Words & Music by Bob Dylan at the Granada

To say Bob Dylan is a musical legend may be an understatement, as the man revolutionized the music industry in the 1960's and continued evolving ahead of the mainstream for his entire career.

To this day, Dylan's name is often listed as one of the major influences on modern rock and roll; his meaningful and poignant lyrics put to catchy music have been covered by everyone from the Rolling Stones to Guns and Roses.

On March 20, the only officially authorized theatrical show about the life and music of Bob Dylan will make an appearance at the Granada Theatre in downtown Sherbrooke and Peter Landecker, who portrays Dylan through his many stages, is excited to bring the bilingual show back to life.

"Everything in the show was either written or said by Dylan, it's an opportunity to tell the story of his life through his person," says Landecker, who wrote the initial play as a student at UCLA in the 1980's.

"This is 45 years of his life, so there are 24 to 25 songs that will appear from different eras. Two thirds of the show is the music of Dylan, while the rest is I speaking as Dylan, talking directly to the audience."

Landecker received Dylan's permission to perform the play when he ran in to him in the mid 1980's.

That conversation inspired some of the musical selections as Dylan per-

sonally selected some of the songs to appear in the play.

"He told me some songs that were in that I shouldn't include and he suggested Idiot Wind, which is a very personal piece," says Landecker.

"He told me 'Leonard Cohen has his own show, why shouldn't I.'"

After performing the play for a couple of years, Landecker took a 15-year hiatus from the stage to pursue a writing career with CINAR, writing children's cartoons and working as an executive producer on such projects as Bethune starring Donald Sutherland.

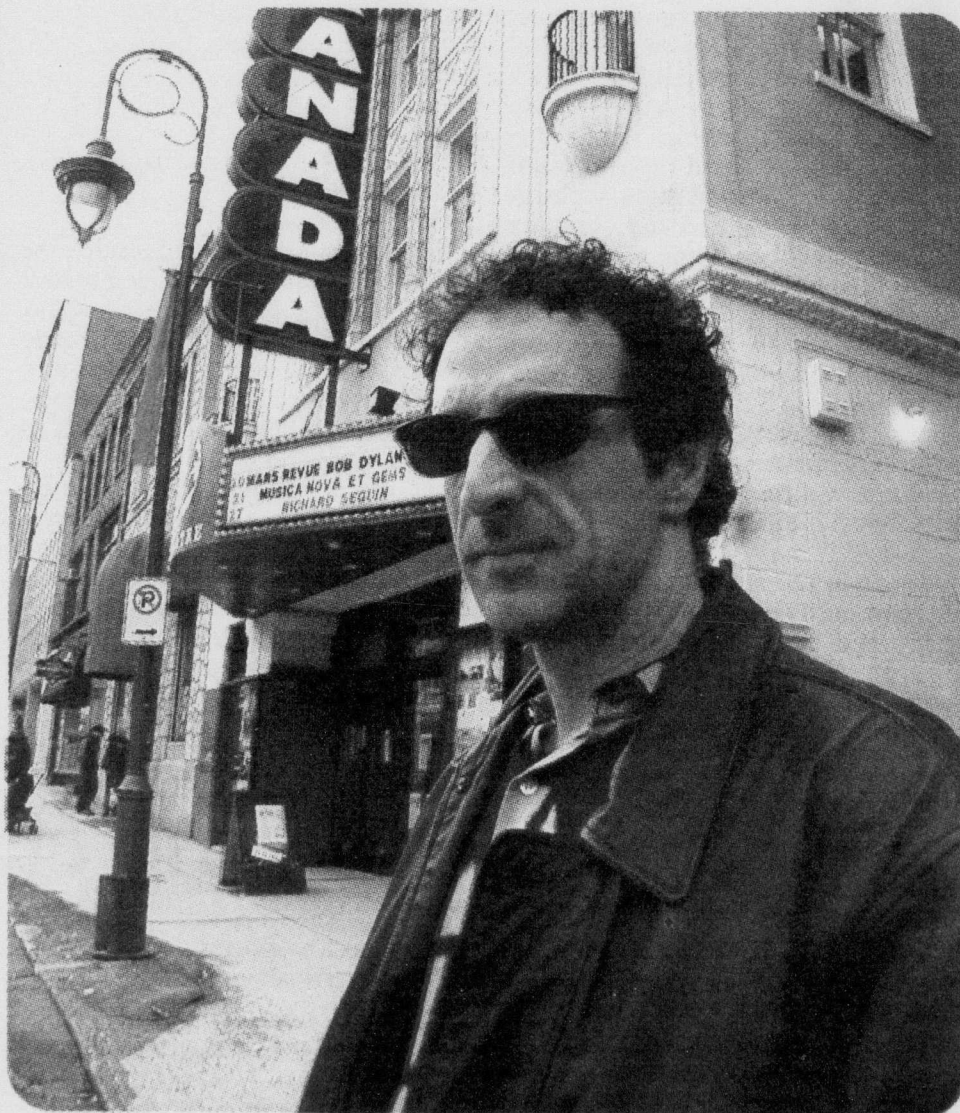
But after a recent run at the Piggery Theatre in North Hatley proved successful, Landecker was offered the opportunity to open the show at the larger Granada in Sherbrooke.

"The show has been sitting there, and I began to think, I really have something here," says Landecker.

