The Names in CAPITALS are those of Subscribers and Advertisers.

When hill, lane, place, road, square, or any other such word, does not follow the residence, the word *street*, it is to be understood ; for example : Abgrall Victor, laborer, Champlain 809, means Champlain street 809.

When two numbers are given in connection with one name, and only one street mentioned, the number first given is the place of *business*, and the second the *residence*,—which is always indicated by the letter h.—and both in the same street.

It will be noticed that the names of all members of a firm are added directly after the name of said firm. This, it must be understood, does not interfere with the regular insertion of the same names in their *Alphabetical order*.

☞ In preparing this year's issue we have noted 1791 removals, have erased 1158 and have added 1240 names ; the number of names in this year's Directory being 9609 shows a gain during the past year of 82 names, there being only 9527 in the last edition. At the time of going to press, 10th May, there were still 544 houses unoccupied, equal to 650 lodgings, a fact which will more than account for not a few of the omissions that may be found during the year.
