

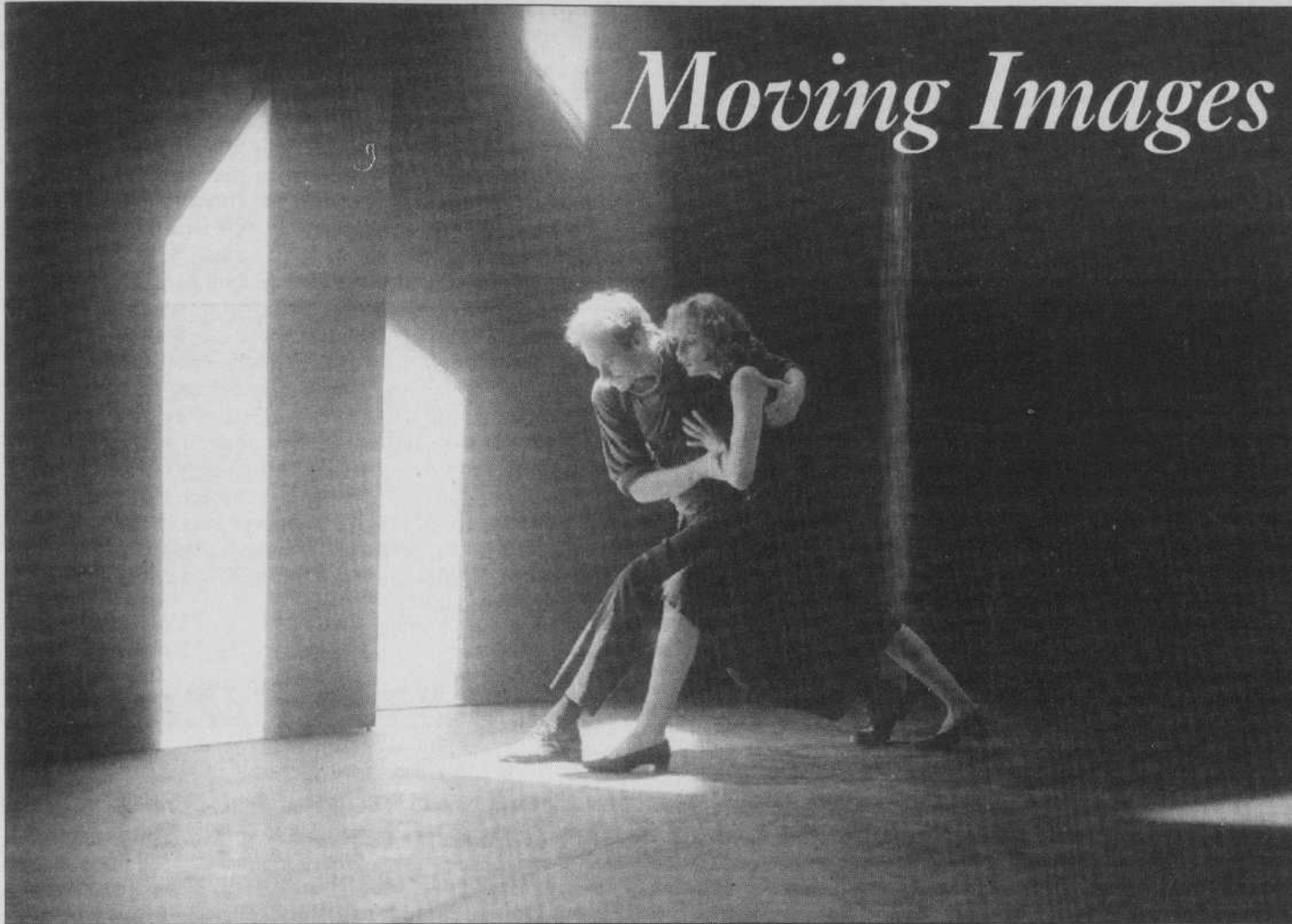

Lovers of the arts are doubly blessed with Jean-Pierre Perreault's visit to Bishop's University for they can view both his visual art and dance.

Les Années de pèlerinage, performed by La Fondation Jean-Pierre Perreault, is inspired by Franz Liszt's second book of Years of Pilgrimage, probably Liszt's most romantic work.

For Perreault, Les Années de pèlerinage is a departure.

