## Love is theme of operatic concert

*Sabina Chambers to sing at Haskell*

Love reigns supreme at the Haskell Opera House in Rock Island. Lyric soprano Sabina Chambers will perform operatic arias and songs centering around the classic theme of love.

The Montrealer who has a summer home on Lake Memphremagog will be accompanied by pianist Pamela Reimer, a Plattsburgh professor who performs frequently in Montreal and upstate New York, in a concert titled *Viva Amore*.

Selections will include works by Mozart, Bellini, Duparc and Dvorzak.

Chambers, who has performed as a soloist with the Light Opera of Manhattan and with the chorus of the Montreal Symphony Orchestra, said the intimacy of the Haskell Opera House appealed to her as the perfect place to sing about love.

"I've done enormous recitals before and worked with many vocal coaches," said Chambers. "I wanted to pick music I truly loved - music suited to my voice. I was going through the list and I noticed there was a thread running through. These are my favourites. They are truly the staple for a lyric soprano."

She said the Haskell is like a miniature version of the Boston Opera House.

The second half of the program is dedicated to the French repertoire, which she said "lends itself well to the lyric voice. It is very legato - very smooth and very lyrical."

Performing for an intimate audience can be a challenge.

"You have to establish a rapport almost immediately with the audience. You have to take them on a journey without the necessary sets, costume changes and all the things in an operatic setting. It involves a lot more playing make-believe. In a sense, it's just you and the audience and you have to be more focussed on the music and on the words. If you're singing an aria, you've got to keep the storyline going."

Strong in storyline are the French arts songs by Fauré.

## Trois Lacs to host cardboard boat race

Sponsored by the local Trois Lacs Preservation committee, the event calls upon the bravest and most reckless amongst us to build a boat out of nothing but cardboard, glue and string then sail it.

Given cardboard's propensity to buckle when wet, the winner of the regatta will probably be the last sailor still afloat at or near the finish line.

# Many treasures found in film festival line-up

The wait is over - the line-up of films for L'International du Cinéma de l'Estrie, slated to roll Sept. 7 to 17 at Rock Forest's Cinéma 9, has been unveiled.

Martine Côté, who took over the reins of director barely a month ago, was proud to announce the selected "honour roll" of films at a news conference Tuesday.

"The theme this year for the festival is 'Le monde en vue'," she said, "and our selection of films reflects this."

The line-up includes 23 films representing 13 countries on four continents, but is weighed heavily towards France, with seven films (plus one that is a co-production between France and Poland), and Quebec, with six. Two each from the United States and Great Britain, and one each from Brazil, Russia, Israel, Australia and China make up the remainder of the list.

Although festival organizers originally mentioned that six or seven of the films would be in English, of the 23 this year there are only three, down from five last year.

Fourteen of the films are in their original French version, and have no subtitles, while two English-language films, one from the U.S. and the other from Australia, will be dubbed into French. The other four films, in Yiddish, Russian, Mandarin, and the co-production in French and Yiddish, will be shown in their original languages with French subtitles.

"We take what's available," said Hélène Deslauriers, director of communications. "(Films in English) simply aren't available from Quebec distributors."

Nevertheless, film buffs will find many treasures in this festival line-up. Opening the festivities on Sept. 7 is *Le*

*gout des autres*, directed by Agnes Jaoui - a film that set records in France.

"It's very funny," said Côté. "It shows how you can see your neighbour in a completely different light."

The much-awaited second film by Quebec director Denis Villeneuve will close the festival on Sunday, Sept. 17. *Maelström* is the story of "a young woman, 25 years old, who hits a fiftyish fish monger with her car and abandons him on the road, but life gives her a chance to atone for her act."

*Le gout des autres* and *Maelström* are both featured at the Montreal International Film Festival.

Sandwiched between these two

"must-sees" are offerings of comedy, drama and romance, as well as political and social commentaries.

From Great Britain, in the original English version, the festival offers *Fish and Chips* (the title is the translation from the French version of the British hit *East is East*). This drama/comedy tells the story of a Pakistani father, married to an English-Protestant, who tries to arrange the marriages of his sons, only "to have the whole situation turn to vinegar," said Deslauriers.

