Restaurant business is more than slinging burgers

Students prepare food, glorious food for real customers

This is not your ordinary lunch spot.

Hidden amid a maze of halls and the cafeteria at Le Triolet is a restaurant that serves up some of the best food in town. And it's practically giving it a way.

The blackboard on the wall is one of the only reminders that the room was once filled with desks and that this is a high school. But despite the thick tablecloths and candlelight, this little restaurant is still a classroom of sorts.

No, the service is not perfect. And you may have to reserve three weeks in advance. But it would be inexcusably petty to complain. After all, the waiter is a 17 year-old student, the escargot entrée costs \$1.25, and the wine mark-up is 50 cents.

WILLING GUINEA PIGS

La petite bourgonne 'employs' only students, and its customers are the willing guinea pigs for some of the 250 students in Le Triolet's three-year food school. Pig is the operative word here. It takes all the self-control you can muster not to overeat on delicious food at one-third the regular cost.

The vocational program trains students in one of three areas: table service, meal preparation, and pastry and baking. And according

to one of their teachers, graduates have all the qualifications the *Institute de Hôtellerie et de Tourisme* in Montreal could give them.

"We don't have Ritz Carlton or Chateau Champlain out here (in the Townships). What we need are good workers to look after the tourists," says teacher Jacques Latulippe. The goal of the program, he says, is not to turn out chefs, but people ready and willing to apprentice. Graduates find jobs in local hotels and resorts. Although he admits that some may be underemployed, Latulippe said this week that everyone who graduates gets a job in the field.

"I get calls all the time from the hotels. They want more graduates than I can give them," he said.

BLACK FOREST CAKE

Students learn to make and serve classic French food, such as locally harvested smoked trout, scampis and Black Forest cake. Although most of the menu is set by the Education Ministry, there is also some room for local variance, hence the trout. Latulippe said that teacher scour local eateries to see what they're serving. He says it's important to prepare grads for the local job market.

"It's an important tourist trade here... there's always work for restaurant people," he said.

Latulippe said English students are more than welcome to enter the program. Most businesses in the Townships need bilingual people because of American tourists. A Galt student, for example, can switch into *La Triolet* when they've finished secondary three and are 16 years old. The first two years students learn the ins and outs of kitchen work one task at a time. By the third year, they spend over 30 hours a week in the kitchen or practising service. Latulippe says the long hours and no pay doesn't bother them.

DUCK FOR \$2.65

"They love to work here. I have chase them out sometimes."

Even the school's cafeteria is run by cooking students. Regular students get a choice of three different meals every day, and it's certainly not burgers. Recent menus have included duck à l'orange for \$2.65. Still some students complain that they'd prefer hot dogs, says

Latulippe. You can't please everybody, he laughs.

What students learn most is that the restaurant business is more than just slinging burgers. Any waiter or waitress worth their salt judges the personality of the customer and adjusts accordingly. Speed, conversation and attentiveness all depend on the mood of the eater. The students in *La petite bourgonne* are taught not only to flambé and pop corks—they're also taught "attitude." The school, says Latulippe, has no pretensions of turning out experts. Students learn the basic skills. The rest comes with practice.

"We don't criticize then for making mistakes in front of their customers. We wait till later. We teach them to think of it as a game."

SOLD AT COST

The food is cheap because the government, as in a chemistry class, supplies all the materials. Some items, like the cafeteria's spaghetti,

cost less to make than what they're sold for. A serving of scampis, on the other hand, is practically given away at \$5. This is done on purpose, Latulippe says, because the cheaper a more complex dish is, the more people are likely to order it, and the more students get to practise.

There are training restaurants in 10 other Quebec high schools. Le Triolet's celebrated its 10th anniversary on Wednesday. Gilles Côté, vice-principal of the high school, says declining school populations and shrinking staff have forced Le Triolet to concentrate on things they do best, and the kitchen is near the top of the list.

"We're one of the best, and we're going to concentrate on what we do best," he said.

The restaurant is open between 11:45 and 1:45 during weekdays, and seats 36 people. For reservations call (819) 565-3885.

Local teacher co-authored cooking text

SHERBROOKE (GM) — Quebec high school cooking schools now have their first "home grown" textbook catering to their course material.

Jacques Latulippe, a cooking school teacher at Le Triolet, is co-author of *Premier volume de cuisine professionnelle*, a text designed to complement the courses taught in Le Triolet and nine other cooking schools in Quebec. The book, available only in French, is not just a recipe book. Most of its pages are devoted to the such techniques of making a plate look appealing, the difference between various knives.