"Three things are different for me,"

Perreault said. "I am using a much smaller space than I usually use. In the past I have worked with 12 to 50 dancers and I think it corresponded to a place where I was as a person. I needed a more intimate relationship with the interpreters, and I deal with fewer people and I use classical music."

Liszt's music is something Perreault had been living with for a long time.

"I listened to it for eight years - that piece was in me and somehow I realized it was time to do Les Années de pèlerinage."

Drawing is central to Perreault's

choreography.

"I travel. I always have my notebooks and drawing books and I was on tour in Holland on trains and drawing Dutch trees - from one country to another the trees are so different, especially in Europe where they are manicured. As I was drawing trees, I turned the page and the ink went through and I realized the trunk of the tree was divided into two spaces," said Perreault, demonstrating by means of a drawing how a tree can resemble a building - part of an urban landscape.

Yule Fest Market

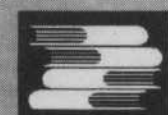

Searching for good Chinese restaurants

A great feast of Chinese food last week in Montreal's Chinatown prompted me to explore similar fare in the Eastern Townships. Unfortunately, I must confess, my search is not complete after the one I tried this week. And since the objective of this column is to direct diners to wonderful dining experiences and not to critique restaurants that don't make the grade, I will continue my search to find the best Chinese restaurant — or restaurants — in the Eastern Townships and readers, too, can feel free to offer their suggestions.

The first Chinese restaurant on my list got the thumbs down for a long list of reasons, many of

which would be the undoing of any good restaurant: The food was generally cold, unappetizing and unattractive.

In contrast to the explosion of taste and colour found at the Chinatown restaurant, this buffet was lacklustre with an overwhelming suggestion there was a mad gingerman in the kitchen.

The meal got off to a rocky start with two choices of soup both proving to be equally bad. The traditional won ton soup was lukewarm with large limp dumplings, while the vegetable soup was uninteresting with a watery tomato base and large chunks of celery. The egg rolls were dried out and heavy on the cabbage.

The buffet itself, though vast and plentiful if you don't care what you're eating, had few saving graces and, except for the tasty ribs, just filled your plate. Most of the 25 or so dishes in the buffet were lukewarm and, at 6:30 p.m., left the impression you had arrived late for supper. The vegetable dishes, while colourful, were overcooked and smothered in a pasty sauce that screamed ginger.

The chef at this particular restaurant should hang his head in shame for resorting to pre-packaged, dried-out chicken fingers that you might pull out of the freezer in a

pinch when the kids have to get to hockey practise. And since when are hot dogs wrapped in bacon considered Chinese cuisine? Or cuisine of any kind? And macaroni doused in soy sauce and sprinkled with bits of meat? Yuk!

Some of the offerings were either too gristly to tackle — like the round things with the mystery gum ball in the middle, or dangerous, like the shrimp still totally encased in its shell.

The desert table didn't warrant more than a glance, failing to even tempt me which is usually about as tough as showing me chocolate or cream. I even passed on the fortune cookie in case it was just more bad news.

In spite of what was obviously a bad dining experience, this restaurant has the potential to turn things around. The environment was clean and pleasant, the buffet is affordable even for families, and the waitresses were courteous, friendly and bilingual. But like so many other restaurants, it seems to have fallen into the trap of preparing and serving mediocre food to mildly dissatisfied diners who have come to accept it as the norm.

Not me. And I will not accept less for you. So my quest for the ultimate Chinese restaurant in the Eastern Townships will continue and when I find it, I'll let you know.

The raffle tickets were sold before and during Circuit des Arts and the proceeds helped finance the event.

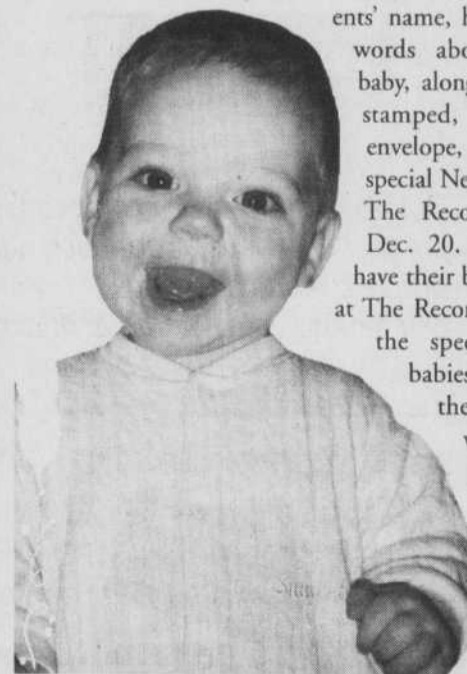

A real Picnic

For anyone looking for a good healthy mix of comedy and drama, Picnic might just be the ticket. William Inge's 1953 Pulitzer Prize-winning play is not only a delight to watch, it has some poignant things to say about how people judge each other based on physical appearance.

