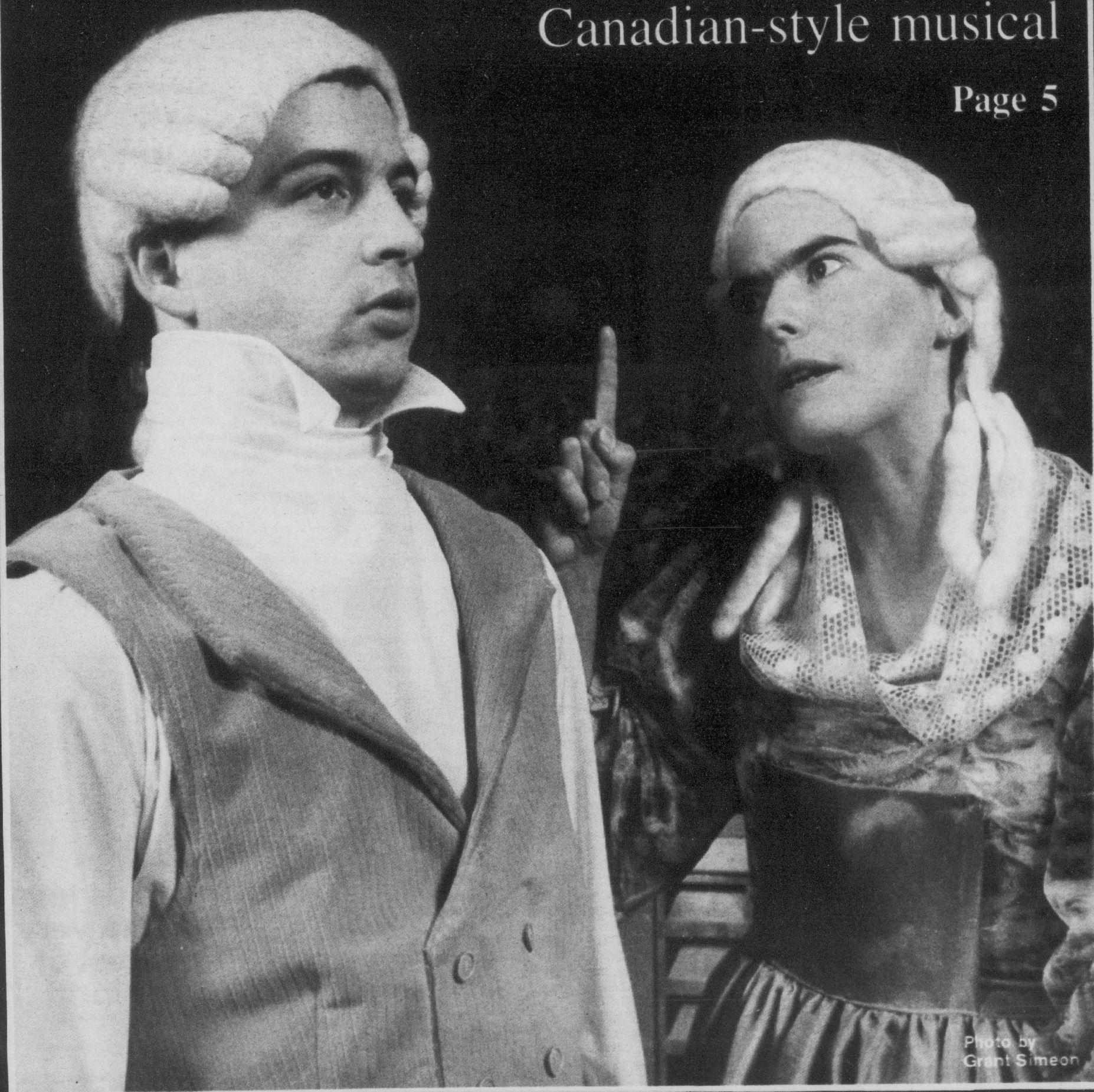

Canada Post offers new Olympic winter games edition

Here we are, already well into the month of March and I almost forgot this is stamp collecting month. I guess I still haven't gotten used to the change from October to February. Part of the reason is that nothing significant helped to remind me, as almost everyone's attention has been focused on this year's winter Olympics, which, I suppose is to be expected.

Speaking of the Olympics, the last of the Olympic stamps were issued on February 12. There was a series of four, two domestic rates in se-tenet form featuring Alpine Skiing and Curling, a forty three cent stamp depicting figure skating, and an international rate depicting the Luge.

In addition to the latest Olympic stamps, Canada Post has also put

out what is called the 1988 Olympic Winter Games Souvenir Edition. The souvenir edition tells about the Olympic site, the stamps and the story behind the stamps. The complete issue of eleven stamps are included with clear mounts to protect the display.

The face value of the stamps is \$4.43 and the package is \$5.25 plus tax. Really not a bad deal. The Souvenir Edition is available through philatelic counters or direct from the National Philatelic Centre, Antigonish, Nova Scotia, B2G 2R8.

Somehow, somewhere down the line someone goofed terribly. In the last article I reported that ROYAL 88 was to be held on the weekend of June 16 in Winnipeg. This week I learned that STAMPEX is also to be held on that same weekend in Toronto.

What difference does it make, you ask? For one thing, it means there will be a lot less quality dealers at Royal 88. Most dealers from the east will probably be at STAMPEX because it's closer. And most

important, Michael Madesker, who is the sponsor for STAMPEX, is also a first vice president of the Royal Philatelic Society of Canada, sponsors of ROYAL 88.

Michael Madesker is a dedicated philatelist who not only belongs to the RPSC, but is also a member of SNAPS RPLS, and the APS. He was chairman of the jury at the National Exhibition held in Montreal in 1984, and show manager of CAPEX 87, last June in Toronto. A promoter of philately, Madesker was also involved in youth exhibition. Regardless of all this, I don't think we have heard the end of this little mix-up.

I've mentioned in the past the postal hike last January would bring about further changes. Well

here's an example of how the post office is planning to get a whole lot more from us.

Not very long ago, you could send an 8½ x 11 envelope for the domestic rate providing it didn't exceed 30 grams. Now, if an envelope exceeds 25.5 cm x 15 cm (5 inches x 6 inches) it costs an additional ten cents, providing it doesn't exceed 30 grams. And if the envelope is thicker than five millimeters, regardless of its size, there is also an additional charge. Stamp exchange by mail has now become an expensive part of the hobby.

Marley's political ideas should come as no surprise

NEW YORK (AP) — At the age of 19, reggae artist Ziggy Marley has seen enough of the world to know he wants to change it.

