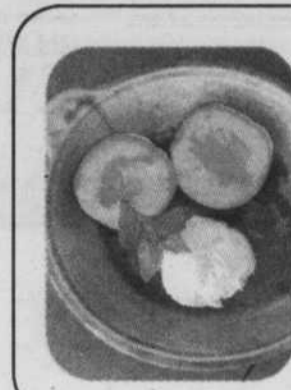

Paper art promoted by Danville gallery owner

For the past few years, the town of Danville has celebrated the Danville Arts Symposium, where visiting painters and sculptures recreate town scenes and display their works for admiration and an occasional sale.

But just three buildings up from the town square where most of the symposium activities take place is the a struggling artist who wants to showcase a more modest, yet ancient art that does not cost people a lot of money.

Noël-Ange Coderre is trying to promote paper art and wants to welcome visiting artists and their admirers to see more than paintings and busts.

"Paper art has been around for centuries in Asia, especially in Japan," she said at her Papiers Choisis store/workshop/gallery dedicated to the love of paper. "In North America, we make a lot of different types of papers and have done so for centuries, but we take it for granted and rarely realized the beauty and simplicity of the material."

Coderre opened up her shop last year in hopes of helping local arts and crafters use paper for more decorative and artistic works. She hopes the artistic inspiration that brings over Symposium 50 artists to Danville from all over Quebec and parts of Ontario, New Brunswick and Vermont can be extended to her endeavors.

"I want to welcome all the artists to my world and maybe spread to them the pleasure I feel when I make a new design or help someone create something useful for their lives."

She said she knows of only a handful of artists in Quebec who make and use different types of paper and cardboard. Many of them have learned how to make paper themselves and create different textures and qualities for specialized decorative needs.

"A lot of these papers are desired by people who want something special for wrapping gifts or sending cards and greetings," she said. "Some ask me to help them create designs and find new

ways to package the gift or the sentiment. When this is done, many of them realize that paper has more value and use than they thought."

Coderre wants people to understand that despite the world's desire for digital technology that no longer requires information printed on paper, the desire to use paper is far from over.

"People still value paper more than they do a computer screen and there

are millions of offices and homes that have papers filed away or hidden in their closets that they treasure.

"Many people keep old cards and drawings as keepsakes, as a way to keep memories of other people and places alive. I want to help them do that better."

Coderre said she has chosen not to be part of the Symposium given that it handles a higher volume of visitors

than she could handle. She wants to keep her store and workshop operating at a slower, less structured pace.

"I want the people who come to me to feel no pressure to follow a step-by-step approach," she said. "I want them to feel free to create and not let the cost of the materials hinder them. I want the experience to be a pleasure, not an enterprise. For me, small is beautiful."

Roasted peaches make winning dessert

I have a confession to make: This week I meant to give you a recipe for baked apples. I went to work on it, and all seemed well, the kitchen filled with a sweet aroma.

But then, upon opening the oven door, I saw — instead of a pretty arrangement of apples turning golden — a big, puffy, liquidy mess.

The apples had totally lost their shape, so in the end, my experiment had to be turned into apple sauce.

That's when I thought of making another fruit dessert — an easier one, at that — which could replace the doomed apples.

The recipe, adapted from British celeb Nigella Lawson's book, is so simple that it can hardly be called a recipe at all — just add butter and sugar to peaches, and bake.

The work is so minimal that you might just want to make this on a regular night, for yourself, instead of saving

it for a bigger occasion. After all, we are at the end of peach season, so this could be your last chance to get nice, ripe ones.

Serve it with whipped cream or vanilla ice cream, and I bet you'll go back for seconds.

ROASTED SUMMER PEACHES (FOR SIX PEOPLE)

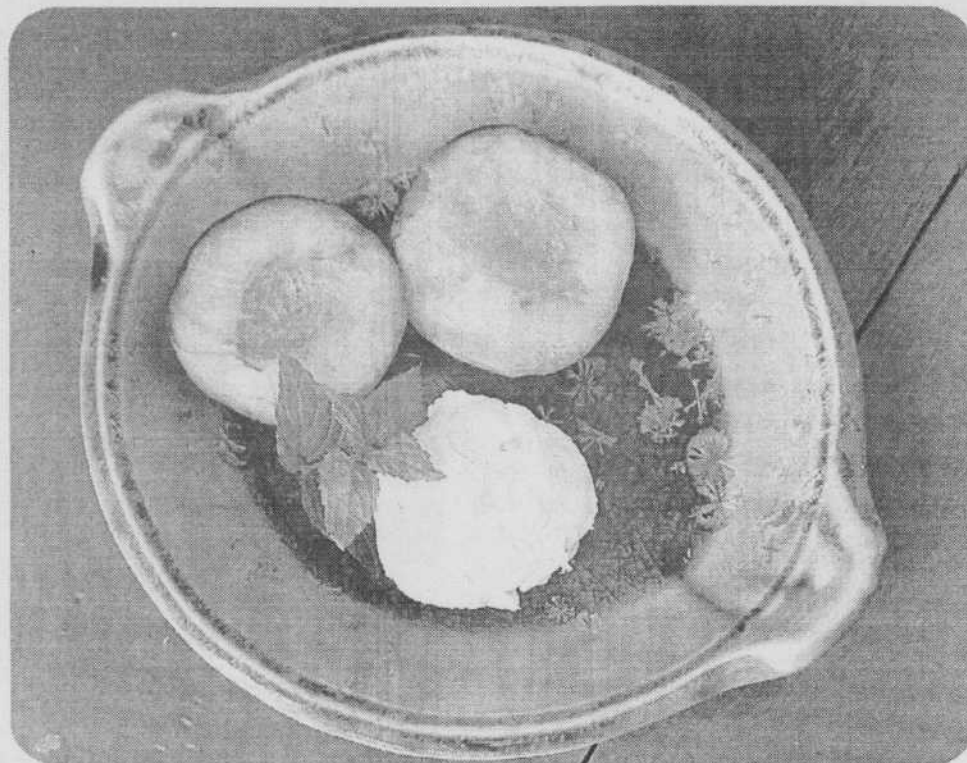
Ingredients:
6 ripe peaches
1/2 cup unsalted butter
1 1/2 tbsp. sugar

Directions: Preheat oven to 350 F. Cut the butter into 12 little cubes.

