

tue of the authority of the third Section of an Act of the Provincial Parliament, passed in the sixteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and chaptered eighty-five, it is ordered that goods *bona fide* exported to this Province from any country, but passing *in transitu* through another country and under Bonds, shall be, until it shall be otherwise ordered, valued for duty, as if such goods were imported directly from such first mentioned country into this Province.

Discount for Cash in Invoices.—By Circular of 29th of April, 1853, Importers of Goods in every case are allowed to deduct the discount actually allowed for cash, or that according to the custom of Trade which is allowed for cash.

Foreign Export duty.—By Circular of 20th May, 1853, it is directed that in all cases in which an Export duty is charged on the face of the Invoice, the same shall be deducted from the amount upon which the duty is to be levied.

Importation of Fish and Oil via United States.—In virtue of the authority of the Nineteenth Section of an Act of the Provincial Parliament, passed in the eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and chaptered four, His Excellency, the Administrator of the Government in Council, has been pleased to order that Fish and Oil, being *bona fide* the growth, produce, or manufacture of any of the British North American Provinces, may be imported into this province *via* the United States, between the First day of November and the First day of May in each year, and be exempt from the payment of Duties of Customs, upon being accompanied by proper Certificates of growth produce or manufacture, as required by law to entitle them to exemption.
