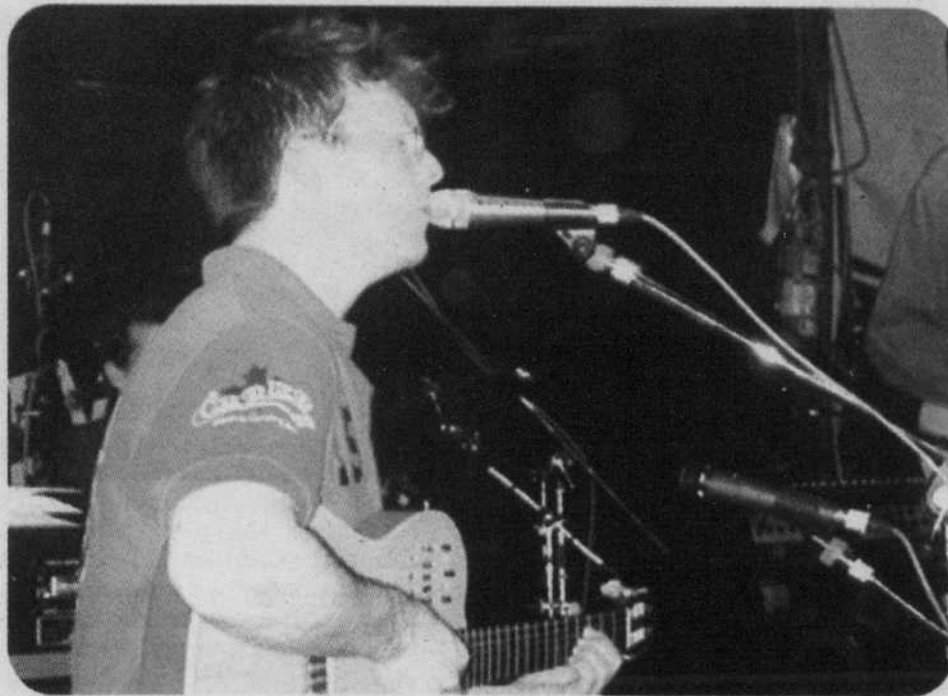

Clafouti creations celebrate season

There's no time like the end of summer, with its explosion of juicy tree-fruit, to venture into the world of clafoutis.

Clafouti is a French country-style dessert made with fresh fruit smothered with a batter that when baked, can be either cake-like or custard-like in texture.

Although traditionally made with tart cherries, we veered from the classic batter covered cherry dish and created two slightly different takes on clafouti: In one, we used other summer fruits and in the other, we made a savoury clafouti (similar to crustless quiche) with roasted cherry or strawberry tomatoes.

For the sweet version, choose peaches or prune plums to make your clafouti — both are suitable to make this quick puffy pancake-like dessert. For a savoury version, combine roasted small strawberry tomatoes and salty bits of flavourful prosciutto.

Both sweet and savoury clafoutis are light yet satisfying, and can make a wonderful contribution to elaborate brunches, simple luncheons or end-of-the-week casual dinners.

After being removed from the oven, clafouti will immediately begin to morph, transforming from a light and airy, slightly puffy pancake to a more uniform, deflated custard-like crustless quiche. So, if looks are important to you, make sure to serve the clafouti immediately, allowing everyone to see the dish as soon as it comes out of the oven. Bon appetit!

Roasted strawberry tomatoes and flavour-intense prosciutto marry well in this custard-like savoury clafouti. Accompany with toasted seed bread and a salad of meslun greens dressed with a delicate vinaigrette.

ROASTED STRAWBERRY TOMATO CLAFOUTI

Serves six
2 cups (500 mL) cherry or strawberry tomatoes, halved lengthwise (about 9 ounces/256 g total)
1 tablespoon (15 mL) extra-virgin olive oil
Salt and pepper
1 teaspoon (5 mL) extra-virgin olive oil
2 ounces (50 g) thinly sliced prosciutto, chopped
1 1/2 cups (375 mL) cream (10 per cent M.F.)
4 large eggs
2 tablespoons (30 mL) chopped fresh

Italian (flat-leaf) parsley
1/2 cup (125 mL) finely grated old white cheddar cheese

1 tablespoon (15 mL) finely grated parmesan cheese

In medium bowl, toss tomato halves with 1 tablespoon (15 mL) oil. Place, cut side up, in single layer, in baking dish. Sprinkle with 1/4 teaspoon (1 mL) salt. Bake at 400 F (200 C) for 30 minutes, then turn tomatoes so they are cut side down. Bake for five minutes.