Cut the peaches in half lengthwise and split them open carefully. Remove and discard the pits.

Place them on a baking dish, cut side up. Place a little cube of butter into each peach cavity. Sprinkle the sugar evenly. Bake for 25 minutes.

Serve warm or at room temperature, with the ice cream or whipped cream on the side.

Foreman Gallery filled with patterns

It's an exhibit that is two years in the making. Jeannie Thib's Pattern Fields is now on display at the Foreman Art Gallery at Bishop's University in Lennoxville.

"The show only features five works, but they are very large in scale – as big as 53 feet by 12 feet. I chose a range of new and older works. What they all have in common is this use of textile – basically the repetition of a pattern. But it's not what it seems. The more you approach the work, the more the work will reveal itself to you," said gallery curator Gaëtane Verna. "Blind for example, is a floor piece that is the reproduction of a pattern built in cut wool felt. It transforms itself from a two-dimension piece (a pattern) to a sculpture."

Added Thib: "You have an impression when you first look at the pieces – but as you move closer, other revelations will surface. Divide – at first glance – looks like a language or a code. But something different is revealed when you approach the work. There are a lot of (sewing) pins in each piece, which suggest displays of actual botanical specimens which may have been the original source for the stylized flora of the design."

Thib has exhibited in Europe and

across Canada.

Verna said it is impressive how some of Thib's works cover an entire wall in the gallery.

"To think, it all came about from the simple repetition of a pattern. I like her idea of using a pattern, and making it different than its original purpose," said the curator.

Verna has wanted to show Thib's work since she came across it six years ago.

"Her work has an interesting link to the area, because of all the textile mills that used to exist in the region. I thought it would be special to showcase that at the gallery," she said. "The textile industry once played a big part in the region's economy, and textiles play are a big part of Pattern Fields."

Thib, a Toronto resident, is excited about her first solo show in Quebec.

"I haven't exhibited in the Townships at all... so I'm interested in getting people's reactions and comments," the artist said. "I hope my pieces reveal more to them as they take a longer look. That's what art should do: Make people think a little. I want people to take something away from mine – to remember it."

