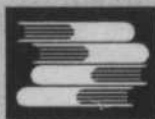

## Shakespeare meets the '60s

*BCS presents  
As You Like It  
in a different light*

It's William Shakespeare meets the peace and love generation of the 1960s in a captivating production of Bishop's College School Player's Club's *As You Like It*, a pastoral comedy full of all manner of love and personal epiphanies.

Director Margot Dionne leads her cast through a timely tale of love, set in the spring when everything is renewed once again, but with a 60s twist from Wednesday, March 6 to Saturday, March 9.

Dionne, a veteran of the stage having worked with the Trinity Repertory Theatre in Rhode Island, spent six seasons in various lead roles at Stratford, where she plans to return in August to play in Peter Hinton's *The Swan*.

Dionne has also been involved in creating several theatre groups including Theatre Encounter and the McGill Summer Theatre. For the last four years, she has been teaching Drama at BCS, and has been involved in the current production since casting in October.

"In the 60s you had people who left the city and found simpler, richer lives by being closer to the land," said Dionne, explaining her decision to present the audience with a different version of *As You Like It*, while keeping its meaning.

"Going back to the land with a communal anti-establishment mentality. All the world's a stage is an anti-establishment saying."

Dionne added that as characters portray different roles, find romance and love on many different levels, the audience will

have the opportunity to witness each character undergo changes in personality and outlook by the end of the play.

Dionne wanted to use the space in the Lewis Evans Memorial Theatre in a dif-

ferent manner, and consequently sought to create something entirely different by placing the actors where the audience would normally sit and vice versa.

## Fancy versions of traditional Quebec recipes

**C**hef Serge Caplette remembers how, when he was growing up in Sorel, his grandmother would test the temperature of the oven in her wood stove.

"She'd put her hand in," he said, holding out his arm and rotating his hand to demonstrate the technique to his brigade of chefs at the Montreal Bonaventure Hilton Hotel.

Then, cooking from memory with never a written recipe, she'd produce the family favourites that still make Caplette's mouth water - her roast of pork with yellow potatoes, rutabaga whipped with potatoes, a nutmeg-spiced custard pie called tarte aux oeufs, and the maple fudge sucre a la creme.

"I can still remember her telling me to finish my rutabaga. 'Eat your choutiam,' she'd say," using the old Quebec word.

Memories of his grandmother's cooking and of other family dishes have not been eclipsed, even by years of chef's training and cooking in top Montreal hotels. The chef, 43, joined the Bonaventure Hilton staff in 1996 and was named executive chef last year.

Two years ago, he started developing what he calls fancy versions of traditional Quebec dishes, and dreaming of putting them on his menus.

This weekend, in the baronial elegance of Le Castillon, the Hilton's top dining room, he's serving his adaptations of traditional Quebec recipes as part of the city's High Lights Festival. This annual winter party, which continues until March 3 in 50 midtown restaurants, combines cuisine, the arts and outdoor light shows.

Many restaurants are welcoming guest chefs from around the world. A number of chefs, Caplette included, have chosen instead to design special festival menus, to put on wine and food tastings, or to offer lectures or classes.

At a recent test-drive of the menu in the hotel kitchen, dishes looked like the latest, chef-style cooking.

For the opener, the chef used a recipe for smoked eel he got from the captain of a boat that used to ply the waters off Sorel. He flaked the eel and mixed it with capers, celery, lemon juice and olive oil. Then he packed the fish into little moulds, unmoulded the eel onto toast rounds, and added paper-thin chips of celery root and more smoked eel. Corn sprouts and tiny leaves of sicho and misula lettuce turned it into a delectable plate of tall food.

Roast partridge with baked beans came next, its recipe from the Mauricie region

north of Trois-Rivieres.

The important aspect, Caplette said, is the "old-style flavour" of the beans and the tenderness of the roast partridge. To get the right effect with these small, lean birds, he roasted the legs right in the beans, and the breasts separately.

Topping the dish off was a puff-pastry creation that might have surprised Caplette's grandmother. Francois Tachon, the hotel's pastry chef, coated strands of pastry with poppy seeds and shaped them into a fan-like frame to top off the beans.

The soup was a lightened version of Sorel's signature dish gibelotte, a lusty fish soup that's been traced to a little restaurant on one of the islands off Sorel. Originally made with catfish from the St. Lawrence River, it's now often made with perch.

The roast pork, while not as elaborate to look at, had a warming succulence. Tender slices of meat were interspersed with thick slabs of pan-browned potatoes. A whipped mixture of rutabaga and potatoes was served on the side, the green accents baby zucchini and bok choy.

Here is a recipe from chef Serge Caplette's High Lights Festival menu:

Caplette "turned" his mixed fresh vegetables, chef language for cutting them into tiny balls. An alternative would be cutting them in small, evenly sized chunks.

