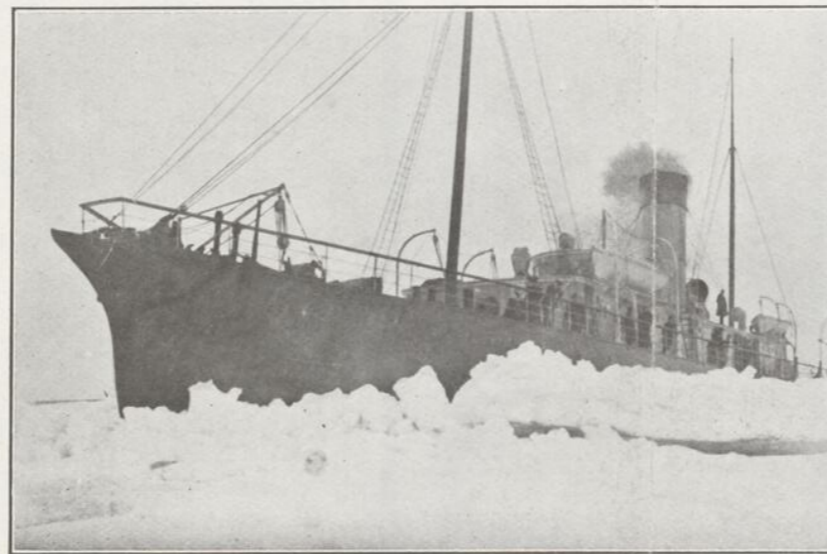

THE CAPE'S SPECIAL TRAIN SNOWBOUND—Rev. Father Burke assisting to remove snow from the plough. Prince Edward Island has just experienced one of the worst storms for many years. Owing to the railway being snowed up, the Prince Edward Island Legislature could not resume its sittings, as Speaker Agnew and a number of western members were on board and the Government was in a minority at the very time when every effort is being made to close the session. Communication with the mainland was also cut off. The steamer Minto was in the ice off Cape Bear and the Stanley was forced on account of heavy ice to return to Pictou.

THE Dominion of Canada is said to be the brightest gem in Britain's Crown, and Prince Edward Island, its smallest Province, situate in the Gulf of St. Lawrence, is known as the "Garden of the Gulf." This appellation, however, is appropriate only during the summer months, for in winter the "Million Acre Farm," as Senator Howlan immortalized it, when referring to his native Province on a notable occasion in Parliament, with its 110,000 inhabitants, is a veritable "Lady of the Snows."

By the terms under which the Island Province entered into the Confederation compact with the Dominion in 1873 it was stipulated that the Dominion

should provide "efficient and continuous steam communication between the island and the mainland winter and summer"; but although in a measure satisfied the attempts made have never yet been successful through a whole year.

To keep up communication across Northumberland Straits, and thus carry out the Confederation agreement the Dominion Government provided the Northern Light, Stanley and Minto at successive periods during the last quarter of a century. The Northern Light, the first winter steamer, was not specially built for this service.

In 1887 the Federal Government sent Captain McElhinney, nautical adviser of the Marine Department, to Europe to study the conditions of ice navigation, and from the information thus ob-

tained the Stanley was evolved. She was completed the following year, and arrived in Charlottetown 14th December, 1888.

Protestations from the Boards of Trade and the Local Government, and also from public meetings calling for fulfillment of the Terms of Union, were an annual occurrence and thus, in the closing year of the last century the Government of Canada was moved towards further improving the service, and had the Minto specially designed.