"Dylan has put out three albums in the 15 years that I have been off stage, so I figured it was time to put the play out there again."

Landecker has made some changes from the original show, adding music from those later Dylan albums.

The show at the Granada will also be the first bilingual show, featuring a screen behind Landecker that will either translate the English words into French, or translate into English parts of the play Landecker already has had translated.

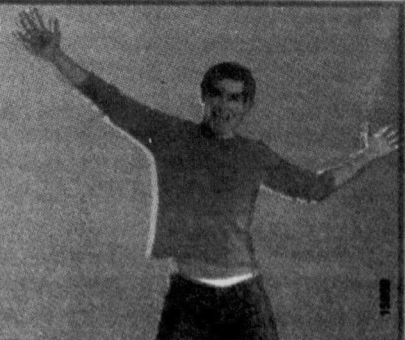

Warm nights with Port-laced onion soup

Dining

We've all had it a million times, a nice hot bowl of French onion soup with lots of gooey melted mozzarella on top. It is my favourite après-ski treat, in fact.

But have you ever thought of giving this old favorite a five-star treatment? A couple of deep-flavoured elements — pumpernickel bread, blue cheese, Port wine — are enough to transform the soup into something sophisticated and complex enough to stand on

its own as a great appetizer to serve to dinner guests.

One that you should make soon, before all the snow is gone and we all get in the mood for lighter, crisper, cooler recipes! Please don't make a special trip to the supermarket for this one. If you only have a multigrain loaf and Madeira wine at home, go ahead and use that instead.

As long as the bread has an interesting, coarse texture, and that you do add some sort of sweet, fortified wine, all's good! Any sort of strong, pungent cheese, like the Fourme d'Ambert or even Stilton, will also work. And re-

PORT-LACED ONION SOUP WITH BLUE CHEESE AU GRATIN

Ingredients: (for four)
5 large onions (about 5 pounds), sliced thin
1/2 stick (1/4 cup) salted butter
1 tbsp. all-purpose flour
2 cans beef broth
2 slices pumpernickel bread
1/3 cup Port wine
1/3 cup crumbled blue cheese
1/3 cup ricotta
freshly-ground pepper

Directions: In a large skillet sauté the onions in the butter over moderate heat for 20 minutes, stirring once in a while, until they are golden brown. Sprinkle the flour over the golden onions and stir, making sure there are no lumps. Set the oven to broil and pre-heat it to 450 F.

Add the broth, plus the same measure of water (two cans). Stir and let it come to a boil. Add the Port wine and some freshly-ground pepper. Meanwhile, toast the slices of pumpernickel and cut them in half. Place each piece of toasted bread at the bottom of an oven-proof soup bowl. Pour the soup over the toasts.

Mix the cheeses with a fork, and make four separate little cheese "pancakes", pressing the cheese crumbs together with your fingers to stick together. Place one on top of each soup, carefully so that they don't sink. Place the bowls on a baking sheet and broil for 10 minutes, or until the soup is bubbling and the cheese has little brown broil marks on it. Serve at once.

Reinventing the chicken noodle soup

Although we, who are fortunate enough to reside in The Lower Mainland (Vancouver), have smugly escaped the harrowing winter weather that the poor Maritimes is experiencing, and the rest of Canada usually endures, we haven't avoided the winter flu season unscathed.

Brenda and I, after taking turns battling the bug, agreed that a quick-cooking soup column was in order.

Piping hot soup does soothe us when we're down for the count, but who feels like preparing it when under the weather?

Here are our two favourite easy, nutritious and fast soups that caretakers, no matter how inexperienced in the kitchen, will be able to handle — and the best part is that these delicious, restorative one-dish meals will have been made with a big dose of TLC.

What could be more comforting than chicken noodle soup? Perk up the spirits with a fresh approach to an old favorite.

CHICKEN NOODLE SOUP WITH FRESH HERBS

Makes four servings
2 tablespoons (25 mL) vegetable oil
2 leeks, sliced thin
1 cup (250 mL) sliced mushrooms
8 cups (2 L) chicken stock
1 cup (250 mL) sliced carrots
1 cup (250 mL) sliced celery
2 cups (500 mL) broad noodles
1/2 pound (250 g) boneless chicken thighs, skinned and cut into 1/2-inch pieces
1 cup (250 mL) snow peas, trimmed and cut diagonally in thirds
1 tablespoon chopped fresh rosemary
2 teaspoons (10 mL) chopped fresh thyme
Salt and pepper

Directions: In large heavy saucepan, heat oil over medium-high heat. Add leeks and mushrooms; saute for two minutes. Add chicken stock and bring to a boil. Add carrots and celery; cover and cook for six minutes. Add noodles and boil, uncovered, for four minutes. Add chicken, snow peas, rosemary and thyme; simmer, uncovered, for about

three minutes or until chicken is cooked, and noodles and vegetables are tender. Season to taste with salt and pepper.