Madge Owens (Ellen Gietz) is a very pretty girl and she is constantly lambasted with compliments everywhere she goes. As a result, she has come to see herself as just a shadow, someone who might not even be real. This is constantly reiterated by her overbearing mother, Flo (Sara Brady), and her boyfriend, Alan Seymour (John Rasmussen.) Even Madge's little sister, Millie (Megan Brayford), is a constant reminder of her physical beauty, although for Millie, these comments come more as jealous snubs

than outright admiration.

The play's action revolves around a picnic the Owens' are attending and the arrival of Hal Carter (Nick Haraszty), a boarder who has only recently arrived in the neighbourhood and is staying with the Owens' next door neighbour, Helen Potts (Treyse Farrant.)

Hal is a good looking young man who, like Madge, has been taught through his life that his physical appearance is his most valuable asset. Unlike Madge, however, who draws into shyness, Hal tells wild stories and becomes the showman everyone expects him to be. When he and his old school buddy Alan are getting reacquainted, he tells an outrageous story about going to Hollywood and getting rejected because of his bad teeth and then getting robbed in the back of a Cadillac by a couple of martini-drinking, gun-toting "babes."

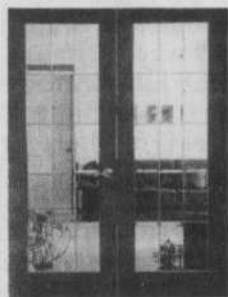

Mandragore creates a lovable local monster

Sutton's Mandragore Theatre will perform *Frankenstein*, an original play by Patrick Campbell.

The author, who is also the owner, producer and director of the theatre, said the comedy is based loosely on the Mary Shelley classic. The play follows the exploits of Dr. Frankenstein and his side-kick Igor as they pilfer a brain to give life to their own creation.

Campbell says his monster, unlike that of Shelley and its many Hollywood incarnations, is lovable. He is also a local.

"Dr. Frankenstein creates the monster

in Sutton, near Mountain View Cemetery," said Campbell, who also stars as the demented Doc. Soon he and Igor (Larry Hastings Jr.) discover the brain they have given their monster (Lynden Gilker) is not quite up to surgical standards. When they create a second, female monster (Marie-Josée Samson), the two monsters do what any respectable newly undead would do - run off together, leaving Frankenstein and Igor to ponder the nature of their acts.

This isn't an easy task to pull off because a theatre audience tends to believe that all characters on stage are "telling the truth" whenever they speak their lines, no matter how preposterous the story may be.

Haraszy pulled his lies off because he knew there was an underlying pathos to his character, the desire to be accepted and the further, albeit untested, knowledge that the 'Hal' people liked was the fake movie star and not the real 'Hal.'

If anything, *Picnic* relates Shakespeare's advice "Know thyself." When Hal is around, Alan tells everyone of his daring escapades on the old school football field. When he isn't around, Alan paints a much truer, and sadder, picture: Although Hal was a phenomenal athlete, the other kids at school didn't think much of him. They found him to be an arrogant child who didn't study because he believed he could make it through life on his looks.

It was perfectly natural that Madge and Hal would be attracted to each other. Watching them fall for each other was a horrible tug-of-war match in the souls of the audience. We see how much the slightly nerdy Alan loves Madge and we do want him to be happy, but we also see that Madge's needs are not being met.

When she and Hal share a moment on the porch, Hal finally comes clean. He admits he's been fabricating tales about his life and that he never was a champion diver as he claimed to be.

In reality, he's spent time in reformatory schools and was disowned by his family. Not exactly a spectacular upbringing, but he

was telling the truth and in telling the truth, he became real. When he and Madge kiss and then move on to touching, we feel bad about the repercussions these actions will carry, but we sure can't blame them for what they're about to do.