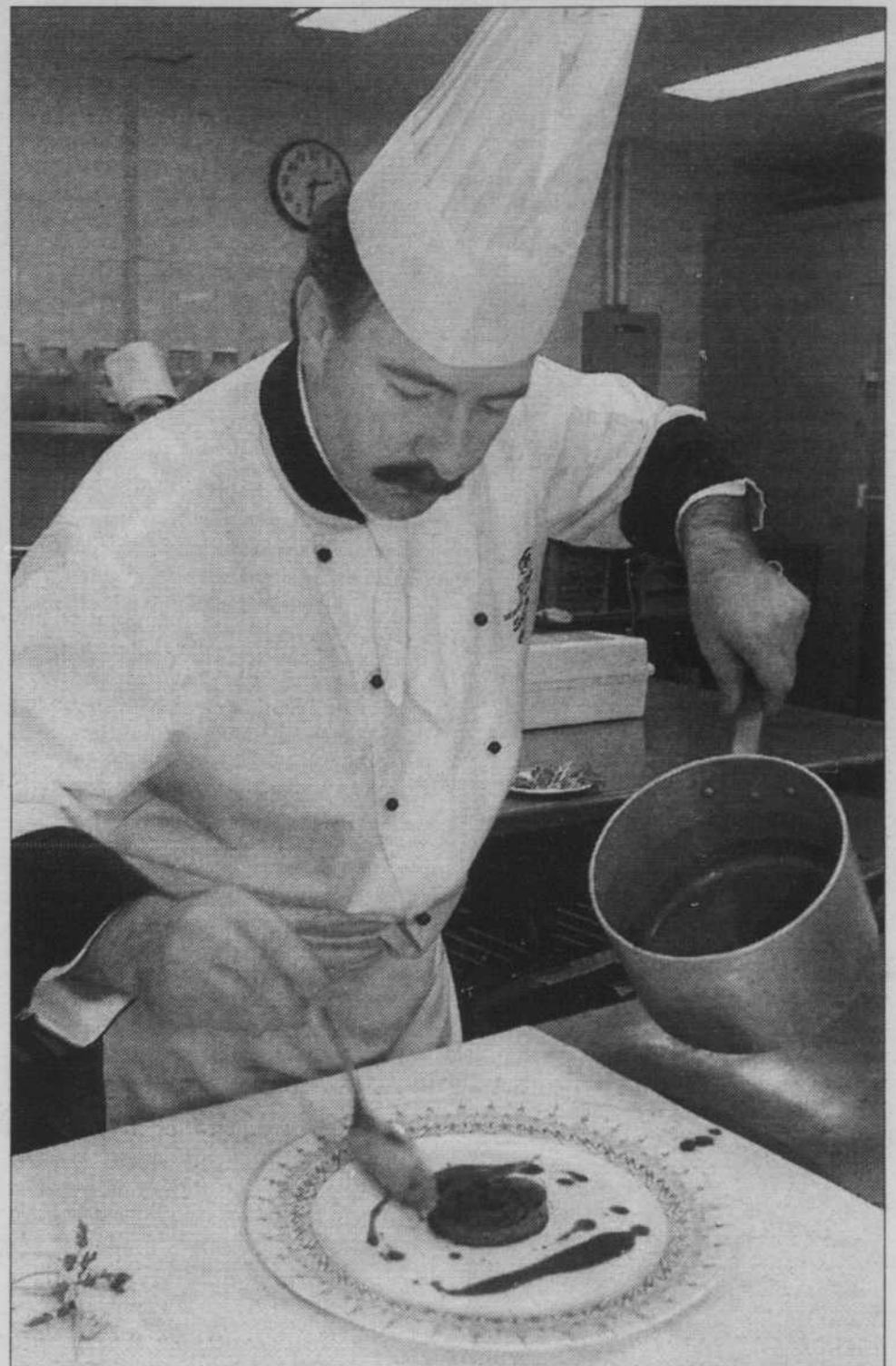
### GIBELOTTE (SOREL FISH SOUP) (Serves 4)

- 4 catfish, cleaned, for a total weight of 8 ounces (250 g)
- 3 ounces (85 g) salt pork, in one piece
- 1 medium onion, quartered
- 3 stalks celery, in chunks
- 2 carrots, in chunks
- 2 medium potatoes, peeled, quartered
- 3 cups (750 mL) fish stock
- 1/4 cup (50 mL) fresh, cubed tomatoes
- 1/4 cup (50 mL) tomato juice
- 1/4 cup (50 mL) tomato paste
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 2 cups (500 mL) mixed fresh vegetables, in small pieces (potatoes, turnips, carrots, green beans)
- 2 cups (500 mL) fresh or frozen corn kernels

1. Have fishmonger clean catfish, reserving bones. Have two of the fish cut into fillets. Have the other two fish cut into 1-inch (2.5-cm) pieces. Refrigerate fish and bones until needed.

2. Soak salt pork in cold water for an hour, then cook in boiling water for an hour. Drain and cut in thin strips. Using a large, heavy saucepan, fry salt pork until crisp. This should give you about 2 tablespoons (25 mL) of pork fat.

3. Add to the hot fat the onions, celery,

carrots, and potatoes and cook for several minutes until softened but not golden. Add the fish stock, cubed tomatoes, tomato juice and tomato paste and simmer for 30 minutes, uncovered. Add the fish cut into pieces (not the fillets) and all the fish bones to the pan and simmer for 10 minutes. Season to taste with salt and pepper, then strain through a sieve. Discard fish, bones and vegetables.

4. Return stock to the heat and, when

simmering, add mixed fresh vegetables, corn kernels and fish fillets, and simmer just until vegetables are tender to the fork, five to 10 minutes. Do not overcook the fish. Ladle hot soup into four heated bowls, dividing vegetables and fish evenly between the four servings. Serve at once.