SPEEDY SNAPPER SOUP

Makes four servings
1 tablespoon (15 mL) vegetable oil
1 small onion, chopped
2 carrots, diced
2 stalks celery, sliced
3 cups (750 mL) chicken stock
2 (398 mL) cans Italian-style stewed tomatoes
1 large potato, cut in 1-inch (2.5 cm) pieces
1 pound (500 g) snapper fillets, cut in 1-inch (2.5 cm) pieces
2 cups (500 mL) coarsely chopped fresh spinach
1/4 cup (50 mL) chopped fresh parsley
Salt and pepper

Directions: In large heavy saucepan, heat oil over medium-high heat. Add onion, carrots and celery; saute for four minutes or until onion is tender. Add stock, tomatoes and potato. Bring to a boil over high heat. Reduce heat and simmer, covered, for 10 minutes or until

potatoes are almost tender. Add snapper; simmer, uncovered, for three minutes. Stir in spinach and parsley; cook for two minutes or until fish flakes easily when tested with a fork. Add salt and pepper to taste.

Artist reconciles precision with innovation

“When you use pastels, you can invent almost anything.” With these words, Paul Hébert launches into an explanation of his art, his technique and essentially, his life philosophy, which can be summed up with the words, “Force yourself to be in constant evolution.”

These are the words of an artist who originally trained as an architect and spent 11 years troubleshooting for various firms in Quebec and Ontario before admitting that there's only so much one can do with the square and rectangular forms he was urged to use by legions of structural engineers and real estate developers.

In 1992, he put down his architect's pencil, and picked up the more varied palette of the pastellist...and began observing the infinite variety of shapes in nature – not merely for inspiration, but rather to appreciate the precision and anatomical requirements of life.

“I'd been attached to animal life for a long time,” says Hébert. “I'm a bird-lover. Not an expert, though: I appreciate the shape of birds and I'm happy to be able to identify different species. But my main motivation is the precision in their design.”

“It's a form of art that is very precise...it's very rare that I would ever do something imaginary – by definition, it would lack precision. I'm a hardened observer, so I try to reproduce what I see.”

But he's not a photographic artist.

“The crayon won't reproduce exact reality. With the crayon, I can eliminate defects in the surroundings, and combine the best of both worlds: reproducing the animal as precisely as possible, but take liberties with its surroundings,” he says.

For example, Hébert might eliminate certain branches on a tree that he finds unattractive or encumbering.

The architect's drive is to create excellent living spaces, so it's no surprise that

Hébert has retained that urge. When he speaks of his work and his techniques, the contradictions that resurface from time to time reflect the tension between creating art while respecting the technical aspects of science.

By transposing the meticulousness of architectural design onto an art form that has few limits, he has developed a personal technique of brushed, fine-powder pastels and diluted oil pastels, always starting with a foundation of pencilled drawings.

“When someone owns one of my works, the most exciting compliment I've received is when they say, ‘every time I look at it, I see something different,’” he adds.

“If I look at it from another angle, under different light, I see something new.’ That's the challenge I've accepted for myself.”

Hébert grew up in the Drummondville region, where as a young boy he would spend whole days on his own, drawing. His mother “excelled in draw-

ing” and his godmother was a fashion designer.

They furnished their protégé with all the necessary material, but he was on his own when it came to learning technique.

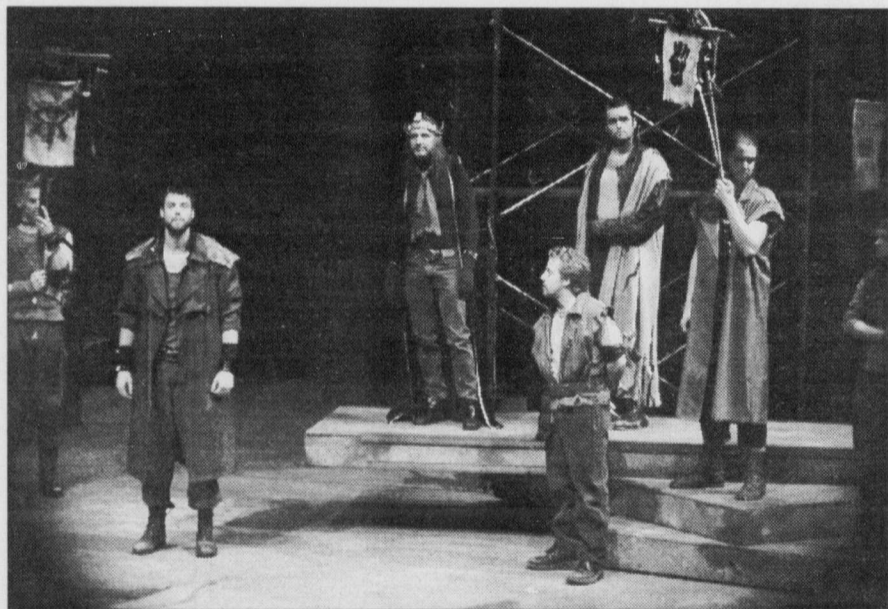
“Do your own thing and you'll see what happens,” was his mother's motto. Hébert remembers that doing his own thing brought lots of errors and very few triumphs. By the time he was ready for CEGEP, he simply wasn't interested anymore, so he stored his pencils away for a few years.

When he entered architecture at Laval University, however, he was forced to pick them up again, and eventually, his drawings evolved again, this time through the use of pastels, into a weekend hobby.

Through several years of trial and error, working through his own technique and becoming a “lone ranger”, as he puts it, he was able to invent, explore and even put his technique into words.

She has been called everything from Canada's next international diva-in-waiting, to the next Diana Krall to simply Montreal jazz great Karen Young's daughter.