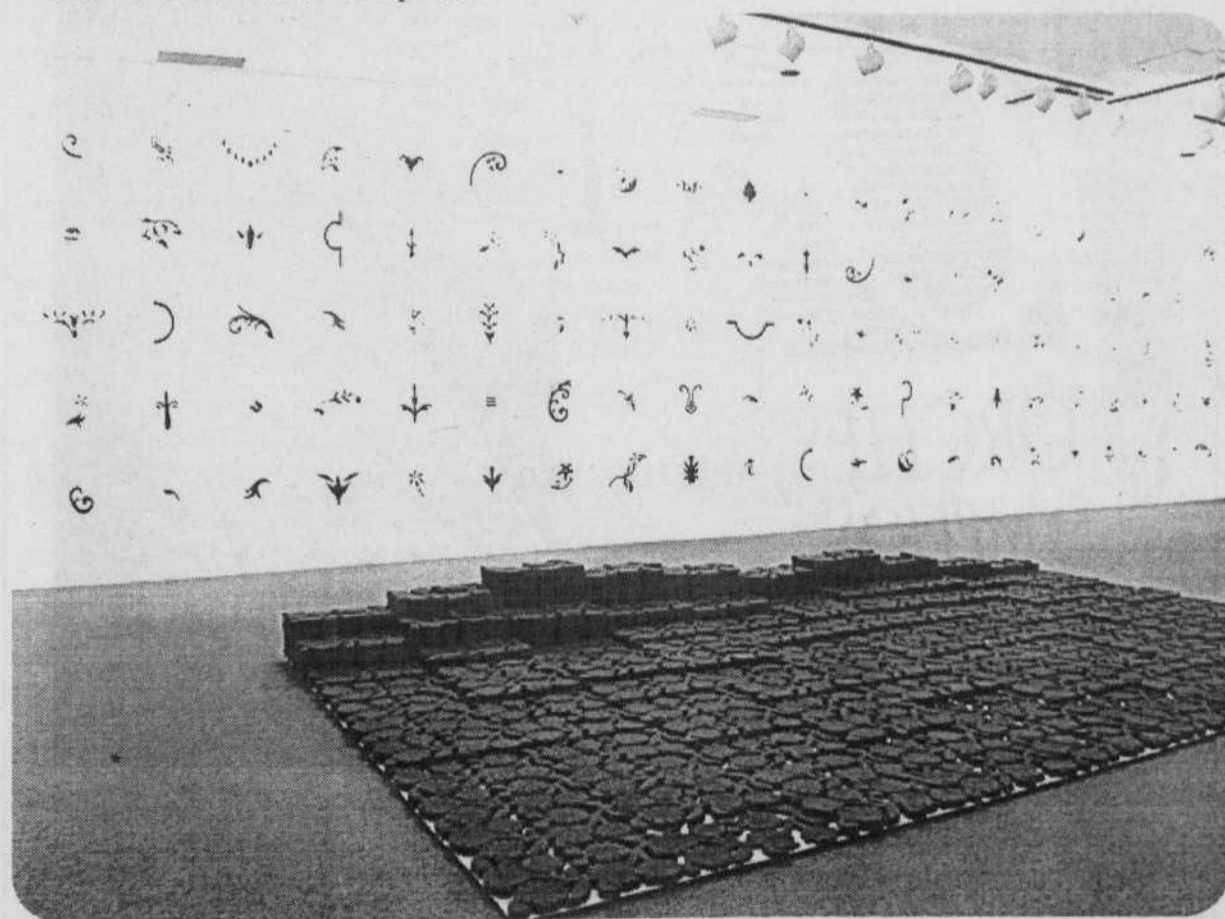

Centennial casts wide net, makes eclectic catch *Music*

The dawn of a new school year marks the launch of a new season at Centennial Theatre at Bishop's University in Lennoxville, but while hip-hop and alt rock will spill from dorm rooms, world music and jazz will be filling the theatre next door.

"We have to appeal to the community surrounding us, and not only the students," said Luce Couture, director of programming at Centennial Theatre, which is funded by Heritage Canada and Quebec's ministry of culture.

"It's to give a large variety to the people in the Townships. We serve both communities — English-speaking and French-speaking. All programs are for everybody and we're trying to find artists that are going to appeal to both communities."

The theatre is striving to bring something a little different to Lennoxville. Along with several world music vocalists and jazz ensembles, this season's repertoire includes concert music, in-

ternational pop groups, and dance.

The season begins Sept. 24 with a launch of Thomas Hellman's new CD, *L'appartement*. The Montreal musician was born to a Texan father and a French mother. His music reflects the linguistic duality.

His first release, *Stories from Oscar's Old Café*, was in English, but this, his second release, is a primarily French album with a handful of English songs.

Couture pointed out two other acts to watch for in October.

Cantabile, an a cappella quartet from England, is expected to offer a lyrical and lively take on jazz and Broadway standards.

"They're very funny guys, and they talk a lot to the audience. It's very lively and funny," she promised.

One of the greatest catches is Brazilian diva Virginia Rodrigues. Rodrigues will grace Centennial's stage as part of a tour that also includes visits to the Hopkins Center in Hanover, New Hampshire and the New York City hotspot, The Blue Notes jazz club.

Rodrigues has been praised as the emerging star to watch on the world music scene.

"I'm very proud of it," said Couture of this year's line up. "I think we have the best of each field that we offer. This year we were able to get artists that are beginning a career or are already rising stars in their domain."

While Couture admits Centennial Theatre is not catering exclusively to the taste of Bishop's students, there are events meant to bring them into the fold.

There will be a two-day conference for science students in the lead up to Tim Brady's *Three Cities in the Life of Dr. Norman Bethune* in late November.

Brady, a renowned contemporary guitarist, has composed a short opera based on the life of the groundbreaking Canadian physician and humanitarian.

"There's going to be a conference around it. We're going to try to interest people in that kind of music. It's very modern but very accessible at the same time."

Couture said the conference, Hellman's CD launch, as well as pre-show chats and post-show receptions throughout the season are meant to introduce audiences to the artists themselves, not only their music.

"We want to create real intimacy between the performer and the public," she said. "The choice of artists is very important because we are always looking for artists who can have a special relationship with students and the people around."

Danville becoming a community for artists

According to painter Richard Pranke, there are 138 art symposiums in Quebec where artists gather and show off their works for the public. But few of them offer the hospitality that is provided by the Danville Symposium that took place last weekend.

"At most of these symposiums, you have to pay for your meals and accommodations, and the atmosphere is one of business where you have to get your paintings sold to pay the bills," he said. "But in Danville, all the costs are taken care of by the organizers. All we are asked to do is create our art. We are well received and encouraged to do what we want to do."

Pranke was one of 53 artists invited to Danville's seventh annual Street Art Symposium. A native of Laval, he was joined by painters and sculptors from other regions of Quebec, as well as from New Brunswick and the town of Danville, Vermont, which is historically linked to Danville, Quebec.

Pranke believes that with the continued success of this symposium, Danville could evolve into a community where painters, sculptors and other artists could frequently visit and be allowed to create at will.

"In the state of New Mexico, there are several artistic communities that operate this way," he said. "Maybe towns like Danville could lead the way in Quebec."

Pranke said symposiums are usually set up to draw in tourists and art collectors. Money flows in for the town and the artists who can sell their works.

Pranke said the money and the crowds can be a motivator to create, but the pace of the events is often too much.

"I can get burned out going to too many of them," he said. "It is just roar

in and roar out and the town counts its money and goes back to normal. What we need is a small mecca for the artist where all forms of art can be explored and improved upon without a lot of financial pressures."

Such a venture is supported by the symposium's spokeswoman Rita Lafontaine, a Montreal actress who has set up a theatre workshop in the nearby town of Ham-Sud.

"Maybe what we need here and in Ham-Sud are several symposiums for other art forms such as acting and cinema," she said. "We have always realized that having artists in a community often helps creativity because one artist will support the other."

For experimental artist Rose-Marie Le Breton from Waterville, a warm reception, good meals and a place to sleep at night in the community gives her creative energy.

"We are accepted here and we get to meet many other artists and exchange ideas," she said. "If we can establish a network of artists here, there is potential for exploring all kinds of art."

Daniele Bergeron, who presented a mixed media presentation at the former bank building in the square, believes an art symposium in a small town is a better place to be than an urban gallery where art is bought and sold.

"Those are cold atmospheres and many artists try to avoid them when they can," she said. "It would be great to have a permanent residence here for the visiting artists and maybe a studio space where they could work in peace."