"I am not blind," Marley says. "Even in Jamaica, injustice happened. It happened all over the world. It means something all over the world."

On the Melody Makers' new album, Conscious Party, Marley sings of oppression, bigotry and hope for a better world.

For anyone who follows reggae music, Marley's political consciousness should come as no surprise. The late Bob Marley, Ziggy's father, was reggae's most celebrated artist and famous for such protest songs as Get Up, Stand Up and I Shot the Sheriff.

But while acknowledging the le-

gacy of his father, Ziggy Marley is determined to establish his own identity. "I want to be fulfilled myself rather than try to follow exactly in my father's footsteps."

Marley was born Oct. 17, 1968, in Trenchtown, an impoverished section of Kingston in Jamaica. When he was 11, he formed the Melody Makers along with his brother, Stevie, and sisters, Cedella and Sharon.

Their first song, Children Playing in the Streets, was written by their father. In 1985, they released their first album, Play the Game Right, which received a Grammy nomination for best reggae record and in 1986, they released the album Hey World.

Hey World contained such overtly political songs as the anti-apartheid 666, and on the new album, he continues to confront in-

justice with songs such as Tomorrow People, the first single to be released.

"Tomorrow People, think of your past," he sings, attacking those who think only of the future and their indifference to humanity.

"The original idea was from robots, like the movie Robocop — people becoming androids," Marley said. "Scientists are making dangerous things."

Although Conscious Party is only Marley's third album, he is already attracting the attention of some of the music industry's most highly acclaimed artists.

Talking Heads members Chris Frantz and Tina Weymouth produced the record and Rolling Stones guitarist Keith Richards plays on the song Lee and Molly, a story about racial bigotry. Lee is a white man who dates Molly, a black wo-

man, and is beaten up by his father because of the relationship.

Ziggy Marley identifies strongly with the people of Africa. On Tumbling Down, he uses the symbols of the Eagle, the Bear and the Lion to warn against the consequences of superpower oppression of the third world.

"The Eagle is the United States and their allies. The Bear is the Soviet Union because of what they've done in Ethiopia and Afghanistan," Marley said. "The Lion is Africa. Bad things are done against my people. Consequences will come down on you."

Marley also sings about Africa on the ballad Dream of Home.

"Home is Africa," Marley said. "We know that's where we originated from. We have to get rid of (South African President P.W.) Botha. Through ourselves, our mu-

sic, we fight apartheid.

Marley is a Rastafarian and religion plays an important role in his life and music. On A Who a Sey he attacks those who do not share his belief in a higher being.

"My religion is a way of life. If I please Jah (God), I will please many more people," he said.

The Melody Makers started touring in 1975 and have appeared at shows with Stevie Wonder, The Clash, the late Peter Tosh and Jimmy Cliff. They performed at Reggae Sunsplash last August in Jamaica. With a worldwide tour scheduled to begin in April, Marley is anxious to play his new songs in front of a live audience.

"It's like relating to people. Like me talking to you," Marley said. "That is where the people feel the music and feel with you. I'm dealing with people."

Platinum Blonde concerts nixed by personnel problems

TORONTO (CP) — The cancellation of Platinum Blonde's January tour was blamed on poor ticket sales, but singer Mark Holmes said that was a "fishy" story to cover up personnel problems in the rock group.

"Basically, it's cleaning up acts," said Holmes. "There's so

much to be said for being healthy, staying away from drugs and booze and all sorts of things."

On the eve of the Toronto band's east coast shows, its record company said the concerts had been nixed because of slow ticket sales. Three days later, CBS announced Ontario dates were being scrubbed for the same reason.

Platinum Blonde, a favorite of

teenage girls, is one of Canada's top selling groups. It comprises Holmes, guitarist Sergio Galli, bassist Kenny Maclean and drummer Sascha.

The group's second album, 1985's Alien Shores, sold more than 500,000 copies. Its latest, Contact, is near the 150,000-sales mark.

"That was a fishy story ... about ticket sales," Holmes said after the band gave a surprise performance at the Rock Express magazine awards at Toronto's Diamond Club last week.

"There's far, far far more to it, but this isn't the time to discuss it. The real reason is due to certain personnel things within the group."

Bruce Barrow, the groups' manager, said the decision to drop the tour was based partly on slow ticket sales, but also in consideration of Maclean.

BAD TIMING

"Kenny was going through some heavy personal problems and it was just bad timing for him to go away and tour," Barrow said.

He refused to elaborate, saying only the "situation has resolved itself."

Attempts to reach Maclean were unsuccessful.

Barrow said scheduling the tour in January was a mistake because concert attendance is usually low right after Christmas. He also said he couldn't confirm bookings in Montreal and Quebec and no dates in the West were available because of the Olympics.

Embarking on a tour with only one date in a major city — Toronto — would have killed the group financially, he said.

The Maritime dates were to include St. John's, Nfld., Sydney, N.S., Moncton, N.B., Halifax and Fredericton. The Ontario shows were Kingston, London, North Bay, Sudbury, Thunder Bay, Ottawa and Toronto.

When the tour was cancelled, the group was in chaos.

But Holmes said the group's short Toronto show — its first public performance in about 18 months — was "a show of strength for the band."

He added: "We're together now. We're feeling good about what we're doing. We've overcome a lot of obstacles."

Holmes — now in Los Angeles

promoting Contact — said the band will not tour until it's stable.

"We owe it to our fans to be coherent. We owe it to them to be 120 per cent perfect on stage for them."

Barrow said the group is planning a cross-country tour for June.

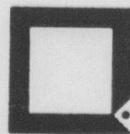

Modern Shakespeare mixes veteran with students

LENNOXVILLE — The play calls for an old man and if Shakespeare wanted an old man, he's going to get one.

The directing duo of Jo-Jo and George Rideout has taken on a heavy task. The Rideouts are directing the Bard's *As You Like It* at Bishop's University's Centennial Theatre.

Shakespeare's play is about finding peace and the answers to many questions by moving from the court of an evil Duke to the forest. This time around, the husband-and-wife team decided they would move the setting to Western Canada where they lived two years ago.

When they were casting for the part of Adam, an old, faithful servant, they decided the role should not be played by one of the students.

"Young students don't do older parts that well. It can take away from the play when they do that," George Rideout explained.

So they contacted Nelson Gonyer, drama teacher at Lennoxville's Alexander Galt Regional High School.

Gonyer suggested 75-year-old Bryce Hatfield, with whom he had worked before, might be just the person they were looking for.

Hatfield had done some theater in Saguenay, where he lived before he and his wife moved to Lennoxville 10 years ago.