While she may be all of the above — actually there is no contesting the fact that she's Young's daughter — singer/songwriter Coral Egan hopes her new album, *My Favorite Distraction*, will introduce her unique brand of music to mainstream audiences.

Known predominantly in Quebec as a jazz vocalist, Egan took advantage of the backing of Justin Time Records recently to create an album bursting with Jazz, R&B, folk, pop, soul, Bulgarian folk and reggae.

In 2002, Egan and guitarist Alex Cattaneo released *The Path Of Least Resistance*, a critically-acclaimed record of jazz standards. The CD was nominated for a Juno and was re-released across Canada under license by Justin Time.

For *My Favorite Distraction*, recorded in Montreal's Studio Frisson under the supervision of producer Charles Papasoff whom she met when she was 16, the 30-year-old Egan wrote the lyrics, composed the music, participated in the arrangements and played both piano and guitar.

"I was in a state of complete vulnerability (when I wrote the lyrics)," Egan told *The Record* recently. "I'm an open book to begin with anyway, but I couldn't eat or sleep. I was tormented by it (writing). But it was a rewarding experience, it really helped me grow as an artist."

Her team of musicians for the recording included respected Montreal musicians Gilbert Fredette on drums, Remy Malo on bass guitar, and Guy Kaye on guitar.

Egan, who lists Joni Mitchell, Stevie Wonder, Beck and Peter Gabriel among her musical influences, was also glad Papasoff was on board for the project.

"He had enough faith in me to convince me that I belonged (in the music business). We both believe in instinct. He always says 'take what you have going for you and work with it.'"

Egan, who in the past has performed at the Montreal Jazz Festival, recorded a Jazz Box special for Musique Plus, and is a top-flight player on the Quebec Sr. beach volleyball tour, began singing occasionally with her mother in concert when she was only 11-years-old, and was performing on her own by the age of 16.

"She's proud of me but I think she was worried about me going into the business," Egan says of her mother. "She doesn't want me to get lost in all the buzz. She'd rather I take everything with a grain of salt."

Egan added that she hopes to make an album with her mother sometime down the line. She has also worked with artists as diverse as DJ Ram and Luc de Larochelière.

Egan will next perform in Montreal in April, but she expects to tour the province, including Sherbrooke, sometime this summer.

Pat LaBarbera at Bandeen

Jazz legend Pat LaBarbera visits the Musique Chez Nous series and Bandeen Hall in Lennoxville for a concert tonight which will be recorded by the Chaîne culturelle of Société Radio-Canada and broadcast on their jazz program.

Performing original compositions, jazz classics and standards, the iconoclastic saxophonist will be joined onstage by Dave Laing on drums, Keiren Overs on double bass and Bishop's own Michael Gauthier on guitar.

LaBarbera is an alumni of Berklee College of Music and is considered one of the finest soloists working within the framework of John Coltrane's principals. He is known internationally for his years on tour with the Buddy Rich Big Band and Elvin Jones' Jazz Machine.

He also performed with the big bands of Count Basie, Woody Herman, and Louie Bellson and has worked and recorded with musicians such as Chet Baker, McCoy Tyner and Dizzy Gillespie.

He has performed at major international jazz festivals and jazz clubs and has appeared in numerous radio and television shows and film documentaries in addition to having recorded over 100 albums.

His ballads album *Deep In A Dream* with Don Thompson, Neil Swainson and Joe LaBarbera featuring lesser-known jazz standards, received both Juno and Jazz Report awards for instrumental jazz in 2000. His latest album *From The Heart* with George Cables, Rufus Reid, and Joe LaBarbera, features original tunes and some standards.

LaBarbera will be presenting a full-day masterclass for jazz enthusiasts on Saturday, March 13 starting at 10:30 a.m. in Bandeen Hall. This masterclass is free to the public.

Five questions with Patricia O'Malley

Artist Patricia O'Malley's medium of choice is oil painting, although she has tried other methods of creating art.

Her work has been seen at the Uplands Cultural Centre in Lennoxville and is currently on display at the Auberge des Grands Jardins in Compton. She frequently takes classes from other artists to spark her sense of inspiration and enjoys sharing her passion for art with her students. *The Record* recently caught up with O'Malley at her home on the outskirts of Waterville.

THE RECORD: You describe some of your paintings as being on the dark side. Do you mean that you try to depict the negative side of the subject?

O'MALLEY: "I wouldn't agree with that statement. I really have a very positive outlook on life. What I meant was that I like to use dark colours while