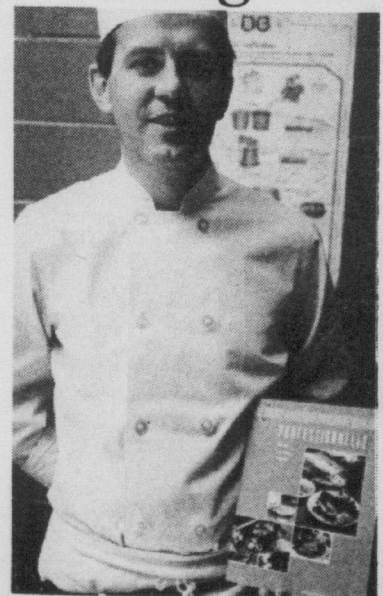
Latulippe, who has already published eight educational books, said the book is proof the school is

still on top of its field after 10 years of operation. Latulippe has been at the school since it's beginning, and said his years of experience teaching the vocational course have taught him what students need to know.

Paul Lessard of the Sherbrooke tourism bureau said a well-trained workforce for the growing industry here is vital. He praised Latulippe's students because they learn more than just how to make food taste good.

"It's not just type food on the plate that's important... it's the way it's presented."

Latulippe graduated from a vocational course himself and worked in restaurants and hotels since 1965. He also has a MA from the University of Sherbrooke.

Everyone should give Baby Duck one try

Wines everyone should taste at least once in their life:

A glass of **Amontillado Sherry** — preferably drunk while reading *The Cask of Amontillado* by Edgar Allan Poe — is an experience that any serious devotee of the grape should try to manage. Since Amontillado is also relatively inexpensive, one of the major hurdles is already overcome. As to where you can obtain Poe's horrible little story, I'll leave that up to you.

One of Italy's rarest and best wines is the stately **Brunello di Montalcino**. Austere, made for long aging and always expensive, this is not for the weak at heart. First made popular by the Biondi-Santi family, Brunello di Montalcino ranks right up there with the best wines in the world.

If I had my way — which I all too seldom do — I would make it compulsory for all students of wine to try a glass of **Dom Perignon Champagne**. This would do two things. First it would show if they had any sense of taste at all and second it would dispell the notion that "all sparkling wines taste the same."

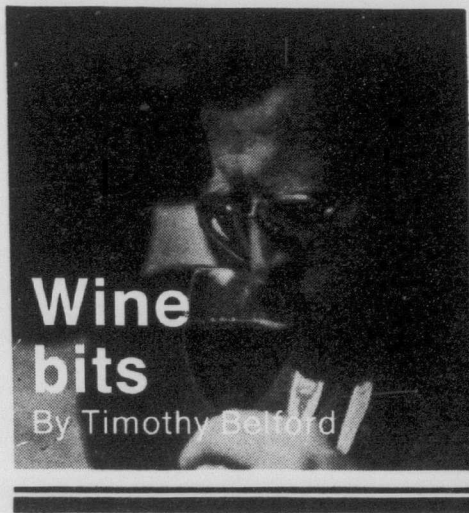
Before anyone is allowed to die, they should have the opportunity to sit in the sun — Portugal's if at all possible — and gulp great, cool glasses of **Vinho Verde**. This faintly fizzy, tart, refreshing little wine is cheap, plentiful and the best cure for sunstroke that I've yet come across.

On a more serious note, the first time you can round up \$200 or \$300 I suggest you try a reasonably good vintage of the incomparable **Chateau Latour**. Now,

you will probably receive opinions to the contrary — suggesting Mouton Rothschild or even Haut Brion — but take it from me, the best Bordeaux in the world, all other things like weather etc. being equal, Latour is the tops.

If you have any change left over after your Latour binge, a bottle of **Montrachet** is just the thing. Definitely Burgundy's finest white wine, Montrachet is conceivably the world's finest white table wine. I make the distinction "table wine" since no life would be complete without a taste of a German **Trockenbeere-nausele**. Literally made from 'selected, dried, individual grapes' this liquid honey is one of nature's most delightful gifts. It is also one of the world's rarest and most expensive.

Finally, everyone should try a glass — no more — of **Baby Duck** at least once in their life if only to demonstrate the difference between all of the above and the saccharine, gassy, alcoholic 'soda pop' that many North Americans have been trained to accept. Cheers!

