## PREFACE

---

The preparation of Directories, perhaps as vividly as anything else, impresses the compiler with a sense of the progress of the country in all that constitutes material prosperity. Villages bearing names yet unfamiliar are found to have taken root where not many years ago the stillness of the forest was only invaded by the stroke of the woodman's axe, and what were formerly thin settlements are seen to be advancing, under the impetus of an active and persevering population, to the rank of important towns.

Looking back over the seventy-five (75) years during which this firm has been engaged in the publication of Directories, the Publishers find ample evidence of an expansion in which the people of this country may well take pride and satisfaction. ## PREFACE

---