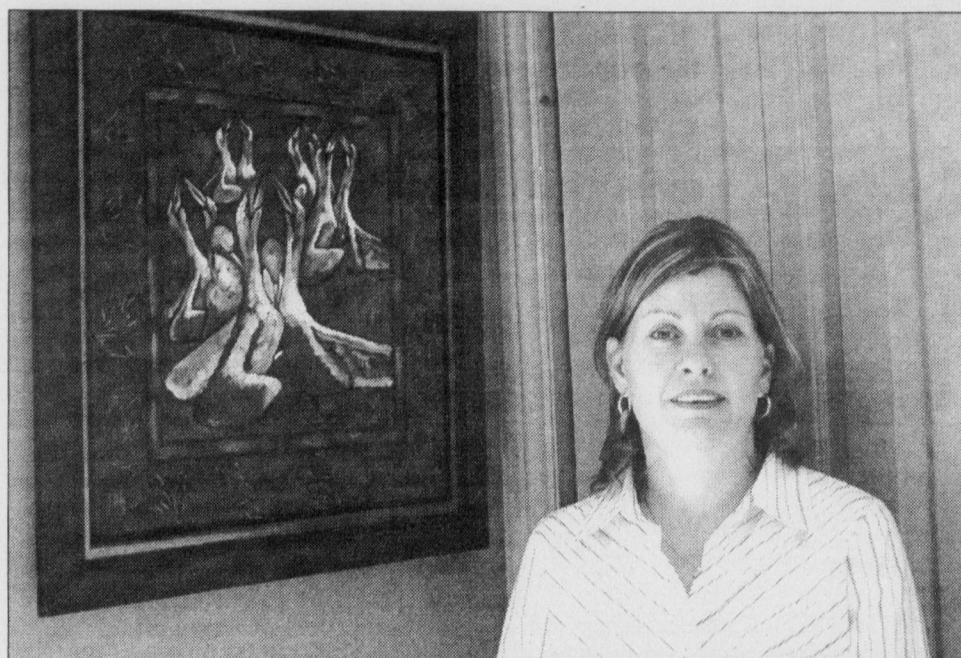
adding touches of browns and golds. They are all darker colours but can still be blended together to give a warm effect to the finished product."

THE RECORD: You have an interesting outlook when it comes to painting people. Would you elaborate on that for us?

O'MALLEY: "I really don't like to paint people with faces. I did one that I was happy with – a painting of my young son looking through several intertwined bubbles that he had just blown. I will do it if that is what someone really wants or if I am doing charcoal sketches but I prefer the sense of mystery that comes from watching a father walk off down a beach or an elderly gentleman bending over his flower garden in full bloom."

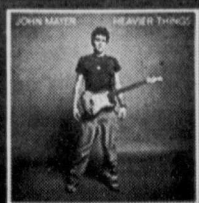
THE RECORD: You were speaking of a unique class that you took not so long ago. I think you said the instructor's name was Yvan Dagenais?"

Dancing for Dog-Cart Productions

Dog-Cart Productions, Lennoxville's newest theatre company, will be holding a fundraising event in the form of a contra dance on Saturday, March 20 at 7:30 p.m. at the United Church Hall, 12 Church Street in Lennoxville.

Created in 2003, Dog-Cart Productions is the brainchild of Laurel Thomson and Jo Jo Rideout.

Thomson is a graduate of the National Theatre School in Montreal. She has performed and toured with the Stratford Festival, Theatre SKAM in Victoria, the Bard on the Beach theatre company

in Vancouver, and the Piggery Theatre in North Hatley.

Rideout trained as an actress at the Vancouver Playhouse Acting School and has worked in the profession for over 20 years, most recently at the Piggery Theatre as well as Theatre Lac Brome.

For the last 17 years, she has been a professor of drama at Bishop's.

Last year, Dog-Cart Productions brought you Oscar Wilde's witty comedy *The Importance of Being Ernest*.

The production involved over 15 students from Champlain College and Bishop's University and performed to

sold-out houses.

Since then, the company has performed *Goodbye Marianne* by Irene N. Watts for local schools, a play focusing on the plight of Jewish children living in Germany before the outbreak of the Second World War.

For it's 2004 summer production, Dog-Cart Productions will once again stage a popular classic in George Bernard Shaw's *Arms and the Man*, a charming comedy filled with Shaw's renowned wit and great insight into the human condition that has delighted audiences since its first performance in 1894.

O'MALLEY: "Those classes in sketching were given right here in Waterville and certainly did a lot to challenge your mind. Dagenais taught us to use the creative side of our brain (the left), and only that. Instead of creating something by drawing an actual shape, we were taught to forget about the object itself and only sketch in the spaces of light. It seemed almost magical when the final outcome was exactly the shape that we wanted."

THE RECORD: Do animals hold a special fascination for you?

O'MALLEY: "Yes, I really do have a fascination for all animals, but especially for horses. I find them to be such magnificent animals. There is a farm that keeps horses not far from my home and I could just watch them for

hours. There is such beauty in their motion. The way their muscles work when they move and the way the light reflects off their backs, it has inspired several of my paintings."

THE RECORD: If you could give advice to someone just starting out in painting, what would you tell them?

O'MALLEY: "I would strongly suggest that they invest in good brushes and paint, the best way to be able to experience the mixture of textures and union of paint and brush when you work. You should try to paint something that you are interested in. If the subject doesn't appeal to you, your motivation will soon fade. You don't have to be good at drawing to be a good painter."

If you make a vague outline of where you are going, and start to add the colours, things seem to take shape on their own. Don't be easily discouraged."

He often gives pastel seminars to adults and children alike, explaining the basic technique of how to reproduce animals on paper using geometrical shapes and mathematical calculations.

He considers pastel art very accessible for children, since it doesn't require complicated instruments and is based on drawing.

"But the challenge for them is to continue practising, to develop precision....," he maintains.

Constantly on the move, Hébert has recently accepted to illustrate a children's book, *Charlie et les géants*, about the adventures of a sparrow.

He has also been solicited by various parks in the province to produce nature

interpretation signs to designate areas where birds can be observed. The magazine *Oiseaux Québec* often publishes his drawings.

