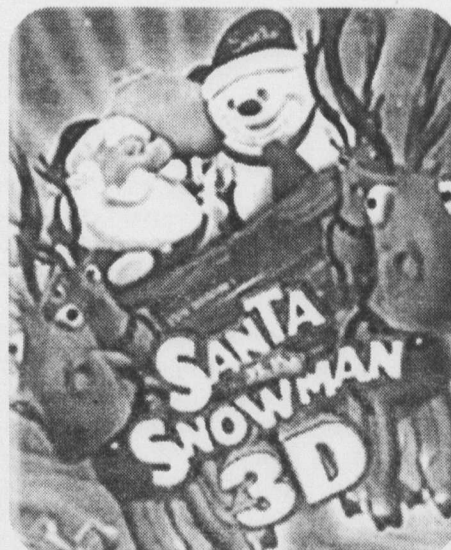

JFK's consistent policy

Who hasn't heard the comment that, under George W. Bush, America's foreign policy has become more aggressive and interventionist?

Such a conclusion leads us to think that the actions of the current administration are abnormal compared to what happened in previous administrations. Along the way, this criticism tends to overstep the legacy of Theodore Roosevelt, who was never afraid to intervene militarily to achieve the goals of his international vision.

It also passes under silence the actions of Ronald Reagan, who put his money where his mouth was, whether about the situation in Latin America or in Eastern Europe, particularly in support of the Polish Solidarity movement in the 1980s.

But Republicans were not the only ones to practice such a conduct. Woodrow Wilson did the same in Mexico. Most recently, John F. Kennedy, whose brutal death we commemorate this week, also articulated a policy with a similar armature.

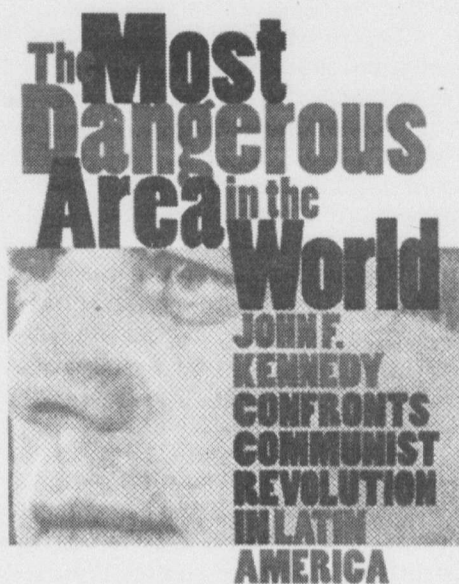
If the Bay of Pigs, the Missiles of October and the Berlin Crisis easily come to mind when we evoke the legacy of this president in foreign policy, we often forget his famous "Alliance for Progress" towards Latin America.

In a very well-documented and eloquently written book, *The Most Dangerous Area in the World: John F. Kennedy Confronts Communist Revolution in Latin America*, historian Stephen G. Rabe explains the origins, the development and the fate of this program.

In March 1961, the 35th president announces in a speech his intention to curb poverty, illiteracy and social injustice in this area of the world. Many efforts were supposed to be invested to promote development and democracy to that end.

Nevertheless, as Rabe points out, "a tension between the administration's call for middle-class revolution and its search for an anti-communist stability," soon proved disadvantageous for the "Alliance for Progress."

The Kennedy administration often-

times had to choose between supporting democratic movements which might prove to be sympathetic to the communist ideology or other vectors whose priority was not democracy but who supported Washington in its quest for a victory over Fidel Castro and Soviet premier Nikita S. Khrushchev.

Of course, JFK supported certain democratic regimes in Latin America, such as Rómulo Betancourt in Venezuela. This said, Washington could also manifest a tendency to align itself with opposition parties which were closer to its intentions.

Such was the case in Chile, where the Christian Democratic Party received sup-

port from the United States in its opposition to president Alessandri, who had disappointed the expectations of the Americans. Along the way, the United States also offered military assistance to some countries, thus cautioning the position of the armed forces in the political life of these nations.