In small heavy frypan, heat 1 teaspoon (5 mL) oil over medium heat. Add prosciutto; saute for two to three minutes or until almost crisp, stirring constantly. Transfer prosciutto to small bowl; set aside.

Arrange roasted tomatoes, cut side up, in single layer, over bottom of greased 9 1/2-inch (24-cm) pie plate (volume of pie plate should be about 6 cups/1.5 L).

In blender, combine cream, eggs, 1/8 teaspoon (0.5 mL) salt and 1/4 teaspoon (1 mL) pepper; process until well blended. Add parsley; pulse to mix. Immediately pour over tomatoes in pie plate. Sprinkle with prosciutto. Sprinkle with cheddar and parmesan cheeses.

Bake at 375 F (180 C) for 25 to 30 minutes or until top is puffed and golden and edges are lightly browned. Cut in wedges and serve immediately.

Approximate nutritional analysis for each serving: 228 cal, 12 g pro, 17 g fat, 8 g carb. Excellent source of vitamin B12.

Tip: Grape tomatoes could be substituted for the strawberry or cherry tomatoes, but they're a little fussier to work with because of their small size.

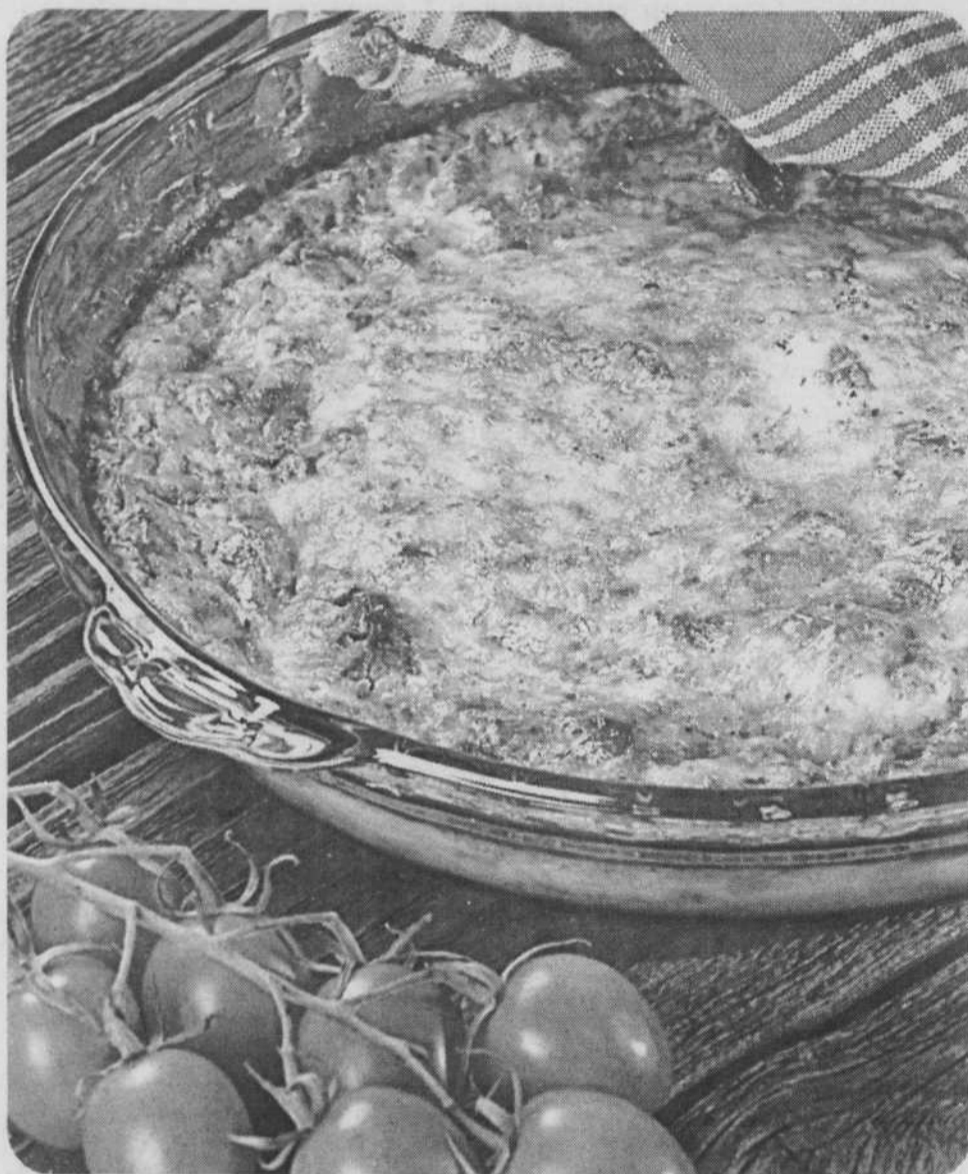

This country-fresh dessert can be made with juicy sliced peaches or halved and pitted prune plums. Daydream about Parisian mornings and serve warm croissants and cafe au lait alongside this juicy fruit clafouti.

PEACH CLAFOUTI

Serves six
2 cups (500 mL) thinly sliced peaches
1 tablespoon (15 mL) butter
1 cup (250 mL) milk (2 per cent M.F.)
2 large eggs
1 large egg yolk
1/2 cup (125 mL) all-purpose flour
1/4 cup (50 mL) granulated sugar
1 tablespoon (15 mL) dark rum or 1 teaspoon (5 mL) pure vanilla extract
1/4 teaspoon (1 mL) salt
Icing sugar
Grease 9 1/2-inch (24 cm) glass pie plate (volume should be about 6 cups/1.5 L) with butter.
Arrange peaches over bottom of pie

plate, with slices overlapping slightly; set aside.

Add 1 tablespoon (15 mL) butter to milk in 2-cup (500-mL) microwavable measure. Microwave on high for 1 1/2 minutes or until hot.

Meanwhile, in large bowl, whisk eggs and egg yolk lightly. Add flour; whisk until smooth. Pour in hot milk mixture, whisking constantly. Add granulated sugar, rum and salt; whisk until blended. Immediately pour over peaches in pie plate.

