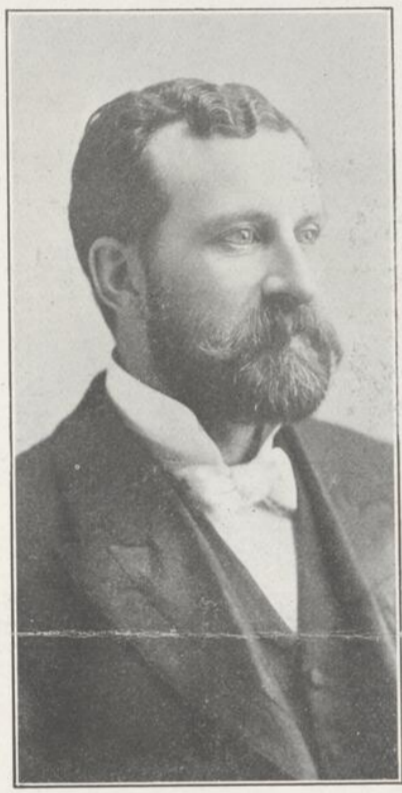

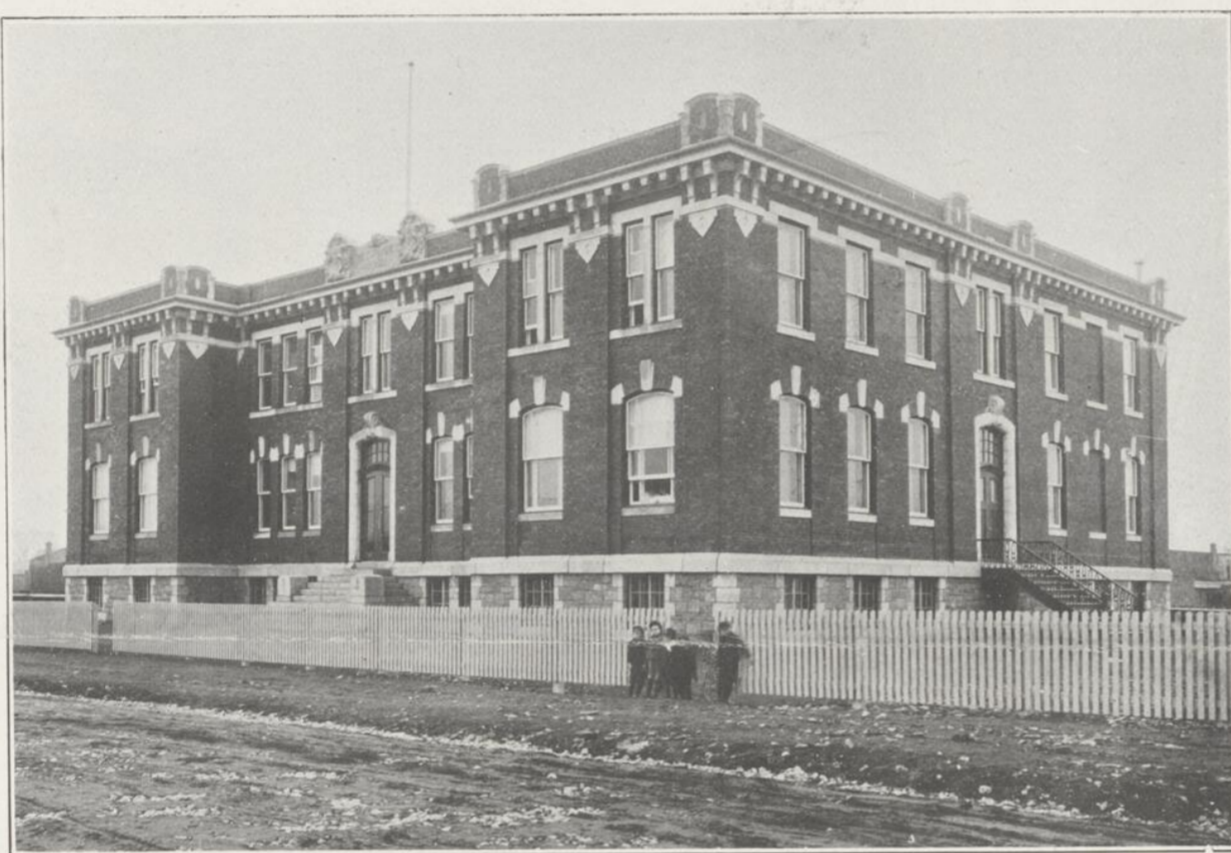

MODERN UP-TO-DATE CANADIAN SCHOOLS

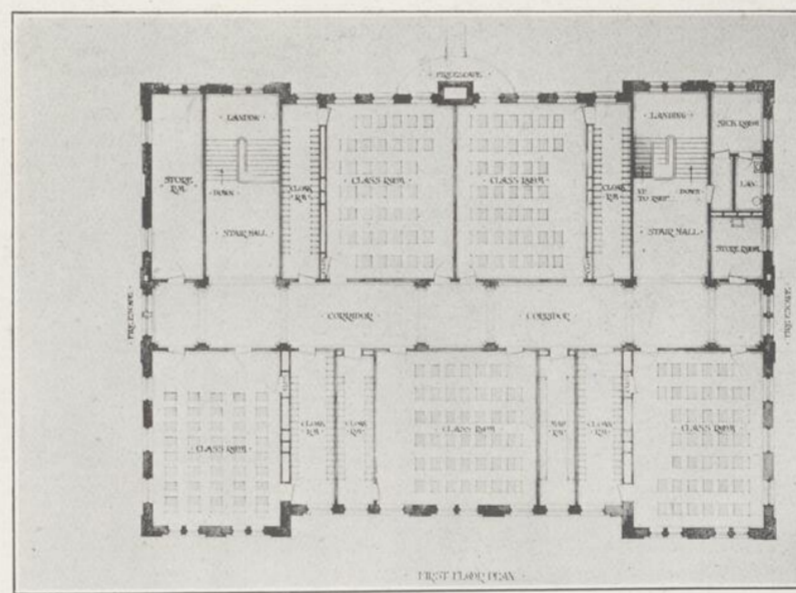

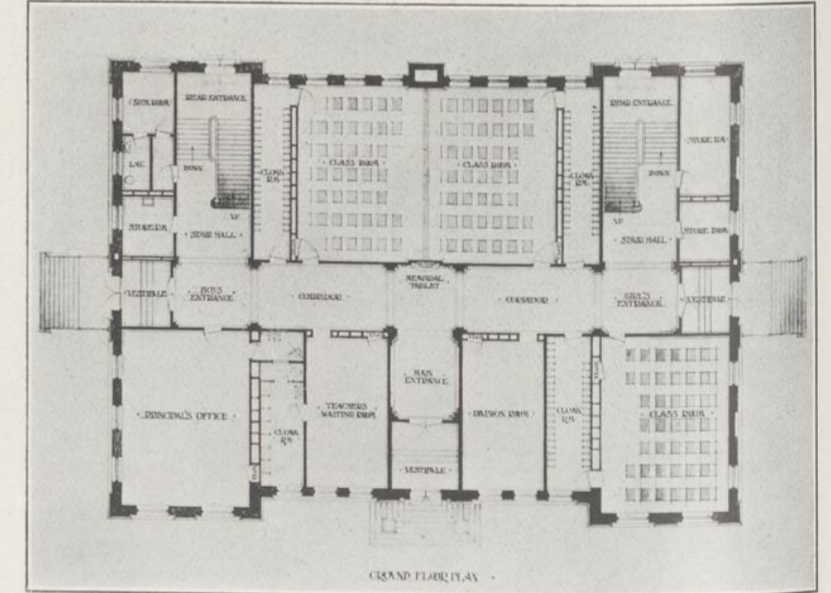

