Georgeville Troupe plays it for laughs

The Georgeville Troupe is mining familiar territory with its latest theatrical production, the comedy *Play On*.

Opening Saturday afternoon, this play-within-a-play sketches the antics of an amateur theatre group who botch up their production of an Edwardian mystery which centres around a missing di-

amond.

"This is very appropriate for us," said John Dickerson, who plays Billie Carew, the know-it-all amateur who in turn plays Stephen Sellers, the wealthy businessman in the mystery. "None of us are in the theatre in real life... we all have different careers and this is just part-time fun for us."

Judging from the cast's high level of enthusiasm and energy, fun is what this production is all about.

"We're still laughing over some of the parts," said Sonia Rocke. "We had one disastrous rehearsal because we were just laughing too hard."

As the dizzy-blonde socialite Diana Lassiter, Rocke has the talent and energy to turn a rehearsal into the real thing when she steps on stage with John Hoblyn, the henpecked Henry who plays Lord Dudley.

"Fiddlesticks, hogwash, damned superstitious lot, the curse, I mean," expostulates Lord Dudley.

"I don't mean the diamond was floating in his tub," replies Diana.

"What eh?"

"He was!"

The constant switching of parts keeps the players on their toes.

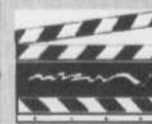

"You have to remember when you come to your lines, 'Am I the first character or the second?' It's very confusing," said Dickerson. "My characters are complete opposites; in the play-within-a-play, I'm an uppercrust gentleman with a strong British accent while Billie, my other character, is the kind of guy who's never put a suit on in his life."

Most of the cast have been coming back year after year and the camaraderie shows in the rehearsal chatter and excitement.

"I love your cleavage," someone shouts at Maureen Cameron, Lady Margaret in the mystery, who sports an extensively padded, rustling black satin 1890s-style evening dress.

Cameron explains it was originally designed for a man when the Georgeville Revue began 12 years ago.

"The Revue was basically a talent show made up of different skits, ranging from dancing to singing — the community got together and put on a two-hour show and the money raised was for the community association," added Dickerson. "But the troupe felt there was a need for a change, and we decided to do a full-length play. Our first year, six years ago, we did *The At-*

tempted *Murder of Peggy Sweetwater.*"

This year's play was chosen by consulting director Lucy Hoblyn whose parents, John and Sarah, both appear in the production. Hoblyn played the maid in a Knowlton Players four years ago and her husband, Danny McCauley, directed the Georgeville Troupe's first three plays. Monique Saint-Pierre is this year's director.

Some of the parts on stage are played close to life. Tammy Seale, director of last year's *Spooks*, plays the director in *Play On*, while Michelle Otto, the stage manager last year, plays the role of stage manager.

Most of the props are donated or on loan, but the troupe was able to pur-

chase a curtain for their stage from last year's proceeds.

"We put a bit of the money back into the group," said John Hoblyn. "But the rest goes to the community centre."

There are just three performances of the Georgeville Troupe's *Play On*: A 2 p.m. matinee on Saturday, May 6, and 7 p.m. showings on both Saturday and Sunday, May 6 and 7. Tickets are \$6 for adults and \$4 for children, available at the door before the performance or can be reserved by calling the Georgeville General Store at 819-843-2417. All performances are at the Murray Memorial Hall.

The Church Street Café will present country singer Bill McMurray and First Stone Cast, to be followed up by Hooked on Bluegrass.

For this Friday night's performance at the Church Street Café, McMurray has assembled a group of excellent musicians from across the Townships map. Hailing from Victoriaville himself, McMurray will be calling in Terry Howell from Island Brook to play fiddle, Larry Comeau from Granby to play dobro, Jules Fradette from Marieville to play

banjo, Serge Robichaud from Sherbrooke to play lead guitar, and our own Perry Beaton of Lennoxville to play stand-up bass.

