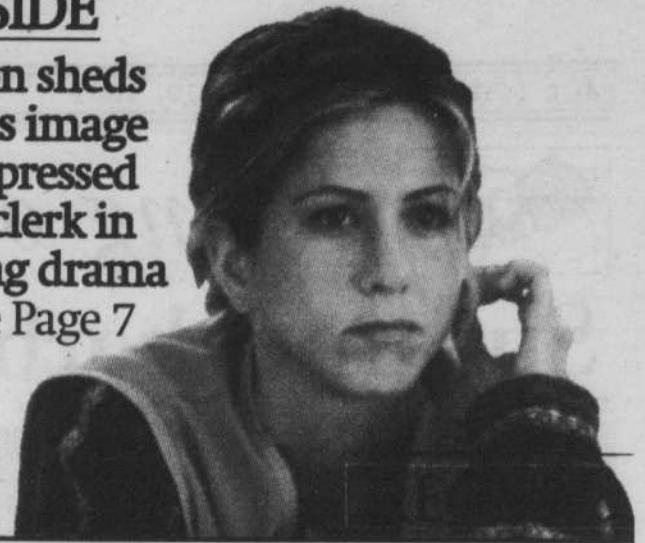

Veteran actor makes Piggery home

Frank Fontaine couldn't resist opportunity to play Malvolio

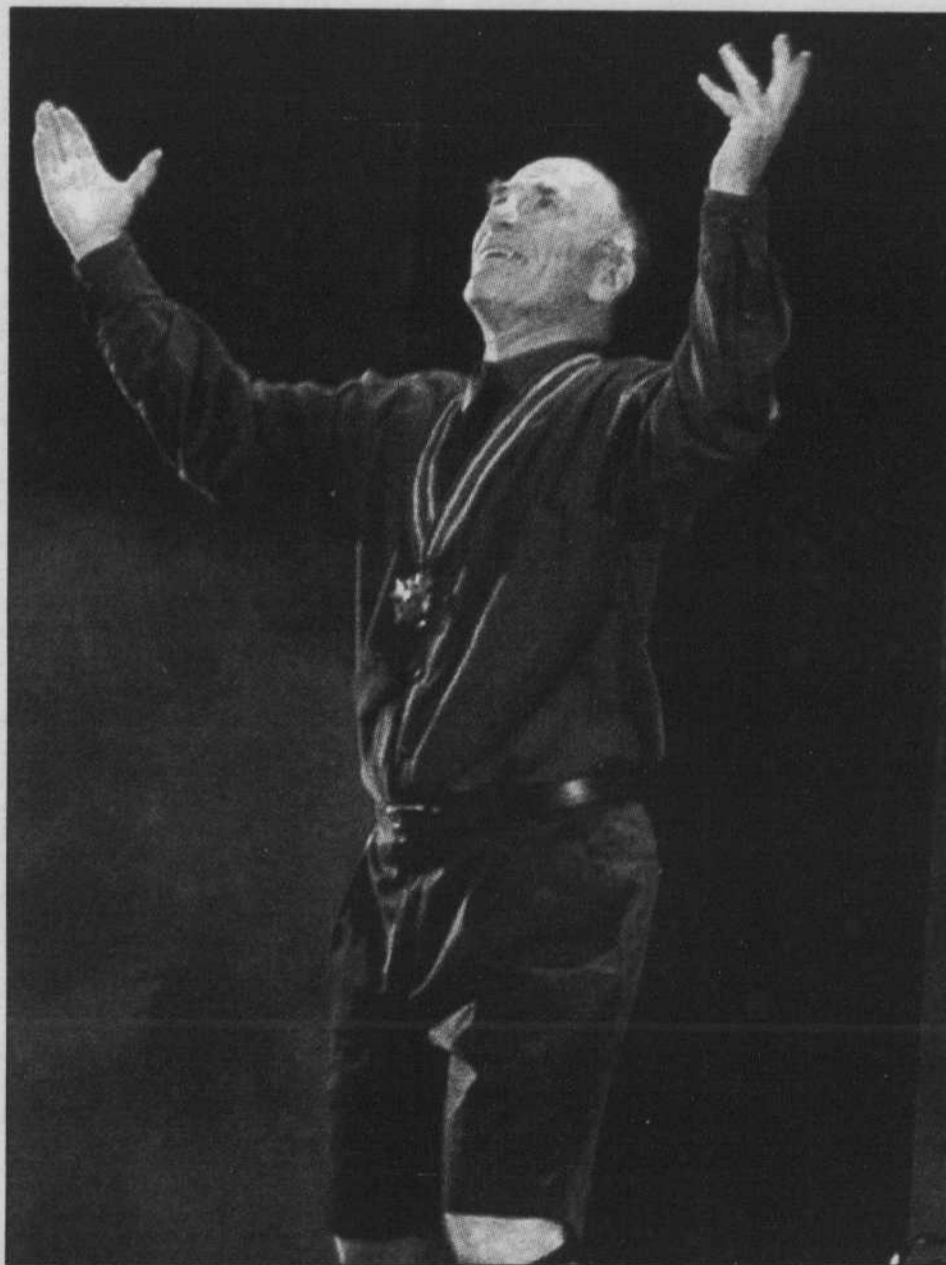
The acting talent of Montreal native Frank Fontaine has taken him all around the world. When asked about his aspirations as a youth, Fontaine confessed: "I always wanted to be an actor, from my high school days outside New York City as a Broadway groupie, to the boat ticket to England and The Royal Academy of Dramatic Art in London."

