LACHINE.

(Incorporated in 1872.)

A town on the River St Lawrence and Island of Montreal (parish of Les Saints Anges), seignory of Montreal Island, county of Jacques Cartier, district of Montreal. It is the summer residence of many Montrealers, and has become famous by its annual regatta. Sportsmen meet here daily at the Lachine Boating Club, at the Bel-Air Mansion, Upper Lachine or Dorval, and Summerlea. A wealthy company has undertaken to make the Bel-Air race-course one of the best in America. In the winter months it is greatly frequented by pleasure parties, and at all times of the year a drive from Montreal to Lachine by the Upper, and in by the lower road, is considered a rich treat to the stranger, and even to the citizen of Montreal. Lachine possesses a large brewery, an extensive saw mill, Dominion wire works, wire rope and screw factory, Montreal car wheel and pipe foundries, the works of the Dominion Bridge Co.; a large Tannery, a Shoe Manufactory, Aerated Waters and Apple Cider establishments; has good local business and extensive lumber trade. The Grand Trunk Railway run several trains a day to Montreal. Montreal Park & Island Electric Railway have also a line of electric cars running from the City of Montreal to the western limits of the Town of Lachine. The Merchants Bank of Canada has a Branch here and is doing a good business. A ship canal connects the navigable waters at Montreal with Lake St Louis at Lachine. Great North-Western Telegraph Co. have offices here, also the Bell Telephone Co.; the town is lighted by electricity, and has a fire alarm system and a complete system of water works. There is an extensive convent under the direction of the Reverend Sisters of St Ann. Distant from Montreal 9 miles, fare 40c., 25c. and 12½c. Mail twice a day. Population 6,000

LAPRAIRIE.

An extensive municipal village and parish of the south shore of the River St. Lawrence, between the Lachine rapids and Victoria bridge, district of Montreal, seigniory and county of the same name. Incorporated March 30, 1846. The parish was erected on the 17th November, 1668. A market is open every day. An aqueduct is constructed. The first railway in British North America was constructed from here to St. Johns in 1836. It was first worked with horses, afterwards by steam, but was discontinued, and the rails taken up a number of years ago. A steamboat maintains regular communication between Montreal and Laprairie. A branch of the Grand Trunk Railway, starting at Fort Covington, in the State of New York, to reach the Victoria bridge, now runs twice a day in close proximity to the village, with a good station and depot, and contributes materially to the future development of the locality, which is considered a very healthy and pleasant summer place. There is also a fire station, thoroughly supplied with new fire apparatus, such as a fire engine and hook and ladders. Fishing and hunting is also largely practised. A new billiard room has been organized. A permanent wharf has been erected. A new channel is also partly made up. The aqueduct is now giving a very good service to the village, and the work of putting up pipes is being done very rapidly in the different streets. The pressure of water in case of fire is also very powerful, as the water is drawn by steam and air pressure, which brings it at a distance of 1,350 feet from the St. Lawrence river. The premiums upon insurances have also been greatly reduced on account of the recent ameliorations to the fire system apparatus. Great North-Western Telegraph Company has an office here. Telephone connection with Montreal. Distant from Montreal, 9 miles, fare 15 cts.; from St. Johns, 18 miles. Mail daily. Population of village about 1,500; of parish 2,200.

STE. CUNEGONDE, CITY OF

A city adjoining the city limits of Montreal, district of Montreal is governed by a mayor and police force is maintained; it is lighted with arc electric light, and possesses first-class water works. The corporation purchased the old St Jude's Church, which they have converted into a handsome City Hall with commodious offices and court room, fire station and a large hall for public meetings, as well as a private residence for the City Clerk. The Post Office has been transported into the Hall. The Merchants Bank of Canada has opened a branch here. The city contains two churches: one Roman Catholic and one Protestant; two convents, one under the St Ann's sisters and one under the control of the School Commissioners; an asylum under the supervision of the Grey Nuns; one college and two schools—one Protestant and one Catholic. It possesses some extensive industries, the most important of which are the Montreal Rolling mills, the Mona Saw mills, Davidson's Stamping works, Luttrell's cracker factory, Ciendinning's foundry, Henault's ice house, Robert Mitchell's Brass foundry; T. Prolontaine, lumber merchant; Aquin & Itzweire, door and sash factory; Wm. Rutherford & Son, sash and door factory; Dominion Wadding Co.; Singer Manufacturing Co. There is telegraph and telephone communication between the City Hall and the Water Works. Population about 10,000

ST. HENRI, CITY OF

A city near Montreal, and formed by the amalgamation of the former villages of Tannery