And then the original, world famous Hooked on Bluegrass, a band comprised of six very talented musicians who spent many hours picking bluegrass tunes together before even thinking of forming a band.

The band's fearless leader, Gordon Cameron, continues to be the heavy-weight backbone, 5-string banjo picker

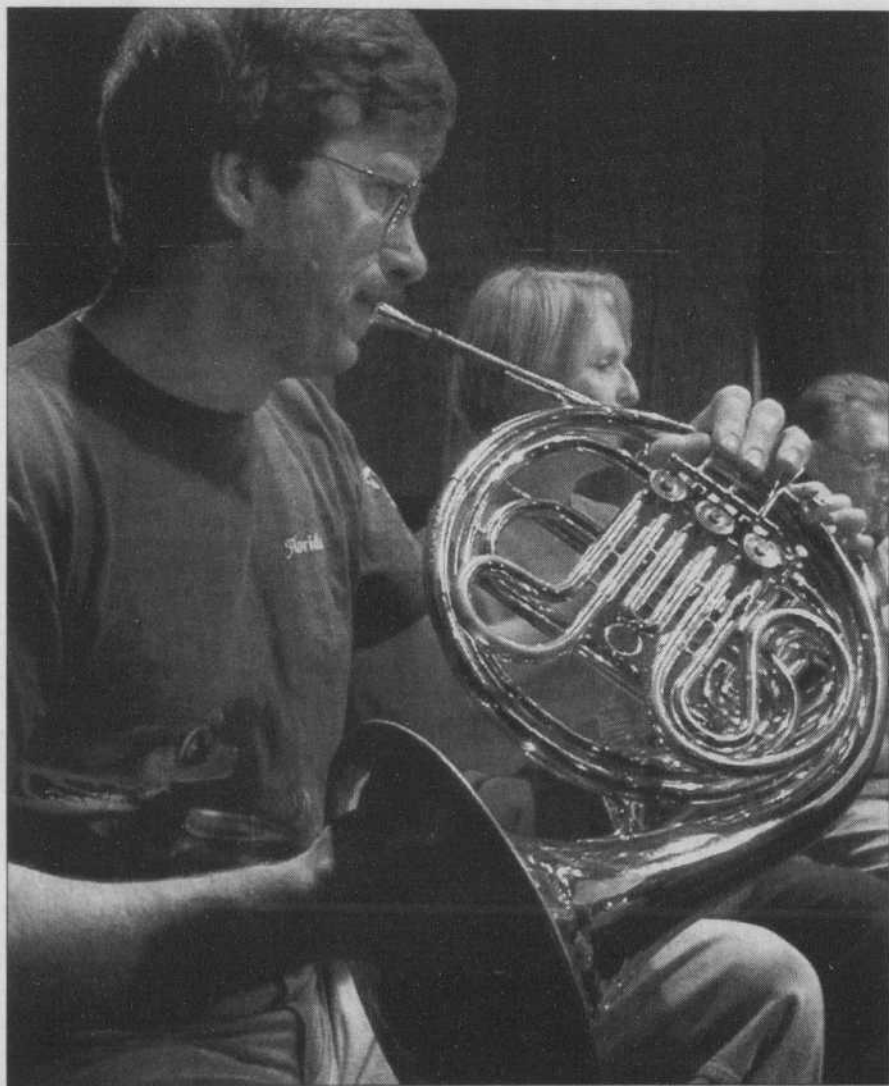
of the band. Cameron sings lead on many tunes, and a sweet, sweet harmony on others. Thomas Kilbride, better known as Tommy Kilowatt (because of his lifelong vocation as an industrial electrician) plays solid rhythm guitar and sings lead on many good old-time country and bluegrass tunes. Ernie Schumacher was forced into playing mandolin because the band already had four guitar players, and Cameron can't play banjo and mandolin at the same time (though Lord knows, he has tried). Ernie sings lead on many of his own tunes and just looks good on stage the rest of the time. And then Terry Howell, the Cookshire Haygrinder (from Island Brook) will be back up on stage, scraping that fiddle in his own inimitable and fine style.

