### Sunshine Theatre presents lesson in constructive lying

Sunshine Theatre Productions opens its second season with Hungarian playwright Ferenc Molnar's

*The Play's The Thing*, adapted in English by P.G. Wodehouse. In this three-act comedy, Molnar explores the paradox of using a fundamentally immoral act - a lie - to achieve a moral end.

Set in the 1920s, the author allows a glimpse of the twilight of European upper classes caught up in social and moral changes they are powerless to stop.

Budapest-born Molnar (1878-1952) was at various times a lawyer, a journalist, short story writer and novelist. He is

considered one of the century's top playwrights and transformed his native city into one of Europe's theatrical centres. His plays, including *The Guardsman*, *Liliom* and *The Play's The Thing*, were transplanted to the New York stage where they were a critical success. His works have also been adapted for stage and film: *Carousel*, the 1945 play which was later turned into a movie, was based upon *Liliom*.

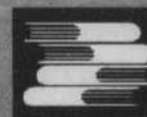

## La Devinière hits the nail on the head

Send them home as merry as crickets." The context may be different from the 1500s when French writer François Rabelais first coined the phrase, but the dining experience at La Devinière brings fresh meaning to the philosophy of customer satisfaction.

The Sherbrooke restaurant situated at the corner of King St. West and Peel is named in honour of the French Renaissance writer and physician François Rabelais, as well-known to the French as Shakespeare is to the English.

François Rabelais was born in 1494 at

La Devinière, a family property near Chinon, where his father, Antoine Rabelais, practiced law. In 1534, Rabelais published his most famous work, *Gargantua and Pantagruel*, the story of a young giant and his father who exhibit great strength and appetite.

History has placed Rabelais in good company with Medieval and Renaissance writers such as Francis Bacon, Geoffrey Chaucer, Machiavelli, Dante and Shakespeare.

So what does all this have to do with dining 500 years later at a French restaurant in Sherbrooke? Well, everything. From the Renaissance reproductions on the walls and the white linen cloths on the tables to the menu of French cuisine that would satisfy the most insatiable appetites, La Devinière does its namesake proud.

Luce Grenier and Yvan Couture have been operating the restaurant for the past eight years.

While Yvon is in the kitchen producing the miracles that appear on the menu, Luce offers the kind of warm welcome you might expect to receive at a private home. She takes my coat and hangs it up while chatting amicably in true Townships fashion, alternating between French and English.

On this occasion Luce and her backstage partner were dealing with three diners with different tastes and at least one who was fussier than the others.

The table d'hôte, which changes daily, offered a broad selection of entrées

and main courses which appealed to all our tastes and Luce didn't bat an eye when we asked to mix and match selections from the à la carte menu with offerings from the table d'hôte.

That's how I got to sample the great oyster chowder while still enjoying a main course of duck breast with green grapes. The creamy, but not too thick chowder with tender oysters was served in a white pot that kept it piping hot to the last drop, which I regretted having to take.

Having sampled Brome Lake duck in all its splendid ways, I was surprised to discover there was yet another way to cook duck, and Yvon is onto something with the green grapes and delicate sauce that together create a flavour that is neither too sweet nor too bland. The sliced breast of duck was served with pureed herbed potatoes, an asparagus spear, pickled purple cabbage, a zucchini strip and squash. And still the plate was not overcrowded.

My son was taken with the house salad which looked like a colourful mid-summer garden — which begs the question, where does one find nasturtium this time of year?

The main course of scallops and shrimp came seared to perfection in an herb and garlic oil. Anyone who has ever endeavored to get that beautiful brown exterior on fresh scallops can appreciate Yvon's efforts. The filet mignon was equally refreshing with a coating of grated cheese and herbs and a touch of

horseradish.

On a more adventurous evening I might have tried the filet of pork with semi-sweet chocolate and ginger or lamb grilled with goat's cheese. Or perhaps the rabbit with mustard sauce. I didn't even ask what the "Mahi-mahi à l'orange et pistaches" was. It was, after all, only Tuesday night.

The table d'hôte prices range from \$24-28 and include a choice of five entrées, five main courses and a foyer full of showpiece desserts that looked absolutely exquisite and, if the chocolate mousse cake we shared is any indication, they taste as good as they look. The à la carte menu, which ranged in price from \$16.95-\$25, provided nine choices and included soup or salad.