Bake at 375 F (180 C) for 40 minutes or until top is puffed and golden and edges are lightly browned. Let clafouti cool slightly in pie plate on rack, about 10 minutes. Dust clafouti generously with icing sugar. Cut in wedges and serve warm.

Note: To peel peaches, put peaches in boiling water for 20 seconds; immediately transfer to ice water to cool. Remove from water and peel off skins.

Approximate nutritional analysis for

each serving: 173 cal, 6 g pro, 6 g fat, 25 g carb.

TIPS

- To dust this dessert with icing sugar, place sugar in small sieve and hold over clafouti; lightly tap edge of sieve to distribute sugar evenly over top of dessert.

- Prune plum variation: Substitute about 12 small prune plums for peach slices. Halve and pit plums and arrange evenly, cut side down, in bottom of pie plate.

- Flour should always be measured carefully. Never use liquid measures to measure dry ingredients. Dry measuring cups come in 1/4, 1/3, 1/2 and 1 cup sizes. To measure flour, stir and lightly spoon into dry measuring cup until filled slightly above rim; level off with straight edge of a knife. (Do not shake or tap cup, this will increase the amount of flour in cup and result in batter that is too stiff.)

Piano Men: Creeggan and Evin duke it out at Café Bla Bla

A duo of sparring pianists will take the stage at Café Bla Bla this Friday as they pass through Sherbrooke on a tour of small stages from Halifax to Toronto.

For Andy Creeggan, who has been living in Sherbrooke since 2002, it will be a mid-tour break to play one of his regular haunts.

"I love this place Café Bla Bla," Creeggan told the Record in an interview.

"We play in the cellar. It's just a lovely little room, perfect for the music. Set up some candles, it's got the right ambiance, and a nice community of folks who love music."

Creeggan will be behind his Rhodes piano and his musical partner, Mike Evin, who is from Montreal, will be playing his mini-acoustic.

