## Parizeau the antithesis of a wild-eyed revolutionary

Some ungenerous things have been said of late about M. Jacques Parizeau, which is a shame because our premier is arguably the best friend Canada has in all North America.

Never was that more apparent than in his recent speech launching the official Oui campaign of the Referendum.

Oh, he said all the right words; "We are a people! We have always been a people! English Canada refused to

recognize us as a people!" But they were delivered with such gentlemanly British reserve that he managed to sound like a London clubman complaining of the quality of its port. His chubby little fingers appeared to finger a watch chain over his ample paunch and he was all tucked up inside that three-piece banker's pinstripe that he looked the very antithesis of a revolutionary leader. Was ever a nation transformed by a chubby man in a three-piece

suit?

I couldn't help comparing Monsieur Parizeau with that other wild-eyed revolutionary of my day, Fidel Castro. Long ago, when we were very young and woefully ignorant, stories wafted out of the Caribbean of an attractive young lawyer, his kid brother Raul and an astonishing intellectual called Che Guevera. They and a handful of bearded followers, supported by a grateful peasantry, conducted raids out of the Sierra Maestra Mountains to overthrow a brutal dictator propped up by Meyer Lanski's Mafia and American robber barons. Fidel needed help and

recruiters were active in the parts of New York City where I lived and worked. I was of military age, my friends were veterans of the recent Korean conflict and we decided to join Fidel, grow beards, live in the mountains, battle oppression and be adored by dark-eyed peasant women.

Before we could sign up, however, Battista's forces captured two young Americans already with Castro, and summarily shot them. Harsh criticism, I thought, for playing Robin Hood, and the next time Castro supporters made the rounds, I threw them some small change and let it go at

that.

By the time we reached Cuba (almost accidentally, we'd aimed for New Orleans), the fighting was over and the old part of Havana was crowded with bearded 'Fidelistas' carrying rifles and bandarillas while being feted by the populace. Juke boxes everywhere blared 'Viva Fidel! Viva Fidel! Saviour of our Country!'

In one of the main squares, bleachers were being set up for one of Castro's seven-hour speeches. I was happy to see my money had been put to good use.

But we didn't stay for the speech.

Echo Art does it again with community musical

## Trip through 60s is toe-tapping treat

KNOWLTON — *The 60s* — A Musical Retrospective begins with a bang and maintains its high energy throughout.

Featuring an amateur cast of 36 and a four-member professional band, the Echo Art production currently running at Theatre Lac Brome in Knowlton is a toe-tapping trip down memory lane that will also appeal to the younger set.

The infectious "Dancing In The Streets" introduces the cast as they bounce and strut across the stage keeping time with the music.

If at times the chorus look somewhat self-conscious during these opening moments, Ralph Steiner and Shiela McManus, exhibiting complete confidence in their singing, puts them at ease and brings their focus back.

Steiner, now an old pro at Echo Art's community musicals having appeared in the hits *Joseph & The Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat* and *Oh, What A Circus!*, is once again superlative throughout this production. Whether he's playing Sonny Bono or one of the Papas in the entertaining Ed Sullivan section of the musical, dancing in the streets or hanging out at a coffee house, he's a natural performer who remains in character throughout.

Remaining in character is always one of the problems of amateur shows, and musicals in particular, in which the cast is usually preoccupied with the choreography.

### FUN TO WATCH

In *The 60s*, the multi-generational cast does have quite a bit of business to accomplish, including some complicated choreography, and at times they look as if they're concentrating too much instead of having fun. This is particularly true during the towel dance sequence at the beach. If Lorna Wayne's choreography is at times challenging for the cast, it is always fun to watch. The energy of the cast remains high and they're clearly committed to doing it right.

Bob Hennessy looked rather comfy with all the pretty women surrounding him, and just a little less so as Ed Sullivan, but only because there

didn't seem to be a script he could follow. Hennessy did prove quite adept at improvising and delivers an endearing, campy performance as Sullivan. And the expressions he makes in character on the side of the stage while the performers are doing their numbers are priceless.

The Sullivan segment might be the most entertaining part of the show, and certainly the most enjoyable, as each act is replicated and presented with bounding energy.

Kate Wisdom's no-nonsense attitude as Nancy Sinatra helps make her rendition of "These Boots Are Made For Walking" a treat. "SINGING NUN"

Shirley Smith and Cathy Ratcliffe, as the "Singing Nun" and her guitarist, give a strong performance of "Dominique", an almost forgotten blast from the past that was an international hit and stayed at No. 1 spot in the United States for four weeks.

