Parizeau victory good news for Slippery Bob

"For Art stopped short at the cultivated court of the *Empress Josephine*."

It's been a long, hot glorious summer and most of us were tickled pink to take a break from politics. The indefatigable J.J. Stewart, the redoubtable Don Healy, even the impish Ashley Sheltus have all shown remarkable forbearance — particularly when a *Record* editorialist naively called for Quebec's independence.

But all good things must come to an end and it's once more unto the breach. Lucien Bouchard has publicly admitted an independent Quebec will probably lose its English community and was quite sanguine at the prospect. Seventy-five percent of Quebec businessmen favor bilingual signs but *Action Québec* toured Stansstead and Beebe and lodged 103

complaints of sign law violations — lest English Quebecers or American tourists be made to feel welcome.

And a meeting of PQ youth at Granby last week geared up for the referendum and subsequent separation. Jolly Jacques Parizeau, asked why there was almost no ethnic representation, went into his wonderful Major Hoople imitation. Hak-kaff! Harrumph!

And last week, the Bloc Québécois gained a new convert to replace the sneak who had second thoughts while the PQ won its first by-election in history. Pundits examined the entrails and turned up all manner of omens while Parizeau was beside himself with delight. Hak-kaff! By Jupiter!

But everyone knows our dear queer Quebec loves to vote one way in by-elections and the opposite in general elections —

just as we vote one way federally and the other provincially to keep creative tensions high. A Parizeau victory is therefore good news for Slippery Bob.

* *

That creative tension has been a great stimulus to the arts in Quebec and a paramount reason why they have mushroomed since the Quiet Revolution. A good argument may be made that anglos have kept French culture alive and flourishing in North America — at enormous expense historically.

The 1774 Quebec Act, for example, preserved the language, customs and religion of French Canada at the cost of the American colonies. One of their complaints against George III listed in the Declaration of Independence is "For abolishing the free system of English Laws in a neighboring Province."

Nationalists, of course, will never admit Quebec's culture depends on anglophones and everybody calls on Ottawa to get out of sponsoring the arts here. When Joe Clark submits his report to cabinet next week, it's a good bet culture will be among the first concessions to Quebec — and that should be bad news to both French and English artists here.

"The time has come," intoned the Arpin Report (Quebec's 'Policy for Culture and the Arts') "to consider culture an essential mission of the State, and cultural activity which enriches Quebec as a basic and civilizing value."

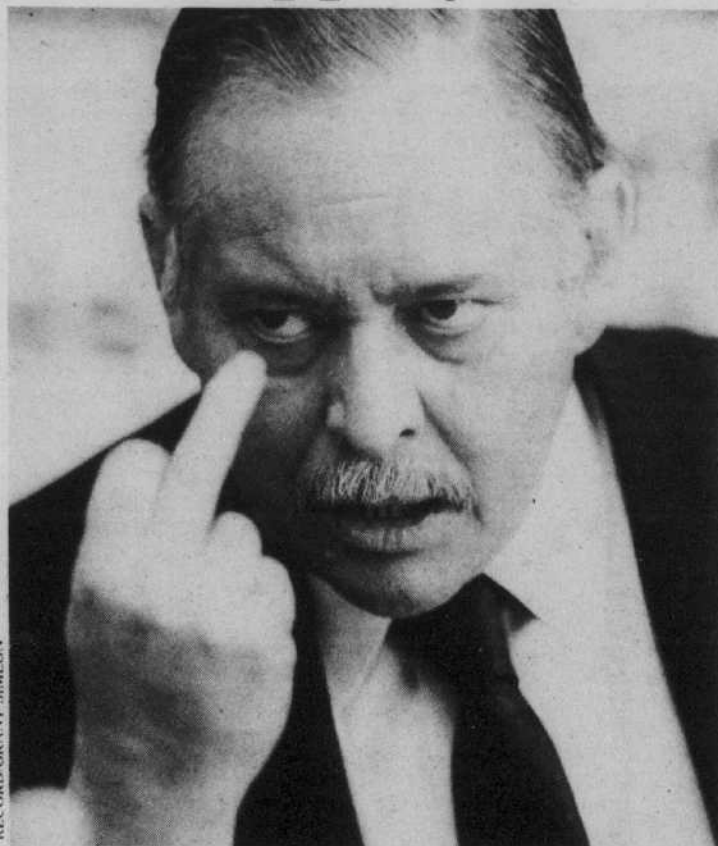
Note the capitalization of the word 'State', a recognition of the collectively over the individual which should put serious wind up every artist struggling for his own voice. That may service performing artists — Hitler's grand spectacles spring to mind — but the *only* productive political position for a creative artist is in opposition.