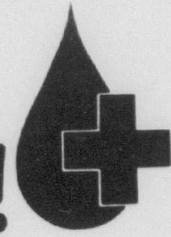

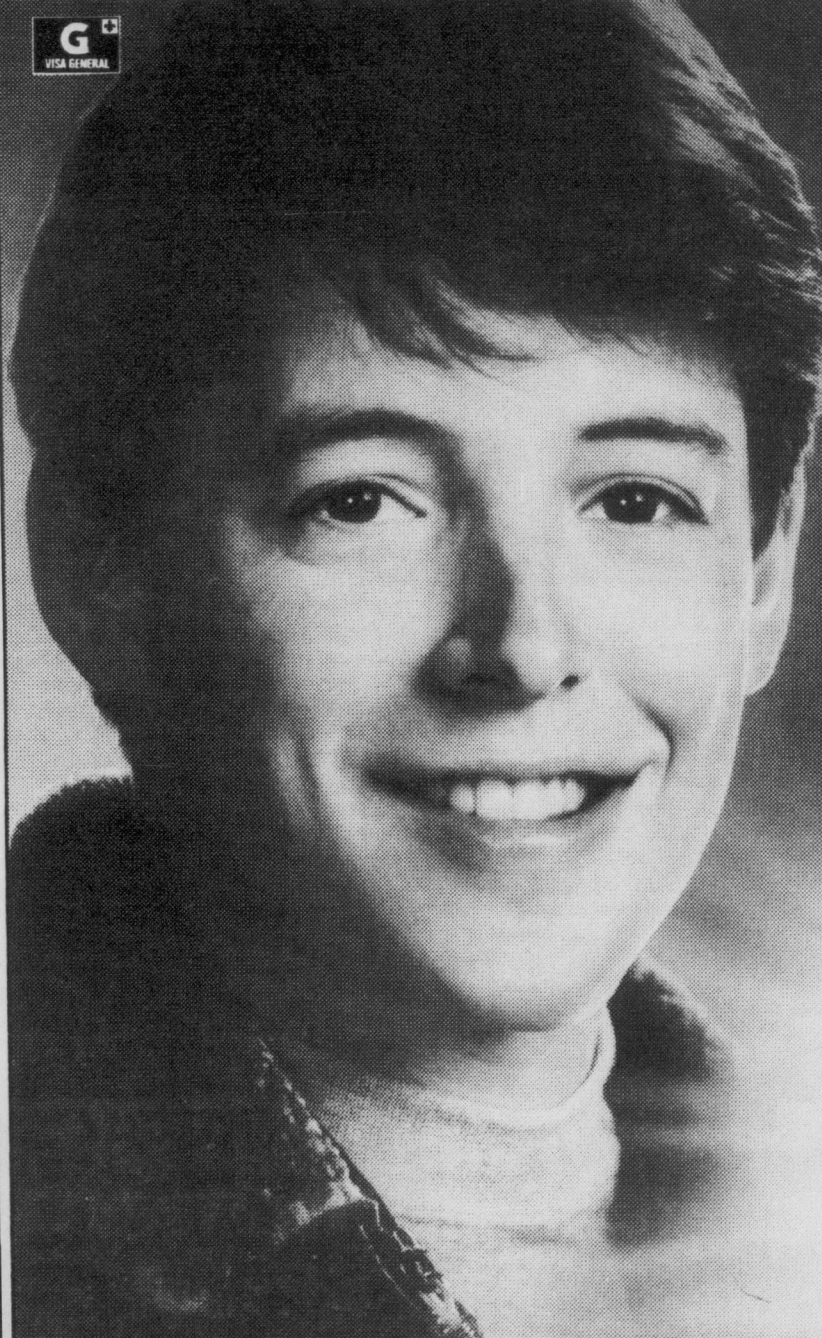

Meyers' account of Hemingway's life lacks emotion

Hemingway: A Biography by Jeffrey Meyers (FITZHENRY & WHITESIDE): \$40.50, 644pp.

A rejuvenation of interest in the life and work of Ernest Hemingway coincided with 1986 marking the 25th year since the American novelist took his own life at his ranch in Ketchum, Idaho on July 2, 1961. The passing of a quarter of a century since the death of the larger-than-life novelist and short story craftsman was celebrated by as many as six fresh biographical and critical studies of the writer, which include Peter Griffin's *Along With Youth*, a concentration on the youth of Hemingway; and Jeffrey Meyers's exhaustively researched biography which follows the Carlos Baker definitive work by some sixteen years. Baker's *A Life Story* looms over most subsequent biographies of Hemingway as a formidable presence thanks to its wonderfully readable prose and rich narrative style. Other studies of the Oak Park, Illinois-born writer pale by comparison, and unfortunately Meyers' is no exception.

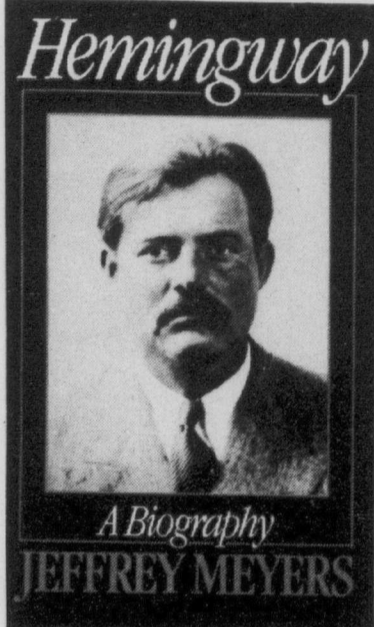
There is no question that Meyers, a professor of English at the University of Colorado, knows his subject and the writings of Hemingway intimately; there are new shadings of understanding revealed about the book's hero in all aspects of his life. The shortcomings of this biography are not in the realm of knowledge of the man in focus, nor in the area of critical appreciation and analysis of his major work — they occur in the stylistic repetition that Meyers employs in discussing Hemingway's life and in a certain tedium that creeps in as the narrative unfolds.

Baker's forte was in drawing the reader into Hemingway's life; in letter the reader experience what it must have been like to have been this literary oddity. Meyers ex-

mines Hemingway from an external position, holding him up to a critical microscope, always attempting to analyze why he would do certain things, and the reader is continually aware of the awkwardness of the style.