That unfailing passion paid off, leading him to many accomplishments: an estimated 70 film roles, and innumerable stage productions in New York, Toronto, Paris and Montreal. Fontaine spent much of his childhood in the Townships, raised in West Shefford, now called Bromont. Now it seems that the talent which has taken him so far and wide has brought him full circle: resettled in Bromont and playing two roles at North Hatley's reviving Piggery Theatre.

Although he has, in a sense, started from the beginning again, at 65 he is by no means drawing his career to a close. "An actor never retires," he observed. "If somebody wants you, you usually turn up. At some point the business or the fates retire you."

Of late, many in Hollywood have wanted him, and he has appeared in such blockbusters as *The Sum of All Fears* and *The Bone Collector*. He is also grateful for his recent opportunities to share screen time with some of his idols, including Marlon Brando and Paul Newman.

Summer barbecue is site of latest gender war

Move over men, more women are stepping up to the grill

It's not a takeover yet, but every summer, more and more women step up to the grill. A key reason is they want to improve the quality of their outdoor meals.

"He let everything cook until it was dead," Felice Levy of Montreal said, recalling a barbecue where a man blackened the food into charcoal-crust submission.

"Men do everything over high heat," Janet Rioux of Notre Dame de l'Île Perrot said. "It's hilarious to watch them grill because there's no such thing as reducing the heat, and they keep the lid open so everything is burned on the outside and the inside isn't properly cooked."

"High heat and that's it," was Joaquina Tino's description of the grill style used by her husband, Robert Hale. "He doesn't have the patience," she said, adding that, besides using overly high heat, she's noticed that men tend to forget to turn the food as it grills.

The way men barbecue is one of the last macho acts women tolerate, Levy said. "I would never have let the food get that cooked," she said of the burned shards of meat she's been offered by male grill cooks.

Men are still in the majority at the grill, according to a survey of 1,508 men and women by a grill manufacturer. But while 66 per cent of the men did most of the outdoor cooking in their households, the number of women handling this chore has risen to 34 per cent, up from 29 per cent last year.

"Women are starting to take control of the tongs," said Theresa Stahl of Weber-Stephen Products, the company that commissioned Leger Marketing to do the study in April.

Women surveyed said they like to grill because they consider food cooked this way to be healthier because no added fat is required. Also, using the barbecue means they avoid heating up their kitchens in hot weather.

Montreal female barbecuers interviewed recently said they pay close attention to the nature of the food they are grilling and expose it to just the right amount of heat from the coals. Marinating is a favourite technique.

Levy immerses beef in a marinade and even freezes it in the marinade so it's ready to thaw and grill. She particularly likes to marinate salmon and uses a favourite commercial dressing (Golden Dip's Low Fat Honey Mustard). Her easy method is to enclose a 4-pound (2-kilogram) fillet of salmon with the dressing in a large, resealable plastic bag; refrigerate it overnight; then bring to room temperature, set in a grill basket and grill at high heat, covered, five minutes a side.