"We've got them set up so we're looking at each other as we play. It's sort of dueling keyboards. It's a lot of fun," Creeggan said.

This is the new musical life of Andy Creeggan. He was once the pianist for Canadian pop darlings the Barenaked Ladies, performing on the albums *Gordon and Maybe You Should Drive*. He left the band in the mid-90s to go in another musical direction.

"I was kind of the research and development guy," Creeggan said of his days with BNL, adding that he always paid close attention to the music and left the lyrics and catchy pop hooks to the other members.

"I take that into my music. I'm constantly working things, trying to understand styles. I'm pushing a little more on the musical side of things than they are now. They keep it in a pop idiom and I don't. Sometimes I do instrumental music, but I generally keep it pretty jazzy. Now and then I just come out with a simple little melody."

"I kind of run around and meander more in music than them."

Creeggan said he is also something of a composer, noting that he likes to orchestrate things in new and interesting ways that is not always as accessible, but keeps him engaged.

Creeggan has been musically prolific since his days with BNL. He has a long-standing side project — The Brothers Creeggan — with his brother, Jim, who is still a member of BNL.

He also has also released a handful of solo albums. It's not always easy for his brother to escape the busy schedule of BNL to record on the side, he said.

"I'm working on a solo project. *Andiwork III* is the working title right now. I think I'm going to change that. It's basically what I do with my brother, but he's not available too much these days. It's Brothers Creeggan without the brother, so it's Andy."

Enter Mike Evin. Creeggan first came across Evin's music when he was studying at McGill University five years ago.

"A mutual friend of ours passed his CD on to me and I just loved it. I heard all kinds of things that are akin to my own music. I was really excited. I

e-mailed him and said: 'Mike Evin, I'm glad you exist,' or something like that," Creeggan said with a laugh.

The two pianists have been occasionally performing together ever since. Creeggan even produced Evin's new album.

Creeggan said their complimentary musical styles also work well on stage. "We just rip off one another and play each other's styles. It's a good evening of music."

Evin may also appear on Creeggan's next album. Creeggan said they have been developing songs on this tour, and Evin has become an integral part of the music.

"I imagine once we've played them enough, I won't be able to stand certain songs without Mike. I'm sure he's going to be singing harmonies and playing keyboards in some sense."

As for this tour, Creeggan said there is something about playing small venues in smaller towns that really appeals to him.

"My father-in-law said something about 'you've got to have people who are hungry for music.' Sometimes in the bigger towns, they have so many shows, they're not necessarily ready for a show, but in the smaller towns

they just don't have as much exposure to stuff. They tend to be more salivating, and it's really nice to play for salivating audiences."

Andy Creeggan and Mike Evin will be performing at Café Bla Bla on the corner of King Ouest and Wellington on Friday, Sept. 22. Doors open at 9 p.m. Tickets are \$8.

Pianist Lefèvre opens OSS season tomorrow

*Orchestra director
promises a season
for all tastes*

The Sherbrooke Symphony Orchestra opens its 2006/07 series of concerts at the Maurice O'Bready Hall tomorrow evening with Rhapsodies and Symphonies featuring renowned guest pianist Alain Lefèvre. "This is the first of our five Grand Concerts on the theme Passionate at the OSS," explained executive director Georges Goulet. "It's a captivating series. We have a line-up of very special guests beginning with Alain Lefèvre who is stopping here on his way from a concert in Japan to Arizona."

The young Canadian pianist has been described as "a new personality that truly stands out from the typical trends and artifices offered on the international scene". Among many engagements, Lefèvre has performed with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra in London, The SWR in Stuttgart, The Detroit Symphony, The National Symphony in Washington, The Montreal Symphony Orchestra, The Toronto

Symphony and the Moscow Virtuosi.

At Saturday's concert, he will play Montreal composer Andre Mathieu's Romantic Rhapsody for Piano and Orchestra. "It's really a first," said Goulet. "He's recorded the piece with the MSO, but the CD won't be released until October. It's very special to start our season with this renowned soloist."

The program will be completed with Lefèvre playing Gershwin's Rhapsody in Blue and the OSS's interpretation of Tchaikovsky's Polonaise.