According to symposium president Rénald Gauthier, an estimated 25,000 visitors came to Danville to see the four-day symposium. He said it was too early to know how many pieces of art were sold or how much the local businesses benefited from sales during the event.

Toronto harvests world films

Will the Toronto International Film Festival become a victim of its own success?

The TIFF, as it is now affectionately known, seriously competes with the other world-class festivals in number, scope and influence. The 30th edition, which opened last night with Deepa Mehta's *Water*, promises to be another banner year.

In the next 10 days, 52 countries will have showcased 335 movies (256 features, of which 84 per cent are world, international or North American premieres).

Each year, attendance exceeds expectations. The last, with over 250,000 people, left its nearest competitor Berlin in the dust.

But some committed pass holders are wondering why they didn't get tickets to any of their first choice films. The prospect of spending hours in lineups is a turnoff for others. And we even know local movie addicts who've never attended the festival.

How can they when TIFF coincides with the beginning of the school year and the post-Labour Day rush back to serious business?

Still, as long as enough junkies choose to spend their vacation in TIFF theatres, as long as foreign movies draw audiences from Toronto's large

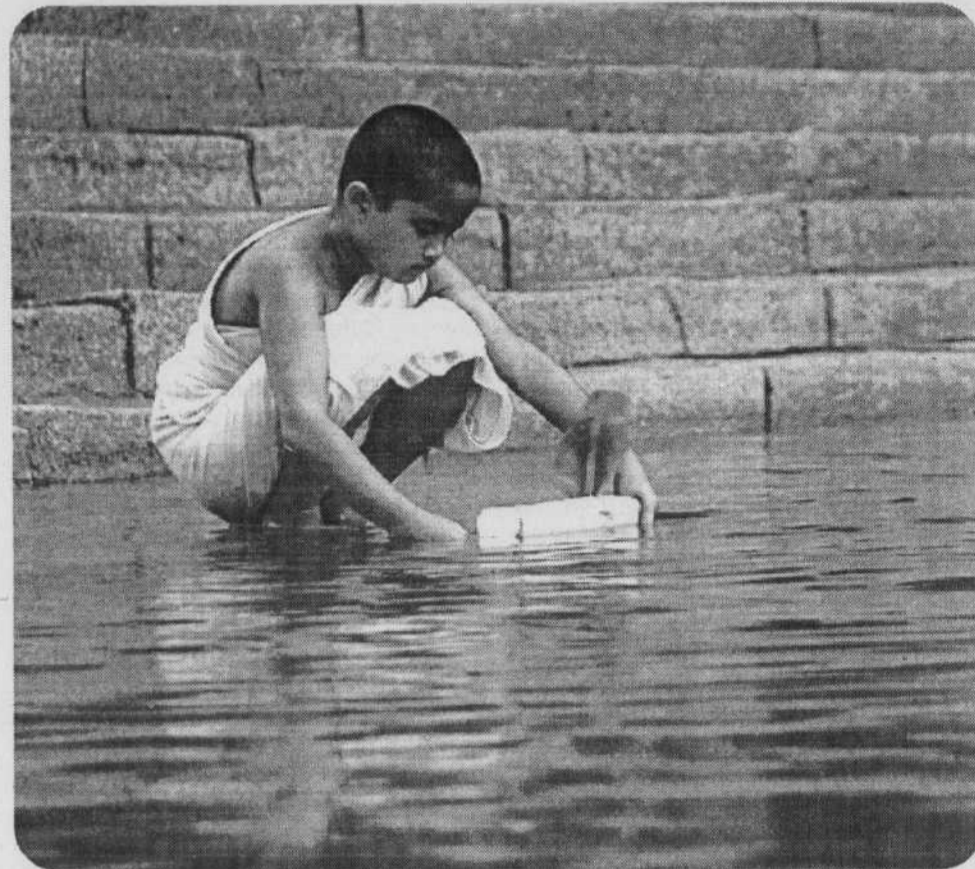
multi-ethnic population, as long as spotting screen idols lures the starry eyed, as long as Toronto lives up to its Amerindian name of "meeting place", this harvest festival will succeed.

By industry standards, TIFF is one of the big four. Scoring here virtually guarantees a film's commercial success. And, unlike Cannes, Berlin or Sundance, it's all based on popular appeal.

Ordinary moviegoers from Toronto's diverse cultural communities are second to none. Every film finds an audience. That's a pretty irresistible drawing card for many of the world's finest filmmakers.

TIFF built its success on the fact that Canadians love to watch. In the beginning, it was called "the Festival of Festivals," a meeting place for the world's cream of the cinema crop. Like our Amerindian predecessors, we see and trade trinkets.

Fulfilment of that mandate continues. A strong selection of 2005 prize winners and critically acclaimed movies from the world's leading festivals will get exposure here for the first time. To name a few: from Cannes, *L'Enfant* by the Dardenne brothers, Michael Haneke's *Caché*, *Free Zone* by Amos Gitai, Wang Xiaoshuai's *Shanghai Dreams*; from Sundance, *Why We Fight* by Eugene Jarecki, Jeff Feuerzeig's *The Devil* and Daniel Johnston, Noah Baumbach's

The Squid and the Whale, *The House of Sand* by Andrucha Waddington; and, winner at both Adelaide and Brisbane, *Look Both Ways* by Sarah Watt.

Inevitably, Hollywood blockbusters-to-be and high-power galas from every continent will bring stars like Gwyneth Paltrow, Anthony Hopkins, Sissy Spacek, Alec Baldwin, Susan Sarandon, Steve Martin and many others to the red carpet. These films are destined to be released commercially. Get ready for the hype.

As for those that don't make it to Townships theatres, there's always video, DVD or the 500-channel universe.