Larry Comeau will be back up also, playing dobro, guitar, and singing lead and harmony. Larry's roots go back to picking bluegrass tunes with his father

and friends in New Brunswick. Perry Benedik will round out the band with his solid bass rhythm, so important to bluegrass music.

The music will begin at 8 p.m. at the Church Street Café, located in the Gertrude Scott Hall of Lennoxville United Church, corner of Queen and Church in the heart of Lennoxville. Coffee, juice, and munchies will be available. This is a smoke-free venue.

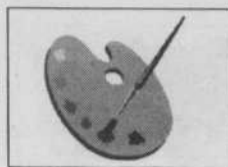

Jury's choice at Bishop's exhibition

The world of contemporary art is a major focus of the Art Gallery of Bishop's University.

Throughout the fall of 1999, the gallery put out the call for submissions from professional and emerging artists and curators of the Eastern Townships. From 25 applicants, five were chosen to exhibit their work in 'Vernissage ... 5 Contemporary artists from the Eastern Townships'.

"The jury was looking for what in their inner feeling was important in the art," said Gaëtane Verna, director of the gallery. "Each of the members of the jury is an artist from a different field. I usually choose the exhibitions here, so it's good to sit back and look at other people's choices."

By the time the gallery got in touch with the artists, some of the juried works had been sold, but Verna met with artists and chose works in the same spirit.

An intriguing collection of pencil drawings by Francine Boivin and French text by Daniel Roy, both of Westbury,

comprise 'Fictitious Bonds are Drawn from the Eye to the Soul'.

Scrolls of text hang in front of a drawing of compartmentalized faces and female nudes. These nudes are full of the feelings and anxieties present at this turn of the century. The text examines everyday male-female relationships and memory.

Fish, a creature rich in literary and biblical symbolism is the subject of a series of works by Louise Gauthier-

Mitchell of Stanstead. The fish fly, featured in a number of the works was actually used by the ancient Macedonians. Not confined to the canvas alone, Gauthier-Mitchell has created a winged mixed-media box entitled 'Pas de deux' and 'Case', an oil on wood box. Both 'Point d'O' and 'Suspension', two large paintings in oil and acrylic combine fantasy and reality. In the multi-layered 'Suspension', a native and European figure share the centre of the painting.

'An Angel Come out of the Shell', by Jean Gaudet of Sutton, is inspired by the sculpture of neo-classical Italian sculptor Canova. Canova's angel is flanked by a large shell and a wing. Gaudet puts nature side by side with his portrayal of the statue, reminding us of the connection of man with the earthly and the divine.

Arnaud Gosselin of Hatley, finds inspiration in the natural beauty of the townships. 'Massawippi: Deep Waters' is full of depth and colour.

'To Come out of the Wood' brings to mind farmer's fields and woods. Gosselin writes of his work, "I am not doing landscapes, but exploring a surface."

The 'To Go Inland' colour prints are from a large series by Normand Rajotte of Montreal. The mysteries of unexplored nature are Rajotte's terrain.

From the cracked earth imprinted with raccoon, bird and human traces of 'To Go Inland #5,' to the shimmering water of #1 and the mussels and footprints on the beach of #7, man's hidden presence is felt.

The show runs May 3 to June 4. Opening reception: Wednesday, May 10, 5-7 p.m. in the presence of the artists.

Bishop's University's Knowlton Centre for Continuing Education has released its spring and summer calendar of non-credit workshops, shows and talks.

- On Friday, June 9, from 7 to 9:30 p.m., art historian Nancy Ring will present a slide presentation entitled "The Lives and Works of Women Painters — 1550 to the Present." Dr. Ring has a Ph.D. in art history and has specialized in the study of women artists.

- The annual Art Show will take place July 22 and 23 at the centre. The show features works in diverse media produced by students enrolled in the art program.