Picnic featured a wonderful supporting cast, too, including Megan Brayford, who all but stole the show as Madge's slightly rebellious artistic sister who develops a crush on Hal, and Juanita Lauzé as the slightly unstable schoolteacher Rosemary Sydney, who is giddily dancing with joy one moment and then angrily telling Hal to grow up and that he won't be young forever the next.

The second act opened with a scene between Rosemary and her boyfriend, Howard Bevans (Mark Scott). We understand the couple has just consummated their relationship at the picnic and now Rosemary wants to get married. She's no spring chicken, she confesses, and she wants to settle down before she becomes an old maid. The electricity between the two actors in this scene borders on perfection. We know from Inge's ingenious script that Howard Bevans is a lech who surely isn't ready to settle down yet. Watching him try to get away while Rosemary presses him for a definite answer was truly one of the most powerful moments of the play.

Director Ann Hodges has done a remarkable job of bringing this wonderful little play to life and, in doing so, asking theatregoers not to judge our fellow brothers and sisters because of the way we look.

With the creation of scenery, lighting and music, Perreault prepares to meet the dancers.

"I never prepare one movement without the dancers. I choose the dancers and I have no idea what's going to happen. If I don't have the dancers in front of me, I can't create one movement."

Intimacy is important in this work which includes couples performing duets.

"There are three different couples. There is a long duet to Liszt

in the first one which is in a very urban setting. It's very passionate but contained," he said. "In the second couple, the girl is barefoot and there are more trees. It is more sensuous and more physical probably. The third couple is enigmatic. Some people see them as a young couple, others see them as an older couple but I don't try to define what they are."

Perreault also draws on the audience.

"My work talks about life and the audience's life. Dance talks to the memory of the audience - physical memory, the unconscious, the subconscious. I al-

ways try to leave a little tattoo on the audience because that's what dance will do - talk to the physical memory, the visual memory."

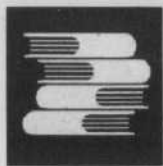

First Rabbit's art naif paintings inspired by song

'The Legend of the First Rabbit' - Galerie Jeannine Blais

The book 'The Legend of the First Rabbit', a beautifully illustrated Mi'kmaq legend of art naif paintings by Lise Poirier, had its genesis in a musical composition.

The Orford Arts Centre runs a summer institute of teacher training and student activities with Studea Musica.

"Two years ago, Mary Gardiner was the composer in residence," explained Gilles Comeau, producer of the bilingual CD that accompanies the book. "She did the piece for the children during that week. It is part of a long tradition of narration with a musical story, the most famous being 'Peter and the Wolf'.

"A year ago we got the project together and started recording with a trio of Ottawa musicians. All three are well-known and have performed extensively across the country. We had a very small budget and the musi-

cians did it from the heart. Robert Cram (flautist), is part of the music department of University of Ottawa, Julian Armour (cellist), is artistic director of the Ottawa Chamber Music Festival and Elaine Keillor (piano) is one of the most knowledgeable experts on Canadian music."

The whimsical, uncomplicated pictures of Lise Poirier mark the transformation of rabbit from a chubby fellow with a bushy squirrel-like tail and a brown coat with straight legs into a lean, powder-puff-tailed creature with legs suited for hopping.

When rabbit saves the prospective bridegroom from a fall into a pit, keeps the wicked forest fairy from marrying the bride and helps the bride with her wedding, he is rewarded with a white coat to wear in winter.

Mireille Blais explained the participation of Galerie Jeannine Blais.

"We were approached by Studea Musica who made the CD. I took photocopies of the story and sent it to 10 artists and I asked people to make a painting to show how they see the rabbit. I received six paintings. I sent them to Studea Musica in Ottawa and they chose Lise Poirier. On

our side, we chose Lise Poirier and I called her back and said 'If you can paint 14 paintings, we will do the book.'"

Poirier is new to painting, but not to art.

"Lise Poirier worked in clay for many years," Blais said. "She's well-known for that, but she developed a sore back and couldn't do it anymore. Five years ago, she took up painting. We have had her in our gallery for two years. She's not very known, but I think that she will be. She's a hard worker and her work is very good."

The bilingual CD is done in the melodious tones of narrator Jim Bradford and Sylvain Landry.