The after-dinner menu offered a good selection of digestive liqueurs and specialty coffees and teas.

La Devinière is an affordable restaurant with tremendous value for money since it incorporates all the essentials: Great atmosphere — did I mention Ella Fitzgerald singing in the background? — an extremely talented chef, personal and pleasant service and a sense you're not just eating.

To quote another of Rabelais' famous adages, "You have there hit the nail on the head"

## University Singers features new voices

This year's Christmas concert by the University Singers, to be held at Bishop's University's Bandeen Hall, will showcase a new choir director Dr. Jamie Crooks and a large new group of singers, performing Vivaldi's Magnificat and a number of carols including two by Rutter and traditional negro spirituals.

Dr. Crooks, a Professor of Philosophy at Bishop's University has a Bachelor of Music Degree from Mount Allison University. He studied voice and piano and was a member of the Choral Society there and assistant conductor. He has choral experience with choirs in Toronto, including two years of experience in the Mendelssohn Choir. He also sang under the direction of the renowned Elmer Isler, the premier choral conductor in Canada for a number of decades.

Crooks was himself a member of the University Singers under the direction of Nancy Rahn and credits her with an influence that is still felt.

"It's an organization that still bears her mark in a really positive way," said Dr. Crooks.

Following in Rahn's footsteps is a challenge for Crooks.

"It's daunting. In the beautiful ivory tower in philosophy, you never put knowledge on display. There's pressure to the whole performance thing. I always thought Nancy Rahn was unflap-

pable in those pressure situations," he said.

More than half the 40 members of the choir are new students.

"Sixty per cent are new first year students, though there is a core of people from before. They have varied kinds of

experience. Some have been in high school choral groups for a number of years, others are basically starting from scratch," Crooks explained.

Crooks is pleased to have a piano student accompanying the group with lots of experience.

The artist has prepared light switch murals in a variety of styles, shapes and designs using only natural colour of slate: Green, red and black.

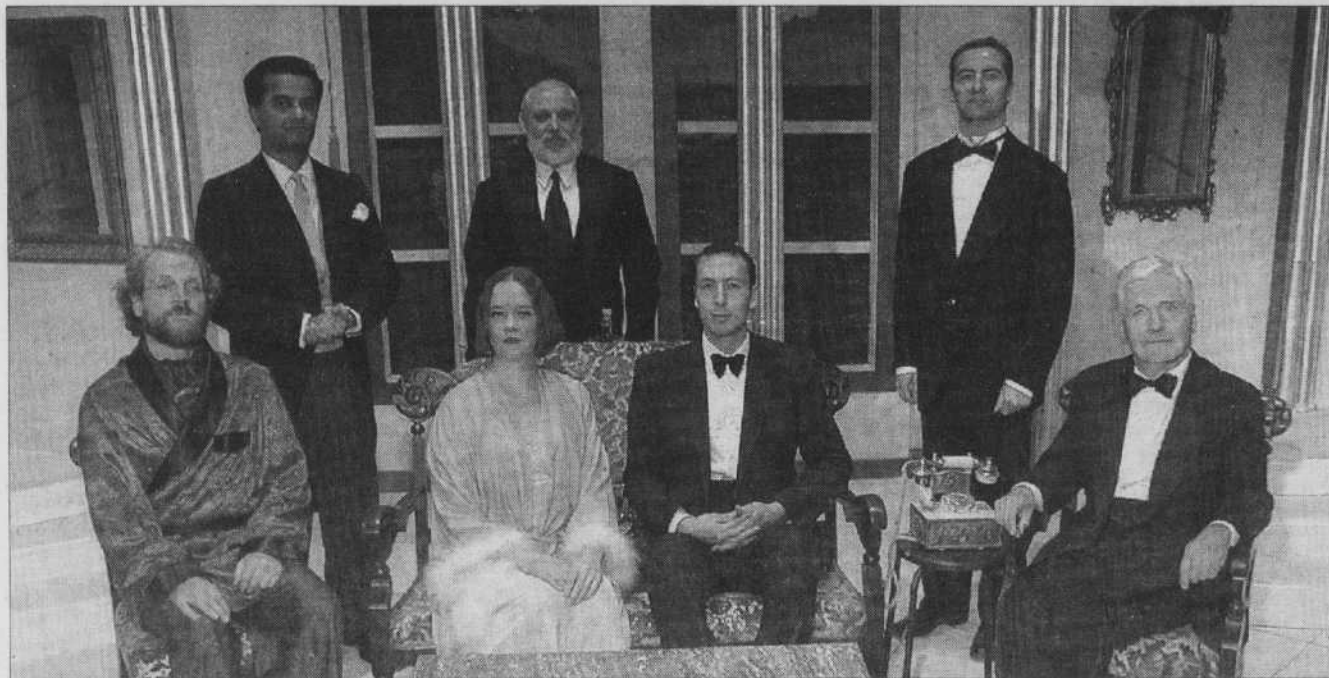
His art is somewhat abstract; he chooses figures which, when added to one another, form something people can relate to and can be found in nature at a microscopic level.