Winston MacElvie's expressions as the Magician on the Sullivan show makes his appearance a delight, although if one looks carefully, it's easy to see the secret of his trade.

The Beatles number — "She Loves You" — captures the excitement of their heyday as it recreates their historic appearance on Sullivan's show — complete with screaming female fans who rush the stage.

Although it is up to the performers to get into their roles, Cathy Ratcliffe's fabulous costumes makes their jobs 50 per cent easier. These multi-colored extravaganzas go a long way in making the right visual impact for the audience, particularly during the Ed Sullivan sequence where each performer is dressed for success.

### OFF TO VIETNAM

Eugene Brotto is expressive and energetic as the boy whose story the musical weaves around, following him through dating and marriage and seeing him off to Vietnam.

Also good to see is the blossoming of Amos Joannides after his promising appearance in Echo Art's *Joseph & The Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat* last year. He's turning into qui-

te a nice little performer.

Both Joannides' and Brotto's talents come together well in the tongue-in-cheek anti-war number "Fixing To Die Rag", which opens the second act's Images of Vietnam sequence.

As the girl who marries Brotto before he goes off to war, Caitlin Joyce fit the part perfectly. Darlene Bell also makes an arresting Grace Slick in her "White Rabbit" number.

The emotional climax of the show comes through back-to-back renditions of "Nights In White Satin" and "Eve Of Destruction". If one doesn't get you, the other one will.

### DRAMATIC STAGING

First, director Emma Stevens uses dramatic staging and choreography to its most effective as a pregnant Caitlin (well above the stage) pines for her now-deceased soldier husband as he sings "Nights In White Satin" from beyond the grave. Brotto gives an appropriately haunting rendition of the love song, although he and Joyce were not always in synch during their dance.

Then there's Hennessy's

capable rendition of "Eve Of Destruction", set against a backdrop of four sets of parents seeing their sons off to war. If this one doesn't get you, you don't have a heart.

Rick Ricciardi has been holding out on us. The musical director-guitarist-keyboardist of the band Echo Art uses for its musicals delivers a surprisingly tender rendition of "Homeward Bound". Vocally, this is one of the strongest points in the show.

On the other hand, the *Laugh-In* segment looked better on paper than it does on stage, but with its corny jokes that incite groan after groan from the crowd and the troupe's over-the-top delivery, it remains fun. Playing Dan Rowan and Dick Martin with straight-faced hilarity are Ricciardi and Jean-Charles Rivard.

Back with Ricciardi are a trio of very capable musicians who never let the cast — or the audience — down with their fine rhythms. They are bassist George Dmytruk, keyboardist Sacha Dmytruk and guitarist

Glenn Bertie.

But not all the talent in *The 60s* is up there for everyone to see. Manning the lighting board — and ably handling some 17 cues — is 11-year-old Laurence Coderre, whose mom is "Singing Nun" Shirley Smith.

By getting a diverse group of talented people from the area involved such as Coderre, who has muscular dystrophy, Emma Stevens and Echo Art give a deeper meaning to the term community production.

This company deserves to be supported in its efforts to bring a little culture and a lot of fun to the Townships.

"I never tried to sound like George Jones but people say I do," he added.

Sorry Jones, we don't have a Tammy Wynette for you. Instead, our female country legends are Connie Smith and Kitty Wells. Gale McNab will be the one pouring her soul on stage to honor those two great

McNab is a genuine country girl — she loves animals, wilderness and good country music. She started singing very young and today she's a good songwriter who also writes wonderful poems.

"Country music is true and touching, it deals with real life," said McNab before talking about her dream. "Six years ago I went to Nashville and I met Kitty Wells, who's been my all time idol. I was so nervous to finally see her that my whole body was trembling as I shook her hand, then I was ready to come back home, my dream had come true."

"I was 18, when I saw Dick Curless for the first time," said Buck Sayer, the deep-voiced singer who will salute the talent of his favorite country legend this Sunday.

"I was really impressed with his ability to reach a high note and then go to a much deeper note without effort, but something else made me like Dick Curless and it was his personal attitude towards the local musicians, treating us as if we would have been Nashville musicians."

Curless passed away May 26 this year.