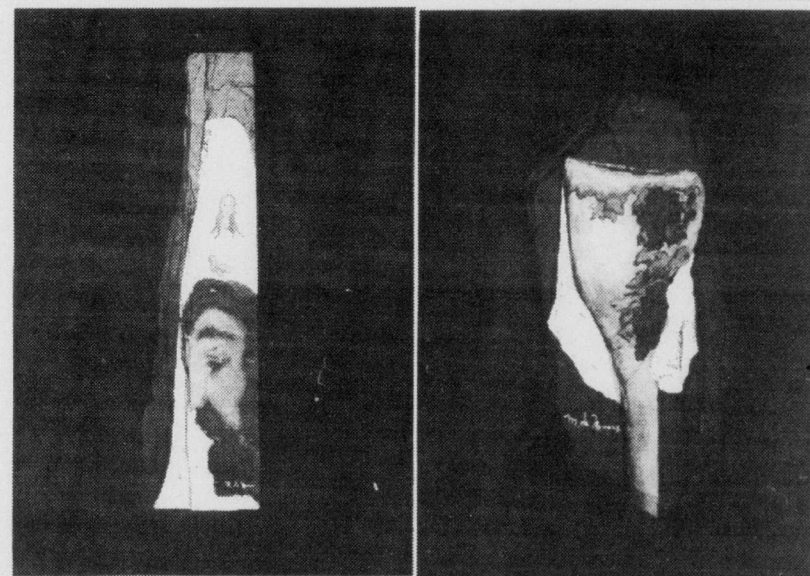
But these commercially oriented activities aren't what stimulates Hébert to get up each morning with positive feelings about work and life.

"I'm not a guy who really appreciates the wheel that turns and always comes back to the same things...I don't want to be forced to continually reproduce things that I don't enjoy doing. For the past 12 years, I've been having fun - I'm always working on something new," he concludes.

Just like Mom always said: "Do you own thing, and you'll see what happens."

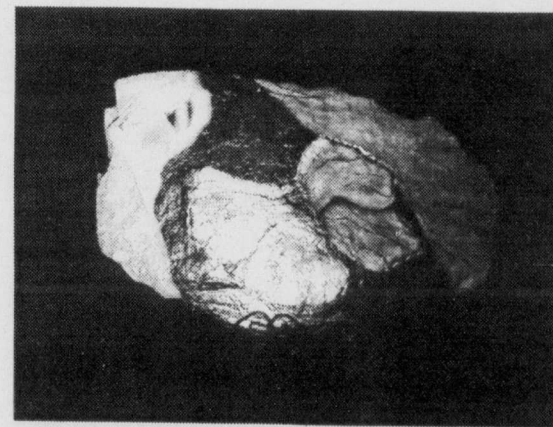

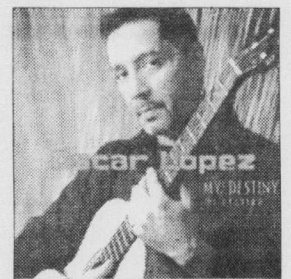



Giving Polk his due

In 1997, Arthur M. Schlesinger Jr. wrote an excellent and insightful article, 'Rating the Presidents: Washington to Clinton'. At the end of this article, all the Presidents were listed, according to a poll conducted among various leading specialists of the American Presidency.

Surprisingly, James K. Polk — 11th President of the United States (1844-1848) — came just after Harry S. Truman and ahead of John F. Kennedy.

But how could a practically unknown personality rate above Kennedy and others like Clinton or Reagan? Schlesinger wrote that "Polk at 49 was the youngest man up to that time, and the only Speaker of the House of Representatives ever, to make the White House.

He specified his objectives early on — to reduce the tariff, establish the independent treasury system, settle the Oregon boundary question, and acquire California — and worked efficiently and relentlessly to achieve them. His objectives have been criticized but not his ability."

Ability. Here's the word one has to remember about James K. Polk. In the presidential gallery, he may well be one of the most gifted with this quality. Yet, this talent is underestimated.

In a short, but interesting book about the 11th President, John Seigenthaler introduces us to this fascinating politician whose 'religion was partisan politics'. Before arriving at the pinnacle of U.S. politics, Polk had been a staunch supporter of Andrew Jackson, both as a person and for his policies.

While serving in Congress, the politician from Tennessee was the promoter and enforcer of the Jacksonian agenda.

At the dawn of the 1844 Presidential contest, Polk was perceived as a political failure. He had twice lost the race for Governor of Tennessee.

Martin Van Buren, the former President (1836-1840) who had a lock on the

Democratic nomination for that year, was cold to the idea of even having Polk as a running mate.

Meanwhile, 1844 was the year Polk was to succeed his political hero and mentor — President Andrew Jackson (1828-1836) — as President.

Two things played for him. First, both Van Buren and Henry Clay — who was to become the candidate of the Whig Party for the Presidency — announced that they were opposed to the annexation of Texas in the United States. Americans were in favour of it. Second, Polk — who was himself a meticulous organizer — was surrounded by an excellent political machine. He thus secured the nomination for the White House.

Upon becoming candidate, he did what few — if any — of his successors would do. He announced he would serve only one mandate.