More than everything, JFK and his entourage didn't want to compose with a second Cuba in Washington's hemisphere. In the end, "the fear of communism frequently tempered the administration's zeal for peaceful revolution in the Caribbean." After all, just before JFK's arrival in the White House, Khrushchev made a speech in which he declared support for national liberation movement around the planet.

In reaction, JFK and his entourage naturally envisioned favourably to support counterinsurgency doctrines.

The author comes to the conclusion that the "Alliance for Progress" was a "notable policy failure in the 1960s, superseded only by the U.S. debacle in Vietnam," notably because Latin America didn't end up in a bet-

ter condition because of that policy.

It is easy for us to observe, today, that the Soviet Union probably had no intention — and most certainly no capability — to exercise its muscles in Latin America. But in the context of the harsh confrontation which prevailed between Moscow and Washington in those days, the potential danger that another revolution might take place in Latin America was no fantasy.

JFK, the man who had criticized both his predecessors — Truman and Eisenhower — for their incapacity to prevent communist victories in China and Cuba, absolutely couldn't afford a similar situation to occur under his watch. JFK, the consistent anti-communist, took steps to prevent it. Much like Ronald Reagan later, he put his money where his mouth was.

Alexander was a big challenge for Farrell

There are still glimpses of the rough Dublin street kid when Colin Farrell saunters into view. He needs a shave and could use a haircut. The wine-coloured shirt is unbuttoned far enough to give a full view of the mass of jewelry clanking about his neck.

The sleeves are rolled up sufficiently to expose the tattoos on his left arm — one saying *Carpe Diem* (Seize The Day), the other showing a black cross. Other defining impressions: the gleam of an earring, the glass of red wine that he carries defiantly into this press session, the package of Camels that he toys with ceaselessly until he finally surrenders to the weed and lights up in this no-smoking hotel suite, his habit of addressing women reporters as “Babe.”

There are also signs of a more polite and introspective Colin Farrell, an actor who cares about his craft and who is determined to respond thoughtfully to questions about the challenge of playing Alexander The Great in Oliver Stone's eagerly awaited new movie about the legendary warrior who had conquered nearly all the known world by the time he was 25. And really, there are several Colin Farrells on view this afternoon — including the one who still comes out with the four-letter words which frustrate reporters anxious to quote him and who is unrepentant about his hard-drinking carousing image, and the Colin Farrell whose on-screen charisma has made him one of the most acclaimed actors of his generation.

As always, he's forthright — stressing at the outset that his role in Alexander was no breeze.

“It's maybe the toughest thing I'll ever do. God, yeah, by a mile. Never say never, it's such a huge story. There's not going to be many parts that pop up like it.”

He struggles to analyze the complex psychology of this youthful hero from the pre-Christian era and the emotional forces behind his successful leadership of a Greek and Macedonian army which seized Western Asia from the seemingly indestructible Persian forces.

“You need to find somewhere in you that can believe what he believed and

can believe that the things he believed to be possible are possible. You have to find something in yourself that can agree with his philosophies. I read a lot about him. I thought a lot about him.

“I fell in love with him in many respects. I found him to have an incredibly sad life — a life filled with great glory and great promise and great achievement and massive wealth, king of the ****ing world. But I found it to be a very lonely existence. One hears stories of the isolation of leadership and how lonely it is at the top — but again, you're never going to please everybody, you're always going to have enemies.”

But Farrell can also turn blunt and profane when it comes to what promises to be the most controversial aspect of the film — Alexander's homosexuality.

The 28-year-old actor knows that back in the Third Century B.C., society had different ideas about sexual conduct, and that the word “homosexuality” didn't even exist. So he didn't think any more of this aspect of Alexander's life — in particular his intimate friendship with Hephaestion, played by Jared Leto — than he did of his turbulent relationship with his alluring wife Roxane, played by Rosario Dawson.

“I never thought of it because it wasn't thought of at the time,” he says. “It wasn't like he was in the closet.”

And although he's irritated by being asked so many questions about this, he's not surprised.

“No, of course not!” he says gruffly. “It's a ****ing, boring world we live in — so narrow-minded that they have to boil everything down to ****ing sex. Just look at my interviews.”