*Time Code*, directed by Mike Figgis and to be shown in its original English version, offers a novel twist on filmmaking. In the film, the screen is divid-

ed into four parts, projecting four different stories at the same time. The entire movie was filmed "off the cuff," with the actors and actresses improvising their dialogue in front of the camera.

All the films will have rating categories, so parents can decide what's appropriate for the kids. Deslauriers recommended *The Cup* as "the most suitable for the whole family." A collaboration between filmmakers in Australia and Bhutan, a small country near the Himalayas, the film deals with a group of young Tibetan monks who are enthralled with soccer. For the World Cup, they try to convince their superior to rent a television to watch the final match.

Three extra events, special to the festival this year, are:

- an exhibition of the tools of the trade used by filmmaker Aleksandr Petrov in the making of his Oscar-winning short animated film, *The Old Man and the Sea*, at Sherbrooke's Musée des beaux-arts Sept. 13 to 24;

- a talk on filmmaking by Daniel LaJeunesse, from Télé-Québec, on Sept. 8 at le Bar Loubards; and

- a discussion by sociologist/director Louise Vandelac of her film *Le Clonage* immediately following its showing at the Presse Boutique Café on Sept. 12.

Prices for the festival are \$7 per film (\$5 for students) or five films for \$25 with the "international card" pass. By using their Mondex card, patrons can save \$1 on each ticket, or \$3 off the pass.

The film festival schedule will be available beginning Sept. 1 in more than 75 different locales in the Sherbrooke area, including Cinéma 9 and the Éva-Sénécal library. # Famous parents a double-edged sword for Hudson

The other night, Kate Hudson was in a preview screening of her new movie, *Almost Famous*, and found it difficult to tune out the chattering of the couple sitting behind her.

When Hudson made her first appearance on the screen in the role of a bewitching rock groupie named Penny Lane, her neighbours became even more animated.

"The girl behind me was saying: 'Oh my God! She looks just like her mother!'" As an audience member, Hudson wanted to turn around and say: "Hey! Keep quiet!" But as the daughter of Goldie Hawn and one of the stars of the film, she decided that risking recognition from such a talkative fan would be a very bad idea. So she kept silent and tried to concentrate on her performance.

"Besides, what can I do in those circumstances?" she laughs.

After all, she's certainly not embarrassed or ashamed to be Goldie Hawn's kid. "I love her more than anything, so if there's anybody I have to look like, I'd want it to be her."

Furthermore, despite a striking resemblance to her famous parent, particularly in profile, the 21-year-old Hudson is managing to define her own identity on screen. It happened in 200 *Cigarettes*, in her first big starring role as a daffy virgin who falls under the spell of a womanizing Jay Mohr. And it happens again in *Almost Famous*, filmmaker Cameron Crowe's affectionate valentine to early '70s rock music. Crowe, whose previous movie was *Jerry Maguire*, thinks Hudson delivers an astonishing performance as the leader of a devoted band of groupies known as "band aids."

"Kate was a revelation," Crowe says. "She possesses this great combination of sexiness, charm, great confidence and even greater vulnerability and... she lights up a room just by entering it."

Co-star Billy Crudup, who plays a volatile musician in the movie which opens Sept. 15, echoes Crowe. "This is a role set up for an actress to fail with - it's that difficult," Crudup says. "So to play this part with such a sense of grace is a remarkable accomplishment."

When Hudson's lithe, denim-clad figure sweeps into the interview room, you're conscious first of her natural elegance.

Then you take in the honey-blond hair cascading, a la Goldie, down either side of a friendly but reflective face. There's the sense of a person at ease with herself and her career, with the special challenge of asserting her own persona while being the daughter of Hawn and the stepdaughter of Kurt Russell.

Hudson's real father is rock musician

Bill Hudson, with whom she has only recently been reconciled. She matter-of-factly refers to Russell, who has lived with Hawn for 17 years, as her dad. She feels she has been remarkably fortunate in her upbringing because she was never allowed to assume she enjoyed a privileged status because her parents were celebrities.