Rabbit is described by all three instruments. The cello delineates his physical appearance and the flute tracks his motion. The wicked forest fairy is described by ominous piano tones. Deep cello and piano tones depict the man's descent into the deep hole. The final dance music reflects rabbit's hopping movements.

"Infected people are like the 38-year-old man who complained to his parents, 'I've just left my third failed marriage, I can't hold onto a job, I'm in debt up to my ears and will have to declare personal bankruptcy. Where did you go wrong?'"

In his two decades of work with thousands of people, Clemmer said he has found "it's very easy for entire groups to become infected with the 'Victimitis Virus.' Many meetings or family gatherings then turn into 'primal scream therapy' or 'blame storming' sessions around why a deadline

was missed, results are down or a family member behaved so poorly. The entire group can end up spending a lot of time in 'Pity City.' That can be a healthy place to visit to blow off steam or air frustrations, but it's a toxic place to live."

With 20,000 copies of "Growing the Distance" in print since its publication this spring, Clemmer hopes his latest will become a runaway best-seller.

"Most Canadian books never reach the best-seller level of 5,000 or more copies sold," said Stephen Quick, Vice President of Marketing at Stoddart and General Publishing. "This book's timely focus on personal growth and taking greater control of our lives is clearly hitting a nerve."

SHADOW OF DOUBT

Randal Kleiser's *Shadow of Doubt* is about a sexual scandal that results in a crime scene. The film is strangely reminiscent of the Clinton/Lewinsky and O.J. Simpson trials.

Actress fights feelings of worthlessness

Angelina Jolie should have been riding high after her triumph in the cable movie *Gia*.

After all, she had won both a Golden Globe Award and a Screen Actors Guild Award last year for her lacerating portrayal of the bisexual, drug-addicted supermodel *Gia Carangi*.

Instead, the experience left her awash in self-doubt.

"It happened so fast," she says now. "I got recognition for a film that was very, very important to me and I gave it everything I had."

"But I got really scared. I looked at the story of her life and how she felt exposed and not having that life mean much... of her going home alone at the end of the day not knowing who she was and not having much that was solid in her life. I was beginning to feel that too. I saw a lot of similarities between us."

It wasn't that she was living *Carangi's* self-destructive lifestyle. It was simply that, like the person she had portrayed with such honesty, she felt "worthless."

It's hard to equate this Angelina Jolie with the forceful, sexually insinuating character she played with such devastating effect in the recent *Pushing Tin*. There is also her current powerful performance in *The Bone Collector* as a courageous cop. But the 24-year-old actress insists she was an emotional mess after finishing *Gia*.

"I felt completely invaluable and not

worth very much and not connected to very much that mattered. I didn't feel of any use to anybody."

She knew that neither friends nor family - her father is actor Jon Voight - could really help. And her marriage to actor Jonny Lee Miller was in trouble. She took a few months off from acting and went to film school in Los Angeles to learn more about the business. She realized that ultimately work was her salvation. "During that time, I really learned to appreciate how lucky I am when I'm on a film set."

And always, she was guided by the dictum that her destiny is her own responsibility.

"I was dealing with what life was going to be about for me. There was a time when I was searching for what makes us happy, for what fills us up. I thought it was going to be love. I thought it was going to be security and being able

to afford things... and I suddenly realized this was nothing. I was going to sleep kind of empty a lot."

Her positive reviews for her performance as Billy Bob Thornton's seductive wife in *Pushing Tin* come only months after she bowled over critics for her work in *Playing By Heart* as a kooky but sensitive extrovert who ensnares Ryan Phillippe. Now there's *The Bone Collector*, in which she plays a New York cop who joins forces with a quadriplegic investigator played by Denzel Washington to track down a serial killer. And the winter will see her opening in *Girl Interrupted* opposite Winona Ryder.

Yet, if you ask her how she managed to regain her confidence in her abilities, she surprises you by saying she still hasn't managed to do that. She says she has accepted the fact that she doesn't have that confidence, but that there's no solution if you just "kind of stop living." So she has taken the view that if she can't change her emotional situation, she must change her attitude to that situation.

Jolie's work gives her a sense of purpose - so much that she doesn't have much of a private life. She matter-of-factly notes that her marriage to Miller recently ended in divorce. "I'm too difficult to be around," she says candidly.

"I don't have many people in my life. I am pretty alone."