Rioux uses either a spice rub or a marinade to flavour meat for grilling. Her pork tenderloin recipe calls for a rub and is served with a ginger sauce. She marinates chicken breasts in a mixture of mustard, balsamic vinegar and maple syrup. Both meats are grilled under cover of the grill's hood. That way, she explained, the meat is cooked through and stays moist and flavours develop. Also, Rioux finds the food ends up staying hot longer.

Tino agrees. One of her favourite grill recipes is from her Filipino background - brochettes made of pork that she marinates overnight in a richly flavoured combination of soya and hot sauces, citrus juice and ketchup. She stands guard at the grill, turning the pork every minute or so "to keep it juicy."

Levy likes to barbecue corn on the cob. Instead of wrapping the cobs in foil or setting them, still in their husks, on the grill, where they tend to dry out and burn - both common practices when men grill - Levy carefully strips back the husks, removes the silky threads and spreads the kernels with butter. Then she replaces the husks and grills the corn until the husks brown and begin to dry out. The result is kernels that are tender and delectable.

Mariam Toure likes lots of grilled vegetables and mushrooms when she barbecues in her St. Henri garden. One favourite is a portobello burger, which she makes by coating a whole portobello mushroom with olive oil and spices and grilling it along with grilled bread. A cheese topping is optional.

Fish is another of Toure's specialties, and her recipes reflect time she has spent living in Haiti and Guyana.

"Some fish are too flaky and don't hold up on the grill," she said. "I like firm fish and I rub them with spices. One is red snapper, filleted without the skin. I cook it en papillote - in aluminum foil - with garlic, onion, ginger and red peppers and some coconut cream."

Times they are a' changing for The Tea Party

Canadian rock outfit set to play *Le Festival de la Rentrée*

True to the Bob Dylan classic, times they are a' changing for Windsor, Ont. rock outfit The Tea Party. It's been 12 years since the trio emerged from the Motor City rock 'n roll tradition of nearby Detroit, Mich., going from unknown to internationally renowned, and to say the music industry has changed is putting it lightly.

Yet according to the group's drummer Jeff Burrows, change is really the only thing that has remained constant for him, keyboarder/bassist Stuart Chatwood and guitarist/singer Jeff Martin. Currently working on the group's sixth studio album, he says it's the continuing evolution of their music in an evolving industry that keeps him going.

"So many bands change their music because they think that is what the fans will like. We've stuck to our guns — we don't write to conformity," admits Burrows, who with the rest of The Tea Party will perform at *Le Festival de la Rentrée Molson Dry 2002* in Sherbrooke on Friday, 9:30 p.m. "We too have something to say; we just want to say it differently."

Nowhere has that difference been more obvious than on stage for the popular rock trio. Originally breaking out as a true to the name guitar band with 1993's *Splendor Solis*, Burrows and Co. began incorporating more indigenous influences into the material (i.e., *Edges of Twilight*, *TRIptych*). After 'returning to their roots,' so to speak, on 2001's *Interzone Mantras*, The Tea Party is again exploring its more well-known grandiose style. As a result, Burrows says concert-goers this summer have often come across a multi-layered version of the group on stage.

"It's as if you are looking at an impressionist painting. When looking at it, you take out its key primary colours, explains 34-year-old Burrows, who is the lone band member still living in Windsor as others have moved to nearby Toronto. "Our (live) music is like that — we pull out the primary parts in our live performances."

He adds that while their last album helped the group "find themselves again," it also gave them an opportunity to step back and evaluate their music, something easier said than done.

"It was fantastic that we did it (*Interzone Mantras*), but sometimes it was very difficult. This time we're trying a combination of things by using

lots of studio instruments again.

"It's become a lot more fun since the last album. Now, things are coming right away, and we're laying it out in less than 30 minutes sometimes. On our latest, the heavy stuff will be heavier, and the acoustic stuff more acoustic. We try to grow as a band — we're not the type that likes to rehash stuff. If we're not able to accomplish what we want, we won't release it."

Coming into Sherbrooke this weekend, the band is also not showing any signs of letting up after more than a decade rocking together. Extensive touring with heavy metal icon turned reality TV personality, Ozzy Osbourne, recently took the group across North America. In addition, a successful Australia tour earlier this year was so well received that the group plans to return in 2003.