Approximate nutritional content per serving: 285 calories; 14 g protein; 19 g fat; 15 g carbohydrates; 3 g dietary fibre; 600 mg sodium.

## Boutin-Turgeon takes viewers along for the ride

### Artist and her travels featured at the Beaulne Museum

Abitibi based artist Danielle Boutin-Turgeon has always remembered the Townships fondly. Her father hails from Stanstead, and a trip here last year brought her to the Musée Beaulne in Coaticook to view the collage works of Richard Fulham.

"When I saw the house, I fell in love with it," she said of the late 19th century Norton family residence, which houses the museum. She also found Director Mario Landry so welcoming that she wanted to exhibit there. Now, one year later, she will.

Opening on Saturday, March 2 at 2 p.m. is a show of Boutin-Turgeon's latest paintings, which always base themselves on memories of her travels.

Appropriately enough, the 22 works on display until April 28 take as their subject her trip to Coaticook last year, which inspired this very show.

That such a beautiful edifice got her creative juices flowing is understandable. "I paint buildings—our built heritage, that's what I love to look at," she said.

But her acrylic paintings have another intriguing element. "My pleasure is to integrate the images and collages I find on the Internet, in newspapers and magazines into my paintings," she explained. "The final product is a collage."

And her choice of the disjointed collage medium seems apt when you consider her principal subject—memories.

"When we remember something, it's not necessarily in order," she explained. "I paint the buildings my way."

I create a story around them—what I experienced, what I've lived through them."

What flows from Boutin-Turgeon artistically—varying perspectives of the past as seen through historical edifices—is doubly appropriate for a retired primary and secondary level teacher. Both her social science grounding and her collage use of ready-made images from outside herself keep what is very personal artwork from becoming overly introspective.

Boutin-Turgeon's modus operandi is keeping her art current and fresh. The pre-fab collage images reinforce that in a concrete way on her canvases and panels, while pursuing courses at the University of Abitibi-Témiscamingue introduces her to a steady stream of new art and artists.

But her biggest source of inspiration comes from her travels to such destinations as Paris, Prague, and Amsterdam, to name but a few. She simply loved the houses in Amsterdam. "They're all so old and practically on top of one another and a bit slanted—they're so charming."

It was in 1996, amidst the history of that

canalled city, that she made an evolutionary leap as an artist, she said. "Before that I was going to university, I took courses, but I painted like everyone else."

Landscapes, portraits, just like everyone else. But there I found my own personal writing style—my painting style."

Musée Beaulne Director Mario Landry agreed.

"The originality of her work and the quality attracted us," he said. "She's an artist worth getting to know more and more."

Since that watershed trip, an Amsterdam symbol also became a recurring motif in her collage paintings—bicycles. "Over there, the bike is king and master," she said. It has taken on an increasingly important role in her work, standing for "people, emotions, characters—it has become like a medium for me, like a key word to express my message."

Landry explained that in Boutin Turgeon's work, "the bicycle travels through time and across different cultures. It's really original what she's done."

Incidentally, since visiting Amsterdam, she also bikes more.

And as viewers we feel like we're on the back, being easily doubled by her as we look at her accessible works. "Danielle takes us with her on her travels," said Landry. "Her work is concrete, even if it is from her imagination."

The exhibition ties in nicely with another travel-themed show on view at Musée Beaulne until March 31, Liliane Mertens' "Femmes du monde," a series of 20 paintings of women from countries around the world.

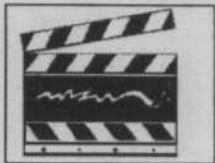

## NFB caters to documentary and animated film fans

Documentary and animated short films aficionados will be pampered next month when the National Film Board's latest French releases are presented in Sherbrooke.

"We wanted to get the NFB-produced documentaries out there circulating among the public in every region of Quebec," said the programming director for Sherbrooke Hélène Vanier. "We also wanted to put the directors in contact with viewers and get them talking about the subject-matter in the documentaries."

The NFB will present six documentaries and three animated short films between March 11 and 20 at Sherbrooke's Presse Boutique Café. It is the fifth year in a row that Sherbrooke presents new NFB releases.

"It was important that we present subjects that touch the Sherbrooke public in one way or another," added Vanier. "Like the documentary Bacon where the environment issue is prevalent."

Bacon will kick off programming on March 11 at 7:30 p.m. at the Presse Boutique Café with the documentary's director Hugo Latulippe in attendance to discuss the theme and debate the issues with viewers.

Also to be presented are Une goutte dans l'océan

about the life of Claudette Picard, a member of Doctors without borders (March 12), Quelques raisons d'espérer about environmentalist Pierre Dansereau (March 13), Partition pour voix de femmes which looks at women and their conditions around the world (March 18) and À travers chants about the world of choirs (March 20).

