



# The Benenati poster: A Brome fair tradition



Doreen Benenati's latest work for this year's Brome Fair represents 'the fabric of rural living.'

This year marks the 142nd of the Brome County Agricultural Fair and the 13th consecutive year artist Doreen Benenati has designed the commemorative poster.

This year's motif is sure to please the artistic palates of fair-goers and poster gourmets. The cheery, colorful print depicts an array of farm produce on a kitchen counter; the window behind looks out onto a peaceful pasture peopled with longhorn cattle.

"Each object in the picture represents some aspect of farm life," said Benenati. "The cut flowers, the baking, the harvest of fruits and vegetables and the cows outside, all are a part of the fabric of rural living."

Time spent in the demanding field of graphic arts cultivated a sense of technical excellence for the award-winning artist.

"We are glutted with empty images. I want my work to be visually nourishing," said Benenati, adding her posters are "affordable works of good art."

Benenati said she visualizes the ideas and elements of her painting months ahead.

"When I can see it in my mind, I begin the drawing."

Carefully balancing line and form, she creates an image that leads the eye through the individual objects in the foreground to the gentle contours of the horizon. The finished drawing is covered with a light-colored wash to lend a subtle cohesiveness to the coming hues.

Then she begins adding color. "Very lightly, in layers. It's at this point I lose myself in the process."

The result, when the final highlights are stippled in, is a cheery, sun-splashed moment of life in the country.

As well as her annual Brome Fair opus, Benenati also paints a number of other pieces every year. Some of these are on display at the Robert Senneville art gallery in North Hatley.

She will also be showing 20 works at the Dunham library from Sept. 5 to 27. The vernissage for this show will be held on Sept. 17 "because the weekend of the fifth I'll be at the Brome Fair with my posters."

"I won't be at my traditional booth in the handicrafts building. This year I'll have a place in the main building."

People may find Benenati on the first floor of the round building with her current poster and rapidly disappearing editions from previous years.

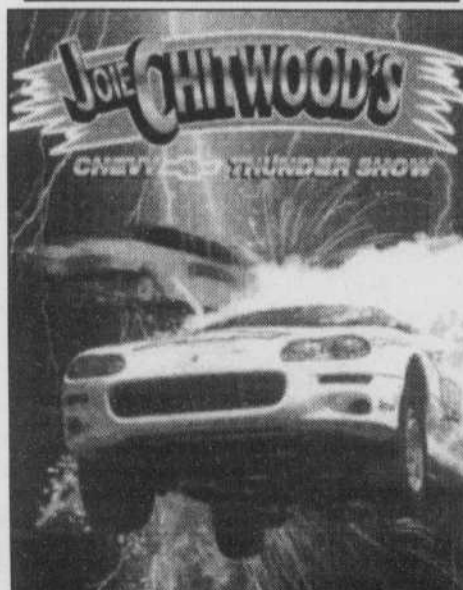

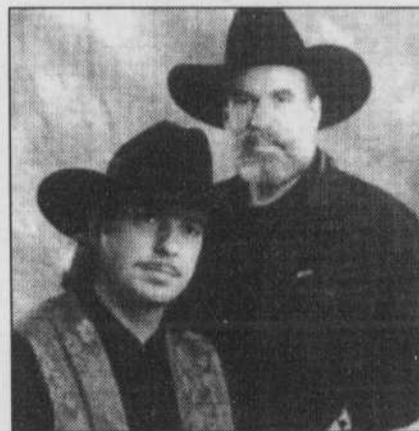

# L'International du Cinéma de L'Estrie Sept. 10 to 20 Much for anglos to see at film fest

From Sept. 10 to 20, L'International du Cinéma de L'Estrie will be serving up several cutting-edge films from around the world. Even better for anglos, this year marks an unprecedented number of English films: A total of eight are being screened out of 24 films and two silent movies.

Festival organizer Hélène Vanier is frank as to why she decided on so many English films for a festival primarily attended by francophones.

"If I'm sure a film is a winner, then I will take it," she said. "There are so many good movies being offered."

Vanier also credits a bigger anglo input, notably from Bishop's University registrar Ann Montgomery, for the increase. Whatever the reason, anglo moviegoers are in for a treat at the fest running primarily at University of Sherbrooke's Centre Culturel.