For example, *No Direction Home: Bob Dylan*, Martin Scorsese's monumental and frank portrait of the man who put his mark on music, will be televised on PBS Sept. 26 and 27. Don't miss it!

Beyond the glitz and glam, TIFF is where unknown filmmakers make their name (67 features are directorial debuts). Here, sleepers attract Oscar nominations. (Remember last year's *Sideways* and *Hotel Rwanda* or earlier hits like *Roger and Me*?)

This time, it could be *Look Both Ways* (Australia), *You Bet Your Life* (Austria/Switzerland), *Perpetual Mo-*

tion (China), *The War Within* (USA), *The Proposition* (Australia/UK), *Gentile* (France), *Shooting Dogs* (UK/Germany), *April Snow* (Korea) or other surprises we'll be looking for.

And we anticipate a barrage of post-9-11 musings from the implicated cultures. *The Sixth of May*, Theo van Gogh's last film before he was assassinated by a Moslem fanatic, is one of these.

Ironically, the docudrama deals with the 2002 slaying of a politician who was also critical of Islam's effect on secular Dutch culture.

A free panel discussion with producers and directors from the Netherlands about the issues raised in this film and in *All Souls* is an indication of TIFF's commitment to movies as dialogue.

Much remains to be seen between now and Sept. 17, when the TIFF reaches its climax. The closing gala is Edison, by David J. Burke in his debut as feature film writer and director.

We hear Morgan Freeman, Kevin Spacey, Dylan McDermott, LL Cool J and pop idol Justin Timberlake will be at Roy Thomson Hall to introduce this gritty thriller.

In a couple of weeks, we'll report back on winners, losers and Donnelly's hot picks for the coming year.

OUR LADY PEACE
Healthy in Paranoid Times

They're still alive and kicking. The band's seventh album was a long time in coming. As they point out in the albums liner notes, it took 1,165 days to breath life into *Healthy in Paranoid Times*. The notes highlight scrawlings of facts and figures that took place in the time it took to put the album together. The list randomly juxtaposes guitar strings used by the band with body counts from Iraq and Darfur. It goes on to list the number of people living in poverty to the amount spent on international arms; presumably these facts string together to illustrate the paranoid times suggested in the album title. But the music on the album doesn't go nearly as deep as the liner notes. The music pulls out a few new tricks. 'Where are you' opens with a Strokes-like guitar line, whereas a haunting organ line and out of focus guitar mark 'Wipe that smile off your face' before the heavy guitars hijack the piece and drown out the mood.

The Invisible Invasion
Deltasonic

The Invisible Invasion is where The Coral come into their own. The album debuted at number 3 on the charts in the UK late last spring. The six members of The Coral came together in the mid-90s when all were teenagers living in the same neighbourhood in Hoylake, not far from Liverpool. North America has been slow to pick up on the band's brand of neo-psychedelia. But *Invasion*, their fourth album in four years, might be the wake up call. It peels away some of the electronic layers that defined earlier work, leaving more room for guitars, bass, drums, and James Skelly's rich vocals. The album sheds the psychedelia and moves more towards intelligent indie rock, the likes of which are making waves on both sides of the Atlantic.

THE ROLLING STONES
A Bigger Bang
(Virgin/EMI)

The reason for Rolling Stones pre-tour product — the word used advisedly — remains unexplained. Typically for

their post-70s catalogue, this one has a decent EP buried in it. The Hot Stuff revisit 'Rain Fall Down', the blues throbber 'Back of My Hand', the dumb, but effective, 'She Saw Me Coming' and the Spanish Harlem strutter 'Biggest Mistake' are solid, but the 12 stiffs that come with them are mostly poor man's rewrites of 'It's Only Rock N' Roll' and 'Hang Fire', with the mandatory pair of Keith Richards tracks marking the low points. The aggressive, stripped-down sound promises a great time, but Mick and Keith no longer have the songs to build on it. File this with Voodoo Lounge and Bridges to Babylon.

DWYER/JONES/WHITAKER
Let Me Tell You About My Day
(Alma Records)

One of the biggest challenges for jazz musicians is the chordless trio, a band where neither piano nor guitar supports the aural architecture. Musicians have to work hard to fill the gaps, but not so hard that they overlap and sound like drones when they should be buzzing like honey bees. The Canadian trio on this Alma Records date stick to making honey. Saxophonist Phil Dwyer, bassist Rodney Whitaker and drummer Alan Jones fill the room with sound without becoming too busy. Take the Jones composition 'The Black Beer', a song where Whitaker lays down a walking bass line, Jones accents slightly off the beat and Dwyer's solo ebbs and flows on the currents the band creates. 'Two White Heads', a ballad Dwyer wrote to honour two late members of his family, is a tour de force for the tenor saxophonist, who creates a elegiac mood that is more celebratory than mournful. Whitaker's bass solo maintains the tone while Jones performs subtle brushwork on the drums. Dwyer does his best tenor playing on 'Camp Whitaker', another of his compositions.

Extremists who say Clapton hasn't made a vital album in 30 years might have a point. In the tradition of bland albums like *Journeyman* (1989), *Pilgrim* (1998) and the close-but-no-cigar *Reptile*

(2001), one of rock's greatest underachievers coasts through another snoozer of a set here. Lazy shuffles, overly-polite blues, reggae-lite rhythms and uninspired Philly soul dominate the soundscape, with little of it sticking to the palette. Even Clapton's dependable guitar work has a phoned-in quality, as it struggles to find its place in a mix dominated by horns and backup vocalists. With last year's tributes to Robert Johnson and a recent Cream reunion reminding us of his fiery musical roots, this album feels like an hour spent nursing a cup of weak tea.