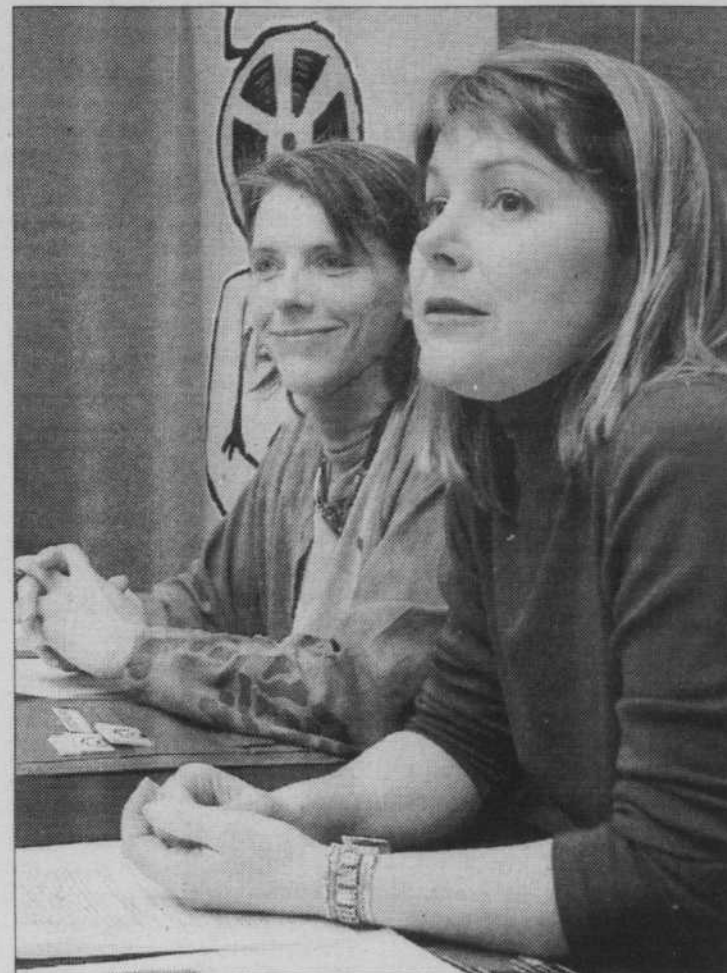
"There will be a great exchange between the crowd and the directors following each screening," added a visibly proud event co-ordinator Renée Giguère, adding that four of the directors will be in Sherbrooke to present their documentary and discuss it with the general public.

Also, Toronto filmmaker Lisa Fitzgibbons' documentary about coping with the suicide of a loved one, entitled après... (Aftermath), will be presented on March 19. Fitzgibbons will also be in Sherbrooke for the screening.

Among the animated short films to be presented is the French version of Martine Chartrand's Black Soul (Âme Noire) about the defining moments of Black history that won the Golden Bear prize at the 2001 Berlin Film

Festival. Also featured are Aria (March 20), Clandestin (March 11) and La solitude de monsieur Turgeon (March 19).

Similar screenings will be presented in Chicoutimi, Trois-Rivières, Québec, Rimouski, Toronto, Ont. and Moncton, N.B.

Another change of pace in the production is Ellen Goldfinch's role as BCS librarian in providing original music for the production.

"I heard the lyrics for two songs as well as the music instruments," recounted Goldfinch.

"I had composed songs in my 20s. I modified those compositions and sang into a little boom box. I gave the tape to Margot who I thought would be the only person to hear it. Somehow it got around and the whole cast heard it so I had kids coming up to me in the library saying I didn't know you could sing and play guitar."

Dionne said that after countless hours on the labour of love that is *As You Like It*, the students overcame the language of Shakespeare and learned to move with the text.

Eric Inoue, who plays Touchstone the

Wit, explained that, although it was his first Shakespeare piece, he has always played the joker or wit in other productions.

"He's so clever. He has all the words anyone could want on the tip of his tongue," Inoue said of his character.

Caitlyn McFadden, who plays Celia, said she has been an avid fan of the works of Shakespeare for many years, but was excited to find herself onstage for the first time acting out scenes by the legendary theatre writer.

"I started speaking Shakespeare when I was 10," noted McFadden, adding she had a more in-depth knowledge of Shakespeare and was able to impart that on her peers.

## Truman scored great political upset

### Dawn of television changed politics forever

The 2000 presidential election with the recounts of ballots, and delay in declaring George W. Bush president will be referred to in history as one of the most unusual.

But there were precedents to this odd political situation. Many may remember the famous picture of President Truman gleefully holding a copy of the Chicago Daily Tribune featuring the headline "Dewey defeats Truman"? It's one of the most famous political pictures ever.

The year 1948 was not supposed to be Harry S. Truman's year. Governor Thomas Dewey, from New York, was on the road, by all predictions, to the White House. But it didn't happen. That's what Zachary Karabell's recent book, *The Last Campaign: How Harry Truman won the 1948 Election* is all about.

Everybody expected a Republican victory. At some point during the campaign, the New York Times predicted that at least 22 states and 281 electoral votes would be won by the GOP and that Henry Wallace would prevent Truman from carrying Illinois, Pennsylvania, New York and New Jersey against Dewey. This prediction was wrong: Truman carried Illinois, while Dewey collected 189 electoral votes and 17 states.

And, by the way, even the polls were wrong in 1948.

Before the campaign even began, Truman was not even certain of winning the nomination of his own

party. Influential Democrats like James Roosevelt, son of FDR, along with people from the ADA (Americans for Democratic Action) "seriously considered jettisoning a sitting president and looking for a candidate who could at least not embarrass himself come November." As a potential candidate, they even thought about General Dwight D. Eisenhower. At the end of the day, Truman would prove them all wrong.