### CANADIAN LEGEND

We couldn't have a country legend tribute without adding one of our own Canadian country singer who did so much for

his peers, Hank Snow.

"I used to listen to the radio and I just loved country music so I thought this is what I wanted to do," said Tony Chivinski, who always admired Snow. "Hank Snow and Hank Williams were my only influences, since nobody in my family ever played music, and I learnt on my own."

Steve Powers started out as a rock 'n' roll musician but it wasn't for long before a Ray Price show at The White House Pavillion would turn him around.

"I don't know how my mother convinced me to go but it changed my orientation. I've loved country music ever since," said this great guitar picker.

### TRIBUTE TO HANK

Steve will pay a tribute to the genius of Hank Williams who's considered as the legend of all time and one of the fathers of country music.

"He wrote great songs and inspired so many musicians but he was never appreciated until he died," said Powers. "I'll sing Hank's songs but there's no way one can impersonate

him. You do your best but you can't do it."

Another pair of shoes we're gonna fill is Merle Haggard's and Steve Aulis, who started playing guitar and singing at an age when he didn't have any business being in bars, will perform a few Haggard numbers.

"To me Haggard is the King of country music and I love the way everything he does comes from the heart," said Steve, who's heart has always belonged to country music and me.

"Steve is well-respected for his true strong and powerful country voice here in the Townships," said Raymond St-Laurent.

St-Laurent will be giving a tribute to the late Conway Twitty. St-Laurent, well-known as a piano player, travelled on the road touring Canada and recorded in Nashville with the duo Jerry & JoAnne.

Besides looking a bit like Twitty, Ray has admiration for Twitty's work.

"The artist was very versatile and that's what we'll be doing this Sunday as 'It's Only Make Believe'," he said.

Also performing on stage in that all star cast will be Al Bailey, Yvan Moreault, Daniel Belanger and we are leaving room for a couple special guests.

"This country legends show is a lot more than a tribute to Nashville stars. It's a good cause permitting to salute our own local country legends," said St-Laurent.

This is the perfect opportunity for country fans to go down memory lane and it will give a chance to new fans to hear what has been the influence and the roots of the new country stars.

A big thank you to all our local country singers and musicians who are so generously donating their time for the good cause. They are in their own right local country legends.

## What I Did Last Summer

# Play examines conflict between materialism and idealism

LENNOXVILLE — It's 1945 on the Canadian shore of Lake Erie. Wealthy Americans have come to a vacation hotspot to play for the summer and a rebellious young boy is about to learn the lesson of his life.

A.R. Gurney's play *What I Did Last Summer*, which is being presented by Bishop's University drama students next week, tackles American materialism, Canadian idealism and a teen's dream as it illustrates the rich lives of ordinary people.

"It takes place in a summer town populated not unlike North Hatley by Americans," said director Greg Tuck, recently re-appointed artistic director of The Piggery Theatre. "It's the story of a 14-year-old boy's coming of age as the war ends. In the course of the play is his attempt to get his first job to impress his first girlfriend, and he gets a job working for an iconoclastic Bohemian woman who teaches art."

Charlie, the young lad, is influenced by this Bohemian art teacher named Anna Trumbull, who taught his mother years earlier.

### CLASH

Tuck said what results is a clash between these two strong-willed women that has something to say of the inherent conflict between the idealism of the American nature, represented by Anna, and the materialism of the American nature, which can be found in Charlie's mother.

"In that mix, the boy is born into an artist," Tuck added. "O-

ne thing I love about the writer is Gurney's a kind of documentarian of the old kind of WASP culture."

He said it's a fine play to do with students. The youth today have more in common with the characters in the play than with young people of the pre-

war period.

"In an odd way, we're still in the same period," said Tuck. "The first job, the first date, the first breakup of the friendship, the buzz words of the day" are all things they have in common.

### DISCOVERING POTENTIAL

The process of a youth discovering his artistic potential also resonates with students.

"I'm teaching students who also have the same hopes and dreams (as the kids in the

play). The choices are real when you're young, and the reasons for making them and the bravery involved are the same."

Audiences have something to learn from Anna Trumbull.

"She tries him at everything, sculpting, painting, he's no good at anything. She says look at the poetry of William Butler Yeats or look at the stars, maybe you're an astronomer, make a choice. The choices you make are who you are."

Through Anna, the play says a great deal about the importance of caring teachers.