Conducted by Stephane Laforest since 1998, the orchestra has base of forty-five professional musicians, a number who teach music at local universities. The number often swells to over seventy during special concerts. "This is our 68th consecutive year of concerts," continued Goulet. "We're the third oldest orchestra in Quebec. This season does honour to our heritage which is varied and full."

The remaining concerts in the series are: The Heroics of Beethoven on Oct. 21 with guest violinist Alexandra da Costa; Holst: The Planets on Jan. 22 with soloists from the OSS chorus; Viva Italia on Feb. 24 with soloist Anne-Marie Dubois. Finishing the series will be an Opera Gala with guest Marc Hervieux on Apr. 21.

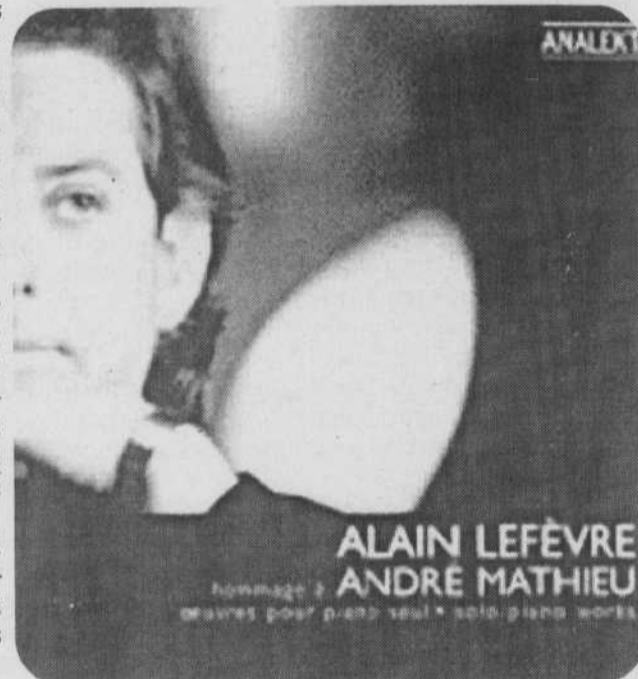
The annual Christmas concerts with guest soprano Nathalie Choquette and the orchestra chorus will take place on Saturday, Dec. 16 at 8 p.m., and at 2 p.m. on Sunday, Dec. 17. "The Christmas concerts are always sold-out so we run two shows."

"We will have other concerts as well, different performances here and there. We've two Pop concert planned the first with French pop singer Michel Rivard and full orchestra on Nov. 10," said Goulet.

"I'm really excited about our English pop concert on March 30 - it's a homage to the Beatles with the Ontario group Jeans and Classic. I've heard them, and they're great performers. The concert will take place at the Granada Theatre, we'll make a night of it, sell beer, make it relaxed and enjoyable."

The orchestra is in the process of translating its promotional material and programs, including the comprehensive web site, into English. "The

Music for modern times

*Jazz score for Chaplin film
premieres
in Sutton*

Montreal composer and percussionist Claude Lavergne is premiering his original score to the classical 1936 movie Modern Times on Sept. 23 at the Sutton Jazz Festival.

"While music usually creates images in our minds, here I've used the images to create music. Much of the score is based on improvisation—with instructions to the musicians for a certain structure," explained Lavergne. "I've assigned an instrument to the various characters in the film. So at certain points, only one instrument will play, then two or three together, then the whole quintet."

"Jazz lends itself perfectly to what I'm trying to achieve here, since the hallmark of Jazz is improvisation. The rhythms of Jazz, such as swing, are all part of the score."

The film is shown on a large screen during the performance. The five musicians—on bass, guitar, keyboard, alto sax, and drums—keep track of the

action on a small monitor.

Modern Times, Chaplin's last film as the Little Tramp, is also one of his most famous, known for its stark social commentary on the dehumanization of modern society. The tramp is a factory worker driven to distraction by the soulless momentum of industrialization.

"I first saw the film when I was quite young, then I saw it again four years ago and it struck me that the subject matter was very applicable to the world today—that it was in fact still modern. This theme of the old/modern combined is reflected throughout the whole performance. It's an old movie but seen in a fresh way."