In the meantime, Truman and his advisers - Clark Clifford among them - articulated a strategy, which focused on independent voters, organized labor, black voters, people from the West. All in all, "if Truman believed what people in Washington were saying, he ought to have conceded in May". He played, to his advantage, the anti-establishment card. At the end of the day, "it was in the farm states that Truman made substantial gains."

President Truman, who had nothing to lose - after all, he was written off by a lot of people - maintained an aggressive strategy. He attacked his main opponent along with the do-nothing 80th Congress which did not produce much in terms of domestic results and began a whistle-stop tour through the west. To add to the many difficulties faced by the Democrats, they were not great fundraisers, where Republicans were masters.

Governor Dewey had his nomination tied up from the start. He nevertheless had two serious opponents: Senator Robert Taft of Ohio, and former Minnesota Governor Harold Stassen. The main achievement of Dewey, during the 1948 election, was

his good use of radio. With a vast amount of money, he could afford it, big time.

Meanwhile, 1948 was the first election where television played a role, albeit in a minor way. It was "television's political baptism", according to Karabell.

If Wallace had been stronger, he could have prevented Truman from winning the 1948 election. But the electorate was less generous with the Progressive candidate than expected. On Nov. 2, he came fourth, behind the Dixiecrats. As for Strom Thurmond, he had no chance of winning whatsoever, but he prevented Republicans from making inroads among those who were unhappy with Truman's civil rights agenda.

In retrospect, President Truman was right to be confident. He benefited from the presence of more than one opponent. Strom Thurmond and his fellow Dixiecrats and Henry Wallace's Progressive Party. Like Prime Minister Chrétien these days, Truman was wise enough to take advantage of the bad moves of the opposition.

A final comment on the 1948 should be that this election "helped create our modern campaign system. Perhaps the greatest irony is that

while Dewey lost, he set the tone for television candidates of the future." After 1948, things would never be the same again. Whistle-stop campaigning would give way to a new medium: television and radio would lose its importance, over time.

Briefly said, *The Last Campaign: How Harry Truman won the 1948 Election* is a very good piece of political history. Simple, concise and well-written, it is easily readable for anyone interested in understanding the evolution of politics since the 1950s.

# Theatre is a matter of life for artist

**D**enise Provencher defies conventional definitions of passion and artistry.

"At 28 I discovered theatre as a total art, a vital part of my soul-searching," says the comedian, producer and newly-appointed teacher at Sherbrooke Seminary.

"Theatre is really a multidimensional human presence at work: emotions, body and soul, conscious and unconscious. That is what I truly love to do..."

Denise Provencher first got her calling some 15 years ago, when she attended a workshop by Laurence Tardif, co-founder of Sherbrooke's Théâtre du Double Signe.

"She told me it was a matter of life and death for me to do theatre. The people at Théâtre du Double Signe were the very first to encourage me; they made my first original theatre piece *Offeranda* (an invented word for offering), possible in 1990. I moved from a reclusive philosophy graduate to being in charge of a complete production without the usual route of diplomas!"

Provencher's pieces combine literature, mythic images and her own body language in acting, with an injection of raw emotion. She also aims to preserve the sacred character of rituals in the theatrical form she chose.

Writer Hélène Ouvrard was the inspiration behind two shows with her poet-

ry and journals: *'La femme singulière'* in 1991 and *'Mémoire'* in 1995. "My pieces all carried the theme of a woman's complete desire and quest for identity through love's pleasures and pains," says Provencher.

"After 1995 I retired from the scene a while, because the workload of seeing through an entire production was too

great for me, as I was acting, producing, directing, promoting and all. It was too much."

The artist continued to conduct her own workshops for training actors until 1997. She met choreographer and Buto artist Jocelyne Montpetit, whose spiritual and creative path greatly influenced her. In 2000, one man she knew from her workshops suggested she direct a benefit amateur the-