In Lennoxville, he took part in productions of *The Mousetrap*, A

Man for all Seasons, *Fool's Paradise* and *Brigadoon*.

"I felt a little embarrassed about asking Bryce to audition for the part, especially since I was going to him and not the other way around," Rideout said.

"But when I went to his house, I asked him to read from the play, and he just read it so well," he added.

Hatfield said he had read the play many years ago. And though the veteran actor said he can relate to the character, he only hopes he can do the part justice.

But one aspect of the production he says he has no trouble with is

working with the students.

"They're so spontaneous. First class. I feel like one of the group," Hatfield said.

The Rideouts agree the kids are the stars of the show. Jo-Jo Rideout said they put in long, hard hours and a lot of effort to make the play a success.

"They work every evening, and during the winter break they worked through the day and evening, every day, instead of having time off," she said.

"I don't want the kids to be forgotten, it really concerns me because they're the ones that are doing the work," George Rideout said.

The Rideouts are sharing the position teaching theater and directing the play at Bishop's, where they have been since 1986. They share the job so they can take turns staying with their kids, eight-year-old Joe and two-year old William.

They were first hired by the theatre department to replace London Green, then they stayed on to replace Gregory Tuck.

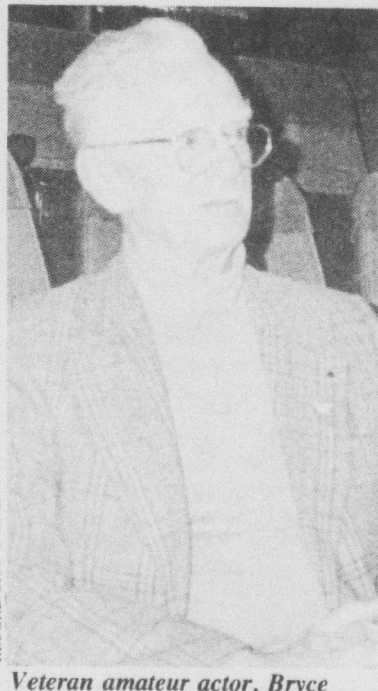
The Rideouts say they are pleased with Hatfield.

"Bryce is very good, and he gets

along well with the kids," George Rideout said.

The play will be done in Western-style costumes, set in Alberta. The play's forest of Arden, where some scenes are set, become the area around the Rockies.

"It wasn't a frivolous idea to set the play there. We think it's going to make the play more accessible to students. And it's also expensive to set it in the Elizabethan period,"

Jo-Jo Rideout explained.

The play runs March 17 to 19 at Centennial Theatre. Proceeds from Saturday's performance go to the Lennoxville Elementary School for new playground equipment.

"But people shouldn't come at the last minute on Saturday, because we may have a problem with seating that evening," Jo-Jo warned.

Behind local surgeon lies unnoticed secret poet

In one of the many tributes written after the death of John F. Kennedy I remember reading a haunting Irish lament for a dead hero. I recall neither the name of it nor the author but I never forgot it. The poem mourned the death of a beloved son and the regretful line, "We hardly knew ye," was repeated over and over.

This past summer, a friend asked if I would be attending the launching of a newly published book of poems written by Doctor Loomis. I almost choked on my coffee. "Poems? Doctor Loomis? Are

you serious?"

She assured me that she was. She told me that, apparently, he had written a great deal of poetry which now, after his death, had been compiled into a single volume and published by his wife, Marguerite Carvell Loomis. The book was to be introduced at a private reading at her home in North Hatley.

This friend and I were both old time operating room nurses and had worked side by side with Doctor Loomis for many years. She promised to obtain a copy of the book for me.

I brought the small volume to

Florida and have just finished reading it. I sat quietly, tears running down my face.

How could this be? How could I have known this man and not seen beyond the competent physician and surgeon? Had I missed any signs indicating that within this tall, taciturn man dwelt a weaver of magic, a poet?

I never thought that in our busy hospital world anyone else sought to capture the enchantment of the written word.

I think now of a story my father used to tell me frequently, of a sick man who spent his entire life and

his fortune travelling around the world in search of a specific plant that would cure him. He finally found it on his own doorstep where it had always grown, when he returned penniless and dying.

I experience an overpowering regret that I, like the man in the story, never noticed the presence of the poet.

Without any doubt, Doctor Loomis's friends, knowing him well, appreciated the many facets of his personality.

His colleagues had seen him as a great doctor and an outstanding surgeon, and often sought his counsel. But did they know he was a poet?

His patients were gratefully aware of his skill and his extraordinary kindness. But who among them thought of him as a spinner of fantasy?

Nurses will not feel too badly about a lack of sensitivity towards Doctor Loomis because he never gave an inkling of his inner thoughts. However, I do have a sense of shame as I remember my constant nagging and scolding over his tardiness and his unhur-

ried decisions.

Perhaps he smiled inwardly, even a little sadly, at my youthful impatience, my inability to see beyond the daily schedule. I had the disease of not listening, the malady of not marking.

Today, in his book *A Doctor's Supplication — Collected Poems of Gordon Loomis*, I read the lovely things he wrote—

"I am sitting on the edge of heaven And I don't know why I am here..."

"Have you ever watched a firefly's flight?"

or, "The gossamershreds of a spider web sipping

Up the colors of a rainbow..."

"My mind," he wrote, "with bounds leaps into the ionosphere

To meet, to cleave the azure ethereal blues..."

In the book's first poem I found words that might apply to how I must have seemed to the poet—

"Although your spirit races high, Weary, sullied feet, clay bound can never reason why..."

All through those years, yearning desperately to touch a star, I never realized how near I came.

Indeed, I hardly knew him.

Vladimir Kosma Zworykin made it but not Madonna

SHERBROOKE (MHG) — Madonna just didn't cut it this year.

That's because the pop queen just didn't have the "staying power" it took to make it into the 1988 World Book Encyclopedia. Madonna's permanence and contribution to society are not yet proven. And staying power is what it takes, as World Book knows all too well.

Over its 70 years of existence, World Book has been read by an estimated 111 million people around the world. They've learned about everything from the A-bomb to Vladimir Kosma Zworykin. But those who open up a 22 volume blue leather-bound set this year will be getting a taste of something completely different.

For the past three years more than 1000 editors, artists, researchers, cartographers, contributors, illustrators and productions specialists at World Book have been tracking down new submissions to add to the completely revised 1988 edition — the most extensive revision in 26 years. It's a huge undertaking all at a cost of \$7 million and a revision of an encyclopedia is not something that happens every year.