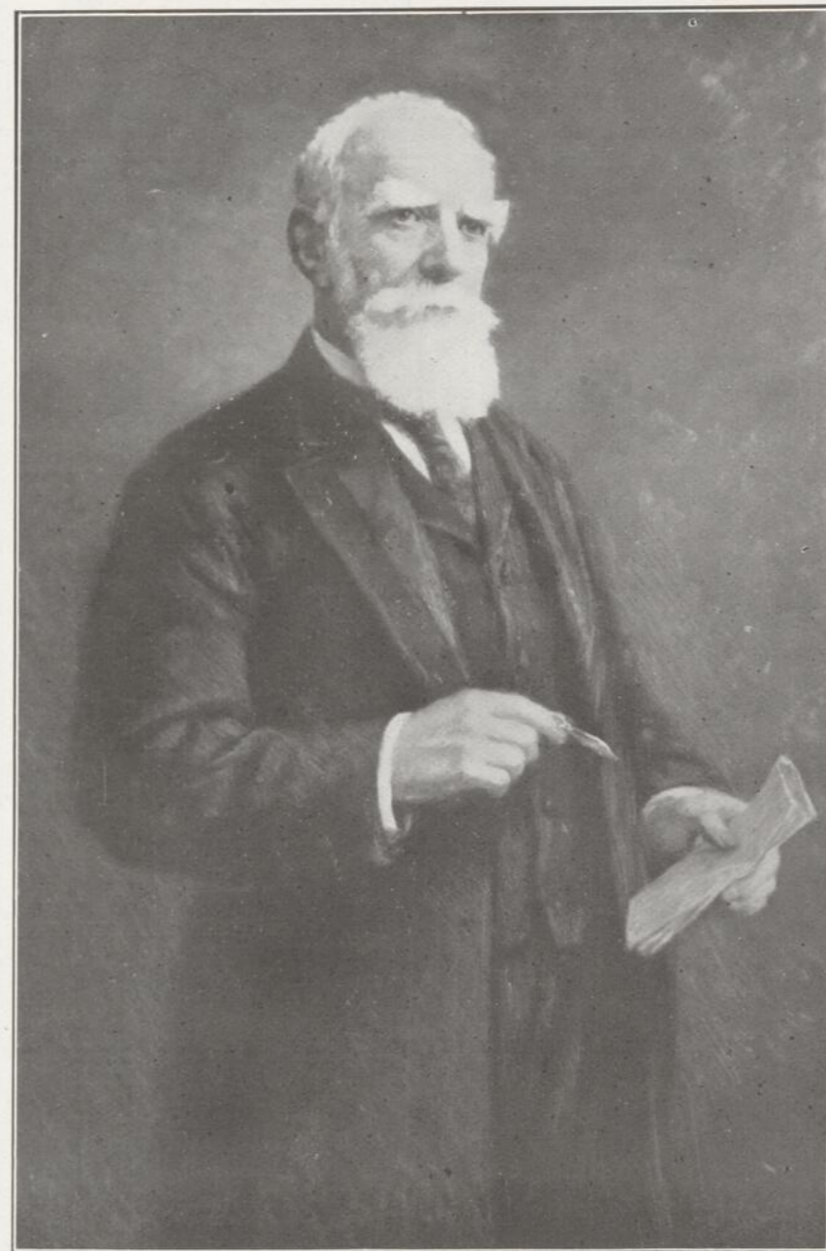

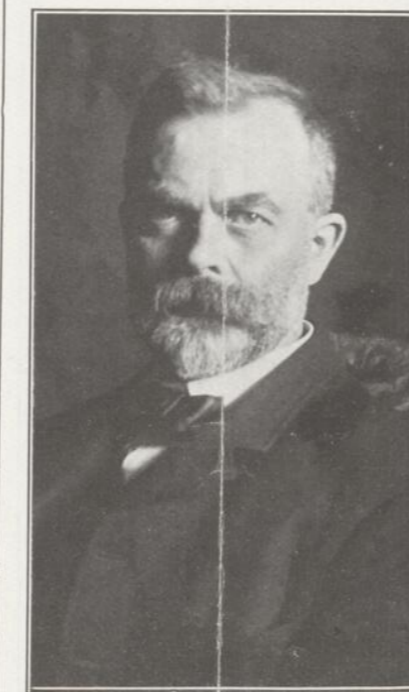