"I feel privileged and blessed, because for any kid who grows up with money, especially when you're little and don't understand things, there is a point when you think you can get away with anything. It's inevitable and parents have to be prepared for it."

Neither Kate nor her three brothers were allowed to nurse notions of superiority.

"They went away really fast. We were simply told it was not acceptable." And if either parent brandished a wooden spoon, that was a

sign to the youngsters that they were going too far.

Russell is a particularly stern disciplinarian - "he's the one who puts his foot down" - but Hawn has her own methods of dealing with troublesome children. She makes clear that she's disappointed in their conduct, and then puts them in the deep freeze by refusing to talk to them. "You end up saying: 'Please don't do that. I'm so sorry. I really am a great person!'"

Some show business parents try to discourage their children from following in their footsteps - but not Hawn and Russell. "Why would they be op-

posed to something they've done their whole lives and loved?" Hudson asks. "Besides, they're parents, and parents should always support what their children want to do, as long as you make a 100 per cent effort."

Hudson is sporting a five-carat diamond these days, but she says it's not an engagement ring. "It does say that I'm in love and want to spend my life with somebody." That "somebody" is musician Chris Robinson and "this is more a ring he got me that I accepted."

Taking a cue from the unmarried Hawn and Russell, whose relationship is one of the longest and most durable in Hollywood, Hudson says she doesn't really believe in the formality of a wedding. "For me, if I ever get married, it will be more of a celebration of the unity of the couple. I don't think I need a piece of paper saying that I'm married. All I know is that I've met somebody and because of that things are greater and much more powerful and I'm the happiest I've ever been. That's the most important thing, I think. Besides, my parents have always said that the moment you stop having fun is when you start re-evaluating your relationship."

### Painter Denis Palmer wins grand public prize

The results are in. The second annual Eastern Townships and Vermont Art Competition at the Frederick Amsden Gallery in Stanstead brought hundreds of art admirers in to look at the works of 72 artists and vote on their favourites.

Josiane Caillet, the gallery's director, addressed a crowd of 50 people at a reception where they lingered again over the artwork.

"The results were extremely tight this year. Even the last day of the competition made a difference," said Caillet, who first announced the winners of the prizes in the jury category.

The four-member jury was comprised of: Michel Villeneuve, an artist

who studied at the École des beaux-arts in Paris; Richard Dube, former director of collections at Quebec's Museum of Civilization; Josiane Caillet, art historian and the gallery's co-director; and Matthew Farfan, municipal

councillor in charge of culture and gallery co-director.

First prize in the jury category was awarded to sculptor George Foster for the unusual 'Moles in Beer.' Denis Palmer's watercolour 'Bennett's Auction' received second place and third prize went to Georges Constantin for his 'Fossil Fish' sculpture. An honourable mention was made for Suzanne Therrien's 'Poisson et murène.'

Foster was pleased to see an interest in his whimsical work.

"I think I'll continue to do more of that fun stuff," he said. "I'm not always sure if everybody wants it. I did a teapot a few years ago being devoured by caterpillars. They'd been chewing on it for 20 years."

"These are miniature stories within songs based on poems by Verlaine. To sing these, one has to have the scene in mind. You definitely need a lot of imagination. You can't fudge it. In a smaller setting, you can't hide behind the scenery," said Chambers.

Though this is the first time Chambers and Reimer have worked together, they have hit it off.

"Pamela's a lovely person and a very good pianist who has accompanied a lot of singers," Chambers said. "It is not actually easy to find the right person to

work with. You need someone really tuned in to voice and phrasing. She's been wonderful for that."

Included in the program is Handel's "Ombramaifu."

"I try to think of the setting and time of year. This happens to be a lovely aria for the country," said Chambers. "Also, one cannot perform at the border without doing a few Gershwin selections."

The singer plans to pursue auditions in Montreal and Europe. Her family, which includes two young children, will accompany her on her travels.