But what's different? Seventy new articles for one. That means subjects that have never made it into World Book before finally have their names engraved in ink. Sir John Gielgud, extraterrestrial intelligence and the Star Wars defense program are all part of the 1988 edition. If you've looked for them before and haven't found them, there all there now.

And so is 18 million pounds of paper. It took that much to print the 1988 editions — paper that would

stretch across Canada and the United States more than 11 times or fill 94 railway cars.

But there's more than just paper and facts to a World Book. As Birdie Hyatt, the division manager for the encyclopedia company says, there are all kinds of programs to get kids of all ages reading World Book.

There are Childcraft and Early World of Learning products for the tots and the Partners in Education program for school-aged children. Just about any school library you can think of has World Book on its shelves.

Hyatt says World Book is a product she believes in because she watched her own children learn through its pages. Hyatt is like many other World Book sales representatives — she joined because she believed what was good for her children, was good for everyone's children.

One of the World Book programs Hyatt says she is most proud of is the "Company with a Heart" project. Thousands of encyclopedias are donated each year to underprivileged families and organizations.

So while you may not find Madonna gracing the pages of the 1988 World Book, at least you can find out who Vladimir Kosma Zworykin was.

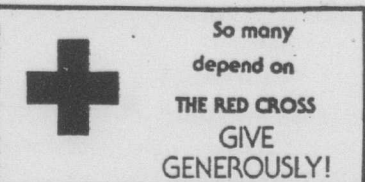

Opera 1980s style might save Townships Theatre

LENNOXVILLE — The Townships Theatre is fighting for its life. But with its latest production the local amateur group might just keep on breathing.

What is possibly the earliest opera composed in North America and in Canada, *Colas and Colinette*, will be staged at Alexander Galt Regional High School March 24 to 26.

Director and set designer John Pille has been rehearsing with the five-person cast since last fall at Alexander Galt, where he is also band leader.

"A week ago I wouldn't have said this, but it's coming along," Pille said after last Tuesday's rehearsal.

"Dialogue-wise and music-wise, it's a lot better than it's been," he added.

And with the help of a very enthusiastic and good humored cast of regulars, the rehearsal moved along at a quick enough pace. *Colas* himself, 28-year-old Philippe Desormeaux, from Stanstead is the quintessence of this light-hearted quality.

"Philippe is the backbone of the group, never a quitting attitude, he just does what has to be done," Bruce Patton said as he watched Desormeaux joke between songs with Peter Kandalaft, who plays his rival. Patton is helping the group with publicity.

"What I like about Philippe is you can understand what he says no matter where you are in the room," Patton added when Desormeaux and Kandalaft continued their duet.

"It's almost like we've schooled him. I first worked with him in *Brigadoon*, and we had to go over it with him almost note by note. But now he can read music very well," Pille said.

Colas and Colinette was composed by Joseph Quesnel around the 1780s. Quesnel first stepped into the society of French Canadians

and British Loyalists when he was captured by the British while he was attempting to land supplies from a French ship for the American rebels.

The operetta is a love story. The hero and heroine succeed in getting together despite the tricks of the heroine's manipulative second suitor.

The English translation of the operetta was first printed by a Canadian around 1850. The play has seen many professional performances, but the original version was last on the amateur stage in the early 19th century.

Patton says he has done everything he can think of to publicize the event.

"I organized a big ad campaign, but there are only a certain number of anglophone businesses and media in the area," Patton said. So he also plans to publicize in the francophone media.

Plus he set up interviews on CBC's *Quebec AM* and *Breakaway* the week before the show.

The Township Theatre is funded through ticket sales. The only outside funding comes from advertising sales in the program which pays for no more than the printing.

Patton is very emphatic about keeping the Players and other anglophone institutions alive in the Townships.

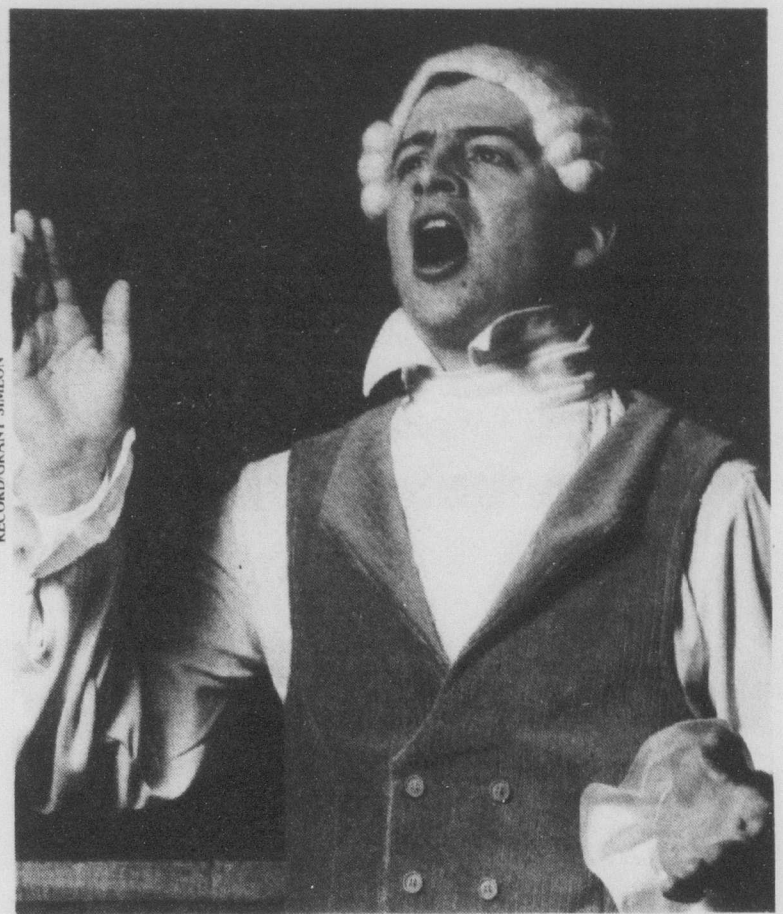
"We're fighting for survival, and every time we close an english school or church it's one less thing," he said.

"I offered groups rates for the show to 50-plus groups. But they always asked if the show was during the day, and when I said it was at night, they said they don't go out at night."

But this year's production should appeal to a wide-ranging audience. *Colas* was composed at a time when the opera was developing as a popular art form.

As the group's press release explains, this opera has "no interminable arias by distraught sopranos and anxious tenors. No plot so steeped in classical literature that only a few could possibly follow it."

"The music is very different. It's definitely not Gilbert and Sullivan," Pille said.

It's simplistic and the songs use colloquial language. But the dialogue is often 18th century English.