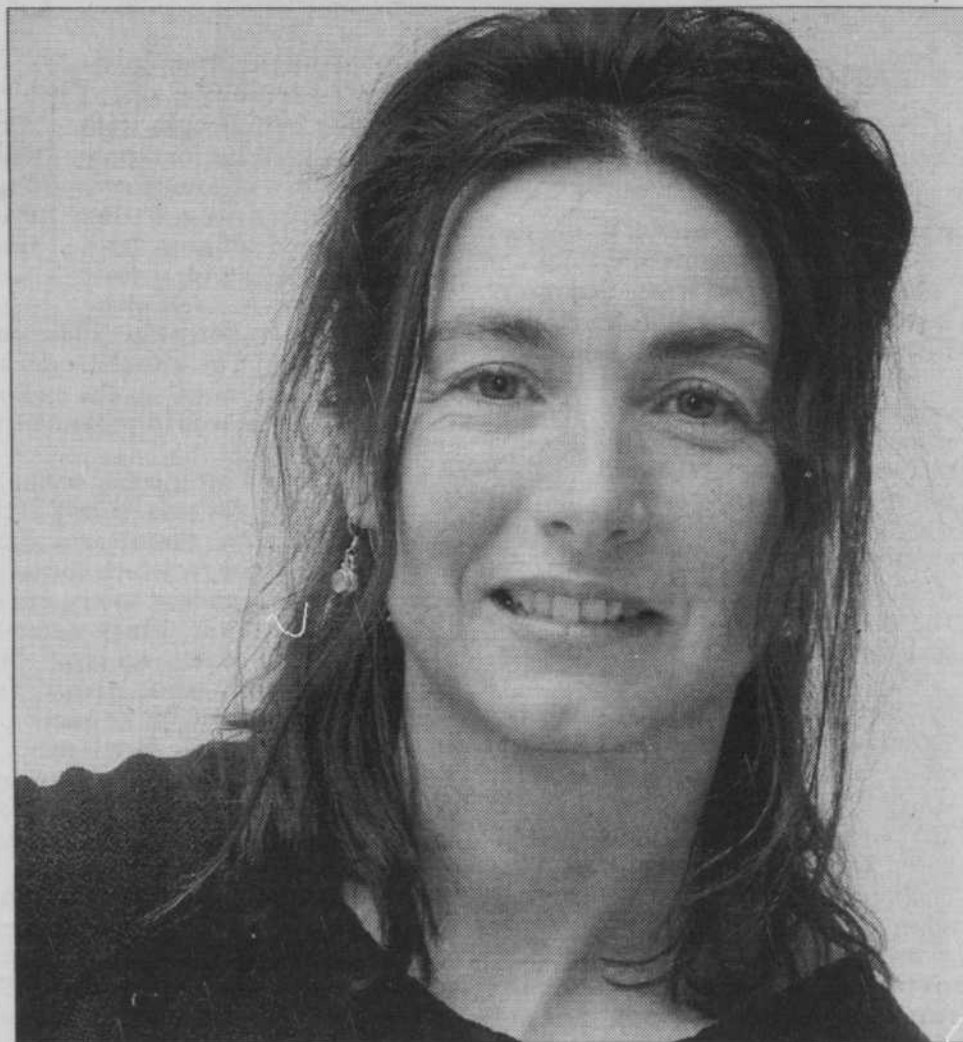
ater show for a CLSC foundation. At Sherbrooke Seminary's Théâtre Léonard Saint-Laurent, where the show played, Provencher was then asked to join the Seminary's regular staff of art teachers. She accepted the offer and is now theatre coach and teacher, as well as part-time coordinator of the arts and culture program there.

"I really love to teach, although it came as a complete surprise for me," she says. "Teaching in the original sense of the word is what I'm doing and I love every minute. I'm a perpetual apprentice in love and theatre: all the same thing to me."

## Theatre recounts assassination of D'Arcy McGee

**T**he Saidye Bronfman Centre for the Arts presents *Blood on the Moon*, the sensational one-man show written and performed by Pierre Brault, in the Leanor and Alvin Segal Theatre March 4-17.

Set in Ottawa at the time of Confederation, *Blood on the Moon* tells of the murder of Thomas D'Arcy McGee from the viewpoint of his alleged assassin, James Patrick Whelan. In a towering one-man performance, Toronto-based actor and playwright, Pierre Brault, plays Whelan and a host of other characters, bringing to life this fascinating yet strangely overlooked chapter of Canadian history.

Brault's mesmerizing solo performance earned him the 1999-2000 Capital Critics Circle Award for Best Actor.

The production is directed by John Koensgen and produced by Sleeping Dog Theatre in association with the NAC English Theatre.

"Though the assassination and trial took place in Ottawa, Montreal also has a strong link to this story, as D'Arcy McGee was a MP for Montreal West," said SBC Artistic Director Bryan Wasserman.

"After seeing *Blood on the Moon* in Ottawa, I knew I had to bring it here to Montreal. I feel sure that Montreal audiences will love this original Canadian play that is a compelling blend of historical fact, mystery, humour and drama."

The story begins in the early hours of an April morning in 1968. As D'Arcy McGee stops to unlock the door of his lodgings at Sparks Street, he is killed by a single shot to the back of

the head.

Some months later, in the Ottawa Courthouse (now Arts Court), Whelan is convicted of the grisly assassination. The evidence against him was purely circumstantial, yet Whelan was led to his death before thousands of jeering spectators in what was to be Canada's last public execution.

Besides his acclaimed performance in *Blood on the Moon*, Brault — who is also Artistic Director of Sleeping Dog Theatre — is well known to Ottawa audiences for his roles at the NAC in *Travels with My Aunt* and *The Secret Garden*, and elsewhere in *An Acre of Time* and *The Collected Works of Billy the Kid* (Great Canadian Theatre Company) and *Brothers of the Brush* (New Theatre of Ottawa).

Brault is currently appearing in a new production of *An Acre of Time* at

Toronto Tarragon Theatre. Last year, he was invited to Iqaluit, Nunavut to direct and perform in a memorable production of *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat*.

Ottawa director and actor Koensgen's recent directing credits include *The Golden Age* (University of Ottawa Drama Guild), *As You Like It* (A Company of Fools) and *The League of Nathans* (Assistant Director, GCTC). NAC audiences will remember him for his performances in *Hard Times* and *The Secret Garden*. He will also appear in the upcoming NAC English Theatre production of Shakespeare's *All's Well That Ends Well*.

# Has traditional animation been left for the birds?

Three years ago, Steve Jobs, the blunt-speaking boss of San Francisco's Pixar Animation, was basking in the success of *A Bug's Life*, his company's latest computer-animated frolic.

His mood was such that he was even prepared to ruffle the feathers of his Disney partners who had released *A Bug's Life* under their banner. He dared to take aim at the very cornerstone of the Disney empire - its six decades of achievement in the field of classical, hand-drawn animation.