"Because of the distinctive character of Quebec society, the State ... should be exclusively in charge."

That can only mean Quebec should finance those artists who "preserve and promote" French Canadian distinctiveness. But that's not art. That's propaganda.

The Arpin Report declares the federal government should

get out of every field of cultural activity in Quebec whether we stay in Canada or not. That's because Quebec wants to promote its distinctiveness while Ottawa also supports English publishing, theatre, radio and television here which undermines that distinctiveness.

Right now in Quebec, Ottawa supports the National Film Board, the CRTC, Radio-Québec, CBC, Telefilm Canada, the Museum of Civilization in Hull, National Archives, historic sites and individual artists, writers, dancers, musicians, etc. through the Canada Council.

Right now in Quebec, Ottawa spends 60 per cent of the money it earmarks for film and videos leaving nine provinces and two territories to divide the other 40 per cent. That's only as it should be, declared Normand Chouinard of Kingsey Falls, president of the Quebec Theatre Council. "Quebec gets a little more than its share ... because it's more than a province and that's what we want to be recognized from the rest of Canada. And when the rest of Canada understands this fact ... great steps will be made."

The Arpin Report adds; "There would be no question of limiting or prohibiting anyone from establishing a cultural initiative. But the budgets are

limited, and we must make a more rigorous selection of organizations qualified for grants."

And again: "Quebec is an open pluralistic society with many resources, within the limits which impose respect for democratic values."

Like it or lump it, majority rules. Right now, the Canada Council has French and English sides accepting applications and awarding grants to artists anywhere in Canada while struggling to keep at arm's length — donate but don't dictate.

Quebec's Ministry of Cultural Affairs also makes grants and English-speaking artists are invited to apply. However, as Sherbrooke's director, Fernand Caron, points out, some of the judges may not understand English so that unilingual French-speakers pronounce on the quality of English writing.

Quebec's Declaration of Independence was clearly set out in the distinct society clause of the Meech Lake Accord and begins something like this:

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that Quebec is a distinct society and endowed by that distinction with certain unalienable rights, that among these is the right to preserve and promote that distinction at the cost of all other cultures...

MusiquePlus fetes fifth birthday with big gala

SHERBROOKE — It's been five years since MusiquePlus, the French counterpart of MuchMusic, hit the province's television screens, and the station is celebrating its birthday by honoring the best Quebec-produced videos of the year and opening its doors to the public.

In town this week was video jockey Paul Sarrasin spreading the word about the festivities which take place Sept. 1.

Sarrasin said the award show was conceived because "music videos have to be considered as an entity. This year, 159 videos were produced in Quebec from May '90 to June '91. This is the biggest year so far."

Both the station and music fans will decide which artists will receive the awards. The public can vote for four out of the 14 categories, the best male, female, group and overall video of the year.

The other ten categories, including best editing, artistic direction and instrumental video, will be chosen by the programming board of MusiquePlus.

The nominees include artists such as Sherbrooke native Jim Corcoran, Celine Dion, Mitsou, Roch Voisine and Bootsauce.

Fans wishing to vote for their favorite Quebec-produced videos can do so at a nearby Burger King restaurant.

"They don't need to buy lunch," Sarrasin stressed. "If they just want to vote, they can vote, and they can win prizes."