Yet, as the group prepares to take the stage at Amédée Roy Stadium with

several relative newcomers, Burrows says the camaraderie between band members is what really has enabled them to continue.

"You have to work with a group of friends to survive (in the music industry). We've seen what happens when you're not. We were also given an opportunity and we took it by the reins and rode with it. You have to be willing to ride with it."

Das Trio's run brings them to the Haskell

Originally formed to perform at Cowansville Cultural Committee's fundraiser Le Gros Show several years ago, members of Das Trio never thought their run would last this long.

Now, as the group's members David Sutherland, Stanley Lake and Andre Lafleur prepare for tonight's concert at the Haskell Opera House in Stanstead, they admit their longevity is best credited to their diverse sound.

"The Trio is hard to categorize. We are a jazz trio, but we are a lot of other things

too," says Lake, trumpet and vocals, who was part of several classical and non-classical groups in Canada and the U.S. before joining the Trio. "Our performances are enhanced by the vast and varied musical and artistic experience that we bring to the stage."

Lake says Das Trio's performances are a blend of improvisation, instrumental, jazz vocal, strumming, rhyming rap, jazz rap and flights of fancy. Sutherland, who performs on saxophone, clarinet and flute, adds that live performances are special because no two are alike

"We enjoy playing to smaller audiences as the interaction is easier to keep track of

than with a larger crowd," he admits. "We often outline our program, but don't always stick to our original plan. We have been known to make up things on the spot — one starts something and the others join in. These are performances that can never be repeated because the standards are totally improvised."

Sutherland says he first got interested in folk music in the 60s while working in New York. Before Das Trio, he played with Shorty Metcalfe and the Giants in Ottawa, the Frank Collard Jazz Quintet and the Homebrew Dixieland Jazz Band, which was founded by Stanley Lake.

"I started playing guitar and doing vo-

cal (with the Trio)," he says. "Now, I leave the singing to Stanley, but I sometimes join in on the harmonizing."

Rounding out the trio is Lafleur, who studied double bass with Eric Lagrace, Normand Guilbart and Michel Danato. He followed the jazz program at Concordia University, and has also recorded his own compositions on 1998's *Interjection*.

Of the notoriously difficult Brando, with whom he appeared in *Free Money*, a television movie made partly in the Eastern Townships about five years ago, he said, "he's not that easy to work with, in the sense that he knows what he likes to

do in front of a camera, so the other actors have to sort of adjust to his ways. He's got a very independent mind." Fontaine was quick to qualify the statement, though, adding, "on a set, he is the most courteous, affable individual that one can ever meet. He will not tolerate strangers, mind you. But everybody else, whether it be an actor or a dresser—it doesn't matter—he's just nice to everybody."

Fontaine found it easier to be unqualifyingly positive about Paul Newman, of whom he confesses he has always been a fan. The day of his scene with the screen legend in the recent film *Where the Money Is* could have gone smoother, however. He arrived on time, but Newman was early, and all the scene's dialogue had been changed, naturally sending Fontaine into a state of panic. "But the guy is so easy to work with that it was just a great experience," said Fontaine. "He's focused, but also out to make everyone around him look good."

Fontaine doesn't know what puts him on screen one month and on stage the next—"nobody decides these things; they just happen," he said—but he does know where his preference lies. "There's something about the stage that's so stimulating. It's direct contact, and walking a tight-rope, and there's a lot of excitement in that. It's a great challenge to recreate something every night in front of a different audience every time, regardless of how you feel on that given day or moment. You have to reach into yourself and use all the technique you have. It's quite a fascinating process."

Despite the pay cut in moving from film to the Piggery, Fontaine said that to play *Malvolio* in *Twelfth Night* was an opportunity he simply couldn't afford not to take. "I don't think there are too many actors that would turn that down. If you like Shakespeare and you like the stage, this is an excellent part."

He has also really enjoyed the egalitarian, ensemble nature of the Shakespearean comedy. "It's like being on a hockey team. What would you rather be, the top scorer in the league, or a part of the best team in the league? You want to be on the best team, and have a hell of a lot of fun with a

whole bunch of great guys. I'm just involved with a whole bunch of wonderful actors."