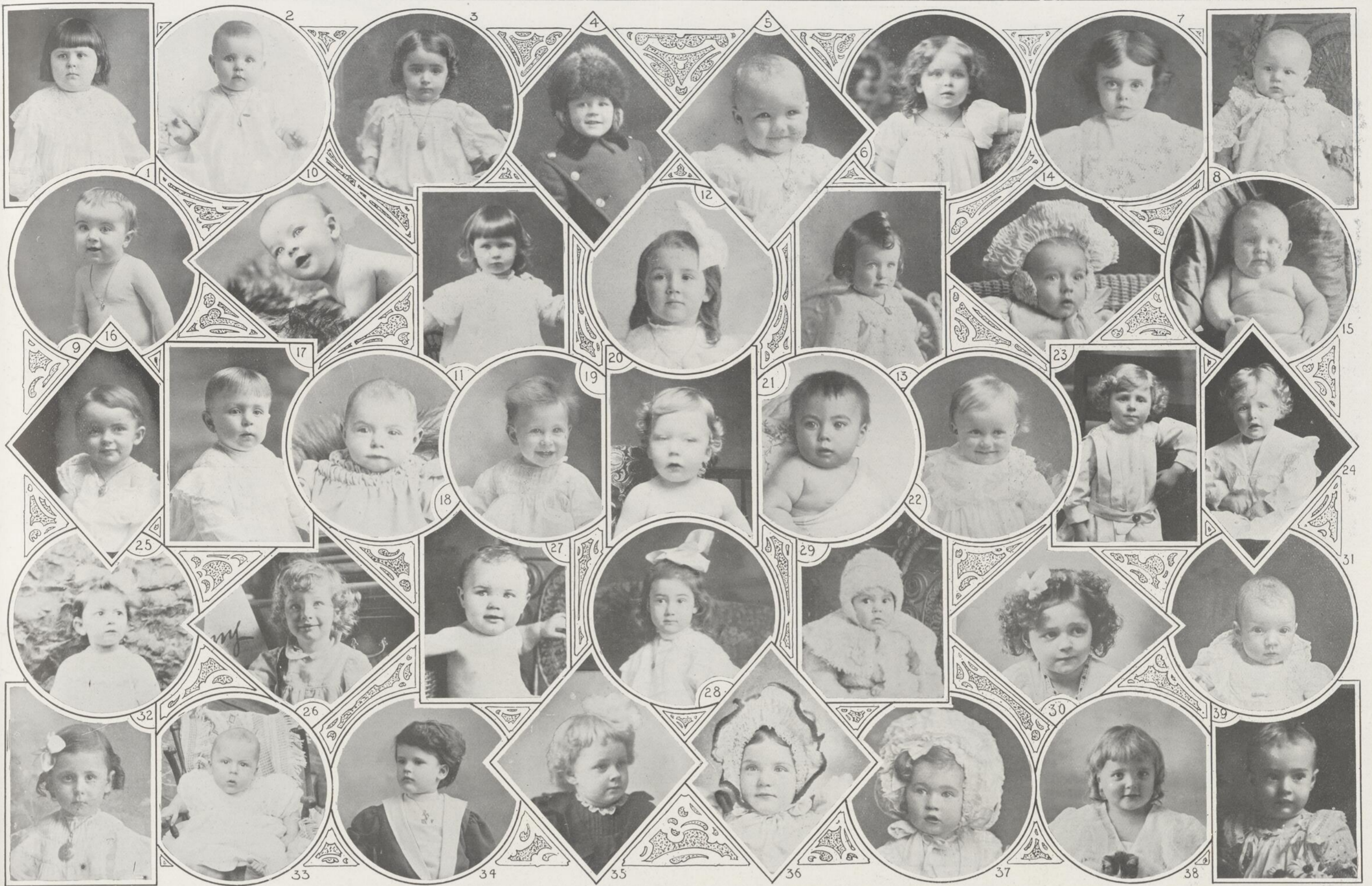

The buildings are heated by twin hot-water boilers, which furnish direct heat, and a steam boiler for the ventilation, which is entirely separate from the heating, and controlled by fans driven by electric motors. The fresh air is heated by a steam-coil and distributed throughout the building and class-rooms, and the foul air is extracted.