The gala, to be aired live, is scheduled to start at 8. During the day, however, the Montreal-based station plans to open its doors to the public. Visitors are invited to tour the editing base, studios and offices.

"They can visit everything," Sarrasin confirmed.

Artists such as Too Many Cooks and Julie Masse will be on hand to sign autographs.

MusiquePlus has come a long way since its beginning in 1986, when it was a pay-TV service in 200,000 homes and only aired four hours of original programming daily, from 8 p.m. to midnight, which was then repeated from midnight till 4 a.m. Equipment at MuchMusic studios in Toronto was being used and the staff had to

constantly travel back and forth between the two cities.

LOTS TO OFFER

Sarrasin, who was hired four months after its debut, said MusiquePlus has a lot to offer viewers.

"Because we're in a different area of the world, we can have musical cultures that are very different from Toronto or New York or Los Angeles," he said. "So, we can play French videos from here, English videos from here, videos from every place in the world. So, it's different from MTV and MuchMusic."

Indeed, artists such as Israeli singer Ofra Haza and Spanish group The Gipsy Kings found huge success in Quebec after their videos were shown on MusiquePlus, but did not receive the same reception in English Canada or the States.

According to Sarrasin, what has changed the most over the past five years is Quebec music video production itself.

"Before we came in, there were 24 Quebec video clips," he explained. "Since we're in, they've made 523 clips. It's 128th of world production so far."

And the beat goes on....

Stratford plays range from classics to Canadian

STRATFORD — *Homeward Bound* was a lame start to the Donnelly annual Stratford Festival foray. We thought the "world premiere" of "a new Canadian play", showcased by the cream of a strong 48-member cast, might merit attention. So such luck.

Margaret Atwood, in the program's introduction to the play, does a creative analysis of this "comedy of manners about death".

Even the title is dissected to posit allusions of a mental "home", hospital "ward" and the sense of confinement in the

world "bound". In light of the play, however, the analysis is a bit stretched.

Donnelly agrees that there's material to make one laugh, then cringe, but not because of a sardonic aftertaste. Rather, *Homeward Bound* leaves one feeling like a victim of formula and fashion.

GLORIFIED SITCOM

We didn't expect to be exposed to a glorified sitcom about serious subjects. Playwright Elliot Hayes pulls all the enlightened gay clichés and liberal notions about euthanasia out of the pop-cult bag, uses stock characters in contrived

ways to make a few points about communications breakdown, the inevitability of death and how to deal with it.

The other Canadian play, an English adaptation of Michel Tremblay's classic *Les Belles Soeurs*, has already received much praise and so it should.

The setup for this revealing kitchen-sink comedy-drama is a stamp-licking party for neighbours and relatives, when Germaine Lauzon wins a million trading stamps. If you haven't seen it in English or French, put it on the list. So much for Canadiana, Stratford-style.

Our Town, on the other hand is a flashback to 1911 Americana. This is a boring, dated, idealistic view of America, bordering on propaganda.

BAD AMONG GOOD

Thornton Wilder's American town never really existed except in his imagination. Coming from small towns, we know that bad exists along with the good. Wilder only viewed town life through rose-colored glasses.

The idea of the stage manager as guide is a good one and Douglas Rains does a bang-up job in the role. The acting and staging are fine. Now if a real story of "our town" were brought to life, we'd be most interested to check it out.

Stratford is Canada's Sha-

kespeare festival and four of the Bard's plays are on show this season. *Much Ado About Nothing* is the best of the lot.

Richard Monette, a fine actor too long absent from the stage, is proving to be an innovative, risk-taking director who usually manages to bring the dead poet back to life. This production is no exception.

Much Ado may at first seem light comedy but it deals with a pretty heavy topic still relevant today — love between equals. Goldie Semple (a Festival Lennoxville veteran) and Colm Feore are marvelous as the battling lovers, Beatrice and Benedick.

