Special Federation Movement Alloys the Feeling Aroused in England by Mercier's Declarations.

LONDON, July 17.—The Council of the Imperial Federation League has selected a committee to consider the definite plan for Imperial Federation made by Charles Tupper in his recent speech.

It is noted as significant that a prominent free trader like Sir Lyon Playfair and other well-known Liberals have shown themselves ready to consider these and similar proposals without prejudice.

This seems to confirm the assertion of the Times that "England is beginning to see that Free Trade was made for man and not man for Free Trade."

Charles Tupper says he is surprised to find the support his scheme obtains in England. He declares that his is the first time that has been made that meets all the Canadian objections to federation in general.