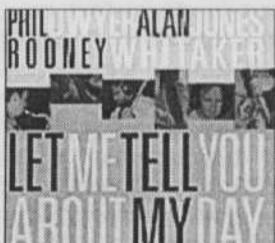

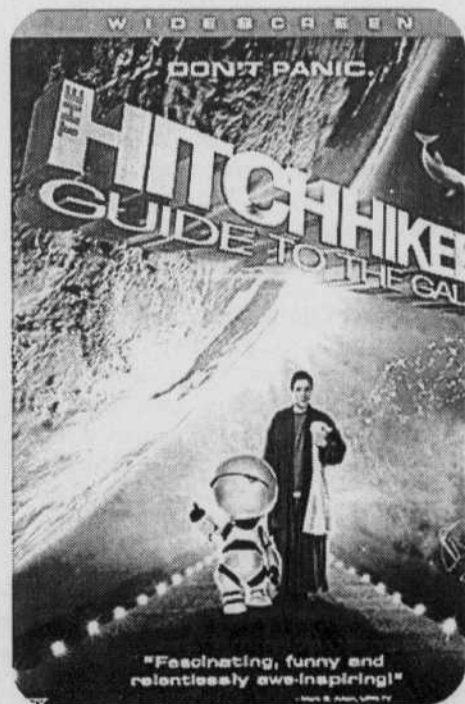

A twist of fate

This week's crime novel is set in Scotland and in St. Petersburg, Russia, with passing references to California and Northern Ireland. At the hands of a less experienced author, such a crazy-quilt of settings could easily lose focus; but Val McDermid is no stranger to crime fiction.

THE AUTHOR

I first met Val McDermid at a crime writing conference in Oxford, in 1997. She was — and remains — a formidable figure (forgive me, Val). About as wide as she is tall, she could easily play linebacker for any team in the NFL. But coupled with that imposing physical presence is an engaging personality, open and generous, and — like her protagonists — a passion for plain speaking: Whatever Val is thinking, you're sure to know it.

And behind her persona lies a consummate skill in telling a good tale, preferably over a wee dram of fine single malt, or if pressed, a Russian vodka. An evening with Val McDermid is never dull.

Since 1987 Val has written some 21 books, including a non-fiction study of real-life female private investigators, *A Suitable Job for a Woman*. The Tony Hill/Carol Jordan series are, in her own words, dark psychological thrillers.

The Kate Brannigan series are about a smart-mouthed PI based in Manchester. The Lindsay Gordon Mysteries are classic British mysteries, but with a contemporary twist: The protagonist is a lesbian journalist. *Hostage to Murder* is the sixth in the Lindsay Gordon series,

and stems in part from a visit she made to Russia under a British Council grant.

In addition to her series novels, Val has produced two stand-alone thrillers, *A Place of Execution* and *Killing the Shadows*. Along the way her books have garnered many awards, including the prestigious Barry Award, given at the Bouchercon (world mystery convention) for the Best British Crime Novel of 2004.

Television dramatizations of her works, starring Robson Green, have been aired in Britain and North America, under the title *The Wire in the Blood*, and are available on DVD. *A Place of Execution* is currently being adapted as a TV film. Val lives with her partner and their son in Manchester, England.

HOSTAGE TO MURDER

Lindsay Gordon is a 39-year-old ex-journalist returning to Glasgow from California with her partner, Sophie, after a 15-year absence, so that Sophie can take a teaching post in obstetrics at Glasgow University.

When Lindsay is out jogging one day, she badly sprains her ankle after colliding with a young woman, Rory McLaren. Tending to Lindsay's ankle, Rory discovers that they are both freelance journalists. Since Rory is overworked and Lindsay is at loose ends, they decide to join forces. Lurking in the background is Sophie's overwhelming desire to have a child of her own. Lindsay is apprehensive, fearful that her relationship with Sophie will suffer, and angry as well that Sophie is absolutely committed to having the baby, regardless of Lindsay's concerns.

Meanwhile, in Belfast, IRA capo Patrick Coughlan has learned that his former mistress, Bernadette Gourlay, has surfaced in Glasgow — a matter of some concern to SEE CRIME, P. 16

Bergen brings us a new, hypnotic story

A young Asian woman, dressed in immaculate, flowing white clothes, pedals a red bicycle down the street, her posture erect, her expression serene. It's a photo from Vietnam and it's on the cover of *The Time in Between* (McClelland & Stewart, 273 pages), the new novel from Winnipeg's David Bergen.

The book tells a classic story. Charles Boatman, an American Vietnam vet who lives reclusively on Sumas Mountain near Abbotsford, travels to Vietnam 28 years after he was a soldier in that misbegotten war.

Unlike the Harvey Keitel character in *Three Seasons*, Tony Bui's excellent 1999 return-to-Vietnam movie, he's not looking for a child he fathered there. He just wants to revisit the country where the most traumatizing events of his life took place and find — let's not call it closure, but some kind of resolution.

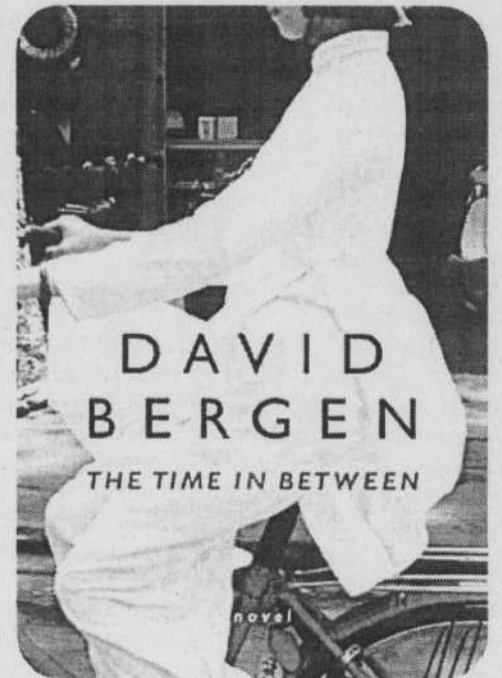
Bergen, who is 48 and best known for his third novel, *The Case of Lena S.* (2002), didn't go to Vietnam as a soldier. But in 1996, he volunteered through the Mennonite Central Committee to teach English there.