## Four charities to benefit from fund-raisers

Fearing the worst for his charge, Turai, the inveterate playwright, seeks to salvage the relationship by writing a one-act play that he forces Almady and Ilona to perform. The humiliated actors must repeat the lines, transcribed by Turai from the previous night's encounter, and try to convince Adam their infidelity was only part of a play.

Molnar uses the device of a play within a play to blur the gray area between reality and illusion while exploring the relativity of morals and truth. Few of the characters emerge uncompromised as the elaborate ruse unfolds. The aging Almady, with a wife and children elsewhere, sets events in motion by relentlessly pursuing the prima donna he helped to create. Ilona, whose stage career has prospered under Almady's tutelage, hesitates to reject him even though she's engaged to Adam. And Turai, the meticulous playwright, fabricates an elaborate fiction to protect the play's only innocent, the idealistic Adam.

Turai does so knowing that the lie only delays, but cannot avoid, the inevitable passing of youthful idealism and the thrill of first love.

"A central theme is the loss of dignity that the characters suffer as a result of their actions," said director Sunil Mahtani. "The play's story is how they regain that dignity - with hilarious results."

Director Mahtani portrays Mell, the aristocrat's secretary, and rounding out the cast is Terry Millard, who makes his stage debut as the sly butler Johann Dwornitschek, amusingly interpreted as a Hungarian Baldrick incarnate.

Sunshine Theatre has continued its popular practice of donating blocks of tickets to area charities, which sell the tickets and pocket the proceeds. This has allowed the year-old theatre company to play to packed houses even before the all-important "word-of-mouth" hits the streets.

This year, the groups benefiting are the Jardins d'enfants de Sutton pre-school, United Church Jamaica Youth Exchange, Mansonville's Citizen's Advocacy and Townshippers' Association.

The Sunshine Theatre production of *The Play's The Thing* is currently playing through Nov. 28 at the Knowlton Pub Playhouse. The first production of *The Play's The Thing* anywhere in the world was at the Great Neck Playhouse in Long Island, New York, in the P.G. Wodehouse adaptation on Oct. 21, 1926. Wodehouse shares with Molnar a fascination with the decay of the gentry, whose mettle is burnt out but who still cling tenaciously to the last vestiges of the privileges of rank.

Wodehouse built a successful career on this theme with his two most memorable creations, the bumbling and hopelessly thick dandy Bertie Wooster and his imperturbable butler Jeeves.

The principal character of *The Play's The Thing*, producer Sandor Turai, shares a key trait with Jeeves: In the midst of almost certain disaster, Turai is able to construct a happy ending by manipulating those around him as if characters in a play.

"The play blurs the lines between fact and fantasy," said Donald Wilson, who co-founded Sunshine Theatre with Kate Wisdom and Sunil Mahtani.

It opens as producer Sandor Turai (Donald Wilson), accompanied by his collaborator Manky (Patrick Godon), arranges to meet his young protégé, composer Albert Adam (Brendan Rhodes) at an aristocrat's home on the Italian Riviera. Turai knows that Adam's fiancée, the prima donna Ilona Szabo (Heather Coutts) is also a guest and has planned a surprise reunion. His plans are thwarted when he, Manky and Adam overhear Ilona in her room with Almady (Doug Hooper), an aging actor and former lover who pleads with her to resume their affair.