"What I've learned from the play is the appreciation of teachers and the positive affect that a person you respect and look up to can have in your life. That's exactly what Anna does, she gives him the chance to find his own potential, which he does at the end of the play which is writing the play," said Alicia Helde, who plays Anna. "This play is like a thank you to his teacher. Gurney might have had a teacher like Anna Trumbull."

David Moase, who plays Charlie, recalled memories of his childhood to help create the 14-year-old character.

"The way my parents nagged me and fighting with my brother a lot" are some of his fond recollections.

After working with young people this summer, Mike Laidlaw, who portrays Charlie's best friend, said they've changed drastically.

"The 14 and the 16-year-olds are completely different. They're a lot more mature for their age. Back then, the thing to do was go on the roller coaster and now the big thing is to get a pack of beer and hang out. They seem to be in a lot more of a rush to get older," said Laidlaw, who taught at the Upper Canada College Tennis Camp.

Shannon Arnold, who plays Bonnie, Charlie's first girlfriend, concurred.

"There really is a difference between what it was like to be 14 now and what it like to be 14 in 1945. I find that maybe something about Bonnie is immature, but other things about her are going to be more mature because of the war. When I was 14, I was trying to be mature, I was 14 going on 40 and you find a few years later that was not necessary, there's no hurry to grow up."

Arnold said there was only one thing troubling her when she was 14.

"The only thing I can remember is AIDS, but that was a controllable fear. In 1945, the war is an uncontrollable fear."

Tuck said Gurney is one of his favorite playwrights. During his first term at the Piggery in the late 80s, Tuck directed Gurney's *The Dining Room* there. *What I Did Last Summer* has also been mounted at the barn theatre.

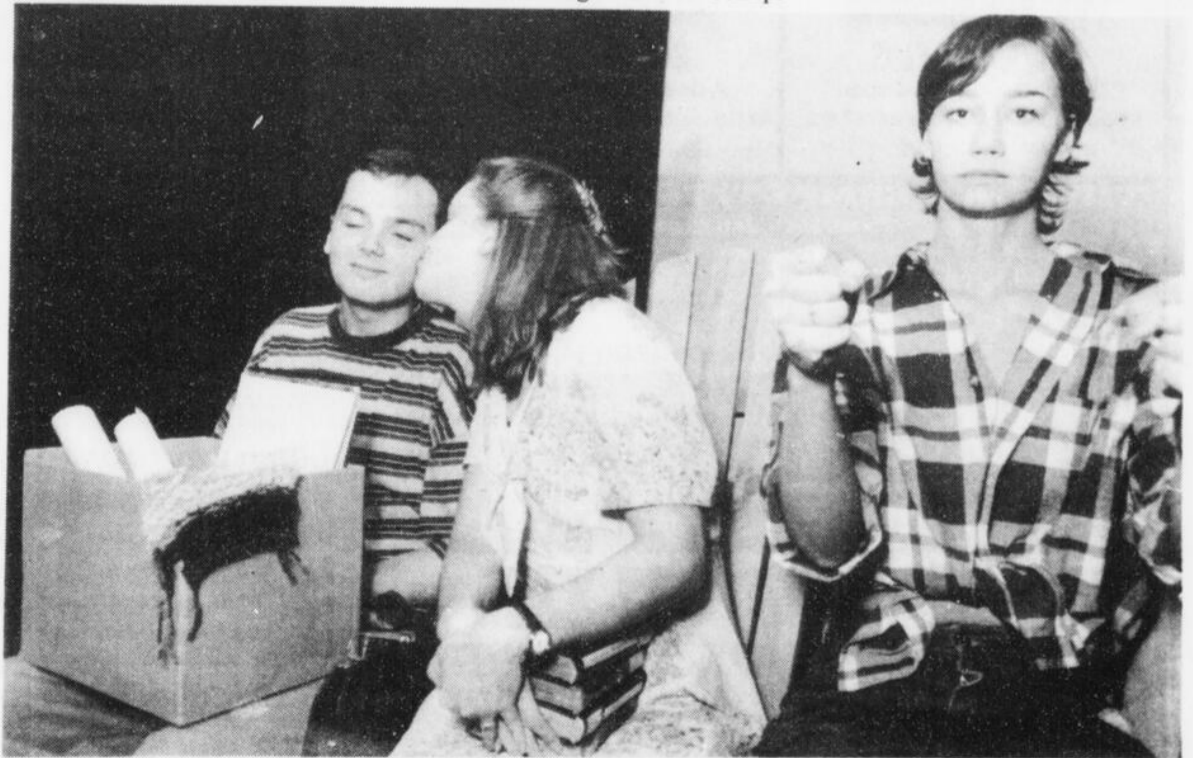
"Everything he writes depends on particular theatricality. I've only see one done on film, *The Dining Room* and it was terrible," he said. "In *The Dining Room*, six actors play 50 parts. *Sylvia*, his current off-Broadway hit, is about a man who brings a dog home and it affects his relationship. and the dog is played by an actor who speaks, it won't work on film. So these work because it's theatre."