For instance, when each new phase of Hemingway's career is introduced the reader becomes wary of Meyers's favorite manner of introducing new characters into his story. A listing of the Hemingway companions is given, such as this one for the Havana, Cuba chapters: "His closest friends in Cuba were Mario (Mayito) Menocal, Elicio Arquelles and Thorwald Sanchez, who enjoyed their leisure, participated in exclusively male activities and valued Hemingway's passion for sport". What follows is a succession of pa-

ragraphs, each one of which offers a small anecdote delineating how Hemingway got along with each of these fellows. This stylistic quirk is used for virtually every occasion in the book when Hemingway finds himself in new circumstances. His Toronto sojourn at the *Toronto Daily Star*, his Key West days, his scuffling days in the cafés of Paris; his dangerous flirtation with the Spanish Civil War, or his introduction to the big game hunting in Africa. Meyers's predictable style of unravelling the mysteries of his subject's life detract from one of the most rewarding aspects of biography — the feeling that the reader is living the life with Hemingway and experiencing what it must have been like to see the world through his eyes.

Factually Meyers' biography is as revealing as Baker's, with perhaps the benefit of many years of hindsight, particularly in the areas of discussing the final year of so of the writer's troubled life, and in analyzing the several posthumous works, *A Moveable Feast* (the most famous example of a great writer's inability, or refusal to adopt correct spelling!), *Islands In The Stream*, and some unpublished Nick Adams stories. It is curious that Meyers does not acknowledge the aid of Mary Hemingway, the author's fourth wife, in his preface to the book, and that her own appearance in his narrative as much as relegating her to being a mental lightweight whose conversations with her husband could never be very intellectual in nature. This is most strange in light of the interesting and revealing book that Mary Hemingway wrote, entitled *How It Was*, which does not give this impression at all.

Meyers tells Hemingway's life

story in a detailed, often too meticulous fashion (an appendix on Hemingway's illnesses and injuries is one example of Meyers's penchant for cataloguing aspects of Papa's life), but at the end of the 572 pages of text the reader has felt nothing on the anguish, joy, frustration, euphoria, despair, triumph, and other of the board range of human emotions that Carlos Baker's biography of Hemingway allowed the reader to share in his documenting this unforgettable man's story.

RECORD REVIEWS
Wire Train TEN WOMEN (COLUMBIA-415 RECORDS)

It's taken them three albums to really get their act together, but San Francisco's Wire train give evidence on *TEN WOMEN* that they are poised to add their name to those of American rock bands such as the Hooters, Lone Justice, Los Lobos, and the Smithereens who are playing a brand of music that makes you sit up and take notice. Kevin Hunter's images reveal that his songwriting is rather Dylanesque (as in Zimmerman, not Thomas), and that they are as unpredictable line to line as any of the early, scrufflin' Dylan: "Her phantom glory is fading/ She melts from the frescoes to floor/ The bread in a vault he's been saving/ The wine he licks from the floor", is but a taste of the imagery that motivates "She's A Very Pretty Thing".

If *TEN WOMEN* has an epic track on it, then "Breakwater Days" must be it. This song was probably heavily influenced by the time that Wire Train spent in London, England in the summer of '86, because the mood is certainly closer to something by Ray Davies of the Kinks than it is to anything they might have heard in their native San Francisco from, say, The Airplane. Early bet for a breakout single from Wire Train might be the lead cut on the record, "She Comes On", which has a large vocal chorus and a clever hook laid on

some neat, Byrd-like riffs that tinkle in the background as Kevin Hunter vocalizes with easy, throwaway delivery. If this album can generate enough FM airplay, or should a single sail into general hearing, then Wire Train can finally say they've paid their dues and everyone can enjoy this group's heady lyrics and fine harmonies.

VIDEO SCREENINGS
BLUE VELVET (KARL LORIMAR VIDEO)