A fan of musical theatre who travels regularly to New York to get his fill, Fontaine is equally elated to be appearing as Henry in *The Piggery's* production of *The Fantasticks*, which was until recently the longest running show in Off-Broadway theatre.

Although he's the senior member of this season's acting company at the Piggery, Fontaine hasn't turned his experiences with Brando or Newman around and assumed the role of mentor figure there. Instead, he characterized the theatre's new artistic director, Douglas Campbell, as the operation's central figure.

"He's so respected that it's really easy for everyone to rally around him. He's a great man, and he's perceived as such."

But like *Twelfth Night*, Fontaine sees the Piggery's rebounding success as anything but an individual effort. "Everything fell into place this year," he

said. "Whether it be the bar man, the people in the box office, administration, people backstage—everybody seems to be the right person in the right place at the right time. You don't see that too often in any field."

Mr. Fontaine's upcoming screen appearances include his role in George Clooney's *Confessions of a Dangerous Mind* and a turn in a new independent film, *Two Summers* by young Canadian director Bruce Lapointe, to be shown at this year's Montreal Film festival.

Meanwhile, he is having such a good time at *The Piggery* that he hopes to return next season to his new local English theatre venue. "If one is given the opportunity to repeat that experience, why not?"

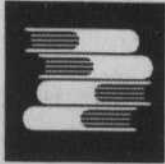

The way to deal with generals

In his first term as president, Bill Clinton encountered some difficulties with the military brass. In a recent book, David Halberstam recounts that the president even had to learn how to salute the military. Politicians sometimes have a hard time understanding generals.

On the other hand, military people also have a hard time coping with politics. In his memoirs, retired general Ariel Sharon writes that, upon entering the Knesset (Israel's parliament) for the first time, he sensed that, "in politics there are no rules, no sense of proportion, no sensible hierarchy."

But in a context where military operations shape a large part of the political agenda, the relationship between politicians and uniformed leaders is a subject of tremendous interest and impact.

Supreme Command: Soldiers, Statesmen, and Leadership in Wartime is an excellent exercise in that regard. Through the pages of this insightful book, Eliot A. Cohen, a Professor of Strategic Studies at the Paul H. Nitze School of Advanced In-

ternational Studies of the John Hopkins University, eloquently explores examples of productive encounters between elected officials and generals.

This relationship is supposed to function under the "normal" theory of civil-military relations. Under that scheme, "officers are professionals, much like highly trained surgeons: the statesman is in the position of a patient requiring urgent care." According to that philosophy, an elected official should not be overly involved in the war process.

But Cohen shows that those who succeeded are those who did not abide by this demarcation line. He cites four cases. Abraham Lincoln, who spent endless hours in the telegraph room of the War Department to monitor and direct the

events on the battlefield. Secondly, he writes about Georges Clemenceau, who visited the front lines of war to boost the morale of his men. His third example is drawn from Winston Churchill, the British prime minister who once said to one of his generals, "you know, in war you don't have to be nice, you only have to be right." Hitler's fiercest opponent tolerated, even encouraged, his military subordinates to challenge him. Finally, there is David Ben-

Gurion, who shaped, one could say from scratch, the Israel army. To achieve that, the father of Israel conducted, for two months, a seminar "to interview systematically the entire high command of the Haganah (and many of its subordinate officers as well), to review its state of preparedness." Few leaders would do that these days.

All these statesmen had some points in common. Except for Churchill - who served for somewhat a significant period of time under fire - the three others did not have much military experience. They also meddled without hesitation into military affairs and decisions. They all operated under Clemenceau's premise that "war is too important to be left to the generals".

Eliot A. Cohen also presents the reader with the other side of the coin. His primary example is the Vietnam war. According to Cohen, President "Johnson's and McNamara's conduct of the Vietnam war reveals the opposite of the methods of a Lincoln, a Clemenceau, a Churchill, or a Ben-Gurion. After the initial decisions to

enter the war, the American civilian leadership held back from the kind of bruising discussions with their military advisers that caused so much grief to Churchill's subordinates." This same "administration [...] chose its top military leaders for political pliability." Lyndon B. Johnson, who was a master of partisan politics, was thus unable to follow the path of other famous war leaders."