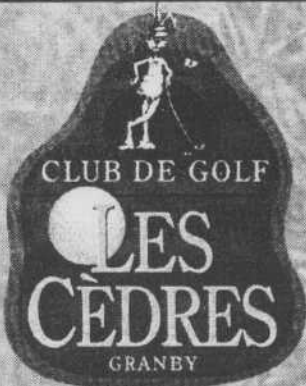

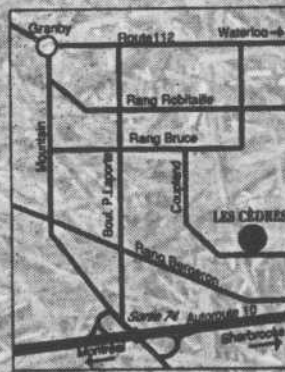

## Girl Interrupted courageous and witty in the telling

*Writer bares soul to share experience*

People will know of the book *Girl Interrupted* by Susanna Kaysen from the recent movie featuring a standout performance by Angelina Jolie as Lisa. The movie narrative is more fleshed out and less anecdotal as it tells of Kaysen's committal to a private mental hospital following on the heels of an overdose of Aspirin and alcohol.

In 1967, according to Kaysen's book, she phoned her boyfriend, swallowed 150 Aspirin and went off to run some errands for her mother at the local supermarket where she was found slumped over the meat counter after the police had been called. Wryly, she comments on how this incident made her become a vegetarian. On a later trip to a therapist, at the age of 18, after a 20-minute session, Kaysen signed the papers to be committed and was packed off in a taxi to McLean Hospital - an exclusive Massachusetts mental hospital which had housed Robert Lowell, Sylvia Plath,

James Taylor and his brother and sister and Ray Charles.

Kaysen's story is an ambiguous one - and it is the ambiguity of the story that is touching.

It is not a simple story of - "Who is to know who's crazy and who's sane?" Though Kaysen obsesses over the fact that she was committed after such a short interview, she tells of serious breaks with reality, terrible sadness and a suicide attempt.

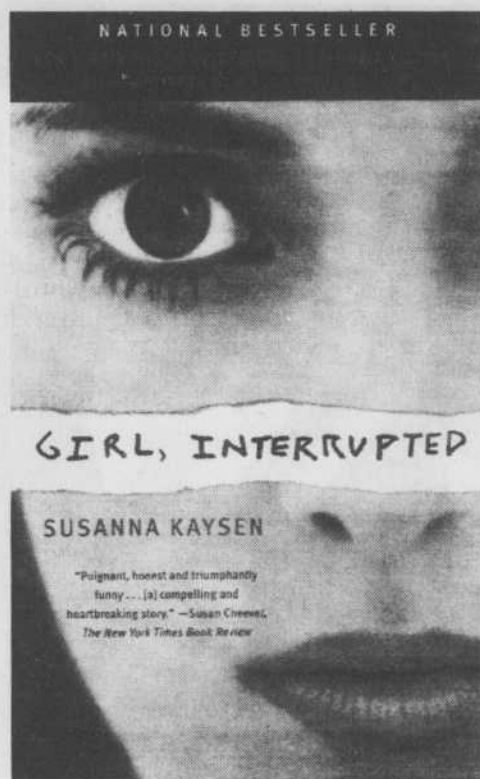
What clearly saw Kaysen through the ordeal and allows her to write about it with compassion and honesty is her sense of humour.

Though diagnosed with a borderline personality disorder, Kaysen made many friends in McLean and tells their stories, anecdotally intertwined with her own.

Even a progressive mental hospital is full of limitations.

In a medium security ward, trouble-making patients could be locked down and the threat of being bumped to maximum security always loomed over their heads.

Kaysen's lean prose is punctuated by



her actual psychiatric records.

Accessing the records is a bold move. They serve as testimony to her actual ill-

ness yet are also juxtaposed to add humour to the narrative. Kaysen muses on the safety of the mental hospital while around them civil rights protests and anti-Vietnam demonstrations took place.

In the movie and the book, we are drawn to the character Lisa - diagnosed as a sociopath, she rarely sleeps or eats, busts out of the hospital regularly and is full of schemes and ideas.

Lisa befriends another patient named Lisa Cody who tries to emulate her. Her manipulations in her new relationship reveals her true lack of feeling.