The highly arty opening of David Lynch's film *BLUE VELVET* may very well scare off a few unenthusiastic viewers of his celebrated little film — shots of a man watering his lawn: cut to the man writhing in hideous pain: cut to the grass on his lawn: cut to close-up of beetles or insects engaged in a deadly struggle beneath the foliage — but once the forced symbolism involved in his dissection of the innocent town called Lumberton is out of the way, what unfolds is one of the strangest trips in contemporary film. When a crusading young man (Kyle MacLachlan) finds the gruesome surprise of a human ear on a lawn, his report to the police brings him into contact with the detective who is daddy to the other lead in the movie, Laura Dern, who is just perfect as the wide-eyed, naive young thing that the boy confides in. She tells him that there have been strange goings on at the apartment of the beautiful Isabella Rossellini, and his decision to spy on this haunted young woman leads to some unexpected complications. Rossellini is being manipulated by a drugged out Dennis Hopper who brutalizes her and humiliates her in some of the most graphic scenes this side of a genuine porno flick. MacLachlan gets caught up in some hideous plot that defies summarization, but suffice to say that it leads to a rendezvous with one of Hopper's pals who does the most insidiously evil lip-synch job on Roy Orbison's "In Dreams" that you will see this side of *CABARET*. The underbelly of cheery little Lumberton turns out to have unbelievably gross slugs crawling around on it, and Lynch's film is all the most engrossing because of its Disneyland approach to perversity and criminality. David Lynch has given us two previous films that broke a lot of conventions (*ERASERHEAD* and *THE ELEPHANT MAN*) but they were nothing like the odd perspective on American life that he represents for us in the quirky but unavoidably controversial *BLUE VELVET*. 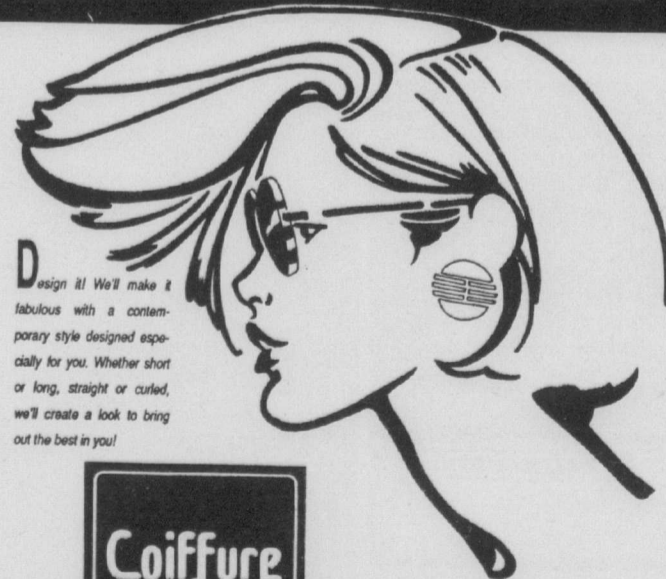

M-V students to model safari fashions

COWANSVILLE — Massey-Vanier High School students are taking to the stage again next week, but this time it's not for a Shakespearean drama or a band concert.

This time, they'll be modelling the latest in spring and summer fashions from local clothing stores.

It's the sixth annual fashion show for M-V students, and this time the theme will be safari/jungle. The 18 girls and 10 boys involved will perform 60 video-clip style numbers to model the clothing, including a recreation of the Genesis video, *Land of Confusion* featuring animal costumes, masks and other appropriate accessories.

Lise Lizotte, a teacher in the adult education department, has directed the fashion show since the beginning, and now works along with Eva Newman, Holly Gosselin, and other teachers who volunteer their time.

It all started six years ago, she said, when a group of Secondary V French students wanted to raise some money.

"They wanted to raise money for a party or something and they had this idea about a fashion show," she said. "They got me involved and now they've all gone and I'm still doing the shows."

The students started practising for the show in early March. But practising isn't all there is to it. To begin with they each had to approach a clothing store of their choice and ask for the loan of seven outfits. Many of them also created their own choreographies, or at least contributed their suggestions.

It's not only good fun for the students, and a way to raise money for awards for graduating students (they raised \$1,500 last year) but it's also good for their development, said Lizotte.

"It improves their self-esteem, we've noticed," she said.

"Kids love to be involved in a pro-

ject," she went on. "When we meet them on the street two or three years after, what they recall most is the fashion show."

Jacques Carriere, a grade 11 student from Granby, finds the show more than just playing around.

"It makes me less shy when I'm out in public," he said. The fashion show, combined with a course in drama, has helped him fight his shyness.

"You can't really be shy to do this," Alex Beauregard agrees. He

was involved in the show when he was in grade 10 last year and he says it's much easier now. "The first time I did it I was really nervous, but after you've done it you're really confident."

There are two presentations of Safari Fashion 87, one for the students during the day, and one for the public at 7:30 p.m. next Wednesday.

Admission is \$5 for the general public.

Passion for fly-fishing prompted couple's artistic career

NORTH HATLEY — Tranquil scenes of Lake Matapédia near Matane in the Gaspé peninsula strike a chord with Paul Bean. That's where he and wife Maureen spend their summers fly-fishing and sketching.

It's no wonder then that a couple so passionate about a key activity in their lives would want to share it with others.

The fruits and tools of their labors — watercolors and fish flies — are now on display in a unique art show at *Le Galerie Tayaut*.

Bean has mounted 92 flies in show cases, tastefully combining some of them with his wife's watercolors, presenting a variety of design and color.

The show began April 11 and continues through May 17.

In his works the ordinary fish fly "has been expounded upon and brought into an art form," says Bean.

It's fitting that the tools of fly-fishing should be turned into art because "fly-fishing is considered an art form," says Maureen. "It's the epitomy of fishing."

Bean has tied flies as a hobby and to use for fishing since he was 10 years old but about 10 years ago he decided to recreate some of the classic patterns of flies.

BEGAN IN 1600s

Fly-tying began in the 1600s in Britain, says Bean.