"The play is so portable. We'd like to go to the Haskell Opera

House in Rock Island, if they'd like to have us," Patton said.

"But if people don't help us, they're helping us to disappear," Patton added.

Robert Plant's Now and Zen: A giant step forward

Robert Plant's solo albums have been marked by a sense that he was trying to distance himself from his days with Led Zeppelin. While accomplished, they sounded restrained — like someone stifling his natural impulses.

But Plant has burst out of his self-imposed chains with *Now and Zen* (Atlantic). This is Plant's big statement.

It's a great rock album because it achieves the near impossible: a major artistic progression that can appeal to a wide audience.

As a former member of one of rock's greatest bands, Plant has a distinctive voice that's ingrained in the skulls of two generations of rock fans. With the good material and his inspired performance, this could be a mega-hit.

As if to prove he's come to terms with his past, Plant has former Zeppelin guitarist Jimmy Page add some climbing solos on *Heaven Knows* and *Tall Cool One*. And yes, the Plant-Page combination is still explosive.

GIANT STEP

Now and Zen, though, is not a step back to Zep's blast-furnace

metal, but a giant step forward. It's bold, adventurous rock that takes risks without straining to be arty.

The album has the shimmering gleam of electronics and the atmosphere of eastern mysticism, but also bump-and-grind guitars, steamy sensuality and mischievous fun. While many tunes don't really rock, there is a metallic edge that powers the songs.

The key to the record, though, is that Plant is writing songs with melodies again. He's also singing like the swaggering stud of old, driving the music higher with the kinds of moans and screams that

made him the definitive hard rock belter.

As the title indicates, he's not above some silliness. On *Tall Cool One*, he's spliced in some classic Zeppelin riffs. He's both sending up and celebrating his past. It's al-

so a shot at the Beastie Boys, the Cult and all the other bands that have blatantly ripped off Zeppelin.

Plant has been due to break out for a while. *Now and Zen* is that breakthrough.

Film version of book brings Kundera recognition

The Unbearable Lightness of Being by Milan Kundera (FITZHENRY & WHITESIDE): \$10.50, 314 pp.

The acclaim being won by Philip Kaufman's film *The Unbearable Lightness of Being*, may, by the reversal of the usual process, send viewers of the film looking for a copy of Milan Kundera's original novel.

Translated from the Czech by Michael Henry Heim, Kundera's experimental novel was published in a glossy-covered paperback in 1985, to enthusiastic but sparse reviews. The film version of this story may bring Kundera's talents for transcribing the dilemmas of contemporary living onto the pages of the European novel into wider recognition by North American readers.

With its background of the Soviet invasion of Czechoslovakia, Kundera's novel traces the complex relationship between a medical doctor named Tomas and his lover Tereza. It is all complicated by the doctor's passion for a mistress named Sabina.

Cutting quickly between the invaded Czech homeland and Zurich, Switzerland, the novel draws the reader into the domestic arrangements of Tomas and his women, relying on stark realism, frank discussions of sexuality, and eroticism.

As important as the graphic treatment of the sexuality of these characters is to his book, it is also part of Kundera's method here to show how the lives of ordinary Czechs were brutalized by the Soviet invasion of their country.

The indignities suffered by Alexander Dubcek, the reaction of the citizens to Russian aggression, and strange happenings — Czech girls kissing and petting in front of the Soviet soldiers who had not been allowed leave for several months at a time, driving them to distraction—form the historical background to this modern novel.

Kundera uses odd narrative techniques and structures in the development of his novel, often treating the reader with a confessional, friendly tone. He often appears to be asking readers to share in the close observation of Kundera's

ra's vision of modernity.

Digressions into the realm of ideas are as important as Tomas, Tereza and Sabina. Beethoven's theme of "Es muss sein" (it must be), taken from his last quartet, is used as a touchstone for Tomas's returning to Tereza after a contretemps.

The discreet crimes of Russia against Lithuanians, Poles and Crimean Tatars are weighed against the invasion of 1968, for which the Czechs have ample photographic proof.

And above all, Kundera is preoccupied with making it clear to all who enter his story that they are in the realm of fiction only. "Franz and Simon are the dreamers in this novel."

As the reader discovers, Franz is on the collateral side of the story, being one of Sabina's lovers, while Simon is the child of Tomas, and has long been estranged from his mother when the book opens.

The chronology of *The Unbearable Lightness of Being* is fragmented, and just as the settings shift from Prague to Geneva to Bangkok, Kundera moves through time with the ease of an experimental novelist.

Many of the techniques Kundera brings to his book will be familiar to readers of Sterne, Woolf, Thackeray and Joyce, but it is fascinating to read a novel from a European tradition using experimental modes of construction and narrative voice that have been so closely identified with the British tradition.

Kundera's explorations of humanity, sexuality, contemporary politics and romance have obviously caught the eye of film-maker Kaufman, (*The Right Stuff*, *Invasion of the Body Snatchers*) but wise film buffs will recognize the richness of the screen treatment as firmly rooted in an exceptional book. And in the case of Kundera's *The Unbearable Lightness of Being*, they are absolutely right.

RECORD REVIEWS

James Taylor NEVER DIE YOUNG (COLUMBIA)

Sweet Baby James is on a roll, seeing how his album from just less than a year ago, *That's Why I'm Here* gained him the airplay that was missing in the early eighties. Now, Taylor followed that winner up with another fine record of soft, melodic rock sprinkled with some Cajun, country, blues and ballad styles, apparently certifying that Taylor is back.

The title track has been getting attention, but "Valentine's Day" could well become to that holiday what Irving Berlin's song, sung by Bing Crosby, became to the more celebrated winter holiday.

Taylor's tribute to Cupid's day is a tongue-in-cheek assembly of diverse images, from Al Capone and Bugsy Moran's infamous deeds on

this day, to familiar objects of the twenties: "Bootleg gin, porkpie hat/ Dew Drop Inn, dirty rat", to one of the most self-denigrating verses ever written: "I lost my teeth, I lost my hair/ I lost my mind, you don't care/ Love is war, all is fair/ On Valentine's Day!"

James sounds righteous on "Sweet Potato Pie", he adds a country fiddle to the Cajun-flavour of "Runaway Boy", and somehow manages to turn the journey of the Magi into a pop song on "Home By Another Way", while "T-Bone" is a rhythm and blues creation that stands out on this very even, listenable album.

Of course, a large part of the credit for the success of this record must go to producer Don Grolnick, who has kept together some of the main elements of the Taylor machine, such as Leland Sklar on bass, Dan Dugmore on pedal steel and banjo, with the performing duo from James's concerts, Arnold McCuller and Rosemary Butler adding vocal harmonies. The resulting blend is the kind of soft rock that Taylor rode all the way through the seventies, and who's to say that with two in a row he won't close out this decade with the same popularity?