EMPHASIZES HUMORZ

This production, however, emphasizes the humor and operatic qualities of the play. Nicholas Pennell (*The Pallisers*) as Leonato makes the tricking of Benedick as contemporary as a skit by Robin Williams and Statford's grand old man, Brian Bedford, turns Dogberry. Chief of the play's keystone cops, into a major role.

Professional singer John Devorski adds magic to the built-in ditties and even Feore contributes, showing his passion for Beatrice in song.

Timon of Athens is a very difficult play to pull off and, as a result, is rarely produced. The fact that it is staged at the newly named Tom Patterson

Theatre, home of the Young Company and new or experimental productions, shows a lack of total commitment, despite Brian Bedford's distinguished presence in the title role.

As it happens, Bedford is not well-cast to bring sympathy to what should be a young Gatsby-like Timon. When Timon loses his fortune, his friends desert him like a sinking ship. But we don't ever really care about Timon, he just strikes us as a naive old fool.

OLD STANDBYS

Two lesser efforts round off the Shakespearean component. The old standby, *Hamlet*, with Colm Feore in the lead, has received ho-hum reviews and disappointing direction of *Twelfth Night* by Bernard Hopkins (remember him from his days as head of Bishop's Drama Department?) have marked it as a loser.

Rodgers and Hammerstein's *Carousel*, Ibsen's *An Enemy of the People*, *The Rules of the Game* by Pirandello, Molière's *The School for Wives* and Elliot Hayes' stage adaptation of *Treasure Island* (Hayes seems to have his finger in a lot of Stratford's pies) are the other major productions, most of which run into November and may yet be visited by the Black Donnellys.

Potter Lucy Doheny breaks conventional molds

LENNOXVILLE—"The biggest misconception about pottery is that it's easy," says Lucy Doheny as she rinses mud from her hair.

"Everybody has taken it," she says with a shrug as she takes off more clumps of clay that cover her face, neck, arms and hands. "You always hear, 'Oh, I took pottery at camp' or elsewhere. People think it's easy. That's because it looks so easy for someone who knows what they're doing."

After she finishes peeling the clay off her body, Doheny looks up and smiles, then bursts into an infectious laugh. "Really the biggest misconception about potters is that they're normal people!"

Doheny is referring to the 'clay treatment' she just underwent for the *Record's* photographer, an apt celebration of a new stage in her career: her first gallery show as a featured artist.

GARDINER MUSEUM

For three weeks starting Sept. 10, Doheny's work will be on display at the Gardiner Museum of Ceramic Art in Toronto. It is the culmination of years of dedication and determination.

She usually doesn't get this much into her art, but neither does it seem out of place. A 15-year pottery veteran, she is at one with her craft and thoroughly comfortable in it — li-

terally, even as it began to harden and crack!

At her family home on Moulton Hill in Lennoxville, the living room has long since been turned into a workshop filled with pots of all shapes and sizes, even the telephone has clay all over it. Doheny tells of a strange 'affliction' she has called 'potter's rot'.

"Scientists will say it's from inhaling the silica, which is the dust in the clay and glazes," she says, offering that as an excuse why "potters say and do strange things."

If there was ever a candidate for the fictional 'potter's rot', it's Doheny, who was first attracted to pottery when she took a course on it at Champlain College.

HOOKED ON POTS

"I was interested in archeology, so I took up pottery to understand more about it, and then I was hooked."

Over the years, she has forged her own style, quite different from conventional Japanese pots popular in the seventies. Doheny says their natural, brushwork designs are a product of a 2000-year-old tradition she can't — and won't — duplicate.

"What I know is my garden," she explains, "the birds that visit my birdfeeder every day. That's what I know, that's what affects me every day. That's what's in my pots."

For Doheny, they are all

'pots', be it mugs, plates, bowls or, once in a while, plant pots.

Doheny's signature pattern is the iris, with its light blue, yellow and green colours. She also works with yellow sunflower and cranberry blossom patterns.

"All my patterns are floral," she says, "I'm an earth child. It seems to be just what leaves my hands."