- Kathleen Patton is currently offering a workshop on Meditation (April

18 to May 30) "to learn and practice meditation." The classes meet Tuesdays at 7:30 to 9 p.m. She currently teaches meditation in Knowlton and Sutton.

- Poet Judith Avinger will offer a workshop in Creative Writing from May 3 to 24. Avinger, the author of "The Empty Bowl," invites students to "open the door to inspiration through the practice of writing." The class will meet Wednesdays from 2 to 4:30 p.m.

- Granby artist Hélène Plourde will offer a workshop entitled "Mixed Media: Plaster and Wood on Acrylics" on May 12 and 13. The class will meet on Friday from 7 to 9 p.m. and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Plourde has taught workshops at Maison Bruck in Cowansville and has exhibited throughout the Eastern Townships.

- On June 17, from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., Bernice Sorge, a practicing art therapist, will offer "What is Art Therapy?" This hands-on workshop requires no prior experience in art.

- On July 4 and 6, from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., artist and UQAM professor Louise Fournel will offer "The Art of Scrapbook Making" (in French). "Scrapbooking" is a new form of writing that

combines text, illustration and photos to write and document a life story. The workshop will cover writing, collage and decoupage.

- On July 10 and 14, from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Louise Jamet will offer "Collage and Mixed Media." This workshop will include an introduction to papermaking. Jewelry designer and artist Anke VanGinhoven will collaborate in teaching this workshop. VanGinhoven is a renown Sutton artist who has studied papermaking in Japan.

- On July 18, Louise Jamet will offer "Introduction to Papermaking" from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

- From July 24 to 28, Seymour Segal will offer "Painting: Drawing Upon Nature," from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Dunham artist Segal has taught at Bishop's University and the Sadie Bronfman Centre in Montreal.

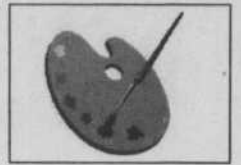

Quilter keeps family in stitches

Picturesque 19th-century homes dot Clarenceville's quiet North Front Street. One of the most neatly tended is home to two sisters who have lived there for the last two decades.

Alice Peverley, her sister Ilse Hertel and brother-in-law Uli Hertel share the quaint brick home that appears deceptively small from the outside, but inside, unfolds into a succession of linked additions that comfortably houses two families. Outside, their meticulously maintained gardens routinely make the Peverleys and Hertels perennial finalists in the village's annual summer garden competition, despite the fact they rarely enter their gardens in the contest.

However, Peverley is known less for her gardening skills as for her skills as a quilter.

Peverley, now 82, has lived in her Clarenceville home since 1983. Prior to her arrival, she lived with her husband (now deceased) in Florida for 16 years.

"My husband was sick and needed a warm climate," she said, speaking from her living room where she is surrounded by her own handiwork.

Now into her ninth decade, she remains vivacious and articulate, though she sometimes defers to sister Ilse when it comes to remembering dates. She ex-

plained that she took up quilting to keep herself busy after her husband's death and since then, by best estimates, has completed more than 100 quilts.

She estimates it takes between four-to-six weeks to complete one of her hand-stitched quilts.

"She works 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. when she's working on a quilt," piped in sister Ilse, accounting for the remarkably short time for a creation that never sees a sewing machine needle.

Yet Alice rarely sells a quilt. As one of eight children, she has plenty of demand for the treasures from siblings and their families. Most years, she also donates a quilt to the annual Clarenceville craft fair to be raffled off as the grand prize. This year was the exception when illness prevented her from working.

She currently has no quilt in progress. Too busy, she says, working with Ilse and Uli on early season garden work. When that is under control, her next project is to make a quilt for her brother, who is in a home for the elderly in Montreal.

"His own quilt was stolen while he was in the shower," said Ilse, who knows the thief got a good deal.

Alice and Ilse, along with six other siblings, were raised in Germany. Their father's job as a civil servant meant frequent moves for the family. After the

end of the second World War, seven of the eight children immigrated to the U.S. and Canada, with only one remaining in Germany. The sisters recall that quilting was not a typical German art form and it was Alice's sojourn in Florida that enabled her to learn the craft.