Although the job didn't pan out in the end, he, his wife and their four children ended up spending six months in Danang, the country's fourth-largest city. He made friends with several Vietnamese artists and jotted down his observations, thoughts and feelings.

Originally, he planned to use them in writing a non-fiction book about Bao Ninh, a North Vietnamese man whose book *The Sorrow of War* had moved him. But he didn't manage to meet Bao and instead eventually wrote *The Time in Between*.

It's a graceful, hypnotic story about gruff Mr. Boatman — and Ada and Jon, two of his grown children who go looking for him in Vietnam after he stops phoning home.

Bergen is, of course, well aware of the many American books and movies probing



the war and its aftermath — everything from *Coming Home*, the 1978 movie starring Jane Fonda and Jon Voight, to Tim O'Brien's 1994 novel, *In the Lake of the Woods*.

On the phone from Winnipeg, he acknowledges that he is "following in big footsteps."

Yet he feels his novel takes a different approach. "For one thing, I'm a Canadian, an outsider sort of looking in on the two different cultures that were in conflict."

What interested him was the Vietnamese attitude toward the war — "not in opposition to the American attitude, but there was a slightly different slant on their take. I was curious about that, without becoming too political about it."

He says he wrote not just about "an American soldier's tortured vision of the world" but also about the man's daughter, son and the Vietnamese people they meet.

On his trip to Vietnam, Boatman takes a copy of *In a Dark Wood*, a North Vietnamese soldier's war novel. Bergen gives us a 16-page chunk of that work, which came straight from his imagination, fuelled by having read Bao Ninh.

In the passage, a North Vietnamese soldier summarily executes a baby and its young mother. The horror of these events is amplified by the plainspoken lyricism of Bergen's prose:

Film awakened Weisz's social conscience *Movies*

It's not often that the star of the movie gets murdered in the first five minutes.

"But I think it's okay to say it in this case," Rachel Weisz smiles.

That's because *The Constant Gardener* moves backward and forward in time with the result that by the end, you have come to know Weisz's character in intimate detail: Her bristling idealism; a political and social activism that eventually places her life in jeopardy when she takes on big government and the international pharmaceutical industry; her love for her husband, a mild-mannered diplomat (Ralph Fiennes) who only realizes how much he loves her after he loses her.

"I love the fact that it's a retrospective love story, that it's told in flashback," the 34-year-old actress says. "There are a lot of assumptions that Ralph and the audience make about my character which are then revised as the film goes on. I think it's a beautiful narrative structure that's very original."

In a way, working on the movie was a life-changing experience for Weisz.

"I've always been fascinated by activists, people who will devote their life to a cause, people who will go to India and Africa and put their life in jeopardy to do what they believe is right," she says.

All this, Weisz finds, is so removed from the pampered life of a movie actor.

"What I do for a living is completely different. I'm a storyteller and an entertainer. I'm nothing like my character, but I had a responsibility to do justice by these people, and I've always been fascinated by what makes these people tick."

Furthermore, she does worry about the world in which she lives.

"In reality, the main thing that keeps me awake at night is probably the destruction of the planet. That's what gets me upset."

She was also upset by the subject matter of the film which is based on John Le Carre's best-selling thriller about the shadier workings of the pharmaceutical industry — in this case the use of unsuspecting Africans as human

guinea pigs for dangerous new drugs. And, her social conscience was further stirred by her research.

"In England, Oxfam were very generous. They allowed me to talk of a lot of people who had been working in the field. But the real inspiration happened in Africa."

During her months shooting the film in Kenya, Weisz came to know an African woman who has been living with HIV for the last 12 years.

"She was a counselor for women with HIV in the slums. She was incredibly generous and allowed me to accompany her on house calls around the shantytowns to visit patients. Meeting the people of Africa was the inspiration. I'd never seen such poverty on that level ever in my life. It's very extreme — no sanitation, no running water... and a very high level of disease.

She thinks some of the best scenes in the film were not in the script — improvised encounters which she and Fiennes had with the Africans. Such moments were encouraged by director Fernando Meirelles.

"The way Fernando works — he really values spontaneity and improvisation. He allows you to stray from the text and try things."

Such spontaneity was also encouraged in her more intimate scenes with Fiennes.

"Ralph and I like to try new things. If the love story is believable, I think it's because of that."

This, she observes, is the classic love story about opposites attracting.

"She is volatile and flighty and likes to rock the boat. He's the exact opposite. He's a diplomat. He likes to keep the peace. He's emotionally reserved. He's her rock. He gives her stability and she feels immediately safe with him."

So what kind of movie is *The Constant Gardener*? A thriller? A political and corporate expose? Or a love story?

"What I love about the film is that I think it's all these things. It is a political thriller, but at the same time it's a big soulful love story about longing and loss."

him as she fled several years earlier with his young son, Jack.

Coughlan wants the boy back at any cost, and dispatches two of his goons to track her down. But before he can act, Bernadette's ex-husband, Bruno Cavadino, appears at Jack's school, spiriting him away to St. Petersburg, Russia.

When Bernadette's present husband, Tam Gourlay, wants to rescue Jack, Lindsay and Rory, realizing that he cannot accomplish this on his own (and sensing a good story), join forces with him and travel to Russia. Meanwhile, Coughlan is lurking in the background, waiting for their return home with his son.