To sum it up, we could well leave the final word to Colin Powell, who knows a thing or two about the junction between politics and military affairs. Cohen quotes the famous general who, in his memoirs, gave a piece of advice to the practitioners of civil-military relations. "Don't be afraid to challenge the pros, even in their own back yard. Just as important, never neglect details, even to the point of being a pest" were his words.

Practice thus seems more important - and fruitful - than theory. That's the main lesson drawn from this work. While much too short, Eliot A. Cohen's book is nonetheless a good investment for students of leadership.

Lil' Ed & The Blues Imperials

It's been four years since Lil' Ed reformed the Blues Imperials in 1998 after taking time off to deal with personal problems. But following the release of their second album since reuniting, and fourth together, it's like the group never left. Lil' Ed (Ed Williams) and Co. first broke out in 1986 with their debut album *Roughin-housin'*, which took band members from car washes to international stages. Their latest album continues the pure Chicago blues tradition that Williams was taught by uncle and legendary slide guitarist J.B. Hutto. *Heads Up!* features 11 originals ranging from up-tempo guitar boogies to slow blues tributes. Joining Lil' Ed is guitarist Mike Garrett, bassist James 'Pookie' Young, drummer Kelly Littleton and a special appearance by rhythm guitarist Paul Buschbacker on 'Four Leaf Clover'. Lil' Ed, although small in size, leaves an enormous mark on every song, whether it's a smoking slide guitar solo or soulful blues selection.

Where The Action Is

Blues singer and guitarist Sue Foley's travels have taken her across the map, from her hometown of Ottawa to Austin, San Francisco, Vancouver and now Toronto. Yet judging from her recently released seventh album, entitled *Where the Action Is*, the 33-year-old musician's most trying travels have been in her personal life. Following a divorce, and consequently raising her five-year-old son on her own, the new disk is centred on themes of relationships and empowerment. It's a little bit of gritty Mississippi blues, toe-tapping roots, country rock and Latin dance all rolled into one. Influenced by heavyweights like Earl Hooker, Bessie Smith and T-Bone Walker to name a few, Foley doesn't hold back on

Co-produced by Colin Linden (The Band, Bruce Cockburn, Lucinda Williams), Foley wrote or co-wrote nine of the 12 songs on the new album, which was recorded in the Tragically Hip's Bathhouse studio outside Kingston, Ont. With a richness and depth to her music, Foley arguably transcended her blues influences long ago. Nevertheless, it's seemingly a challenge Foley is still working toward as her latest is a heavyweight in its own right.

A world of adventure, comedy and drama awaits

Aniston undergoes change of pace in new movie

Jennifer Aniston wants to set the record straight this morning. Contrary to what we may read on the Internet, she does not attend "cardio-striptease classes" in order to keep healthy. In fact, she doesn't even know what the term means.

There are other stories she wants to squash as well — like the report she's joining Madonna and her director husband Guy Ritchie to star in the remake of the cult Italian film, *Swept Away*. Definitely untrue, Aniston declares. So would she like to do a movie with Madonna? "Well you know, anything's possible," she shrugs.

She's resigned to the fact that truly lunatic rumours will keep surfacing. Such as? "Well, did you know that for my flaky scalp I crush aspirins and drop them into my shampoo?" she grins.

The shampoo story isn't true either. On the other hand, Aniston does admit that she has the peculiar habit of scooping out the inside of a bagel and leaving the rest. She also sleepwalks — a situation which makes husband Brad Pitt frantic.

One night, the burglar alarm woke her up. She discovered she was outside and had tripped the alarm system.

But she's quick to remind us that before *Friends* came along to change her life, she had a series of dismal, dead-end jobs much like the one entrapping Justine, the depressed small-town clerk she portrays in her new movie, *The Good Girl*. In fact, she found herself relating painfully to Justine's dilemma.

"I was a telemarketer once — and I apologize if I called any of you. I got yelled at, and I was the worst telemarketer because I would just apologize and hang up. It was in 1989 and I was selling time shares. It was awful, awful, awful."

When she was struggling to establish an acting career she also worked as a receptionist more times than she can count — also as a messenger, "which was the low point because I'd just moved to L.A. and didn't know anybody."