The bedrooms throughout the Clarenceville house are adorned with Alice's work. From a traditional starburst pattern to a lattice of grape clusters, each is unique. From a quilt chest, Alice unfolds a quilt delicately adorned with hand-embroidered violets and violas.

In addition to quilts, she also makes embroidered pillows to match a quilt or simply to adorn a sofa. No one pattern or style dominates her quilting, rendering each one a work of art unto itself. Some are full of rich colours, while oth-

ers play on textures. One small, white pillow is adorned with patterns of white-threaded French knots, each resembling small pearls.


Sister Ilse, too, has an artistic flair: She studied rosemaling (traditional Norwegian decorative art) in Bedford from local teacher Jack Paton, from whom many of the area's most accomplished rosemalers learned their craft. Ilse also makes stained-glass art and her many works hang throughout the home.

For the present, though, there is gardening to be done and the quilting and stained glass take a backseat to clearing away the winter's debris. Despite the fact there are three months to go before the garden judging, as long as Alice and Ilse are healthy, it seems likely the community's other gardeners will just have to wait their turn for a first prize.



De grands moments jazz et blues en perspective

Encore une fois, côté musique, la scène estrienne nous propose cette semaine de grands moments. En effet, deux parmi les plus talentueux musiciens et guitaristes du Québec sont de passage chez nous, à savoir Steve Hill et Michel Cusson.

Hill, jeune guitariste de blues originaire de Trois-Rivières, est pratiquement considéré comme un phénomène tant sa maîtrise du genre et de son instrument suscite l'admiration. À 25 ans, il se balade déjà avec deux compacts sous le bras, dont le second, *Call It What You Will*, lui a valu une nomination aux Juno Awards pour le meilleur album blues de l'année. Les amateurs auront sans doute droit à un spectacle riche en décibels, ce soir, au Théâtre Granada, alors que Hill sera accompagné de Bob Stagg aux claviers, à la guitare et à la trompette, de Tim Loftin à la basse, de Scotty Doubt à la guitare et de Sébastien Langlois à la batterie.

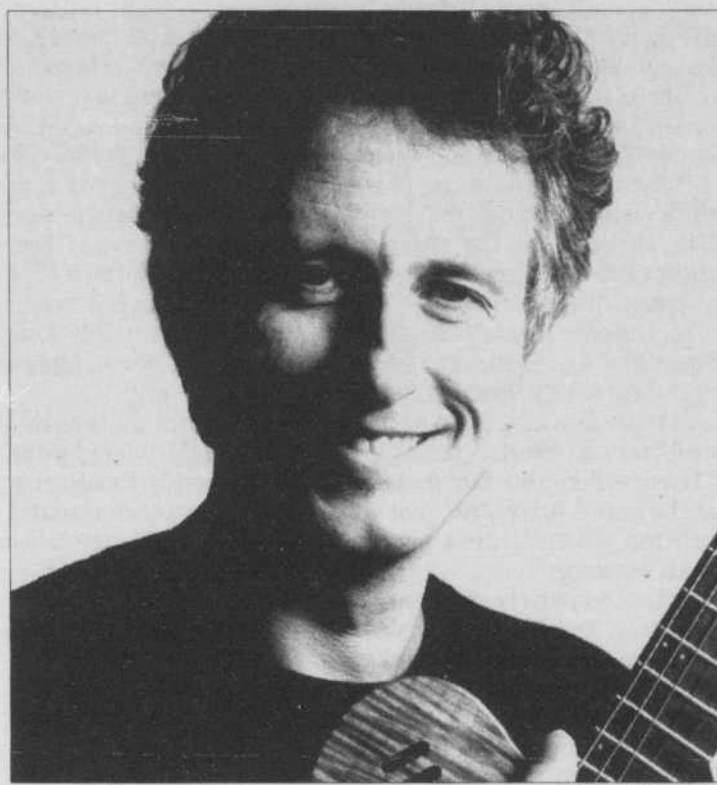
Si la notoriété grandissante de Hill dépasse de plus en plus le milieu blues proprement dit, Michel Cusson est sans doute l'un des musiciens jazz qui a le plus contribué à la popularité du genre au Québec. Même ceux qui ne l'ont pas suivi au sein du réputé groupe Uzeb connaissent ses compositions, puisqu'il est notamment l'auteur de plusieurs musiques de films et du fameux thème musical de la série *Omertà*.