Here's what's on the anglo menu:

- For anyone who gives a damn, *Gone With the Wind* will be shown, fully restored and digitally remastered, on Sept. 19 at Cinéma 9 in Rock Forest. Considered the first big color film, director David O. Selznick's sweeping adaptation of Margaret Mitchell's novel takes us back to the golden years of film-making. It won 11 Academy Awards and changed the way movies were made.

- English actor and author Stephen Fry plays famous English bard Oscar Wilde in *Wilde* (Sept. 12). Touching on his entire life, Wilde delves into the tragic and fascinating travails of Oscar Wilde, from his courtship of his wife Constance Lloyd and his scandalous affair with Lord Alfred 'Bosie' Douglas to his imprisonment at England's notorious Reading Gaol. Throughout the late Victorian era, Wilde's personality and lifestyle often eclipsed his widely renowned works. The author was utterly obsessed with the young, handsome

Bosie, and their affair did much to destroy Wilde's life and malign his reputation. Yet for all the trouble it caused him, Wilde never apologized for his relationship with Bosie, despite the best efforts of Bosie's father, the Marquess of Queensberry (played by the Full Monty's Tom Wilkinson). All accounts say Fry is a dead ringer for Wilde, in appearance and pose. Fry was named best actor at the Seattle Film Festival this year.

- Directed by Canadians Marco and Mauro La Villa, *Hang the DJ* (Sept. 18) is a documentary-style film that explores the world of the contemporary disc jockey. As the fringe culture of the DJ scene seeps into the mainstream, the cast of characters (New York phenom Junior Vasquez, Roger Sanchez and Q-Bert, among others) struggle to deal with the sudden influx of cash and attention fraught upon them. The buzz quotient on this flick is huge; you might want to check out the Internet sight ([www.hangthedjy.com](http://www.hangthedjy.com)) for some magnificent eye candy.

- Christina Ricci often brings a sadistically twisted quality to her characters. Forgetting about Casper for a second, Ricci is usually the bad seed who knows exactly what she is doing. She did a marvelous job of this in the Anais Nin's *Ice Storm*, where she played a sick little trollop with frightening perfection. She brings this character, with a comic twist, to the *Opposite of Sex* (Sept. 12).

Directed by American Don Roos, Ricci plays Dedee Truit, an uprooted and dejected 16-year-old gone to visit her gay brother Bill (Martin Donovan). Almost immediately after landing on his doorstep, Dedee seduces Bill's boyfriend Matt (Ivan Sergei) and promptly becomes pregnant. She then convinces Matt to steal \$10,000 from her brother so the two can hide out in Los Angeles.

Add consummate straight man Lyle Lovett as the sheriff, Friends's Lisa Kudrow as Bill's uptight friend and The Opposite of Sex has the makings of a black comedy tour de force.

British actor Gary Oldman brings a parade of ugly, spiteful characters in Nil by Mouth (Sept. 16), his directorial debut. Set in a dead-end neighborhood in South London, the movie takes a quasi-autobiographical look at a family on the brink of destruction at the hands of violence, alcohol and drug abuse. The movie has won several awards, including Best Actress at Cannes for Kathy Burke. Unrelentingly brutal, the story is obviously close to Oldman's heart; Nil by Mouth is dedicated to his father.

Take a pretentious but honest sex offender-writer and a down on his luck garbage man and put them into a dingy apartment together and you have Henry Fool (Sept. 13), a film by American director Hal Hartley. Thomas Jay Ryan plays the narcissistic writer penning what he believes to be a work of incalculable importance. He persuades new acquaintance Simon Grim (James Urbaniak) to write poetry. The pair's roles are reversed when Grim's pornographic prose becomes instantaneously popu-

lar, while Fool's work is looked upon as egotistical drivel. To add to the mess, Fool seduces Simon's mother and flirts with his sister in a sick attempt at revenge.