The role of Rachel Green on *Friends* changed her life but didn't erase those memories of hardship, which helped her relate to her character in *The Good Girl* — a movie that has already opened in the U.S. to a volley of enthusiastic reviews for her performance. (It opens Aug. 21 in Toronto, Aug. 23 in Vancouver and Montreal and Aug. 30 in other Canadian cities).

But some journalists are still skeptical about the ability of a highly paid sitcom diva to bring off a character like Justine.

She's asked: "How much can you with your perfect life identify with a character who believes the grass is greener somewhere else?"

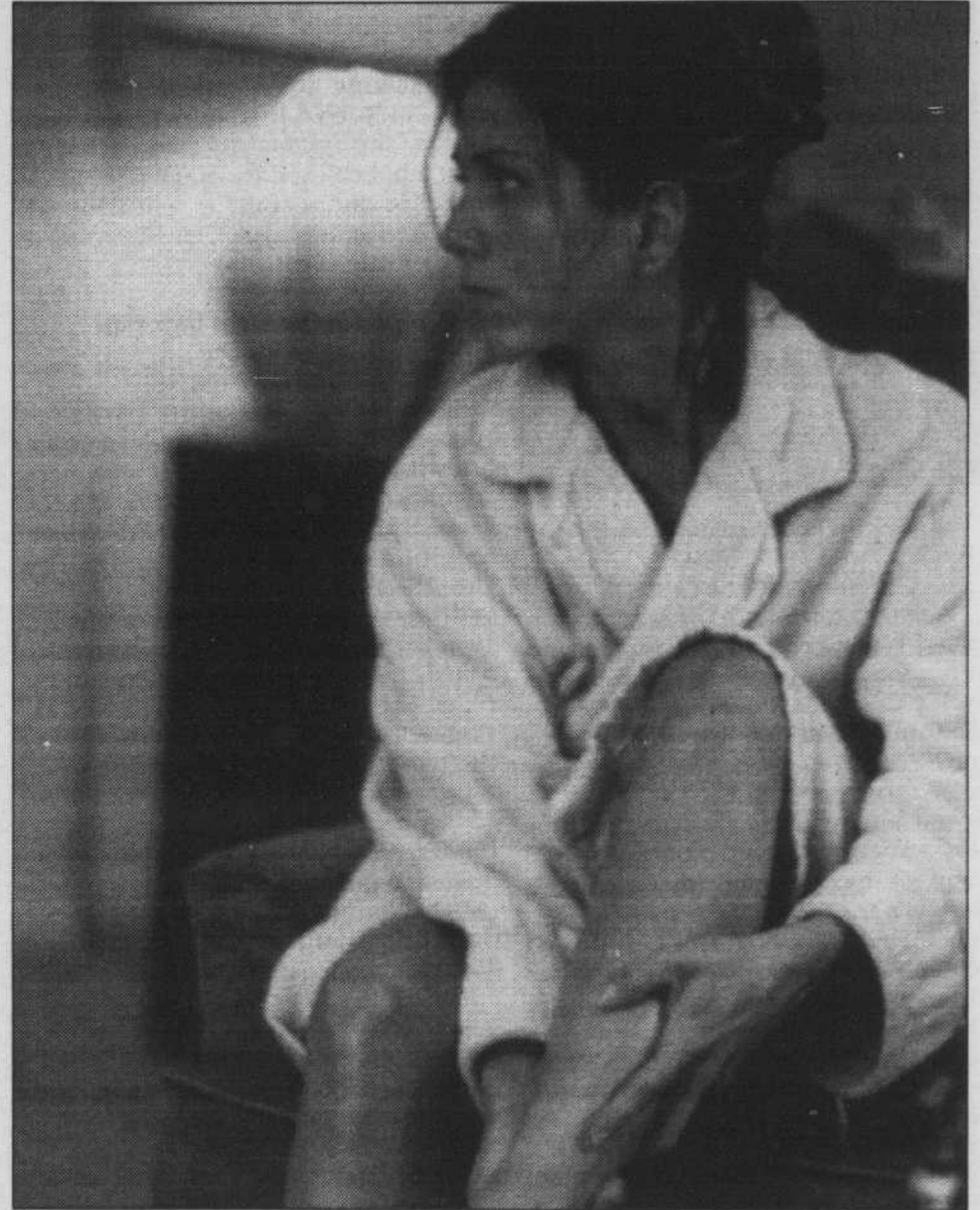
It's the reference to a "perfect life" that bothers her the most.