Musicien en constante recherche, Cusson se tourne depuis quelque temps vers les rythmes du monde. Son dernier

album *Camino* s'inspire, dit-on, des folklores étrangers, entre autres d'Italie, de Cuba, de l'Europe de l'Est et du Moyen-Orient, et il se propose de nous le faire découvrir, demain soir, sur les planches du Vieux Clocher de Magog.

Un autre cousin français

Quant à nos petits cousins d'Outre-Atlantique, on dirait bien qu'ils se sont donné le mot pour venir nous rendre visite. Après le Belge Semal, l'inimitable Higelin, voilà que le frerot du célèbre Renaud, Thierry Séchan, nous arrive à Sherbrooke. Il faut croire que ce dernier est en train de prendre racine au Québec puisque son second album, *Tu seras comme le ciel*, a entièrement été réalisé chez nous et instigué, paraît-il, par Daniel Lavoie. Séchan se produit ce soir, au Vieux Clocher de Sherbrooke, entouré de Luc

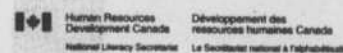
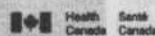

Aaron Eckhart, Nice Guy

Julia Roberts showed co-star how to deal with fame

Aaron Eckhart plays a nice guy in Erin Brockovich. That fact, coupled with the film's phenomenal success, should do wonders for the 32-year-old actor's on-screen image.

Let's face it, his image needs a boost. Until the chance came along to play Julia Roberts's lovable biker boyfriend, Eckhart was in danger of being remembered primarily for his portrayal of one of the most loathsome characters in movie history.

It happened in 1997 with *In the Company of Men*, a movie that polarized critics, many of whom were repelled by the subject matter. They were particularly offended by Eckhart's portrayal of a vicious and predatory male who - just for the hell of it - sets out to emotionally destroy a young handicapped woman by seducing her and then abandoning her.

People still ask Eckhart why he made that movie. For him, the answer remains obvious: he thought the character would be interesting to play and he wanted to work for filmmaker Neil LaBute, a writer-director with a blood-shot vision of personal relationships.

Eckhart expected raw and angry reactions to the movie, especially from women. He wasn't disappointed. "Women did come up to me and told me what they thought of me. They threw a lot of expletives at me."

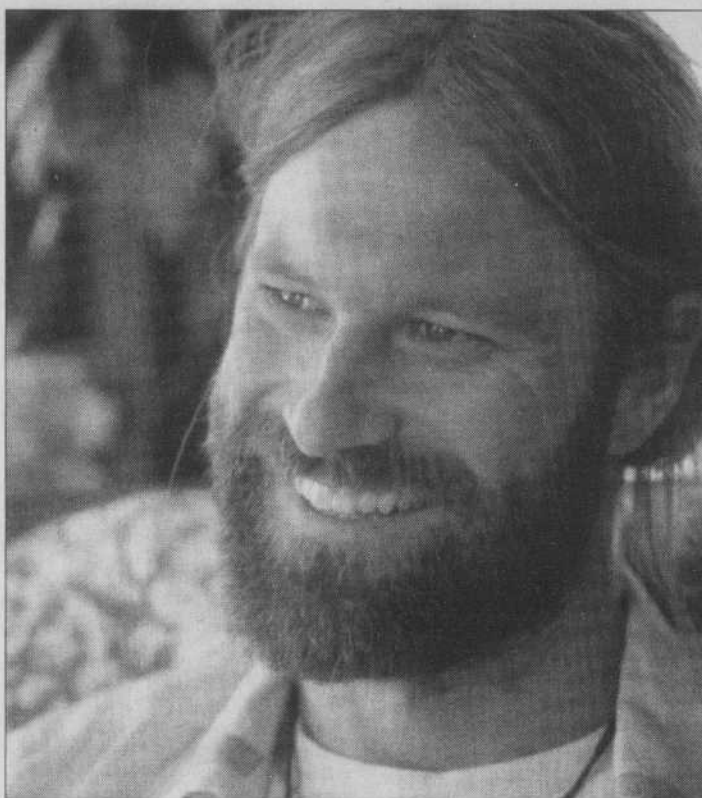
But he was less prepared to have women coming on to him as a result of the movie. One outraged female moviegoer said in one breath that she really hated him and in the next breath asked for a date. "What are you doing next Monday?" she wanted to know. That bothered Eckhart. He was also troubled by some men who managed to ignore the movie's stark moral concerns and instead told them they admired his character because he was such a "good businessman."