Also, as we saw at the beginning, he stated the four objectives of his tenure at the helm of the state. And he met them. This said, Polk is perceived as a warmonger because he fought against Mexico for the acquisition of new territory. This conflict was perceived as unnecessary and brutal by his opponents. At the end of the day, Polk's actions 'increased the landmass of the country by a third and offered the United States the opportunity to become a continental nation.

But why is it that James K. Polk doesn't spring more often to the minds of historians and political junkies? John Seigenthaler has an answer to that. In his opinion, "Polk suffers because historians instinctively measure his accomplishments, which were substantial, alongside his presidential personality, which was anal.' Often, we confuse charisma with achievement. Let's just take an example.

If you ask anybody which, between John F. Kennedy and Lyndon B. Johnson achieved the most, people will instinctively reply Kennedy. The historical truth might be different, for LBJ achieved more from JFK's agenda than the famous President himself. But Johnson was neither sexy nor magnetic.

It might be true that the 11th President was not a charismatic man, but he was nevertheless a great — and a fascinating — president.

Hopefully, John Seigenthaler's book is the starting point of a reconsideration which will not only entice historians to produce more work about Polk but which will also bring us to look under the surface when we judge Presidents or politicians.

Teen spy Cody Banks back for new mission *Movies*

It didn't take Cody Banks long to go from disarming preteen secret agent to gadget-toting irritation. First sequel, and we're already sick of him.

Agent Cody Banks: Destination London takes the pint-sized James Bond to England for an adventure that is not just incomprehensible — you come to expect that in movies aimed at a younger audience, where pee and fart jokes can always be brought in to paper over the cracks in character and plot — but tedious.

After two outings, Cody Banks already seems second-hand and smarmy, and the charms of the first film have disappeared.

Frankie Muniz, who returns as Cody, was last seen sharing a bed with Cher in *Stuck On You* in a scene that played on Muniz's look of skinny innocence. In *Destination London*, he's grown into adolescence: he's filled out a bit, he's tan, and he looks like he belongs in bed with Cher, in fact.

The tone of the film has thus changed from gawky parody to teen franchise-in-the-making, and its young audience may feel abandoned.

The film, which begins at a summer camp that is a thinly disguised CIA training facility for underage agents — the fantasy idea of being an undercover spy living at home with your parents is one of the few successful hangovers from the first *Cody Banks* — soon moves to London for no discernible reason or benefit.

Cody is chasing his CIA instructor/camp counselor, a rogue agent who has stolen plans for thought control, a device that may very well account for the screenplay.

In London, Cody is teamed up with undercover agent Derek (Anthony Anderson), a refugee from Compton, which further calls into question the point of the British setting.

Cody's cover is that he is a musical genius, which throws him in the company of a group of international musicians who are variously ridiculous, stereotypical, or simply impossible, like the East Indian bassoonist who calls Cody, in what is meant to be an engag-

ingly humorous sing-song, "my woodwind buddy."

Cody and Derek — who disguises himself as a pastry chef at the swank estate where the students live, thus occasioning many visual jokes about bad cooking and broken eggs — are on the trail of some cartoon villains whose evil plans climax at the G7 meeting to be held at Buckingham Palace (in the presence, while we're at it, of the worst Queen Elizabeth lookalike since the *Naked Gun* series.)

Every third person seems to be mentally ill or auditioning for a role in a Terry-Thomas vehicle, circa 1951: the feeble butler, the imperious music school chief, a secret service gadget-

maker whose laugh is a bark of insipid eccentricity.

Some of the trademark devices of *Cody Banks* are in place: a spy gadget that comes packaged in his mouth retainer, for example.

For the most part, however, those touches are dropped in favour of generic kids' film pap: villains who pop their eyes and talk funny, world takeover plots that are run with computer joysticks, the way a music ensemble bursts out of the confines of classical pieces to enjoy, in the big closing finale, the liberation of terrible faux-rap.

The first *Cody Banks* played on the fantasy aspect of the teen spy; here, it's just a shabby frame for a lot of weak

chases and wan perils, and director Devin Allen (*The Big Tease*) has no feel for the notion. The movie plays like the slapdash film version of a kids' comic book.

Young fans may also be interested to know that Hilary Duff, the love interest of the first film, has been replaced by 2 Club 7 singer Hannah Spearritt, who looks like a British Cameron Diaz.

She's a sort of young Bond girl, an acknowledgement that the series wants to grow past its teen roots. *Cody Banks*, one realizes with a shudder, may be racing the *Spy Kids* to the adult leagues.

It may come as a shock to find that no one is waiting for him there.

Secret Window is a story director is familiar with

David Koepf knows what it's like to sit in a room by yourself and try to invent reality. Among the realities he has come up with are the screenplays for Spider-Man, a couple of Jurassic Park movies, and Mission: Impossible.

He also knows what it's like when someone says you've taken their idea.

"You can't really have a popular success without someone coming out of the woodwork saying you stole it from them," Koepf said this week. "Sometimes they're crazy and sometimes they have a point."

That's the dilemma faced by audiences watching Secret Window, Koepf's new film that stars Johnny Depp as a successful writer and John Turturro as the frightening stranger who shows up at his door one day — at an isolated cabin deep in the woods — and accuses the author of stealing his story.