Lavergne has worked as a sideman for various groups over the last twenty years. He's performed at the Montreal Off Jazz Festival and played and written music for various films including several at the National Film Board. "I really enjoy playing music for film and when I saw Modern Times again, I realized it would be a perfect vehicle for a jazz score."

"In the past, I've written bits and pieces for film, for a specific scene or two. It was a challenge to see what I could do with an entire film, to create a tandem performance of film with live

Munira Judith Avinger will be leading Dances of Universal Peace on Sunday, Sept. 24, as the second event in Emmanuel United Church's Music and Poetry series. "Munira has studied many religious traditions, and in her spirituality she celebrates the unity of all creation," says Wendy MacLean, incumbent. "She is an initiate of the Sufi order of Dances of Universal Peace. These dances incorporate many prayers - Christian, Islamic, Sanskrit in movement, song and simple gesture."

Avinger will also read from her poetry, some put to music and inspired by the dances. She will also lead the dances related to the poem. "At first I thought that the dances and the poetry were separate parts of my life and that I somehow had to divide my time and attention between them," Avinger explained.

"At some point, however, I began to realize that the energy of the dances were beginning to flow into my writing

and that they actually enhanced each other. Since then many poems have been inspired by my contemplations of specific dances. The poems like the dances have become my way of reaching out, of doing my true work in the world."

Avinger has a number of books published, including a novel 'Julia'. Her most recent book of poetry, 'Hidden/Cache' is available at local bookstores.

"Over the summer I have drawn real inspiration from Munira's vision of world peace," says Rev. MacLean. "She explains that peace is expansive, opening the soul, the mind, the resources of our world to share and be generous. Fear and violence - even the violence from wars across the world - have the effect of constricting our hearts. Munira has an expansive vision that crosses the lines of different religions."

The event begins at 2 p.m. on Sept. 24 at Emmanuel United in Cowansville.

Bishop's chancellor's heart is in Africa

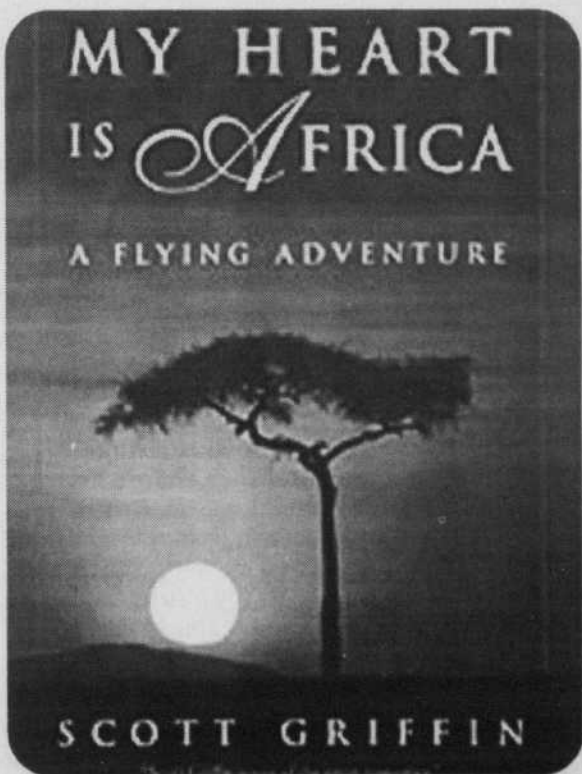
The biggest man on campus at Bishop's University will make an appearance outside of convocation ceremonies. Chancellor Scott Griffin - a Bishop's alumnus - will host the Lennoxville launch of his new book next week.

In 1996, Griffin went to work for the the Flying Doctors Service, where he flew medical personnel to remote areas across the African continent. Along the way, he survived two crashes in a single engine Cessna. The tome My Heart is Africa: A Flying Adventure (Thomas Allen & Son) is billed as "an absorbing adventure story, but it is also the story of Africa - its problems and people, its landscapes and limitations, its culture and courage."

In fact playwright David Young once gave a speech introducing Griffin this way: "Friends from student days remember him as someone with a literary rather than a mathematical turn of mind. He was, as they say, not good at sums. Despite this handicap, Scott went on to do rather well in the world of business and finance. With his own rare mix

of nerve and intuition, he built a mini-conglomerate in the field of high technology engineering and

manufacturing. Then, as his habit, he made another great escape, over the banister, two floors straight down.