The word from Jobs was that animated movies created in the computer (known in the trade as 3-D or CGI) would soon bury the traditional 2-D form where artists had meticulously created hundreds of thousands of hand drawings to give us the likes of *Snow White* and *The Lion King*.

Jobs - the aggressive visionary who was also behind the renaissance of the Apple organization - saw films like *Toy Story* and *A Bug's Life* as proof of the superiority of his kind of animation. To him, these movies represented the future: he argued that CGI could do everything that the classical hand-drawn techniques responsible for *Lion King* could do - only better.

"The characters we make are far more expressive," he boasted, "so we tell better stories."

The first slate of three nominees in the Academy Awards' new feature animation category must therefore be causing Jobs delight. Pixar's latest hit, *Monsters Inc.*, was in the lineup, along with *Shrek* from Dreamworks and *Jimmy Neutron* from Paramount. All three came out of computers.

For Disney, the nominations were ominous. True, it had released *Monsters Inc.*, but it had been banking heavily on a nod for *Atlantis*, a piece of traditional animation that had taken four years and the efforts of hundreds of artists to create. *Atlantis* had underperformed last summer, blown away by *Shrek's* massive box-office. The *Hollywood Reporter* was quick to conclude that the success of *Shrek* and *Monsters Inc.* has established the dominance of computer animation over the old-fashioned kind.

But are such verdicts correct? On the surface, traditional animation is in trouble: witness the continuing layoffs at Disney, cradle of this unique 20th century art form.

Furthermore, rival studios like Warners and Fox are still smarting from their humiliating attempts in the 1990s to emulate Disney's 1994 triumph with *The Lion King* by setting up their own animation studios. Movies like *Titan A.E.* and *The Quest For Camelot* were flops both

with critics and at the box office. Even *Iron Giant*, a superb example of traditional animation released by Warner Brothers, failed commercially despite ecstatic reviews. In the face of these results, hundreds of animators were fired by both studios.

"There's lots of unemployment out there and a lot of retraining going on," says Steve Hulett business manager for the Motion Picture Screen Cartoonists.

"But retraining isn't the whole answer because some people transfer to CGI easily and others don't." Meanwhile, the *Los Angeles Times* has predicted that within two years 95 per cent of traditional animation artists will be trained in computer skills.

Other industry watchers are cautious in their forecasts.

"I think Steve Jobs is somebody who has a lot at stake and has shareholders," says Jerry Beck who operates a widely read Web site, [Cartoonresearch.com](http://Cartoonresearch.com).

"He thinks computers are going to change the world. I don't think even John Lasseter (the directing genius between Pixar's top movies) thinks that."

Beck thinks a death sentence for traditional 2-D animation is premature, saying that in a less refined form it will definitely continue, for example, as a mainstay of Saturday morning TV.

"But if I had to consult a crystal ball, my guess would be that 2-D is going to have to re-invent itself - it's going to have to find out what it is that people want to see. So the original Disney-style type of movie may well be over."

On the other hand, 2002 could trigger another cosmic shift, given this year's slate of animated product. In late March, Fox will release *Ice Age*, a digitally animated film regarded as something of a dark horse. But this year's heavyweights are three movies created the old-fashioned hand-drawn way. Two come from Disney: *Lilo And Stitch*, opening June 21, is a whimsical comedy about a lonely Hawaiian girl whose adopted dog turns out to be an escaped genetic experiment from an alien planet; *Treasure Planet*, arriving in early winter, is a science fiction version of *Treasure Island*. The third film, from

Dreamworks, is an animated adventure, *Spirit: Stallion Of The Cimarron*.

Both Beck and Hulett say the performance of these three examples of traditional 2-D animation will be under close scrutiny by the industry.

"But the advance buzz on *Lilo And Stitch* is amazing," Beck reports. "Everybody who's seen it - even the 3-D people - say it's really great."

Indeed, despite reports of a rush to embrace 3-D, the overall slate of 2002 animated releases is very much in the 2-D mode. The list also includes *Mutant Aliens*, a raunchy science fiction spoof; *Powderpuff Girls: The Movie*; *Rugrats 3*; and *8 Crazy Nights*, a vehicle featuring the voice of Adam Sandler.

Veteran Disney filmmakers Kirk Wise and Gary Trousdale staunchly contend that 2-D still has a future, but they also say that future lies in a blending of traditional animation and state-of-the-art computer graphics. They cite last year's *Atlantis* in which both forms were used for the scene in which a leviathan attacks a submarine.

But the Disney official most under pressure is Thomas Schumacher, the studio's

affable head of feature animation and a huge fan of the classic form. He's such a fan that he was distraught when *Iron Giant*, a film from another studio, failed at the box office.

"I thought *Iron Giant* was sensational. I walked out of the theatre with tears running down my face."

A couple of years ago, Schumacher was philosophical about Steve Jobs's assault on classical animation.

"I understand why Steve said that. Come on - of course he's going to push that point of view."

Schumacher argued that there was a place for more than one type of animation in the future Hollywood universe.

"There were no grounds for making *Toy Story 2* in traditional animation - it wouldn't resonate. Conversely, we wouldn't have made *Tarzan* as a computer-animated movie because of the texture of the film and what we were trying to do with it."

Then he gently pointed out that *Tarzan*, an example of traditional animation, ended up doing more business than the computer-generated *A Bug's Life*.