Doheny's pieces are different from other potters. Her china-like stoneware is pleasing to the eye and surprisingly delicate to the touch.

She uses a small, but effective, potter's wheel to form clay into pots, two electric kilns, or ovens, to cook them and a mixture of clay and cobalt, copper or ironoxide to create the colors she uses.

BACK TO THE EARTH

The pieces that break she returns to the ground in her flowerbed. "That way I'm giving something back to the earth."

Doheny says traditional potters don't like her work.

"My pots are crafty, they have flowers on them," are the usual complaints. "My pots are very, very thinly-thrown stoneware. Very fine. Pots have a bad reputation for being chunky. I paint it as if it's a watercolor."

Another criticism is that her work is functional, which is one of the reasons some don't consider it an art.

"It's not accepted as an art form. It's a craft. As a potter, I'm making functional ware. It's considered kitchenware." Certainly the pottery that surrounds her workroom is not just there to be stared at. The jugs, bowls, mugs and wine coolers are to be enjoyed through everyday use.

Fortunately for Doheny, they are enjoyed by many people in many places. She sells everything she makes and can hardly keep up with demand. Her work has been selling in the pottery gift shop at the Gardiner Museum, her largest wholesale customer, for over five years now.

SUCCESSFUL

"I'm well proven there," she boasts.

People can also buy her pottery in Lennoxville at Uplands Museum and Valerie Courshene Pharmacy or, in North Hatley at *Le Coeur d'Or* and The Piggery Theatre. She's also made oil lamps, funeral urns, pattens and chalices for the United Church.

Multi-talented, Doheny recently took over the restaurant at The Golden Lion in Lennoxville with a partner, and also works two nights a week as Maitre'd at Hovey Manor in North Hatley. But it's pottery that takes up most of her time and energy and she doesn't want to know why her work is so successful.

"I don't want to know what I'm doing right. If I try to figure it out, it will have changed and it won't be good anymore."

Doheny began making pots long before it began to pay off. The most important reason for doing it is because she loves it.

"It gives me absolute, complete joy, satisfaction, spiritual comfort. Everyday, I make something I think is beautiful. The whole world doesn't have to think so, but I do and that's important."

SPIRITUAL TOOL

She says she doesn't meditate, but uses pottery as a spiritual tool.

"It keeps me centered (and) I have to focus my energy... because it's moving and you have to keep it on center."

But she doesn't think about pots 24 hours a day. Another of her passions is opera, specifically Luciano Pavarotti.

"I saw him in Montreal and (until then) I never understood why people screamed at the Beatles. Then, when he came out on stage, I screamed."

Does she also scream for Patrick Swayze, who showed

people a few different moves that could do with pottery in the movie *Ghost*?

"I've been waiting for Patrick Swayze," she exclaims. "I've been a potter for fifteen years and he's never come. I've been waiting day and night."

Kidding aside, Doheny says the movie did change the way people look at pottery.

"Pottery has now become sexual. People now have seen pottery. It's almost created a new fashion."