Young Adam, caught up in the worship of his first love, is crushed by her apparent infidelity.

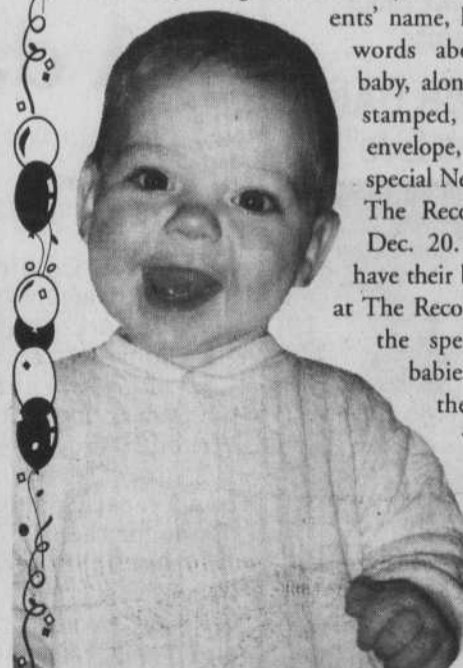

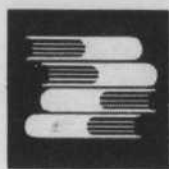

## Three stories by Pulitzer Prize-winner

'Women with Men' by Richard Ford

Twice, Richard Ford has written novels about Frank Bascombe, the novelist turned sportswriter whose humour and basic American goodness, which falls down now and then, is an honest portrayal of a modern man trying to find a little love and respect. His second novel featuring Bascombe, 'Independence Day,' won the Pulitzer Prize and the PEN/Faulkner award in the same year.

In 'Women with Men,' Ford returns to the short story genre, with three stories about ordinary men and women going through difficult times. Full of nuance, genuine pathos, description without intrusion and a myriad of insights, it is a book worth returning to many times.

Martin Austin, 'The Womanizer,' has had a few affairs during the 22 years he's been married to his beautiful wife, Barbara. On a trip to Paris, he becomes enamoured with Josephine Belliard, an editor, though he decides against becoming her lover. On his return, shocked by his wife's admissions of being unhappy, he returns to Paris, convinced that love will grow from his friendship. When Martin decides to

take Josephine's spoiled child for a walk, all that is destroyed and Martin's thoughts return to Barbara.

The 17-year old narrator of 'Jealous,' living in Montana, goes to see his recently divorced mother with his aunt Doris. Doris, similar in age to his mother, is an adult not totally in the adult world: During the car ride, she pulls out a bottle of peppermint schnapps and regales the narrator with intimacies of his father and mother and herself. The trip includes a stop at a bar and an unexpected event.

Doris, all honesty and foolishness, is his link between his mother and father.

'Occidentals' tells the story of Charley Matthews, a recently divorced first-time novelist and the big-hearted girlfriend to whom he feels superior. The two of them are on a trip to Paris.

At day's end, Helen, a not-so-recovering cancer victim, turns out to be full of wit and intelligence, though not so bouncy and upbeat as Charley may have assumed. There are some hilarious scenes around Paris with two old friends of Helen they bump into.

Each thought and gesture of every character is as telling as what they say. The interior life is equally as important as the exterior, perhaps more. Characters agonize over how they appear and the impressions they make. Ford's American descriptions of Paris are full of wry, intelligent observation that is intrinsically American.

The American pursuit of happiness in 'Women with Men' is made universal.

## A dark holiday in Amsterdam

This dark novel, winner of 1998's Booker Prize, displays McEwan's subtle, wry humour as he offers us a lesson in morality. Clive Linley and Vernon Halliday are best friends. Clive is a procrastinating, self-important composer struggling to complete a symphony for the end of the millennium: "to mourn the passing century and all its senseless cruelty, and to celebrate its brilliant inventiveness". Vernon is a newspaper editor in conflict with his

co-workers over the necessary ingredients that make a top-selling newspaper. These two central characters are linked by their former lover, Molly, a wild, unconventional woman who has become a legend in the novel.

A preventable rape and an unnecessary scandalization of a political leader's name lead to betrayals and revenge. Clive and Vernon share a strong drive to achieve their career goals at the cost of other people, and eventually at the cost of their friendship.