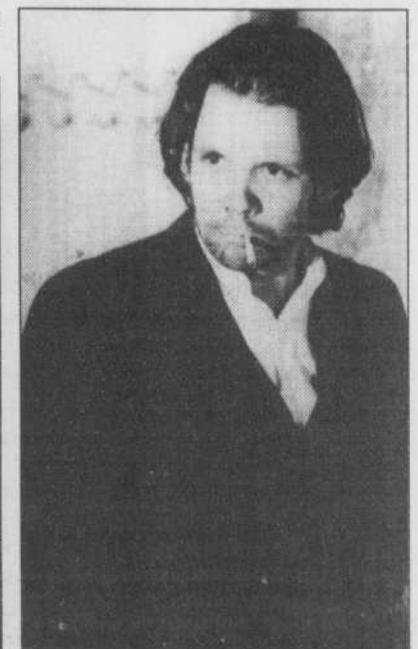
Those underwhelmed by this summer's Godzilla flop will be glad to know festival organizers have slated the original flick, entitled Godzilla vs. Monster Zero, for Sept. 16 at the Graffiti bar on Wellington Street S. Unlike Hollywood's glossed-over atrocity, the original 1954 monster personified Japanese director Inoshiro Honda's vision of the cold war nuclear menace.

The fest will present two early versions of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde from 1912 and 1920. The silent movies will be accompanied by pianist Gabriel Thibaudeau and will close the festival on Sept. 20.

Tickets cost \$7 regular, \$5 students, \$25 for five films and \$10 for the festival closer. Tickets are on sale at the Centre Culturel box office beginning Sept. 2. For more information, call (819) 346-6933.

Can't draw a straight line? Paint a blue sky? Make a clay ashtray? Don't think you have a creative bone in your body? Well, you're wrong, at least that's what Seymour Segal says.

The painter and educator has been giving workshops on creativity for 30 years - from Israel to Italy and most points in between. He believes everyone has an inborn need to be creative that is stifled as society's criteria of what is worthy kicks in.

"Curiosity and audacity are the essence of a child's creativity. Everyone has it, just most people stop trying," he said in an interview at his Dunham studio.

Segal has spent most of creative career attempting to motivate people to start trying again.

Born in Montreal, the eldest of three children, Segal grew up in an extraordinary household. His younger brother, Hugh, is currently running for leadership of the federal conservative party against Joe Clark and his other brother, Brian, is the publisher of Maclean's Magazine. Segal took a different direction from his brothers early on. He attended the Fine Arts School of Montreal for one year before quitting after concluding that "art school is no place for an artist."

"The teachers had no respect for students. They attacked people's work and wanted students to paint the way they did. They were not teaching anything," he said.

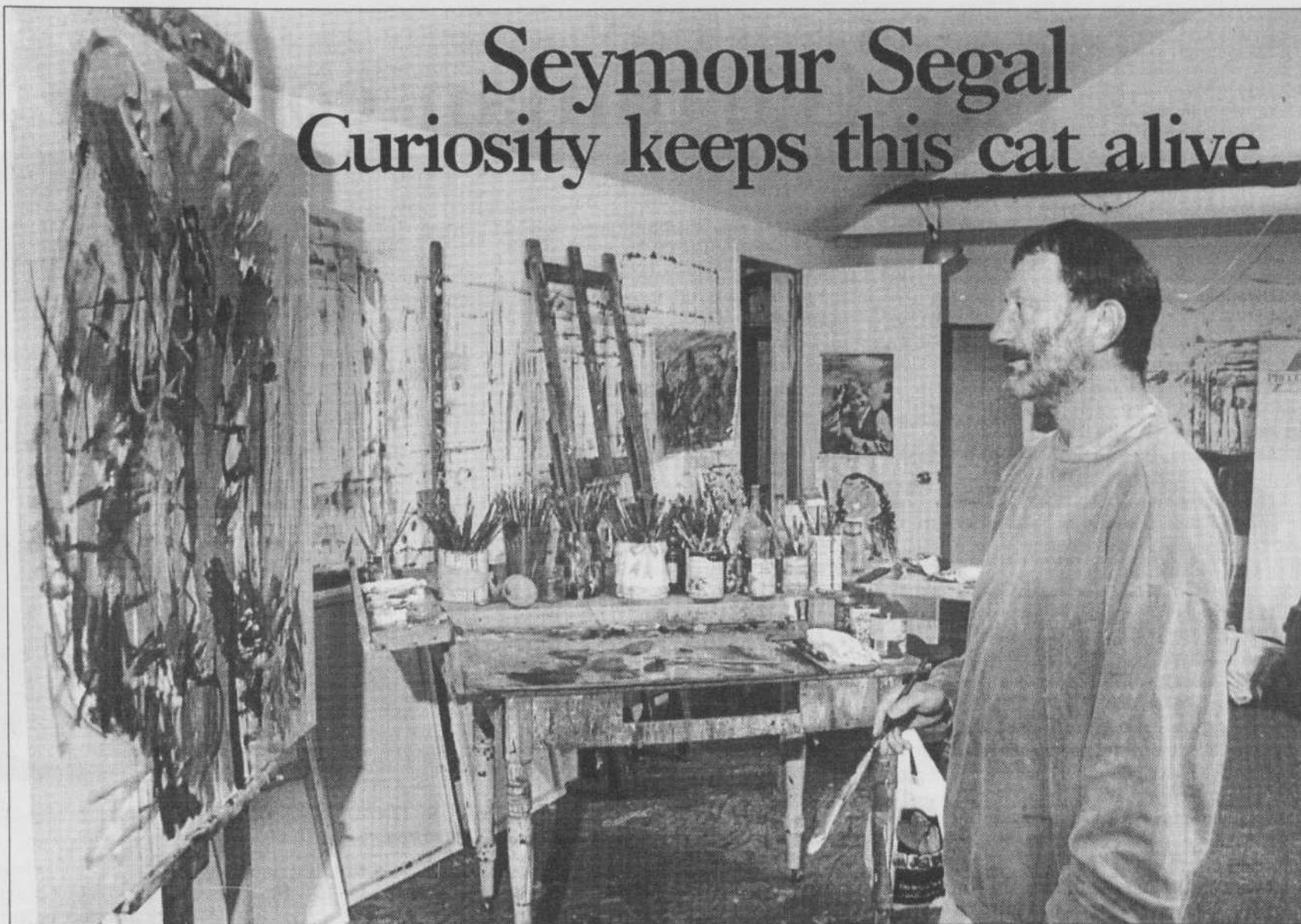
Segal's career path took a different direction after his unfulfilling stint at school. He became Canada's first male nursery school teacher in 1959.