Jerry Harrison (WEA-SIRE)

Talking Heads fans will revel in the fact that this solo album by guitarist Jerry Harrison is only a teaser, pending the imminent release of the long-awaited album by the avant-garde darlings of pop.

Harrison, whose first solo package in 1981, *The Red and the Black*, did not do much business, appears to have a far more noteworthy session with *Casual Gods*.

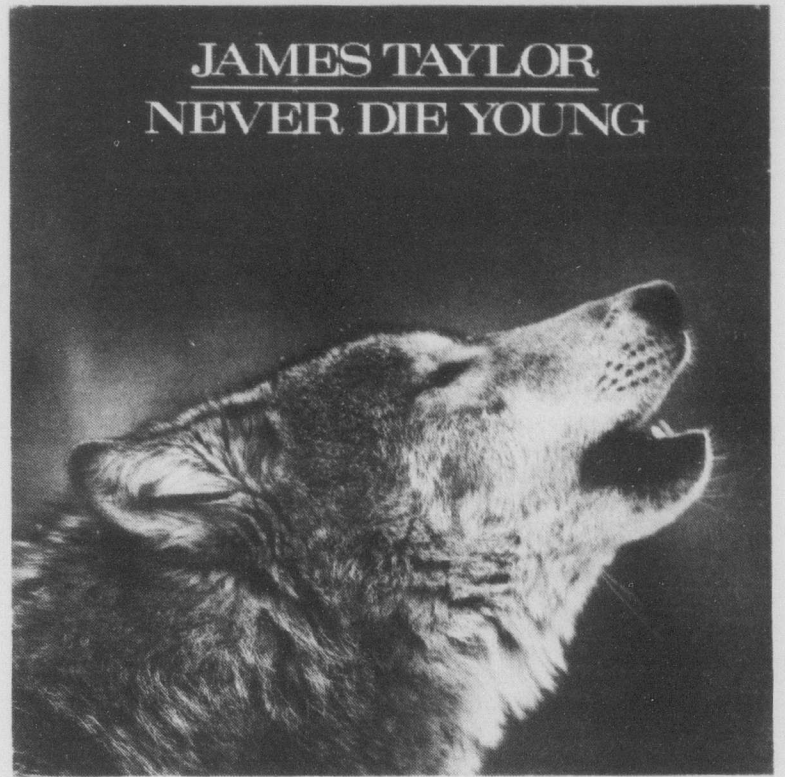
Very much an exercise in compelling rhythms stacked on rhythms, Harrison's experimental guitars, whether it's the slides on "Cherokee Chief" or the laser-sharp licks on "A Perfect Lie", keep this record on the edge between experimental and pop.

In addition to the interplay of African and black funk rhythms, Herry Harrison's cover artwork features a startling photograph. It is almost Hieronymous Bosch-like in its broad perspective of ant-like men swarming up and down ladders on a vast hillside. What appears to be a scene from the building of the pyramids or some other earthly wonder is a 1987 photo taken in Brazil of 50,000 men digging for gold.

From this picture, Harrison takes his album's title, saying that these men are "reduced to this condition by poverty and the bewildering indifference of casual gods".

And as the music also reveals, Harrison takes his social conscience quite as seriously as his Talking Heads cohort, David Byrne. Until their next, this one will do quite nicely.

LADY BEWARE (IVE VIDEO)

A psychological thriller with several unique twists, for instance, it's set in Pittsburg, instead of L.A. or N.Y., this one pits a young modern woman against a psycho who haunts her with pathological intensity.

Diane Lane plays the department-store window-dresser whose imaginative, kinky and provocative placing of manikins creates great advertising for her store, even as it kindles ideas of aggression and kinky sex in her secret admirer.

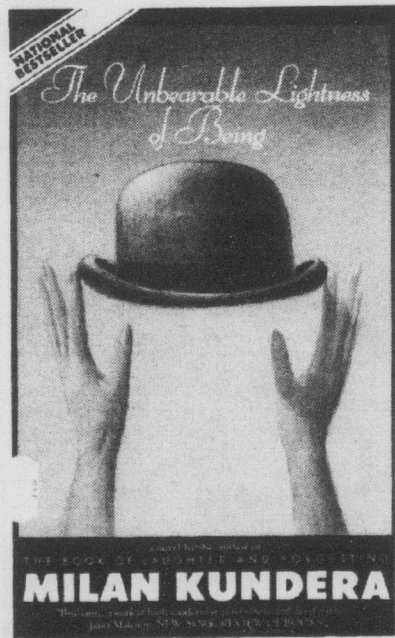
Newcomer Michael Woods is perfect as the radiology technician who works across the street from Lane's suggestive window displays. He begins to track her in devious and ingenious ways.

Lane's character is hardly the squeamish type, but the intrusions

into her life move beyond suggestive phone calls and intercepted letters from her family, to eavesdropping by her stalker while she entertains her love interest at home.

And when the assaults on her private life and on her mind reach an unbearable intensity, Lane turns the tables on her antagonist, and *LADY BEWARE* has a neat twist ending.

To its credit, the film never falls to the level of a cheap B-movie, where it might have oversensationalized the plot. There are moments of Hitchcock-like dramatic tension, as Lane gets into a deadly mind-game with her potential killer and taunts him into making a fatal move against her in the exciting climax. And if you like to support Canadian television, the series **Mount Royal** continues on the CTV network.