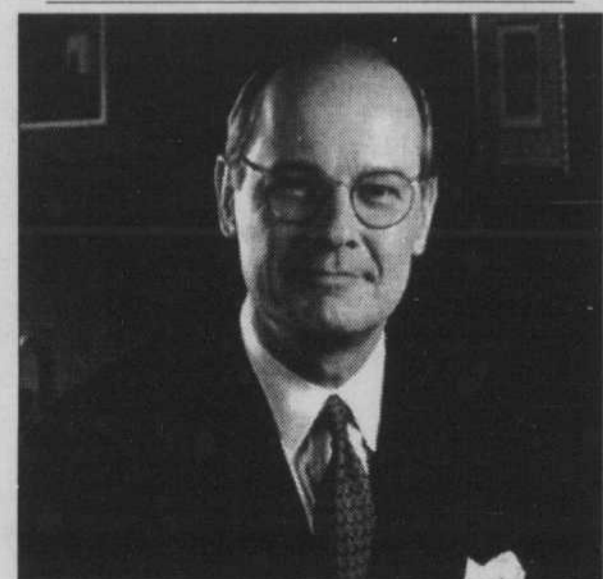

The two-hour retrospective shares some of the most revealing, poignant and humorous moments from the show's 15 years, and goes behind the scenes of its production. Since April 1987, *Biography* has profiled nearly 900 subjects, ranging from Albert Einstein, Nancy Reagan and Franklin Delano Roosevelt to Josephine Baker, Jerry Lewis and Tennessee Williams.

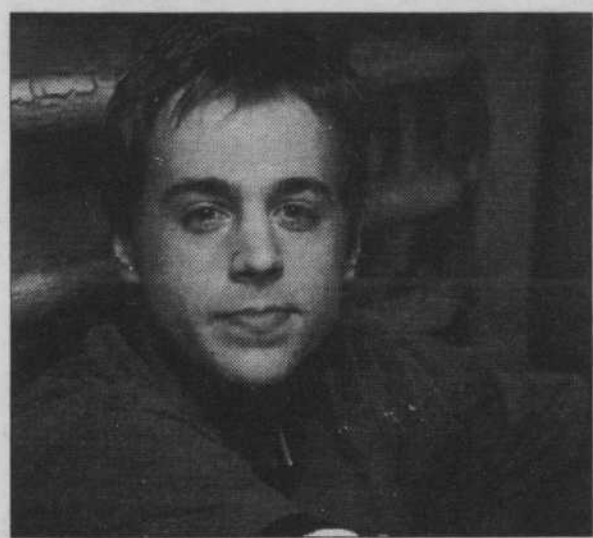

# The Man in Black still cashing in after five decades

In tribute to Johnny Cash, who recently turned 70 on Feb. 26, Columbia/Legacy Records has released The Essential Johnny Cash, a 36-song, two-disk set in honour of 'The Man in Black'.

Despite being plagued with health problems for several years, Cash hasn't slowed down one bit, as he recently recorded a duet with rock singer Dave Matthews entitled 'For You' for the soundtrack We Were Soldiers.

In March, Columbia will also release American Milestones, an extended versions of five vintage Johnny Cash albums that were not available on CD before. The Man In Black is currently preparing his fourth album with producer Rick Rubin. Rubin, is the rock producer who was at the helm of the first American Recordings in 1994 which introduced Cash to a much younger crowd while still pleasing the older fans.

It was in 1955 that Cash first met Sam Phillips, and in a matter of days he was in studio recording the legendary single 'Hey Porter'.

His first chart-topper came several years later with 'I Walk The Line', with his first No.1 hit 'Ballad of a Teenage Queen'. In 1963, he recorded a signature song co-written by June Carter whom he later married in 1968.

During the late 1960s and 70s, Cash kept recording hit after hit. From 1969 to 1971 he hosted ABC's The Johnny Cash Show, that featured a diversity of artists from across the musical spectrum.

Musically, Cash knows no boundaries as he manages to mix country, gospel, folk and rock music together in a magnificent manner. There's no need to be a country fan to know about Cash - he is to gospel

and rock n' roll as Kenny Rogers is to pop music. They both have successfully crossed over and come back to their roots.

Cash has taken home 10 Grammys, the Lifetime Achievement Award (1999) has been inducted into both the Country Music and Rock 'n Roll Halls of Fame.

Despite the honours, however, Cash has had a very hard life. Indeed, addictions to alcohol, cocaine and painkillers were part of his life for a long time. He has since managed to battle the addictions, but it has left its mark on the Man in Black.

In the mid-80's, Cash continued his success, joining Willie Nelson, Kris Kristofferson and Waylon Jennings to form The Highwaymen, while maintaining a

promising solo career.

After meeting Rubin, Cash regained his popularity with the first American Recordings, which won a Grammy for Best Folk Album. In 1997, Cash continued where American Recordings left off, recording Unchained, which features several covers of songs by rock musicians like Tom Petty, Soundgarden

Unchained brought Cash another Grammy Award for Best Country Album. Not too many artists would have pulled this off with such great success, showing why this man is a pillar of country music.

The year 2000 brought Cash more accolades, including a Grammy for Best Country Male Vocal Performance for Solitary Man.

After all these years as a performer, I think that health permitting, Cash still has a lot to give to country music and its fans.