"People wondered what kind of a screwball male wanted to work with kids. Whenever they'd ask me I'd tell them it was because I just had to get out of the kitchen!" said Segal with a laugh.

Working with young children helped Segal cement his ideas on creativity and taught him how to teach.

### Curiosity keeps this cat alive

"Sharing technical information is not teaching," he said. "Real teaching means offering the person the opportunity to create their own experiences."

Segal says words like "good" and "bad" do not apply to art.

"The art object is a mirror into the quality of the artist's process, nothing more. When someone is insecure about themselves they will look at art and say, 'That's no good,' instead of having the courage to say, 'I don't like it.' Art is a subjective, emotional experience."

Segal's dismissal of the importance of criteria in art is revolutionary in a medium which is dependent on constant value judgments on whether an object is good or bad.

The whole point of Segal's workshops, whether they're given to individuals or groups in need of creative stress management techniques, is to learn to stop judging the outcome of the art and to take pleasure in the creative process instead.

Segal's workshops are designed to help people get in touch with the daring, artistic side of themselves they may have forgotten or pushed aside in favor

of more "practical" skills.

For many people it is difficult to relinquish control and dare to create something that hasn't been planned on, but Segal says such a loss of constraint is healthy.

"Life is like a big ship - if it's securely attached in the harbor then it's safe, but the ship has been made to sail the sea, not sit at the dock. There is wisdom in insecurity," he said.

He tries to guide people away from the metaphorical harbor to get in touch with their creative side. Segal's latest traveling workshop will be going to Costa Rica in January. Participants will get the chance to snorkel, explore ancient ruins and, of course, spend lots of time getting in touch with their creative sides.

For Segal, the satisfaction he gets from his own painting and the enjoyment he reaps from the workshops are similar.

"I don't paint to sell, I paint to explore, to discover. My work is the filtration of contemporary life through my own experiences."

For the past few years, those experi-

ences have centred around the Townships. He moved from Montreal to Dunham with the view of getting his three daughters away from big city crime and grime.

"I'm a city boy, that's where I was born and bred. But when we started having kids we looked around for a healthier place for them to grow up. We fell in love with the area around Dunham. The pollution is less visible, there are open spaces and lots of nature."

Segal's wife, Josée Grodin, is also a painter, but Segal dismissed the notion that their professions might cause friction in the marriage.

"When there are difficulties it's not because we are painters, it's because we're people."

Perhaps the most important thing Segal has learned from living in a small town is the importance of the artist's role in society. Segal maintains the artist is just as much a community leader as a minister, doctor or teacher.