"Scott walked away from the company he built and the life that went with it. He took an entirely new direction."

Africa was a part of that new direction.

Griffin, in fact, has managed to successfully mix business and culture.

He's the chairman and major shareholder in a couple of manufacturing companies, and also owner of the literary publishing house Anansi Press. And then there's his own awards foundation, the Griffin Trust for Excellence in Poetry.

It was founded in 2000 (with other big names in the Canlit field like Margaret Atwood and Michael Ondaatje) with the purpose of raising "public awareness of the crucial role poetry must play in society's cultural life."

The trust gives out two \$50,000 prizes for English poetry annually (one to a living Canadian, the other is awarded to a writer regardless of nationality — but they, too, must be living).

Griffin has said of the initiative: "From where has this idea of a trust for poetry come? And why poetry?"

"The fact that these questions could be posed is, I submit, an indication of just how far poetry has slipped from the mainstream of our cultural lives.

"This is a shame and more than anything else, serves as the justification and purpose for the establishment of the Griffin Trust.

"Poetry speaks to the soul of a nation and its people, and these days, at least in North America, it seems to me that there is precious little that addresses the soul."

All royalties from the sale of Griffin's book will be donated to the flying doctors.

Griffin's is the first guest of this year's Morris House Reading Series. He will speak at 6:30 p.m. at the Bishop's University Bookstore (Marjorie Donald Building) on Fri., Sept. 29. Admission is free.

Future events will feature author and spoken word artist Corey Frost (4:30 p.m. on Nov. 22, reading from My Own Devices: Airport Version). New Brunswick playwright and poet Bob Moore will read (from Museum Absconditum) on Feb. 7 at 4:30 p.m. And Nova Scotia poet and playwright Pam Calabrese-MacLean will present Twenty-Four Names for Mother at 4:30 p.m. on March 14.

Wayne Johnston creates another 'big baggy monster'

Novels should not be written with restraint. Instead, they should be "big baggy monsters".

Wayne Johnston is paraphrasing, most favourably, something Henry Fielding said three centuries ago. Fielding is the 18th-century author best known for Tom Jones, the ribald novel that is not only the size of the New York telephone directory but is filled with as many larger-than-life, eccentric characters as can be found on the streets of The Big Apple.

There was definitely no restraint exercised in writing Johnston's latest novel, *The Custodian of Paradise* (Alfred A. Knopf Canada). It's more than

500 pages long, this tale of an assorted pack of Newfoundlanders who, at first blush, seem totally preposterous but, in Johnston's hands, become most believable. The plot has more mysterious twists and turns around foggy, gin-soaked corners than the Victorian-era hunt for Jack the Ripper. Expect to be exhausted, a little spooked and maybe even enlightened by the end of the journey.

Actually, *Paradise* is Johnston's third consecutive big baggy monster.

First came *The Colony of Unrequited Dreams* in 1999, a much-praised breakthrough novel, a loud galloping romp across the early life of Newfoundland's first post-Confederation premier, Joey Smallwood. Then came the somewhat tamer *The Navigator of New York*, about rival Arctic explorers.

And now we have *The Custodian of Paradise*, an unruly Dickensian tale set in early 20th-century Newfoundland about Sheilagh Fielding, a fictional woman, six-foot-three in height, with a drinking problem, a lame leg, a checkered career in journalism, two illegitimate children, a crush on Smallwood and an existential crisis.

Paradise is not a sequel, nor a prequel, to *Colony*, says Johnston. It is, he says, coining a word, a "simulquel", *Paradise* being a story happening simultaneously to the events of *Colony*.

In *Colony*, Smallwood dominated, with Fielding playing a supporting role.

In *Paradise*, we get the world from Fielding's point of view, with Smallwood largely limited to being a supporting character, a whirling dervish, actually, popping in and out of the plot, at times, most unexpectedly.

Paradise is layer upon layer of allegories. Fielding could be seen as representing all of Newfoundland, her story being Newfoundland's story.

She is stalked throughout her life by a mysterious figure called The Provider, who also assumes a role as The Creator.