"I like to pick work that can be done at its best by actors on stage, and that were written for the stage."

# Nationwide search begins for best printmaker

TORONTO — Townships artists take note — the search for Canada's best printmakers in 1996 is underway.

The contest, sponsored by Ernst & Young in association with *Canadian Art* magazine, is accepting nominations to find Canada's top three printmakers.

The winners will be profiled in the summer issue of *Canadian Art* and will be eligible for prizes of \$5,000, \$3,000 and \$1,000.

Submissions require up to

five slides of the printmaker's work, a description of each work and a brief biography of the printmaker.

The work will be reviewed by a jury of five prominent representatives from the art community. The final deadline for submissions is March 29, 1996.

Ernst & Young has a varied art collection that contains many prints and other original works.

"Sponsoring the competition is an extension of a history of

involvement with the arts. We are proud to support the artistic community and appreciate the lasting value art adds to an ever changing world," said Kerri MacPherson, Partner of Sales and National Marketing of the accounting firm.

Last year's top winner was Penetanguishene artist John Hartman. He won first prize for his copper plate drypoint of a bayfront scene entitled *Manitou Dock*.

"I was surprised and delighted to have won. The

publicity since the announcement has generated a strong response to my work," Hartman said.

*Canadian Art*, now in its 11th year, was voted "Magazine of the Year" at the 1995 National Magazine Awards. Its circulation has risen to 18,000, making it the largest circulation art magazine in Canada's history.

"We're delighted that Ernst & Young is renewing their commitment to this project.

With each year, this contest will become an increasingly prominent feature of the artistic landscape," said editor Sarah Milroy.

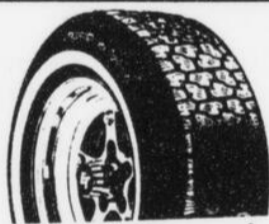

## Robert MacNeil bows out of news program

NEW YORK (AP-CP) — When Friday's edition of *The MacNeil-Lehrer NewsHour* leaves the air, so will its executive editor and co-anchor Robert MacNeil.

Say it ain't so, Robin. "Twenty years is enough," MacNeil said with amiable finality. "You have to know, in the rhythm of your own life, when it's appropriate to quit something."

A relaxed, genial man off-camera, MacNeil's persona belies the wintry Canadian who launched the half-hour *Robert MacNeil Report* from New York City on PBS in 1975, with Jim Lehrer as his Washington, D.C., correspondent.

Since then, *The MacNeil-Lehrer NewsHour* has become an award-winning program respected for its high journalistic standards and Lehrer has become (in no particular order), his co-anchor, associate editor and best friend.

"We've had an agreement for years that if either one of us wanted out, the other would

understand," MacNeil said. In August 1994, the partners and their wives met to discuss his decision to retire.

"One of the first things I said to him is, 'I really want to do this next year — and you can, too,'" MacNeil said. "But he wants to stay. . . . That program is in his blood, there in Washington, in a way it hasn't been in mine for a little while."

Already the author of several books, MacNeil wants to devote more time to writing.

But he'll miss his day-to-day partnership with Lehrer, who'll go it alone beginning Monday with *The NewsHour with Jim Lehrer*.

"Professionally and personally, it's not going to be easy on me," said Lehrer, who accepts and reluctantly endorses his friend's decision.

This isn't the first time MacNeil has wanted to call it quits. In January 1991, on the brink of the Gulf War, he said, "I was desperately trying to get my first novel out before I became 60 years old."

His *MacNeil-Lehrer* colleagues scotched his idea of leaving. "They all landed on me, starting with Jim," he recalls, "in the most unprintable terms."

The war came and went and he finished the novel, *Burden of Desire*, by getting up earlier in the morning.

The book is set in Halifax, where the Montreal-born MacNeil grew up, and focuses on the First World War explosion that destroyed huge sections of the city and its harbor.