"I think the artist does for society what it doesn't have the courage to do for itself."

# The Garthman cometh

In the beginning of 1996, Garth Brooks announced he would kick off a world-wide tour lasting three years. The project seemed ambitious at the time, but coming from Garth Brooks nothing is impossible.

The tour started in March 1996 and is still going strong. On Oct. 3, the superstar will be back in Montreal for a mega show. The tickets went on sale Saturday, Aug. 22, and the prognosis is that he will perform another sold-out concert.

So far each city on his tour throughout the United States, Canada and Europe has hosted sell-out shows with new attendance records set regularly.

Keep in mind that seeing a Garth Brooks show is not expensive if you compare other artists of lesser calibre. Through his trip to the top he never lost contact with reality and is well aware that a buck is hard to earn, so he doesn't want people to cut down on groceries in order to be able to see him perform. Thus his concerts are always reasonably priced.

He also tries to reduce scalpers' access to tickets and give each fan an equal opportunity to get good tickets. No need to camp out overnight, since on Aug. 19 numbered wristbands were available at all Admission outlets, guaranteeing the

patron a place in line at the ticket centre Saturday morning.

He was recently named the top-selling solo artist of all time in the U.S. by the Record Industry Association of America due to his U.S. album sales of over 80 million units. In Canada, his current album *Sevens*, is certified quadruple platinum.

When Garth Brooks started his career back at the beginning of the 90s, nobody was prepared for the huge phenomenon his music would turn out to be.

The man has writing and singing talent along with a wild and vivid imagination, while his power of accomplishment and his understanding of what the fans want has no limit.

But all these qualities are not enough to explain the Garthmania; so where do we look to find the explanation to such infatuation for a man and his music. His

candid and humble personality is another reason we can regard and so is showmanship.

This of course fulfills our need for spectacular entertainment. Somehow his energetic performances on stage - and I'm not referring to swinging from a rope or breaking guitars - gives people a chance to let off steam resulting in a loss of inhibition for most fans attending.

Those who have seen his show already have "the fever" and others can grab the chance and see him on Oct. 3, at 8 p.m. at The Molson Centre. You can buy your tickets by calling 1-800-361-4595. It will be the experience of a lifetime.

Here's my review for this week:

**VARIOUS ARTISTS, *Ultimate Country Party*, (Arista)**

A compilation album is always an asset to your collection, as it offers a variety of country artists performing songs you already know and love. Put it on and you get some party music without having to pull out half of your records.

The album includes 18 songs on which the beat never drops lower than mid-tempo - a brochette of numbers put together for the pleasure of dancers. If you don't like dancing, you'll love it anyway.

There's Alan Jackson's mega hit "Chattahoochee," and BR5-49's retro sound of "Cherokee Boogie" while Clint Black sings "A Better Man." Infectious guitars take over while Lee Roy Parnell sings his snappy country rock on "If The House is Rock-

ing."

Tunes have been picked carefully to insure a perfect balance between new and veteran artists. The finished product is a seamless mix of music and talent.

Other big names on this album are Patty Loveless, Lorrie Morgan, George Strait, Diamond Rio and Shania Twain. There's enough talent here to satisfied everyone.

Put it on, crank it up and let the party begin!

**DON WALSER, *Down at the Sky-Vue Drive-Inn*, (Watermelon)**

Don Walser is still keeping the country music tradition alive at 63, and despite his age, he is still the Texas crooner by excellence. On this new album the Texan sings and yodels on pop, western and swing tunes with his big baritone vocal.

There's a few compositions of his own, including "Ramon," a tribute to a Mexican cafe singer he met while he was on tour south of the border. He also covers a few numbers such as "Please Help Me I'm Falling," and the Louvin Brothers - penned, "Are You Teasing Me?", made famous by Carl Smith in 1952.

He has enlisted a few other singers such as Larry Gatlin, Mandy Barnett and The Kronos Quartet to help with harmonies. So if you're dying to hear the sound of a bygone era this will be an album you'll love very much.

## All-star production of Twelfth Night on PBS Helen Hunt is mad about the Bard

**F**or Helen Hunt, apparently film and TV glory isn't as good as it gets.

The Oscar- and- Emmy-winning actress (As Good as It Gets, Mad About You) has spent the summer on the boards of Lincoln Center, brushing up her Shakespeare as Viola in Nicholas Hytner's production of Twelfth Night. The production has received high marks from the critics, and its final performance airs on PBS on Sunday, Aug. 30, as part of the venerable Live From Lincoln Center series.