Based on a novella by Stephen King, Secret Window, which opens Friday, presents the Depp character as a tormented man, in the midst of a painful divorce, who lies around all day in his bathrobe until he is jerked to life by the mysterious accusation. And while the charge of plagiarism seems absurd, there is something about the writer that makes it seem faintly plausible.

To Koepf — who alternates a career as

a screenwriter and a writer/director — it's also faintly familiar.

"Over the years there have been a couple of those sort of things," Koepf recalled. "Only one guy was crazy and became a problem, and I had to get some help."

Koepf says he can't talk about the details, because the accuser threatened to kill him. Another time, someone claimed the entire Jurassic Park idea was his.

You can see why Secret Window would resonate. It also touches several themes that Koepf has explored in his other movies: the sense of confinement of Panic Room, an original script that precipitated a Hollywood bidding war before it was turned into a film with Jodie Foster, and the tightening screws of mental instability of Stir of Echoes, one of Koepf's previous forays into writing and directing, which starred Kevin Bacon as a man who thinks he sees ghosts in his house.

Koepf got involved with Secret Window when the King novella was sent to him by Matt Tolmach, co-president of production at Columbia Pictures. "He said, 'This might be up your alley' and I read it and thought, 'Well, maybe a little too up my alley.'"

Koepf has directed three movies, including the 1996 suspense drama The Trigger Effect, and they all have familiar links.

"I worried about it to Brian De Palma (who directed the Koepf scripts for Carlito's Way, Mission: Impossible and Snake Eyes). I said, 'More of this upper-middle-class white people scared in their homes,' and he said, 'Relax, it's called who you are.'"

Making a film with an author as a hero was also a familiar element. Koepf said making a "writer movie" both appealed to him and frightened him.

"Writers just don't make interesting characters in movies usually. Because what we do is not interesting to watch. It's so internal. Typing scenes are just a nightmare. But because he couldn't write, I figured it was okay because it's really about other things. So one brief scene showing him trying and failing to write I thought was enough. And then he became kind of interesting."

Having a movie whose main character is a blocked writer who sits around the house mumbling to himself much of the time also demands a strong presence on screen. That's where Johnny Depp came in.

"This guy's got to hold the screen for long periods of time while he's doing nothing," Koepf said. "I mean, he's taking naps. This is not stuff we traditionally think of as dramatic or entertaining. Johnny Depp popped into my mind early because he's so compelling and he makes such idiosyncratic choices in terms of

roles and performance. I thought, 'This is a guy we will want to watch, moping around in his bathrobe.'"

The Pirates of the Caribbean, the film that won Depp an Oscar nomination and continued his reputation as a box-office sensation, opened the week Koepf's movie started shooting.

"It put all of us in a good mood," he said. "We hired a great actor and we got a movie star."

Working as both a writer and a writer/director puts Koepf into a unique position in Hollywood. He says he has to treat his own screenplays as ruthlessly as if they were by anyone.

Koepf said that while writing is nice and peaceful, directing is difficult but more fulfilling because he takes one idea all the way from the idea to the finished product. It's also easier to live with the flaws.

"If someone screws up your script it drives you crazy. It's easier when you understand why."

So far, he's happy with the way Secret Window turned out, but he said his feelings may change in a few weeks, after he has watched it with a paying audience.

"I'm not doing this in a vacuum. It's not a canvass that I painted that I'm going to hang on my wall. It's popular art. I want an audience to like it. I made it for an audience."

Chesney album is all about summer fun

The time has come to start planning summer activities for those who do not want to miss the country artists that will be performing near by during the fair season.

Champlain Valley Fair organizers announced recently that Kenny Chesney will be at this year's event.

Chesney will perform on Aug. 29 at 7 p.m. on the Coca Cola Grandstand as part of the Guitars, Tiki Bars and A Whole Lotta Love Tour.

They have many reasons to be proud because Chesney's previous album, *No Shoes, No Shirt, No Problems*, made him one of the most popular singers in country music.

When *The Sun Goes Down*, Chesney's eighth album was just released a few days ago.

It is somehow a bit different from the previous one, with lyrics written from a more grown up perspective.

It's all about life, love and memories and a good part of the record offers some fun summer music. I'll bet this

record will be one of the biggest albums this summer. The whole collection has a beach feel and Chesney's duet with rock singer Uncle Kracker, titled 'When The Sun Goes Down,' is the perfect example.

This song celebrates walking in the sand under the sun. It's a reminder of Alan Jackson and Jimmy Buffet's 'It's Five o'clock Somewhere'. This is not a new style for Chesney, who usually loves including a feel of the Caribbean Island in his music.

The album's first single 'There Goes My Life' was already number one before the release of the album. It's a bittersweet tale about being a parent and seeing your children ready to leave the house, taking your heart with them.

Other highlights include the truthful 'Being Drunk's A Lot Like Loving You' about falling in love, getting hurt and swearing it will never happen again.

'The Woman With You,' is about picking love over a career, love over personal goals. It's all about that special person who becomes so much more important than any plans you may have.

Chesney covers a lot of topics on this album. It offers fun and feel-good music, but also some reflective numbers.

Though the progression of Chesney's early recording career came very slowly, he managed to make the giant step to stardom. One positive thing is that his recordings always reflect his high energy live shows.

His love for music comes from being raised in a musical family; his mother and aunt appeared regularly on an East Tennessee gospel radio show. Although he had a passion for sports (he considered a career in baseball) music won his heart.