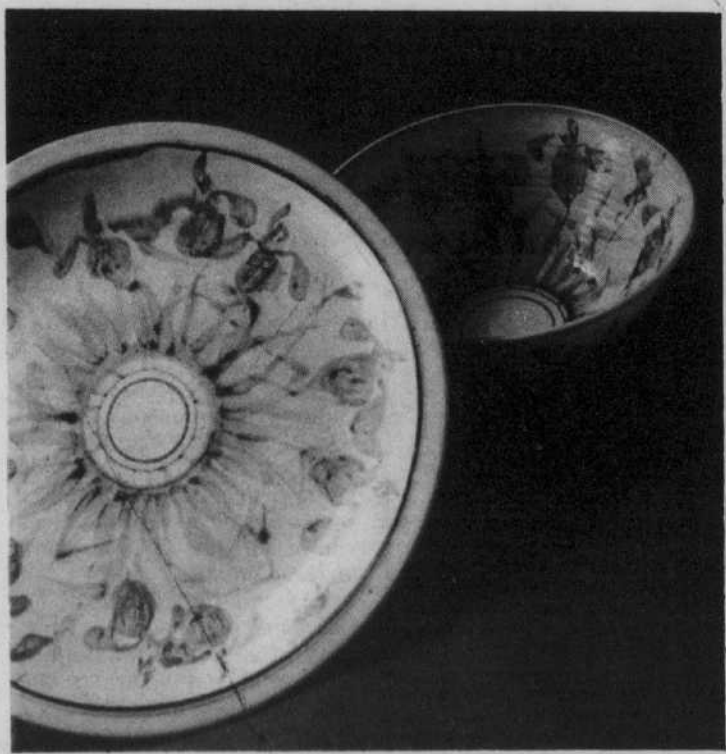
UNDERSTANDING

But lest anyone think pottery is easy, Doheny says it takes years to learn. "It's easy once you know how to do it. It doesn't take a lot of skill, it takes a lot of understanding."

The artist in Lucy Doheny was born long before the potter. With a keen eye for colour and design, she spent many a time painting in her early days, something she gave up when she discovered pots.

Doheny sums up why she loves them. "Maybe because you never know how they're going to turn out. It's a mystery. It's kind of dangerous. I've been doing it for 15 years and every time I open a kiln I never know what it's going to look like."

If it comes out of one of Lucy Doheny's kilns, one thing's for certain: it's going to be beautiful, yet functional, floral, a bit spiritual and, well, awfully good.

Tom Petty: Dread in the great wide open

NEW YORK (AP) — Tom Petty is not a rapper or a head-banger or a producer of new jack swing. He is a writer and singer of rock 'n' roll, a musician who's been performing rock for most of his life.

At 40, Petty's career is on the rise. He has had three hit albums — two with the Traveling Wilburys and the solo Full Moon Fever — in the last two years. His new release, *Into the Great Wide Open*, quickly climbed up the charts.

His success is worth noting because it's happened even with critics wondering if his style of music is on the way out and because the average rock 'n' roller doesn't stick around much longer than the average baseball player. (Few players are still in the game at 40 and far fewer than that are still productive.)

Petty is neither trying to keep up with new music nor struggling to recycle old hits. Like Bonnie Raitt, Neil Young

and a few other peers, he seems to be building on his craft rather than repeating himself. He also seems to be having more fun.

FEELS INSPIRED

"In the last couple of years, I've felt more inspired than I have in a long time," Petty said in a phone interview from Los Angeles.

"There were times when it seemed like all I could think about was the pressure to write a song, but it's more better for me now because I actually enjoy writing. I enjoy it immensely at the moment. I feel like I'm improving: It's a wonderful feeling."

Into the *Great Wide Open* is, of course, a guitar-powered, rock 'n' roll album, without strings or dance remixes. On *Out in the Cold* and the self-defining *Makin' Some Noise*, Petty simply rears back and sings as hard and fast as he can, straining to be heard while his longtime band, the Heartbreakers, bashes away behind

him.

"I really think rock 'n' roll at its best is one of the great thrills," he said. "I want rock 'n' roll to still be represented. I don't pay much attention to other forms of music."

Petty grew up in Gainesville, Fla., and his story could have been lifted from a Chuck Berry record: a working-class kid who left school to play in a rock 'n' roll band.

FAMOUS SONGS

By 1970, he was already with two future Heartbreakers — guitarist Mike Campbell and keyboard player Benmont Tench — and soon was writing *Refugee*, *Don't Do Me Like*

That and the other songs that would make him famous.

With his shaggy, blond hair and his love for the Beatles, the Byrds and Elvis Presley, Petty's become one of rock's most recognizable and dependable performers.

He's changed, but in subtle ways. His singing has relaxed over the years: it's more his own style. His voice is deeper — age and cigarettes helped with that — and his approach is less mannered, without the twisting and slurring of words that marked early albums such as *You're Going to Get It* and *Damn the Torpedoes*.