In addition to Hunt, the cast includes theater veterans Paul Rudd, who previously teamed with Hytner for the movie The Object of My Affection and Kyra Sedgwick (Singles).

One of Shakespeare's most beloved comedies, Twelfth Night mingles two bittersweet love stories with spiraling confusion over mistaken identities.

As the play opens, a devastated Viola reaches the shores of the kingdom of Illyria following a shipwreck that apparently has claimed the life of her twin brother, Sebastian.

To survive, Viola disguises herself as a boy, Cesario, and becomes an attendant to a handsome duke, Orsino (Rudd), with whom she falls in love. He, however, is in love with Countess Olivia (Sedgwick) and sends his "boy" to woo her in his stead. In a reverse Tootsie, Olivia promptly falls in love with "Cesario," thus forming a comic triangle: Viola, masquerading as Cesario, loves Orsino, who loves Olivia, who loves "Cesario."

Matters become even more confused when Viola's twin, Sebastian (Rick Stear) returns alive - and is the very image of "Cesario."

"The two things that I find extraordinary (about this production) are, first, you can understand what they are saying extremely

easily," said John Goberman, who has been the executive producer of Live From Lincoln Center since its inception 25 years ago. "It doesn't have that kind of stilted, otherworldly pronunciation that makes you not sure of what's going on."

"Secondly, it's just very, very funny. The comic bits are genuinely funny, so this is very accessible Shakespeare."

Goberman credits Hytner's production skills for the unusual accessibility.

"The concept is so extraordinary as to where this is happening and when; it's not modern dress, but it's not costume drama, either," he said. "There's just a marvelous sense of otherworldliness, but always appropriate to the play."

In addition to the three celebrity leads, this Twelfth Night features other familiar faces from film and TV playing the characters who handle most of the play's more raucous comedy.

Tony Award-winner Philip Bosco, who appeared as the father of the bride in My Best Friend's Wedding, plays Malvolio, and Max Wright, familiar to millions as the TV "daddy" of ALF, plays Sir Andrew Aguecheek. The mischievous Maria is portrayed by Amy Hill, who played the irascible grandmother on All-American Girl.

Small wonder that Live From Lincoln Center opted to present a play for only the second time in the history of the series.

"With this I said, 'Let's just take a chance,'" Goberman says. "It's got a great director, a great designer (Bob Crowley) and a terrific cast - and it's Twelfth Night! We'll make it work."

"The cast is really 'up' about doing this at their last performance together, which is usually something special. And they'll be performing for an invited audience. I feel very good about it!"

# Tennis coverage begins Monday in New York Macatee front and center for U.S. Open

**B**ill Macatee is all set for a volley of U.S. Open tennis when he calls the play-by-play for CBS' extensive coverage.

"It's exciting for me to work so much of the Open," he said. "And I'm looking forward to my first Grand Slam finals."

Macatee believes the U.S. Open, which begins

Monday, Aug. 31, may be the breakthrough tournament for Venus Williams to overcome defending champion and No. 1-ranked Martina Hingis and win her first major title.

"No one rival consistently steps up and beats Hingis, but I'm looking for Venus to do it in New York, where the animated home crowd will help her and sister Serena. Venus has been on that stage before and loves it."

Macatee sees one dominant figure on the less-colorful men's side: Four-time U.S. Open champion Pete Sampras.

"I can't turn away from Pete. He reaffirmed his dominance at Wimbledon, but I believe he won't really be fully appreciated

for his accomplishments until he's gone in five to 10 years. Then everyone will say, 'Wow, look at what he did.' He's not a showman - just the best all-around tennis player in the world."

Following the ball at wild angles is CBS' "Mac-Cam," which was named after John McEnroe and reveals in slow-motion replay whether a ball is in or out after a disputed call.

McEnroe, who is behind the mike for CBS, was known for disputing just about every borderline call as a player. Now he has the technology to show who's right.

Leading up to the U.S. Open, CBS continues a tradition of telecasting Arthur Ashe Kids' Day on Sunday, Aug. 30.

American Venus Williams is part of the exciting tennis coverage of the U.S. Open beginning Monday.