The *Paradise* of the title refers to Loreburn Island, a desolate speck of

land off the Newfoundland coast that was abandoned as uneconomical by its first European settlers. Shunned and desolate herself, Fielding picks this island-ghost town to live alone and sort through the messy baggage that has been her life. On Loreburn, Fielding is simultaneously living in *Paradise*, in *Paradise Lost* and in a metaphor for Newfoundland itself.

"You get a structure in the book that is like those Russian dolls, where you

have dolls within dolls within dolls, with each one, as you move out from the centre, bigger than the other," says Johnston.

This all sounds more complicated than it really is. Anyway, readers uninterested in allegories or hidden meanings can simply revel in a good story. It is a story as hauntingly powerful as such contemporary Canlit triumphs as Ann-Marie MacDonald's *Fall on Your Knees* or Rohinton Mistry's *A Fine Balance*.

Paradise has already made it to the Scotiabank Giller Prize longlist, likely just the first of many honours to come its way.

Paradise is to land in bookstores across the country this weekend.

Johnston immediately hits the road to drum up publicity. He is not a morning person and not particularly looking forward to all those early morning radio and television interviews that form the backbone of book tours.

But he is trying to get in shape for the 7 a.m. talk shows: "Every day, I get up 15 minutes earlier." But being "up" does not necessarily mean being "perky." He promises to rise early. But he won't promise to be perky.

Johnston is speaking during a noon-time telephone interview from his Toronto home and, frankly, he sounds none too perky yet. Maybe it's just a bad connection or the thickness of a Newfoundland accent.

Rock 'n' roll — not originally a musical genre

David Savage (aka Super Dave) hosts *What's Your Point and The Oldies Show* on CJMQ 88.9 FM on Monday evenings from 5 to 8 p.m. In this and future articles he will discuss, define and otherwise describe segments of the musical period we know today as the Oldies era.

In my travels I'm always pleased to find and tune in to oldies music stations. From Kool 105 in Florida to Kool 101.5 in Plattsburg to 100.9 in South Portland, the music transcends the years and still reverberates in the ears and hearts of the baby boomer generation.

I first got involved with CJMQ while working at The Record and from my studies in Radio and Television and being a baby boomer I naturally wanted

to host an oldies music show. My material was mostly vinyl with a couple of CD's received as gifts from my kids. Not having been in a studio since the early 70's, CD players and CPU's were definitely a "new" thing. I loved the ease of cueing CD's as opposed to that of vinyl. The rest was as always, a question of timing and pushing buttons along with the rush of voice-over intros trying to time the exact moment to cut out as the lyrics break in.

The musical era as defined by the oldies began somewhere between '53 and '55 and progressed through a variety of genres to 1975 with a couple of exceptions (Abba continued to '79). It is generally conceded that this style

ended somewhat abruptly with the arrival of Disco or Dance music. Disco by the way, almost killed record sales. While there were a handful of popular groups (Bee Gees, KC and the Sunshine Band et al) disco sounds and beats varied little from group to group. If you'd heard one, you'd heard them all but the sounds and beats were a must for discotheque generation.

Back to the oldies. Rock and Roll progressed from the Rhythm and Blues sounds of the black artists of the time. It, in many ways, saved radio stations from the television grasp of the story telling market. Radio stations thrived on the murder/melodrama serials with a blend of the big band sounds and artists...until TV arrived.

With the new music there was a whole new generation of listeners who commanded some of the purse strings and they wanted to Rock and Roll. Radio stations were glad to be of some assistance along with the advertising dollars which allowed them to beam 50,000 to 100,000 watts of AM power into homes, cars and the local A&W hamburger stands.

Hindsight may suggest that radio tycoons created this new sound out of desperation for the advertising dollar or was it created by the arrival of the pelvic gyrations of a young Memphis lad named Presley? The truth probably lies somewhere between the two.

Spa Eastman wins culinary kudos

A cookbook produced by the local business Spa Eastman has picked up a gold medal in the Canadian Culinary Book Awards.

Jocelyna Dubuc, Pierre Cornélis and Stéphane Triballi picked up the top award in the French Cookbook Category for *Le Spa Eastman à votre table*.