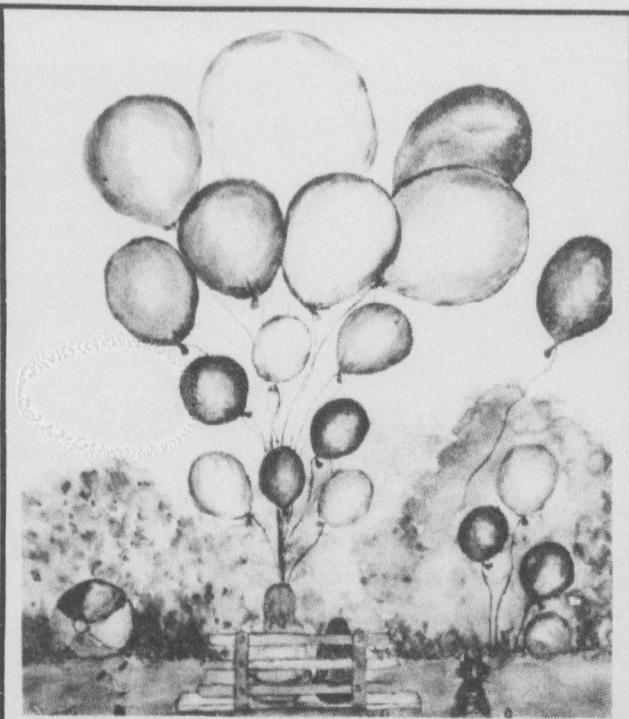

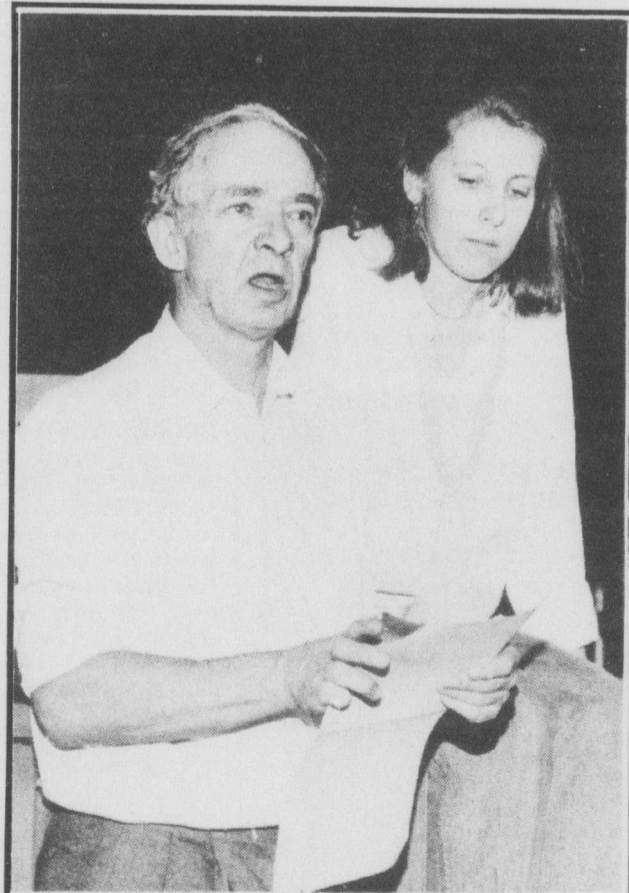

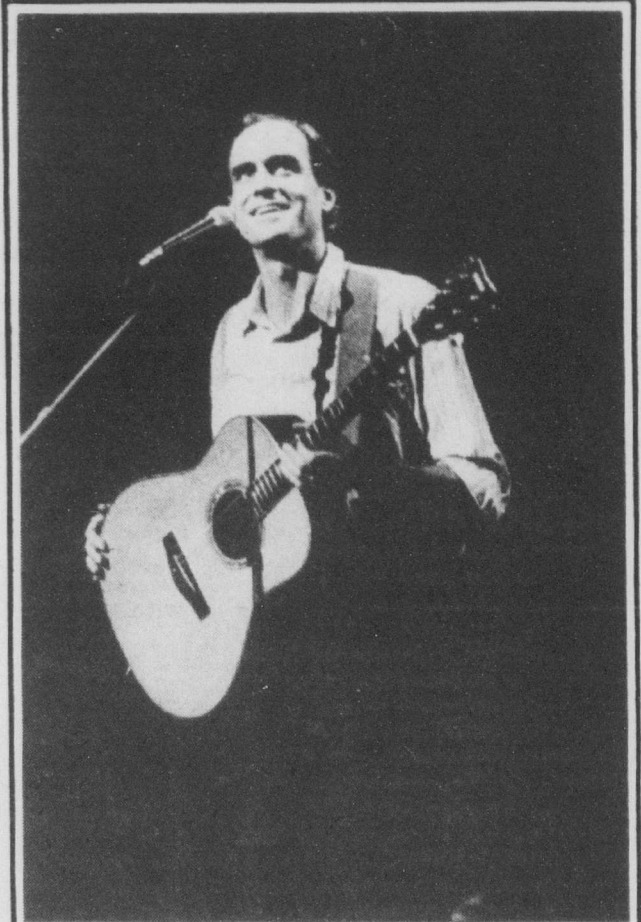
Showtimes are 7:20 and 9:30 weekly, with weekend matinées at 1, 3:05 and 5:10.

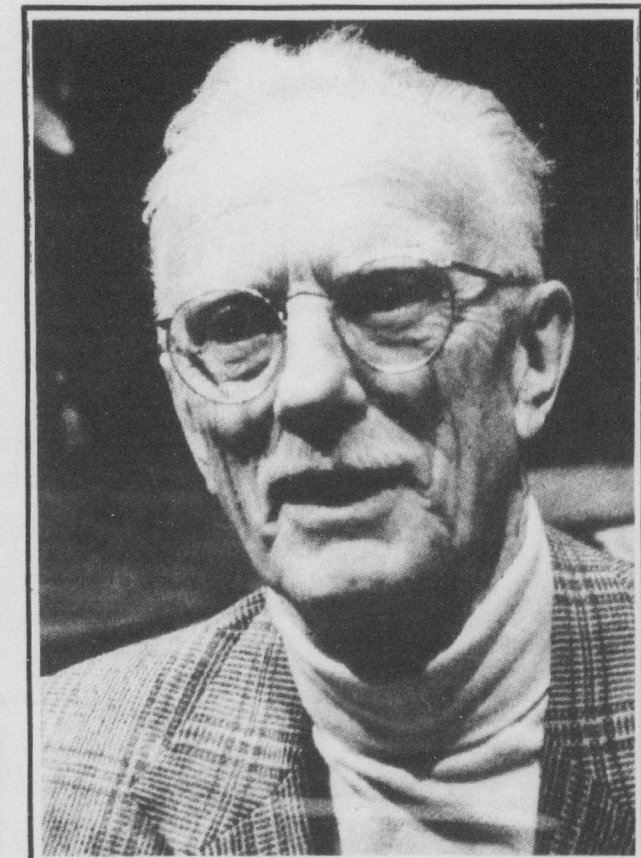
probably want to avoid this one. It's not one of the most intelligent attempts at portraying life in a rock band on the big screen.

North Japan's Lake Tazawa offers many pleasures

LAKE TAZAWA, Japan (CP) — The spas, hot springs and hiking paths surrounding Lake Tazawa draw thousands of urban and rural Japanese. But the area is one of Japan's best-kept secrets and very few foreigners venture this far off the tourist path.

Located high in the mountains about 450 kilometres north of Tokyo, Lake Tazawa is the deepest freshwater lake in Japan. Mysteriously, it never freezes over, even during the long, cold winters.