In researching some of the old patterns created when the British Empire was thriving, Bean found different materials had been used and the designs had been more colorful.

During the peak of the British Empire in the 19th century, the millinery trade (concerned with

making and selling women's hats) had access to many different feathers because the empire was spread around the world.

After the first world war when the empire started to collapse, access to the wide variety of feathers was limited and so different materials had to be found, says Bean.

He says fly-tiers had to switch from feathers to fur.

In recreating the designs, Bean uses, among others, the feathers of Macaws, Toucans and the Indian Crow from South America and the Jungle Cock of India. Some patterns also require seal fur and peacock berl, the fibre of the peacock feather.

"They're exotic materials. They're very hard to find," says Bean.

MOSTLY WHITE

Bean says even using turkey feathers in some of the flies is a challenge because most turkeys are domestic and have white feathers.

"Try to find a brown turkey," he says.

Bean is considered among the best fly-tiers in the world and has a network of feather suppliers including pet shops and zoos.

It takes Bean about 20 hours to complete one fly and some of his designs required him to develop a special technique to mount the larger feathers.

Tying down a broad feather is akin to stuffing a ship into a bottle. The feather fibres have to be gathered together so they can be secured into the head of the fish hook like the masts of a model ship that are flattened down so the vessel can be inserted into the bottle.

The difference is that the masts of the ship are intended to spring up afterwards. The feather, on the

other hand, must remain flat, sitting up like a dorsal fin on a fish instead of collapsing and bunching up.

Bean's technique is to separate the feather and mount each section one at a time. The task is made easier because the fibres in the feather act like "velcro" and adhere to each other, he says.

RE-ALIGNS PATTERNS

Still, the task is by no means simple. The different sections have to be matched so the patterns on the feather are re-aligned.

The patterns Bean creates are simply what strike him as the most appealing and colorful. He says most of the flies are not designed to look like food.

Bean says many fly-tiers think their fly "is going to catch everything in the lake."

But Bean says no one really knows why a salmon will strike a fly because when it comes into a river or stream the fish has no food in its stomach. It's there to spawn.

"Salmon don't come into the river to eat," Bean says.

"Everyone has their own little theories and I have my own: I don't care and I don't want to know."

Some of the flies are intended to look like food, he says.

"Trout streamers" are supposed to resemble minnows. However, one display of 20 streamers includes a blue fly because the color was needed to balance the display, says Bean.

Bean is careful to not copy an existing fly. Each fly he creates is researched to make sure his fly pattern doesn't come close to any other design.

TRIED SCULPTING

Besides tying flies, Bean has also tried his hand at sculpting and one of his works, an atlantic salmon, is also on display.

Bean says the sculptures show what the fish really look like when they're pulled from the water. When a specimen is stuffed by a taxidermist it loses some of its co-

lor, he says.

Bean makes his living manufacturing fishing lures. His "trout spinners" are sold across eastern Canada.

Bean got started internationally when Maureen took one of his flies to Joe Bates, an outdoor writer. Bates wrote a story about Bean and his flies and things took off from there.

Two flies in the exhibit are of particular interest. One is named for Dianna, Princess of Wales and is displayed with a letter of appreciation from Buckingham Palace for the "beautiful" fly.

Another fly was designed for Rosalynn Carter, wife of former president Jimmy Carter. The display is accompanied by a letter of appreciation and a photo of her fly-fishing.

Everything on display is also for sale. The price tag for the royal fly is \$400 but Bean says the average price for one of his creations is \$150.

Bean doesn't mind selling his works.

"It's been hanging in my home now and I've had my pleasure from it," he says.

Maureen takes her sketch pad on the fishing trips to Lake Matapédia and does the rough work for her painting then. During the winter she does the watercolors, she says.

Both are studying fine arts at Bishop's University.

"We would like to get an education in art," says Maureen.

Jacques Cartier's home town promotes Canadian links

ST-MALO, France (CP) — The "Canadian connection" is alive and well in this English Channel seaport which combines medieval charm with the best aspects of a summer resort.

Take a walk along the old granite ramparts — where St-Malo residents gathered more than 450 years ago to watch native son Jacques Cartier set sail for the New World — and you'll soon be in Quebec Square.

Follow the wall that skirts fine sand beaches and modern discos, cross Jacques Cartier Street, dodge Jacques Cartier Basin and you're in Newfoundland Quay.

Not much farther on, just past St-Pierre and Miquelon Avenue, you'll find Canada Square itself.

Finally, round one last corner at Limoelou, Cartier's old house, and you can read on a plaque all about a group of area residents who took the biggest plunge of all and emigrated to Saskatchewan a century ago.

PROUD OF TIE

St-Malo "takes great pride in being a part of Canadian history," says Dr. Gilles Foucqueron, a member of the St-Malo Association

of Friends of Jacques Cartier which looks after Cartier House and promotes the Canada-St-Malo link.

The weather-beaten brownstone house, faithfully restored inside and out to reflect the lifestyle of more than 450 years ago, contains a series of exhibits marking Cartier's voyages to the New World which should be of great interest to any Canadian.

