COTE ST ANTOINE.

Situated in the County of Hochelaga, district of Montreal, and adjoining the City of Montreal. It is principally inhabited by merchants and others doing business in Montreal, and has a large number of fine residences and grounds within its limits. Its streets and avenues are well laid out, are nearly all drained and macadamized, and the whole lighted by electricity. It has a free postal delivery twice a day, possesses an efficient police force and fire apparatus, and the electric street cars afford rapid and easy communication with the City to and from the Western limits of the municipality. Population about 3,600.

COTE ST PAUL.

(Incorporated in 1875.)

Forms part of the late municipality of the parish of Montreal, seigniorly of Montreal, county of Hochelaga. It is bounded on the north by the Lachine canal, south by the Aqueduct, on the east by the line of the G.T.R., from the said Lachine canal at the buildings of the Aqueduct, on the west by parish of Lachine. There are here several mills and large manufactories. Distant from Coteau St Pierre 1 mile, from Town of St Henry 1 mile, from Montreal Post Office 3 miles. Mail twice a day. Population 1,850.

hood, and also a new church and Scholasticate, under the direction of the revs Fathers of La Compagnie de Jésus. Distant from Montreal 2 miles. Population about 800.

In the winter months it is greatly frequented by pleasure parties, and at all times of the year a drive from Montreal to Lachine by the Upper, and in by the Lower road, is considered a rich treat to the stranger, and even to the citizen of Montreal. Lachine possesses a large brewery, an extensive saw mill, Dominion wire works, wire rope and screw factories, Montreal car wheel and pipe foundry, and the works of the Dominion Bridge Co.; has good local business and extensive lumber trade. The Grand Trunk Railway use several trains a day to Montreal. A ship canal connects the navigable waters at Montreal with Lake St Louis at Lachine. Great North-Western Telegraph Co. have offices here, also a fire alarm system and a complete system of water works. Distant from Montreal 9 miles, fare 40c., 25c., and 12c. Mail twice a day. LAPRAIRIE.

An extensive municipal village and parish of the south shore of the River St. Lawrence, between the Lachine rapids and Victoria bridge, district of Montreal, seigniorly and county of the same name. Incorporated March 30, 1846. The parish was erected on the 17th November, 1668. A market is open every day. An aqueduct is constructed. The first railway in British North America was constructed from here to St. Johns in 1836. It was first worked with horses, afterwards by steam, but was discontinued, and the rails taken up a number of years ago. A steamboat maintains regular communication between Montreal and Laprairie. A branch of the Grand Trunk Railway, starting at Fort Covington, in the State of New York, to reach the Victoria bridge, now runs twice a day in close proximity to the village, with a good station and depot, and contributes materially to the future development of the locality, which is considered a very healthy and pleasant summer place. There is also a fire station, thoroughly supplied with new fire apparatus, such as a fire engine and hook and ladders. Fishing and hunting is also largely practised. A new billiard room has been organized. A permanent wharf has been erected, and will be much improved during the present summer. A new channel is also partly made up. The aqueduct is now giving a very good service to the village, and the work of putting up pipes is being done very rapidly in the different streets. The pressure of water in case of fire is also very powerful, as the water is drawn by steam and air pressure, which brings it at a distance of 1,350 feet, from the St. Lawrence river. The premiums upon insurances have also been greatly re-

A suburban villa on the south shore of the St. Lawrence, directly opposite Montreal, in the county of Chambly, district of Montreal, with a population about 1,500, and growing rapidly. It is an important railway centre, and is supplied with an excellent railway service by the Grand Trunk Railway, having over twenty trains each way daily. Return fare by suburban trains, 20c; by regular passenger trains, 25c; by commutation tickets, 5 cents.

The Victoria Bridge spans the St. Lawrence here, and all trains to and from the City stop at the railway station. Several lines of railway run here, viz.: Grand Trunk for points South, East and West; Central Vermont for Farnham, New York and Boston; Delaware & Hudson for New York; Montreal & Sorel for Sorel. The distance to Longueuil, the county seat, is three miles. There are four churches: Methodist, Episcopal, Roman Catholic and Presbyterian, with resident ministers. There is a large Model school, conducted by the Protestant School Commissioners, with a staff of four teachers; and a French school, conducted by the R. C. Commissioners, with two teachers. There is excellent boating on the river, and the St. Lambert Boat Club is recognized as one of the best clubs in the vicinity of Montreal. The residents are mostly employed in the City, and select it for a suburban home from its favorable situation and excellent means of communication at all seasons with the City. During the winter month much driving is done by the river road. St. Lambert is being rapidly built up, and is destined to become a very important point. The distance by rail is six miles. Mail twice daily. G.N.W. Tel. Co. has an office, also telephone communication.
