EXPLANATIONS :

The Names in CAPITALS are those of Subscribers and Advertisers.

ABBREVIATIONS USED IN ALPHABETICAL DIRECTORY : bdg. hse. *boarding house* ; bds. *boards* ; h. *house* ; r. *rear* ; sq. *square*.

The object of the ALPHABETICAL DIRECTORY is to find a person's address knowing his or her name : the object of the STREET DIRECTORY is to find out a person's name by having reference to the No. and Street.

When hill, lane, place, road, square, or any other such word, does not follow the residence, the word *street*, is to be understood ; for example : Abgrall Victor, laborer, Champlain 809, *means* Champlain street 809.

When two numbers are given in connection with one name, and only one street mentioned, the number first given is the place of *business*, and the second the *residence*,—which is always indicated by the letter h.—and both in the same street.

It will be noticed that the names of all members of a firm are added directly after the name of said firm. This, it must be understood, does not interfere with the regular insertion of the same names in their *Alphabetical order*.

Names of residents in houses of ill-fame not being inscribed in the Street Key, will not, as a consequence, be found in the Alphabetical Directory.

There are 1,583 proprietors in the city.

The number of landlords in each ward, including women, are as follows : Champlain 100 ; St John 133 ; Montcalm 242 ; Palace 125 ; St Roch 314 ; St Peter 96 ; St Louis 188 ; Jacques-Cartier 385.

In preparing this year's issue we have noted 1448 removals, have erased 1033 and have added 1291 names ; the number of names in this year's Directory being 9858 shows a gain during the past year of 258 names, there being only 9600 in the last edition. At the time of going to press, 15th May, there were still 120 houses unoccupied, equal to 200 lodgings, a fact which will more than account for the few omissions that may be found during the year.
