In 2024, \$7.2 million, i.e. 58% of all revenues, was dedicated to funding projects that improve patient care, research, as well as teaching and skill development at the Hôpital Maisonneuve-Rosemont (HMR). Unused revenues are partially capitalized to ensure the sustainability of the HMR Foundation and will be

YOUR DONATIONS' IMPACT

PATIENT CARE

IN 2024, DONATIONS MADE SIGNIFICANT PROJECTS THAT DIRECTLY IMPACT QUALITY CARE A REALITY.

The anesthesiology department, led by Dr. Olivier Verdonck, acquired target-controlled infusion (TCI) pumps, a technology which allows for the precise intravenous delivery of anesthetics, all the while reducing the use of anesthetic gases and their ecological footprint.

Another project was the April 2024 launch of L'Escale Préma-Québec, the first accommodation service dedicated to families with hospitalized premature babies, spearheaded by the Préma-Québec organization. A yearly \$20,000 financial contribution, over three years, was sought from the HMR Foundation to support this crucial initiative.

2024 was also marked by a major modernization project in nuclear medicine. Nuclear medicine is a state-of-the-art specialty that delivers precision functional imaging through the injection of radioactive tracers. It plays an essential role in the diagnosis, monitoring and evaluation of several pathologies, particularly oncological ones. At Hôpital Maisonneuve-Rosemont, over 90% of all nuclear medicine patients are living with cancer; it carries out some 5,000 exams each year.

In 2024, a comprehensive modernization project of this service was undertaken so as to optimize care pathways, as well as improve not only patient comfort and safety, but the working conditions of all medical teams. This project, valued at 3.5 million dollars, was made possible thanks to the decisive support of HMR Foundation donors.

RESEARCH

In 2024, we celebrated the 50th anniversary of the Maisonneuve-Rosemont Hospital Research Centre (CR-HMR), founded by nephrologist Dr. Serge Carrière. Nephrology research remains a central focus at the HMR Foundation. It is supported as always by clinical services at the HMR, which is also home to the largest dialysis centre in Quebec, the Raymond-Barcelo Integrated Dialysis Centre.

To further enrich this research area and develop better care for people suffering from kidney diseases, we are in the process of recruiting a leading nephrology researcher.

Your donations, both large and small, help recruit exceptional researchers that energize everyone's research work and contribute to the discovery of new

therapeutic approaches toward caring for people in our community using groundbreaking techniques. Additionally, given that the CR-HMR is a training centre for graduate and postdoctoral students, your donations ensure the training of future generations.

Our many thanks to the Fondation Courtois for its exceptional \$3M donation toward basic research in functional genomics at the CR-HMR. Learn more about this donation on page 30.

In recent years, the scholarship program has proved effective in attracting exceptionally qualified candidates.

RESEARCH SUPPORT FUND

This fund makes it possible to lend a helping hand to early-career researchers, providing for their remuneration and their laboratory start-up funding. The latter allows new researchers to set up their research activities so as to present competitive funding applications to national contests, where success rates are less than 20%. Thanks to this support, the CR-HMR distinguished itself in recent contests.

Their project, *Decoding biological complexity through high-throughput combinatorial genetics*, builds on state-of-the-art technologies to unlock the mysteries needed to distinguish healthy and diseased cells. To accelerate this type of project, researchers, clinicians and data specialists join forces to decipher gene expression and conceive new treatments. Each discovery paves the way for life-saving breakthroughs.

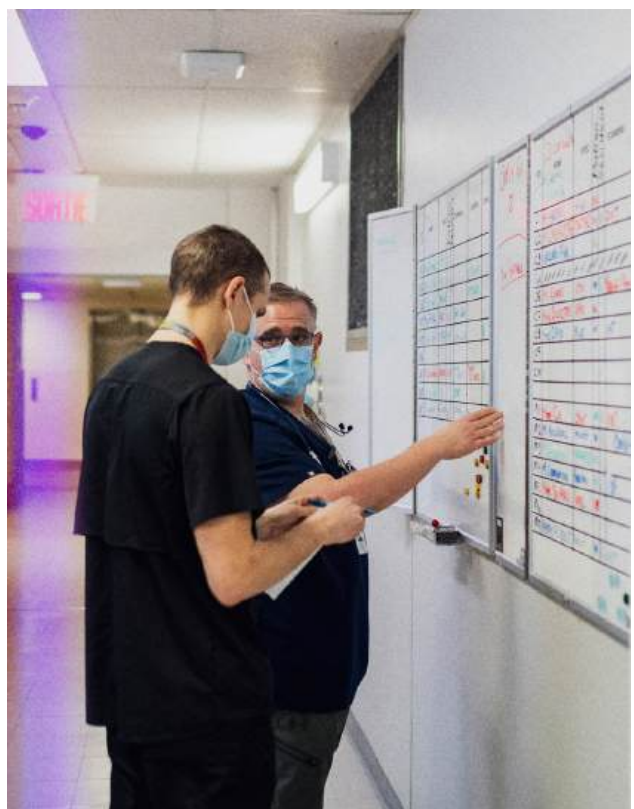