"That's an untruth," she says firmly. "We all have lives that are relative. How did I relate to her? You dive into your own life, into moments where you've been stuck or felt complacent or felt depressed — moments which I've always fought."

"I guess I've been more on the comedic side because it was a safe haven and made me feel good, so this was a challenge for me to explore that other side of myself which we all have — which is sometimes sad and dark and depressing."

The character of Rachel on *Friends* is far removed from that of Justine in *The Good Girl* — a drama from two stalwarts of the independent movie circuit, director Miguel Arteta and writer Mike White whose creepy screenplay for *Chuck And Buck* turned that film into a cult hit.

Justine has a hopeless job in a small-town chain department store and a hope-

less home life with her perpetually stoned housepainter husband (John C. Reilly). Her loneliness leads her into an affair with an unhappy young co-worker (Jake Gyllenhaal) and this in turn triggers a major emotional crisis and forces Justine to take a long hard look at herself.

With *Friends* due to end next spring after nine seasons, Aniston has been

looking to expand her already successful film career, and *The Good Girl* offered a challenging opportunity to depart from her usual image. She was not the filmmakers' first choice for the role. White — who has a small role as a born-again Christian in the film — says he didn't write the movie with a specific actress in mind.

"The first people who came to mind were actresses who had done projects like this — indie movies, dark movies."

But at the same time, he and Arteta were looking at unusual casting possibilities — someone who would bring a "fresh" quality to the project — and Aniston's name came up.

"We sent the script to her and she read it overnight," Arteta recalls. "Then she did something people don't do in Hollywood. She called us the next day and said, 'I love it!'"

Miss Fortune is one of the year's best

Allison Moorer is one of the most talented singers in music city these days, but is also one of the most under appreciated. Her Alabama drawl creates magic with the lyrics of every songs she sings.

On her new collection, entitled Miss Fortune, Moorer passionately delivers a selection of great numbers that she wrote or co-wrote with husband/producer Doyle Primm.

This new album is the follow-up to 1998's Alabama Song and 2000's The Hardest Part, which was a real masterpiece. How can you record another album and still surpass yourself?

Moorer did it with the new album, which features beautifully crafted songs. The theme remains the same as she explores love in all its forms and with all its emotions. Miss Fortune is a great album, and the production is impeccable.

The album's first track is the sad, soulful ballad 'Tumbling Down' about love dying. It is followed by the sombre 'Cold In California', and the bluesy 'Yessirree'.

Moorer also sings the tale of a young woman born in 1900 on 'Ruby Jewel Was Here', while the jazzy 'Dying Breed' is poignant and chilling. Each one of the 13 songs included on this album revisit feelings that are familiar to most of us.

Moorer shines on every song on Miss Fortune although she has a special way with ballads. She has included a bit of classic R&B to her raw country sound, which allows listeners to hear a different side of her singing talent.

Only a few numbers are really radio friendly, however, and many of the songs are way too long for radio land unless there's a radio edit version. But when it comes to listening to the album, the length is not a problem.

While this new album doesn't exactly fit today's radio format, and it is not hard-core country, one thing is for sure - Miss Fortune is one of the greatest

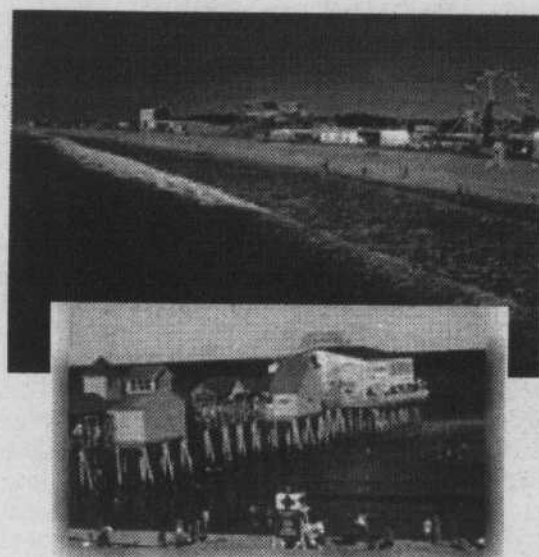