He's determined to be himself, to be Colin Farrell, complete with blemishes. Only on a few matters does he impose limits on his candor. For example, his current girlfriend, model Kim Bordenave, and their 14-month-old son.

“I'll say it's great to be a dad and all that stuff, but I'll never talk about my son, I never talk about his mother at all — those kinds of things.” He doesn't tell tales either: “I never talk about anyone else's business or my experiences with anyone else. I never bring anyone else

into my shit, but I've talked consistently — and at this stage repetitively — about my past experiences and what they meant at the time individually to me, and the way they happened and what happened. I've done that to death.”

Alexander, which opened Wednesday, features some draining emotional sequences, many of them stemming from his troubled relationship with his one-eyed father, Philip of Macedonia, played by Val Kilmer, and his possessive

reptile-loving mother, portrayed by Angelina Jolie. It also contains gruelling battle sequences and Farrell — who was right in the middle of the carnage — toughened up with a stint in boot camp.

“It was cool. A lot of tired boys and a lot of pissed-off boys because the food was really rationed and we were tired and working hard and jogging at six in the morning — and then doing military drills and battle formations and horse riding.”

The blues is where you find it, where is pretty well everywhere, if you look. The blues is what you play to get rid of the blues.

"Blues is not a play thing like people think they are," the venerable Son House tells the documentary cameras that are backstage at Radio City Music Hall, where the greatest living legends of the musical form are about to put on a 100th anniversary concert. "They ain't but one kind of blues and that consists of a man and a woman that's in love."

The great thing is, there are enough blues to go around for everyone, and most of them are featured in Lightning in a Bottle, a documentary by Antoine Fuqua (Training Day), who has put together a living archive, a wailing, smokey tribute to a unique musical genre.

The film takes the story from its beginnings, as represented by the silvery anthem Zelig by African-born singer Angélique Kidjo, to the Mississippi Delta, up to Chicago and right on through to its modern incarnations: Bonnie Raitt, Steve Tyler, David Johansen — the artist also known as Buster Poindexter — Macy Gray and a hip-hoppish version of

'Boom Boom' by Chuck D that verges on downright rock and roll. The blues are nothing if not malleable.

Lightning In A Bottle is a history lesson of sorts, supplemented by a little archival footage that is both horrifying — black and white photos of lynchings to an eerie interpretation of 'Strange Fruit' by India Arie — or just evocative — scenes from a sharecropper village to illustrate Buddy Guy's story of how he made his own guitars from screen windows and an old lighter fluid can. Later, we see Jimi Hendrix at a Buddy Guy concert, soaking up the act and the sound.

Mostly it's just the music: Dozens of artists taking to the stage at the Feb. 6, 2003, concert for a chronological trip up the Mississippi, culminating in two songs by B.B. King, who still draws from his guitar Lucille an ethereal twang that is unmistakable.

Some of the performances are haunting: James "Blood" Ulmer's version of 'Sittin' On Top of the World,' a spaced-out rumble so dark it is almost psychedelic; or 75-year-old Ruth Brown, whose rehearsals with the excellent house band (which includes Dr. John on piano) is interrupted by Odetta, who doesn't like the way her friend has been treated.

"I do not know why this woman, this brilliant woman, has to compete with the band," she scolds, effectively lowering the volume on the speakers.

There are oddities as well: Brown, Natalie Cole and Mavis Staples sing 'Men Are Like Streetcars' as Bill Cosby sits at a table set up on stage and mugs.

Johansen's version of 'Killin' Floor' is a hypnotically watchable cabaret of modern attitude and ancient chords. Aerosmith's Steve Tyler seems both out of place and at home, a rock star rediscovering his harmonica chops.

Throughout, Fuqua tries to keep the mood intimate with subdued lighting and close-ups that replicate some of the feeling of a small club.

Lightning In A Bottle tends to wear down as it wears on: the earlier performances are grittier, more authentic and



more watchable, although this may depend on your tolerance for the electric guitar and the introduction of rhythm into rhythm and blues.

It gets more raucous the more distant it moves from the delta, but whatever its form, it never gets too far from that sweet sadness that B.B. King talks about, recalling a concert at which he was booed when he was introduced.

The blues, he says, is like being black twice.