McEwan reveals the consequences of placing one's self-interest over the needs of others in this novel. He shows us how we often delude ourselves into believing our judgments and actions are free

from all personal considerations (such as competition, pride, greed, revenge.) The metaphor of classical music is used to convey the humanitarian ideals of the past compared to our individualistic society today: "a humanistic tradition which had always acknowledged the enigma of human nature; it was time to accept that a public performance was a 'secular communion'".

McEwan conveys the conflict between humanity's essential aspects: emotion and intellect. The surprise ending reveals McEwan's dark humour and irony. This is an intriguing, complex and unsettling book that keeps you wondering after the last page is turned.

In this sentimental comedy, Grant plays William, a struggling bookstore owner in Notting Hill, London. Being divorced, William does not believe in love, but he changes his mind when Anna Scott (Roberts) - the world's most famous American actress - enters his bookstore. Thus, their two worlds collide. Unfortunately, their love is threatened by the mass media, and by lifestyle and class differences.

NOTTING HILL's witty dialogue, its eccentric yet warm characters, and its funny and touching performances are the film's strengths.

Roger Michell, the film's director, presents us with an idealistic vision of love. In this film, love breaks all the rules and it overcomes all barriers. NOTTING HILL's premise is that regardless of our class, status, gender, age, or ethnicity, we all share

the basic need to be loved, as Anna Scott says: "I'm just a girl standing in front of a boy, asking him to love her."

Romance is alive in NOTTING HILL. Allow yourself to dream and travel with Hugh Grant and Julia Roberts thorough the colourful, romantic streets of Notting Hill, London.

**LIFE IS BEAUTIFUL**

Italian filmmaker Roberto Benigni wrote (with the collaboration of Vincenzo Cerami) as well as directed and acted in LIFE IS BEAUTIFUL. This dramatic comedy's cast is composed of Nicoletta Braschi, Giustino Durano, Giorgio Centrani, and Sergio Brustic.

This is a painful, yet miraculous story that begins in pre-World War II Italy. Guido (Benigni), a Jew, moves to the city for better wages. There he meets a "princess", Dora (Braschi), and falls in love with her. With his tricks and charms, Guido steals Dora's heart. Out of this union, Giosue (Giorgio Centrani) is born. The years pass and they live blissfully, but their lives are interrupted by the war: Giosue, Guido, and Dora are sent to a con-

centration camp. Despite the hardships (and conditions) that Guido faces in the concentration camp, he maintains his imagination and positivity to ensure the survival of his loved ones.

Benigni's approach to the Holocaust is sensitive and humorous. Thus, the film erases the ugliness of this historical event. LIFE IS BEAUTIFUL has a rare humanistic quality. The screenplay is well developed and the characters are profoundly attaching and funny.

**ARLINGTON ROAD**

Experience paranoia at its highest intensity in Mark Pellington's dark and disturbing film, ARLINGTON ROAD. This film reminds us of the Oklahoma City bombing, and it reinforces the end-of-the-century anxiety.

Michael Faraday (Jeff Bridges), a devoted history professor, is fascinated by the American underground. One day while Michael is driving home from work, he finds his neighbours' child (Spencer Treat Clark) injured and bleeding in the middle of the street. He brings the child to the hospital and saves his life, and as a result

befriends the child's parents (Tim Robbins and Joan Cusack). As their friendship develops, Faraday discovers that his neighbours hide something behind their perfect facade. Perhaps Faraday should let sleeping dogs lie.

ARLINGTON ROAD is a portrayal of the world as a hellish place where we have no control over our own lives. We cannot trust our government nor our neighbours, we cannot depend on police and federal agents for protection, nor can we rely on the media's so-called truthful information.

This thriller's sound effects, music, camera work and its oblique angles, and the contrast of light and shadow effectively create tension and anxiety. Performances by Bridges and Robbins are convincing.

After watching ARLINGTON ROAD, you might want to reconsider being friendly with your neighbours.

# Tim Burton loves his horror

As usual, Tim Burton looks as though he's just emerged from an Animal House party. There's the trademark rat's nest of hair. There's the funereal wardrobe which this morning consists of a drab black suit and an even drabber midnight-blue shirt. And even though it's a dull Manhattan morning and even duller in the hotel suite where Burton is meeting reporters, his eyes are invisible behind grotesquely oversized blue-tinted sunglasses which look as though they've been acquired at a rummage sale.