West and Coteau St Augustin. The city of St Henri is situated in the seigniory of Montreal, county of Hochelaga and district of Montreal. The Lachine canal passes on the south side, and signal stations of the Grand Trunk Railway are situated here at the junctions where the roads branch off east and west, and to Montreal and Lachine. The Grand Trunk Railway System, with the aid of the Council of the City, has just erected a splendid station, at the curve, near the Notre Dame street bridge. The city of St. Henri is governed by a Mayor and Corporation, and a separate permanent Fire and Police force is maintained. The city contains 6 Roman Catholic colleges and convents, 2 Roman Catholic churches, St Henri and St Elizabeth du Portugal, and 3 Protestant churches, Episcopal, Methodist and Evangelist, and several important industries, amongst others, 3 pork packing houses, 2 tanneries, boot and shoe factories, boot and shoe stiffener' manufactory, brick yards, Ingersoll Rock Drill Co. of Canada, the Page-Hersey Manufacturing Co., Tombyll Furniture & Upholstering Co., The N. K. Fairbanks Co., St Henri Chemical Co., the C. W. Williams Manufacturing Co., the Merchants Cotton Co.'s mills, employing 1,500 hands, one of the finest in the Dominion; the Tooke Bros. Co., manufacturing shirts, neckwear and ladies' underwear; the Lang Manufacturing Co., biscuits, crackers, etc.; the Colonial Bleaching & Printing Co., colored cottons, prints, etc.; the Alaska Feather & Down Co., mattresses, pillows, etc.; and a public Abattoir and Stock Yard Co. The Johnson Wire Mills of Manchester Eng., have opened out a branch here lately. The Quebec and Hochelaga Banks have each a branch here. The Council has built a very fine City Hall, Fire and Police station, at the corner of Notre Dame and St James streets, and an additional Fire and Police Station at the corner of Notre Dame and St Elizabeth av, at a total cost of \$25,000. Building is being prosecuted briskly, and the city is now one of the important places of the province, having Fire and Police system of alarm telegraph. The Citizens Light & Power Co., operated by the Lachine Rapids Hydraulic & Land Co., has a large station within the limits of the city, from which the city is lighted by arc electric light. The city is divided into two parishes, St Henri and Ste Elizabeth du Portugal. Distant from Bonaventure depot 2 1/2 miles, from Lachine 6 miles. Population 21299. The city of St Henri being the third city in the province of Quebec

ST. LAMBERT.

A suburban village on the south shore of the St. Lawrence, directly opposite Montreal, in the county of Chambly, district of Montreal, with a population about 1,500, and growing rapidly. It is an important railway centre, and is supplied with an excellent train service by the Grand Trunk Railway, having over twenty trains each way daily. Return 25c, single 50c. on suburban trains, return good for day of issue only, 25c; return good for 1 month 35c; single fare on regular train 25c; by commutation tickets, 55 trips for \$2.75, or 5c a trip.

The Victoria Jubilee Bridge spans the St. Lawrence here, and all trains to and from the City stop at the railway station. Several lines of railway run here, viz: Grand Trunk for points South, East and West; Central Vermont for Farnham, New York and Boston; Delaware & Hudson for New York; Montreal & Sorel for Sorel. The distance to Longueuil, the county seat, is three miles. There are four churches: Methodist, Episcopal, Roman Catholic and Presbyterian, with resident ministers and curé. There is a large Model school, conducted by the Protestant School Commissioners, with a staff of five teachers;

The Roman Catholic School Commissioner's school is now conducted by the sisters of the Holy names of Jesus and Mary and have a staff of five teachers. There is excellent boating on the river, and the St. Lambert Boat Club is recognized as one of the best clubs in the vicinity of Montreal. The residents are mostly employed in the City, and select it for a suburban home from its favorable situation and excellent means of communication at all seasons with the City. During the winter months direct communication is had with Montreal by an ice road across the St. Lawrence, on which considerable driving is done, and by the bridge St. Lambert is being rapidly built up, and is destined to become a very important point; and a system of water and drainage has been inaugurated. The Canadian Hunt Club composed of Montreal gentlemen, have their Club and Kennels located at Slocum Lodge, an excellent situation on the river bank. The distance by rail is six miles. Mail twice daily G.N.W. Tel. Co. has an office, also telephone communication at post office.

The government are now completing a crib work wall along the river bank, which gives the Town a fine promenade of over 1000 feet in length, from which the view of Montreal, lighted at night by thousands of electric lights is magnificent