Eckhart has made several movies since *In the Company of Men*. He worked for LaBute twice more - first in another controversial project, *Your Friends and Neighbors*, in which he played a sexually inadequate male, and later in the still-to-be-released *Nurse Betty*, a black comedy about a waitress who falls in love with a soap star.

He also worked in two mainstream movies - with Elisabeth Shue in *Molly*, which was a flop, and in Oliver Stone's football saga, *Any Given Sunday*. But Erin Brockovich is the type of breakout movie that could do wonders for his career while also giving him a kinder, gentler profile.

"I am interested in creating a character I haven't done before, to exploit the other side of my personality," the actor says. "This was a good opportunity for me to exploit the vulnerable and sensitive side - to be caring, loving and paternal."

Erin Brockovich appealed to him also because of the chance to work with director Steven Soderbergh and with Julia Roberts. He did the film after *Any Given Sunday* and clearly found Soderbergh to be a relief after Oliver Stone. "They occupy two different worlds, two different styles. Oliver is a frenetic kind of general who likes to work in a battlefield environment. Steven is quieter about it and calmer. Oliver likes to rush around and be consumed by things. Steven is more detached, and has a more sensitive way in terms of creating comfort on the set. It's like having a picnic as opposed to being in Vietnam."

Eckhart, who co-stars in *Erin Brockovich*, was happy to shed the bad guy image he obtained after his performance in the movie *In the Company of Men*.

Roberts was a joy to work with, Eckhart says. "We met each other as human beings and we liked each other from our first meeting. We were there to do a job and that's what we did. I felt

she was gracious and absolutely forthcoming in everything ... a dream to work with in my opinion."

Eckhart says he'd love to earn up to \$20 million a picture, as Roberts does, but he doesn't think he would be as adept as her at coping with the celebrity status.

"She's got a lot of dough - but she's also got a lot of fame. There would be times when we were out bowling trying to get to know each other and a wall of people would be running at her. Her bodyguards took care of it. That I could do without. I thought we were going to war. But I don't think Julia was fazed at all. The whole time I was with her I don't think she was ever uncomfortable with her situation. I felt she knew how to handle it."

