1 — OBJECTIVE

The purpose of this program is support the establishment of young fishers in the commercial fishing industry.

2 — MEANS

To reach this objective, the Ministère de l'Agriculture, des Pêcheries et de l'Alimentation du Québec (MAPAQ) offers financial support to help young fishers when they purchase their first fishing business.

3 — ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

To be eligible for the *Financial support program for young aspiring fishers*, potential applicants must proceed to purchase their first fishing business and show:

- 3.1** If the fishing business is composed of a natural person, that that person is of full age and less than 40 years old, domiciled in Québec, that he practices commercial fishing himself and is registered with the Bureau d'accréditation des pêcheurs et des aides-pêcheurs (BAPAP) and holds a commercial fishing licence issued pursuant to the Fisheries Act (R.S.C., c. F-14);
- 3.2** If the fishing business is a general or undeclared partnership, that the applicant holds over 50% of the interests of the partnership and meets the conditions set out in paragraph 3.1;
- 3.3** If the fishing business is a legal person, that the latter has its head office and principal place of business in Québec and that the applicant meets the conditions set out in paragraph 3.1 and that he alone or together with other persons who meet the same conditions holds over 50% of the shares in each category or each series issued.

May also be considered eligible for financial aid pursuant to this program, a company composed of a group of several natural or legal persons or partnerships as long as it can be shown to the Minister's satisfaction that one or more of said persons meeting the conditions set out in paragraph 3.1 or paragraph 3.3 control said company. For the purposes of this program, the term "control" means holding decisional authority for the entire group and holding directly or indirectly over 50% of the ownership of said company.

4 — FINANCIAL SUPPORT

The financial aid granted corresponds to 20% of the total cost of the project, to a maximum of \$25,000. This financial aid can be offered in one of the three possible ways described below, to be chosen by the applicant:

- 4.1 A subsidy to cover 100% of the cost of interest on all the loans contracted by the eligible business, for a maximum period of three years;
- 4.2 A subsidy to be used to finance new equipment for a vessel purchased by the fishing business within three years of the date the business entered the fishery; or
- 4.3 A combination of the options described above.

5 — GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 5.1 The other conditions governing the financial aid granted pursuant to this program shall be set out in an agreement binding the Minister and the fishing business, if necessary.
- 5.2 The applicant agrees to comply with any applicable legislation or regulation, notably the legislation and regulations that fall under the jurisdiction of the Ministère de l'Agriculture, des Pêcheries et de l'Alimentation.
- 5.3 Any other financial aid from government sources granted for the same eligible expenditures will have to be deducted from the financial aid granted pursuant to this program.
- 5.4 The applicant, and consequently, the business shall by law automatically be divested of the financial aid granted and shall be required to reimburse any amounts paid out to him or to the business if:
 - a) He fails to comply with the requirements set out in the program and in the agreement negotiated with the Minister;
 - b) He makes a false or misleading statement to obtain financial aid;
 - c) He cedes his assets or is subject to a seizure order rendered pursuant to the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, makes a proposal to his creditors or declares bankruptcy pursuant to this Act, is subject to a liquidation order rendered pursuant to legislation governing liquidation or winding-up, is insolvent or about to become so.

6 — PROCEDURE

Eligible applicants who wish to receive financial aid under this program must send their applications in writing to one of the Commercial Fisheries and Aquaculture General Directorates operated by the Ministère de l'Agriculture, des Pêcheries et de l'Alimentation.

7 — DURATION OF PROGRAM

The *Financial support program for young aspiring fishers* came into effect on January 1, 2008 and shall end on March 31, 2011. The Ministère reserves the right to modify this program in whole or in part without prior notice.