When Kaysen left the hospital, after an initial need to talk about her illness, the author experienced a need to distance herself from the whole experience. She wanted to move on. And she moved on very successfully. But this piece of Susanna Kaysen, where she revisits the sad puzzle of her adolescent life, stands as testimony for heartbroken people everywhere.

## Experience weaves tale of trailing in father's footsteps

Self-conscious, rambling and carrying on three or four narratives at the same time, *Experience* has much of the charm, wit and pathos of

Martin Amis' novels. This time, however, Amis writes of his own life as a writer and son of famed English novelist Kingsley Amis with real affection, honesty

and hilarity.

Like his father Kingsley, Martin is one of the bad boys of English literature. He is capable of writing satire in days which would seem to have rendered satire obsolete. At the heart of every one of Amis' novels is a serious look at modern society.

Unfortunately, I have not read Kingsley Amis' novels which include the classic 'Lucky Jim', 'The Anti-Death League' and 'The Old Devils', a fact which Amis would no doubt have hated (an anecdote of Martin taking an ailing Kingsley into hospital with an ambulance attendant better versed in the works of the son than the father). However, his deep understanding of his father as a person and the way it is reflected in his work will send me towards his novels.

Characterized by a series of long footnotes, the narrative circles and swirls, at times inchoately, at times with unexpected symmetry, this is the story of a father with great opinions, passion and humour and of a son who wished to follow in his footsteps. In a series of letters to his father and new stepmother, peppered with the callow literary awakenings of youth, one gets a sense of the awkwardness of growing up in the spotlight and the desire to be completed.

Martin Amis' characterization of both his mother and Jane Howard, who became the boy's loving stepmother is

interesting and fair. Amis dwells on the pain of his own divorce, but does not go into particulars. The English press seems to have done its own coverage on Martin's divorce, as well as discovering that he is the father of a grown daughter from a brief affair.

Throughout the book, Amis is haunted by the death of his cousin Lucy Partington, who disappeared at a bus stop in 1973. Only recently, was it discovered that she was one of the victims of the vicious Fredrick West killings. Amis is clear that, though he loved his cousin and misses her, he cannot imagine this having happened to a sister or daughter.

His grief for her is partly the grief of the novelist who absorbs things to look evil and injustice right in the face.

An inordinate amount of time is spent on Amis' grueling dental surgeries, also well-covered by the English press, which had a field day pummeling Amis for his huge advance for 'The Information'. The account of the tooth problems is, in spite of itself, surprisingly funny. Much is known of the infamous rift between Julian Barnes and Amis' English agent (and Barnes' wife) Pat Kavanagh. For his part Amis is saddened by the split and brief in his response.

As full-bodied as any fiction and like Martin Amis' fiction, 'Experience' is by turns hilarious, exhilarating and maddening.

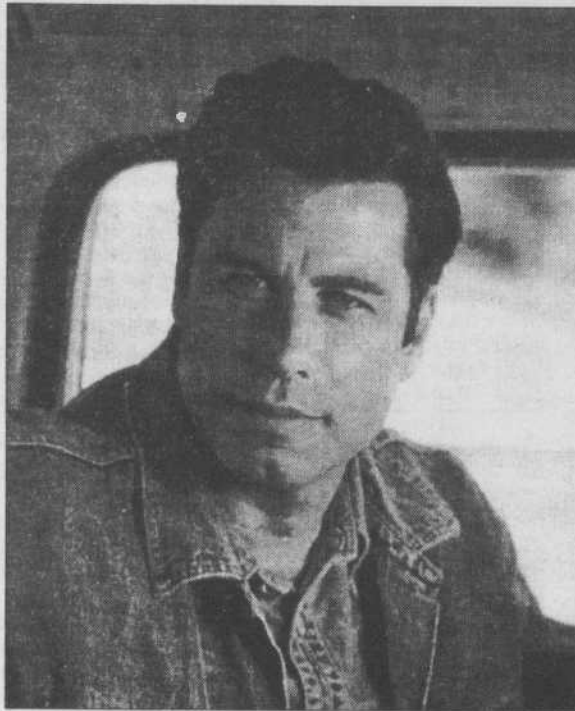