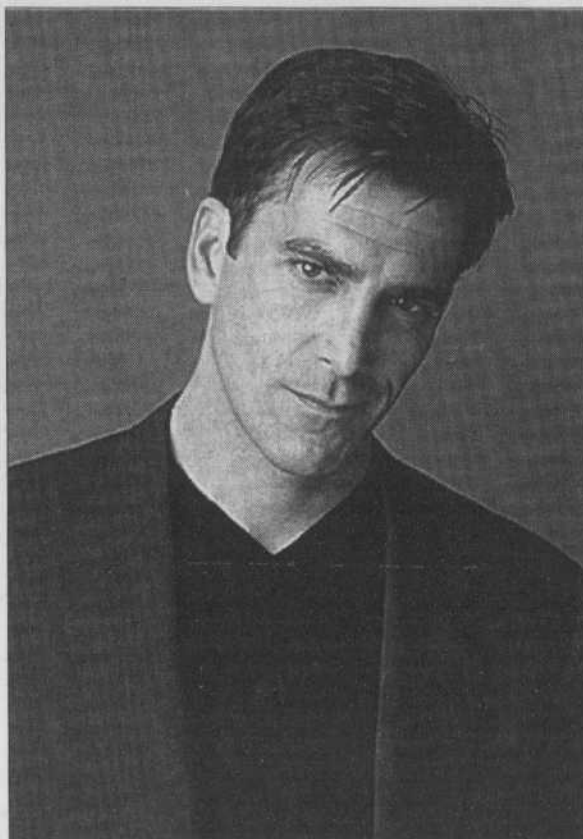

Love and Leukemia

An aimless young woman with more charm than beauty, who is forever at odds with her disapproving father, dumps her high-society fiance for a man she just met — and then finds out he has leukemia. *Cupid & Cate*, premiering Sunday, May 7, on CTV, is the kind of movie that tissue companies thrive on: a sweet and weepy romance whose plot contrivances are willingly overlooked by those who enjoy a good cry. It is not the kind of movie, however, that you normally associate with Hallmark Hall of Fame, the long-running series of dramatic specials that has traditionally adapted plays and works of literature. Inspired by Christina Bartolomeo's novel *Cupid and Diana*, it still seems outside Hallmark's usual range. To its credit, though, *Cupid & Cate*, directed by Brent Shields, is handled with almost as much care as more substantial Hall of Fame programming. The cast is first-rate, and there are echoes of *Terms of Endearment* in its familial dysfunction. The versatile Mary-Louise Parker (above, with Peter Gallagher) plays charming Cate De Angelo, the youngest and least successful daughter of overbearing Dominic (Philip Bosco), a widower who presides over his kinfolk whether they like it or not. After a series of jobs, Cate has bought an upscale secondhand clothing store, but that doesn't impress Daddy, who considers her a dilettante. His other daughters — doctor Francesca (Bebe Neuwirth), model Cynthia (Joanna Going) and perfect housewife Annette (Rebecca Luker) — are the apples of his eye, while Cate is the target of his barbed commentary. Cate's boyfriend is as colourless as her life. Phillip (David Lansbury) is comfortable but not passionate, or even articulate. Their relationship keeps going only because no one has called a halt. When one sister introduces Cate to the affable Harry Dietrich (Peter Gallagher), sparks fly.

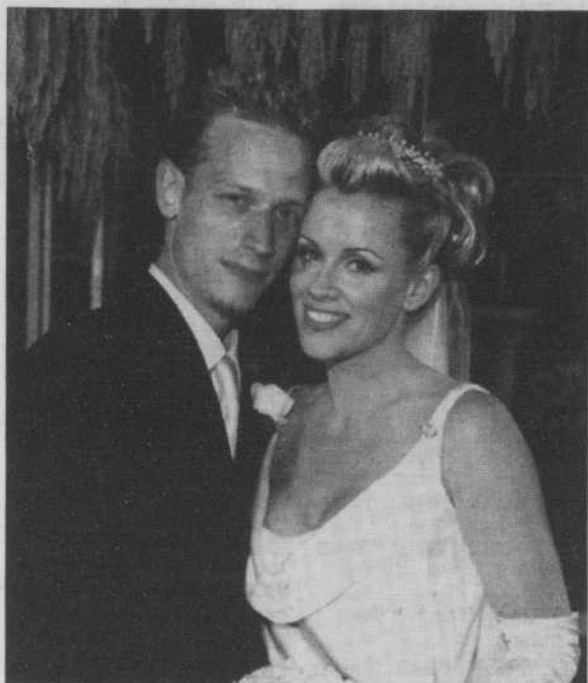