But what the heck. The idiosyncratic filmmaker is in an upbeat and talkative mood today, combining two irresistible attributes - the eternal child possessed by a sense of wonder, and the savvy director with a visual style unique in Hollywood.

For example, only in a Burton interview would you expect an animated discussion on the niceties of ensuring that a severed head rolls properly after it's lopped off. This was one of the challenges that the 41-year-old director faced when filming his new supernatural thriller, Sleepy Hollow.

The new Paramount film, which

opens Nov. 19, is a very loose adaptation of Washington Irving's classic horror story about the terrorization of an 18th-century New England community by a sinister headless horseman. "This was a story I'd known from childhood," Burton says happily. "There's something very powerful about that image of a headless horseman. I was fascinated by the visceral conscious power of that image."

This version of The Legend Of Sleepy Hollow is very much a Tim Burton film in the same way that the first two Batman movies and a quirky science fiction thriller like Mars Attacks were filtered through his mock-gothic sensibility.

So in Burton's treatment of Irving's story, the rampaging horseman is a good deal more homicidal than in the original - which means his blade cuts a mean swathe and many of Sleepy Hollow's most illustrious citizens end up losing their heads.

Since Burton is a director whose obsession with artistic symmetry and visual impact even governs the way drops of blood are photographed landing on a surface, he didn't simply want his heads to roll haphazardly. They had to do so in an esthetically satisfying fashion. Often, this meant take after take after take.

"Sometimes I felt like a very bad bowler endlessly trying to roll a head to hit the right mark," he sighs. "Sometimes I did it in a couple of takes. Sometimes I seemed to be rolling heads endlessly."

Burton is proud of the cast he assembled. It includes Johnny Depp as hapless hero Ichabod Crane, who in this version is not a fallible schoolmaster but a fallible policeman instead; Christina Ricci as the village maiden he falls in love with; Michael Gambon as her enigmatic father; and Christopher Walken as the Horseman.

Burton, who has been a fan of horror movies all his life, says Sleepy Hollow gave him the first real opportunity "to make a film like the ones I watched as a kid." So he's upset that in the United States, his film has been slapped with a Restricted rating by the Motion Picture Association Of America - which means many young people won't be able to see it, unless they sneak in.

Burton has had trouble with the ratings board ever since he made his first movie, a short called Frankenweenie, a spin on Frankenstein which sees a kid bring his dead dog back to life. He complains that the MPAA is depriving kids of the joy he used to experience as a youngster attending monster movies.

## New season of CTV drama series finds focus in City Hall

Created by the husband-and-wife team of producer Pierre Sarrazin and screenwriter Suzette Couture, CTV's *The City* was conceived as an ensemble character drama without an anchor.

A police station, a developer's office and an inner-city church run by Father Shane (Aidan Devine) were among the dozen or so recurring settings in the hour-long series.

The drama came out of the unexpected ways in which characters from diverse segments of Toronto's society interacted, and the show remained true to this vision for the first season. But, as the second season begins on Friday, Nov. 26, viewers will see that the series has been retooled.

Gone is the notion of an anchorless drama; the action is now centered on City Hall, where Rosedale liberal Katharine Strachan (Torri Higginson)

won a council seat last year. Gone as well is Father Shane, with barely a backward glance at his once central relationship with Katharine. After the producers moved the on-screen action, they decided to separate church from state, so to speak.

"We were roaming all through the city last year," Couture says, "but now we have to settle down. We have to find a place where all the people meet. It's part of the evolution of the series."

Though Father Shane departs before the new season begins, most of the rest of the characters return, sharing the stage with some new faces.

Katharine, now living apart from her scheming husband, Jack (John Ralston), takes up with a law-and-order cop (James Gallanders) whose trigger-happy actions are being investigated by City Hall. She also meets with opposition in her new job thanks to a newly added nemesis, played by Larissa Laskin.

Also returning is someone whose presence will surprise viewers: the drug pusher played by Jody Racicot, who appeared to have been killed last season. Although the character's real name didn't come up then, the self-possessed hoodlum is now identified as Crispin St. James.