Legend has it that heat generated by the passionate union of Princess Tatsuko, now a dragon living in its depths, and her equally reptilian husband, Hachiro Taro, prevents the deep freeze.

The wind, redolent of pine needles and fireworks (a favorite Japanese summer activity), blows gently from the lake. Beckoning us is a sign advertising "Bichi Hausu" — a transliteration of the Japanese word for beach house — the traditional Japanese inn or "ryokan" where we'll be staying for the next three days.

PRICE IS RIGHT

Bichi Hausu is run by a number of friendly Japanese women who, like most people in the area, speak little if any English, but they seem delighted to see us.

A double room with breakfast and dinner costs the equivalent of about \$85 Cdn — a real bargain for those used to the inflated prices of Tokyo and Osaka.

A timid young housemaid leads us up the smooth pine stairs from the main floor dining room, past the stuffed fox on the landing and into a charming tatami-mat room with a large window looking on to the lake.

The maid bows demurely after pouring us each a cup of green tea (free at most ryokans) and offering rice crackers.

RENT A BIKE

Bichi Hausu, like many of the other hotels and ryokans along the lake, has a huge stable of rusty but serviceable bicycles for rent at

about \$3 an hour: an excellent way to explore the immediate area.

But beware! An hour will take you only one-quarter of the way around the lake. If you want to encircle it, a whole day should be set aside. Ask the Bichi Hausu ladies to pack you a picnic.

Peddalling past forests of pine and deciduous trees and the occasional serious-looking hiker, it's possible to cruise down side roads through lush rice paddies beside well-kept, thatched-roof farmhouses. Here, as elsewhere near the lake, the sight of foreigners brings smiles and waves from

friendly farmworkers.

Some of the big attractions near Lake Tazawa afford even more of an opportunity to meet the real folk of Japan. "Onsens" (hot springs) are magnets for the sybaritic Japanese. It's possible to spend time in spas like Kuroyo (minutes by bus from the lake area's Tazawako Station) with farmers in a thatched-roof inn, drinking, singing, and bathing in communal sulphur and thermal baths.

If that doesn't appeal, a hike around Tazawako-Kogan Plateau (30 minutes by bus from the station) may intrigue you. Mount Ko-

maga Dake, a dormant volcano, offers the hiker a variety of trails over terrain ranging from scrub to bleak moonscapes of volcanic boulders. Real samurai culture is available in the town of Kakunodate (also 30 minutes from the station), in which several samurai houses over 375 years old and their traditional gardens may be toured.

The inviting, pale turquoise waters of Lake Tazawa itself offer splendid swimming and sunbathing. Other activities include a ferry ride past a golden statue of the inimitable Princess Tatsuko in human form.

DINNER DELIGHTS

Upon returning to Bichi Hausu that first day, we are told that dinner will be served — in our room — at 6:30 p.m. Should we wish beer to accompany it, a dispensing machine on the main landing offers Kirin, Asahi, and Suntory brands in cans ranging in size from 150 millilitres to 3.5 litres.

Shortly after changing out of our wet bathing suits, a timid scratch at the door (no western-style knocking here!) announces the arrival of our housemaid, Mitsukosan, carrying two black lacquer stand-up trays on which dishes of exquisitely prepared food are arranged.

In addition to the standard rice, miso soup and pickles, the trays are loaded with fresh shrimp and cucumbers drizzled with rice vinegar, delicate fronds of boiled fern, salt-grilled trout, slivers of ginger chicken, marinated adzuki beans and crescents of honeydew melon. More green tea in a gleaming indigo teapot completes the memorable meal.

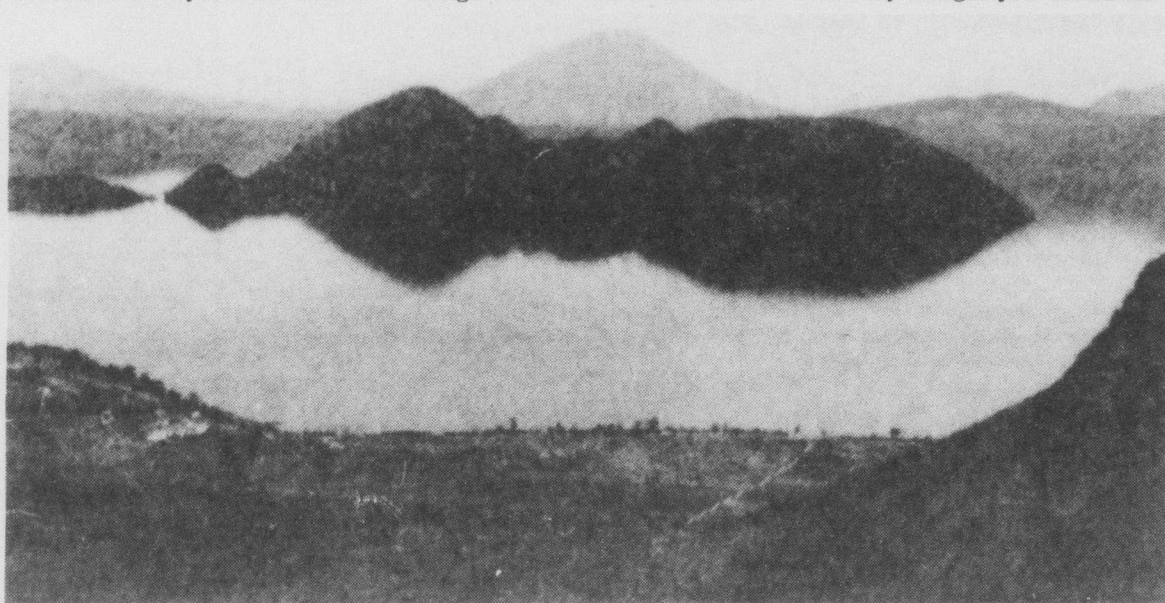
GETTING THERE

Getting to Tazawako, as the area around the lake is called, without a car (by far the recommended way for non-Japanese) is easy. A round-trip Shinkansen (bullet-train) ticket from Tokyo's Ueno Station to Morioka, the jumping-off point for Tazawako, costs the equivalent of about \$20. On the high-speed train, passengers are served by white-coated waiters offering steaming hot towels and delicious food.

At Morioka (four hours from Ueno), a choice of a slow (approximately one hour) or an express (20 minutes) local train for \$15 or \$20 respectively will take you to Tazawako Station via a somewhat hair-raising route straight up the side of a mountain. From Tazawako Station, any Tazawa bus will take you to Bichi Hausu and the lake for \$6 within 20 minutes.