The lyrics have also grown

up. *Learning to Fly*, *Built to Last*, and *Makin' Some Noise* are about endurance, surviving the past and confronting the future. And when he writes about "girls," on *Zombie Zoo* (from *Full Moon Fever*) or *All the Wrong Reasons*, he's often making observations about the next generation rather than thinking about a date on Saturday night.

SENSE OF DREAD

"If these kids wanted to play rock 'n' roll for a living they'd be faced with a much bigger corporate nightmare to endure than I had," said Petty. "The way the industry is treating artists, it's more like entering law school."

Petty doesn't mean to sound so sour. Rock 'n' roll promised him a better life and delivered more than he could have expected. He's a wealthy man and has survived professional conflicts (with his record company, MCA) and personal tragedy (the death of Roy Orbison, a fire that burned down his house four years ago).

But at the heart of his music is a feeling of dread, a sense that happiness is, at best, temporary.

"I don't know if I ever feel good about anything," he laughed. "I'm too neurotic about that. I tend to find something wrong about everything. I think we're all in the great wide open. I really want to like the world, but I also have to address what I see in it. Life is wild, you know?"

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (AP) — An English tourist who scrimped and saved for two years to visit Elvis Presley's grave was among fans who paid respects Friday on the 14th anniversary of the singer's death.

"In England, they all say we're (foolish), you know," said Valerie Anderson of Chickenley, England. "A few that I work with say, 'Why are you going to spend all that money just to see a grave?' But unless you're an Elvis fan, you don't understand."

Memphis police said about 12,000 people turned out Thursday night for a candlelight procession past the grave. The procession is the biggest draw in a lineup of concerts and fan club gatherings called *Elvis International Tribute Week*.

Projectors roll at Montreal world film fest

MONTREAL — The 15th Montreal World Film Festival is in full swing today with the first full day of movies.

The inaugural film, *Rambling Rose* (USA), starring Laura Dern, Robert Duvall and Diane Ladd, was scheduled to be screened last night before an audience of celebrities and moviegoers at Place des Arts' Theatre Maisonneuve.

The 12-day festival boasts over 300 films from 50 countries.

Twenty-two feature films and eleven shorts are competing this year for the festival's top honors, chosen by an international seven-member jury, including Quebec director Jean-Claude Labrecque.

Los Angeles Times arts editor Charles Champlin, German filmmaker Helma Sanders-Brahms and European actress Giuliana De Sio also sit on the jury.

LAVOIE AND LANG

Two popular Canadian singers leave their mark on film this year. Quebec singer Daniel Lavoie stars as a comic strip artist who bases his science fiction characters on himself and his family in *Le Fabuleux Voyage De L'Ange* (*The Fabulous Voyage of the Angel*). The film, by Montreal director Jean-Pierre Lefebvre, is presented in the Official Selection/

Hors Concours category.

Country singer k.d. lang stars in *Salmonberries*, about a young woman in search of love from German filmmaker Percy Adlon (*Bagdad Cafe*). That's presented in official competition.

Syrian-born Bashar Shbib, who emigrated to Canada at a very young age and later studied film production at Montreal's Concordia University, has two films at the festival this year. *Love \$ Greed* and *Lana In Love*. Now a resident of Los Angeles, his 1990 film, *Julia Has Two Lovers*, is currently playing on Montreal cinema screens.

CONCORDIA GRAD

Other festival films of note include *Pablo Qui Court* (*On The Run*), the debut feature film by another Concordia University graduate, Bernard Bergeron, who studied theatre there.

Volere Volare (*I Want To Fly*) is an Italian comedy about a soundman in search of noises for old cartoons who finds himself beginning to turn into one just when he falls in love. Maurizio Nichetti directed, co-wrote and stars in the film.

Shakha-Proshaka (*Branches of the Tree*) is the latest offering from prolific Indian filmmaker Satyajit Ray. It's about a father and his four sons.