"Who has not heard of St-Malo?" gushes the map of the town given to all visitors.

"The name alone evokes for those who have not hitherto visited the city, adventure at sea, flying flags of privateers and discoverers, iron-bound chests filled with fabulous riches, (and) sailing boats under way for the Newfoundland fishing grounds."

LOVE CANADA

Cartier, the first European to sail into the Gulf of St. Lawrence and explore its coasts, remains the most visible symbol of the link between Canada and St-Malo.

An artist's conception of his face, surrounded by a heart, still peers out from signs proclaiming I Love Canada on store fronts, hotels and restaurants.

And his exploits are proudly recalled in the town's small museum, nestled under the ramparts in the medieval area of narrow cobblestone streets, tall gabled houses, covered passageways and courtyards.

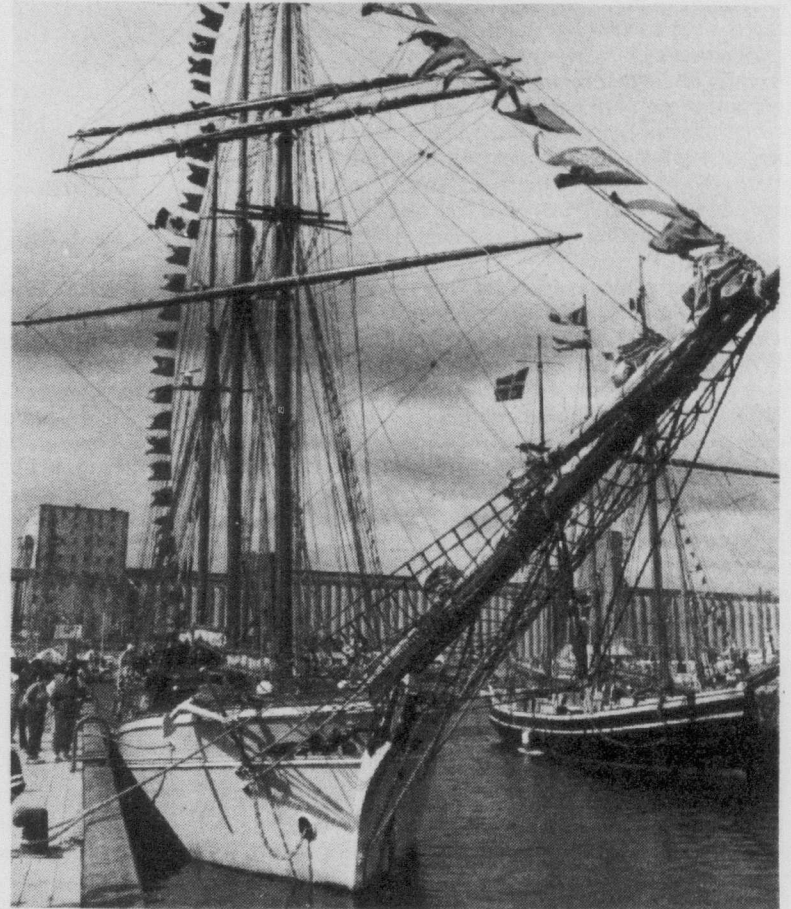
St-Malo still depends on the sea today. Its biggest industry is fishing. Its second biggest is tourism.

BEACHES CROWDED
Thousands of Canadians and Europeans are lured every year by the beautiful beaches, crowded from June to October when there are annual festivals of theatre, folk arts and sports.

Sedate visitors can take formal tours of the aquarium or the nearby oyster beds, while more active tourists can enjoy sailing, underwater diving and windsurfing. A casino and two discos provide the night life.

Air access to St-Malo is possible but limited via London or Paris. The train is the visitor's best bet, with direct summer service from Paris or rail-sea links from southern England via the Channel Islands.

Cartier House is open from June 1 to Sept. 30. Admission fees, with slight variations for fluctuating exchange rates, are about \$2 Cdn for adults and \$1.25 for students. Children under 10 are admitted free.

Indian public transport not for timid

NEW DELHI (CP) — There are two ways to deal with traffic in India: One is to stay home, the other is to take a ride in a scooter taxi.

The latter is the faster way to acclimatize to the mayhem of Indian roads, governed by the Darwinian principle of survival of the fittest.

New Delhi has 40,000 of these scooter-taxi hybrids — known locally as auto-rickshaws — noisily belching exhaust and blithely ignoring any known rules of the road.

Pick your driver carefully, preferably a grizzled old-timer. If he has lasted this long, chances are he's good for a few more rides.

Climb into the back — three people fit at a pinch on the narrow bench seat — and hang on in the maelstrom of vehicles, from bullock carts to Mercedes-Benzes, and assorted donkeys, dogs, cows and camels sauntering the streets.

You've seen those near-collisions in movies where cars miss each other by millimetres? India offers those scenes in real life.