When Lindsay and Rory are drawn together into an intimate relationship

during their time in St. Petersburg, Lindsay tries to sort out her feelings. The situation is worsened when Sophie suspects her infidelity, and Lindsay admits it. Sophie throws her out of their home just as Coughlan is moving in for the kill.

RECOMMENDATION

Hostage to Murder contains a refreshingly original plot line, as do all of Val McDermid's novels. The story moves effortlessly and enjoyably to its conclusion, while raising along the way issues of loyalty, betrayal, and honesty that transcend the gender boundaries of this tale.

Whether you pick up *Hostage to Murder* as a study in contemporary relationships, or simply as a smashing good read, you will not be disappointed.

Laurie ready for season debut of House



Blame the bin Laden tape. Hugh Laurie, English character actor familiar for playing foppish twits in class-conscious British comedies like *Blackadder* and *Jeeves and Wooster*, was filming last year's big-screen clinker *Flight of the Phoenix* in the Namibian desert, when he recorded an audition tape for the lead role of a cranky doctor in a new TV show called *House*.

Laurie had grown a beard, for his *Flight of the Phoenix* role. He looked, to hear him describe it, like hell on earth.

Emaciated from weeks of self-imposed deprivation, woozy from the relentless African sun and inwardly skeptical at the absurdity of an upper-class English twit playing a bad-tempered, Vicodin-popping American doctor - with a gimpy leg, no less - Laurie recorded what he surmises just might have been the most bizarre, off-putting audition tape in the history of entertainment television. It was, he says, his Osama bin Laden moment, and he buried himself in the role.

Little could he have known that David Shore, *House's* Canadian creator, head writer and executive producer - and filmmaker-producer Bryan Singer, would take one look at Laurie's audition

tape and say: "That's our *House*."

Little more than a year later, with one season of *House* behind him and another about to begin, not to mention that Emmy nomination - the actual awards will be handed out on Sept. 18 - Laurie is suddenly faced with the peculiar prospect of being labeled a sex symbol, a lady's man and the quintessential American actor. Die-hard devotees and casual viewers alike recoil when they hear the Eton in his off-screen accent.

Laurie, far from being the upper-class English snob about it, is privately tickled by the newfound attention.

He has also found time to shave and don a better cut of clothes. The only resemblance to bin Laden now is that both men are tall and lanky.

"I'm rather enjoying the whole process of reinvention," Laurie said recently. "To be able to pretend to be something that I'm frankly not is very liberating and exciting."

Playing the irascible Dr. House, a diagnostician who hates patients almost as much as he loves a good medical mystery, has not turned Laurie off the medical profession in any way. He would, he insists, take the kind of abuse Dr. House hands out to his patients, if he were on

the receiving end.

"Yes," he said. "I love abuse. I really do. But I have a private arrangement with someone. You needn't know about that."

Yes, the real Dr. House is also capable of being serious. On occasion.

"Plainly, if your life is hanging in the balance, the most important thing to you at that moment is going to see the best person for the job," Laurie said. "If you have an ingrown toenail, then the abuse would probably take on a different shade of importance. It's all about proportion, isn't it? If your life, or the life of someone you love, is hanging in the balance, of course you would withstand any amount of abuse to get the job done and to get the life saved. Of course, you have to be convinced that person knows what they're doing. In real life, you have no way of knowing that you're dealing with the best person for the job. It's only on television that you can know that."

House's physical ailment - chronic pain from a crippling injury to his leg - affects the way Laurie plays him, but not in the way one might expect.

"It's not his physical gait that is transforming," Laurie said. "It's the having

one hand. It's being one-handed. I find that much more constricting than walking with a limp. Actually walking with a limp is not that troubling. But to be one-handed, to drink a cup of tea and put two sugars in, and open a door and answer a telephone - it all becomes incredibly time-consuming."

Characters don't always change, however. In subtle ways, over time, perhaps - but deep down, faithful viewers suspect *House* has not changed much from the day he delivered his first diagnosis in the first episode, when he said: "Brain tumour. She's going to die. Boring."

It's up to Laurie, and to Shore, Singer and *House's* writers, to show *House* maturing over time, growing older and wiser. Sela Ward will return for seven episodes this season as *House's* ex-flame, newly married, and she rekindles a light in him.

It will all be very subtle and on the up and up, however. This is not *Desperate Housewives*. Shore named his lead character - *House* - as a synonymous tip of the hat to Sherlock Holmes ("*Homes*"). Whatever happens with Dr. House from here on, it won't be elementary. And Laurie is perfectly happy with that.

The white sky, the grey smoke, the blue pants of the men, the brilliance of the sun off the blade of the scythe, the thin red line at the baby's throat, an infant's howl descending into a mother's wail, and then that wailing, too, gone, disappearing like the pink bubble that rose from the opening at the mother's neck.

He writes with equal strength of Ada Boatman visiting the Vietnamese village where her father killed a boy and begging her Vietnamese companion to ask an old man there if he remembers that moment.

Of course, it's unlikely the old man would want to cast his mind back to that time. Her companion tells her time comes in layers, each one burying the one before.

Bergen says that image of layers came to him late in the writing, perhaps in the book's fifth draft. It shows how Ada and her Vietnamese companion have different views of the world.

"Where she has a sense of immediacy and a goal, he stands back and lets it evolve."

The Time in Between is Bergen's first work of fiction set outside Manitoba. Publisher McClelland & Stewart expects it will be his breakout book and is, according to Quill & Quire, giving it a \$40,000 advertising push.

It's sure to reach readers beyond Canada. Random House will publish it in the United States in December. A French edition is also planned.