British actor Anthony Hopkins stars in a social comedy about a consultant who's hired to boost a factory's profits. *Spotswood* is directed by Mark Joffe. Hopkins will be attending the festival. He is one of 12 recipients of a special tribute at the festival. His hit film, *Silence of the Lambs*, will also be shown.

ARCAND AND JEWISON

Other tributes are paid to Quebec filmmaker Denys Arcand (*Jesus of Montreal*), Canadian director Norman Jewison (*Agnes of God*), Italian director Marco Ferreri, actor Sidney Potier, American filmmaker Oliver Stone (*Born on the 4th of July*) and Italian actor Marcello Mastroianni. Films by all of these artists are scheduled to be screened this year.

There is also a special homage paid to animation at the National Film Board of Canada and to the Canadian Film Centre, the latter of which was founded by Jewison.

Some of the other special categories at the festival this year are Scandinavian Cinema of Today, Latin American Cinema, Panorama Canada, Cinema of Today and Tomorrow, TV Films and a section spotlighting films of the Cannes Critics Week in France.

Once again, cable subscri-

bers can watch film clips, interviews with the stars and obtain festival information on both of Montreal's cable services. Videotron subscribers can tune in to cable 30 and for those who have CF cable, channel 39 will air the same programming. These cable services are provided 24 hours a day during the course of the festival.

Movies at the festival are screened at the Parisien, Imperial and Complexe Desjardins

cinemas, as well as at Place des Arts, all within five minutes walking distance from each other. Festival schedules are free, but one can purchase a glossy program at the Parisien explaining all the films.

Tickets cost \$6.50 per film, and film buffs can buy a book of ten tickets for \$45, or a 9-to-5 pass for \$160, which is good for all films that begin between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. inclusively. Taxes are included in the ticket prices.

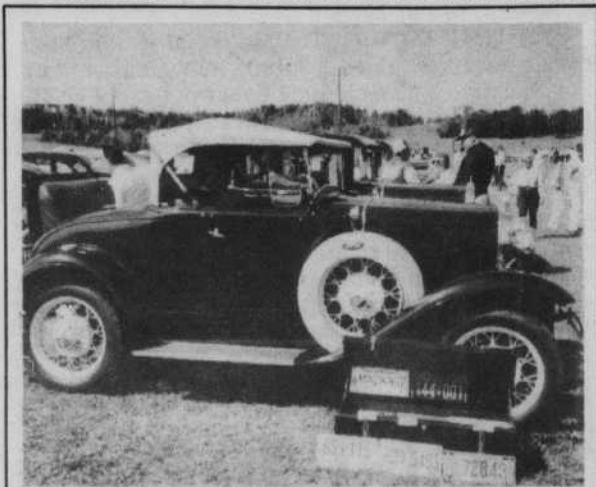

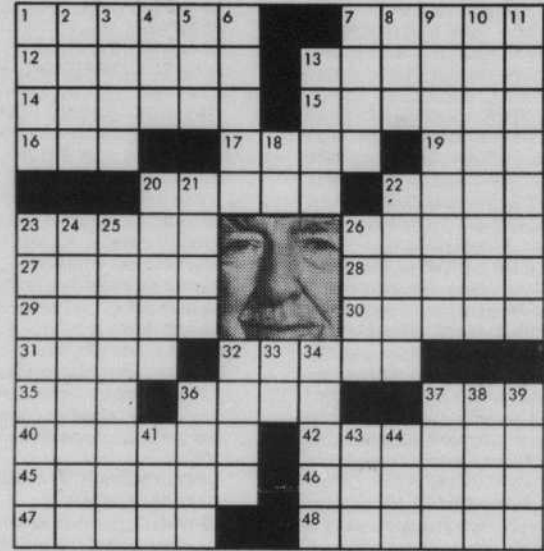

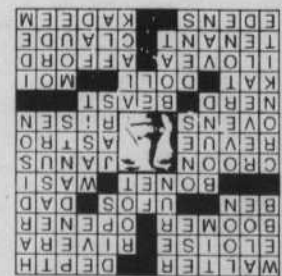