HORROR MOVIE

You can easily find yourself staring in mesmerized horror at a bus bearing down on your tiny three-wheeled vehicle while your driver sticks steadfastly to his

course.

It's all right. It's just like the movies. You don't collide — most of the time.

But you should be aware that, with one per cent of the world's motor vehicles, India records more than six per cent of the world's traffic fatalities.

And Delhi and Bombay are the most dangerous cities in India.

Many have asked why Indians, whose country is founded on principles of non-violence, are so aggressive on the roads. Some note tongue-in-cheek that the figure of the god Shiva, the destroyer, is the almost universal dashboard talisman.

Delhi's battered, overcrowded buses are among the most hazardous ways of getting about, contributing 22 per cent of the city's traffic deaths.

GRAVE DRIVERS

The Delhi Transport Corp. used to be called the Delhi Transport Undertaking, and residents joke that the old name was more suitable.

Its antiquated vehicles, few of which boast working tail-lights or windshield wipers, rumble through the streets, rarely coming to a full halt at bus stops.

Passengers must run to get on — often ending up clinging desperately to door handrails — and have to literally leap off to disembark.

Part of the trouble is that Indian bus drivers consider themselves kings of the road but few other drivers recognize their domain. Undaunted by size, many drivers see buses as a challenge, not a threat.

Drivers of long-distance buses are as unpredictable as their city colleagues, the only difference being that quieter country roads reduce the dangers.

CHOOSE MOVIE

Travellers between cities can choose between the more expensive air-conditioned buses showing Hindi movies and non-air-conditioned buses which have no movie.

Pay extra — Indian buses are inexpensive by North American standards anyway — and take the bus showing the movie. The video screen mercifully conceals the front of the bus for the whole ride, saving you the sight of all those near-misses.

The only indication you'll have that your driver is encountering a "spot of bother" is by the way he constantly leans on the horn, trying to scatter the motorized, pedestrian and animal traffic contesting his right of way.

Passengers can be stranded while the drivers confront each other nose-to-nose. Often, their arguments are settled with fisticuffs.

The movie plays nightly at 6:45 and 9 with a matinee Sunday at 1 p.m.

There's something new called **Project X** on this week at the **Cinemas du Carrefour** in Sherbrooke. **Matthew Broderick**, I am told, stars as an Air Force recruit who doesn't fit in with the rest of the guys in the force, and somehow ends up working on a mysterious project involving chimps. The movie is showing at 12:45, 2:50, 5:10, 7:30 and 9:40 daily.

Burglar starts the evenings off at the **Cinema Princess** in Cowansville this week, at 7:15 nightly. SHERBROOKE — An instructor reads from a little white card to a group of students wearing red and blue hockey sweaters.

"A man has just won a million dollars in a lottery. You have a minute and a half to improvise a sketch."

The students form a huddle, crouched low to the floor, whispering frantically. About 30 seconds later the instructor gives the command to start.

One young man sits on the floor and adopts the persona of a television set reading out the winning lottery numbers, while a girl and another boy play a dim-witted couple trying to figure out where they put their lottery ticket.

With a lot of fumbling and a few technical problems from the television set, the couple eventually figure out they have indeed won a million dollars, only to have their estranged daughter step in the door asking for a handout.

HOSTS CHAMPIONSHIP

This is the stuff that improv theatre is made of, and a whole lot more of it is going on this weekend at the College de Sherbrooke as the school hosts the second annual *Championnat provincial intercollégial d'improvisation*.

The trainer of the school's improv team, **Daniel Bolduc**, says although it's the second championship, this is the first time it's

been truly *nationale*. Last year schools in the west of Quebec couldn't attend.

This year 10 teams from all over the province will take part in competitions today, Saturday and Sunday in the Salle Alfred-Des Rochers of the college.

The College de Sherbrooke team, *la Ligue d'improvisation à l'Os*, came away from last year's competition in Victoriaville with the provincial championship cup.

"We have the firm intention to remain champions in defense of quality improvisation," says Bolduc.

The school has had a great influence on the development of improv theatre at the college level, says Bolduc. "The College de Sherbrooke is quite in the avant-garde because it's the only one that has an animator for improvisation," he says. "Improvisation has become very solid very rapidly in Sherbrooke."

The improv team has been in existence since 1982, created by drama professor **Denis Girard**.

PRACTISES SIX HOURS

The school's improv team, made up of about 15 members, practises six hours a week. It's been that way at the college since 1984.

Larry Michel Demers, an author, director and actor who is honorary president for the championship this year, says the involvement of young people bodes well for the art.

"I think that after 10 years, since the national improvisation league was founded, we're less astonished with the success of improv theatre," he says. "But I think after 10 years we can open the doors to new ways of seeing improvisation."

He encouraged the young people to keep innovating, and to avoid sticking rigidly to the conventions established by the league.

The public may attend any of the competitions, which go on from 6 to 10 p.m. tonight, 1 to 5

p.m. and 7 to 10 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.

A weekend pass is \$7 for students, \$10 for adults. Tickets for a single afternoon or evening are \$2 for students, \$4 for adults.