His steamy second novel, *The Voyage*, is about a Canadian diplomat based in New

York who's drawn into the mysterious disappearance of a woman on whose yacht are found letters addressed to him.

In addition to his fiction, MacNeil wants to work on TV series about Shakespeare and on the American language, much like his 1986 Peabody and Emmy award-winning project, *The Story of English*.

"I am most proud of that, and I had so much fun doing it, people who watched it said, 'My God! He's smiling! He never smiles on television!'"

MacNeil expects to live mostly in New York but spend more time at his vacation home near Shelburne, N.S. That's

where he began writing *The Voyage*, three years ago.

He also expects *NewsHour with Jim Lehrer* to continue coverage of significant Canadian events. At Lehrer's suggestion, a correspondent has been assigned for the first time to concentrate on Canada and Mexico. He's currently working on a documentary about Quebec's Oct. 30 sovereignty referendum.

"Jim and I joke about Canada a lot but I think the commitment is there," he said.

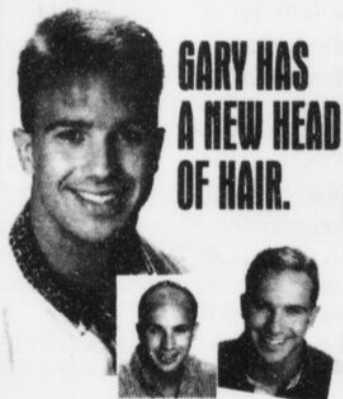

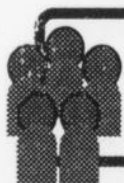

## Homicide, Prime Suspect: Great police dramas return

NEW YORK (AP) — Great police drama, like real estate, has its three essentials:

Character, character, character.

Nowhere is that more evident than in television's best: NBC's *Homicide: Life on the Street*, which returns for a fourth season Friday, and *Prime Suspect*, the British drama which resurfaces with a two-hour episode Sunday.

Don't miss the opening of Friday's *Homicide*. Although actors Ned Beatty and Daniel Baldwin have quit the series, their characters have not. Their absence is explained, and it's funny.

That attention to detail has made the series a critic's darling. From its first episode, *Homicide* has had the look and feel of the real thing, evoking the squad room so vividly you can practically smell the wastebaskets.

The season premiere is "City of Flames", a two-parter in which a warehouse arson turns up a body. It also introduces cast member Reed Diamond as Arson Squad Det. Mike Kellerman, a likable young hotshot.

His friction with the prickly supercop Frank Pembleton (Andre Braugher) is immediate and gratifying, as is the diligence of sweet, sad-eyed Det. Kay Howard (Melissa Leo), who is determined to pass the sergeant's exam.

Other welcome returnees are Kyle Secor as Bayliss,

Clark Johnson as Lewis, Richard Belzer as Munch, Isabella Hoffman as (newly promoted) Capt. Megan Russert and Yaphet Kotto as Lieut. Giardella (with a great new haircut).

On Sunday night, Helen Mirren returns to PBS as London police investigator Jane Tennison, the role she created in 1990 for the first of the Emmy Award-winning *Prime Suspect* miniseries.

From the first, Tennison has suffered the curse of her ambition. Fighting the Old Boy network every inch of the way, sacrificing her personal life, she has attained major rank, as a detective superintendent.

*Prime Suspect: The Lost Child* is a complete, two-hour drama, rather than a multi-part miniseries like its three predecessors. Two more follow in February and April.

In the harrowing *Lost Child*, Tennison has only just undergone an abortion and its emotional consequences when she must lead the investigation of a 14-month-old child's abduction.

Tennison's original gang of detectives are back with her on this case, including Jack Ellis as big, burly Det. Insp. Tony Muddyman. His performance is one of several standouts, along with Stuart Wilson (*Death and the Maiden*) and Beatie Edney as the distraught mother.

There's no sign of the missing child, but a prime suspect

(Robert Glenister) quickly surfaces. He's a convicted pedophile. He has a girlfriend — with two young daughters.

"You'll put up with anything

to be near someone you love," he says in an unguarded moment. It's a performance that will chill you to the bone.

*Homicide: Life on the Street* airs Friday at 10 p.m. on NBC and CFCF-12. *Prime Suspect: The Lost Child* airs Sunday at 9 p.m. on Vermont ETV.