The Commissioners purchased large lots which give plenty of room for the building of additional class-rooms. This need seems to be immediate from the large number of pupils applying for admission.

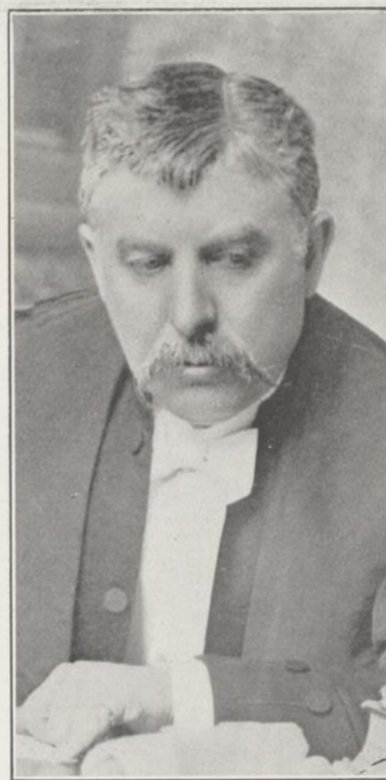

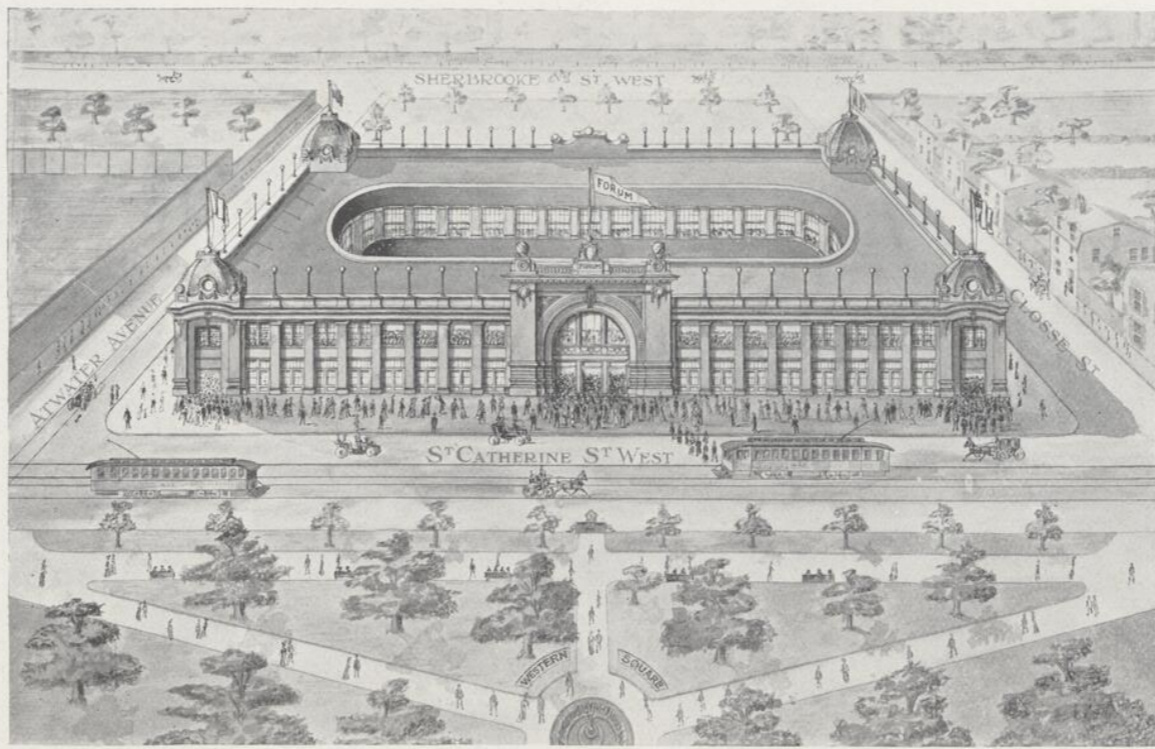
